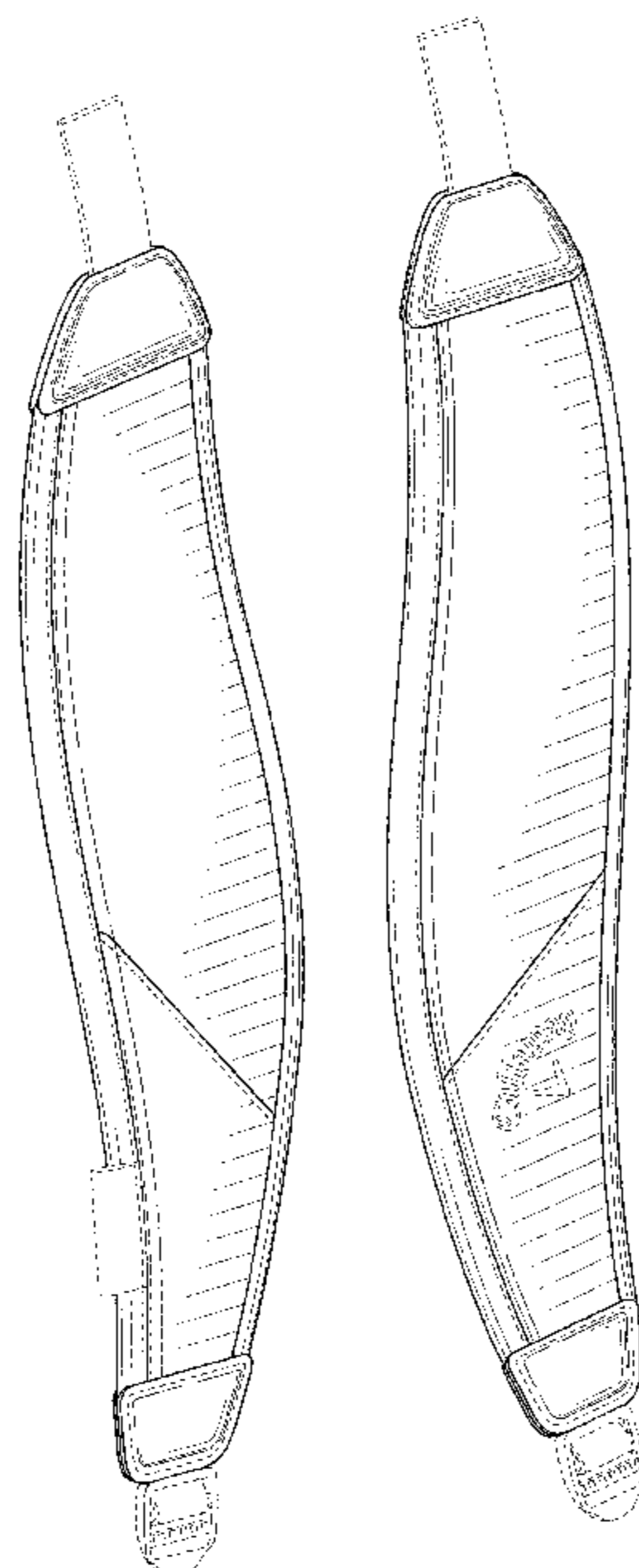
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pair of bag straps, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a pair of bag straps claimed herein;
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;

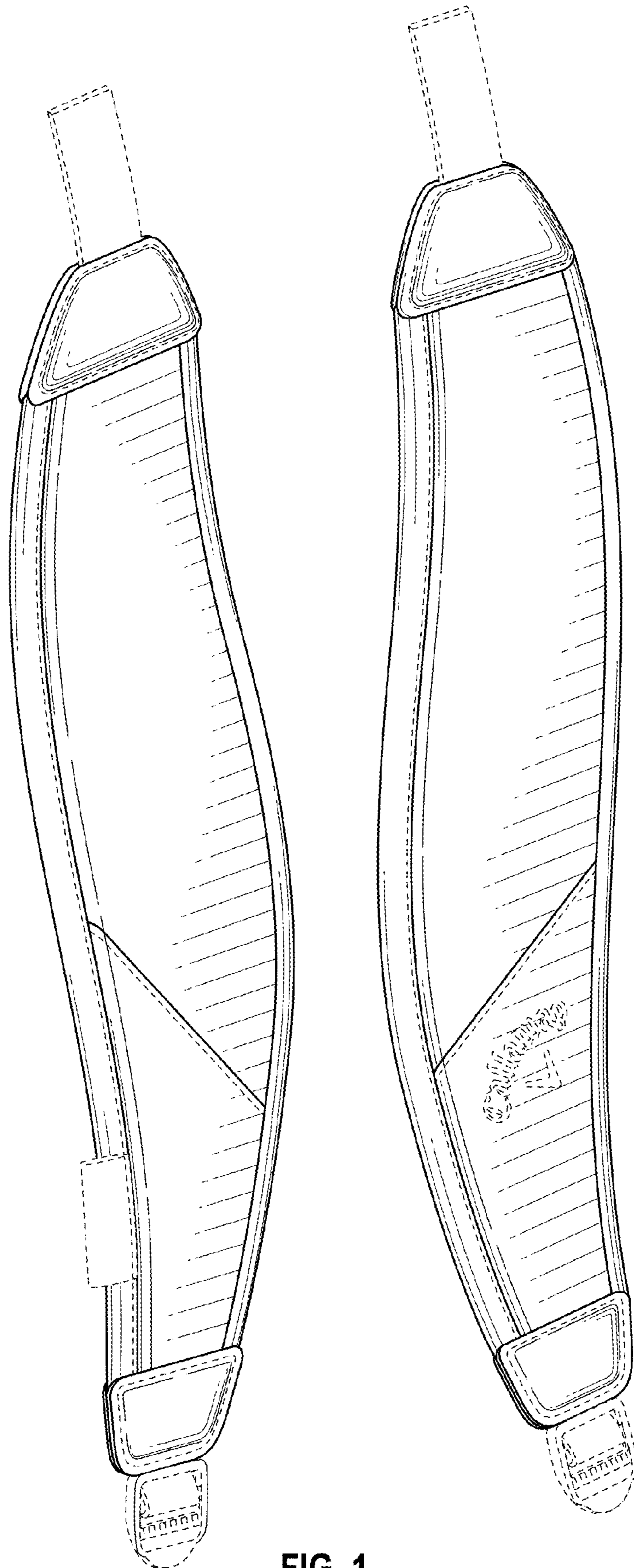

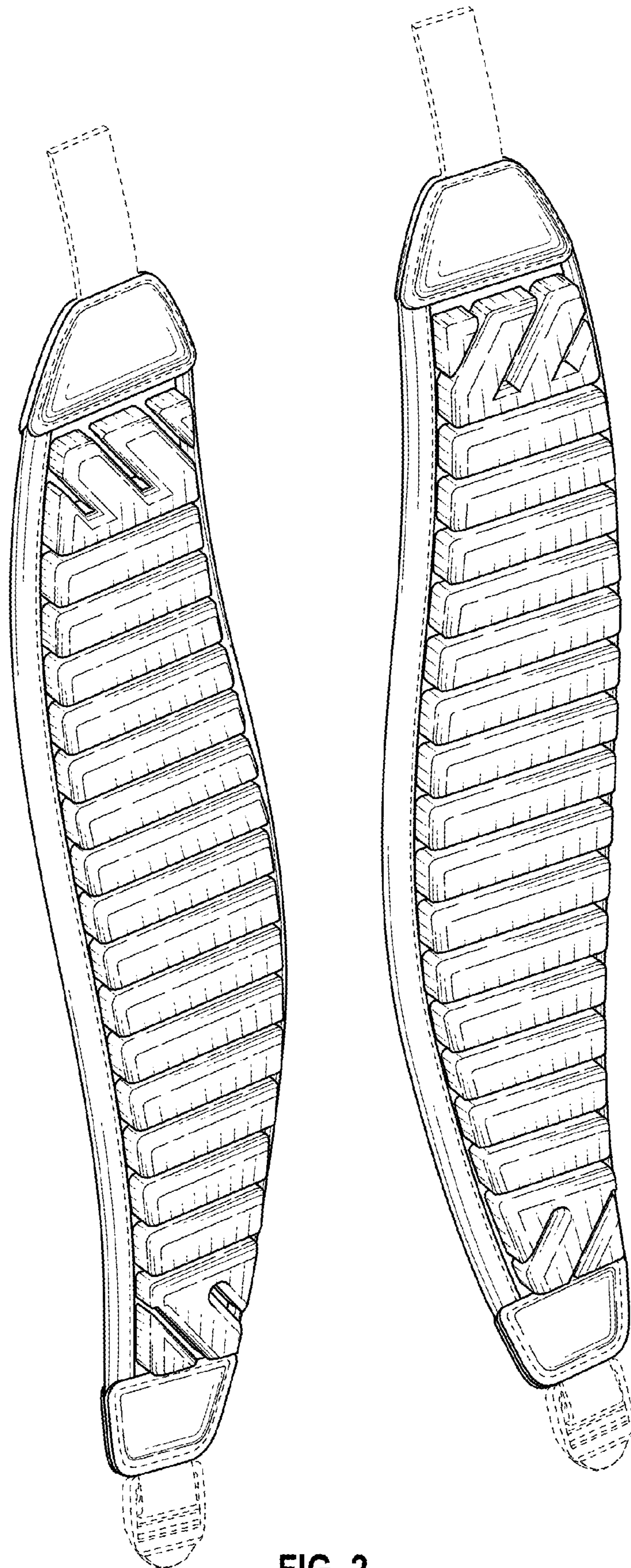

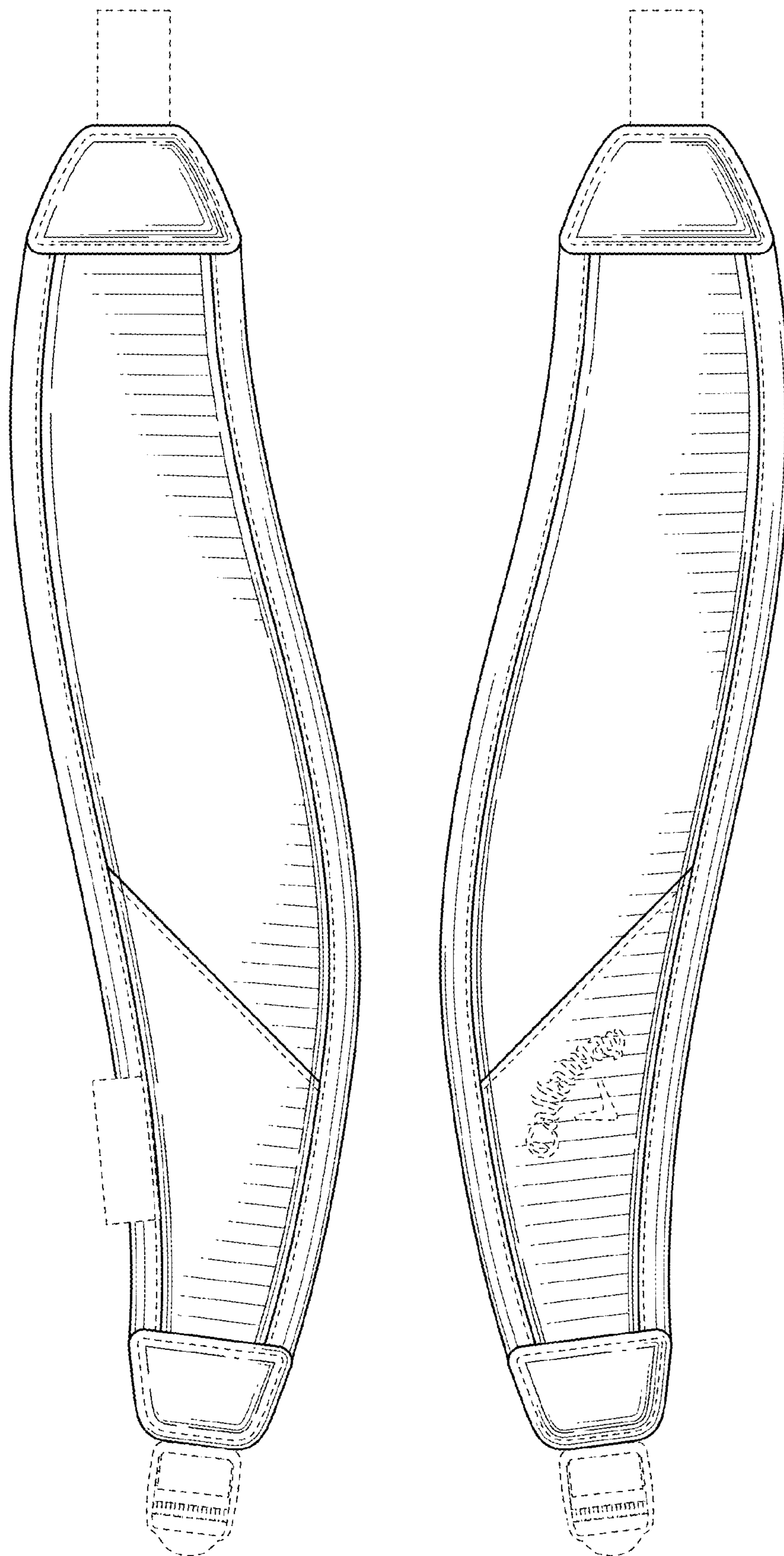

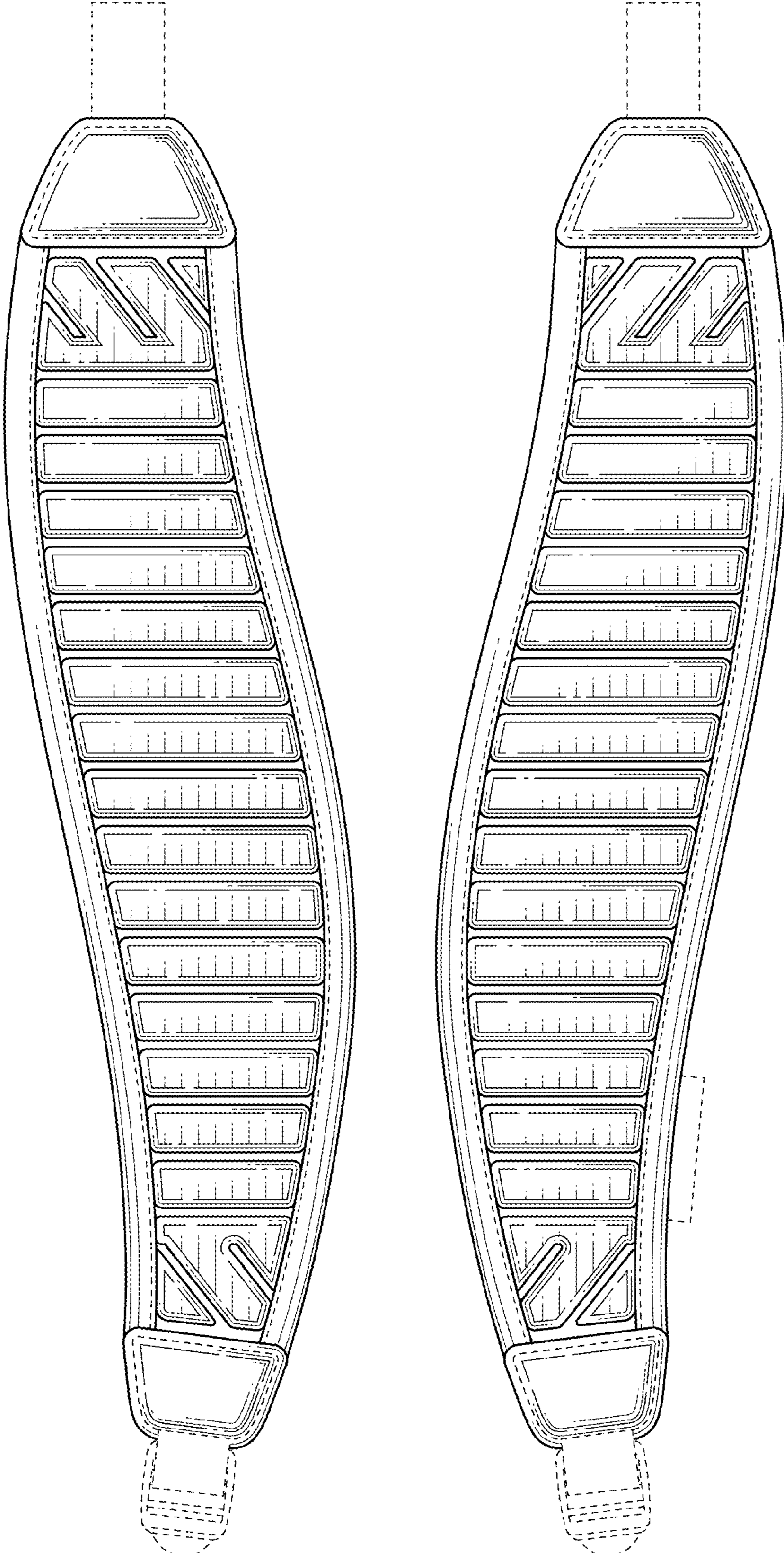

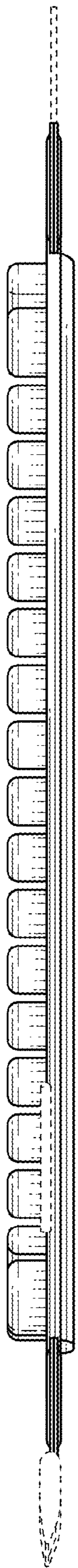

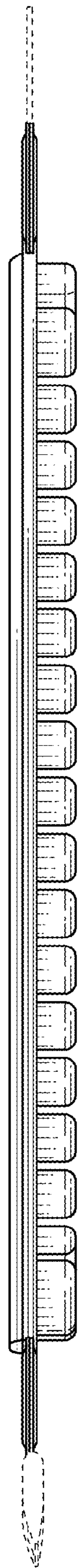
