FIG. 5 is a second perspective view thereof;

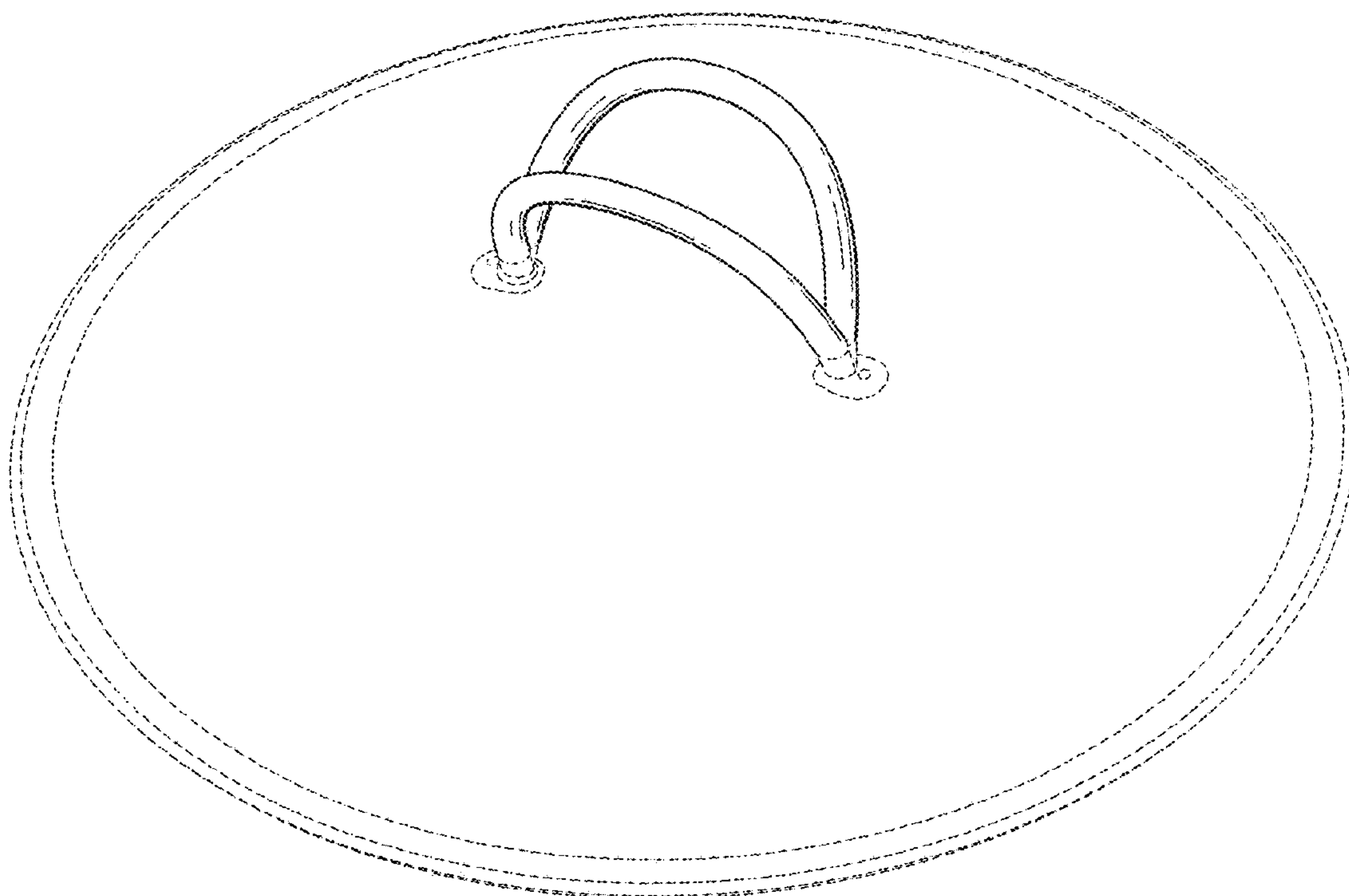
FIG. 6 is a side elevation view thereof;

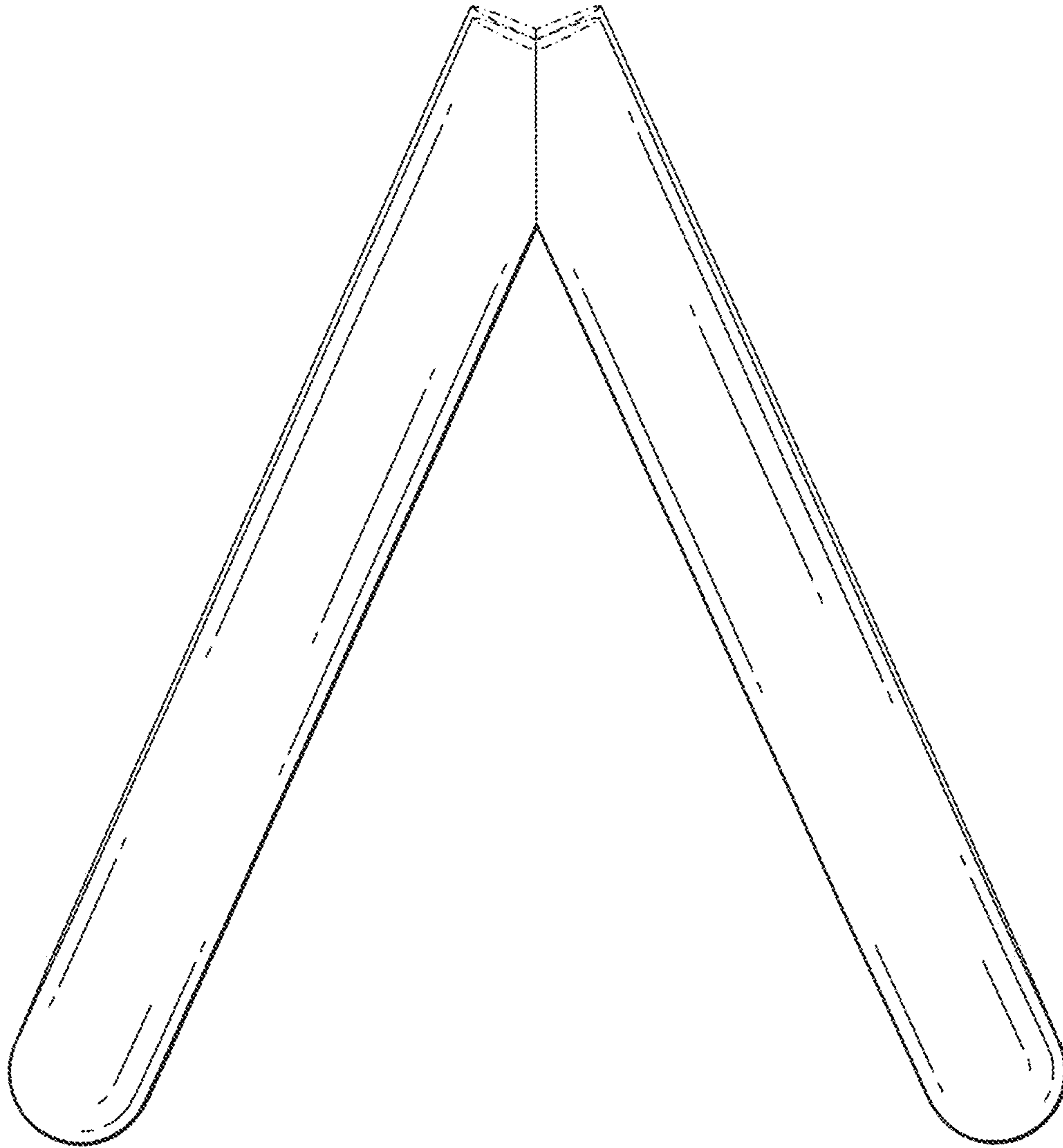

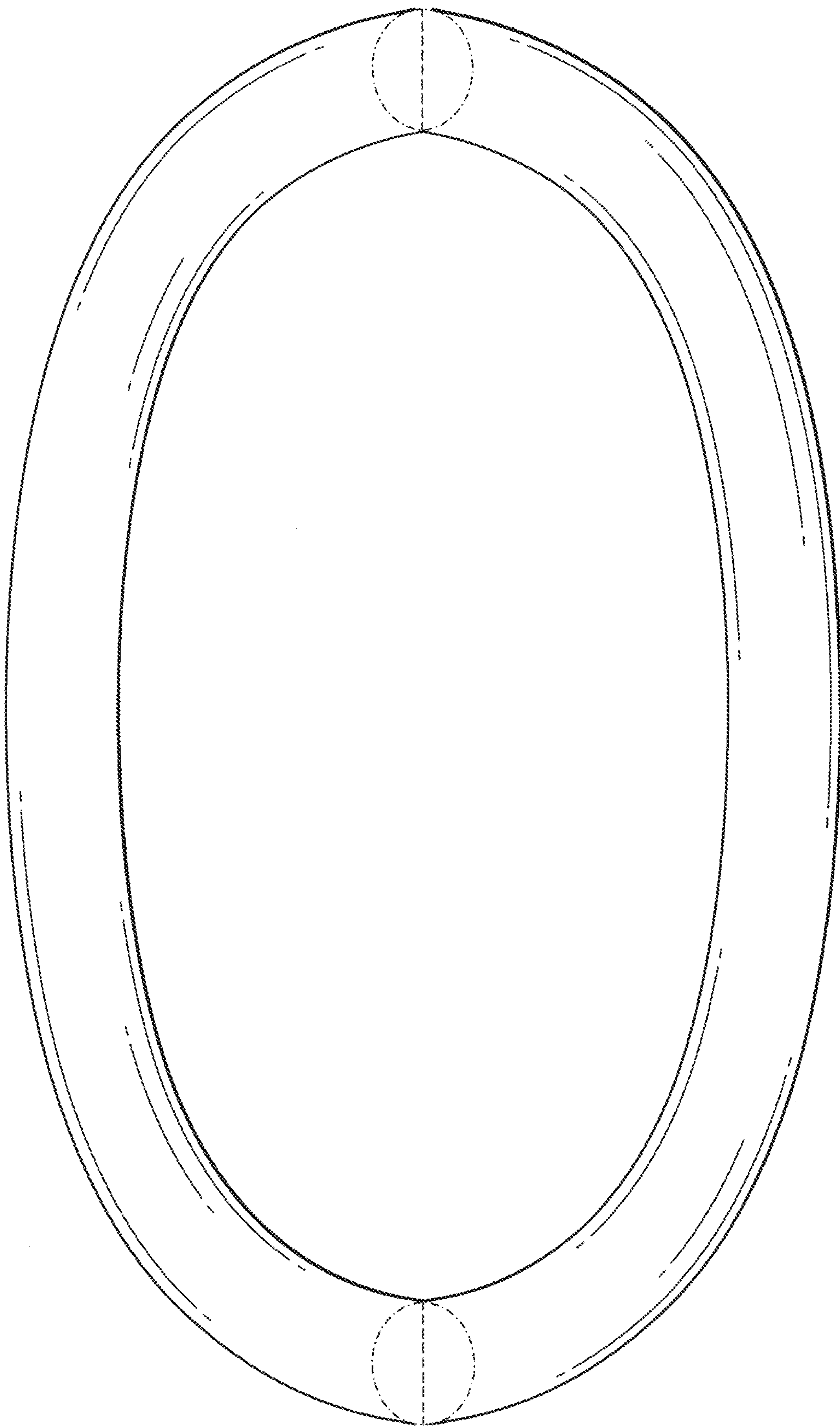

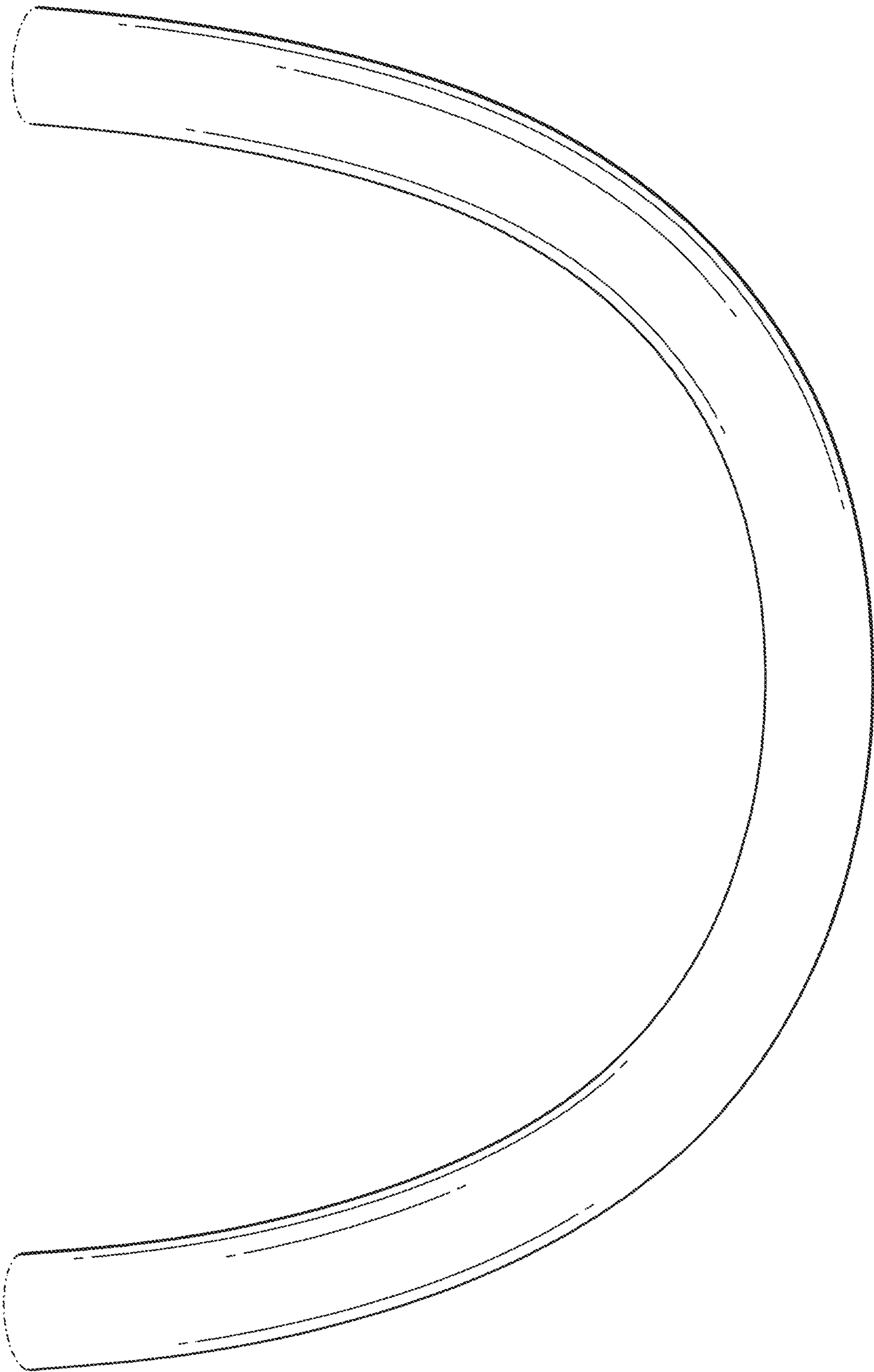

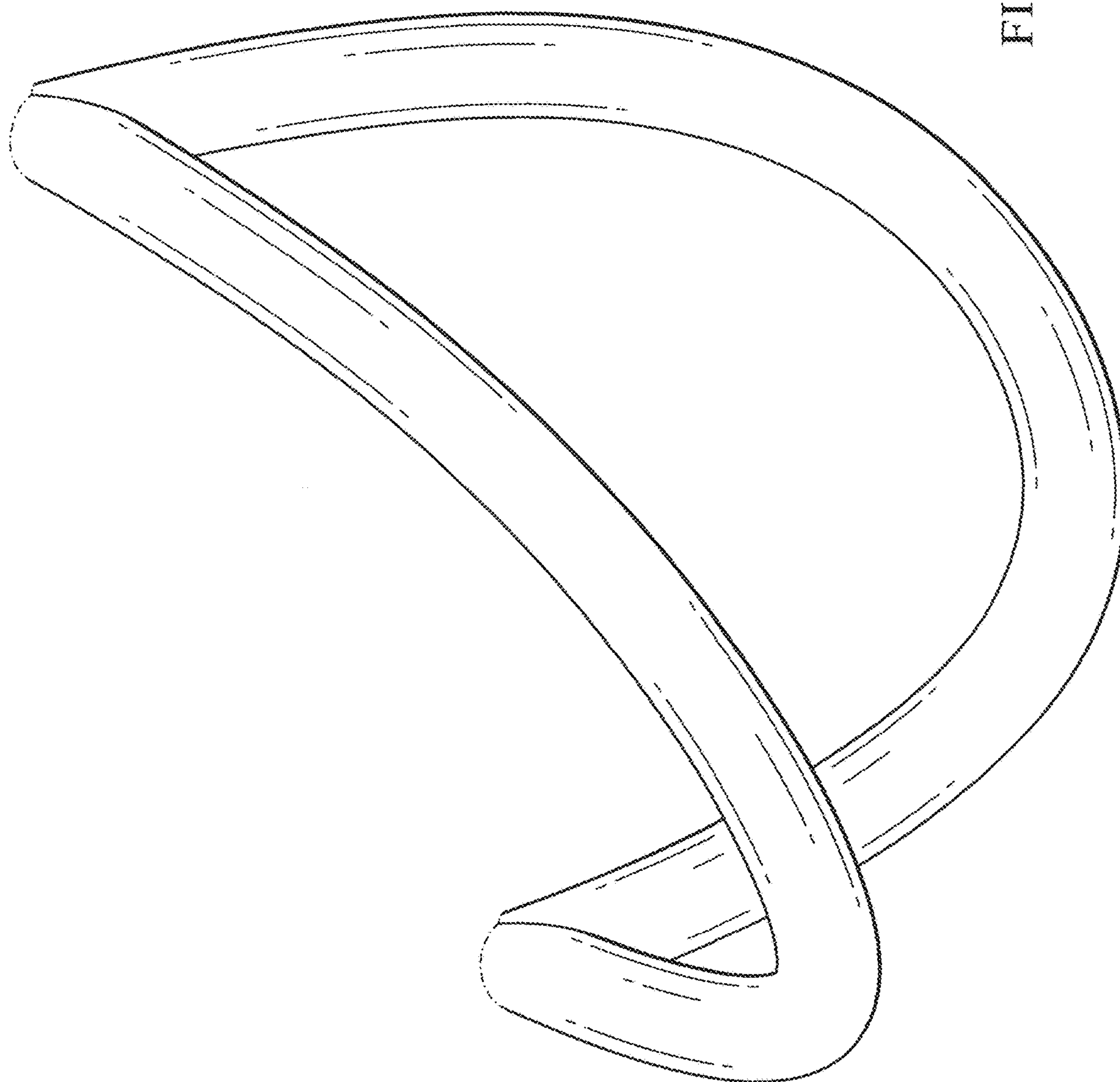

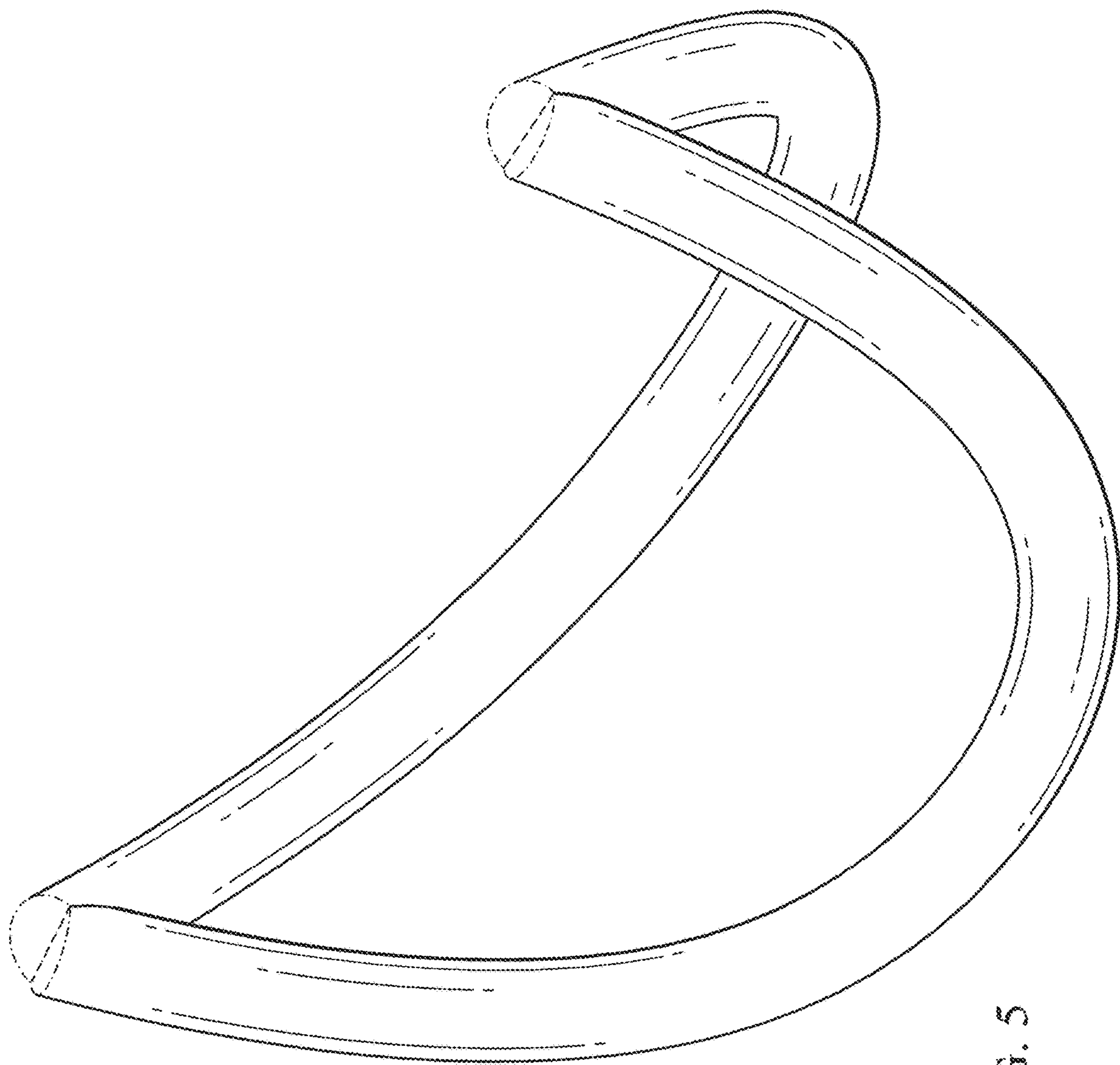

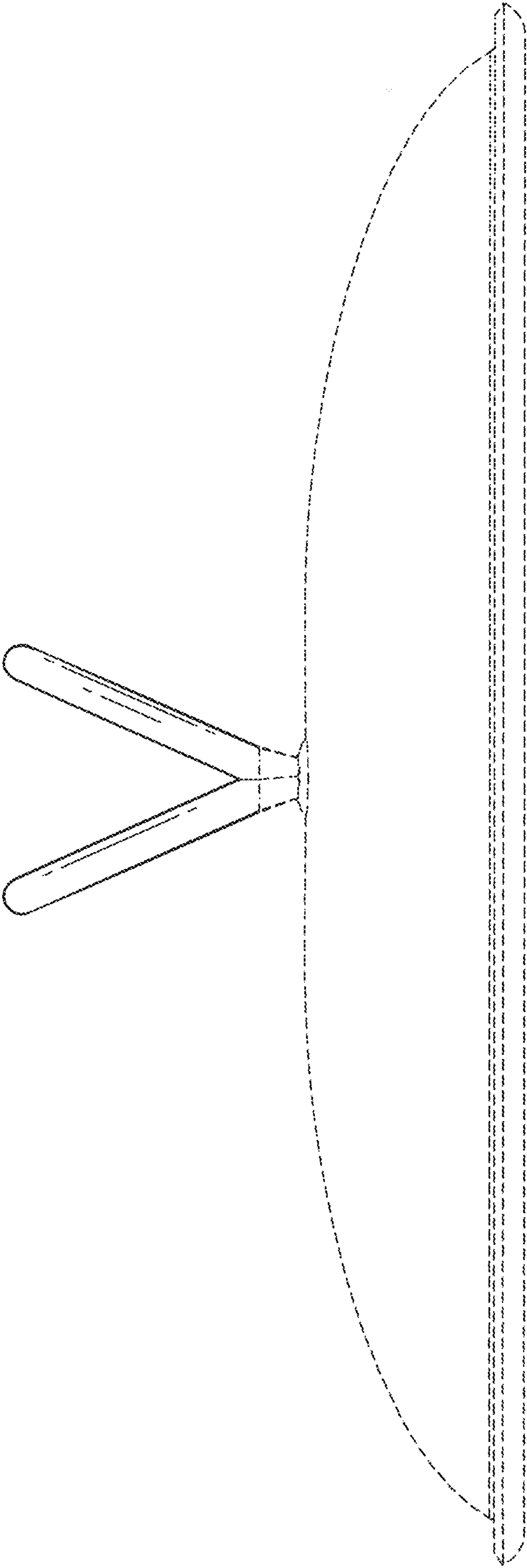

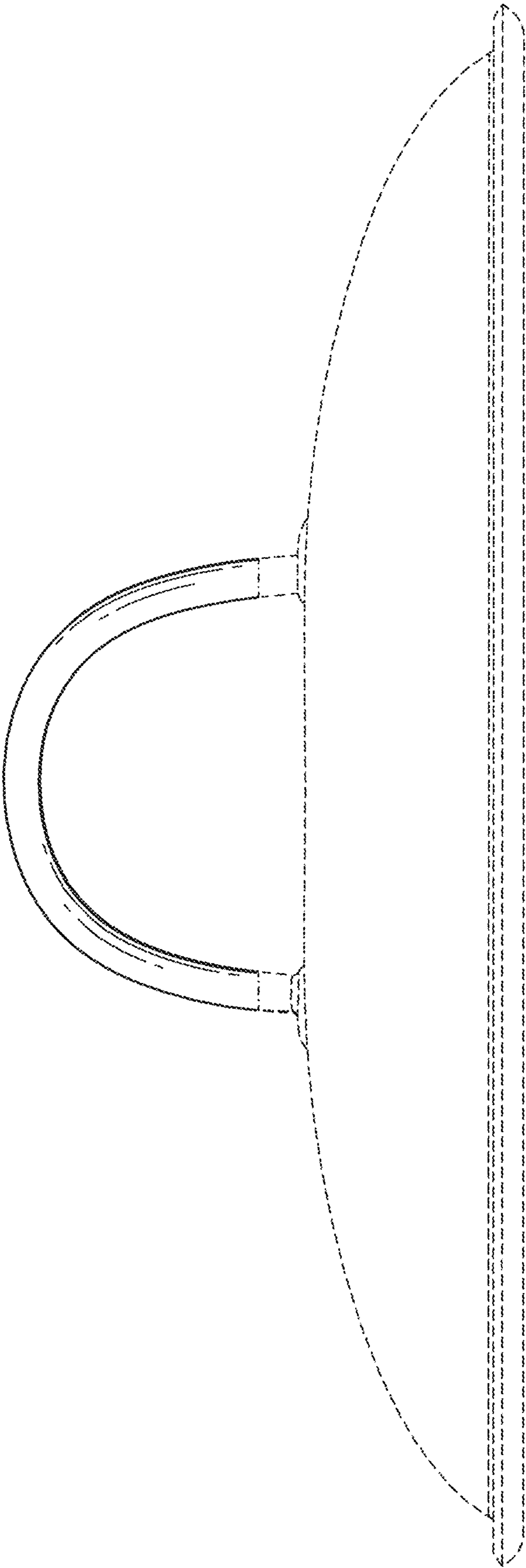

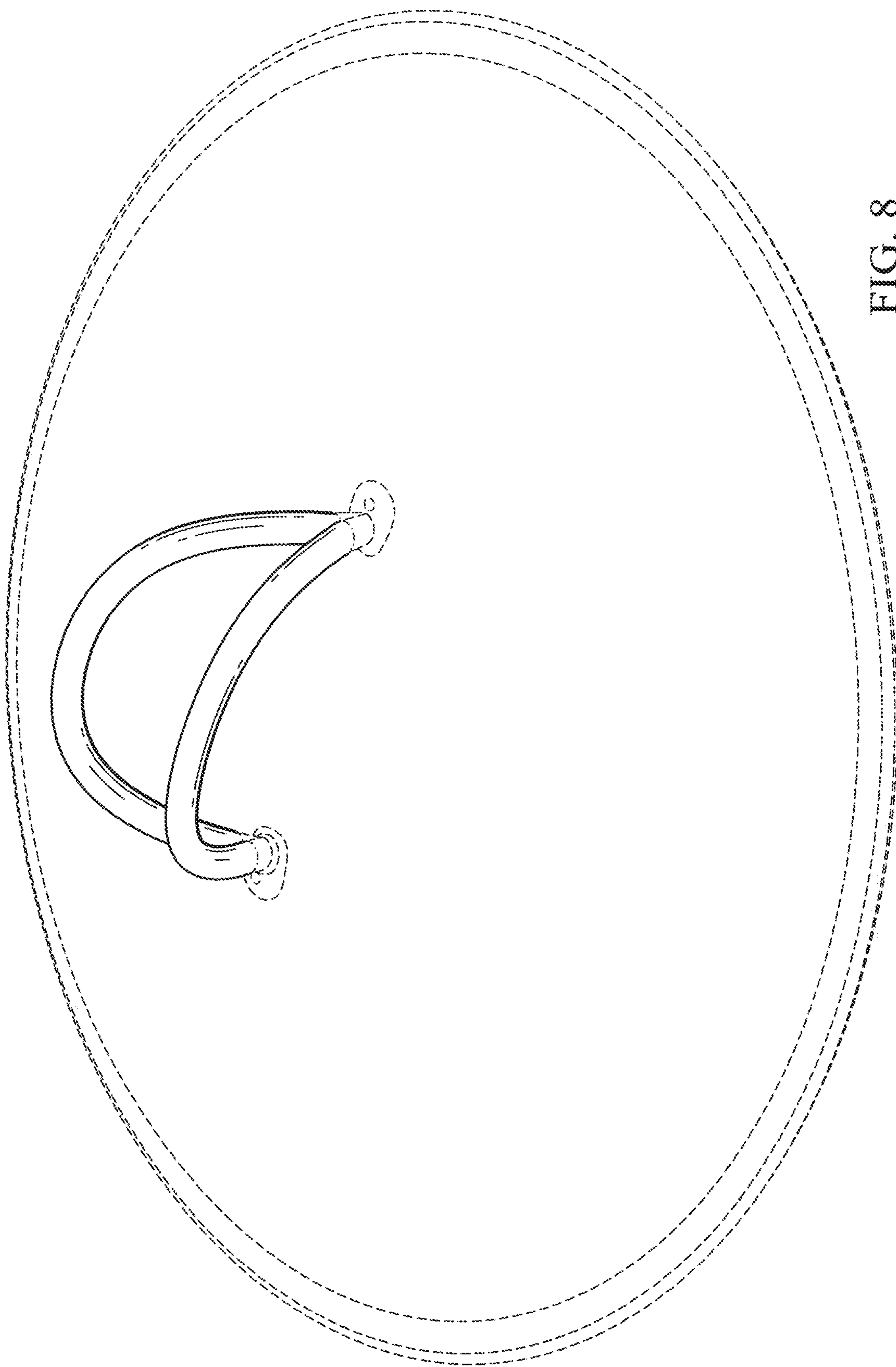
