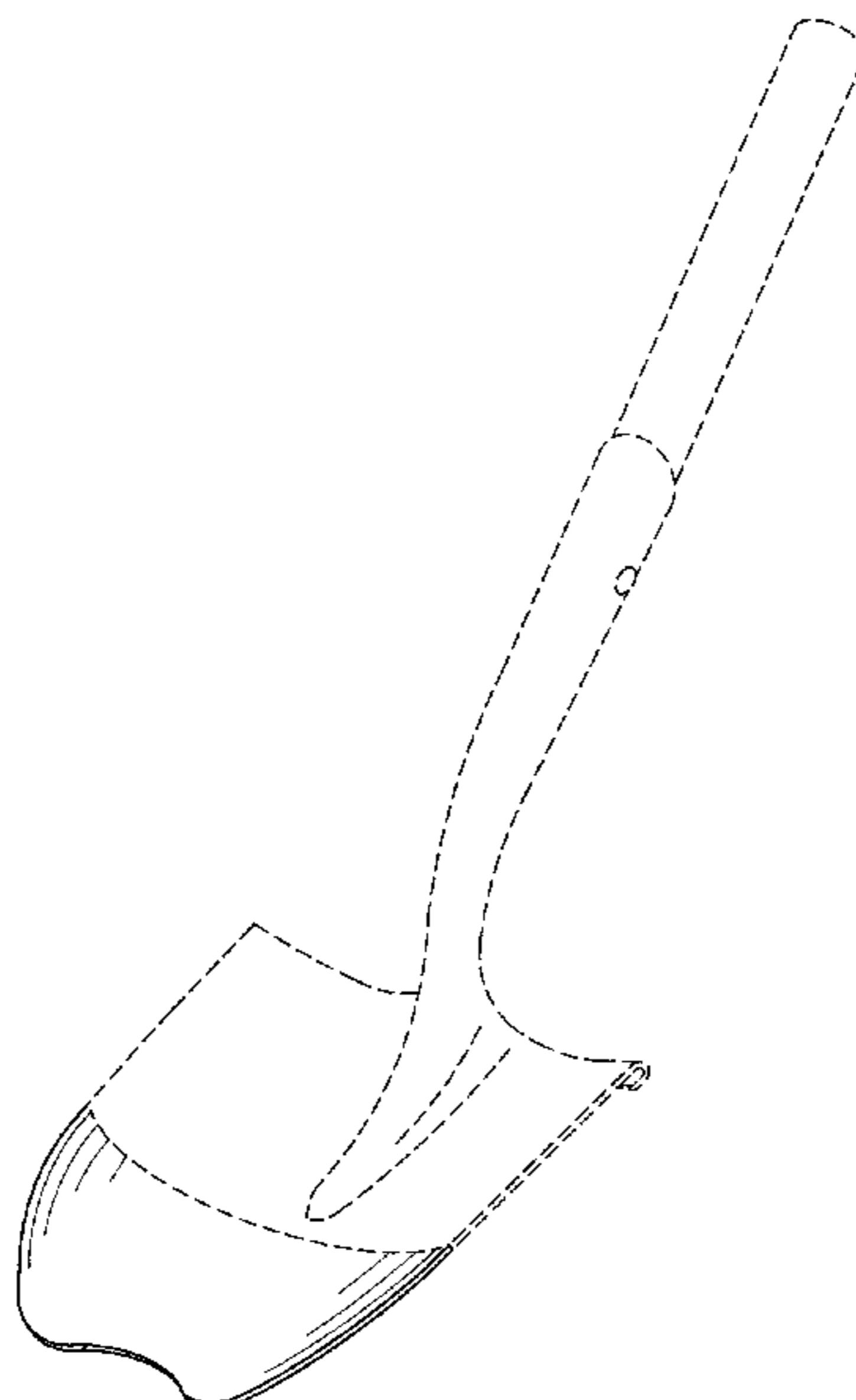
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shovel blade showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the shovel blade of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the shovel blade of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the shovel blade of FIG. 1; and,

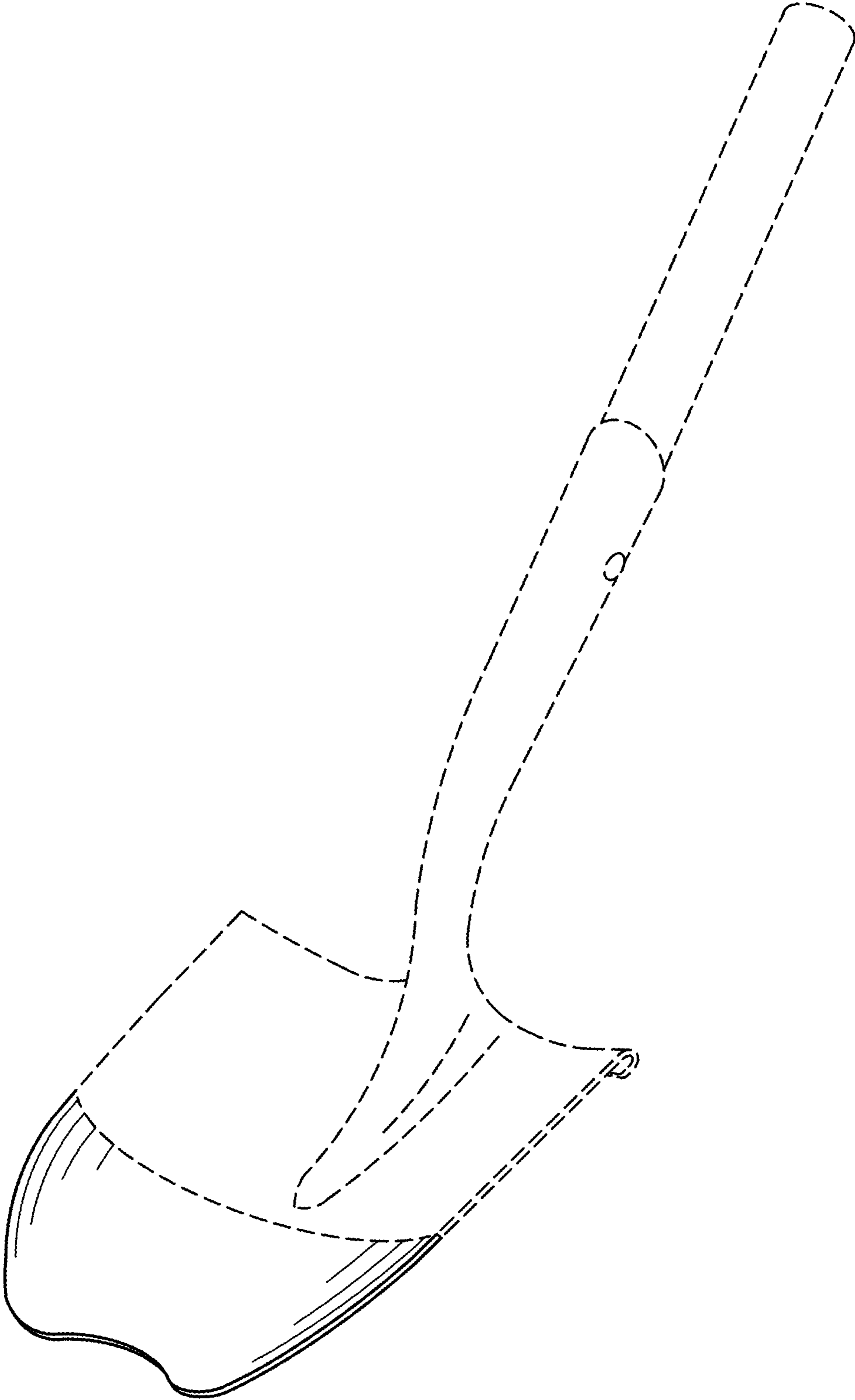

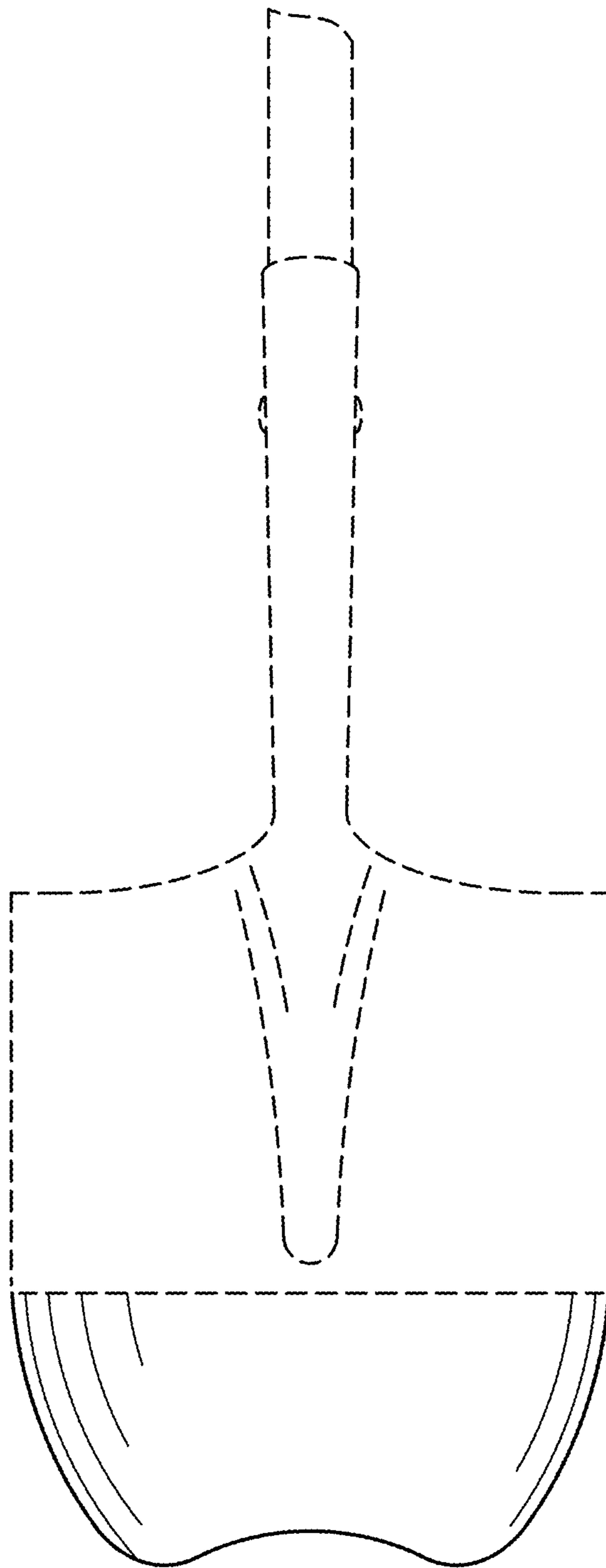

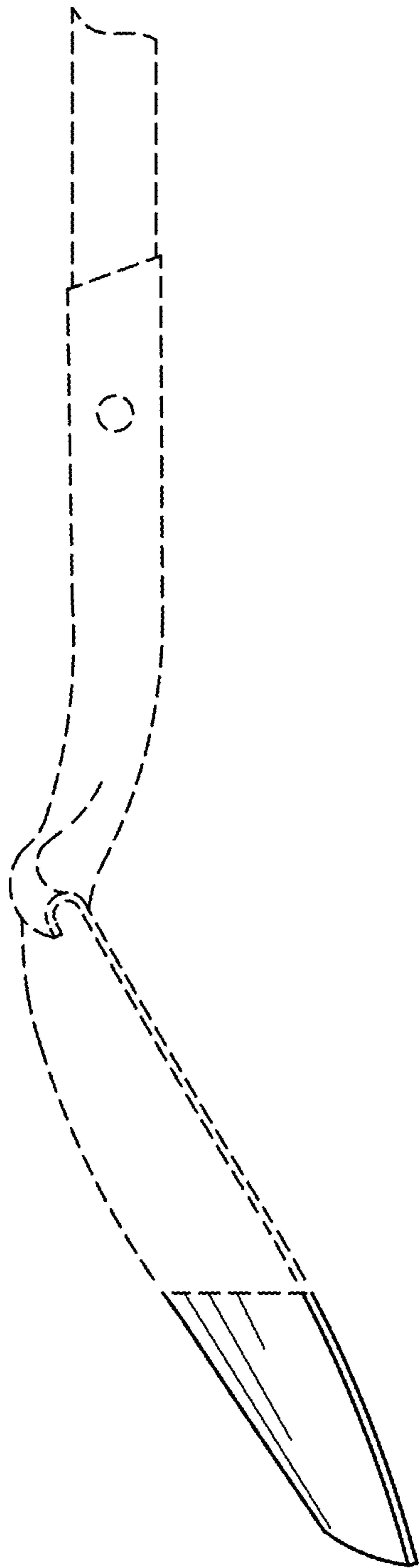

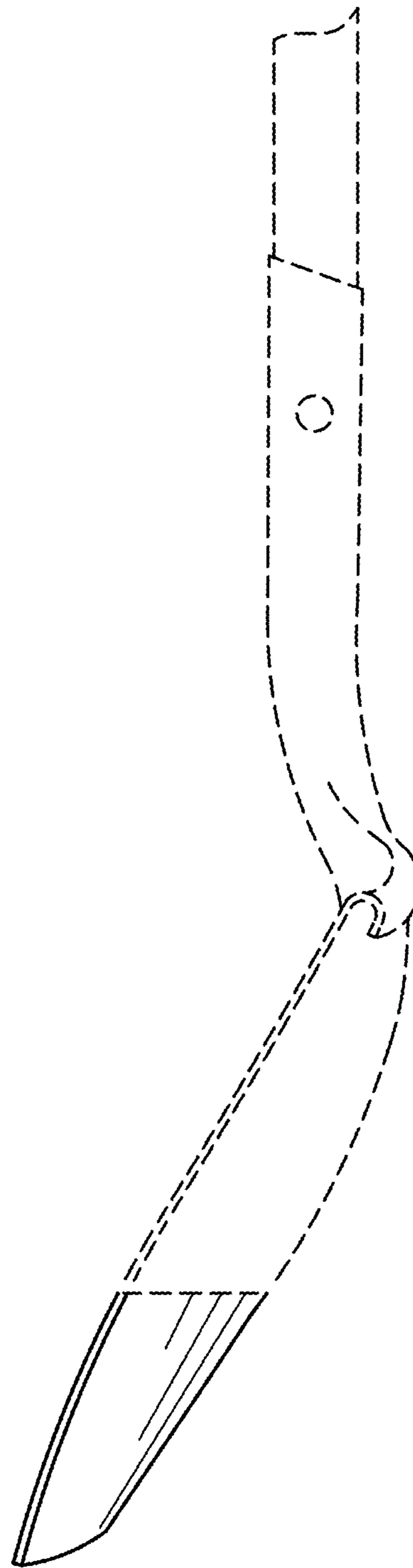

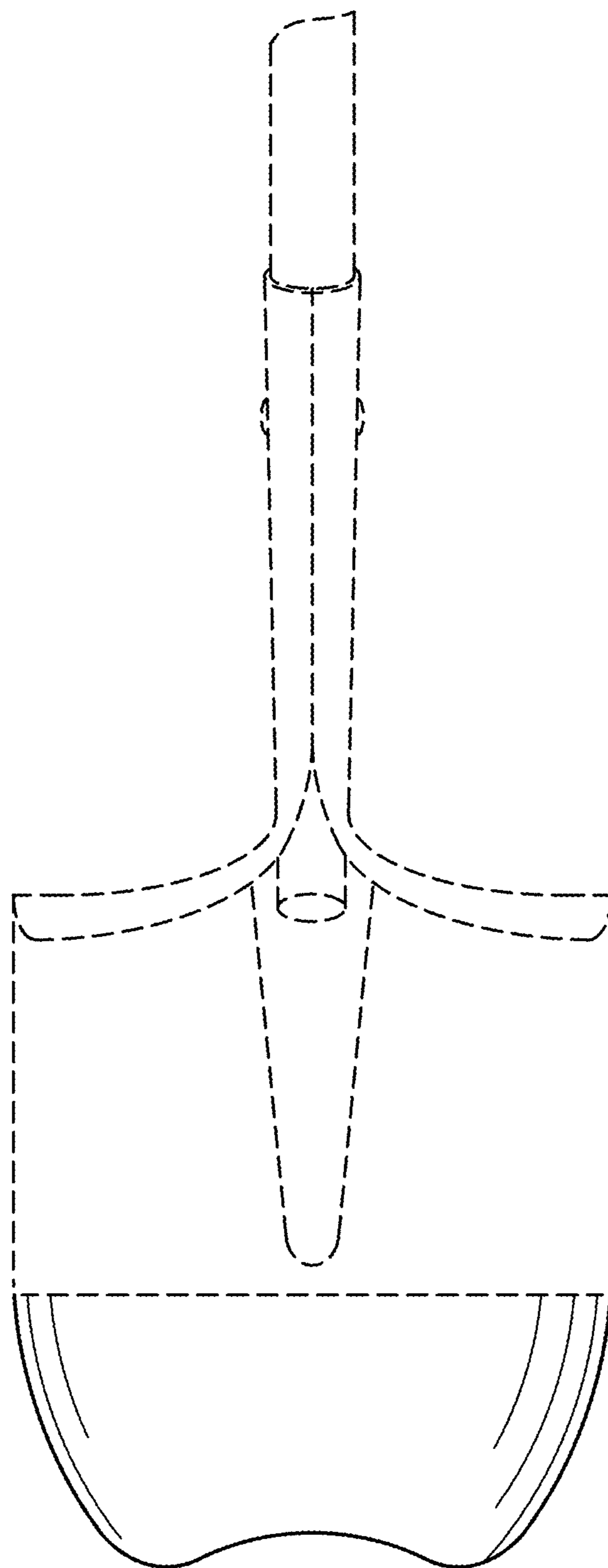
