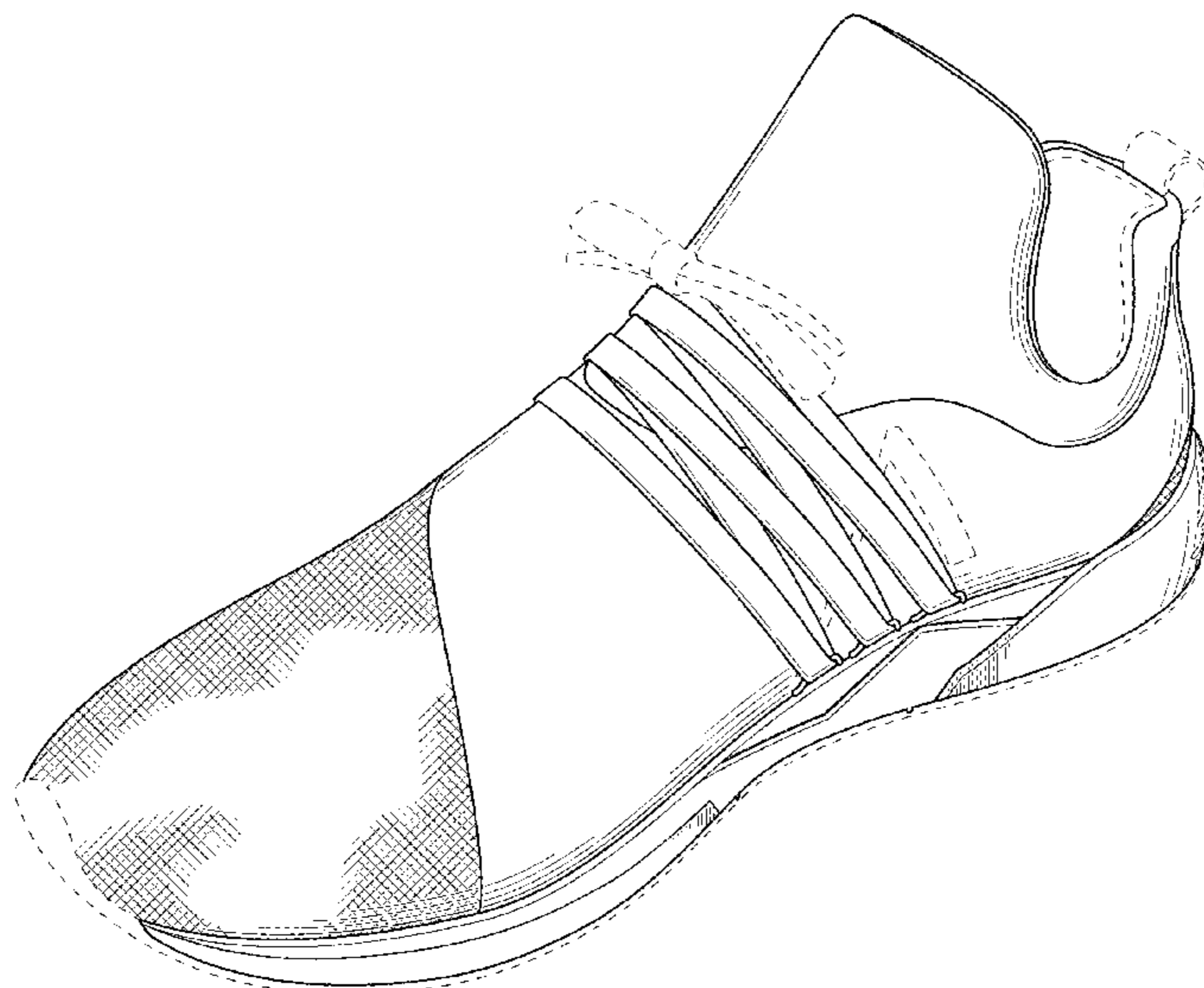
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe according to the present disclosure.

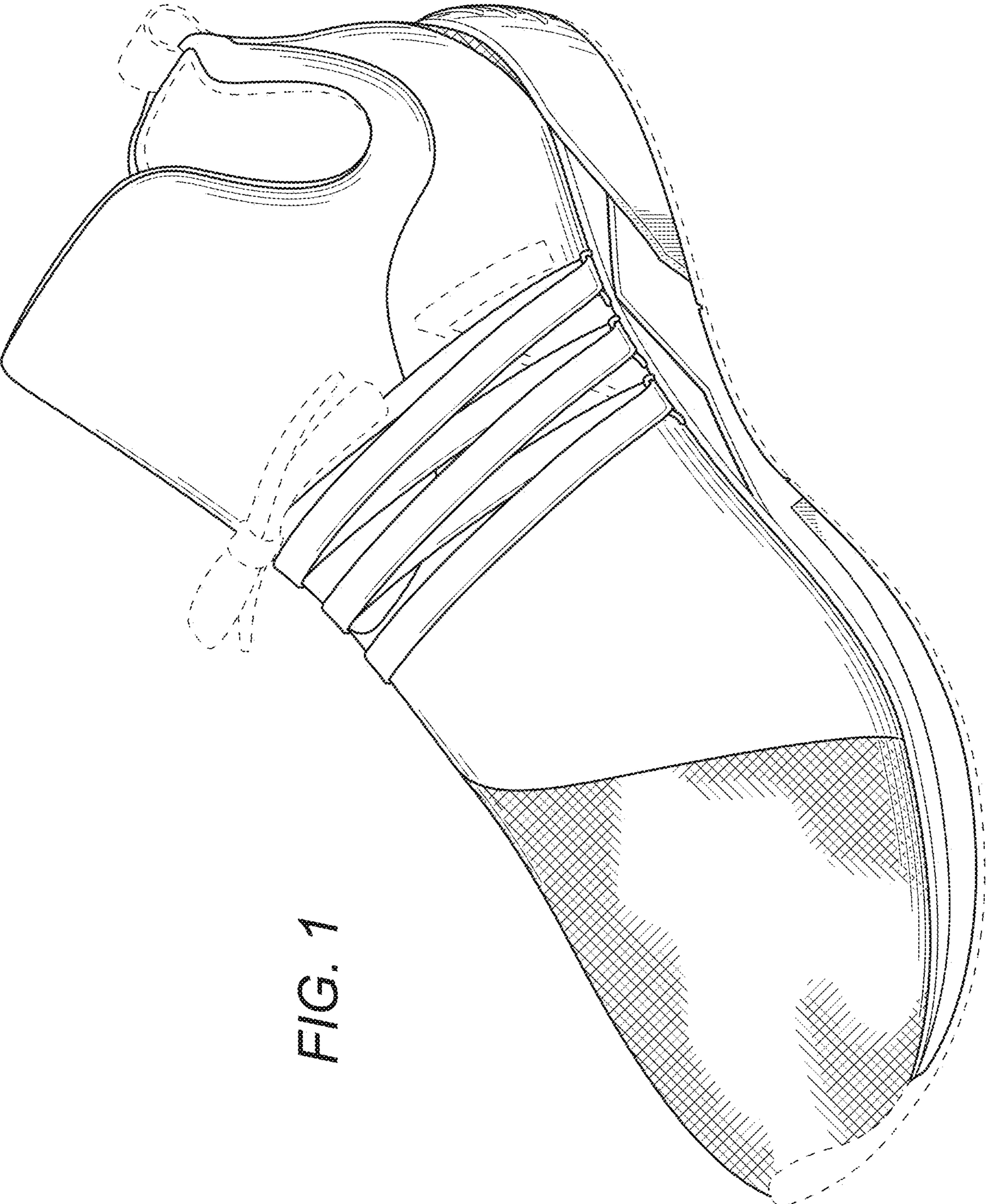

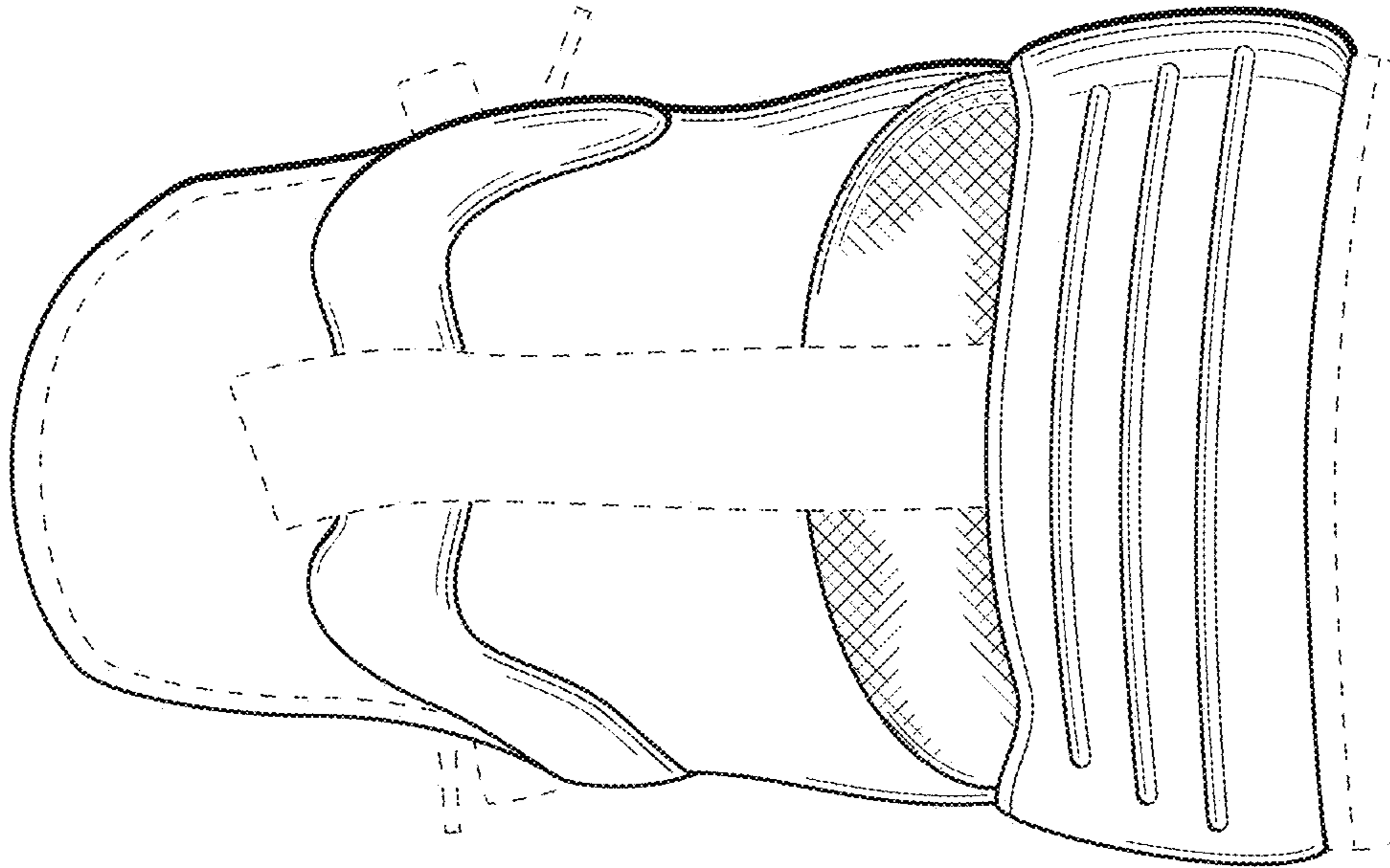

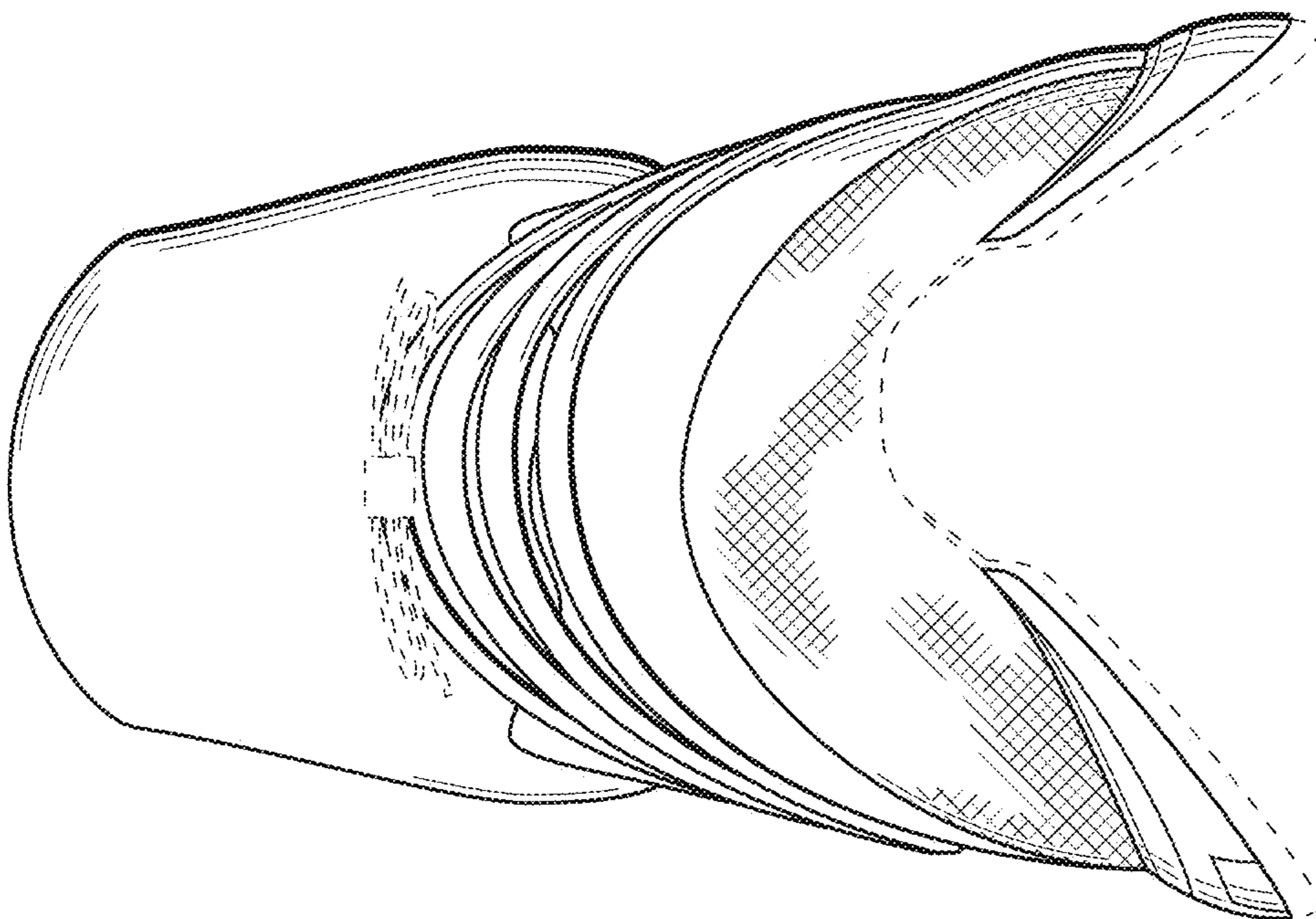
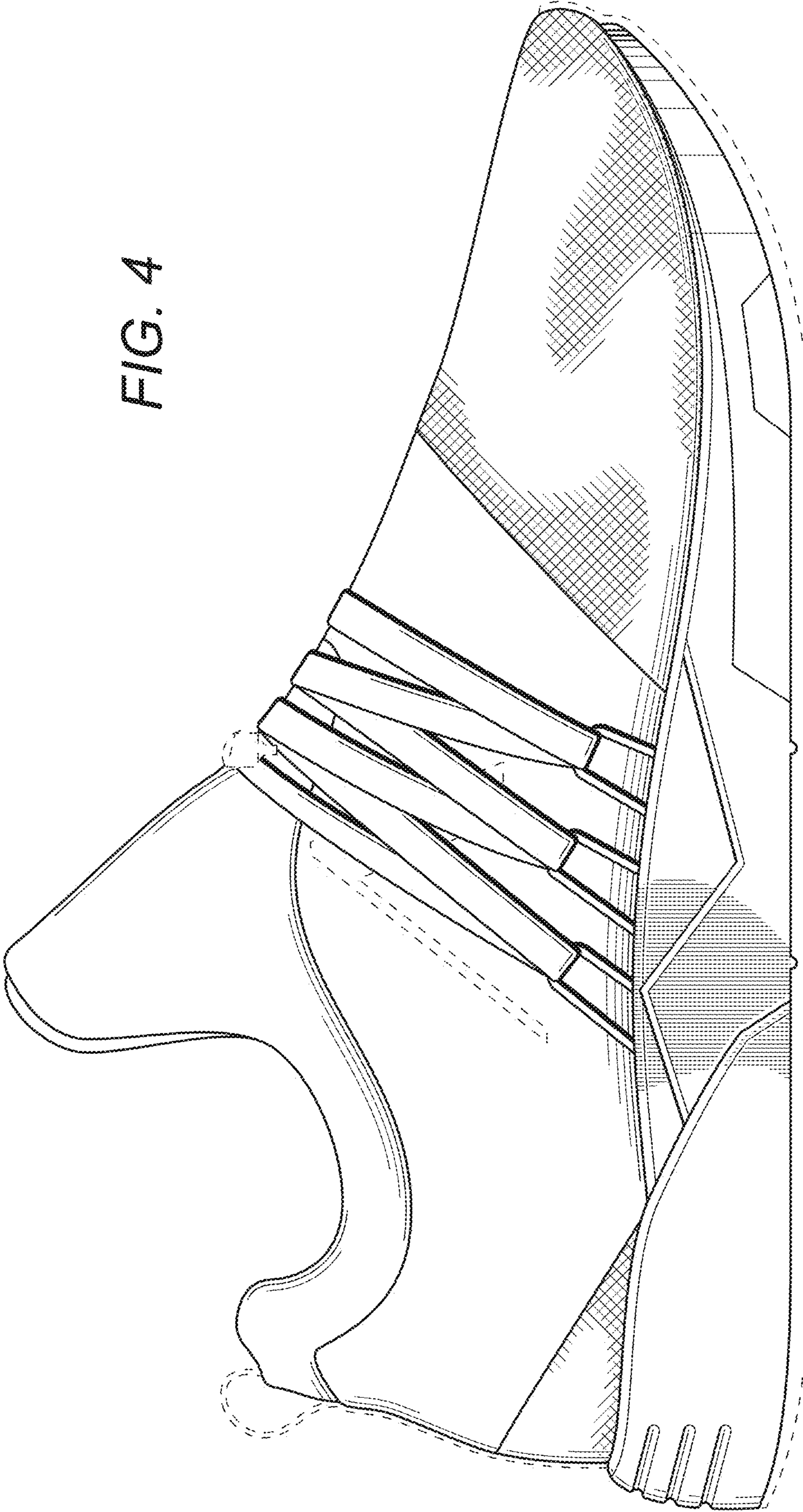

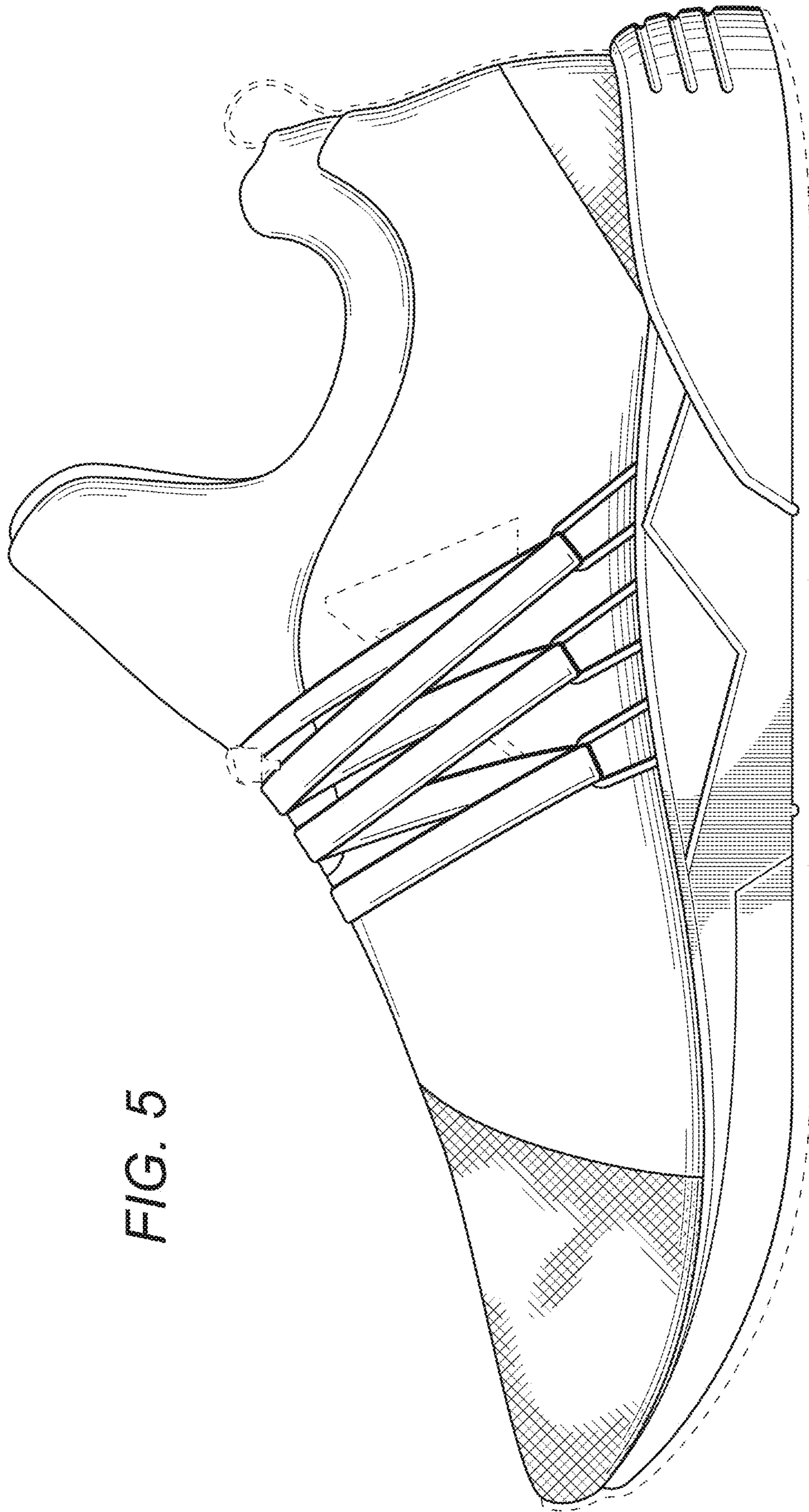

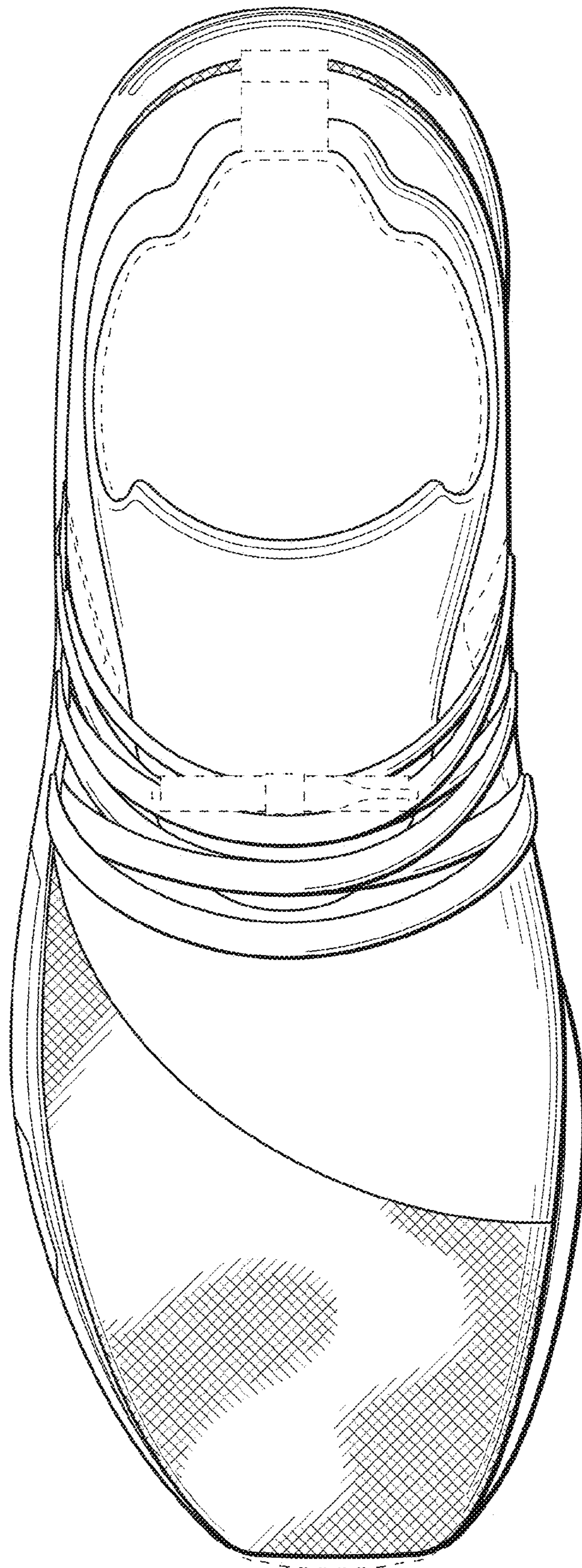
