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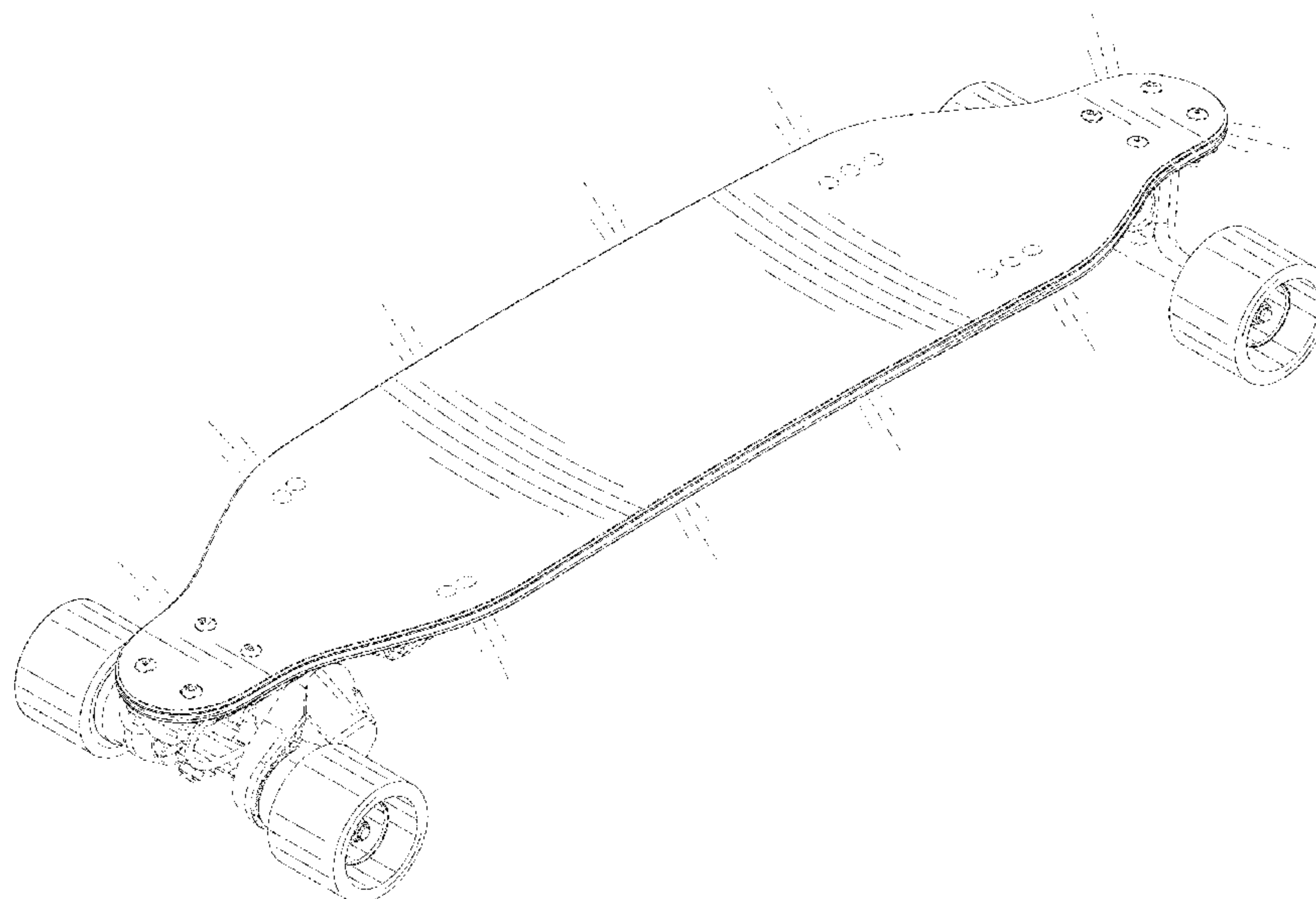
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of an electric powered personal transport vehicle;
FIG. 2 is a bottom up perspective view of an electric powered personal transport vehicle;

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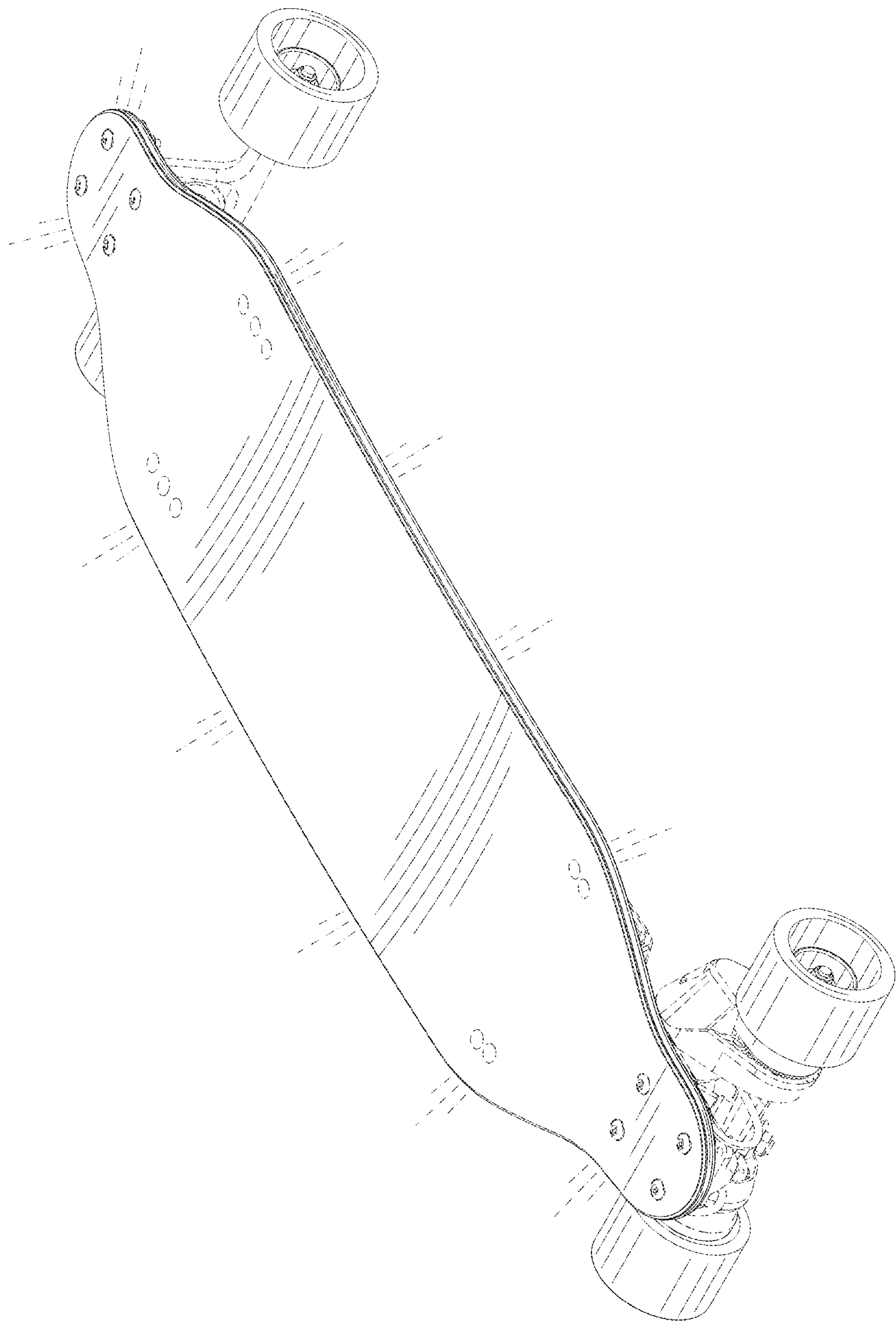

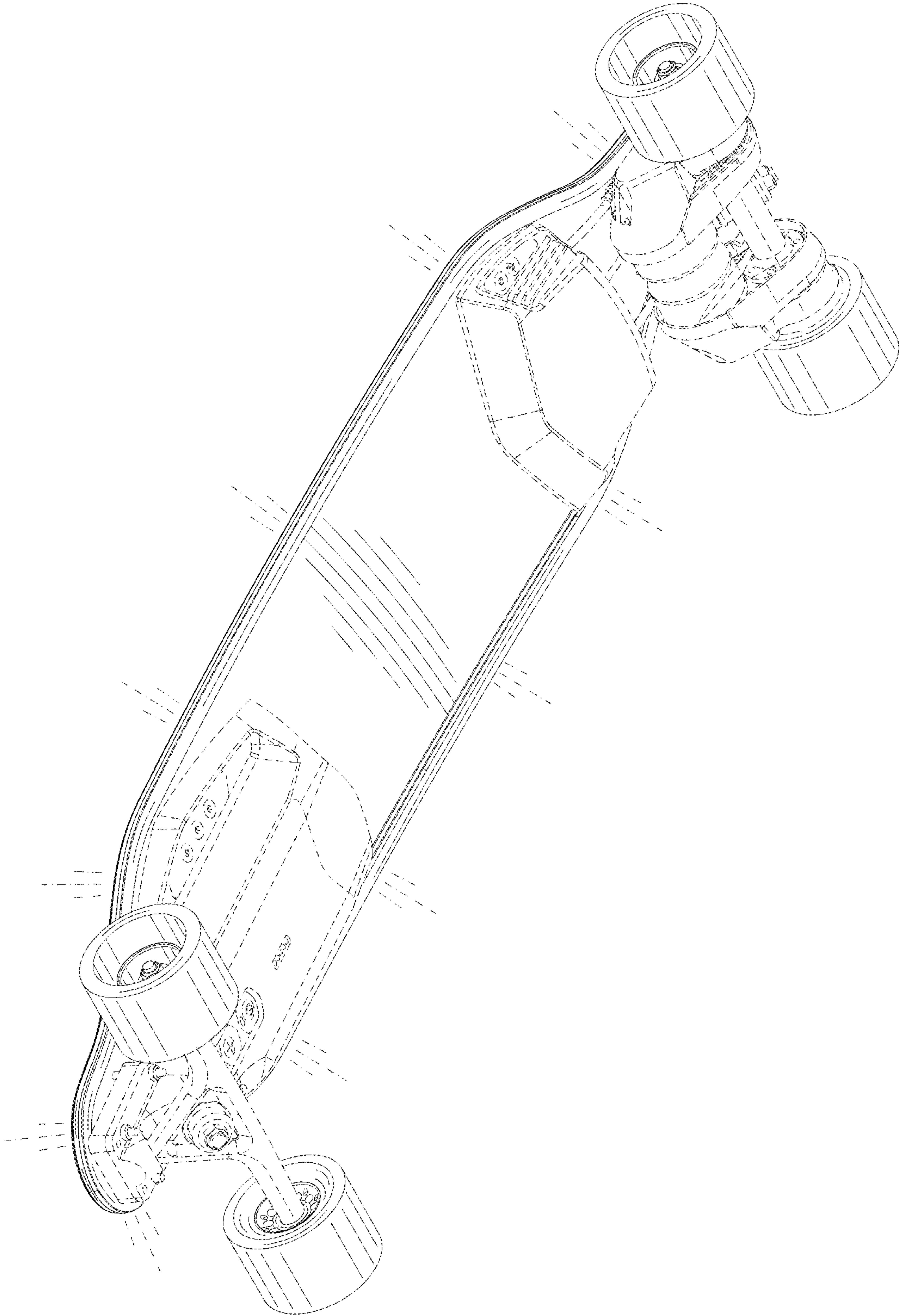

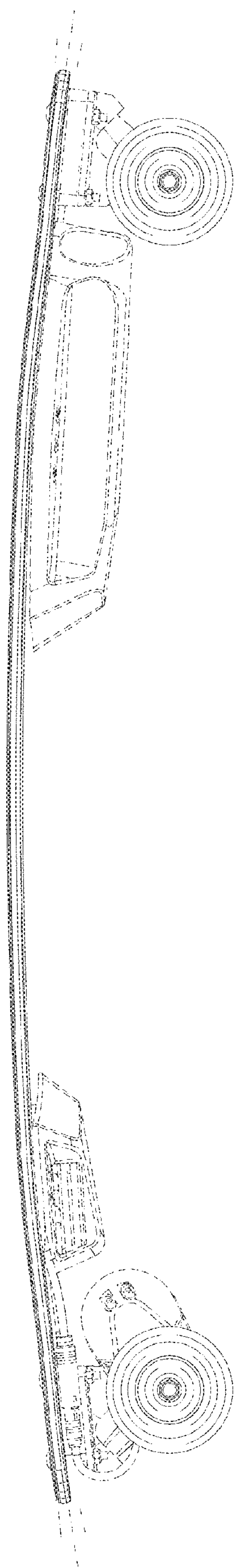

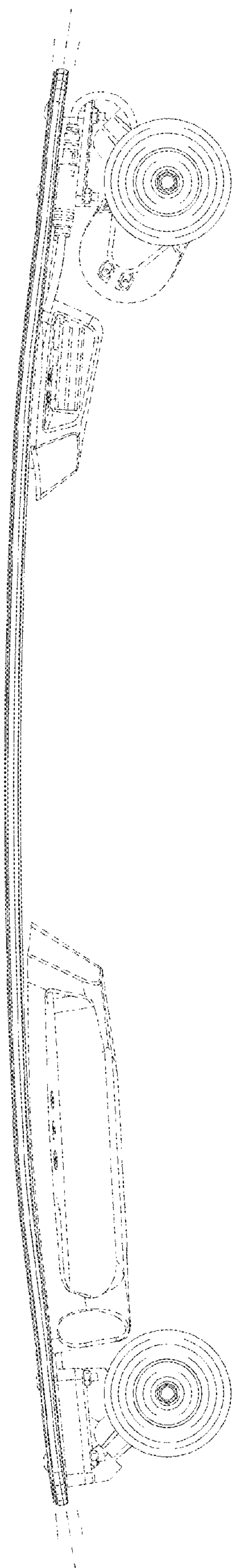

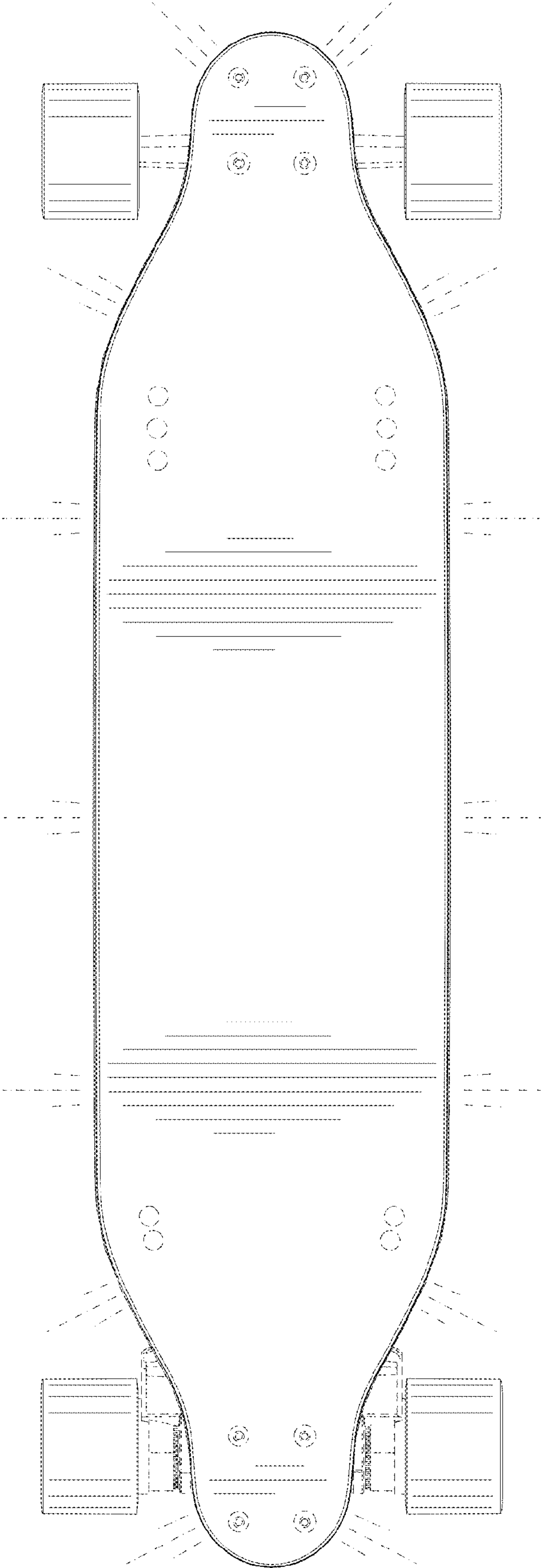

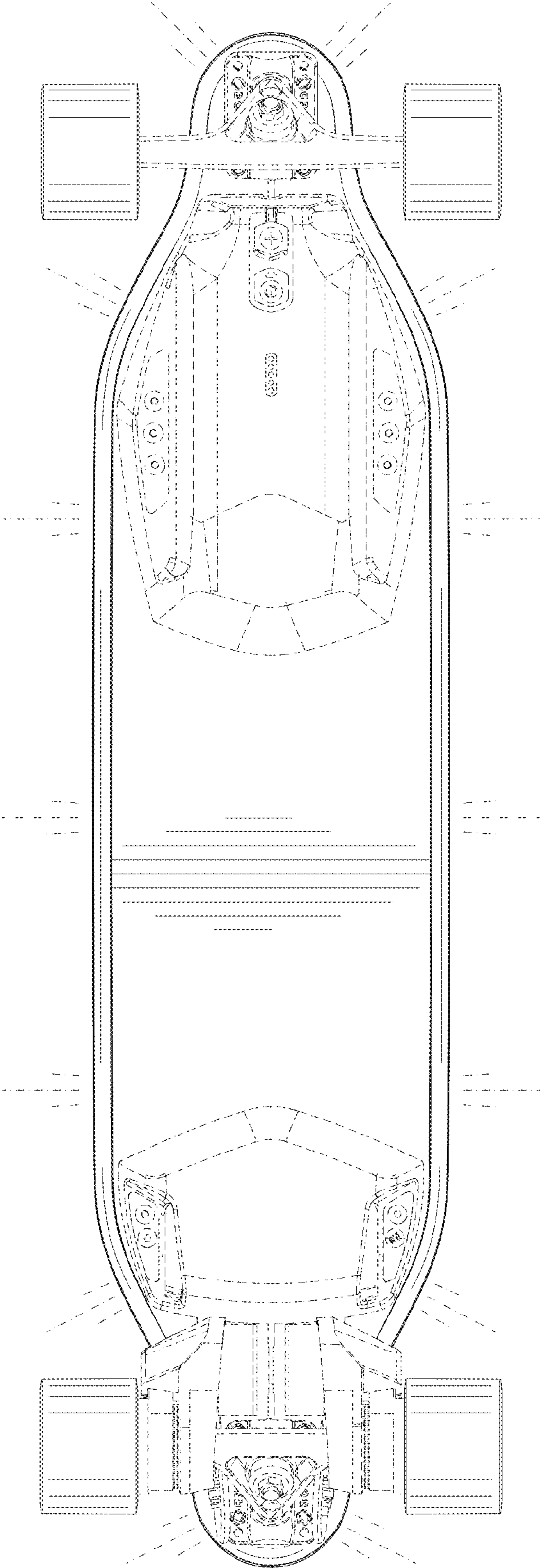

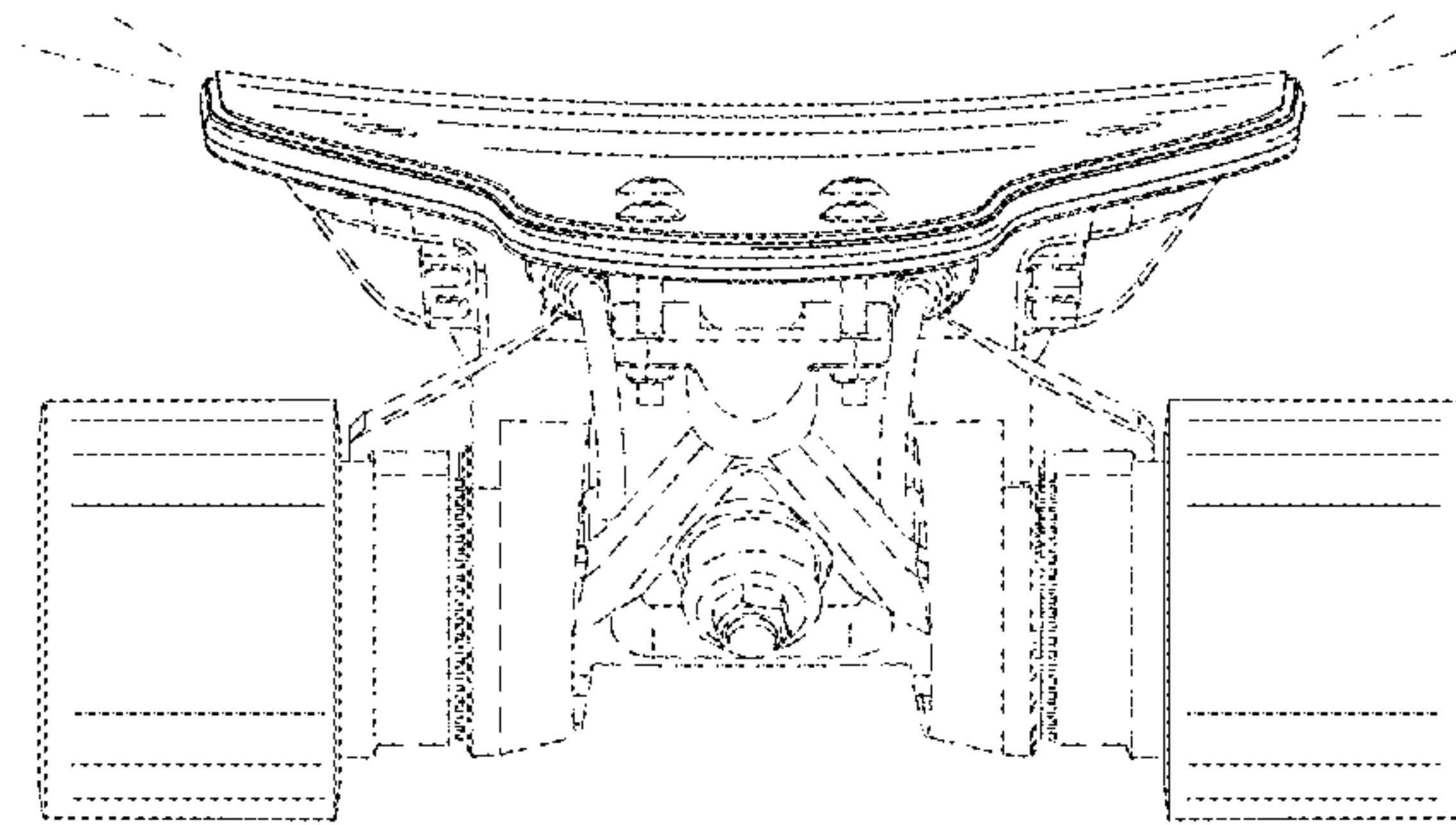

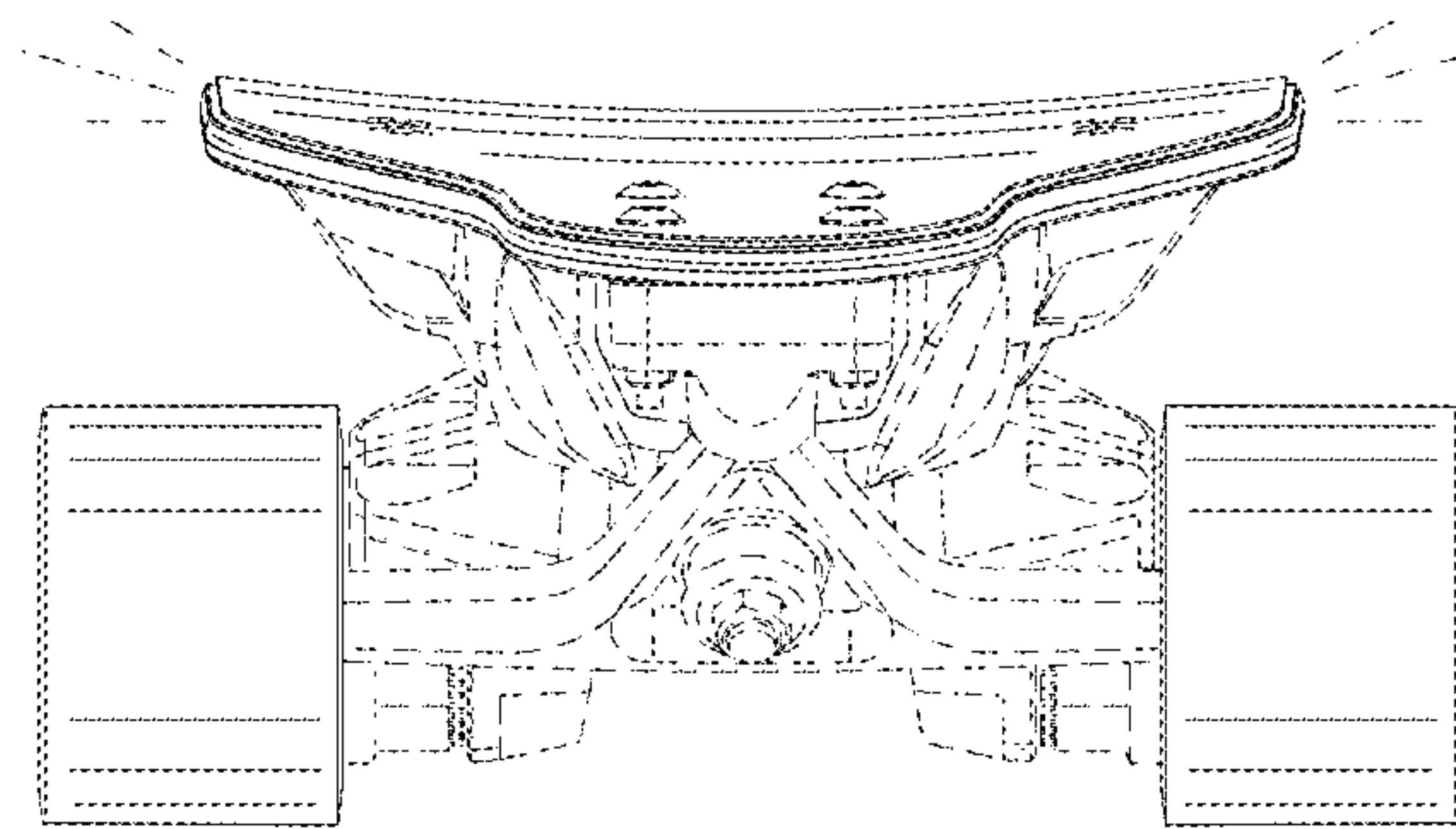
