of FIG. 1 shown in the environment of the ceiling fan;

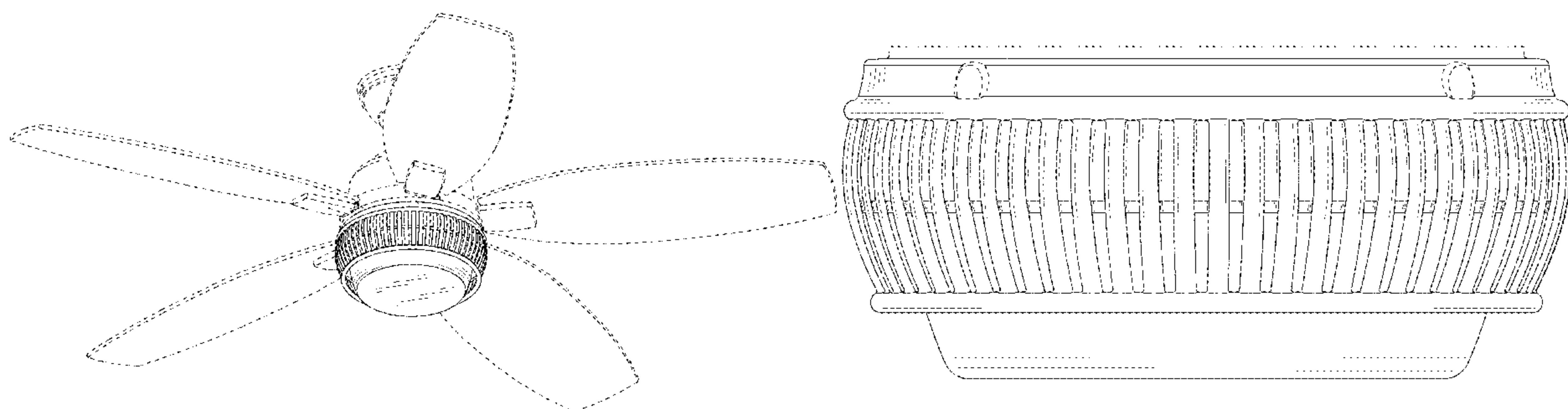
FIG. 3 is a top view of the ceiling fan light kit of FIG. 1

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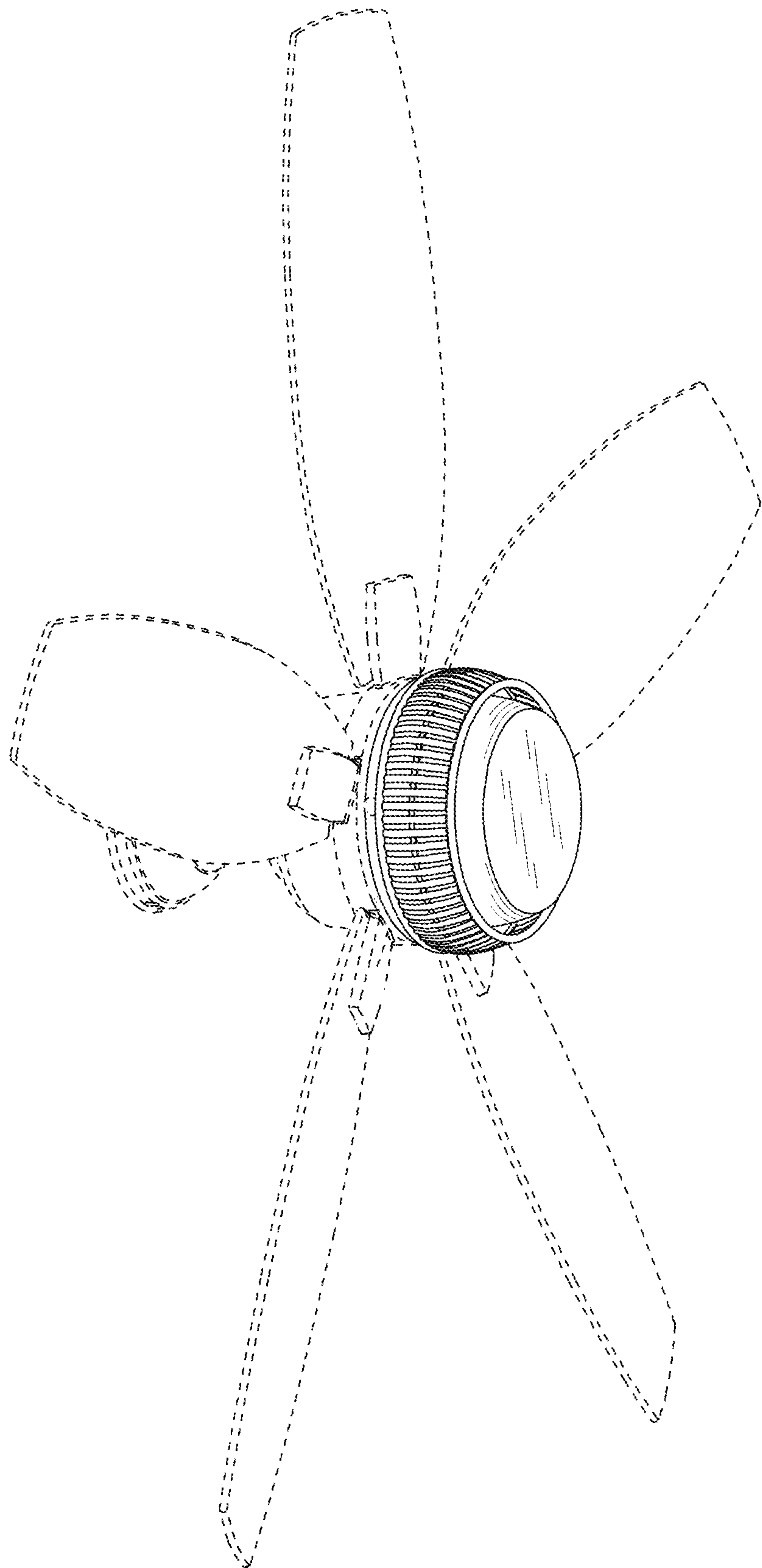

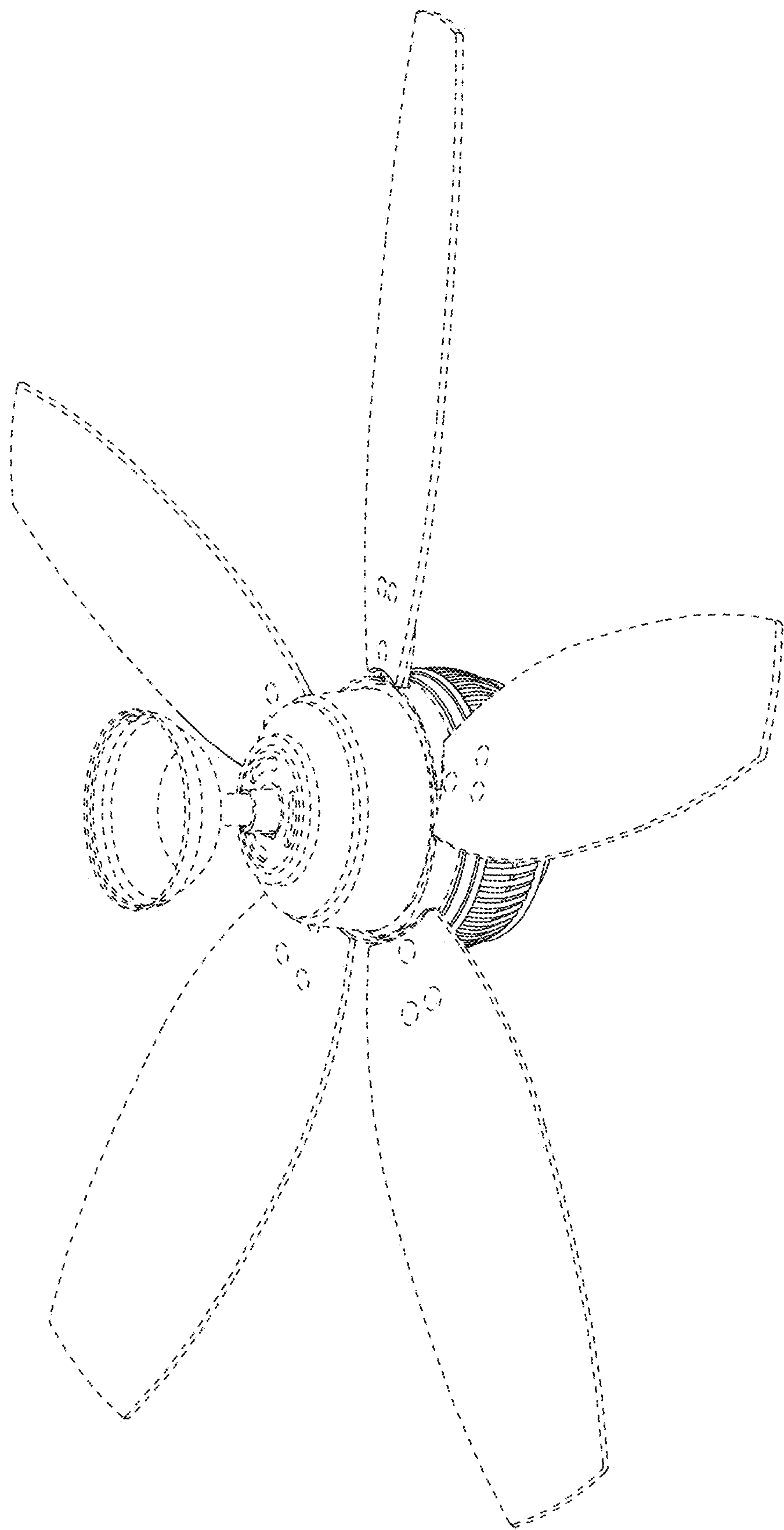

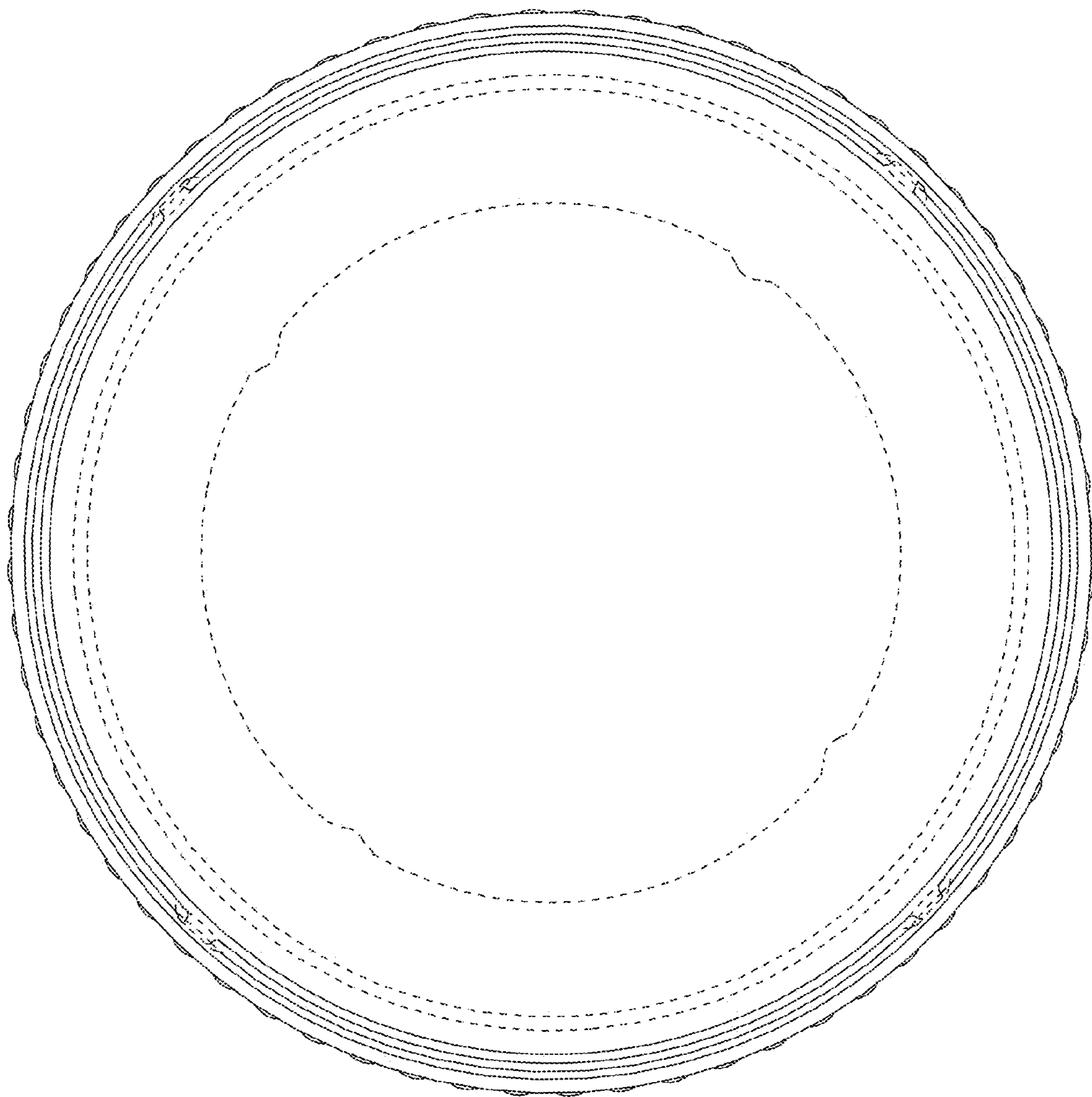

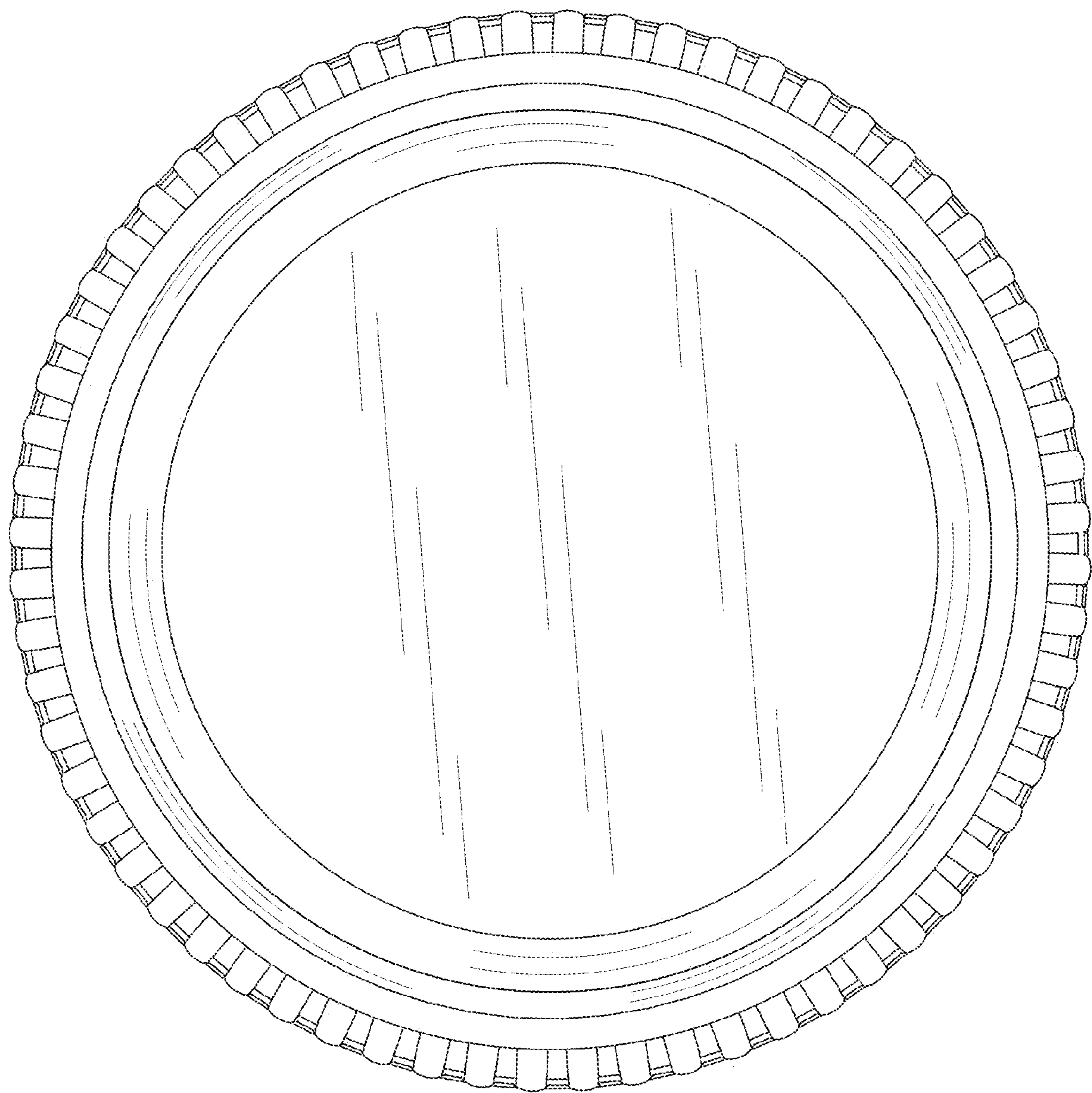

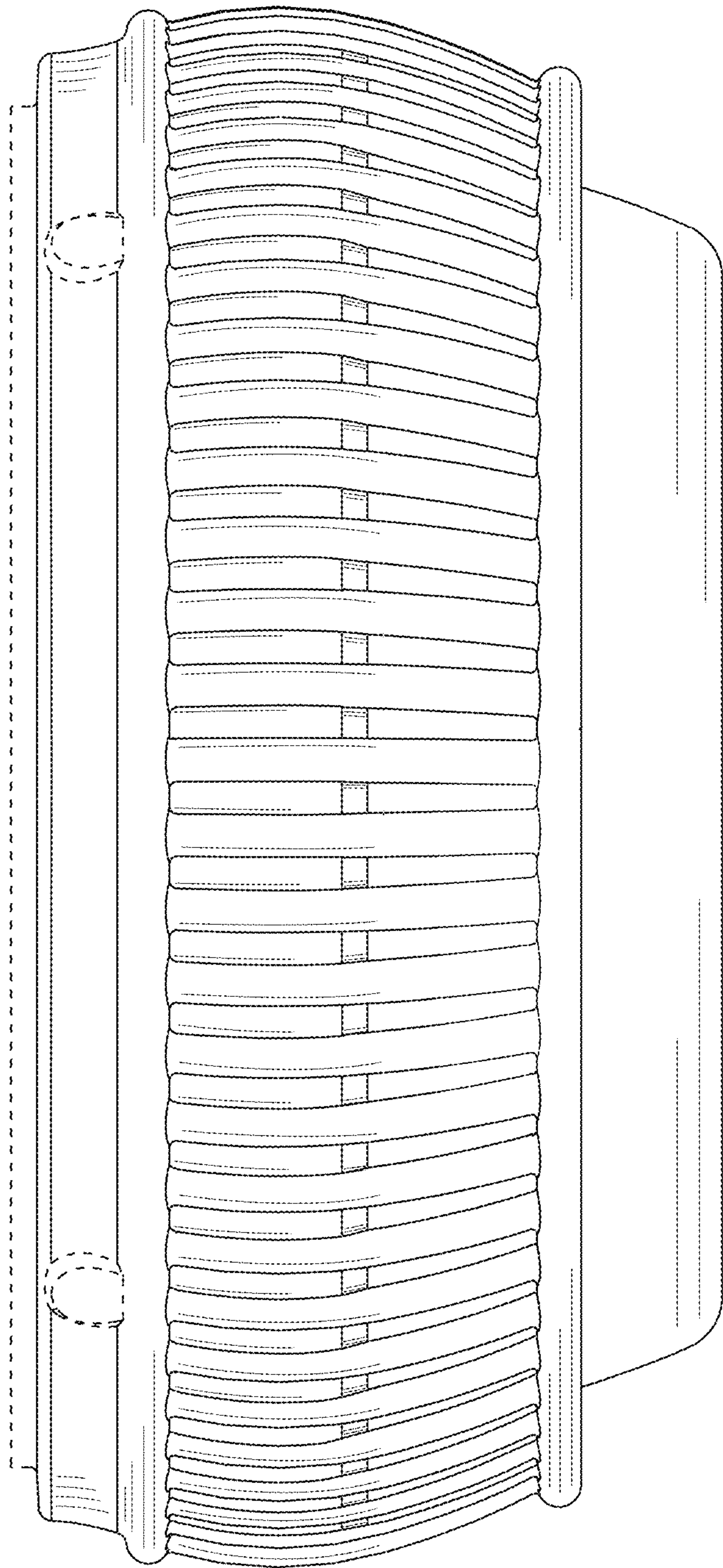
