DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an upper perspective view of a container in accordance with an illustrative embodiment of our new claimed design.

FIG. 2 is an elevational front view of the container in FIG. 1, the right, left, and rear elevational views being substantially the same as FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a top view of the container in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the container in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is an upper perspective view of a container in accordance with another illustrative embodiment of our new claimed design.

FIG. 6 is an elevational front view of the container in FIG. 5, the right, left, and rear elevational views being substantially the same as FIG. 5.

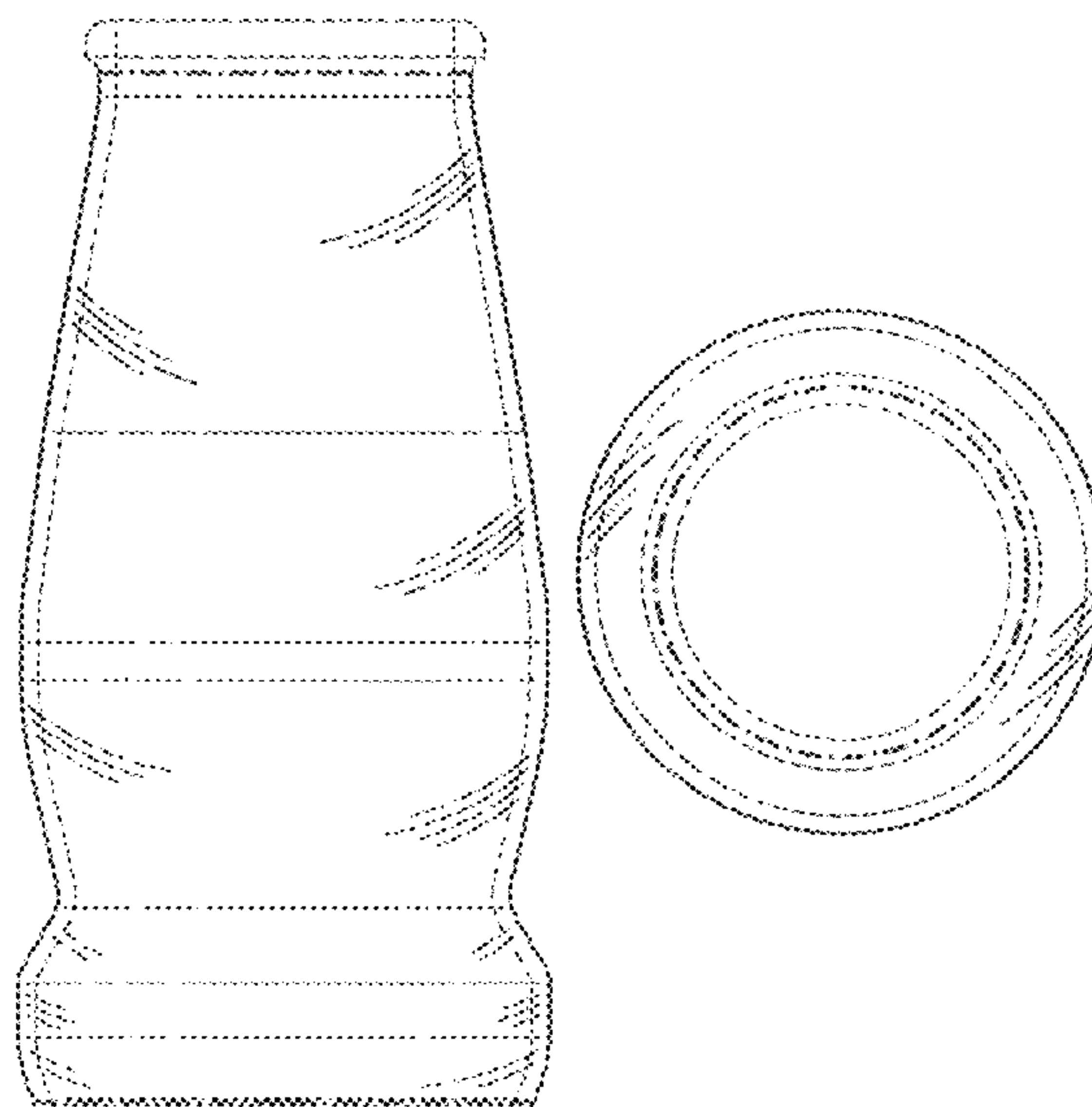
FIG. 7 is a top view of the container in FIG. 5; and,

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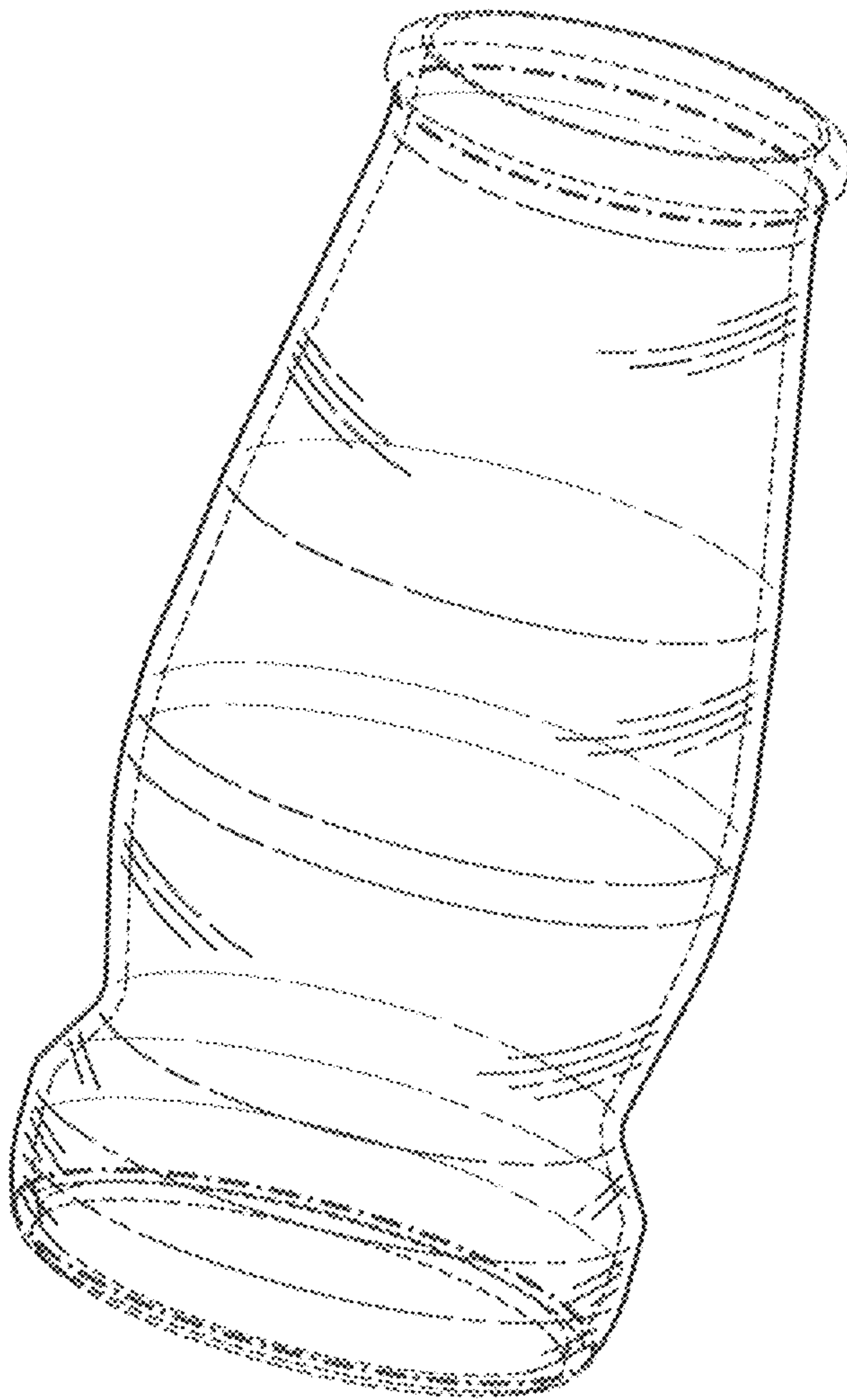

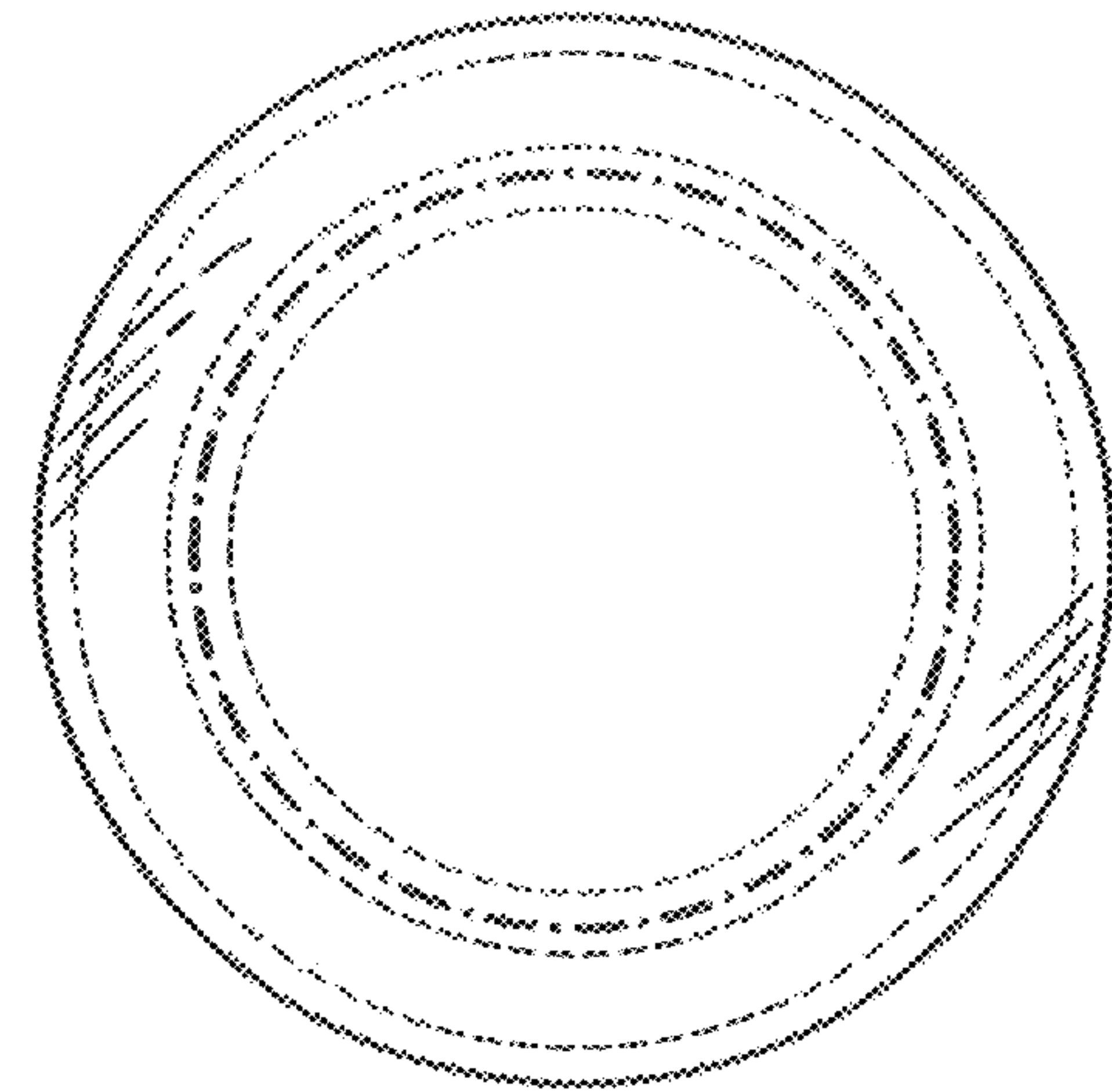

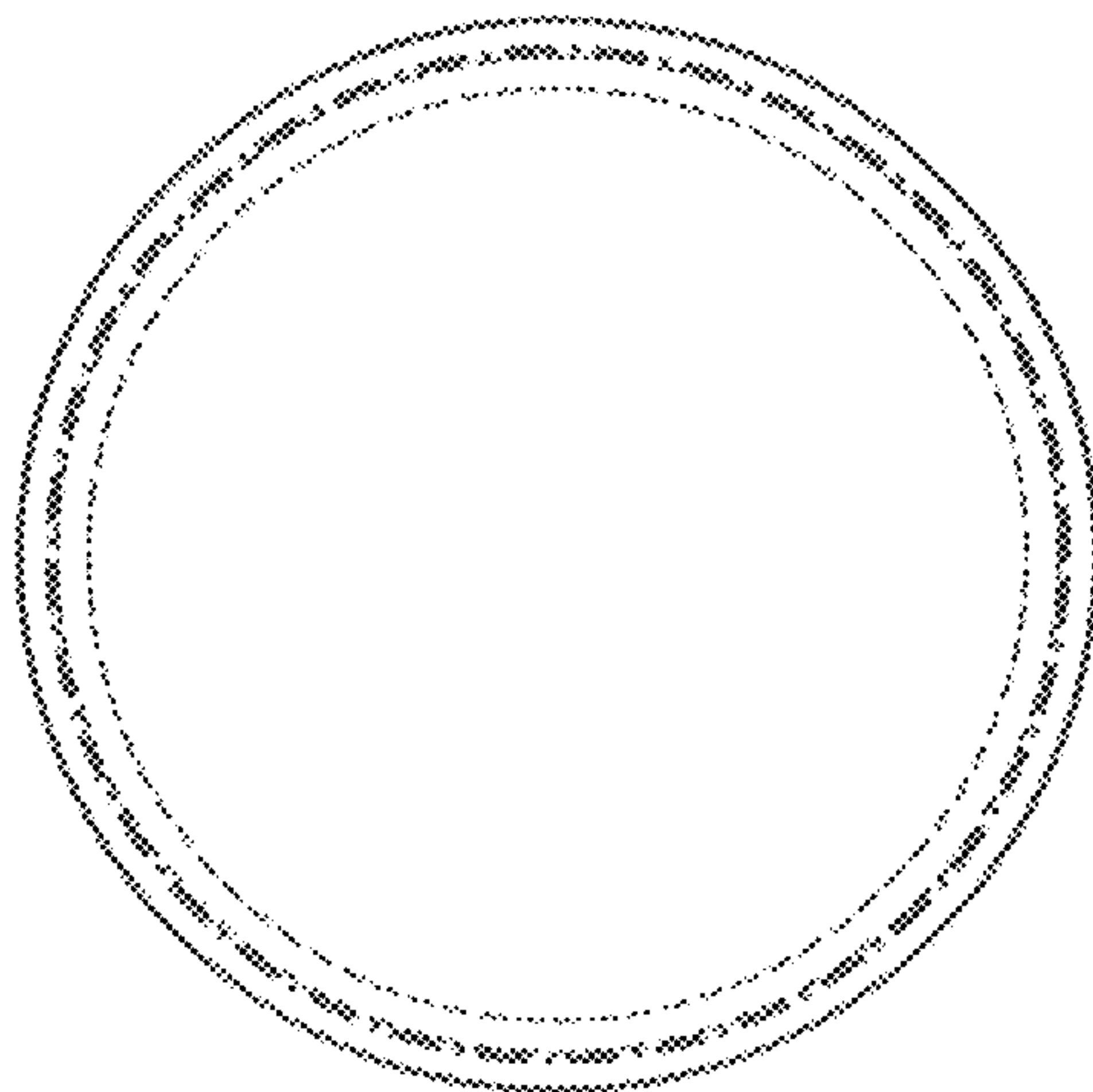

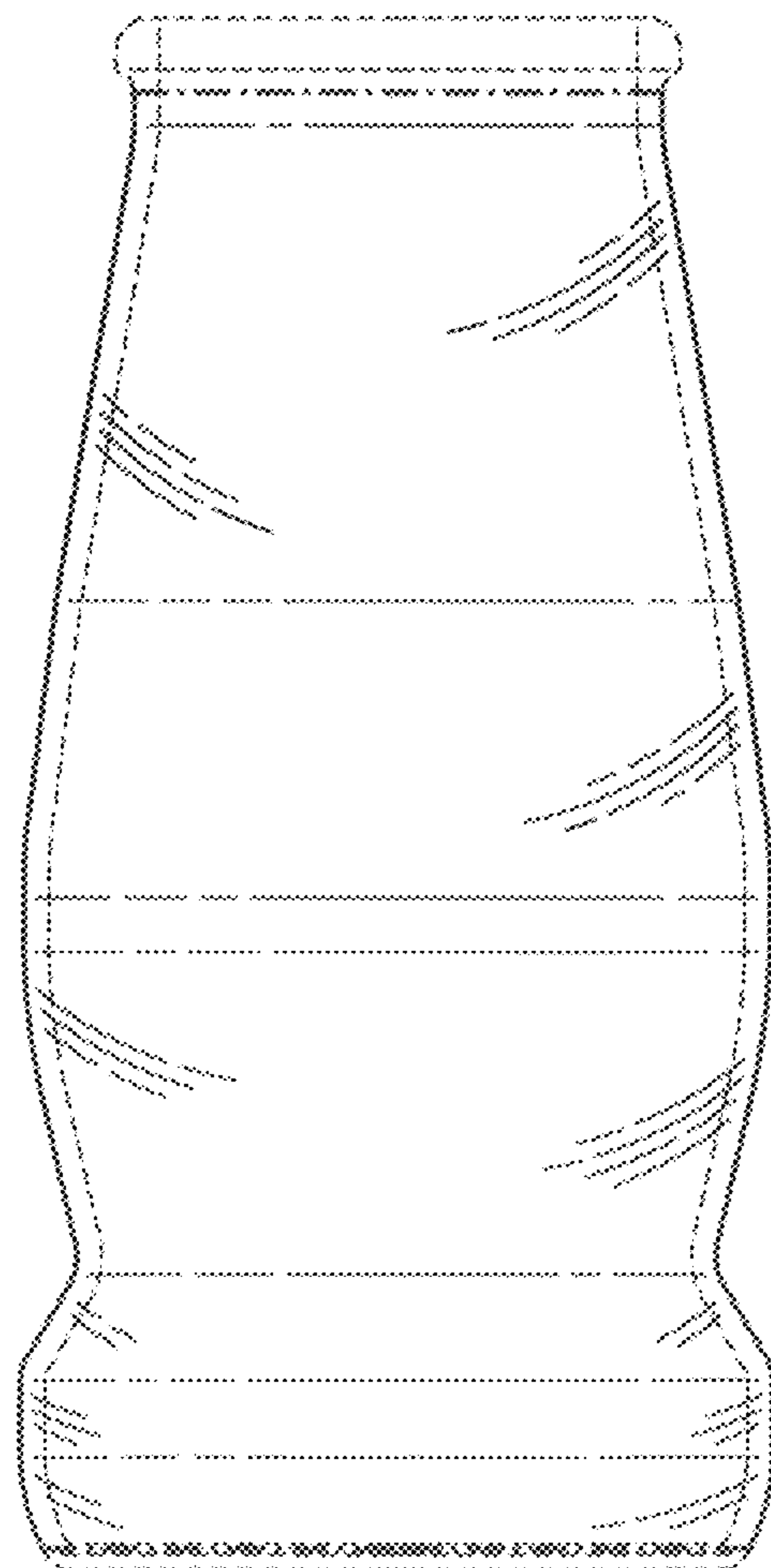

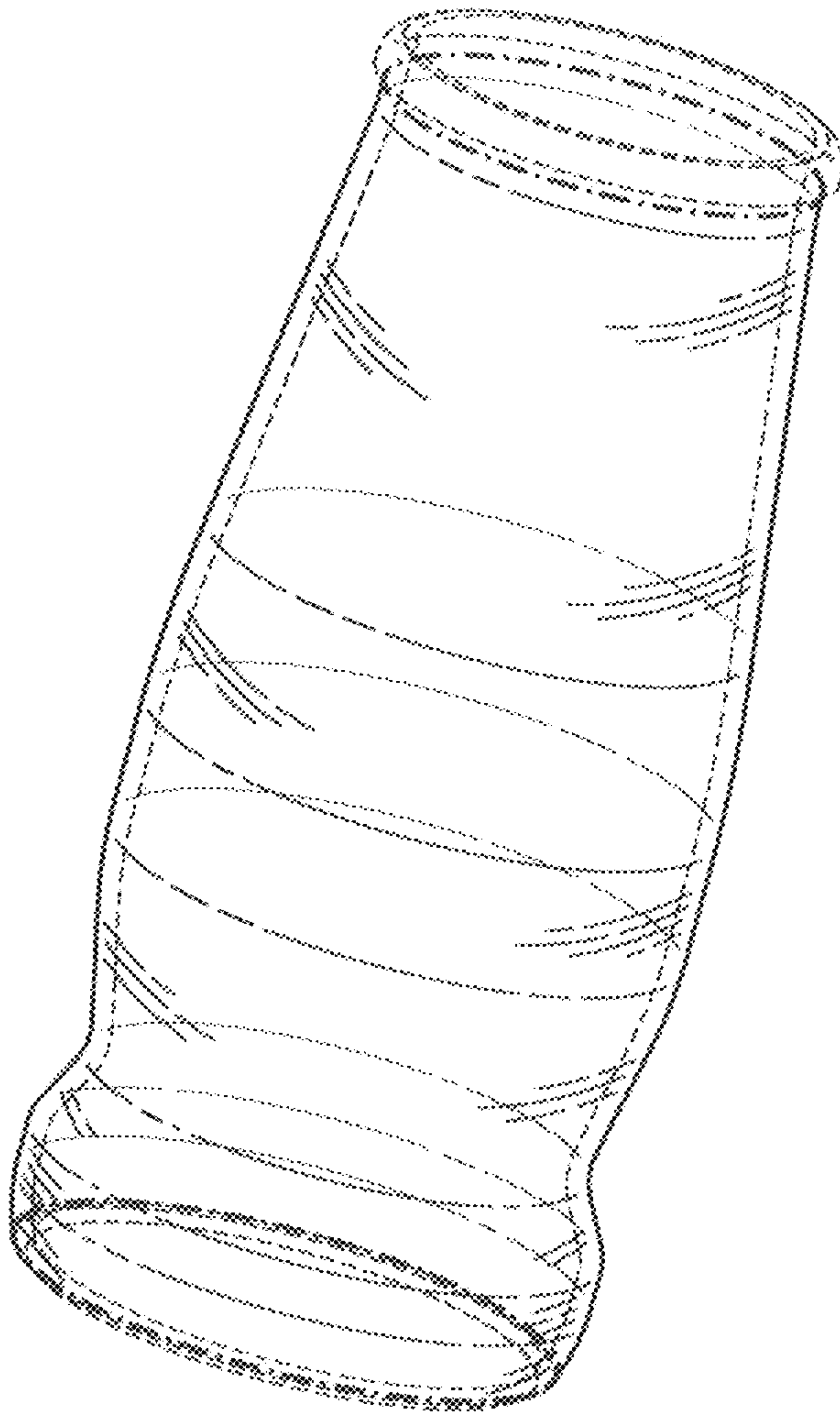

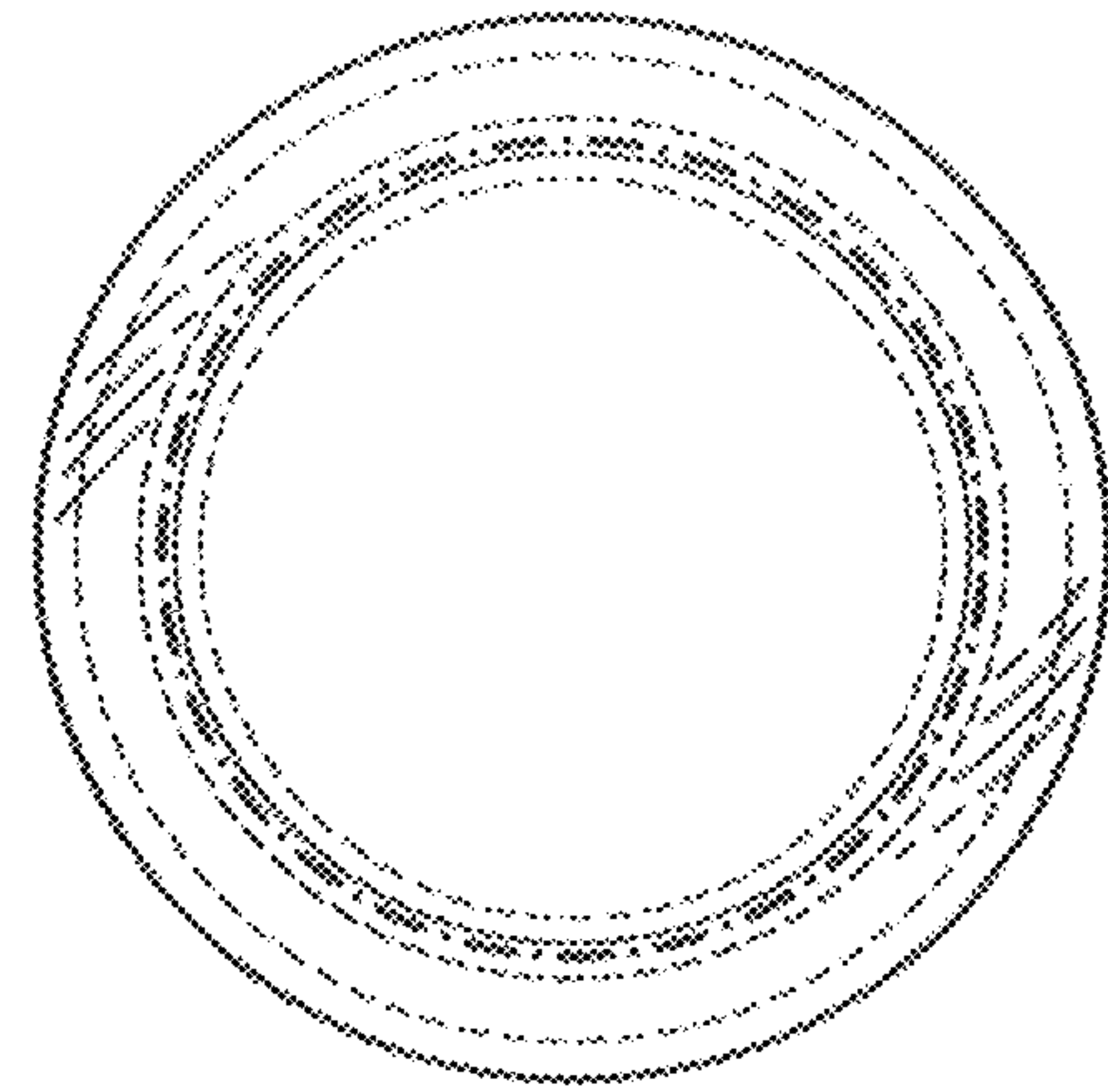

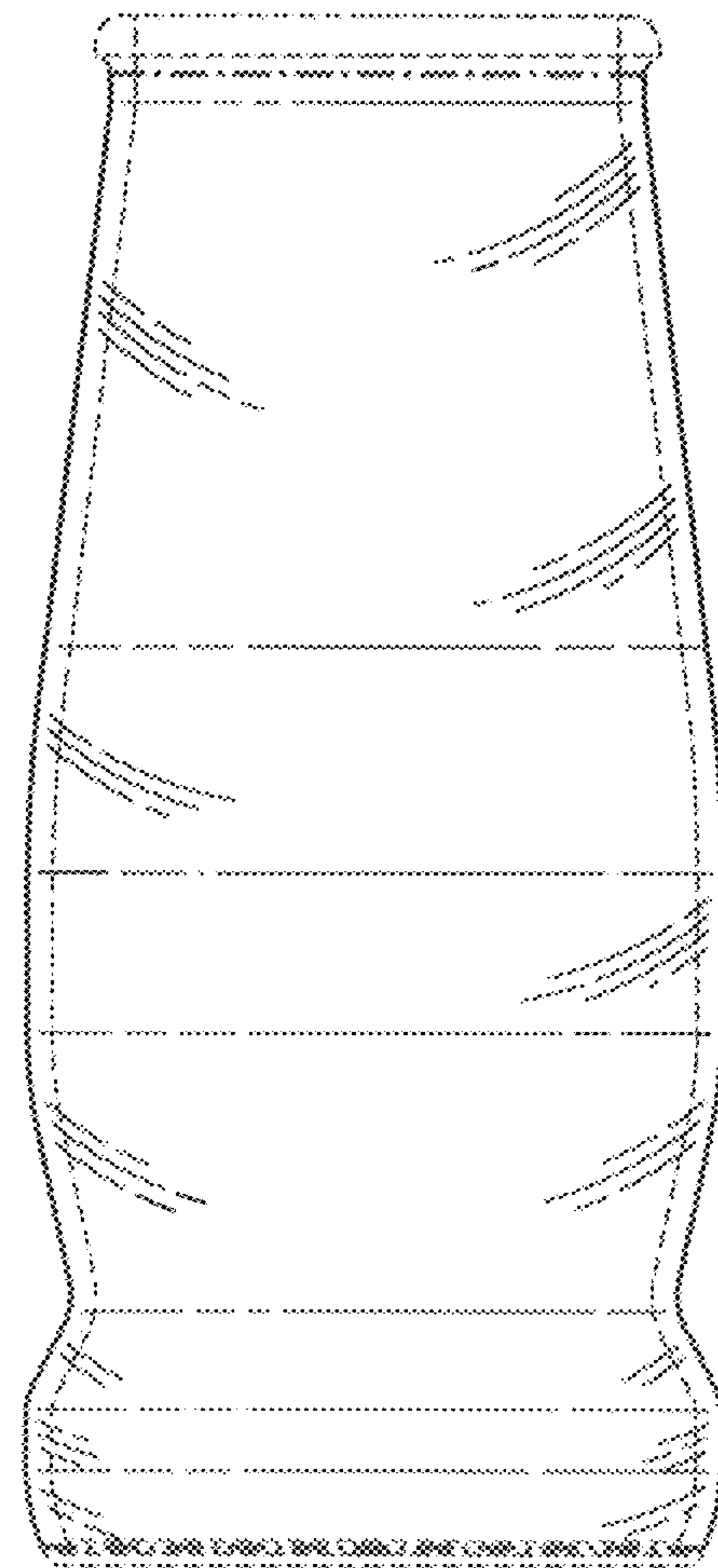

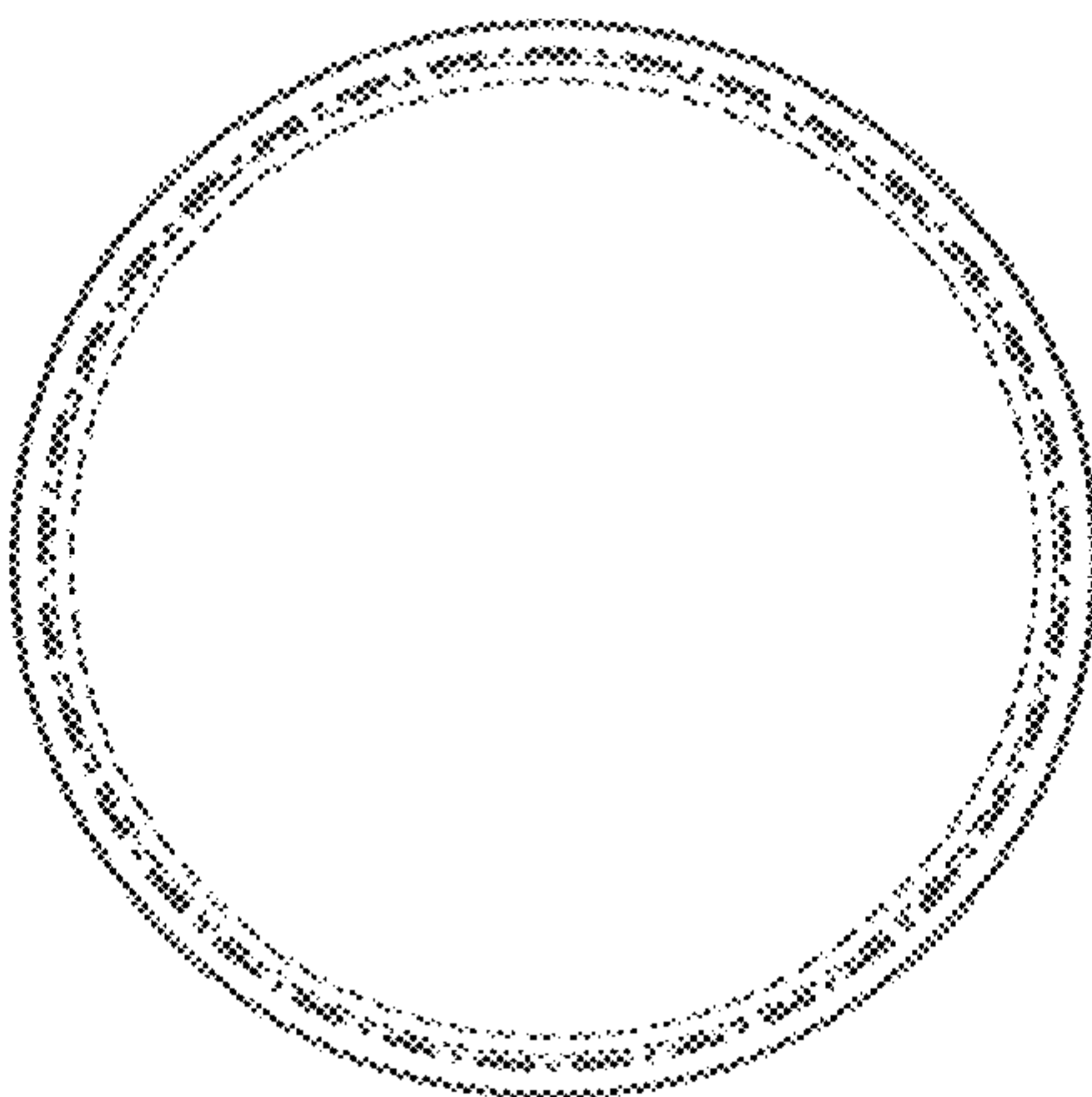
