DESCRIPTION

FIG. 11 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 8.

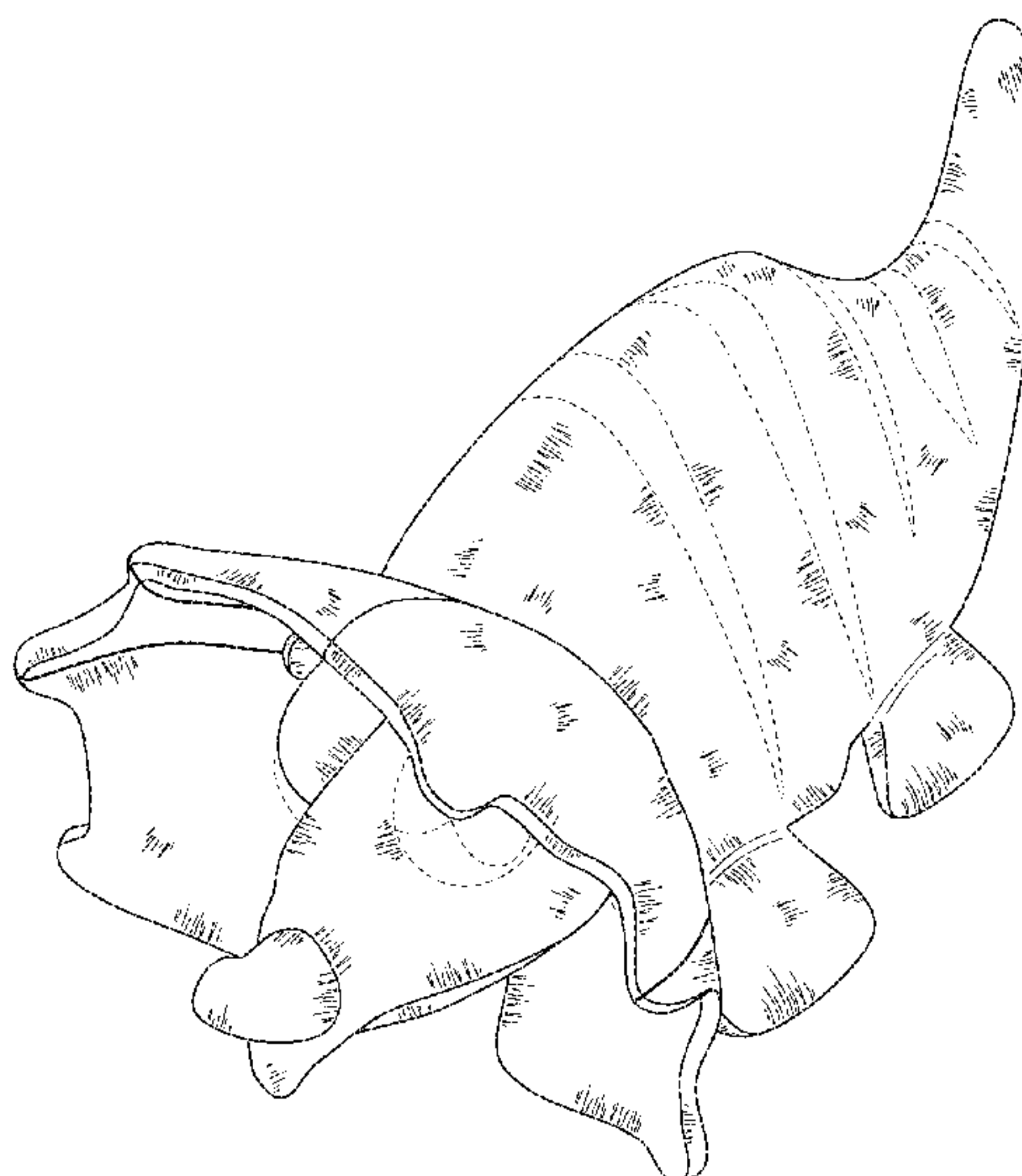
FIG. 12 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 8.

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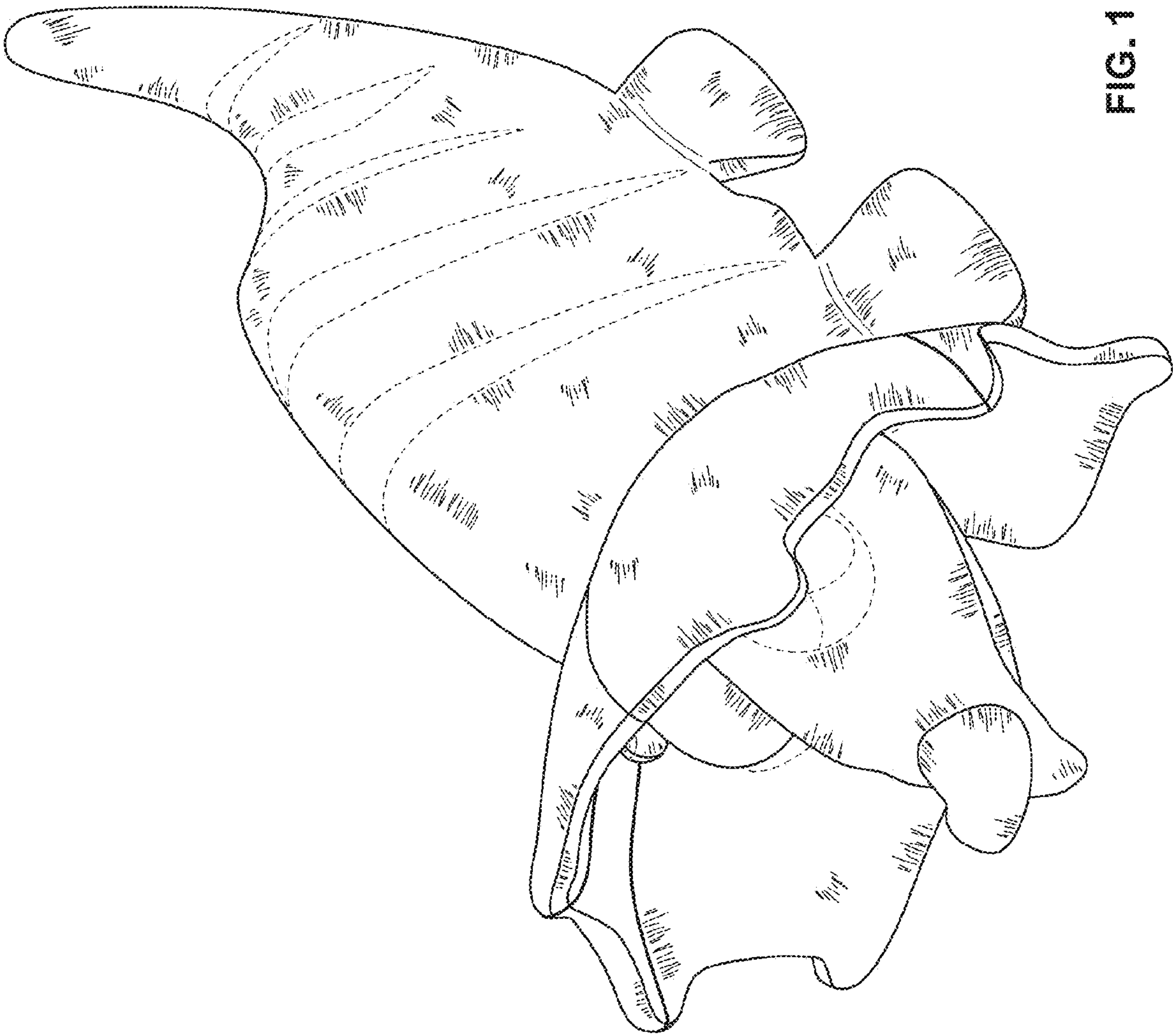

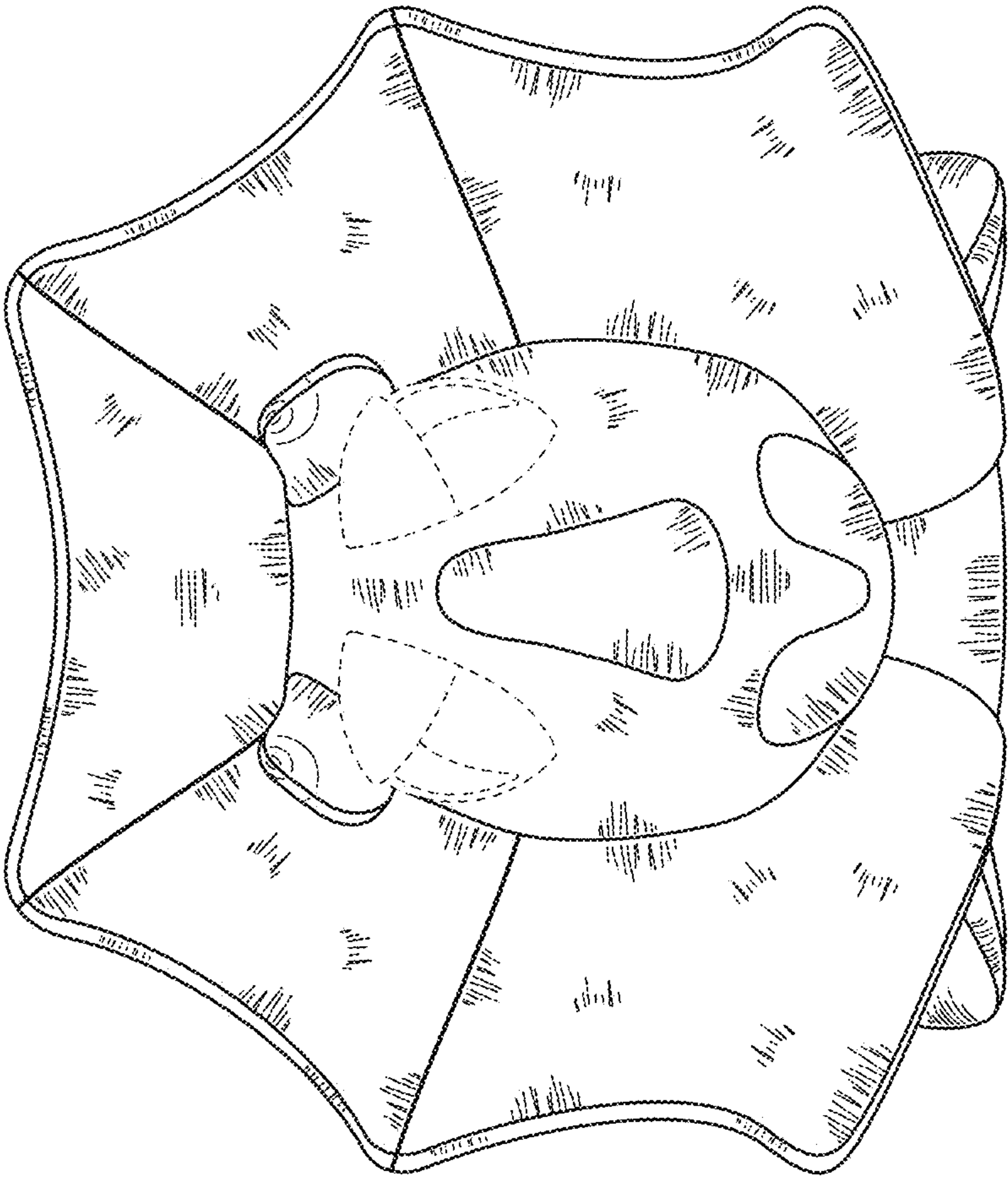

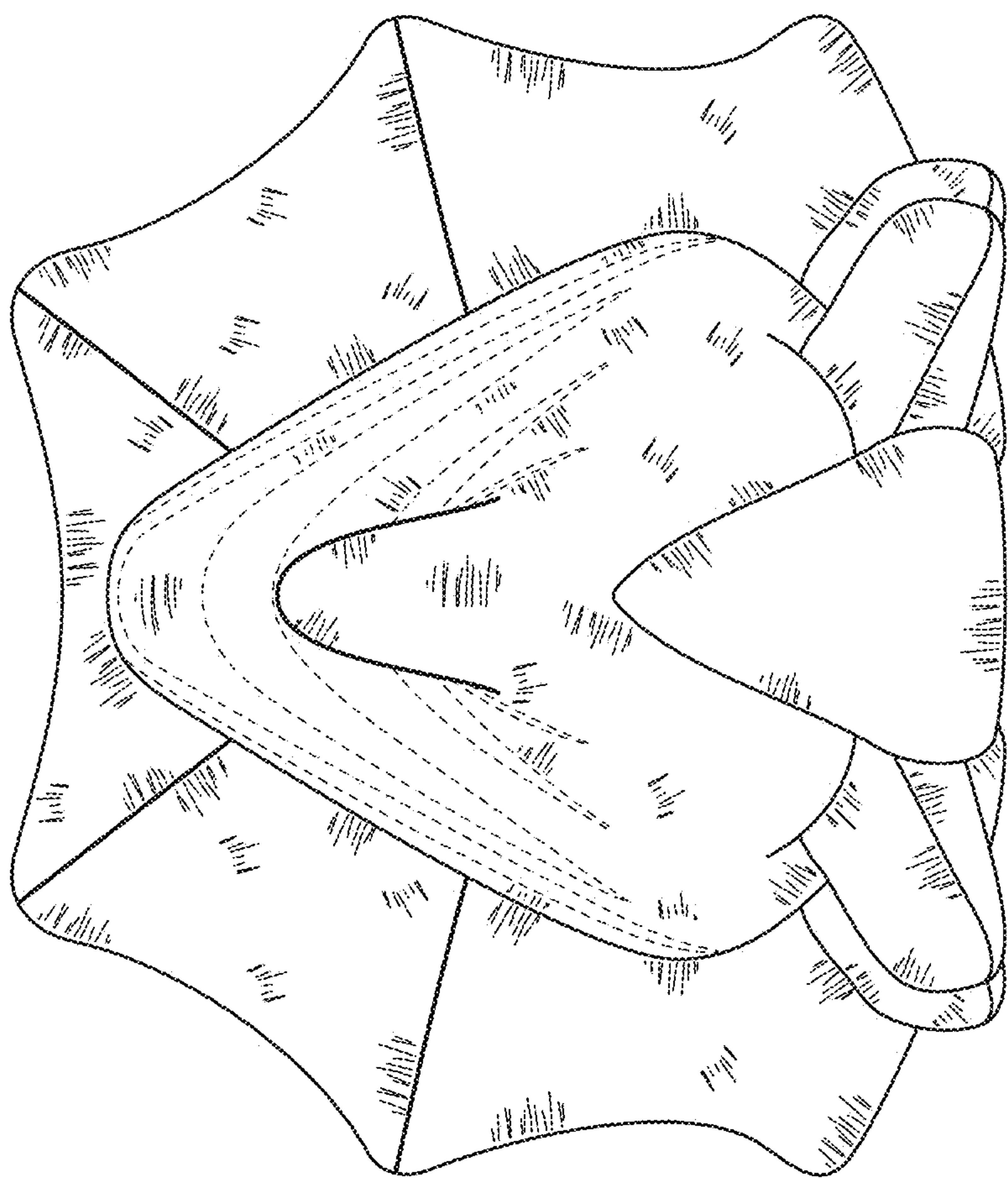

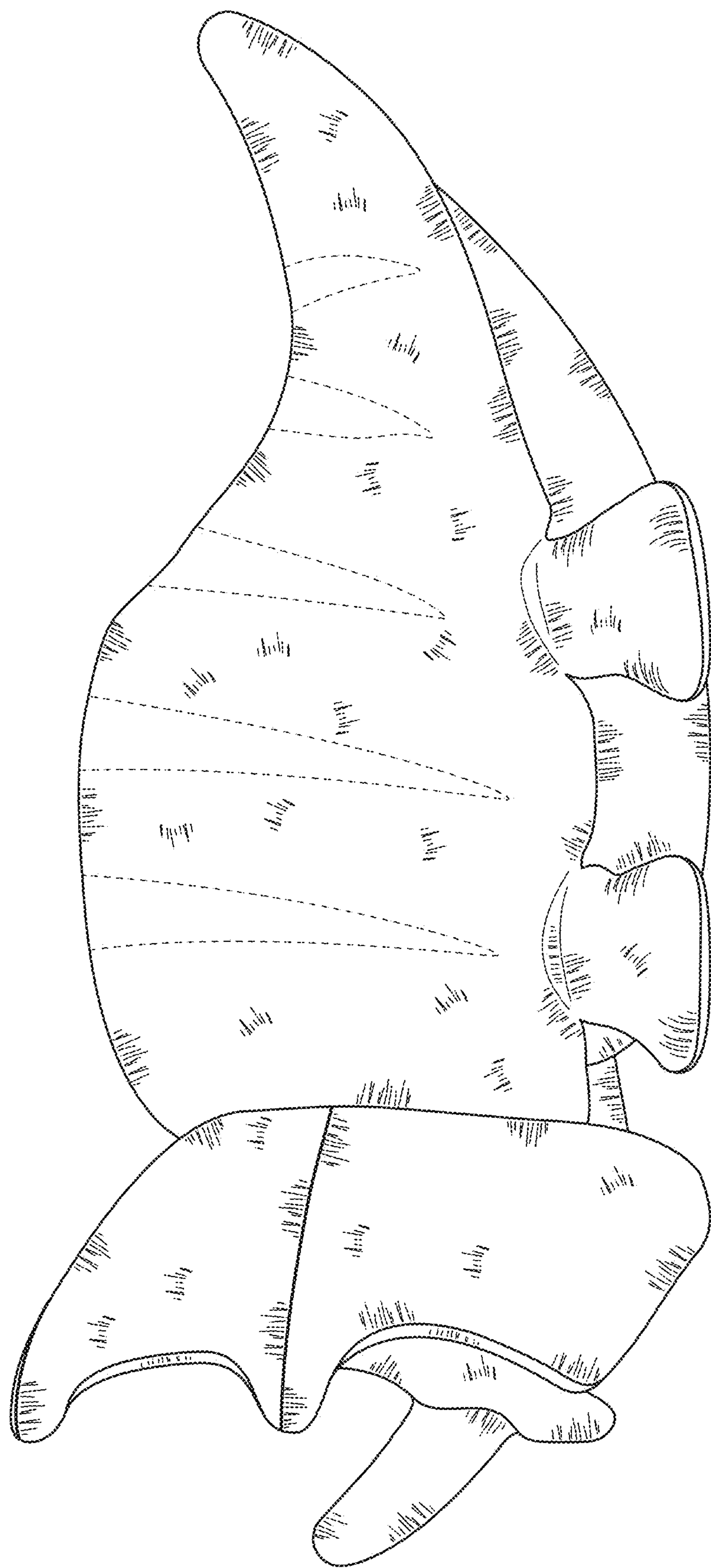

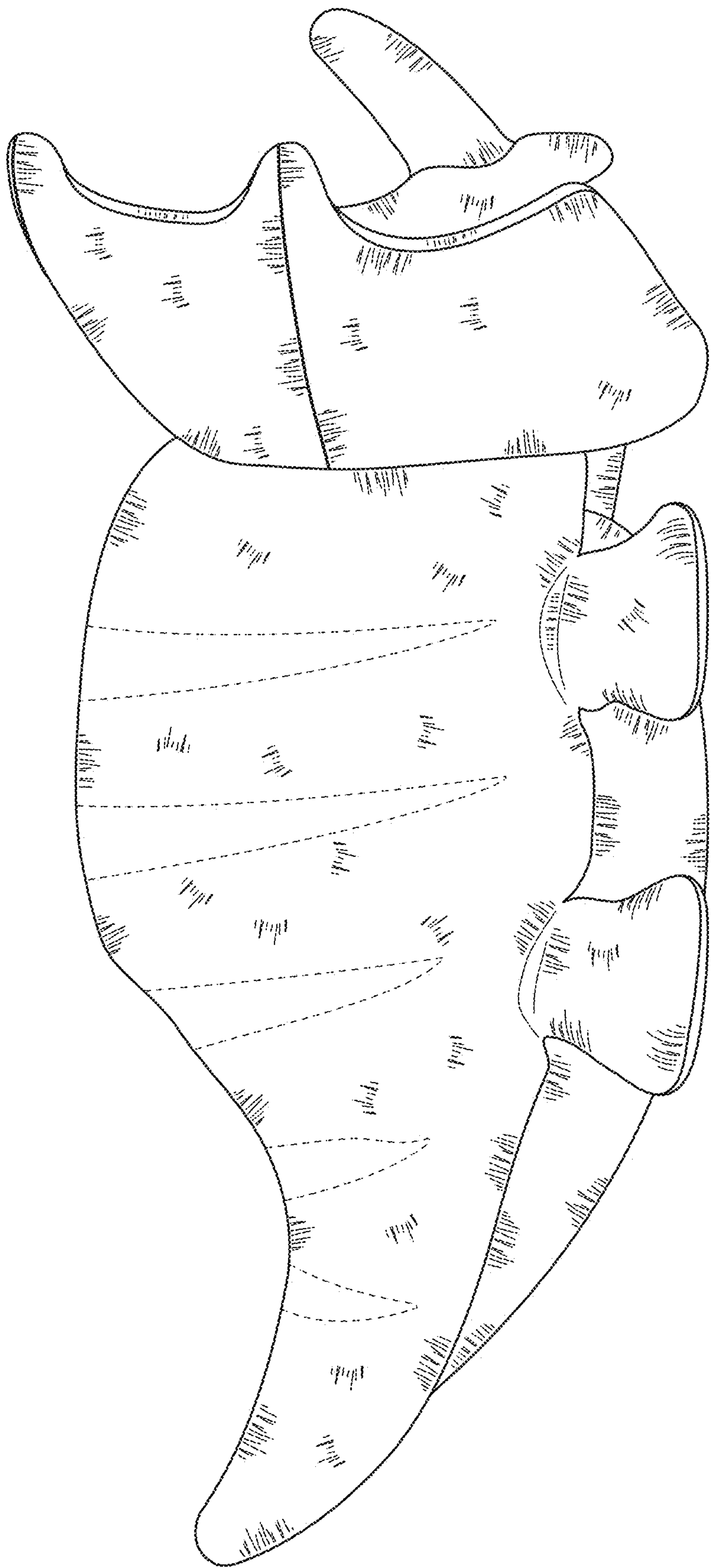

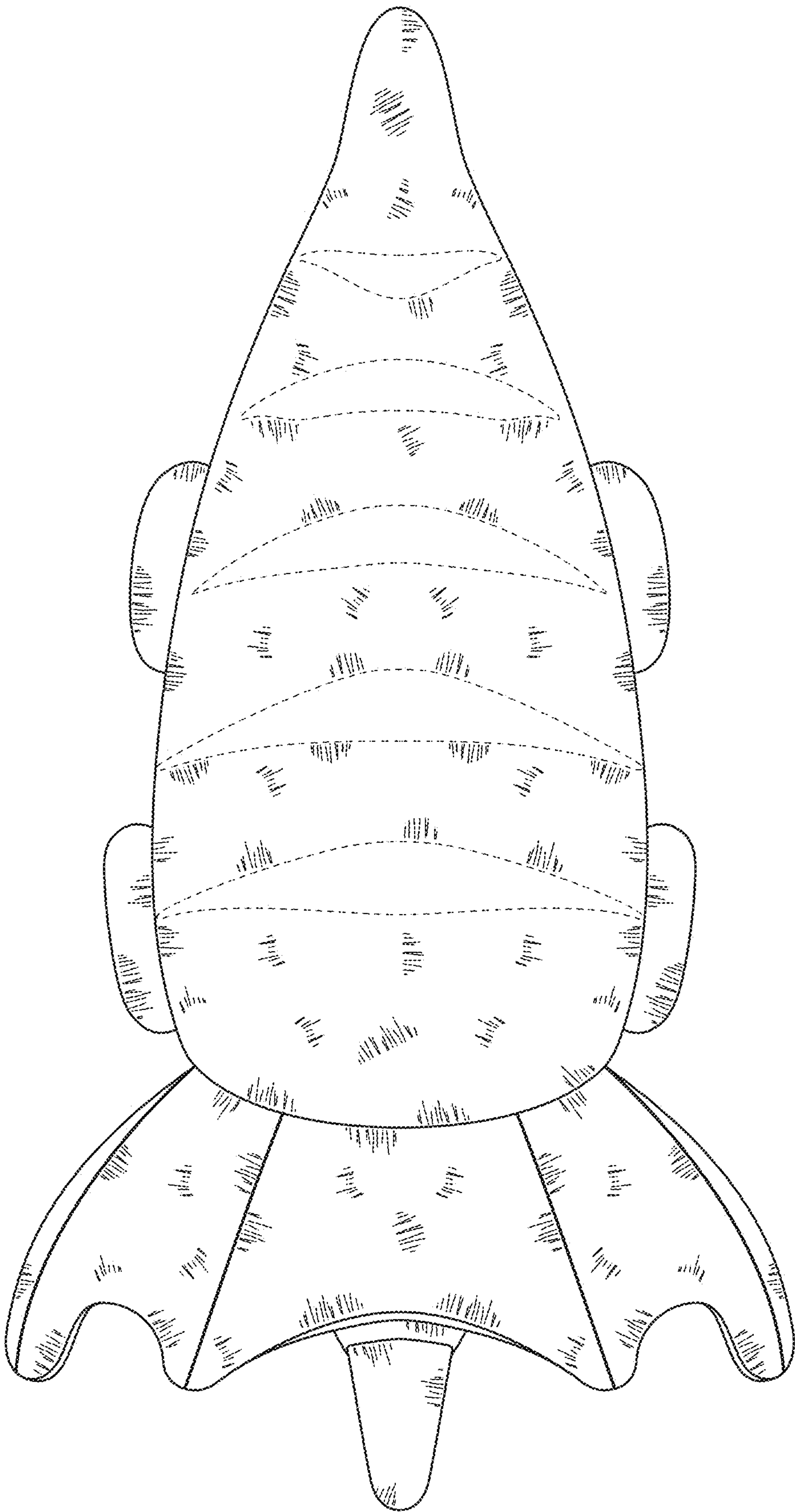

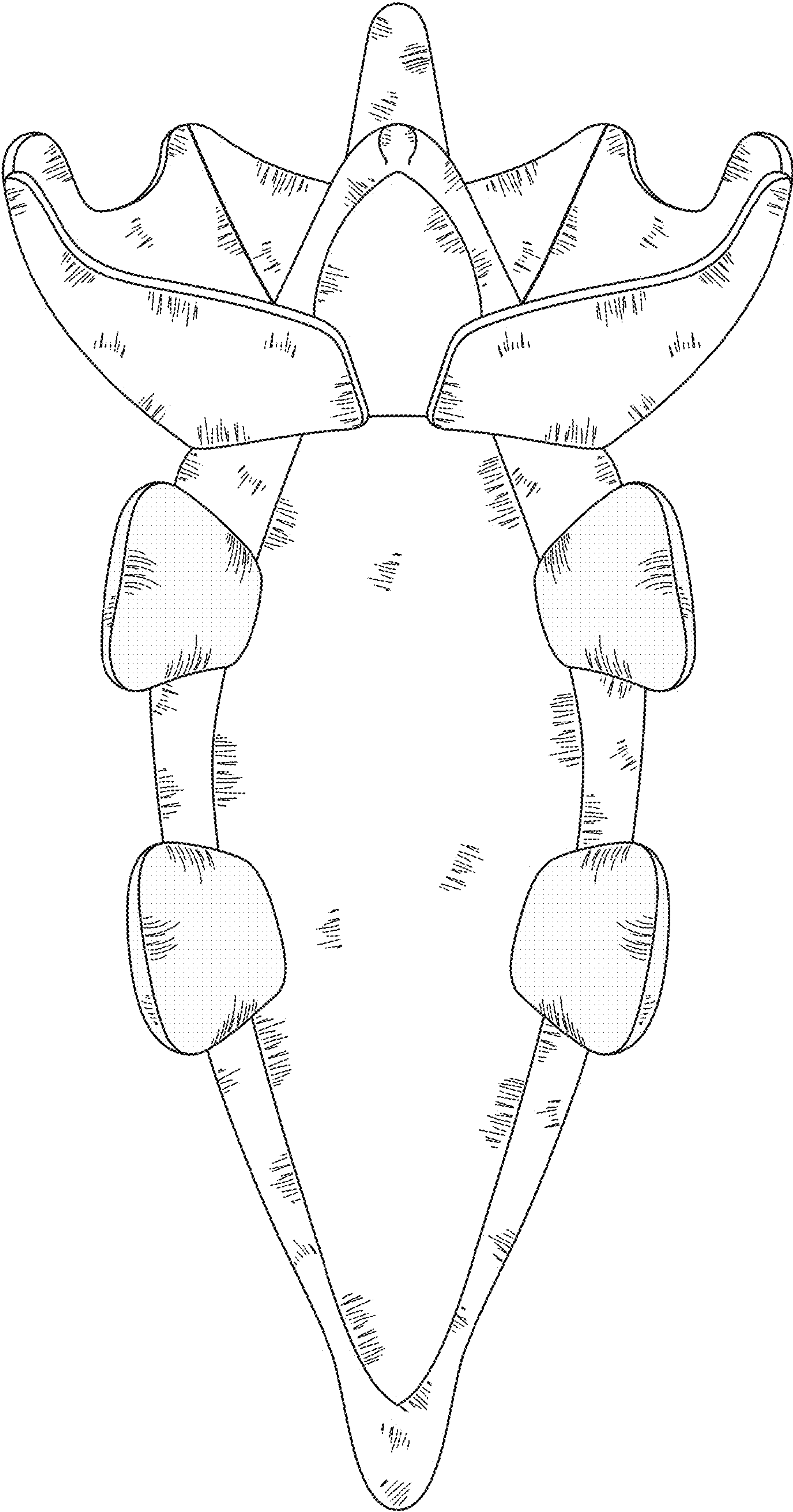

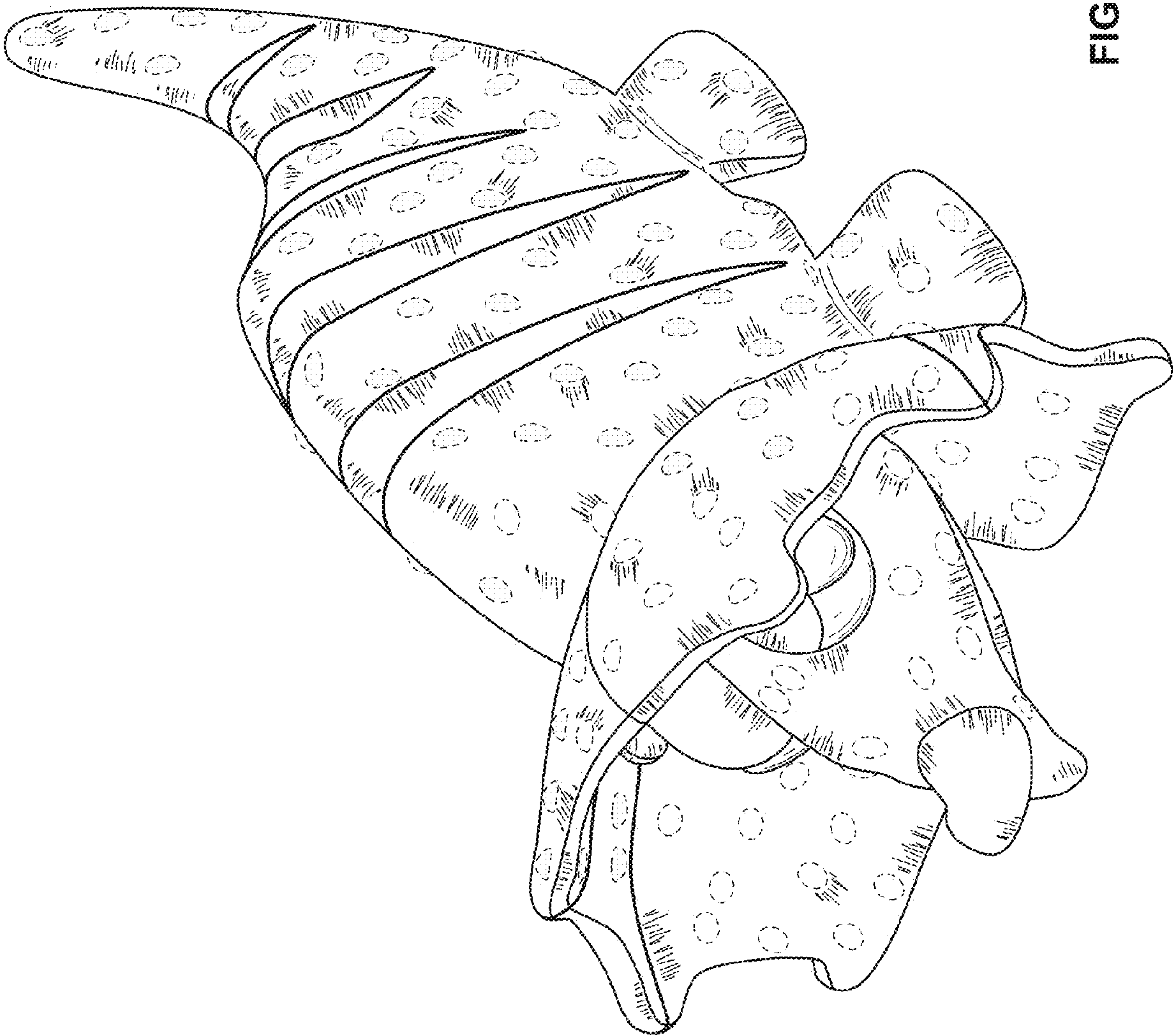

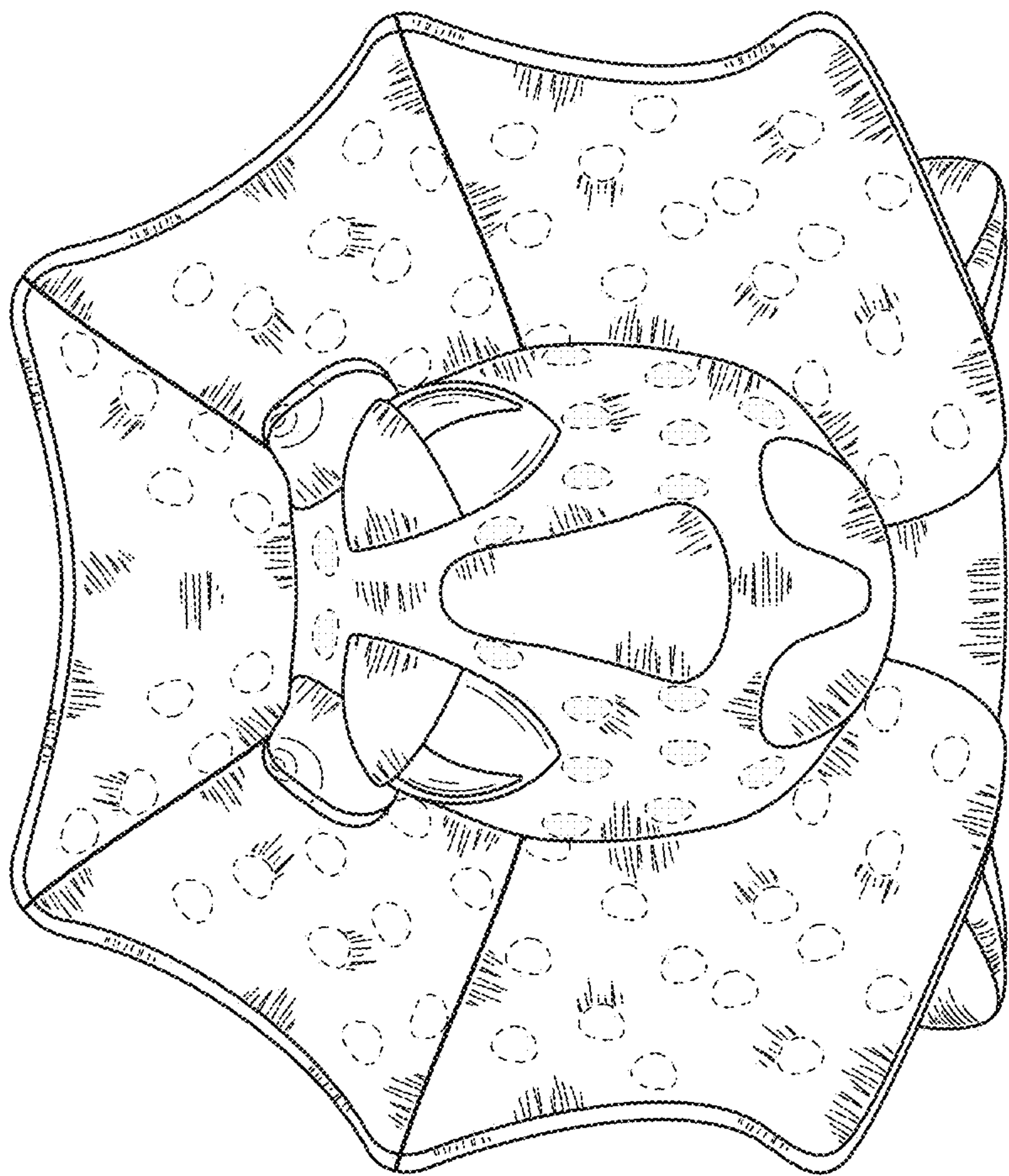

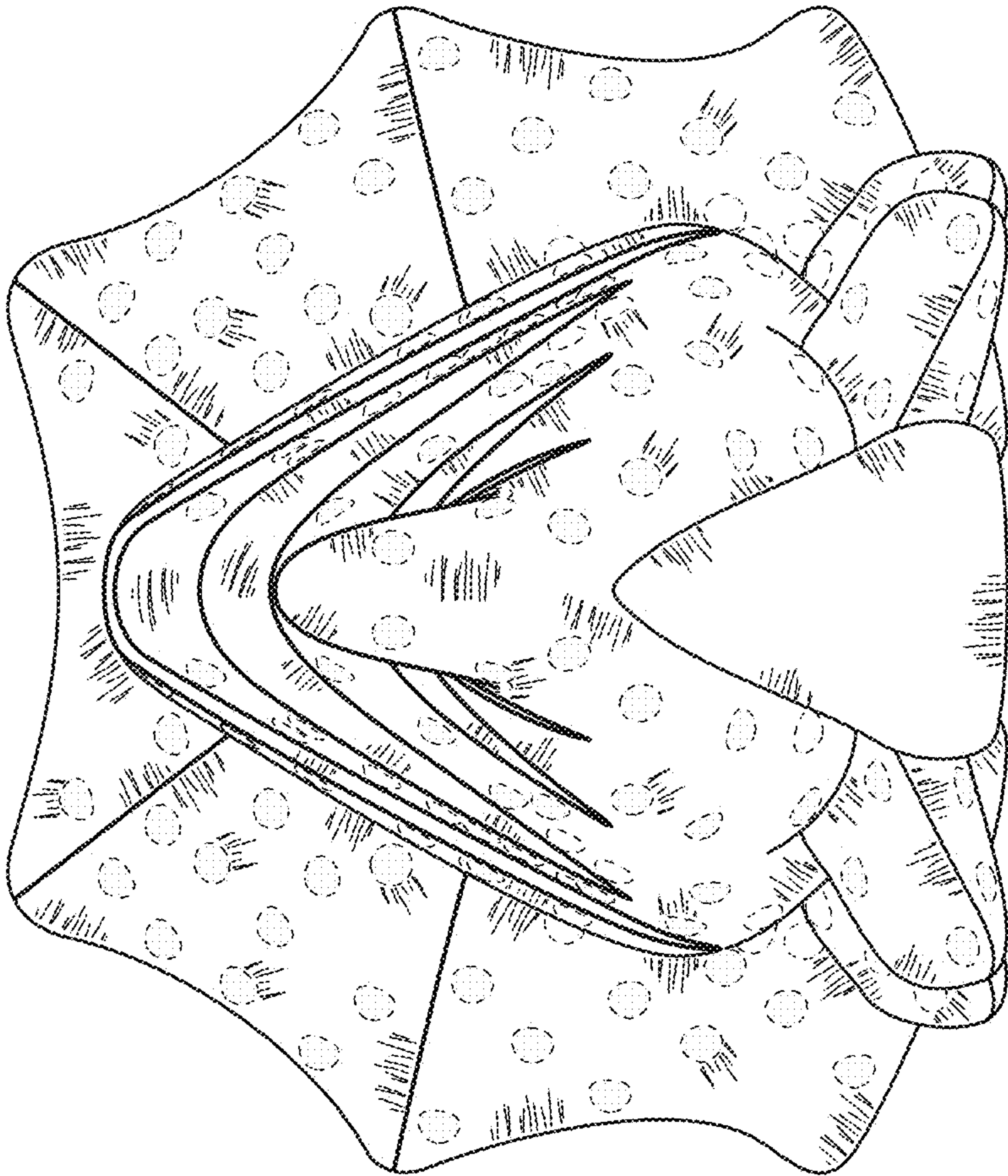

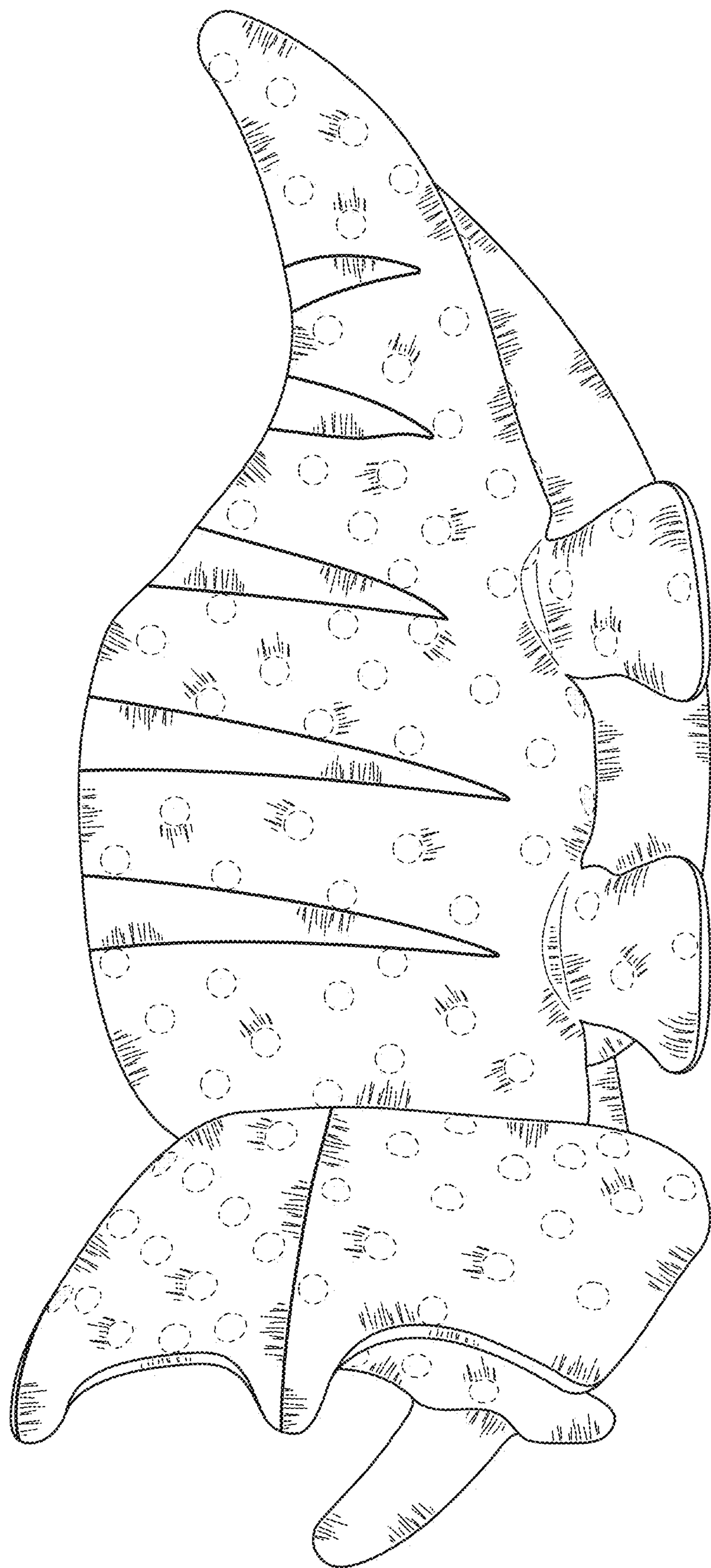

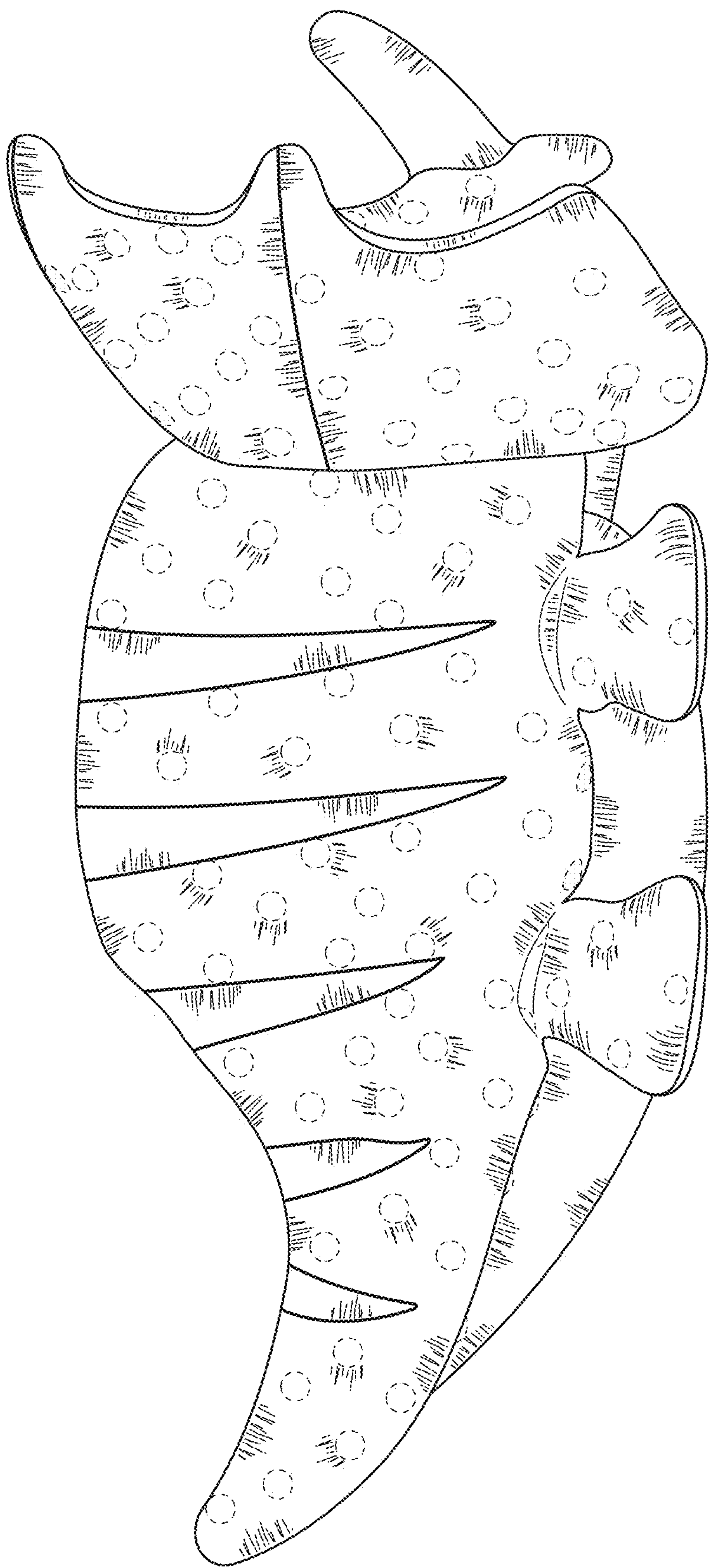

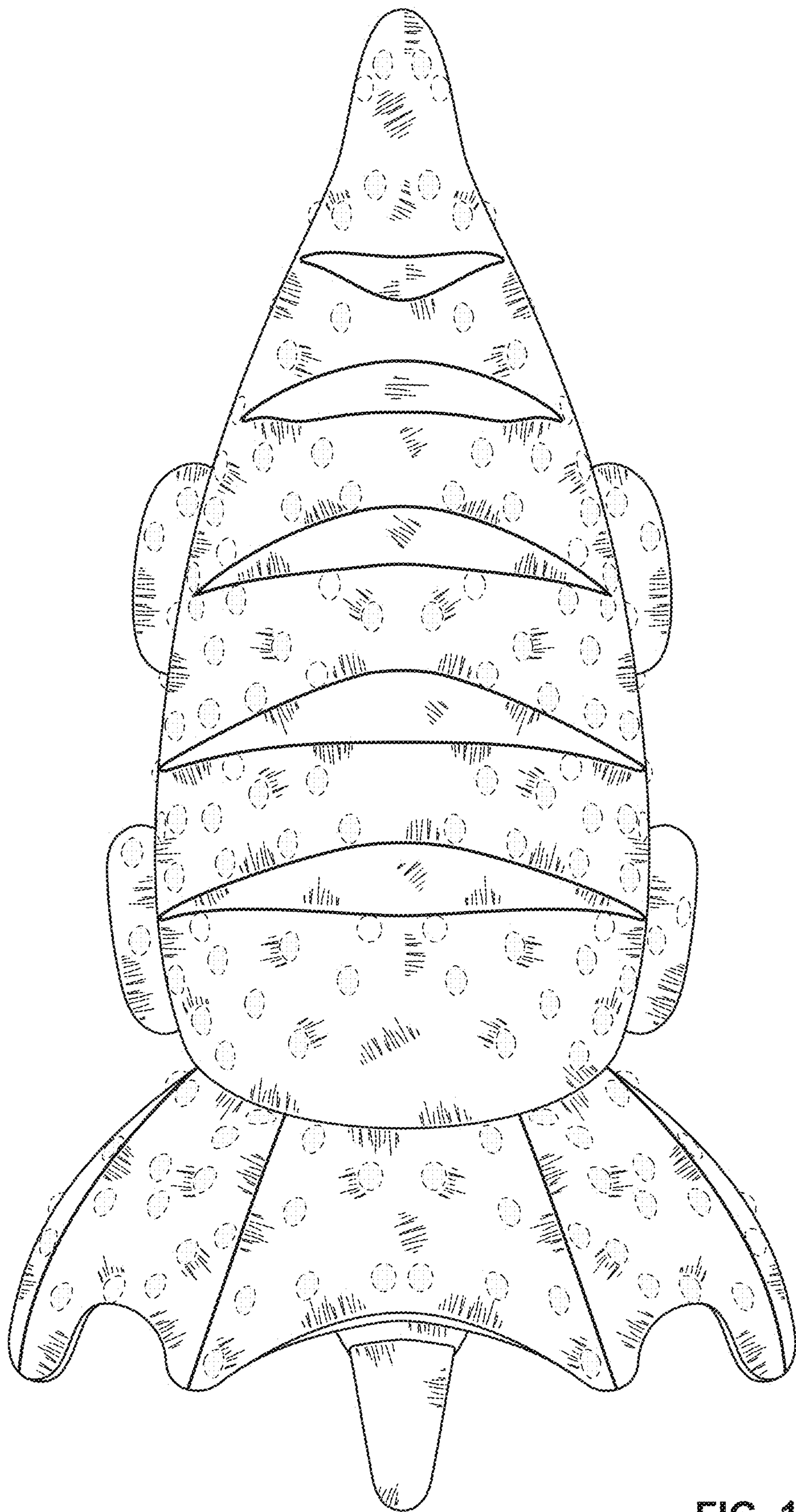

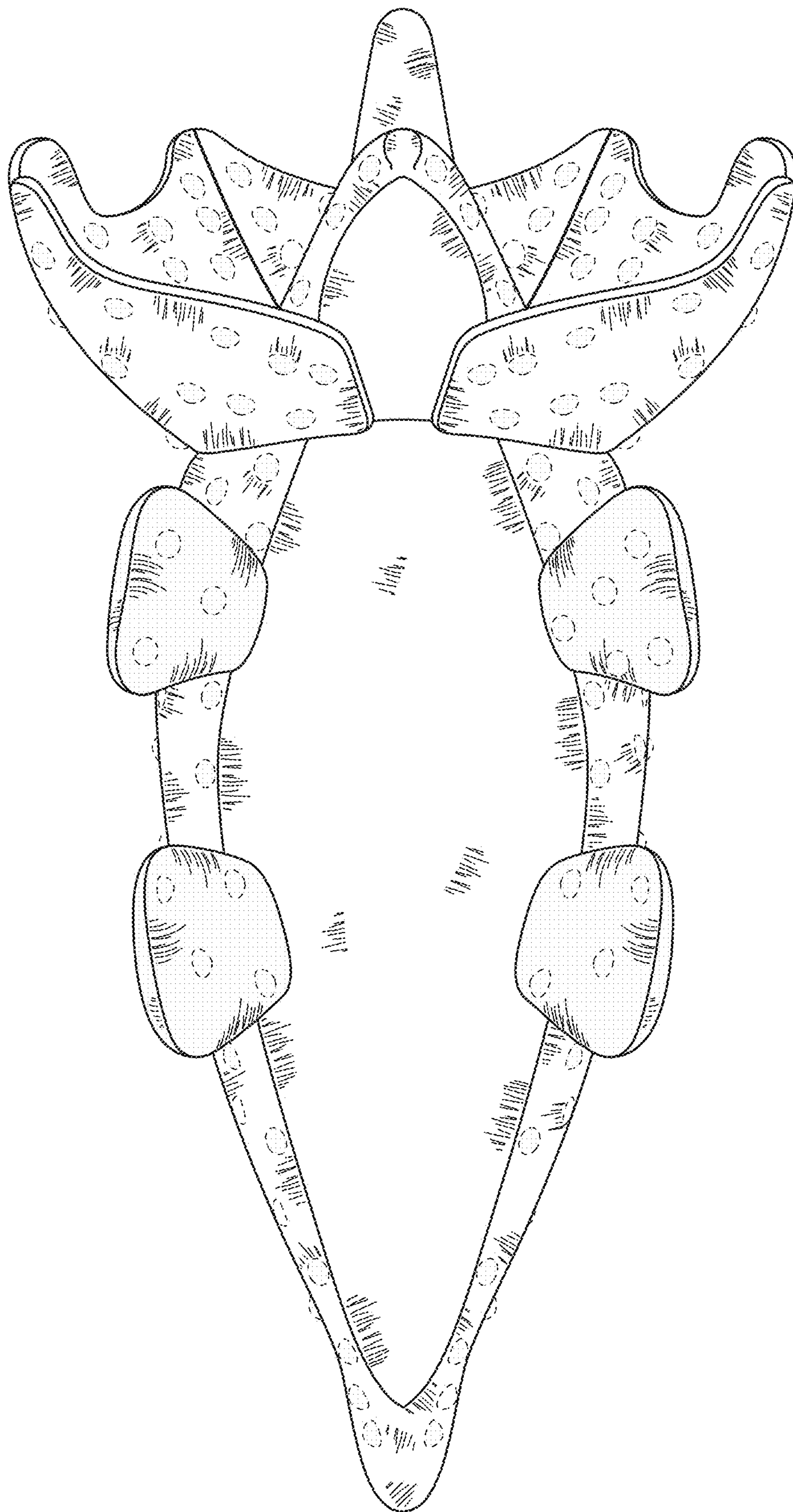
