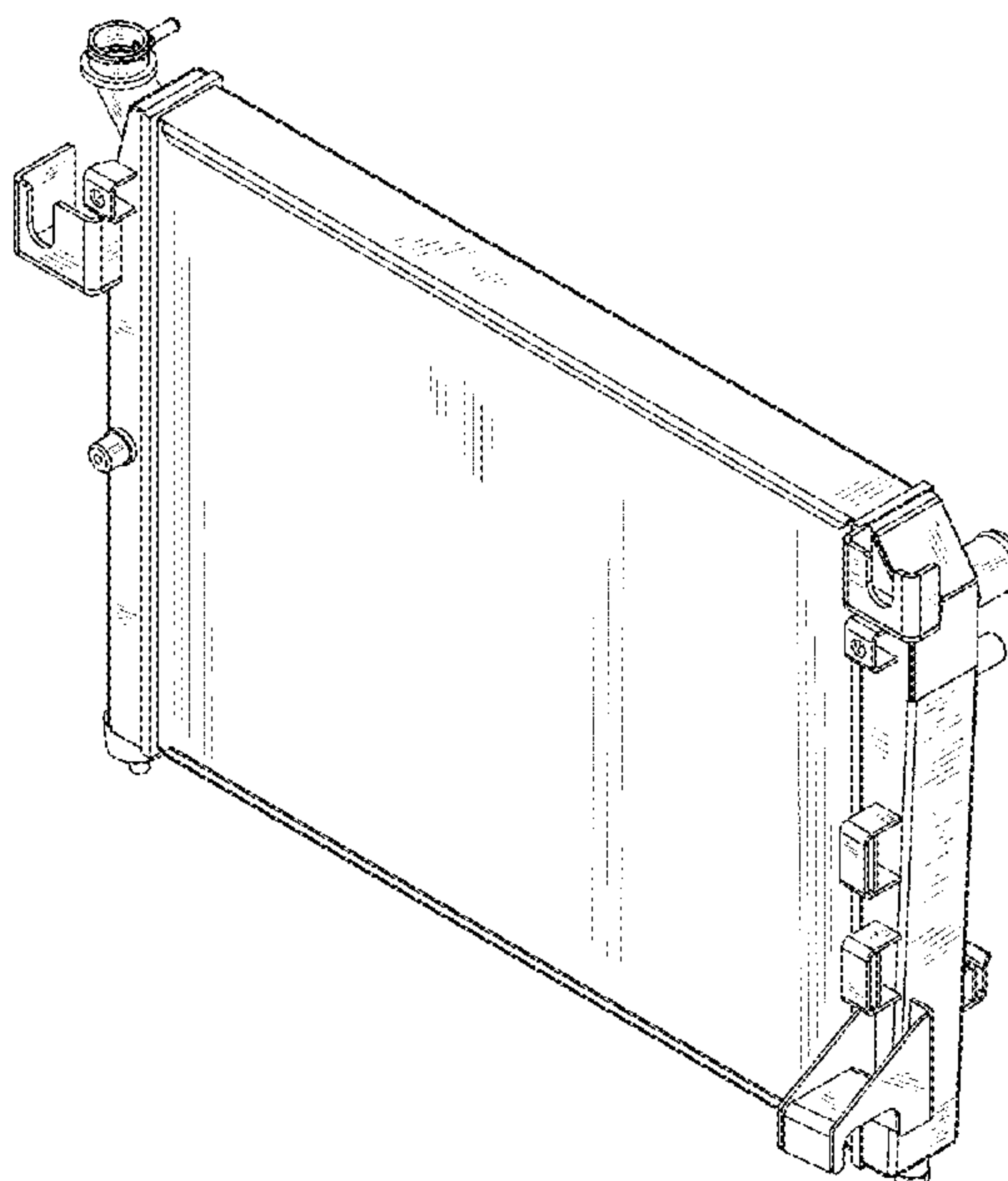
The ornamental design for a radiator for automotive applications, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

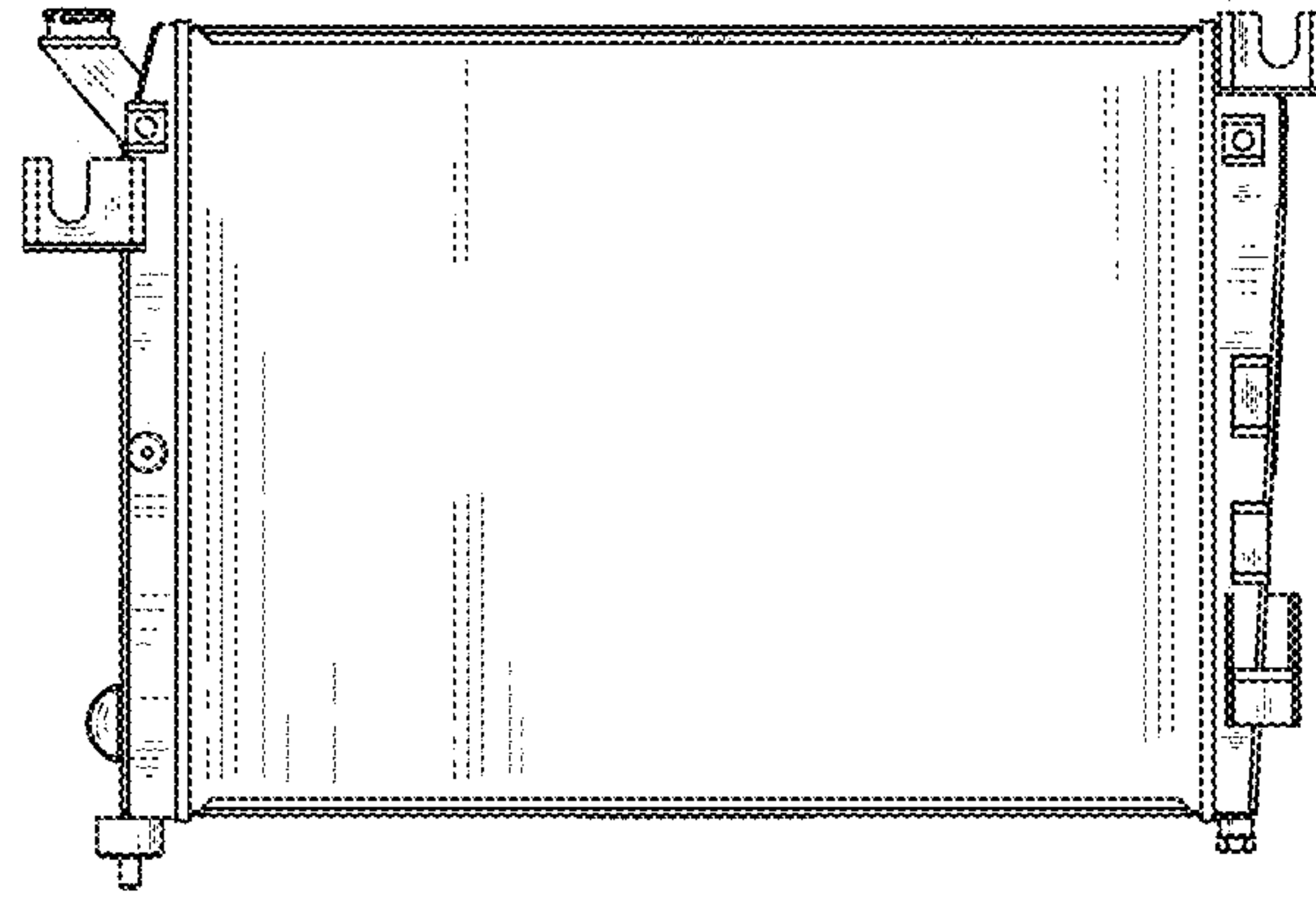

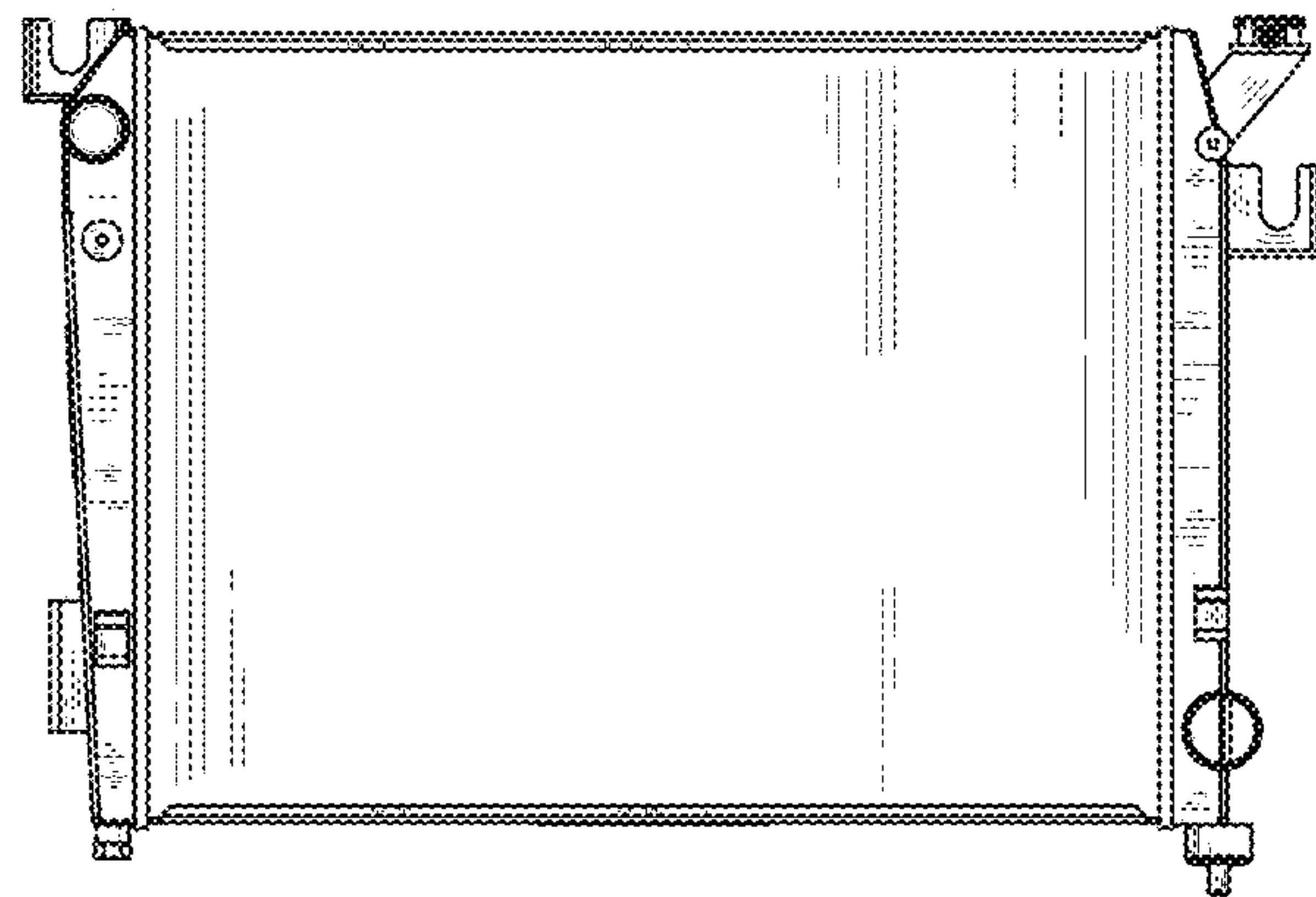

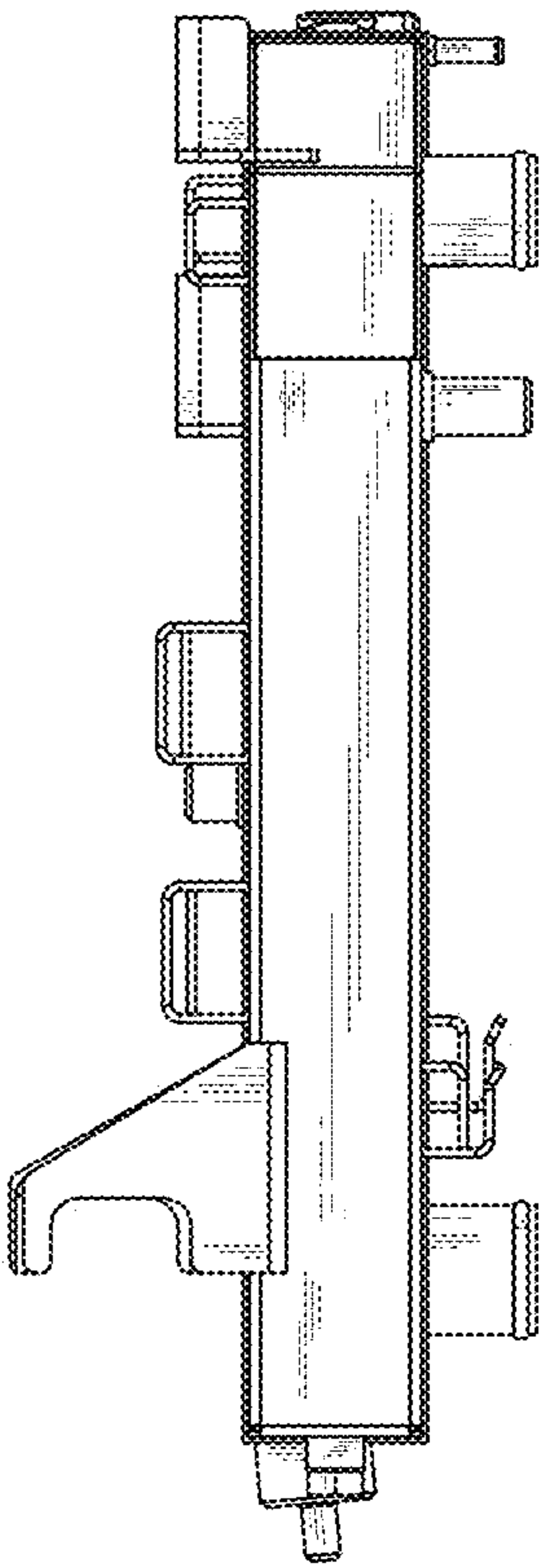

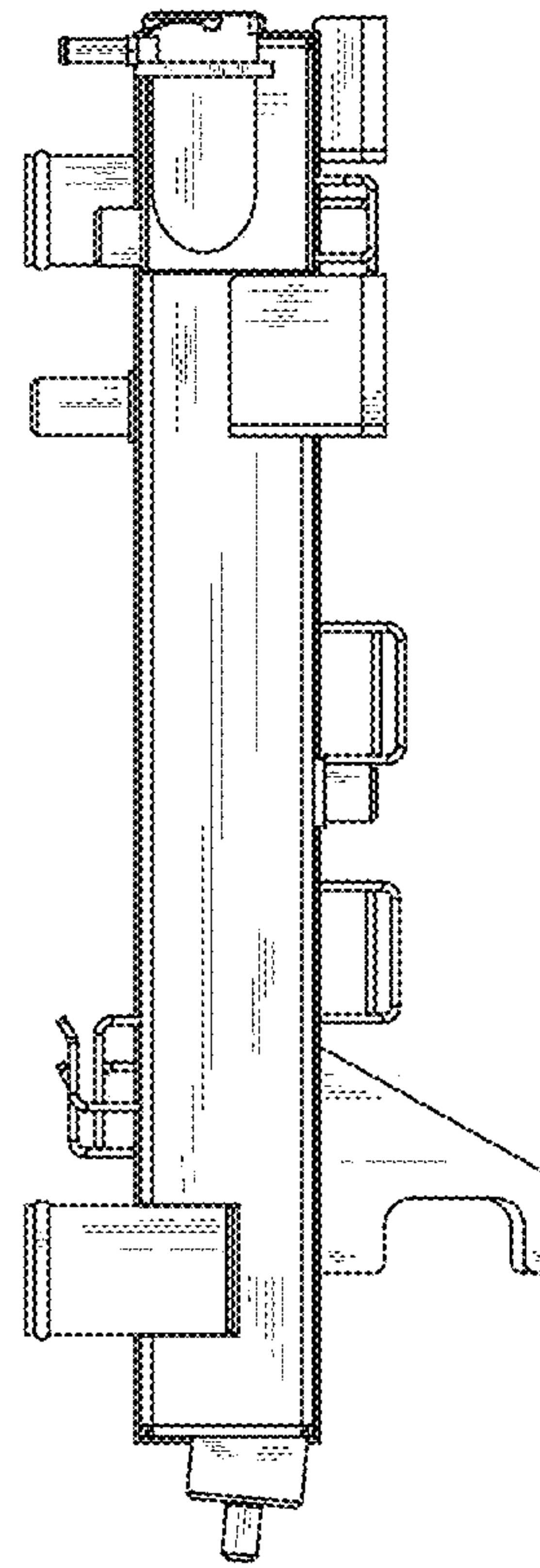

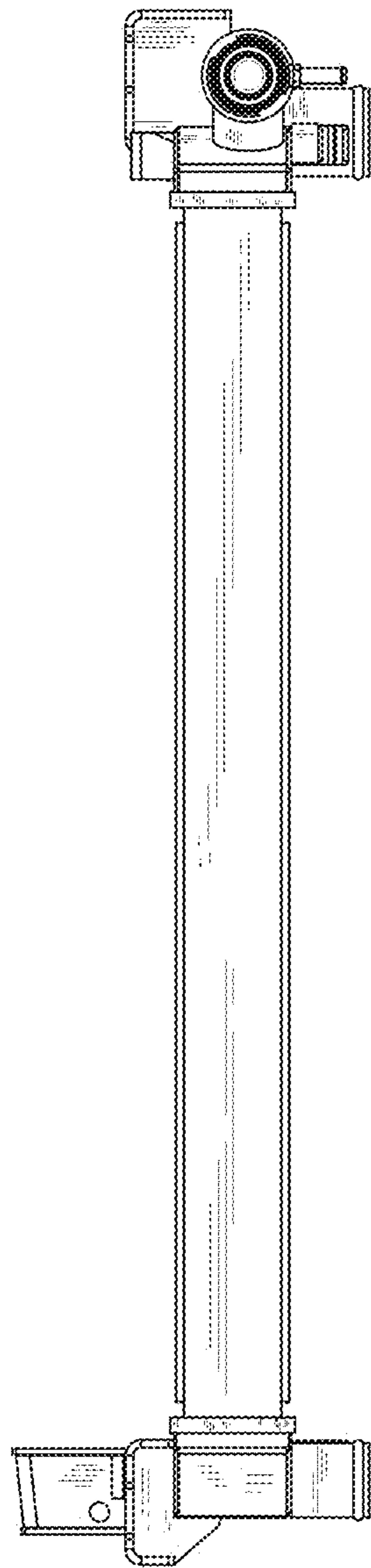

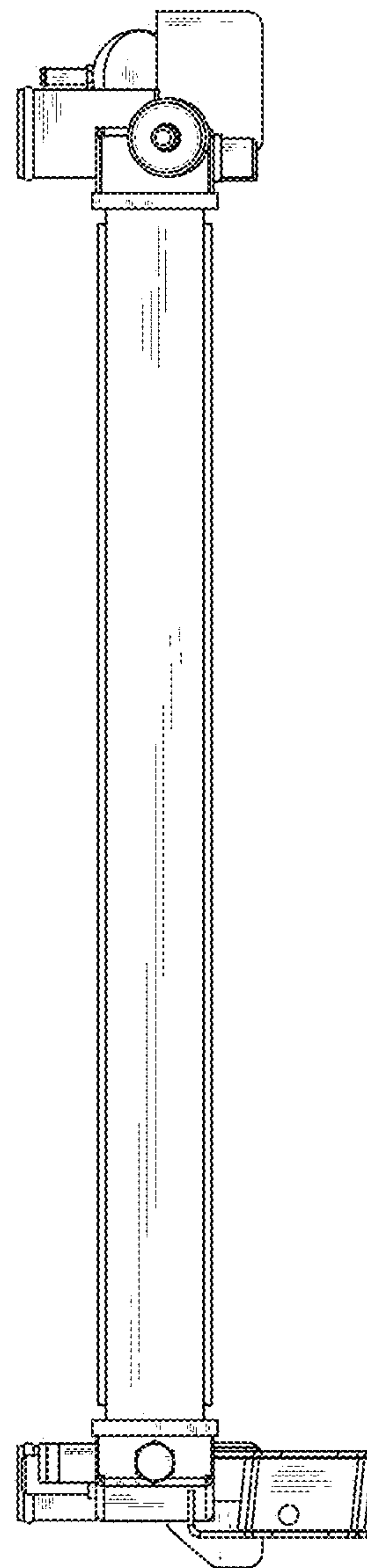

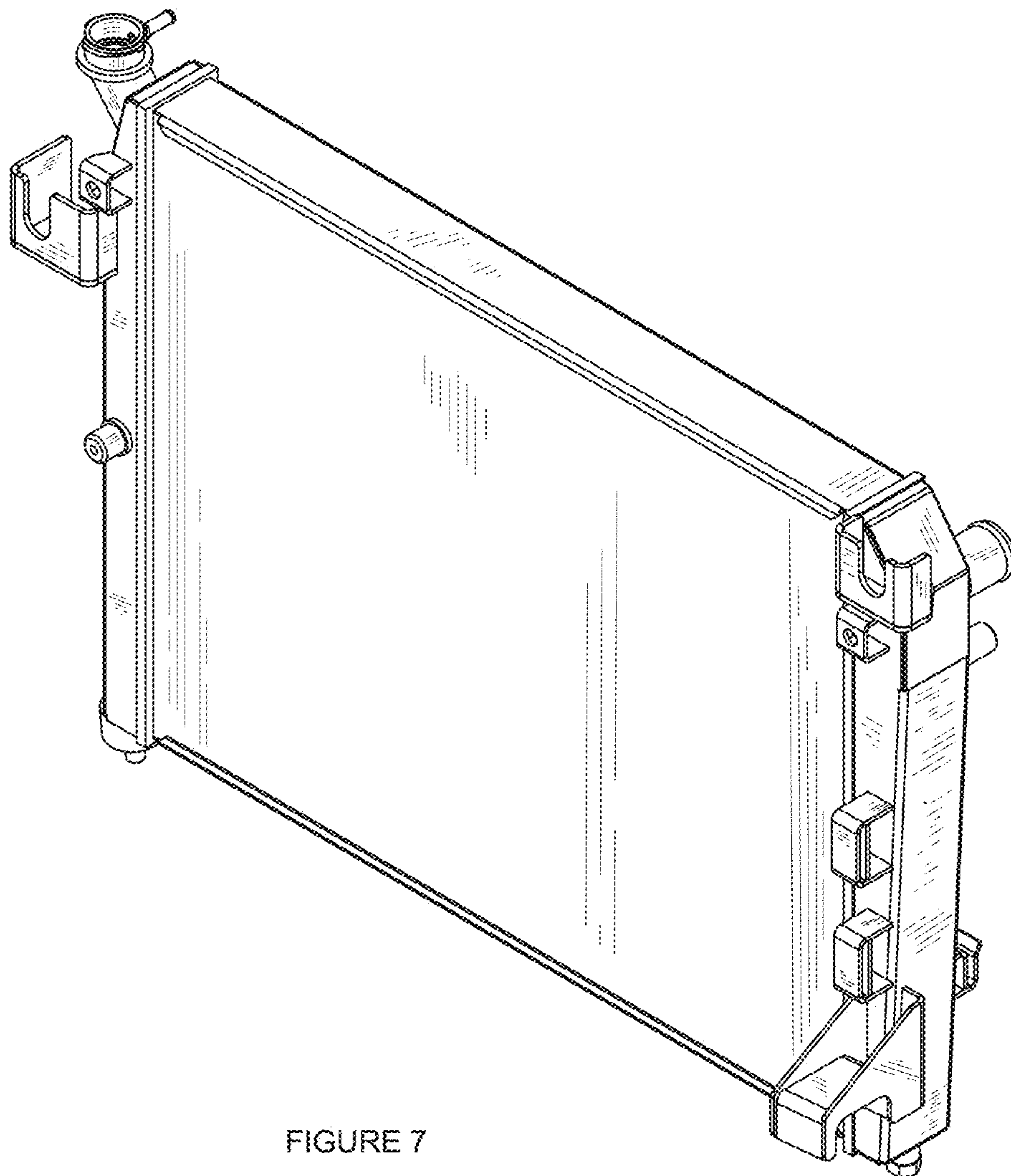

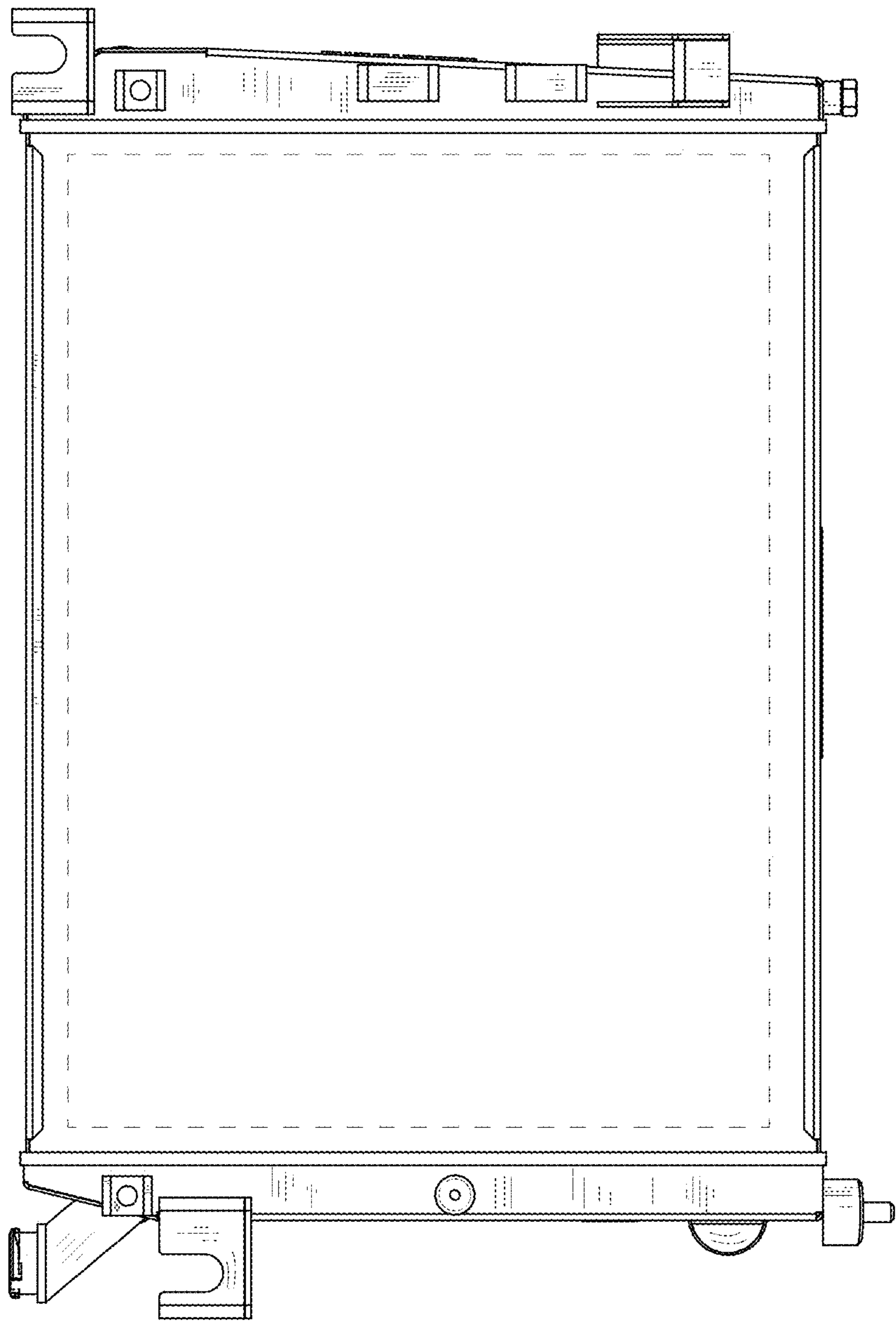
