I claim the ornamental design for an umbrella handle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;

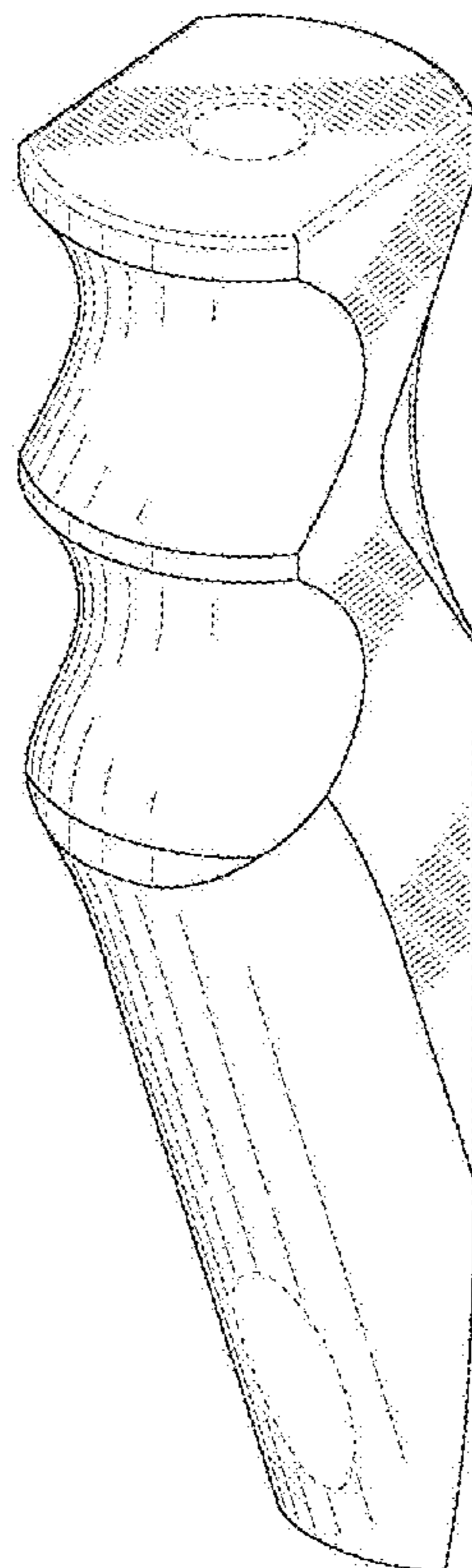
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;

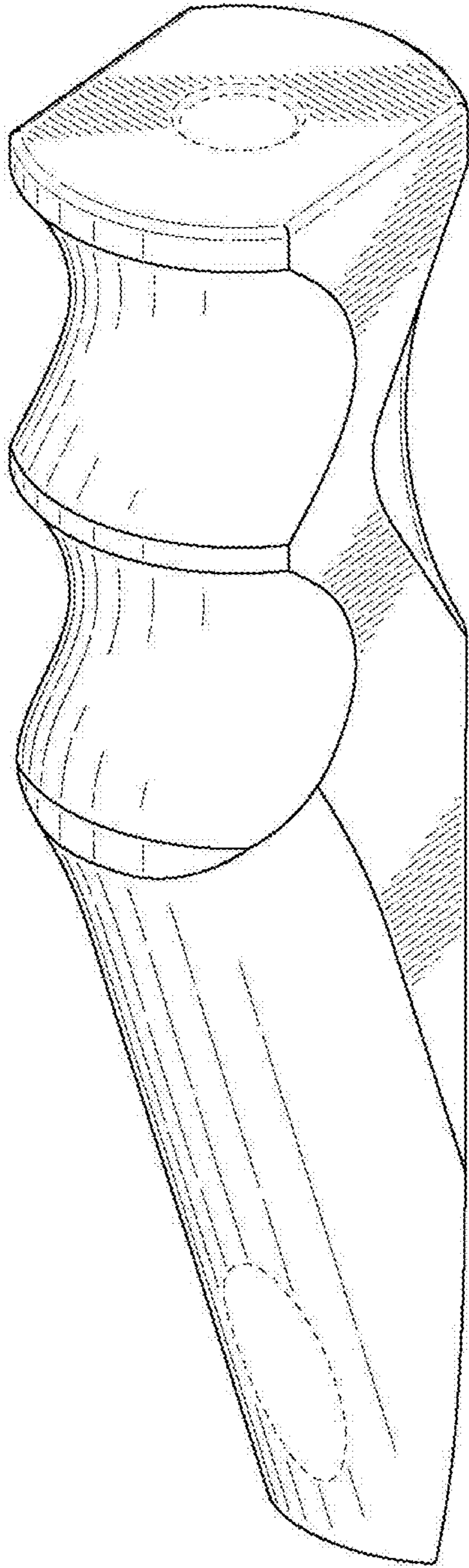
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

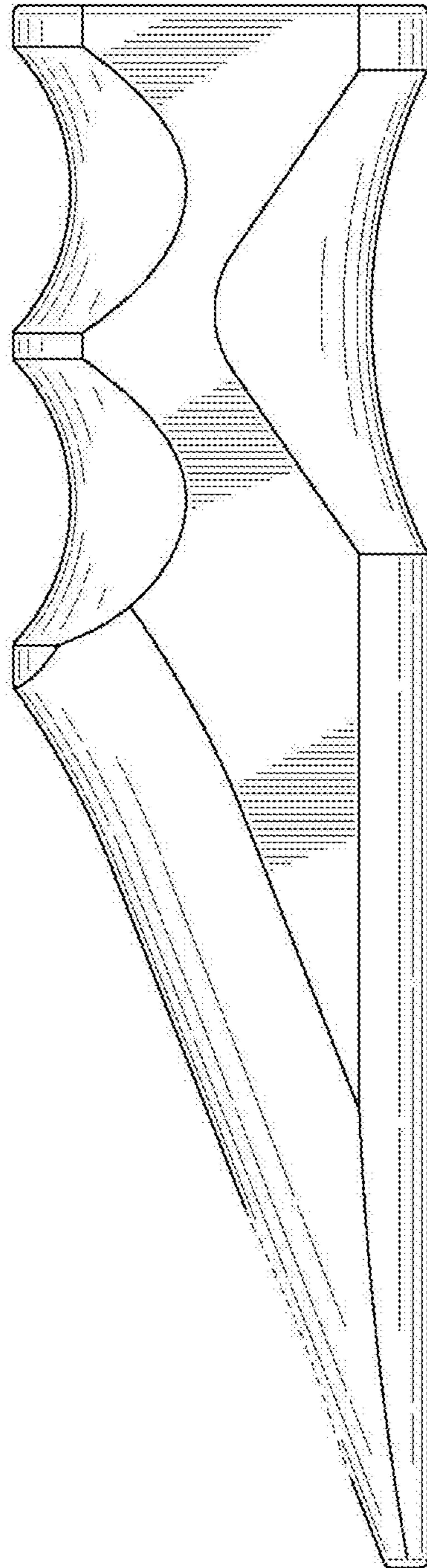
The broken lines depict portions of the article that form no part of the claimed design.

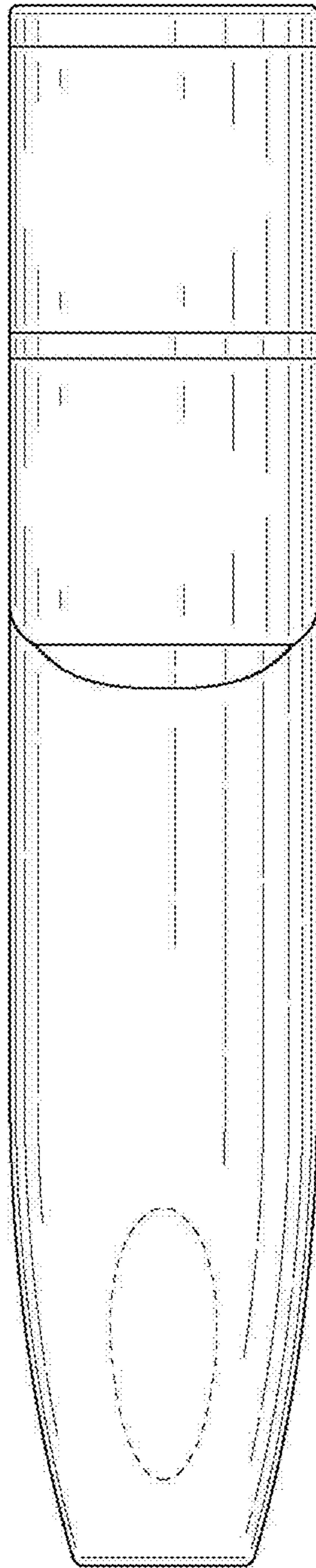




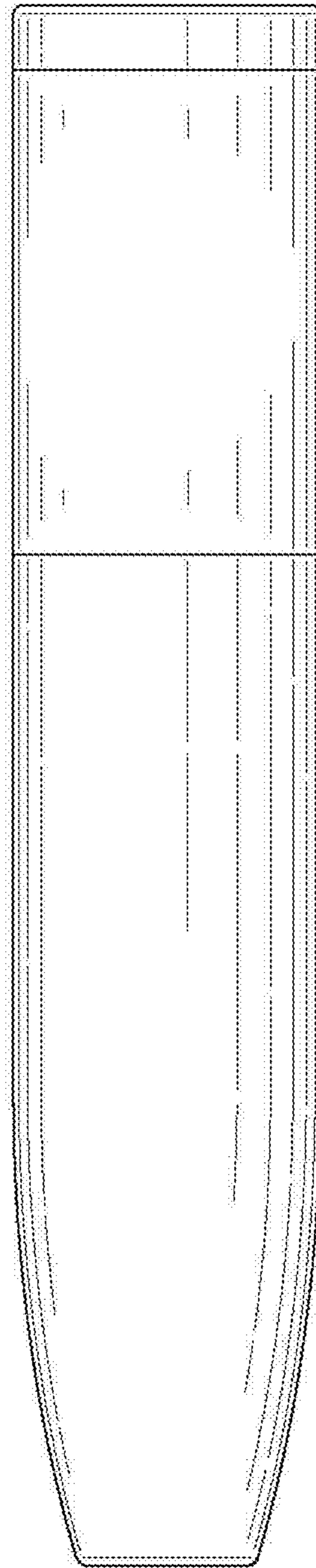

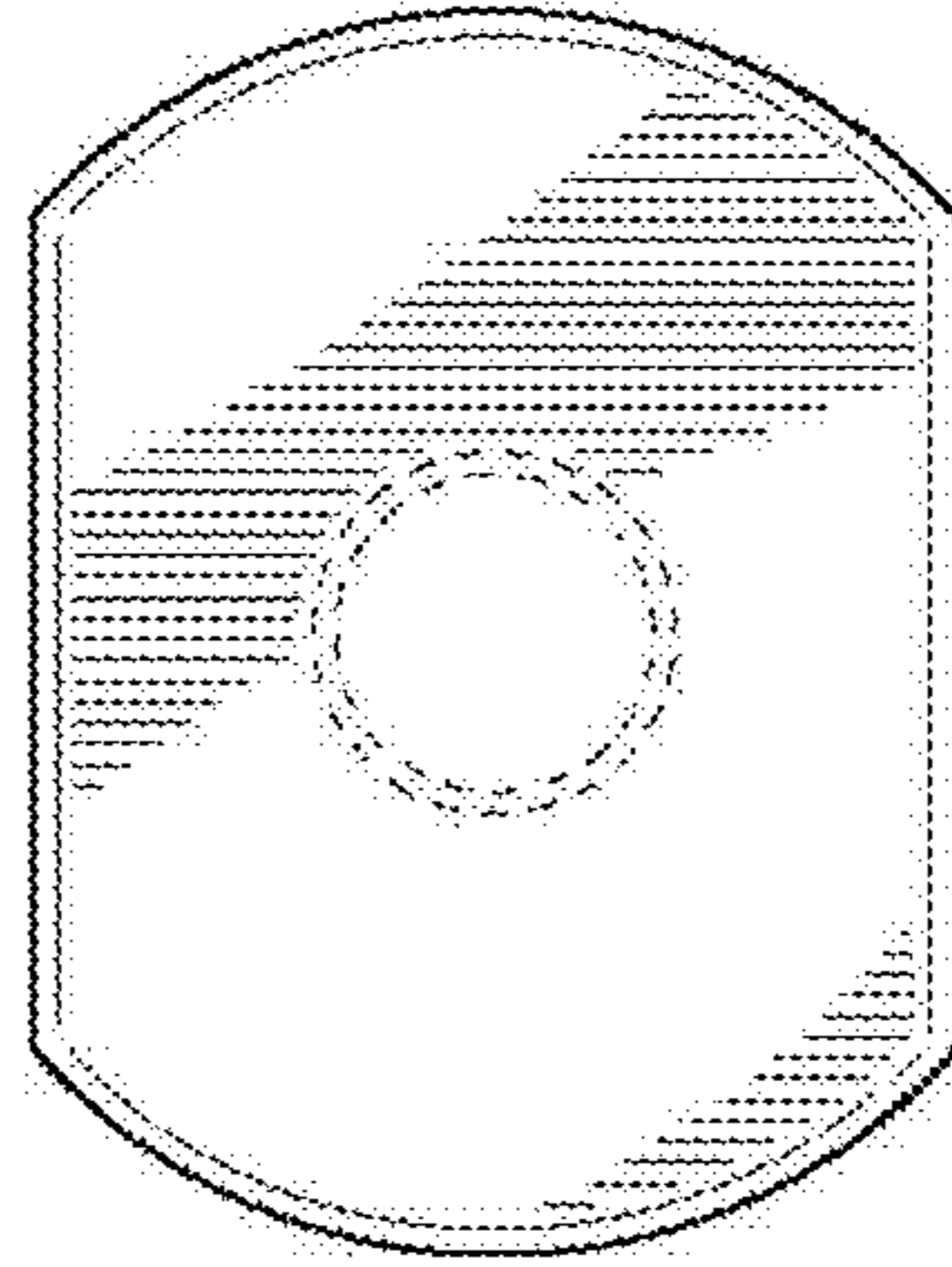

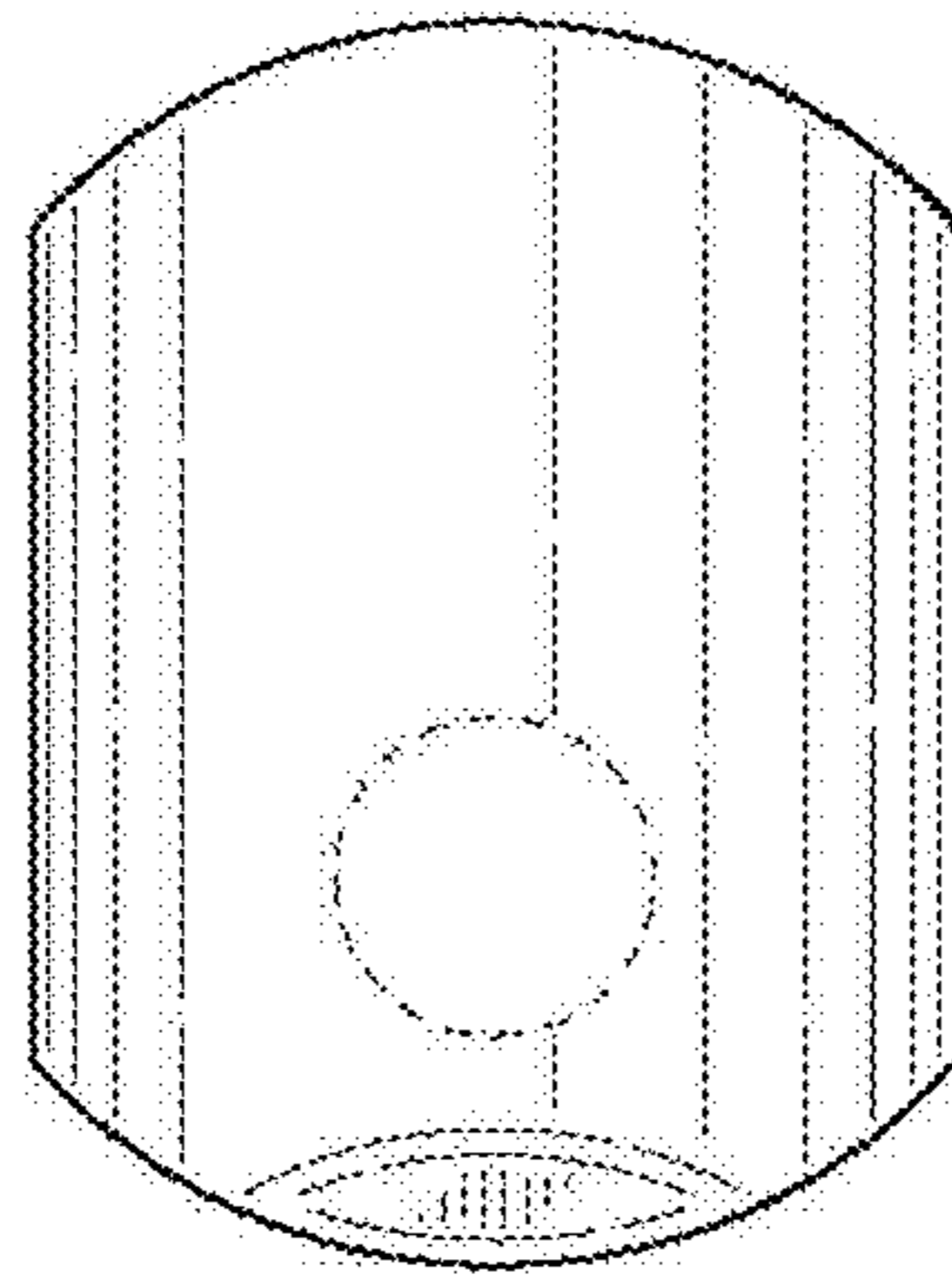
