(57) **CLAIM**

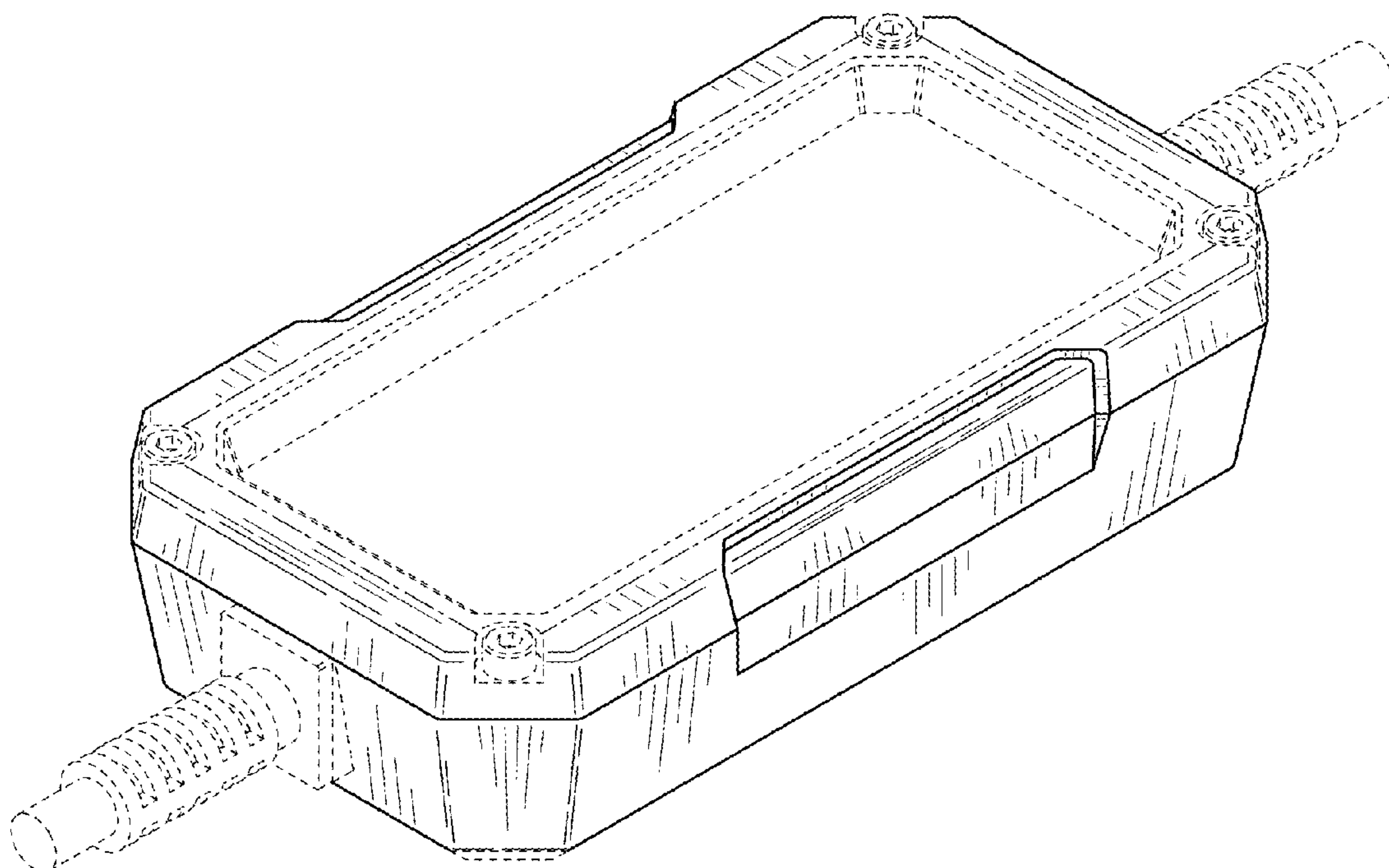
We claim the ornamental design for a work light, as shown
and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of our work light;
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof, the rear view being a mirror
image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof, the right side being a mirror
image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

The dashed lines in the figures represent environmental
structure and form no part of the claimed design. The long
dash-short dash lines that abut a claimed surface represent
an unclaimed boundary between claimed and unclaimed
surfaces and form no part of the claimed design. All other

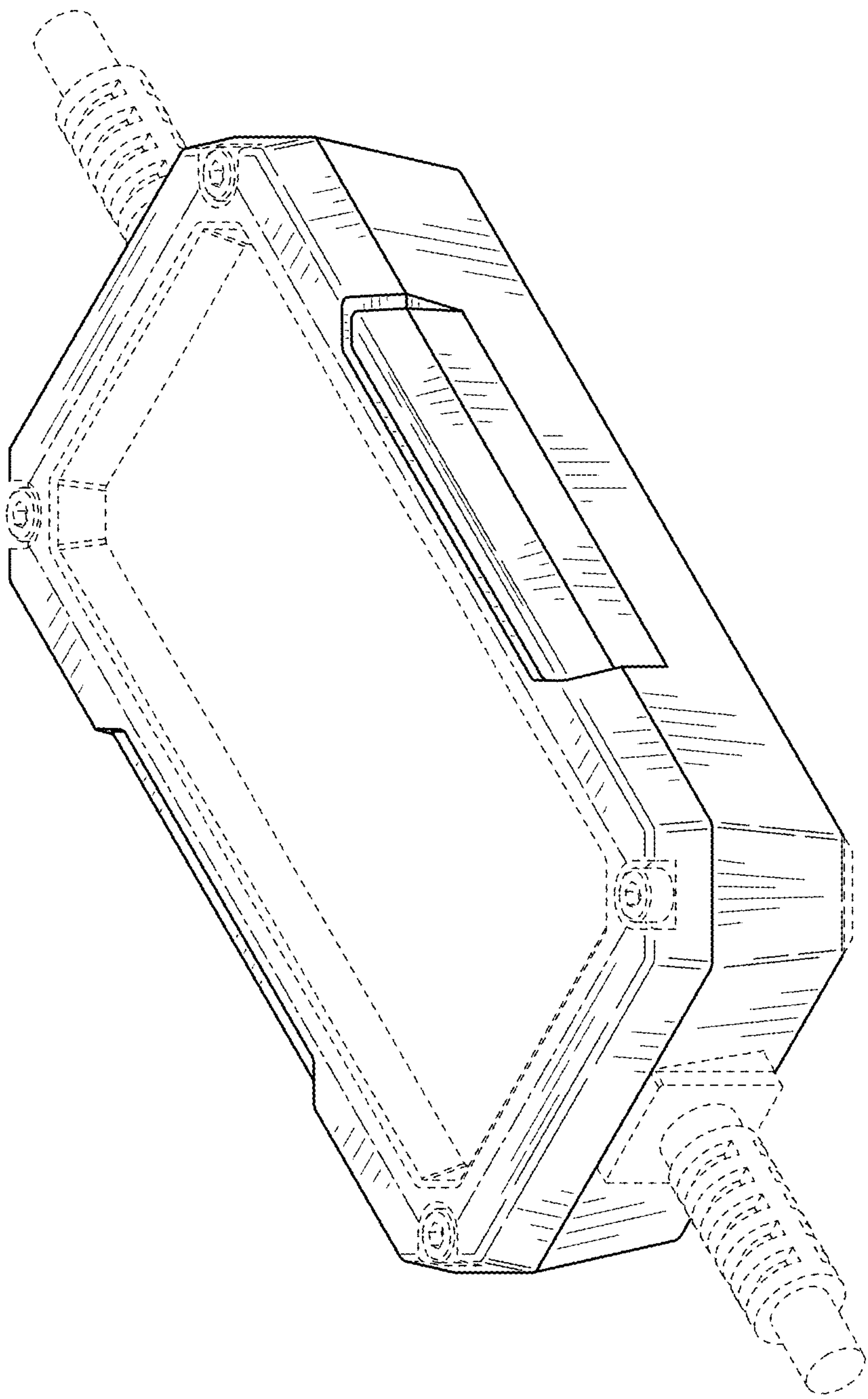

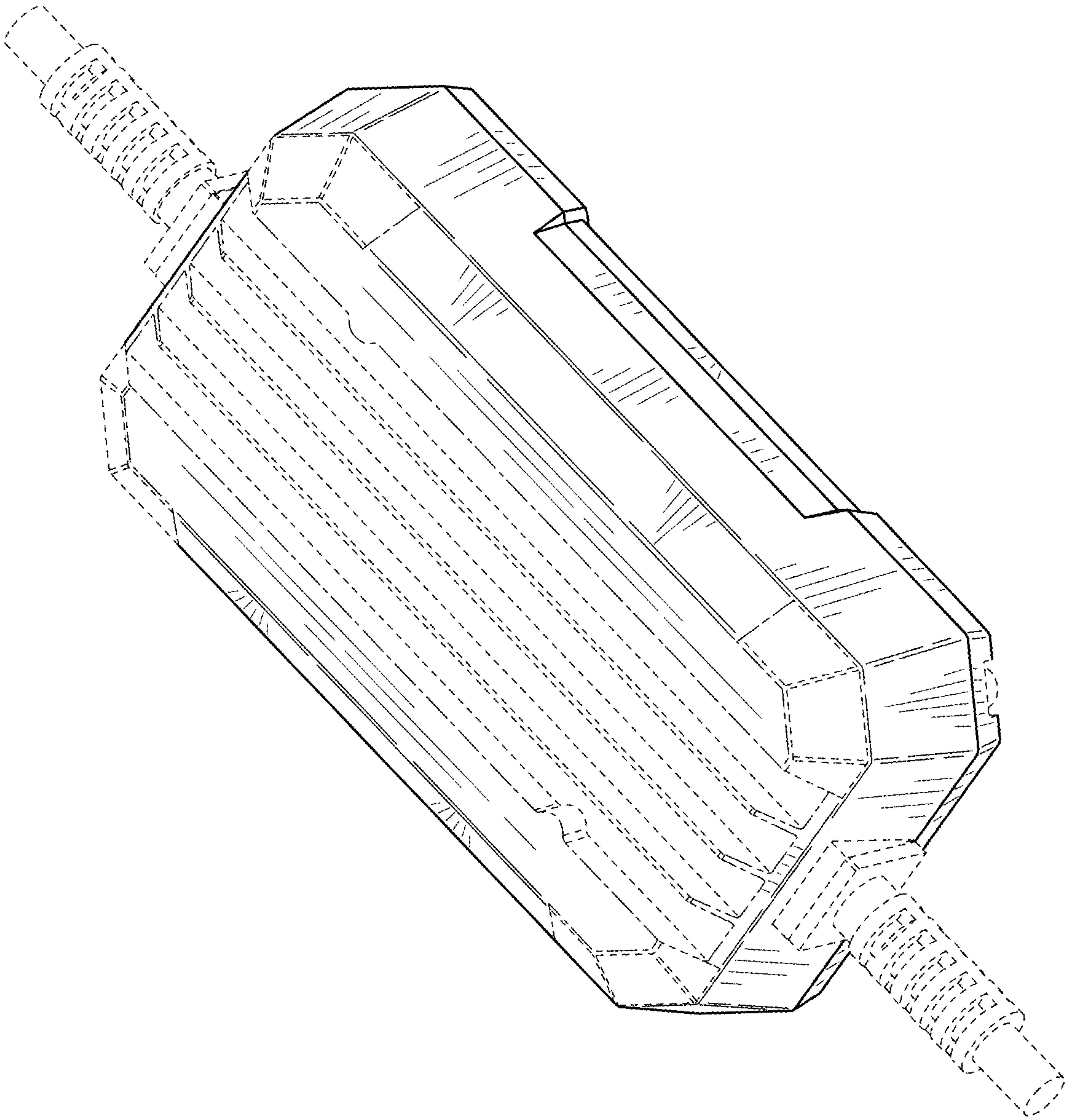

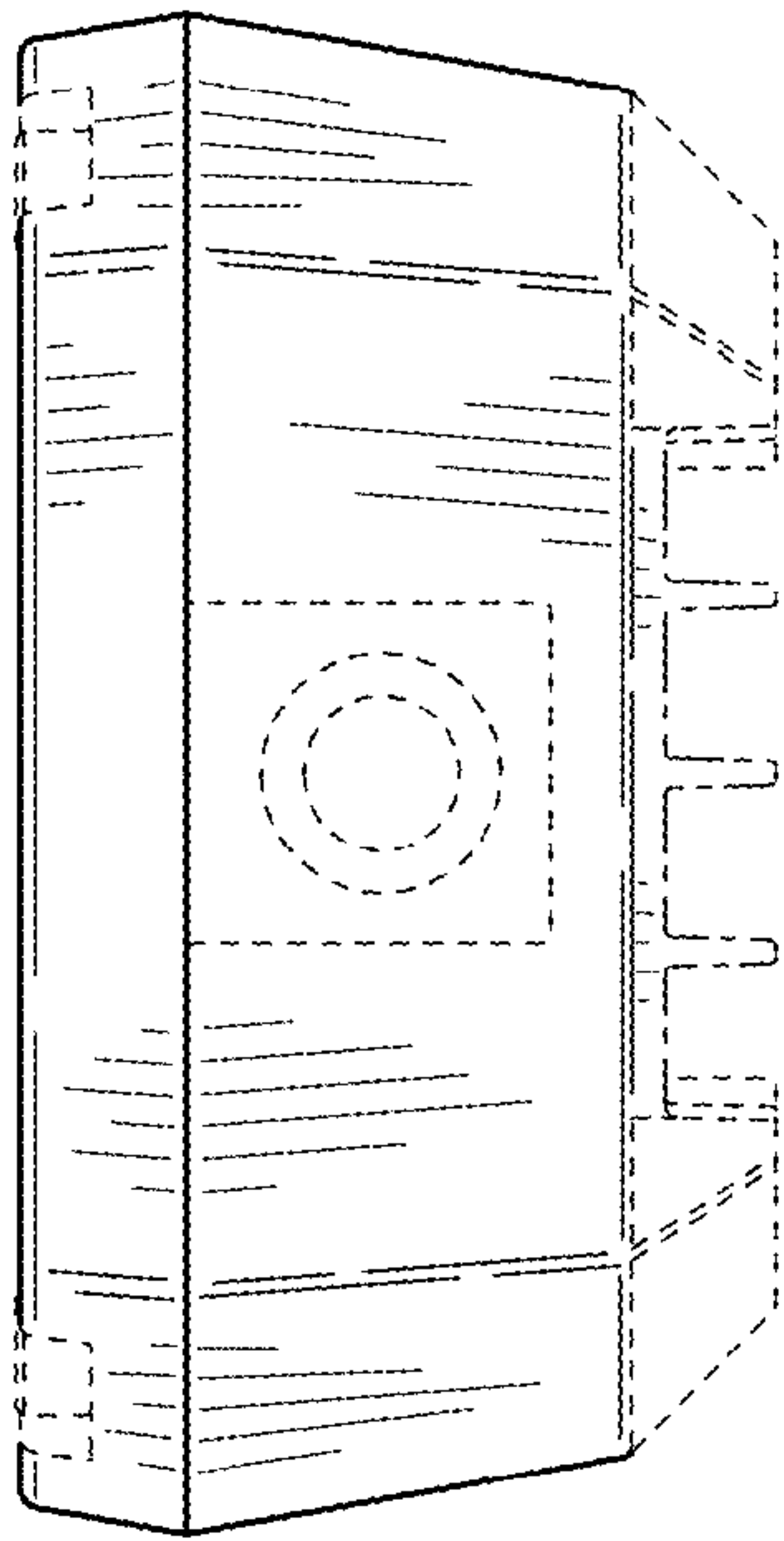

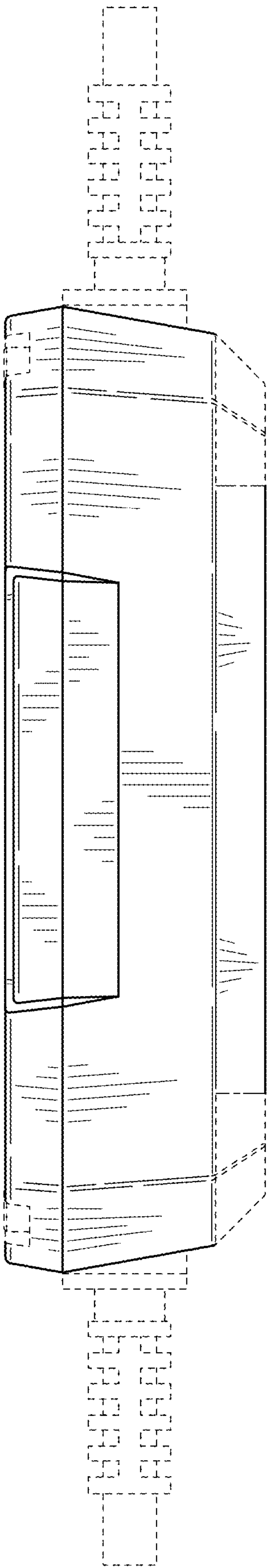

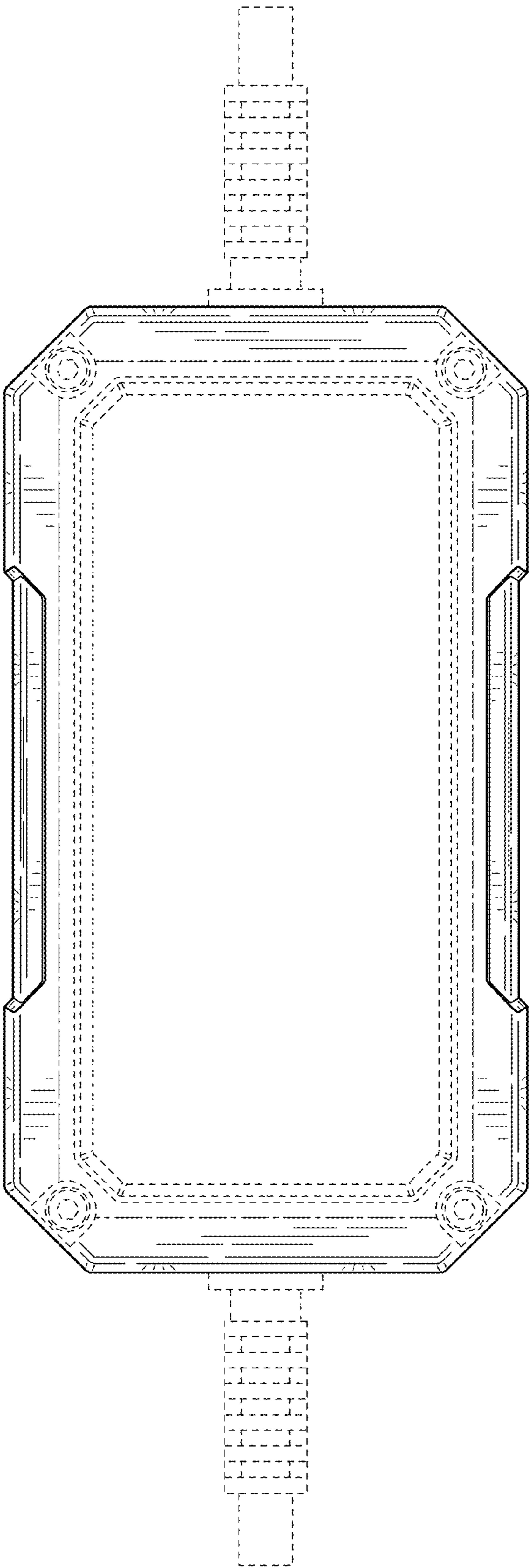

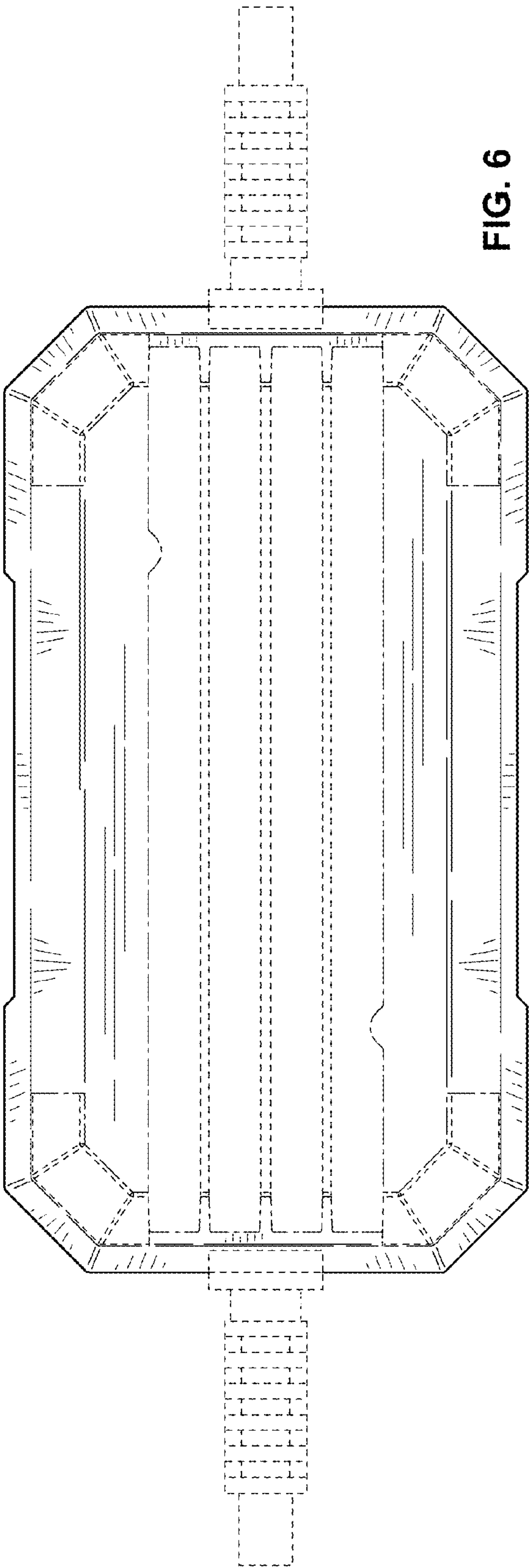
