of FIG. 7;

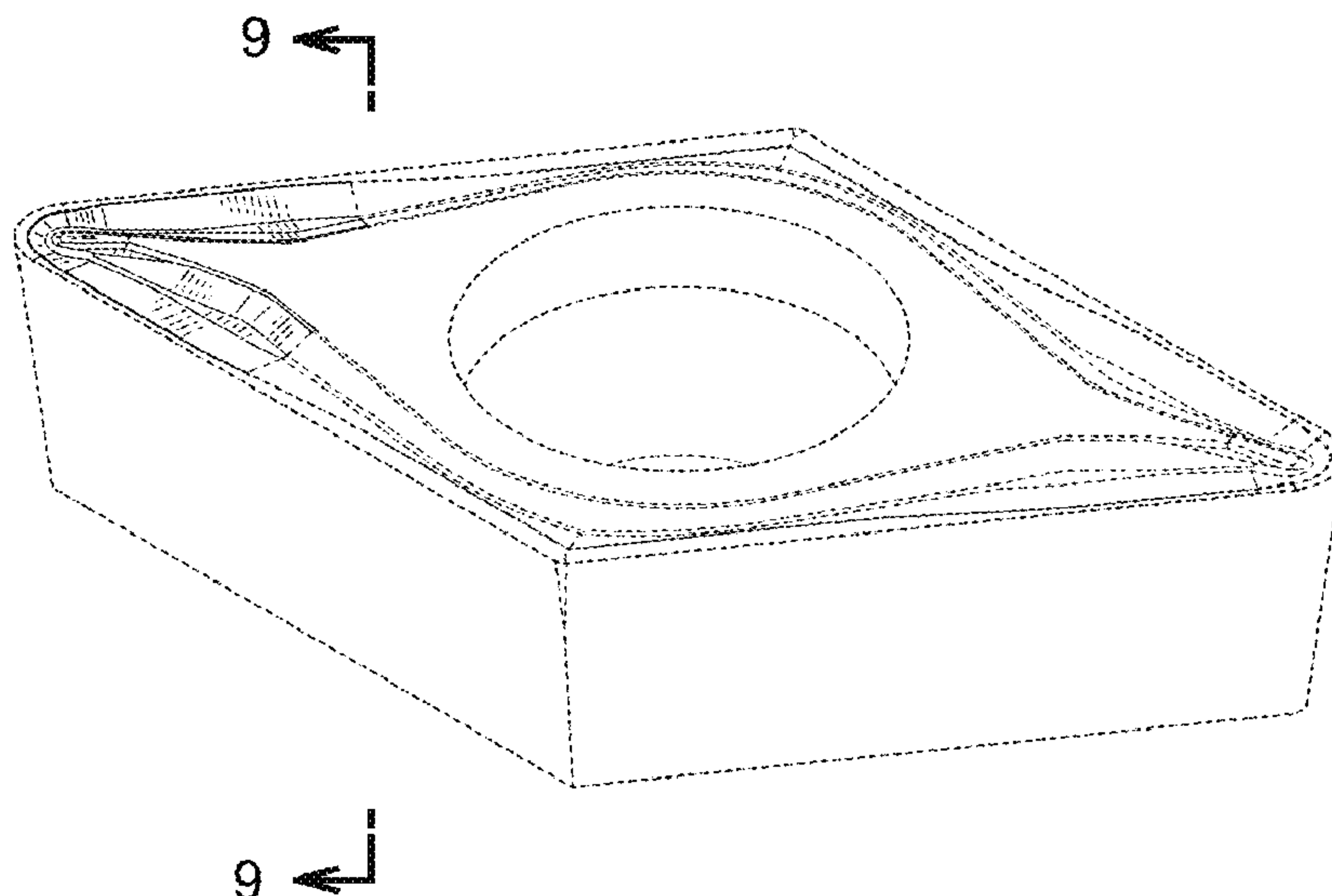
FIG. 10 is a cross sectional view taken along line 10-10 of

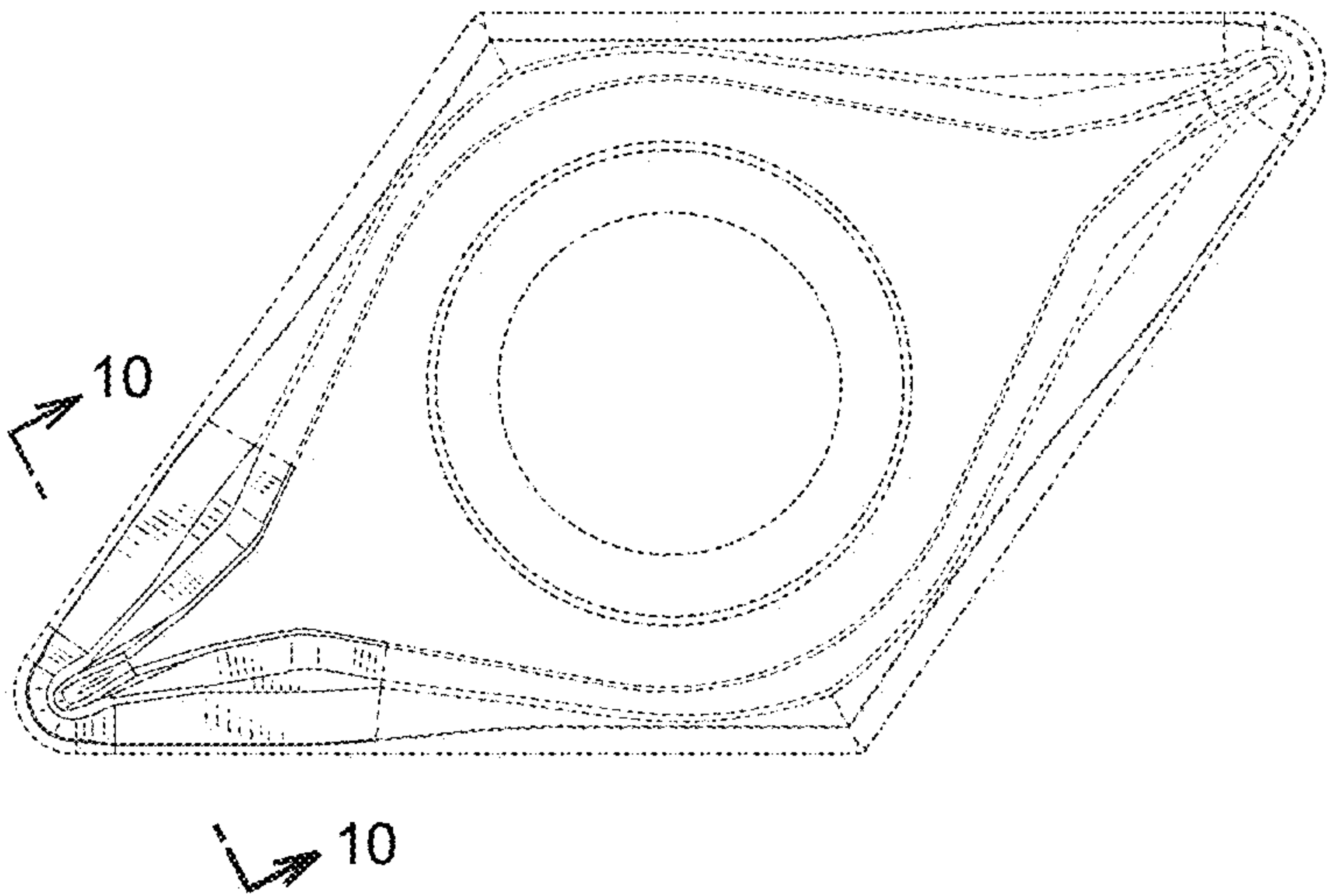

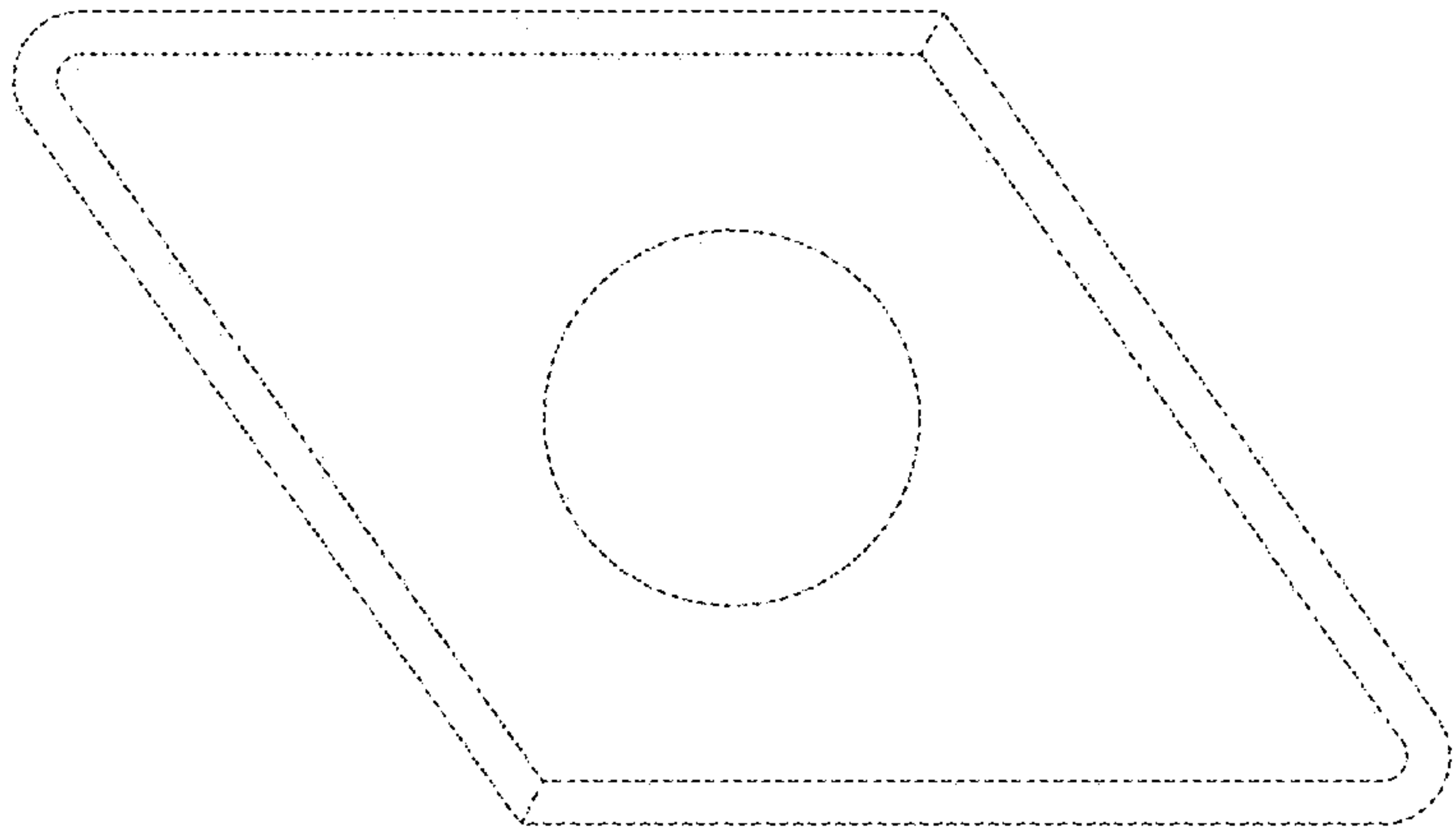

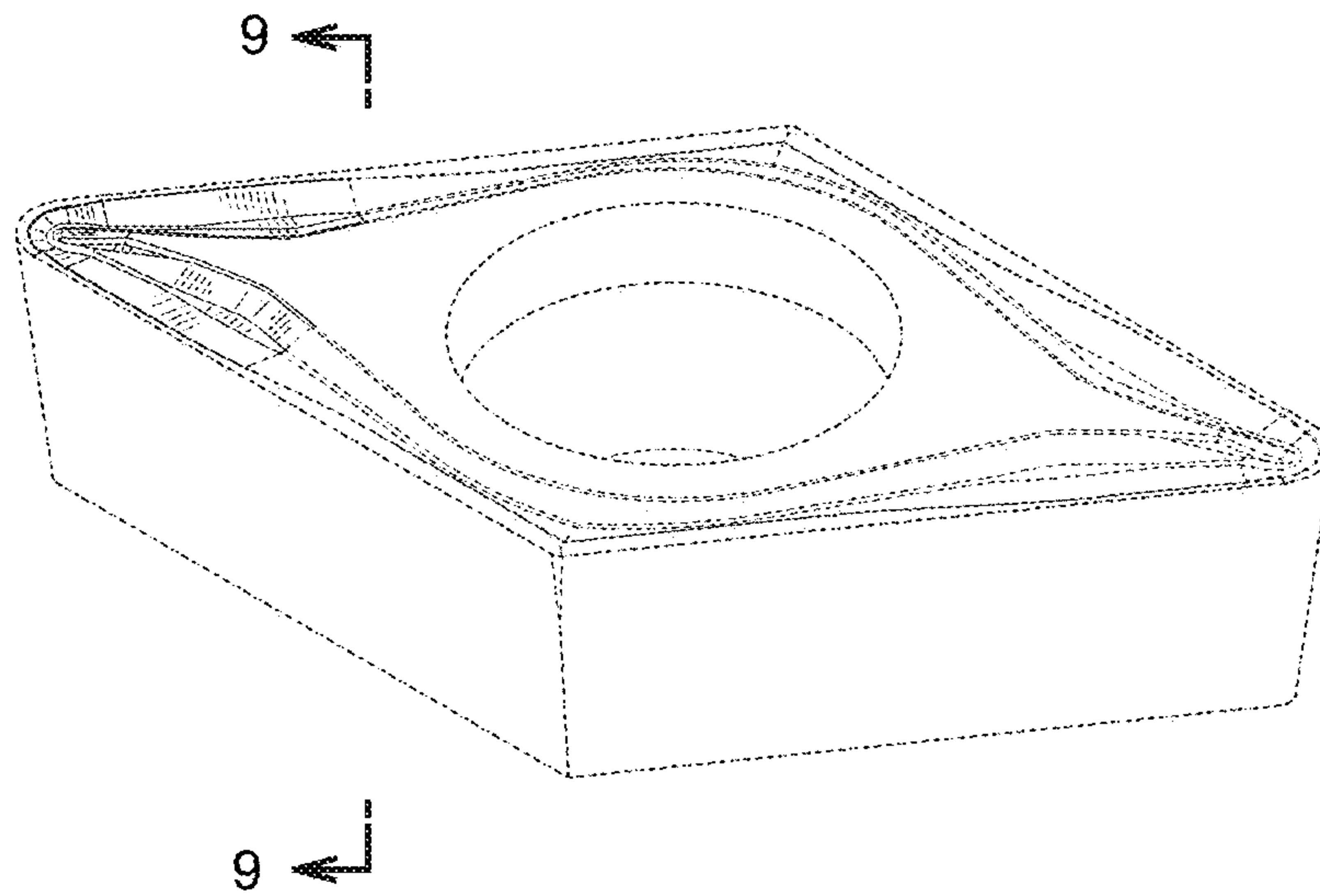

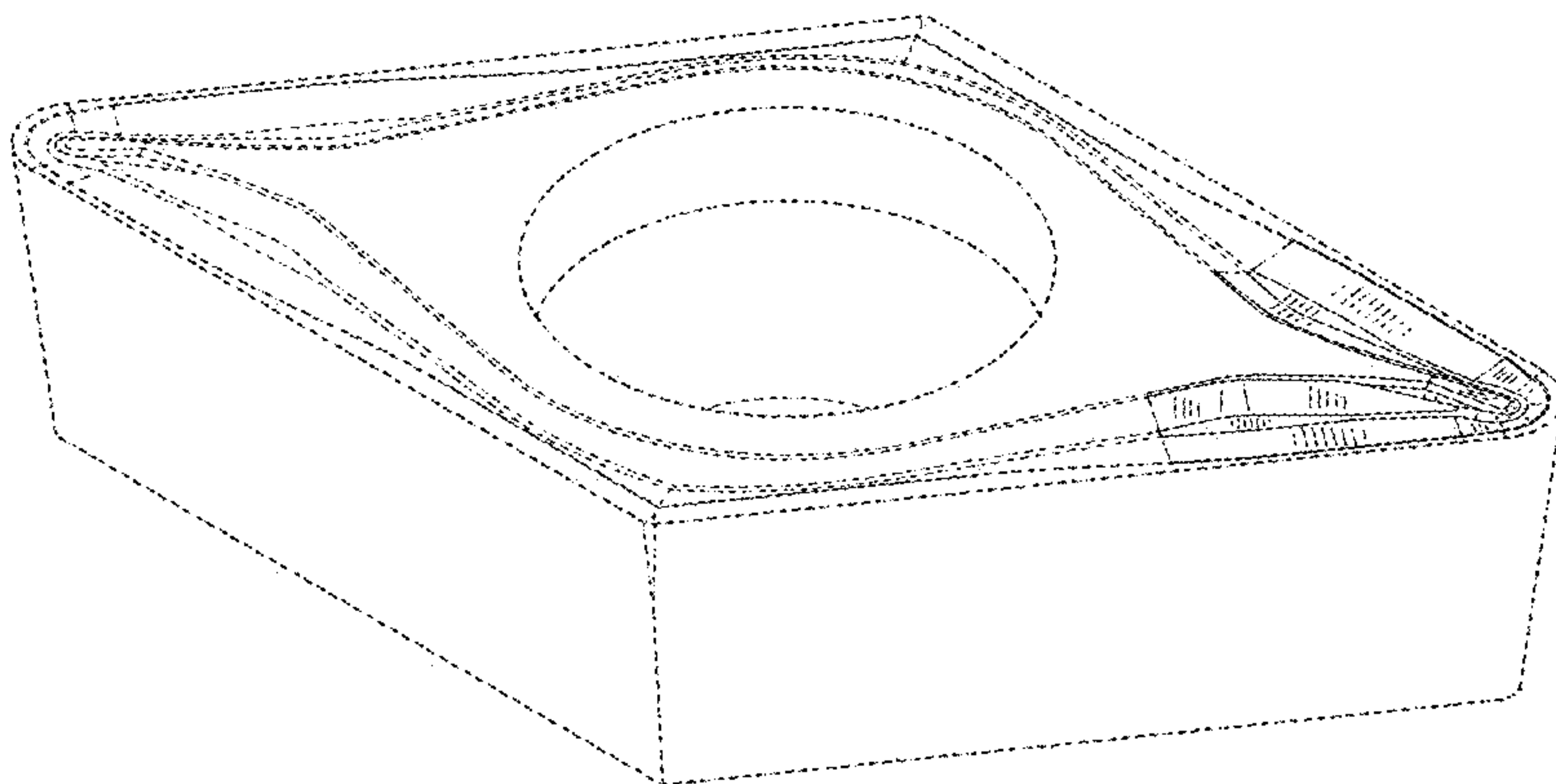

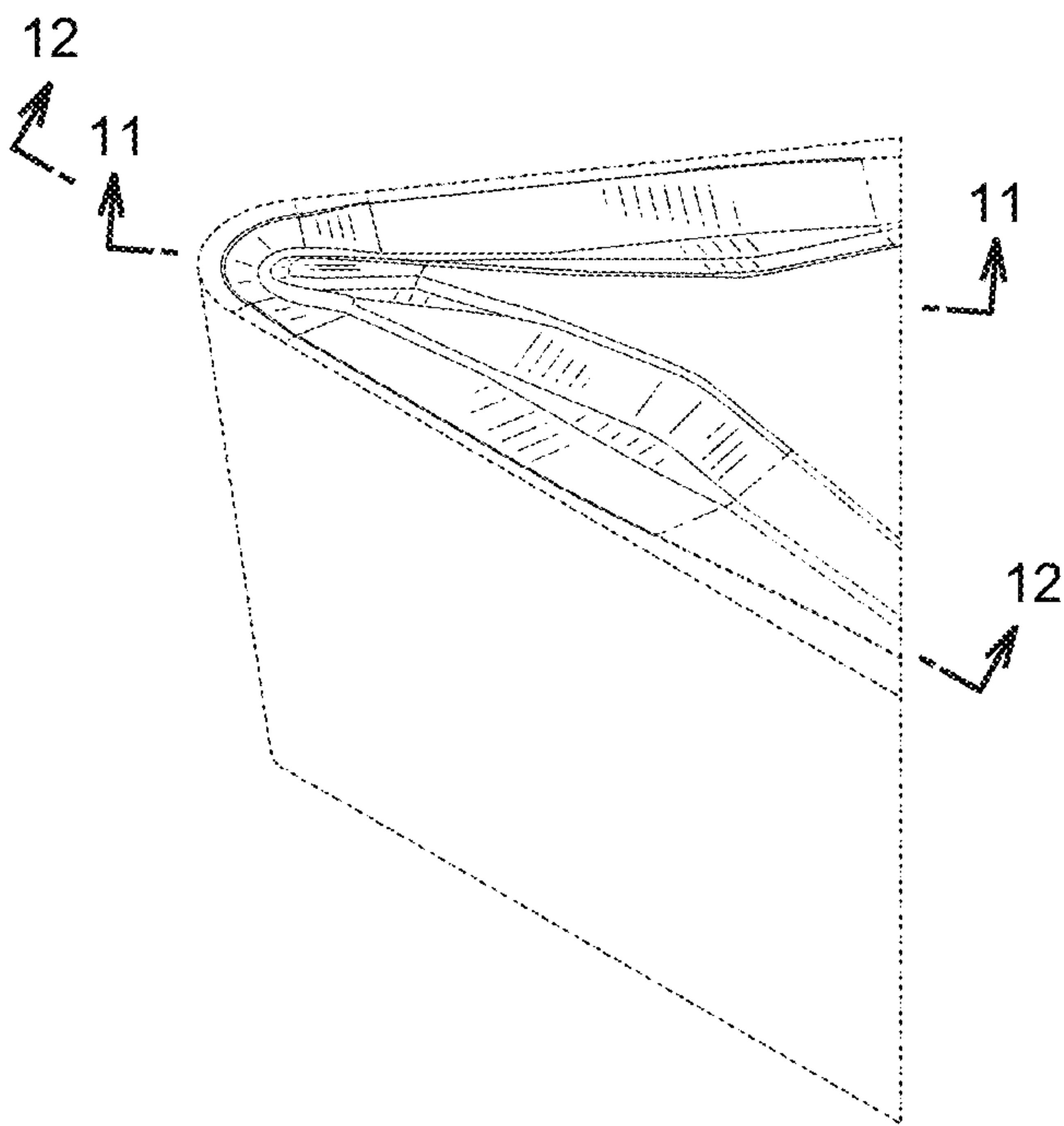

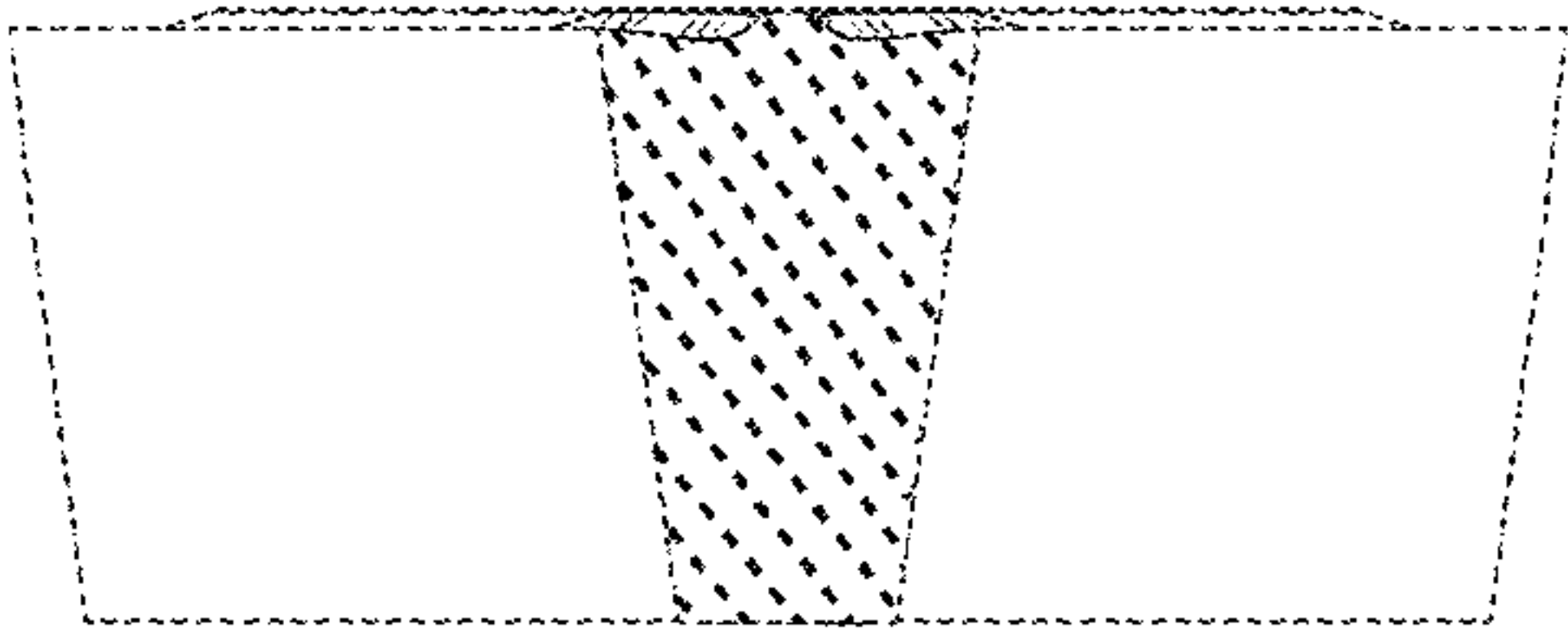

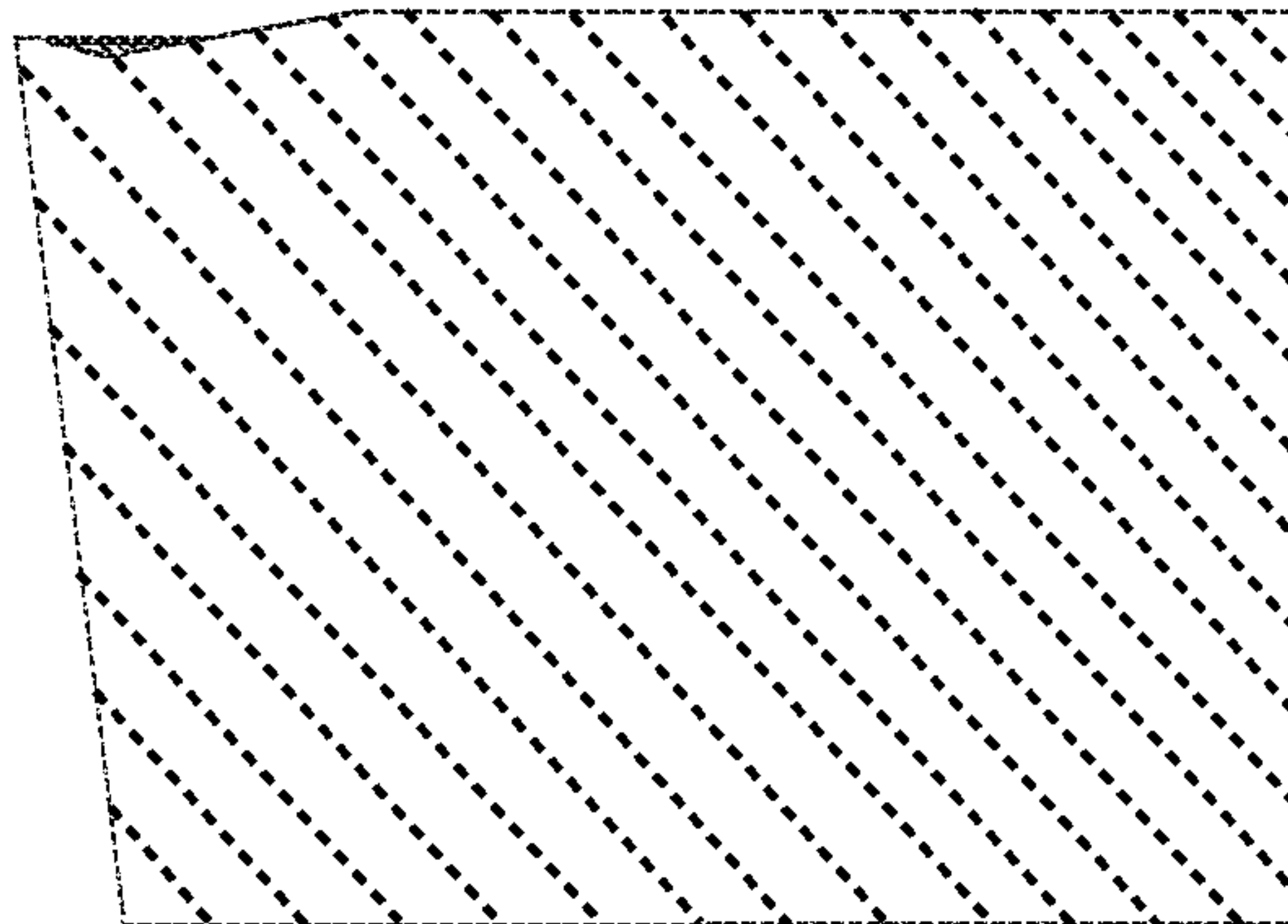
