DESCRIPTION

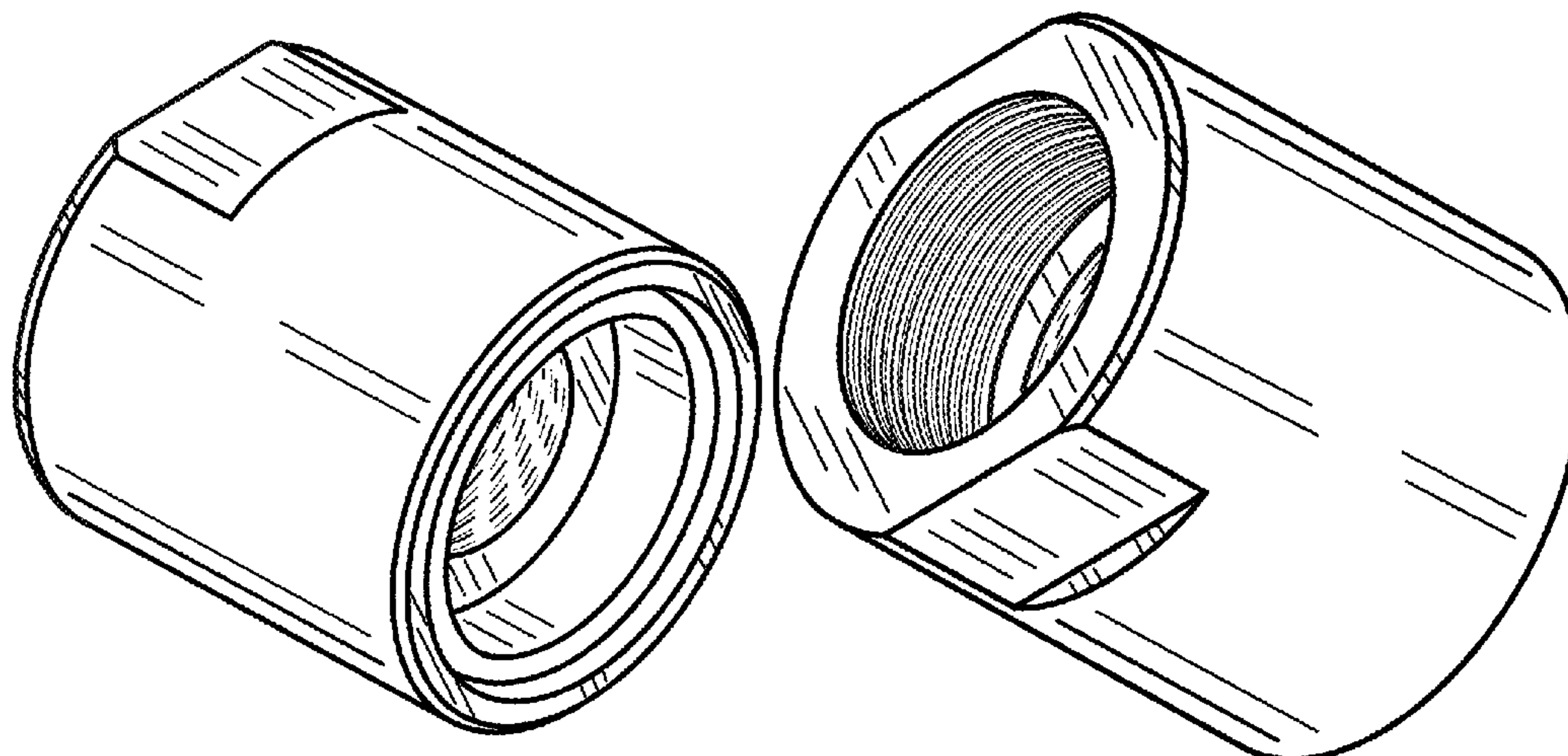
FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of a tall pour spout adapter showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

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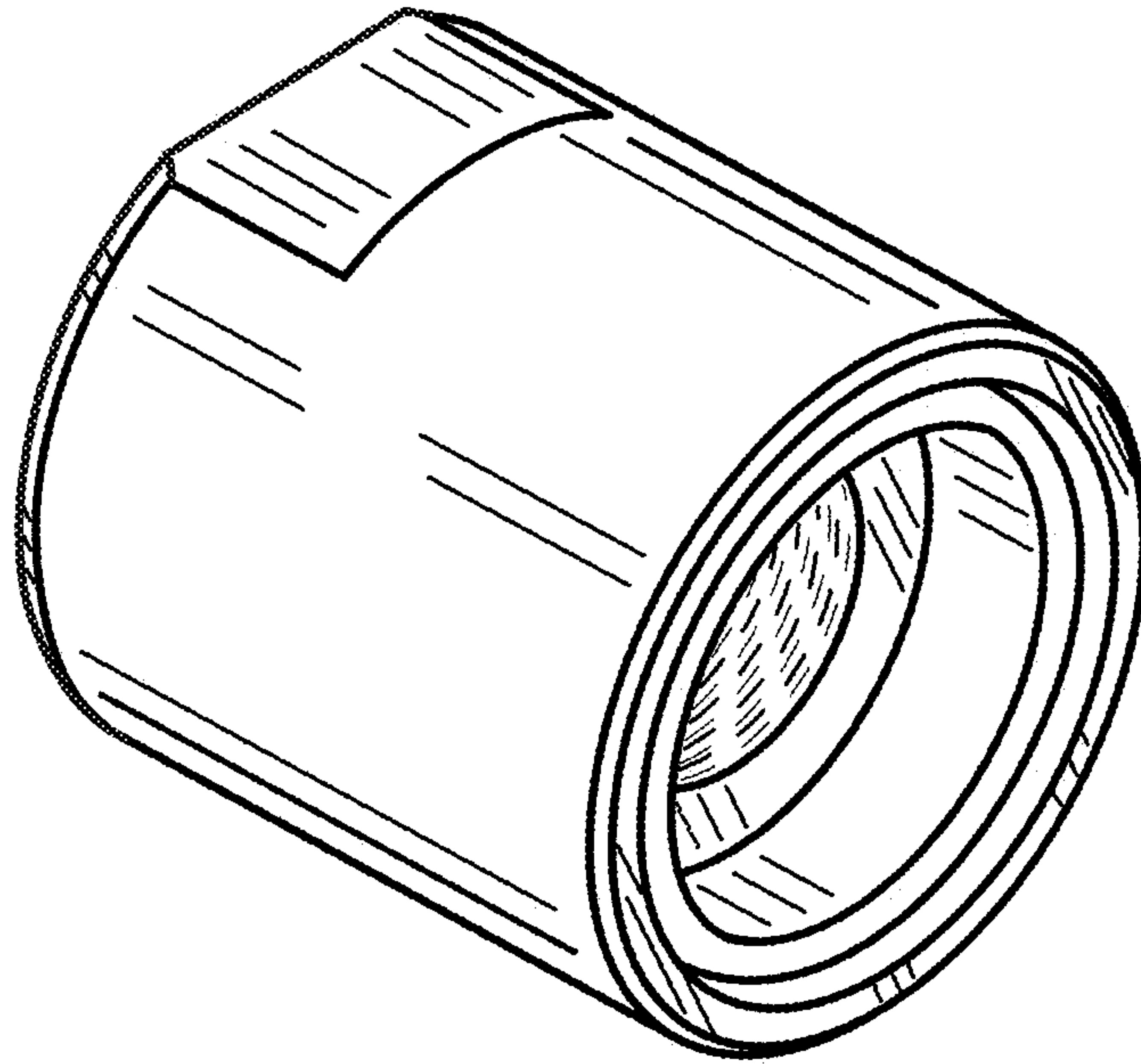

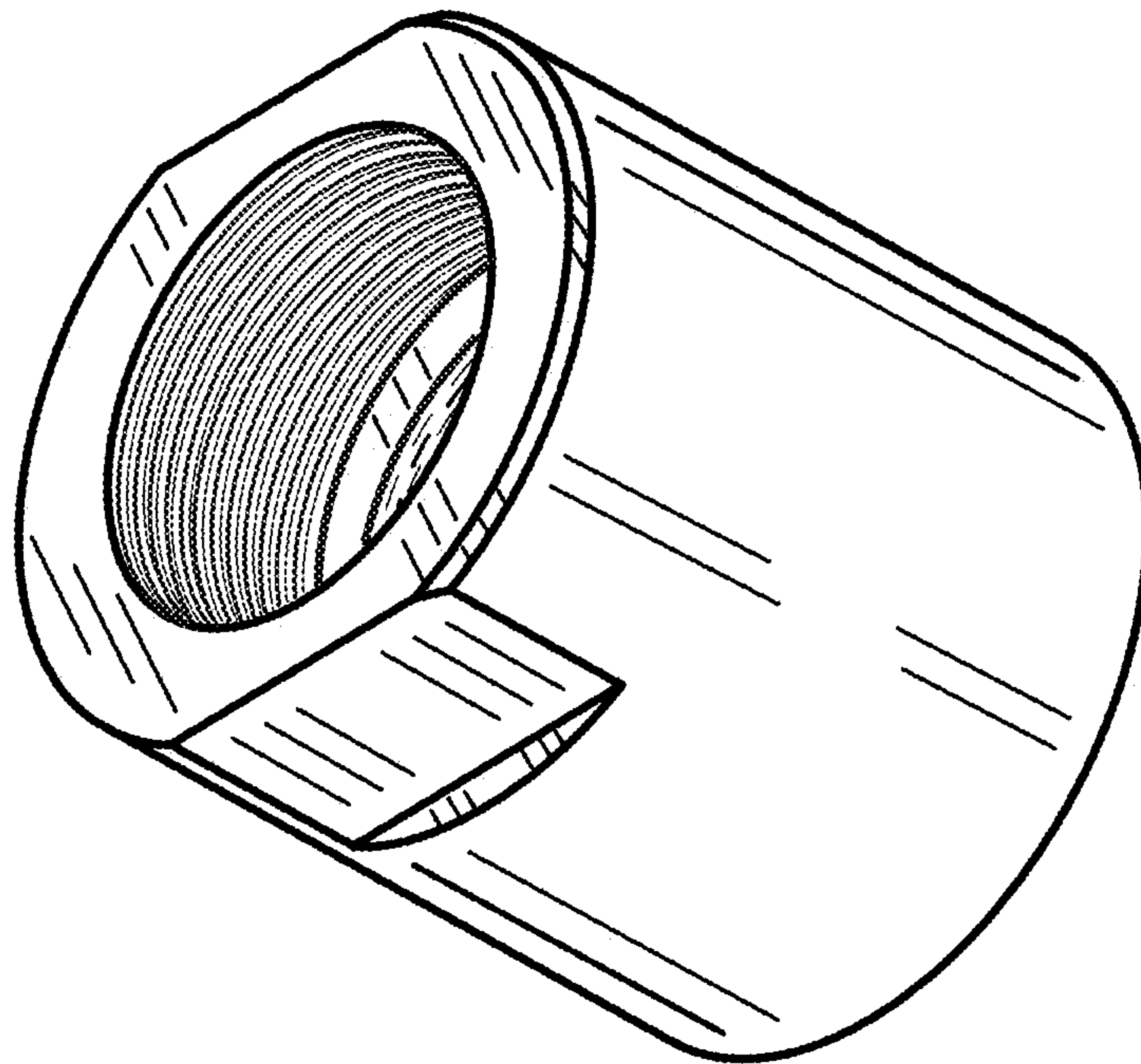

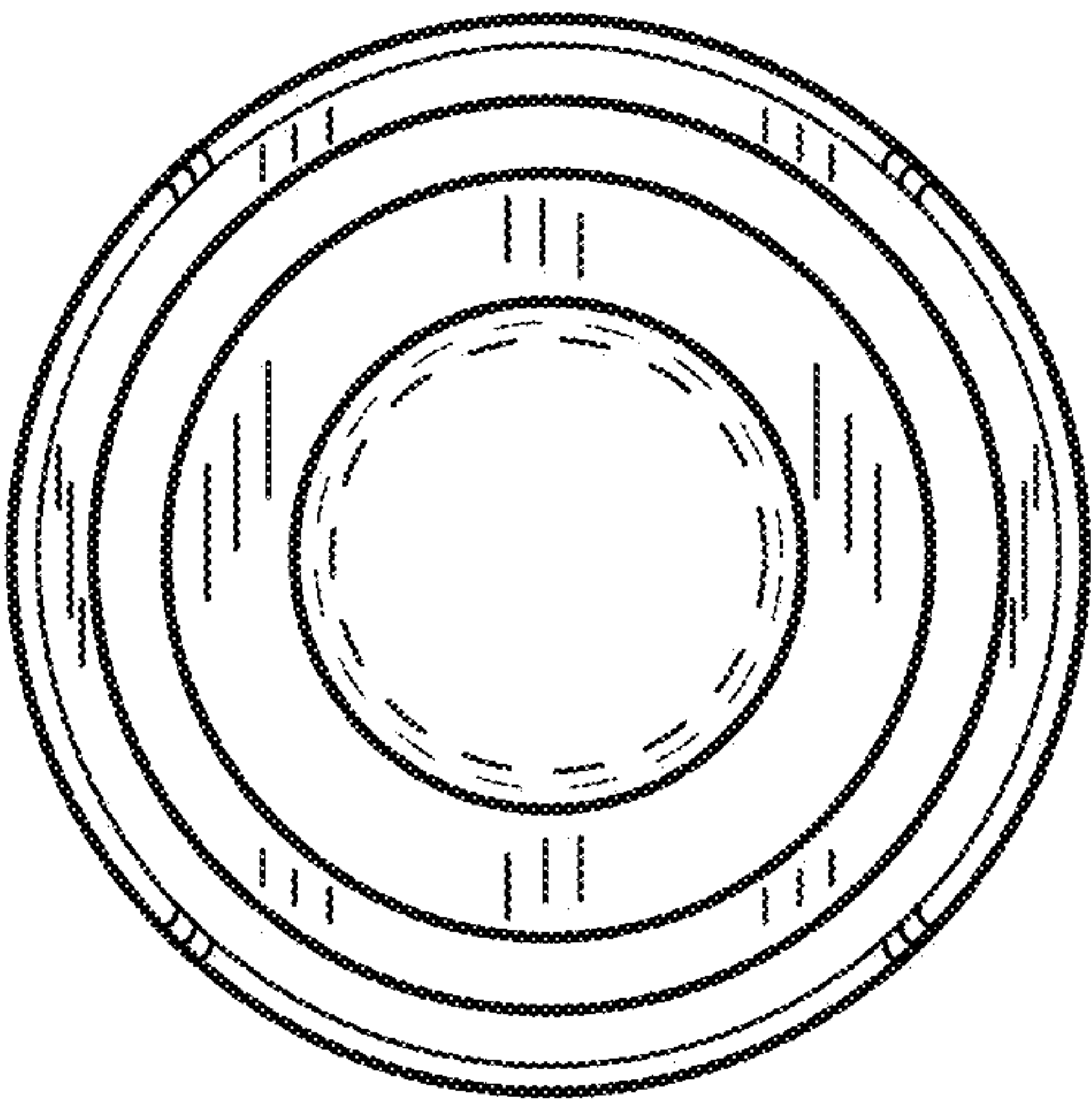

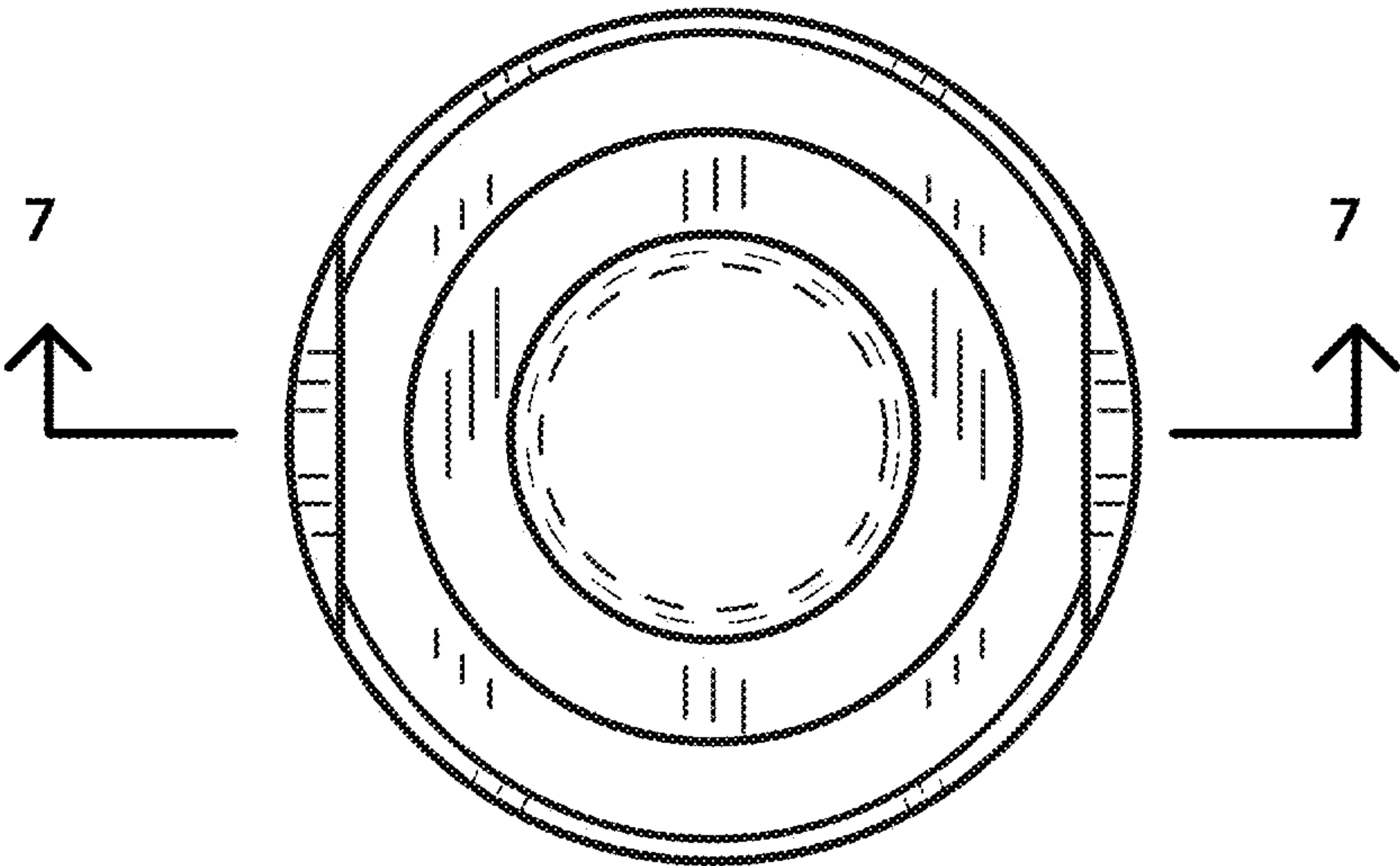

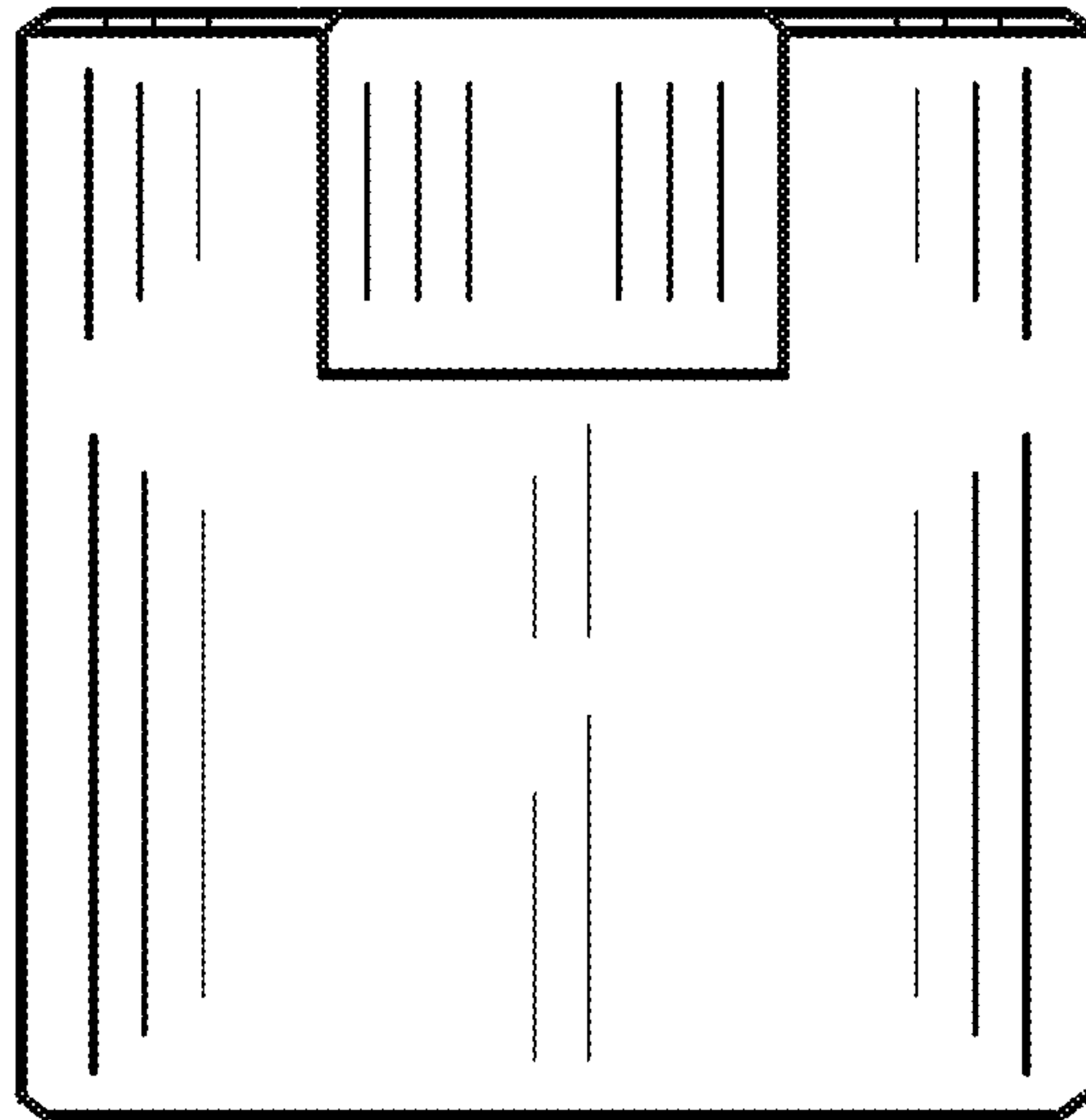

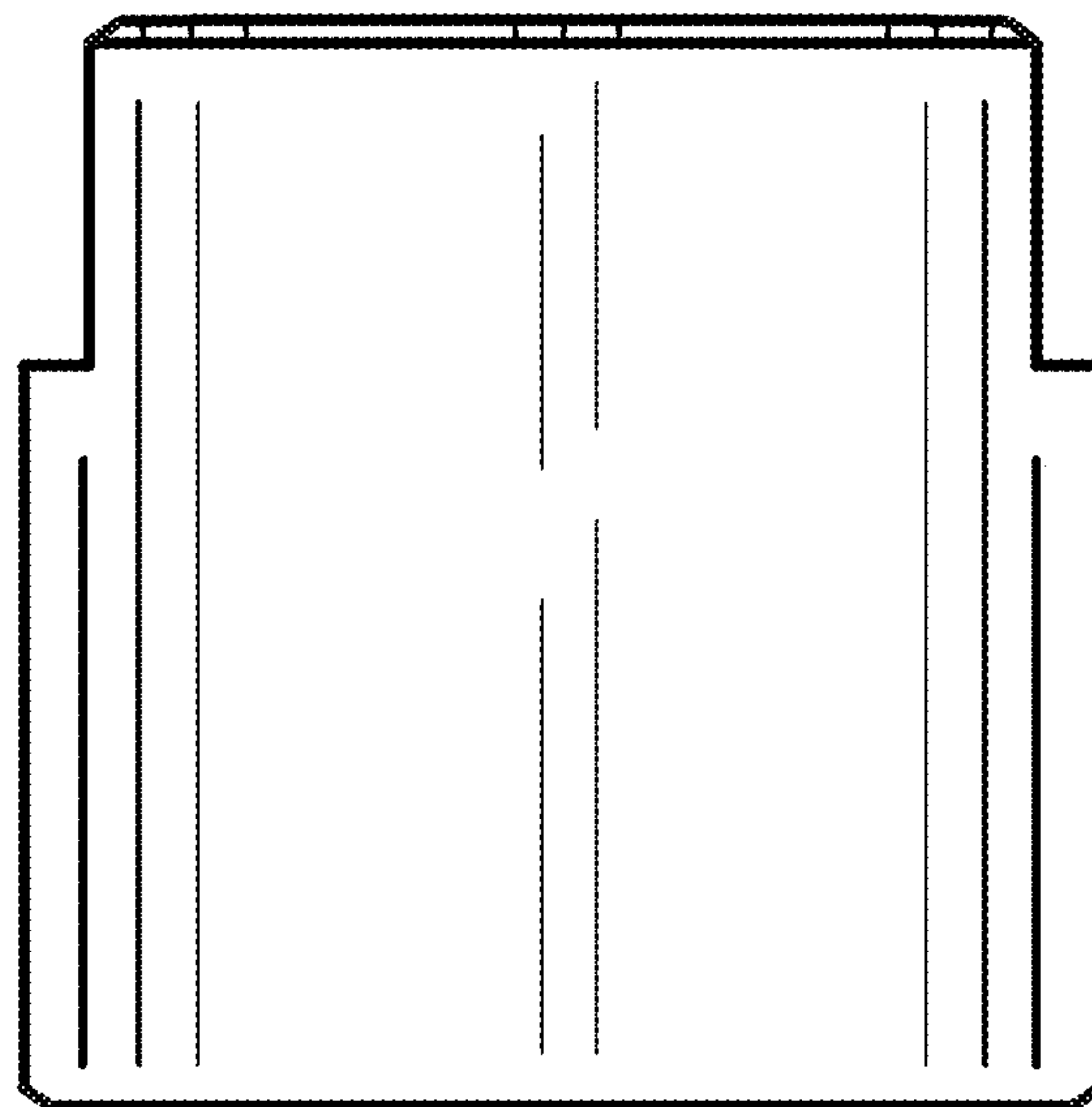

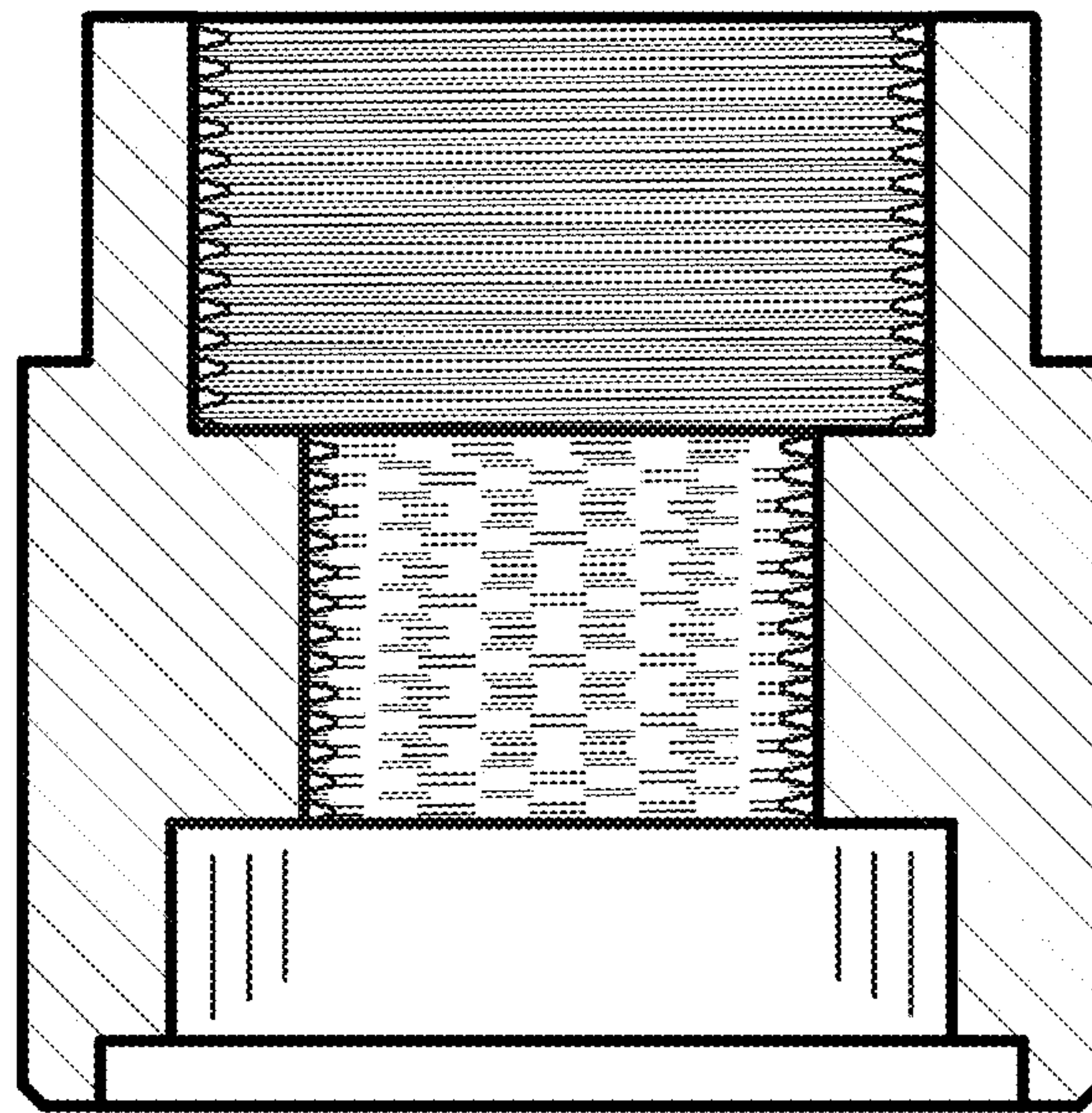
