The ornamental design for a holder for personal care and disposable items, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a holder for personal care and disposable items according to our new and ornamental design;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof;

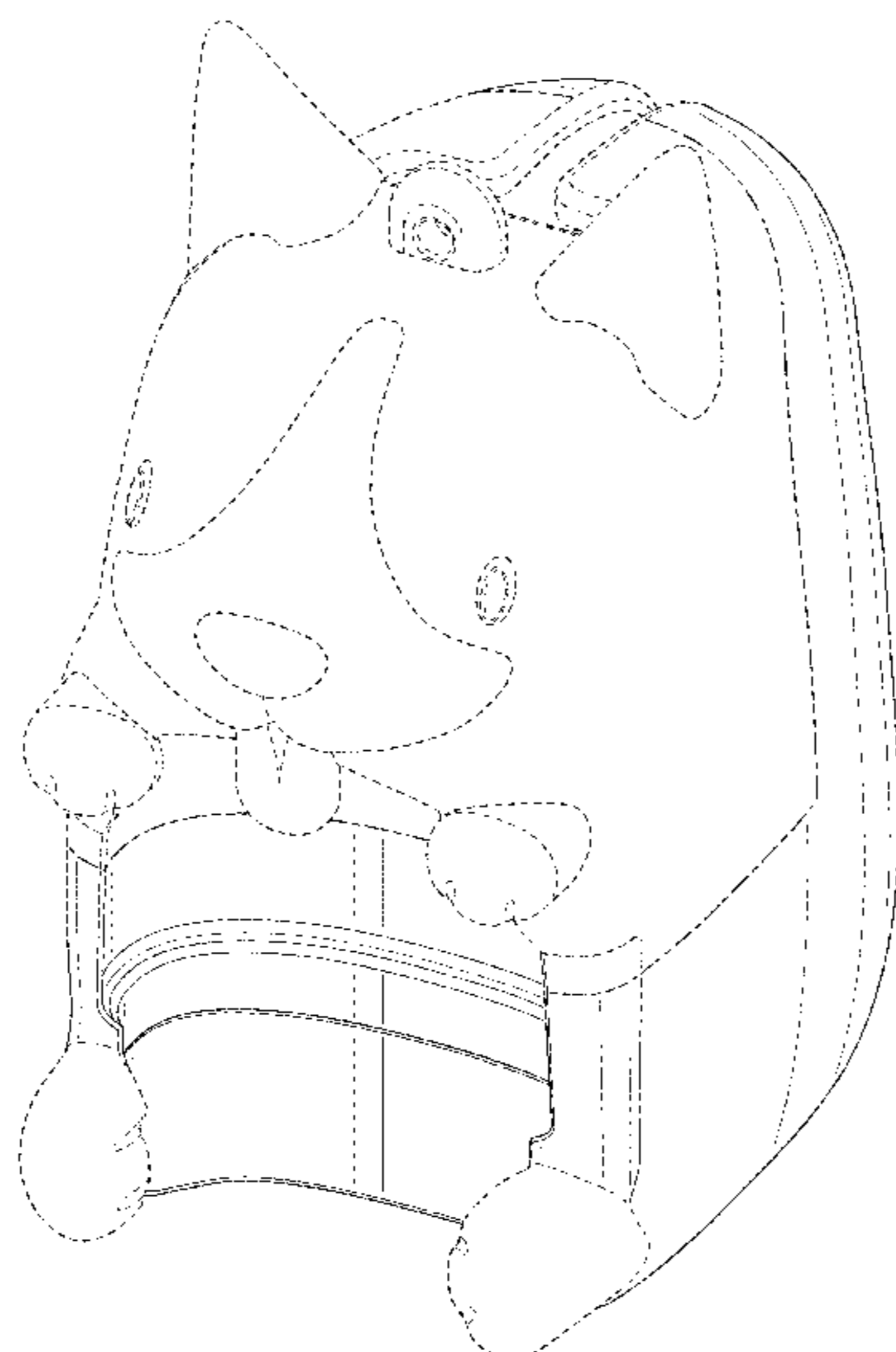
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

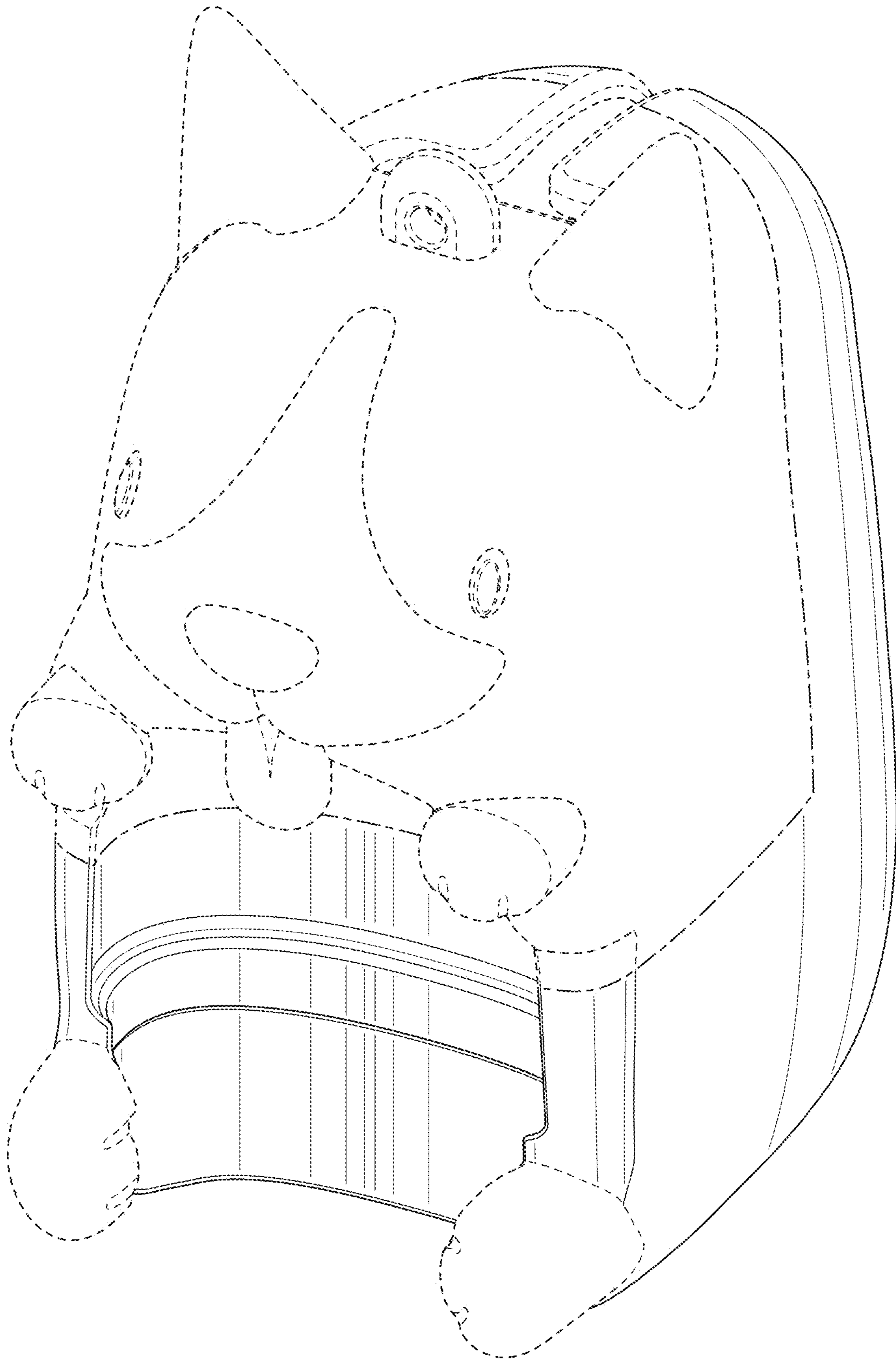

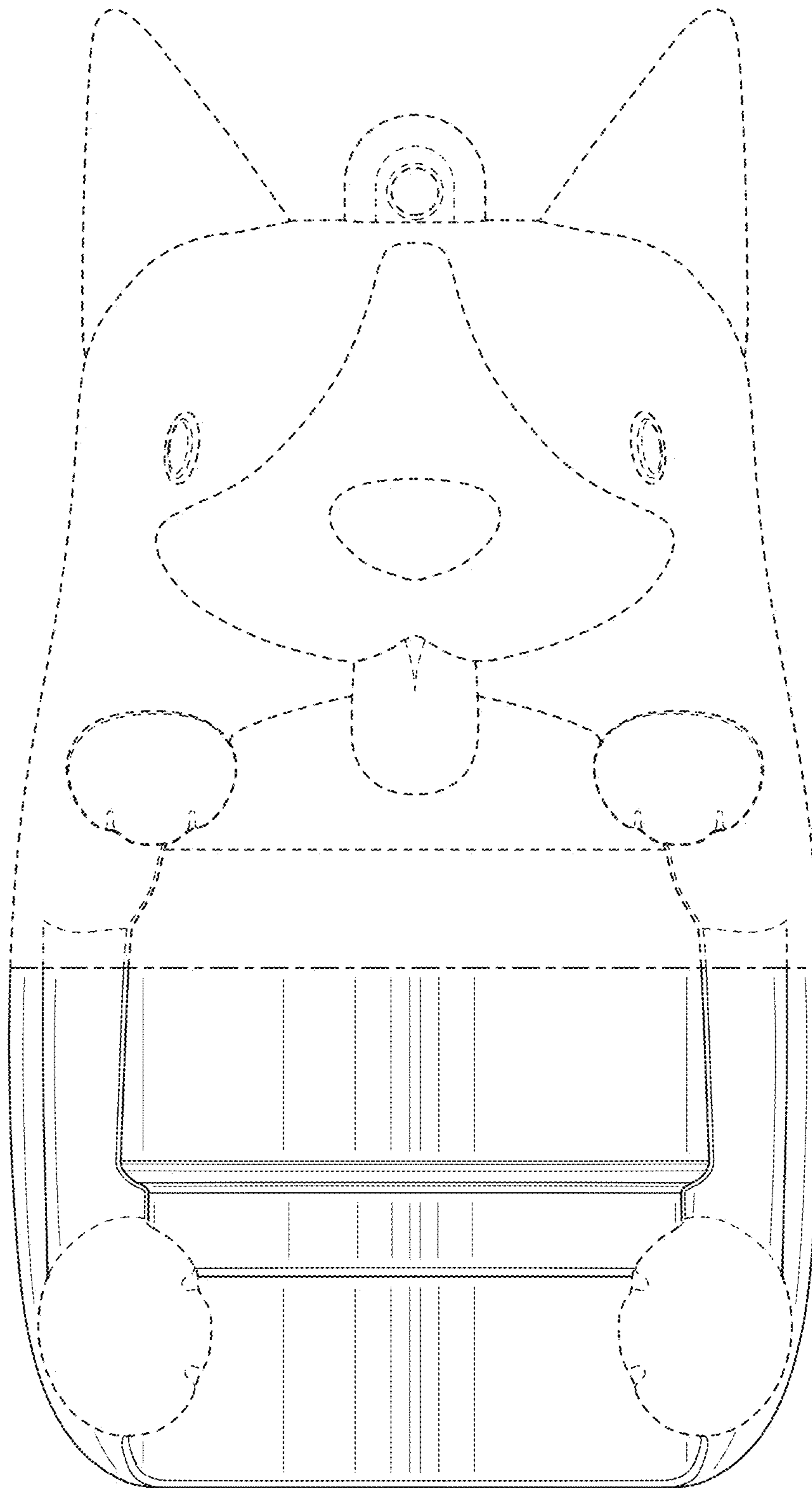

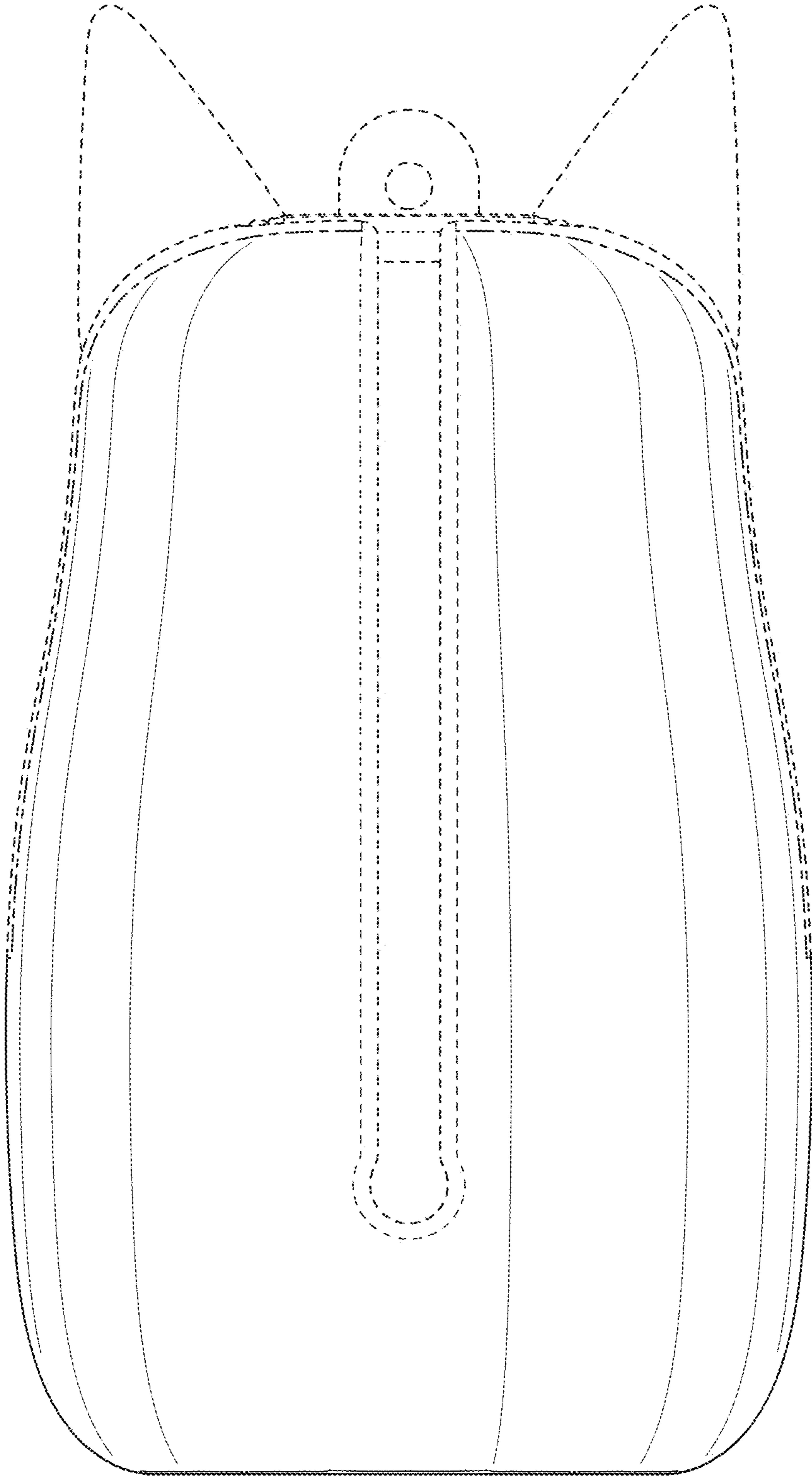

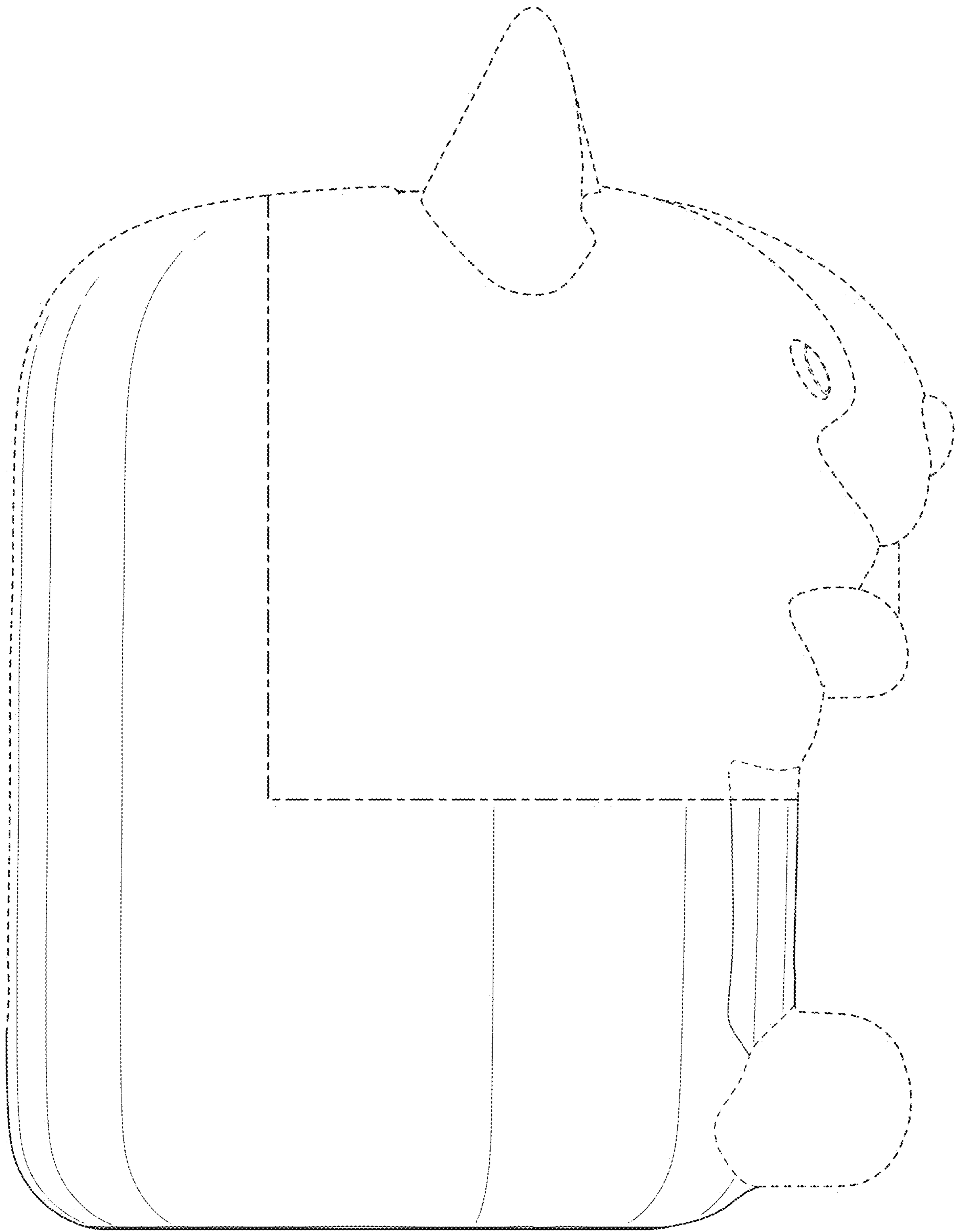

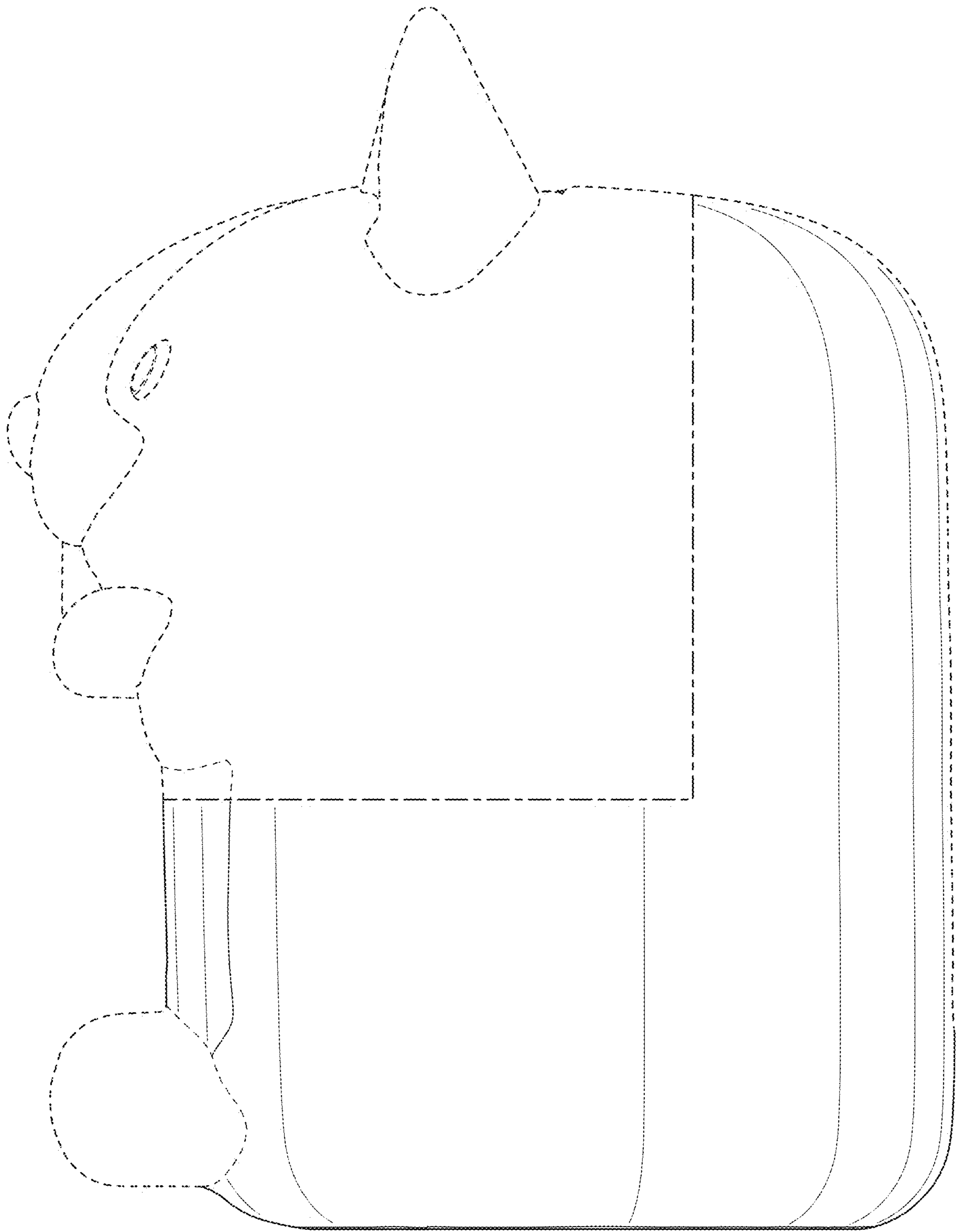

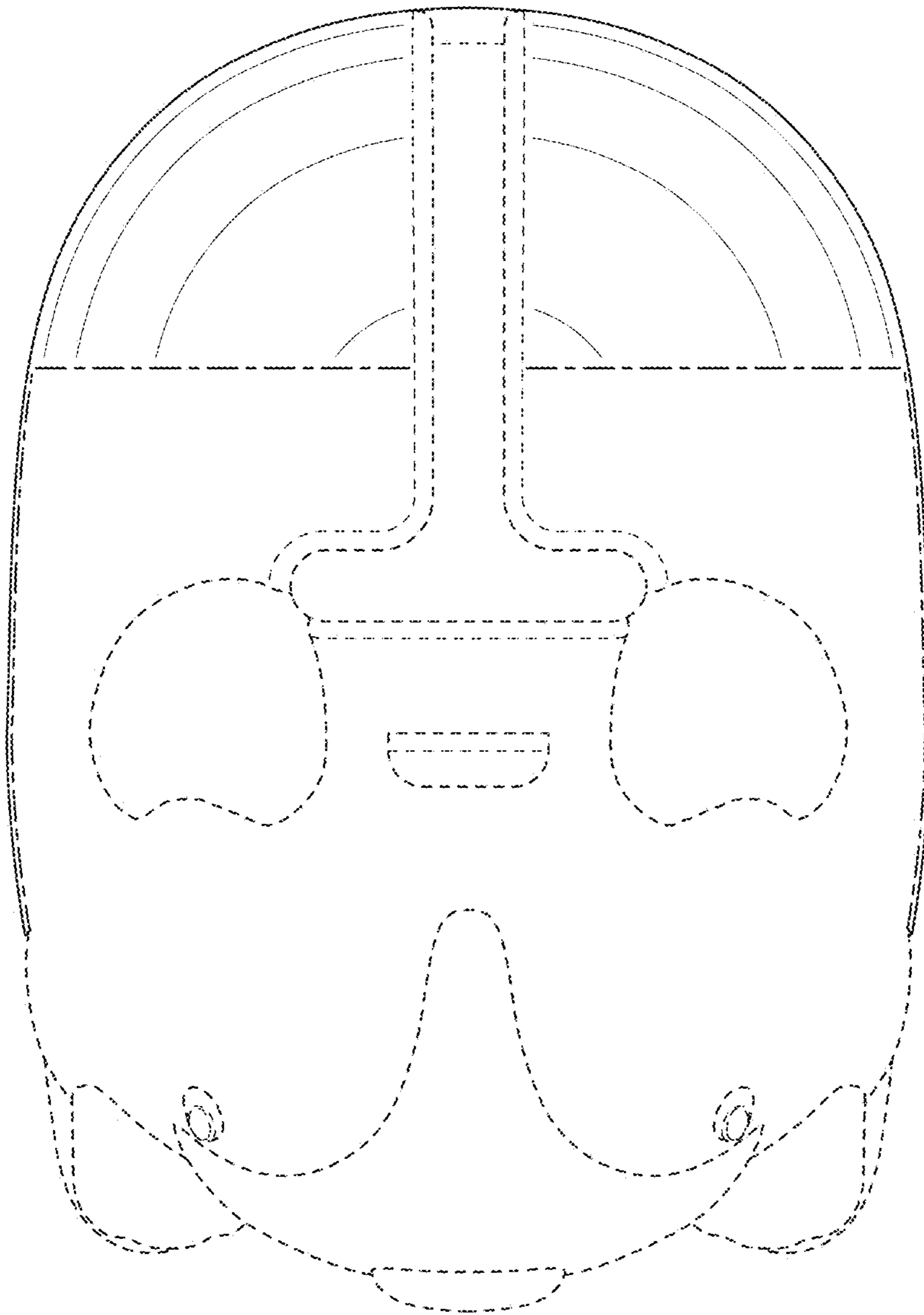

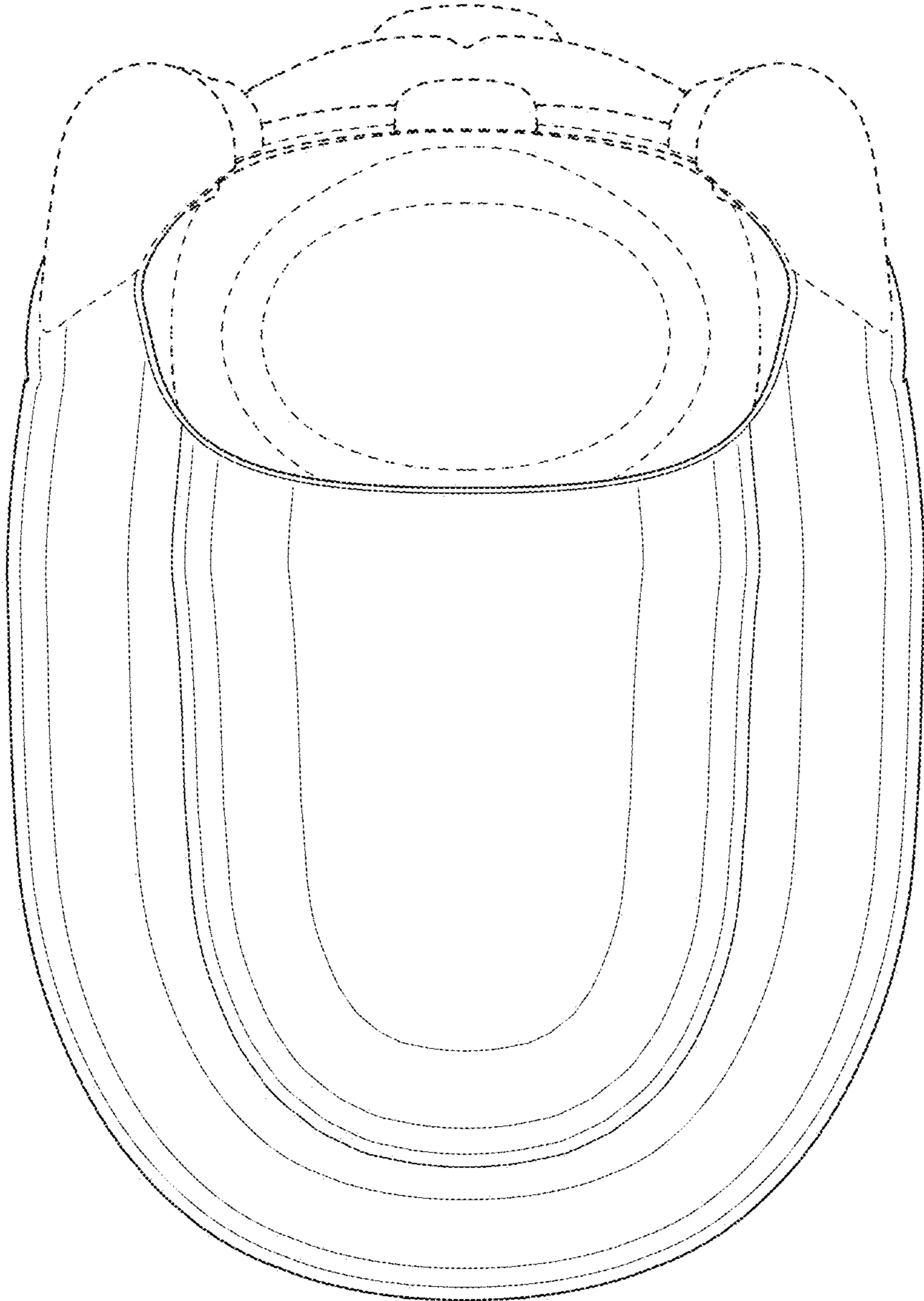

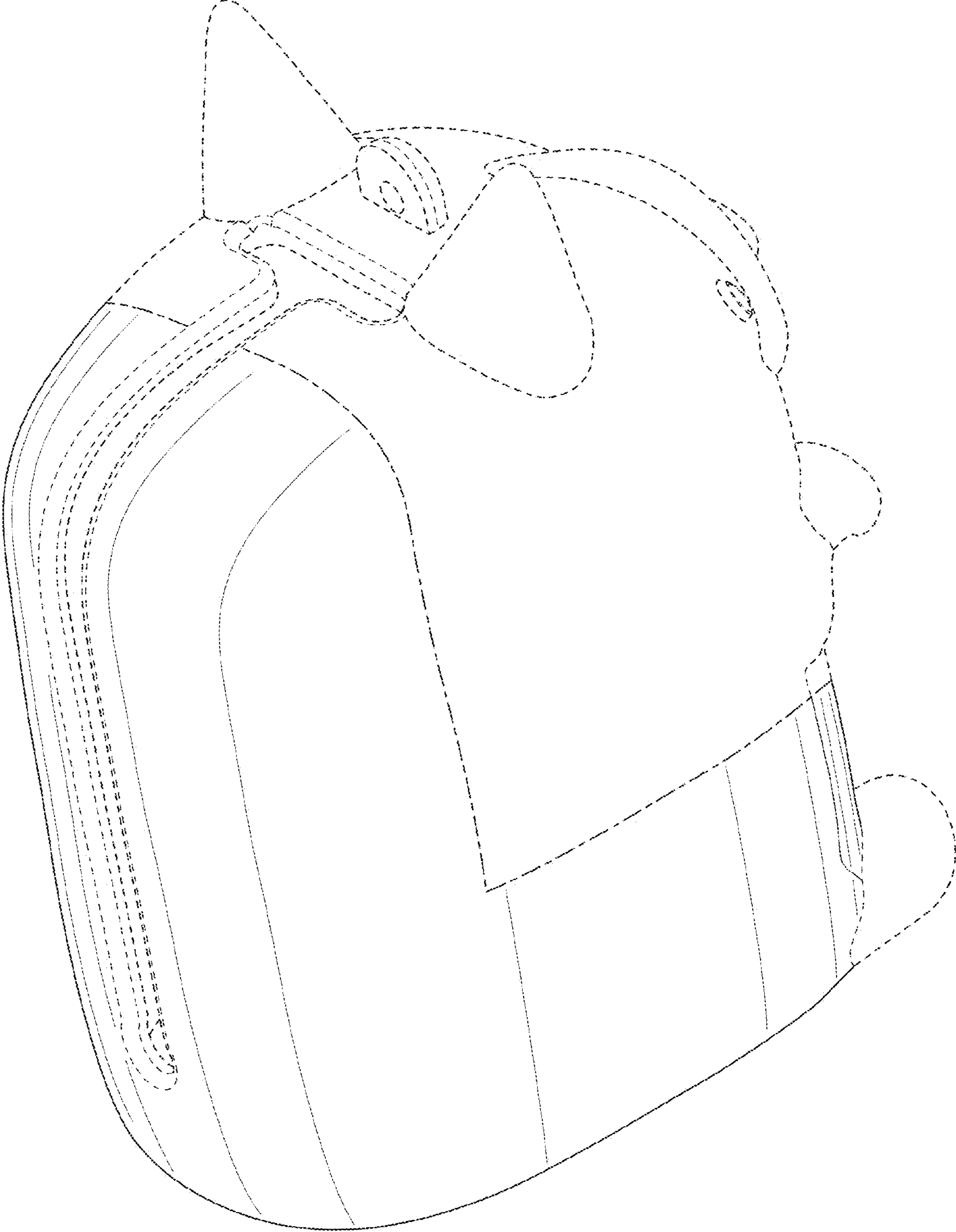
