(57) **CLAIM**

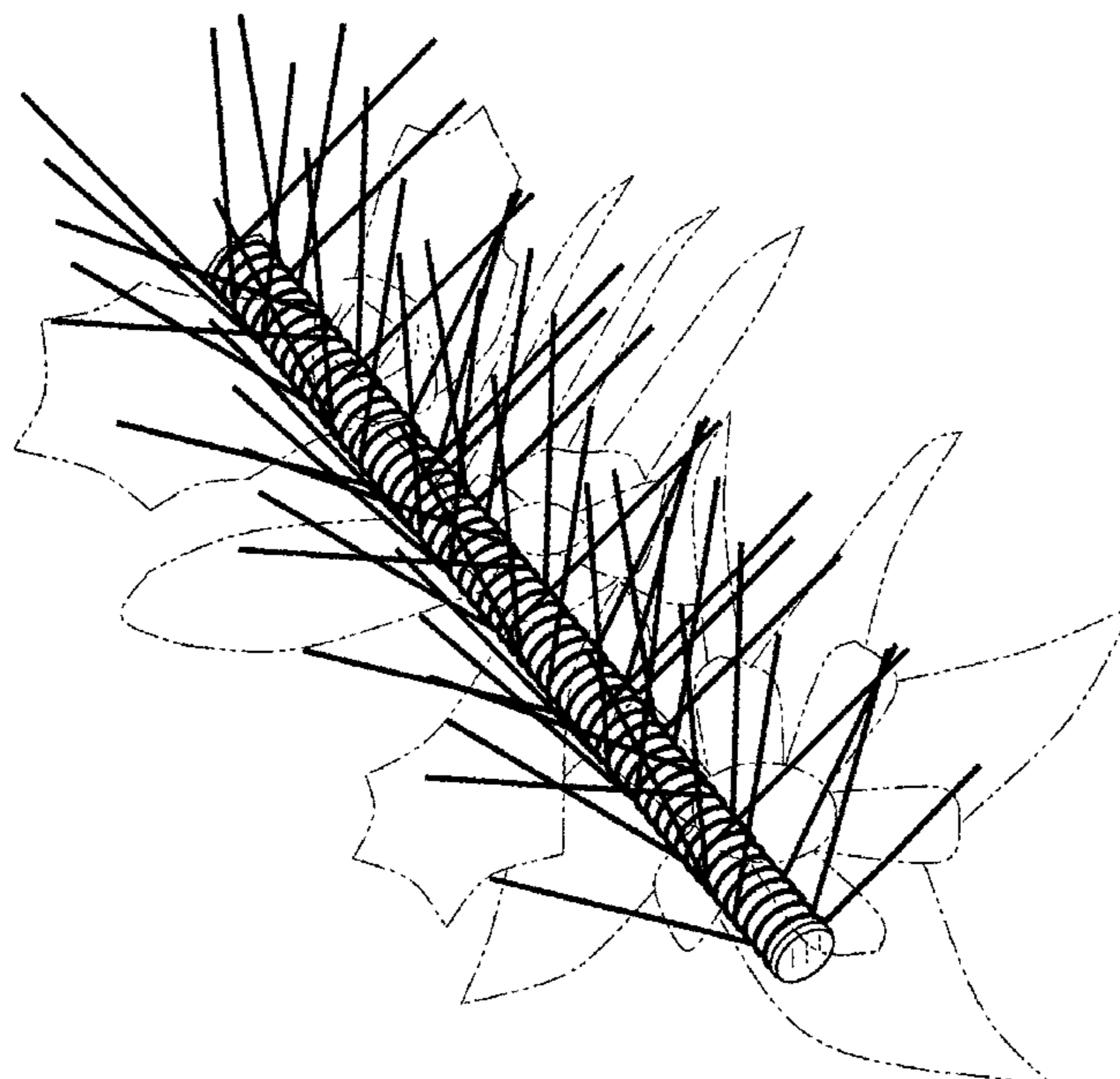
The ornamental design for the supporting wire base for floral arrangements, as shown and described.

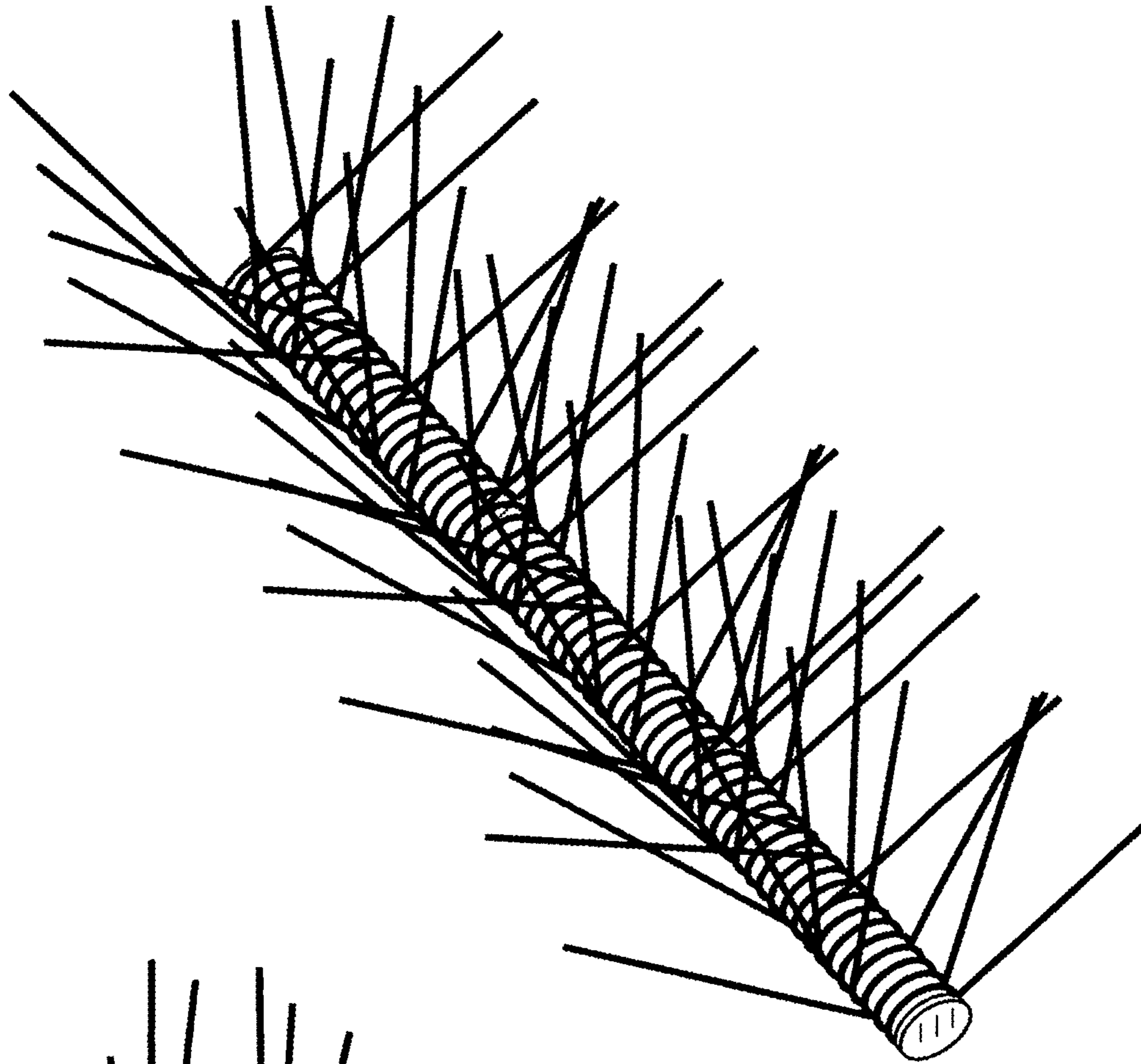

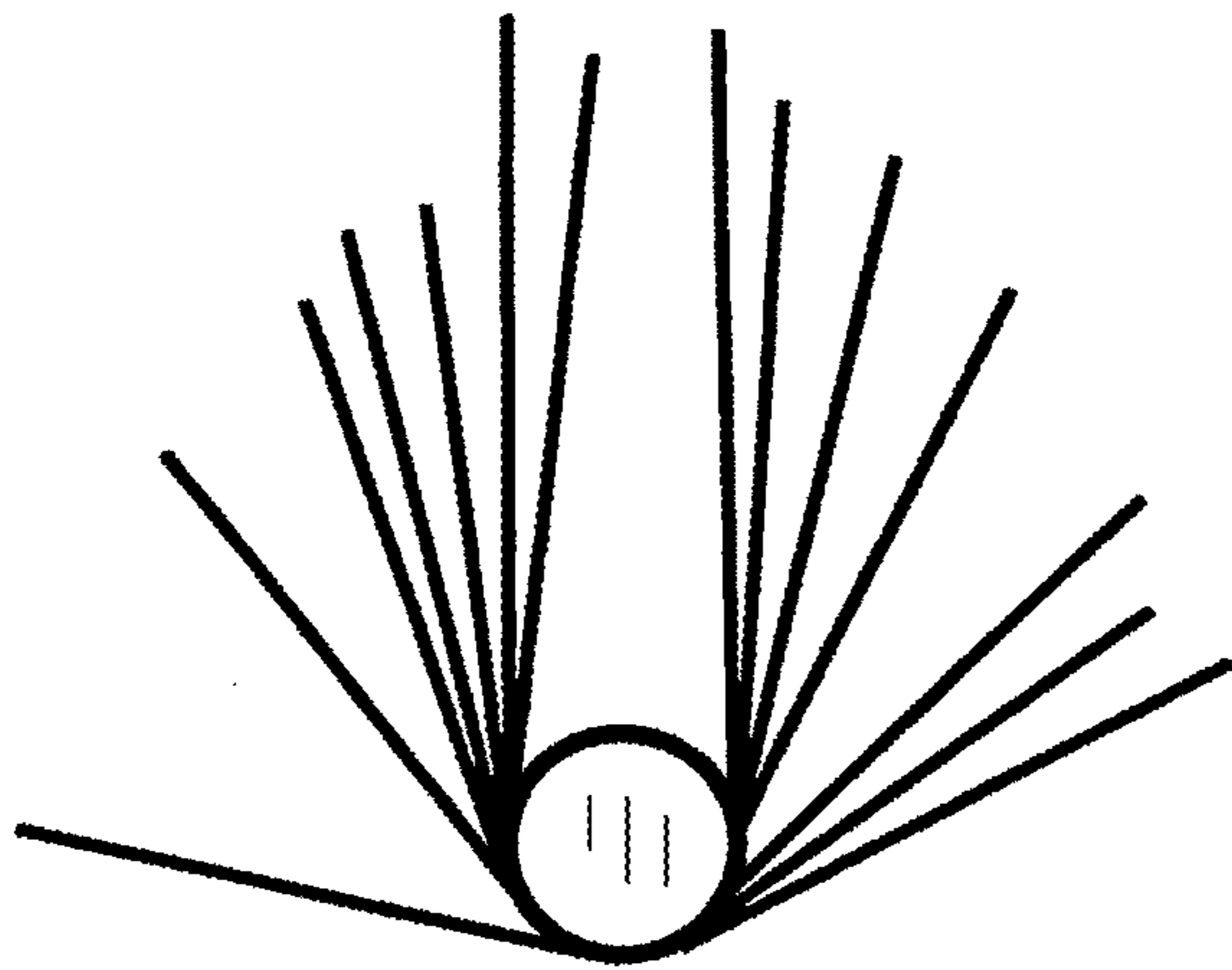

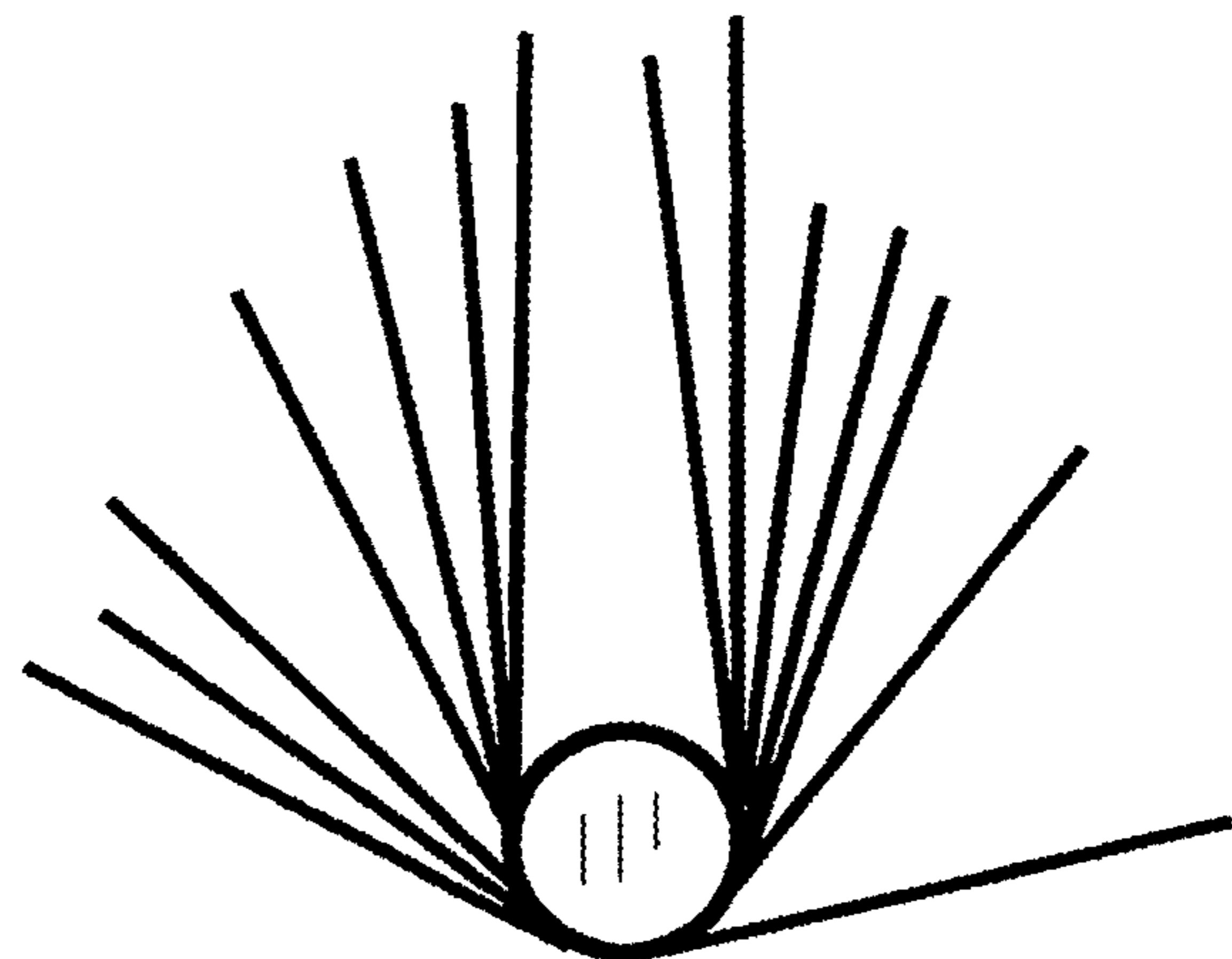

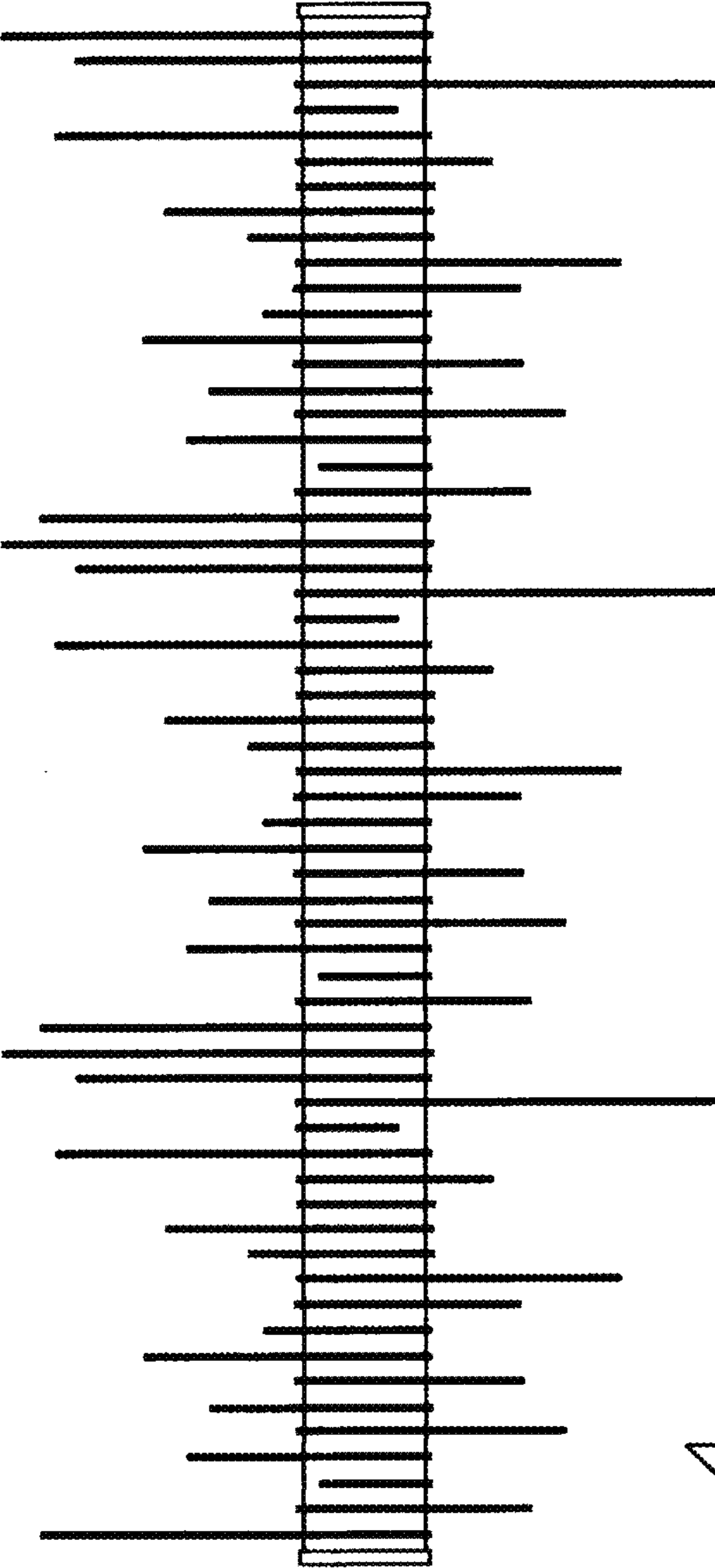

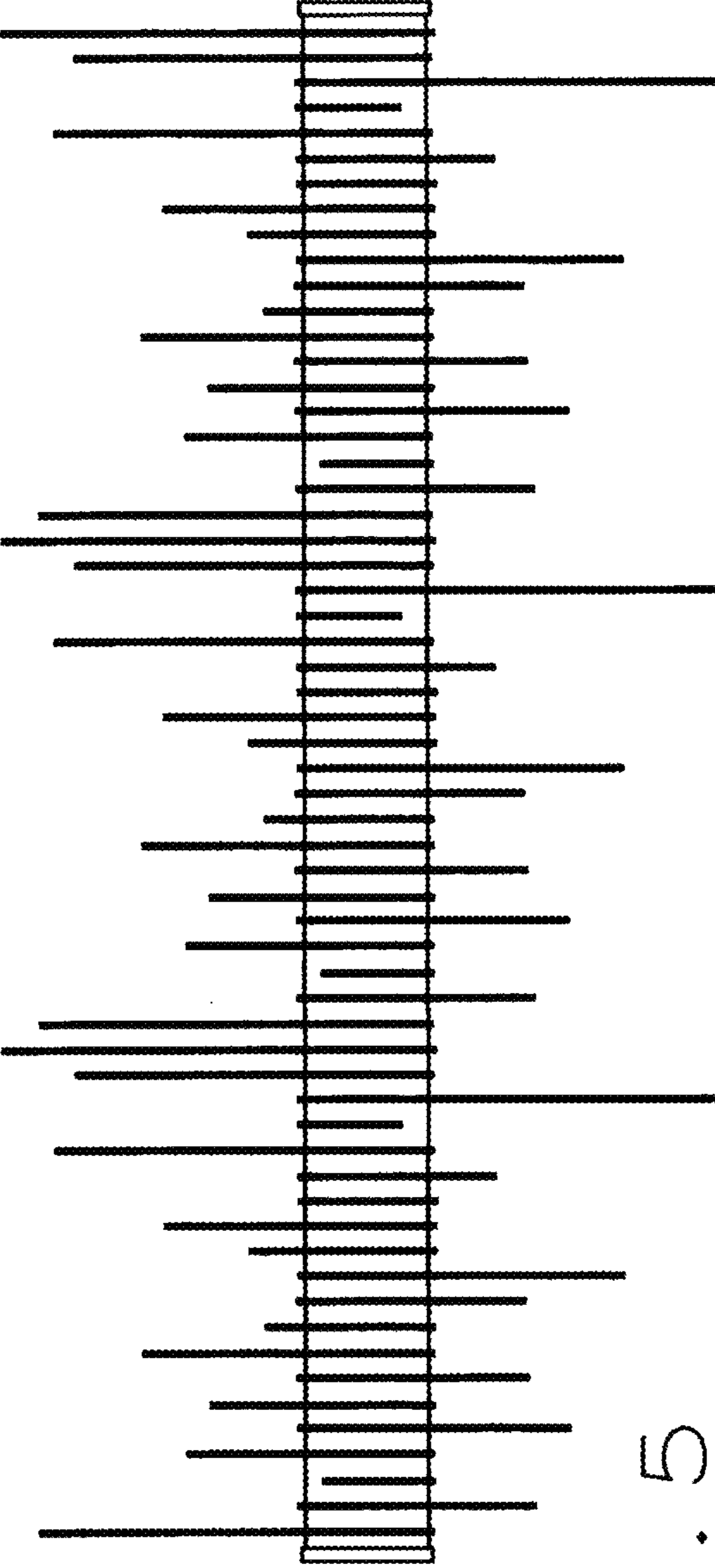

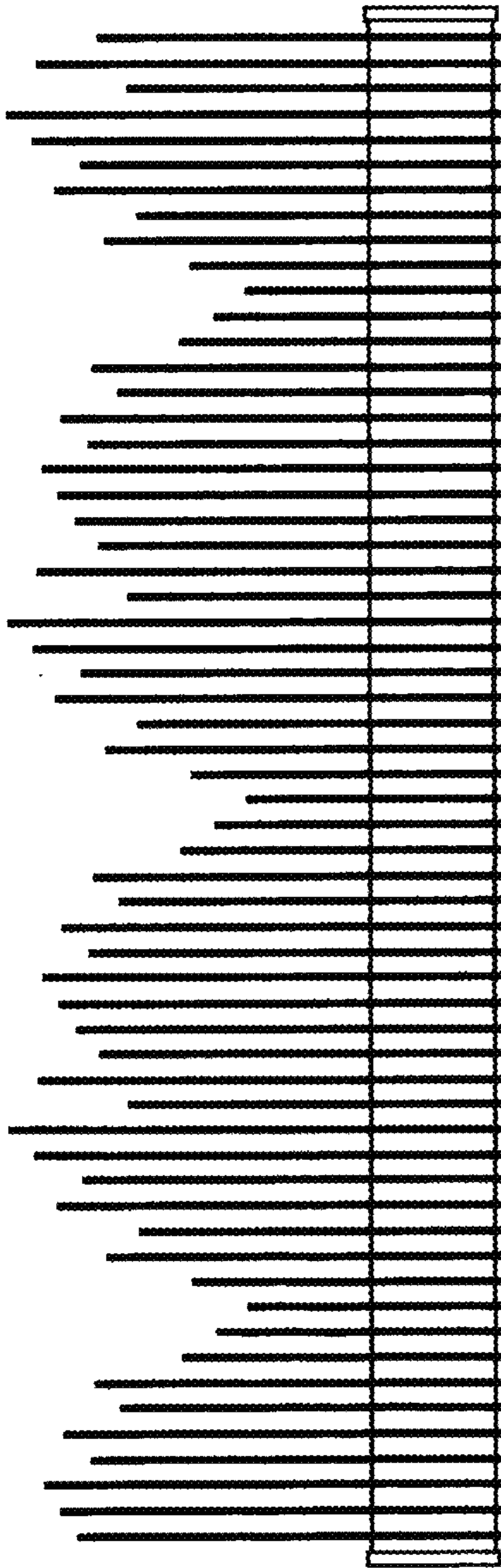

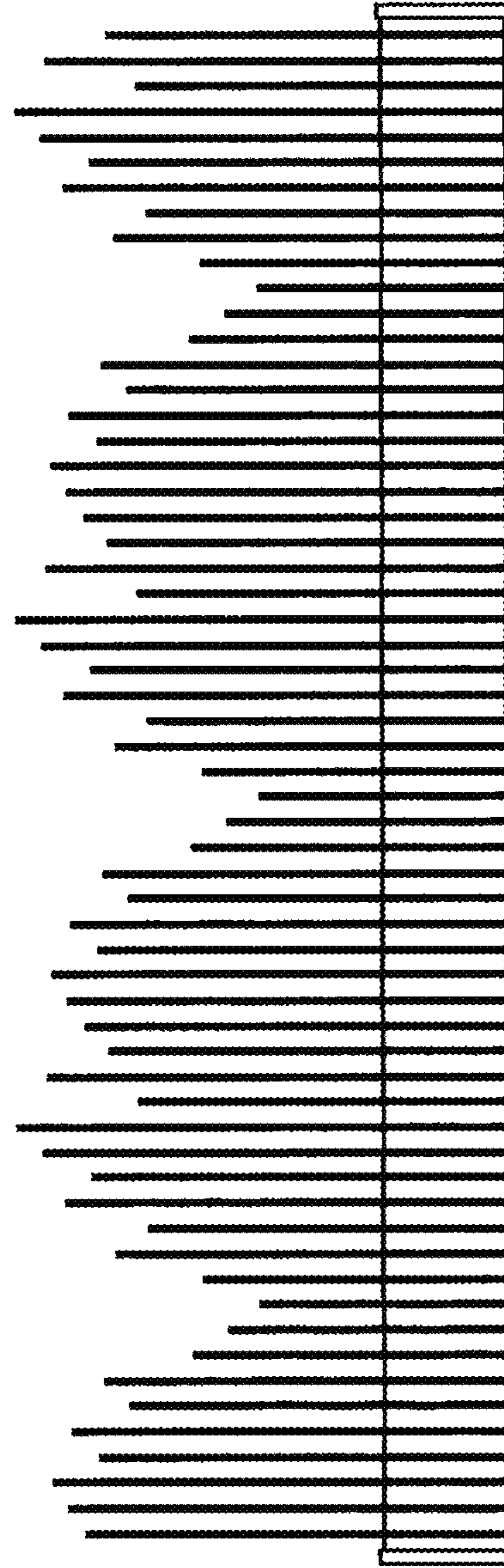

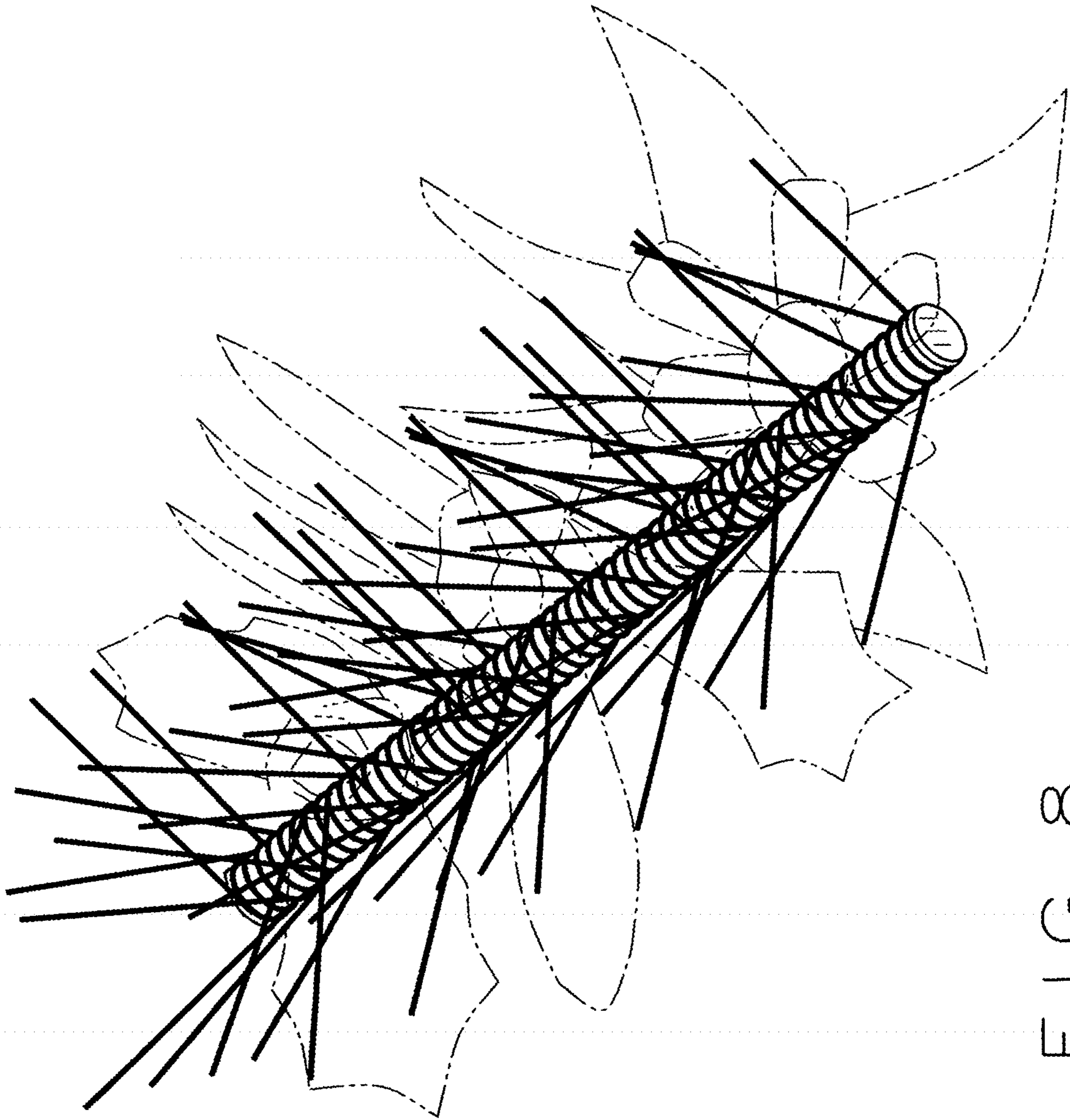
