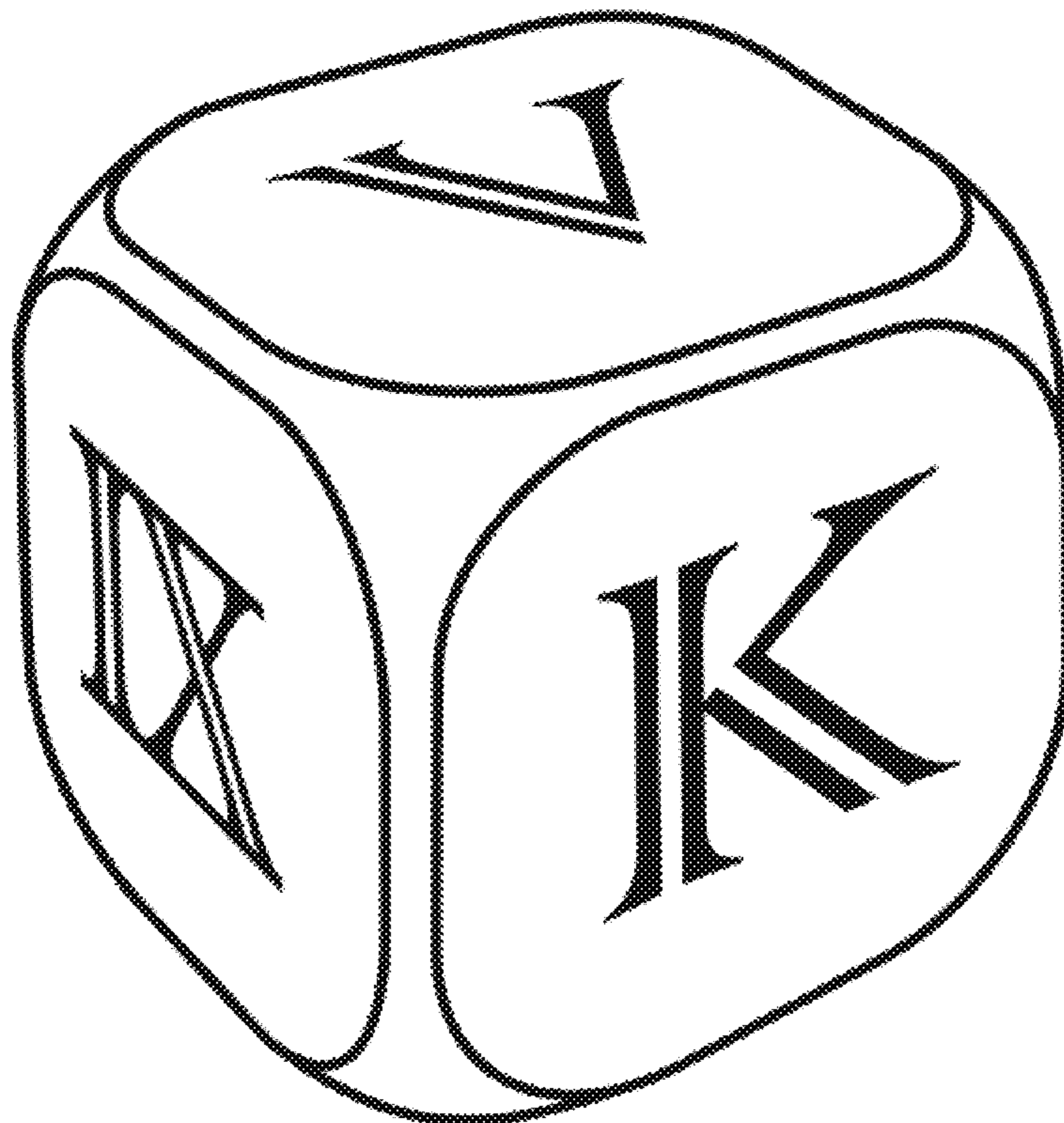
The ornamental design for dice, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

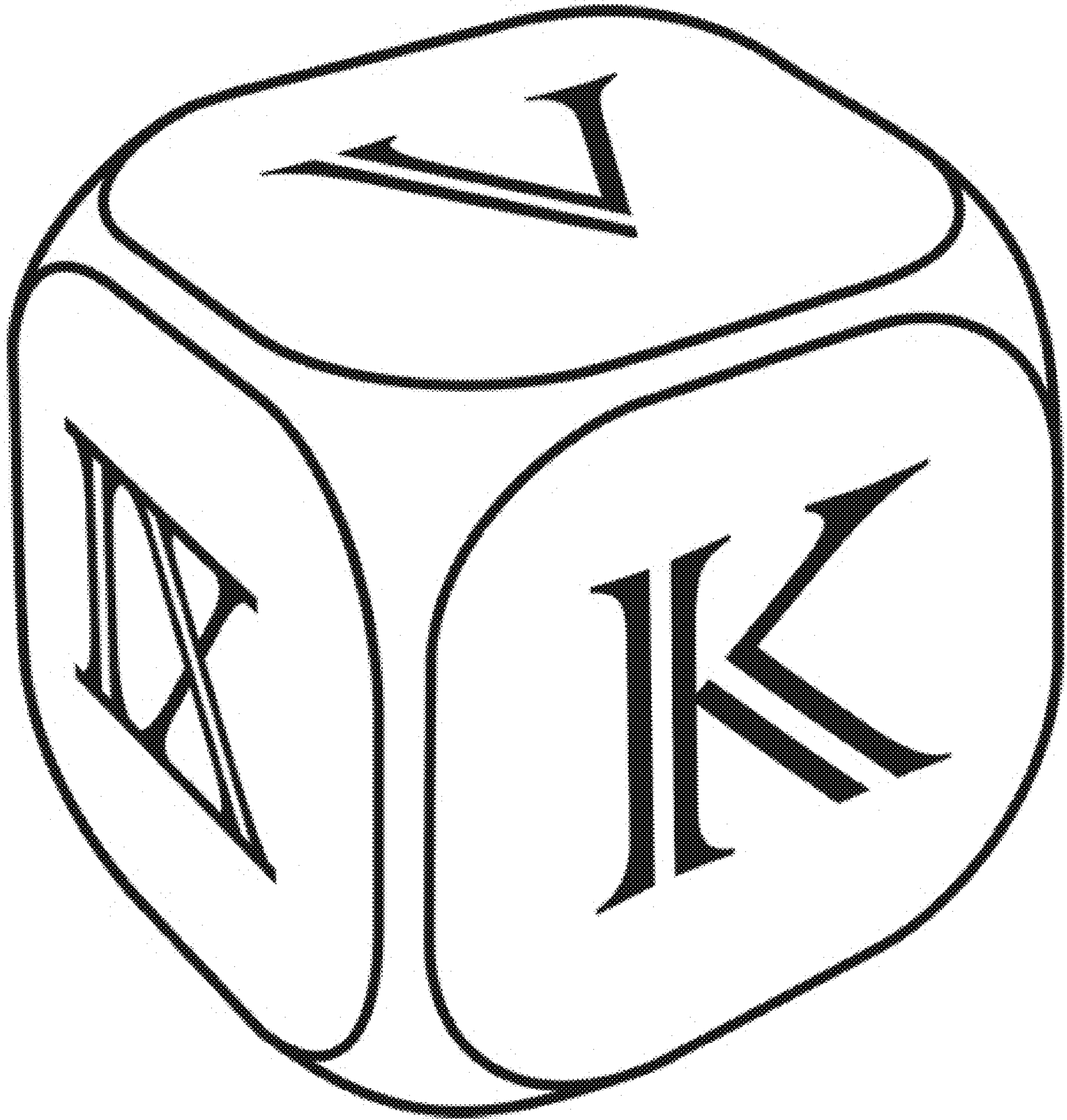
2.1-3.2 Dice

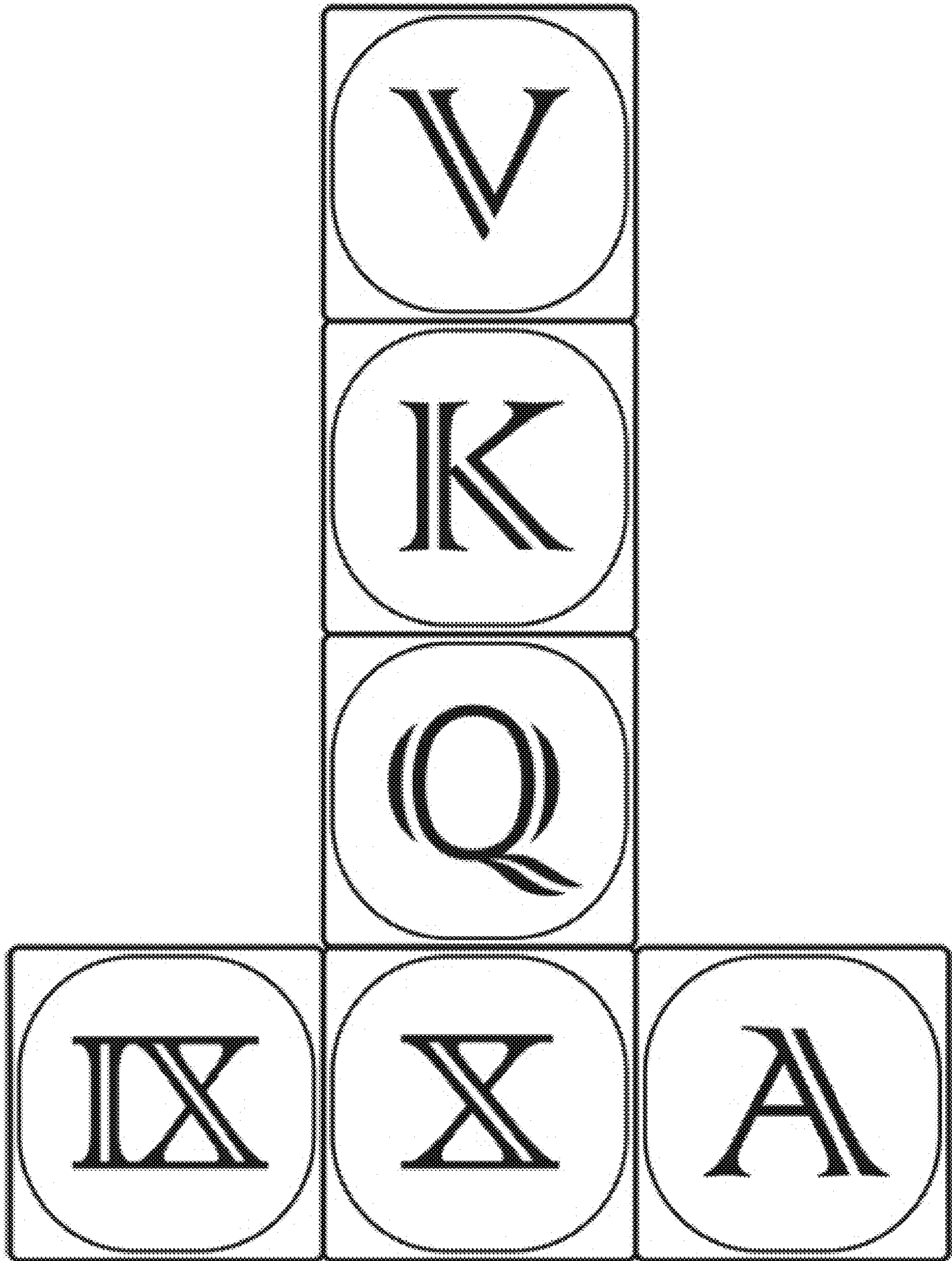
