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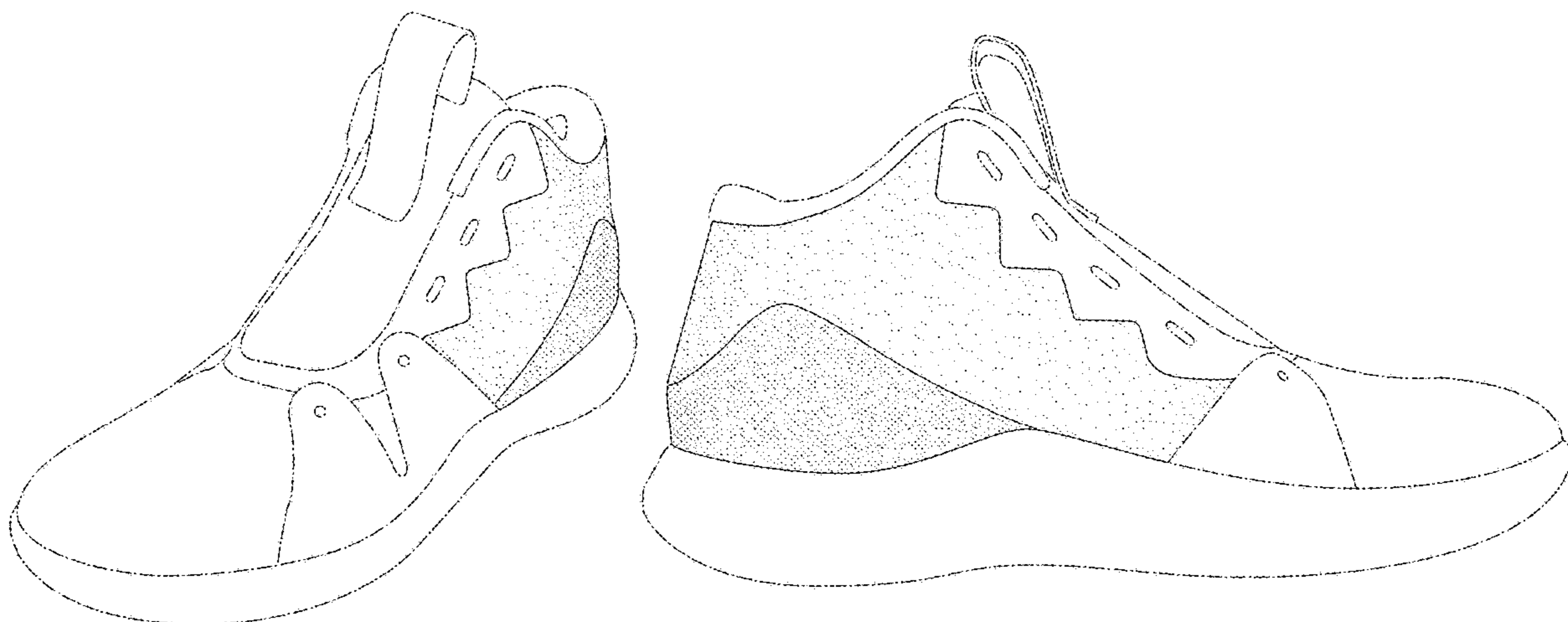
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an opposite rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 6 is an opposite side view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is an opposite front perspective view thereof.
The contrast in shading between the two regions represents a contrast in appearance only and does not represent any particular color, material, texture or finish. The broken line bisecting the shaded area represents a feature that forms no part of the claimed design. The broken lines immediately adjacent to the shaded area define the bounds of the claimed design and form no part thereof. The broken lines depicting the remainder of the shoe show features that form no part of the claimed design.

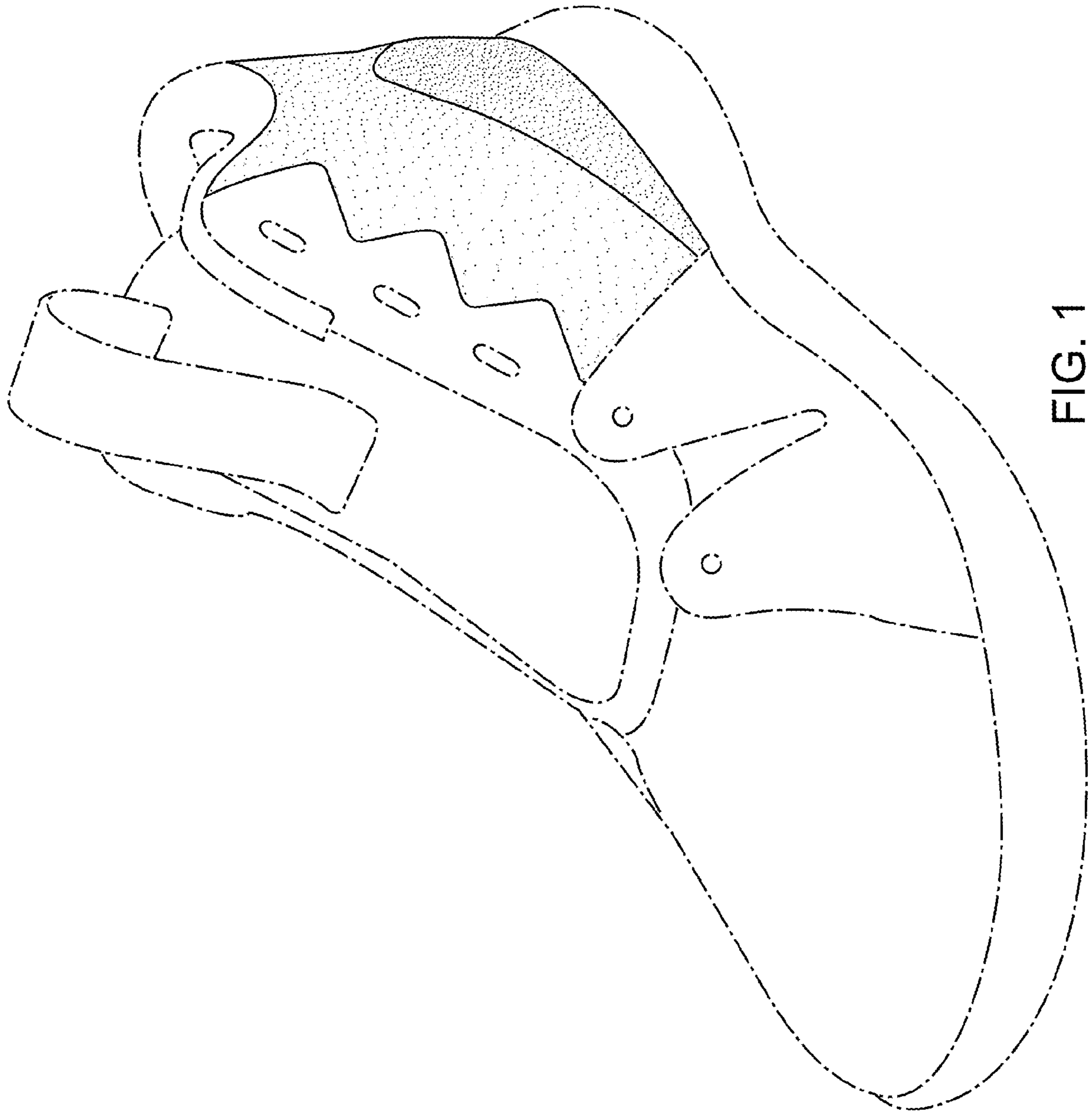

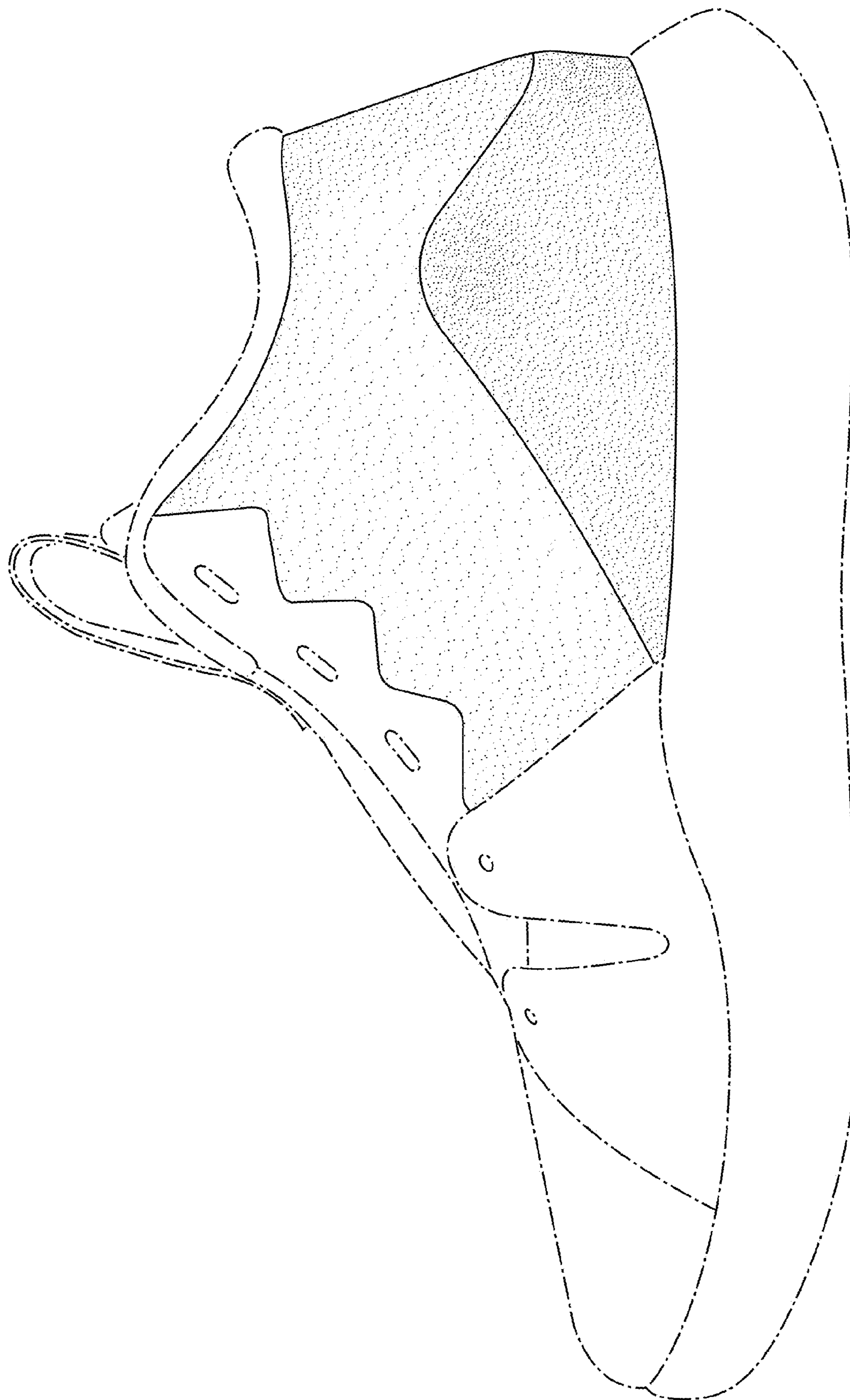

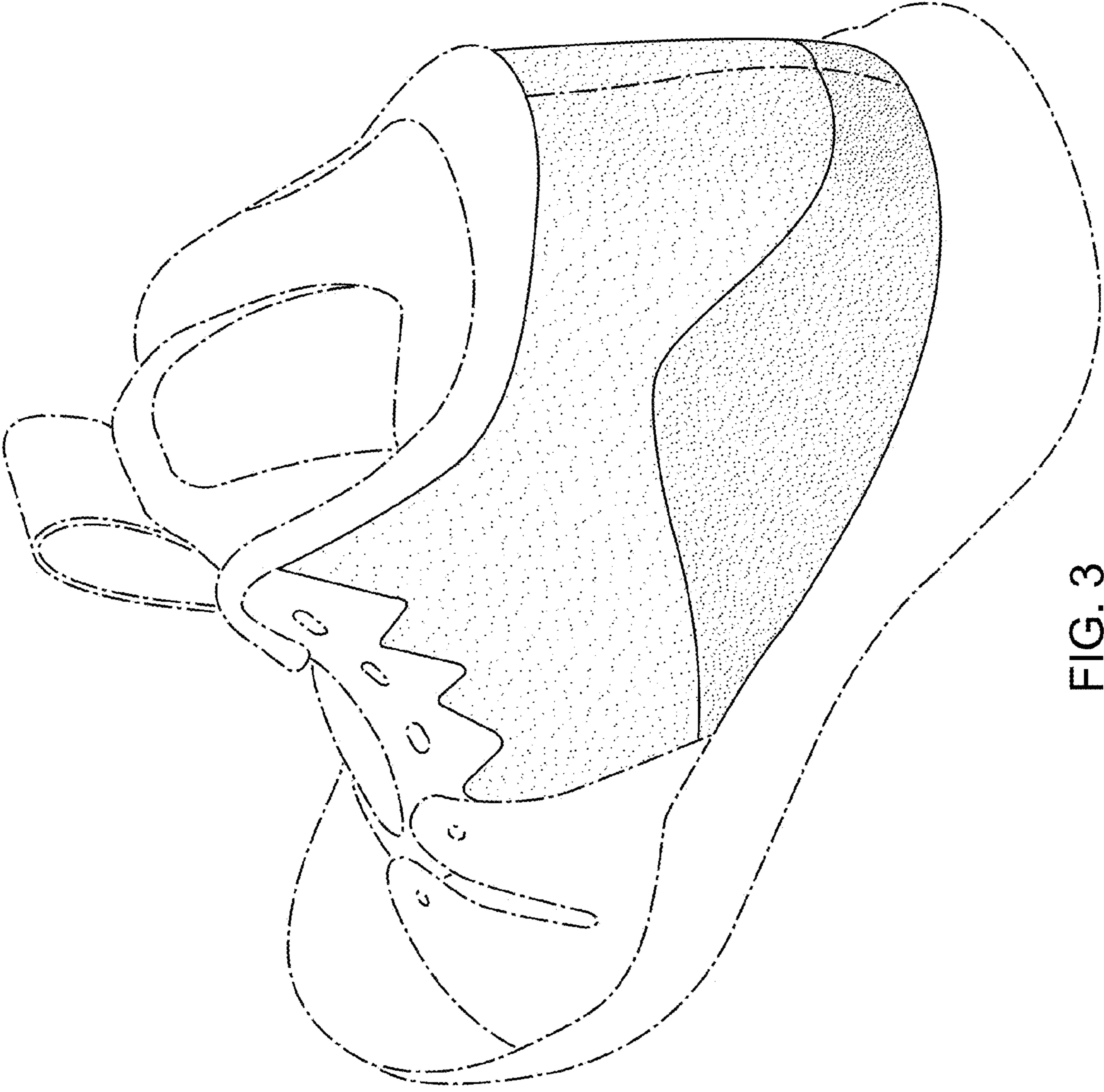

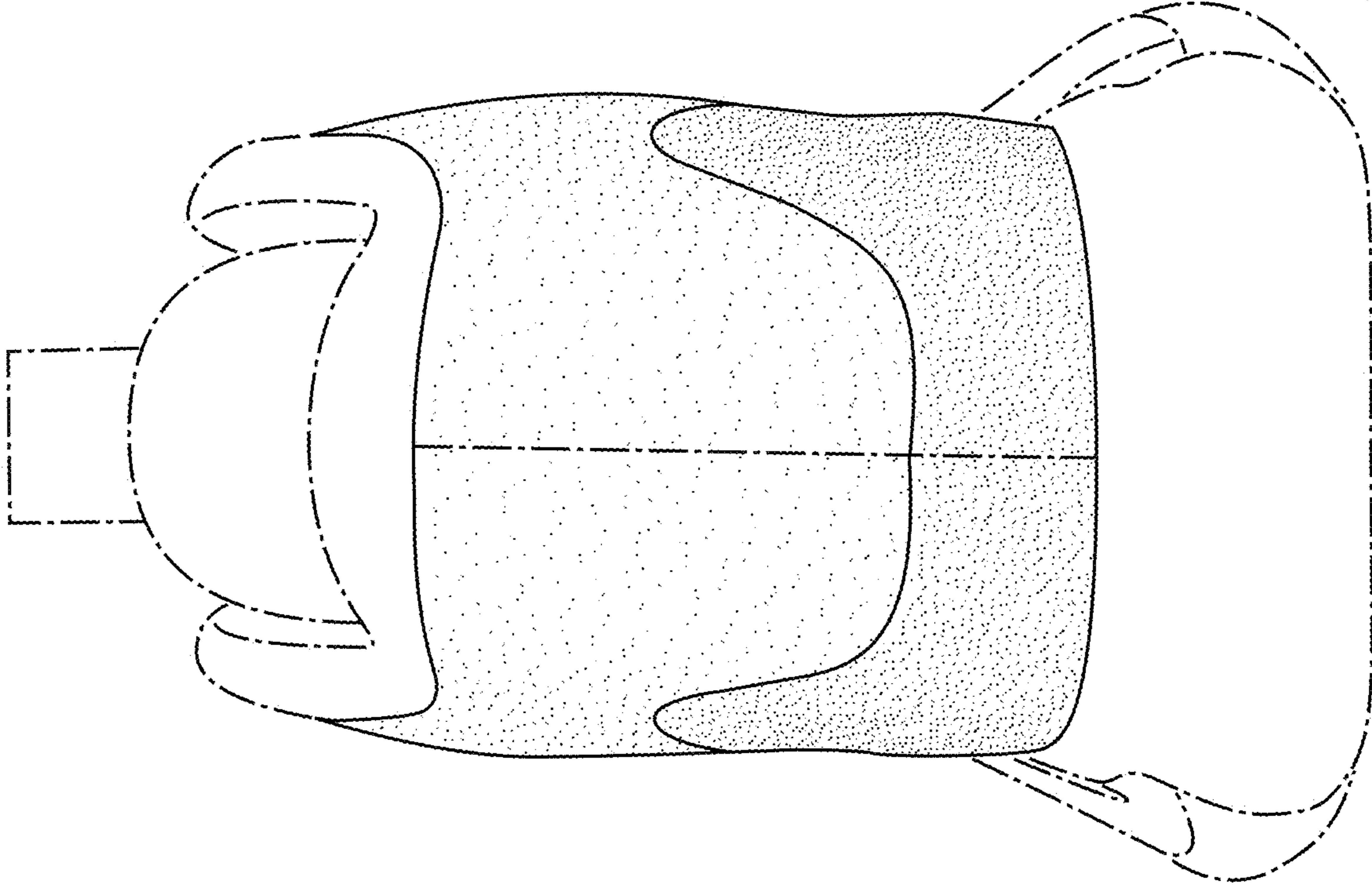

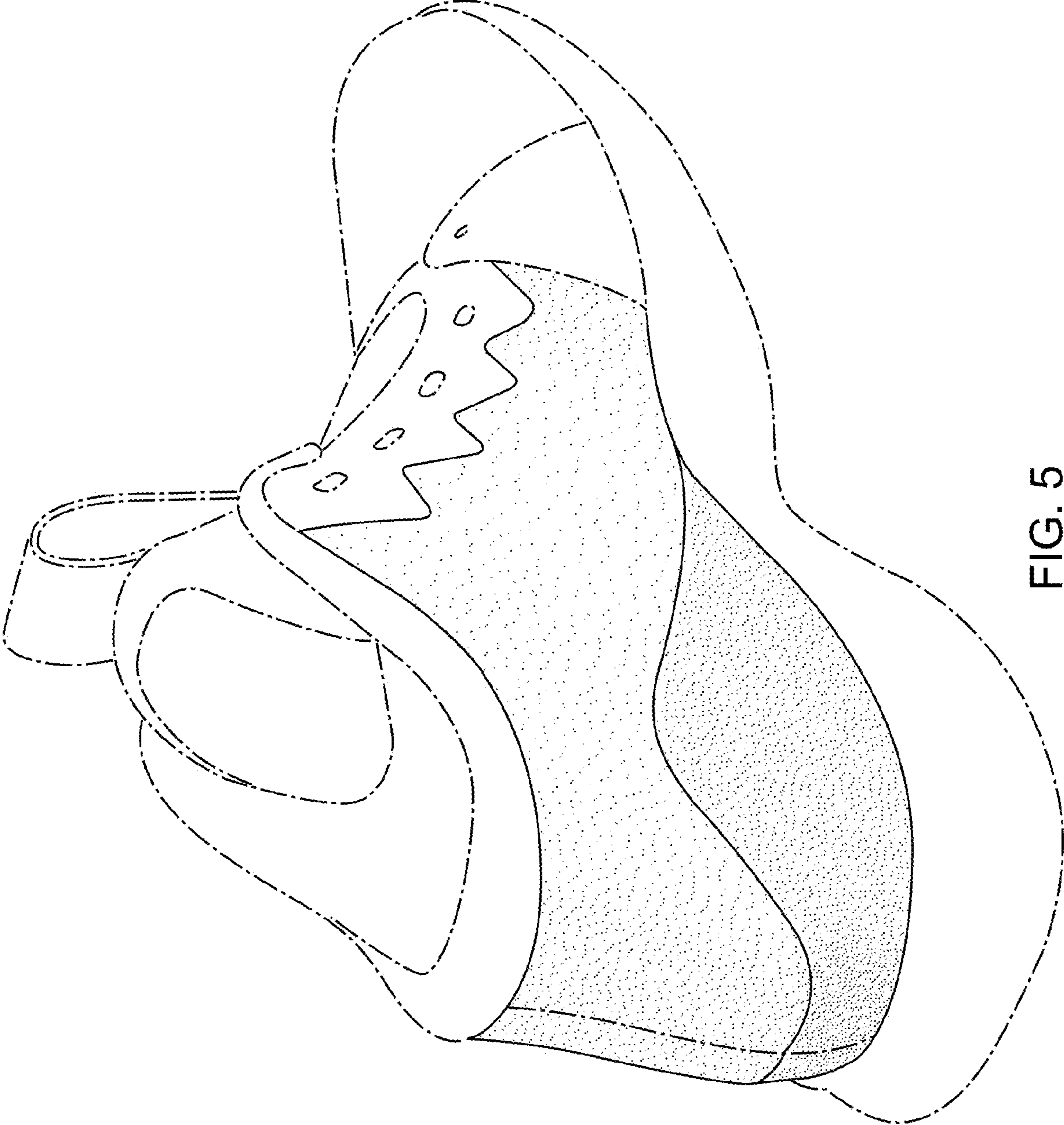

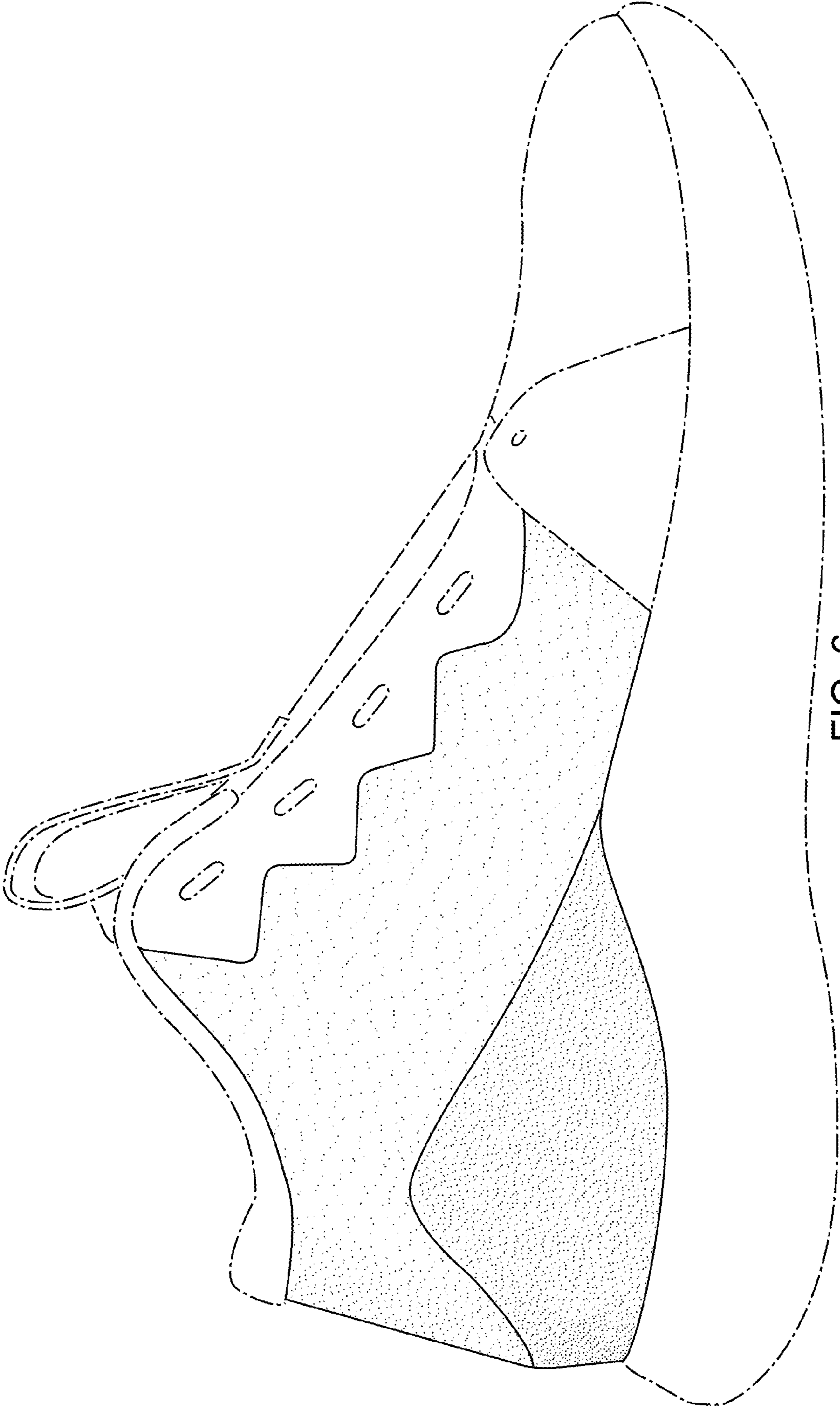

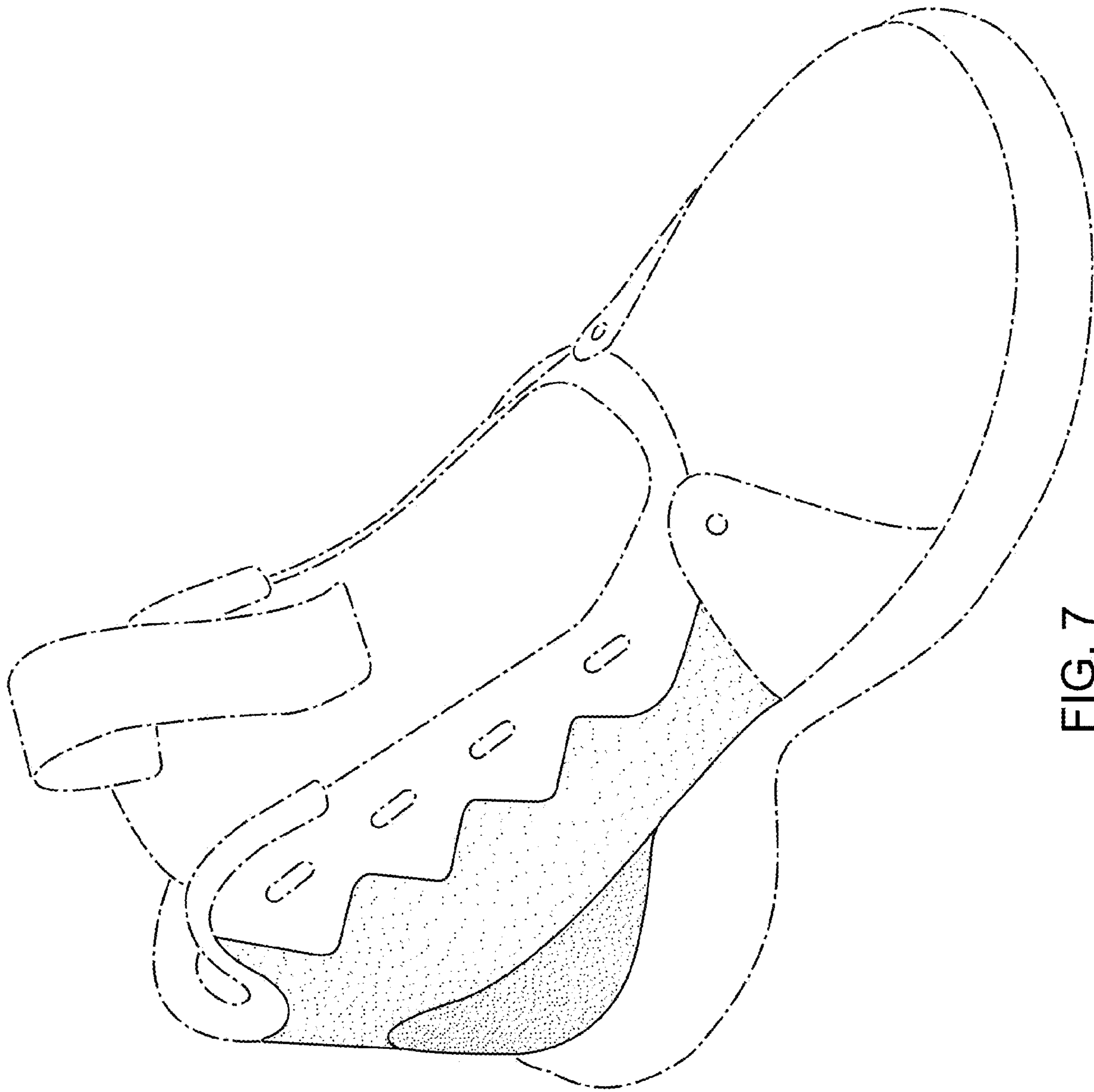
