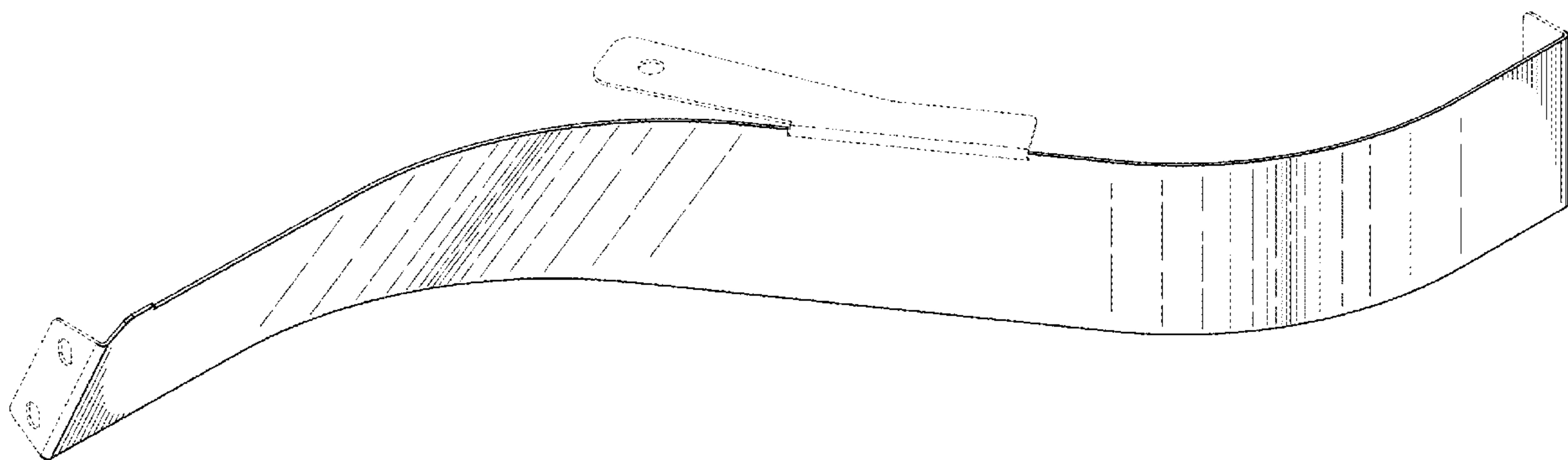
The ornamental design for a transition panel, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an environmental view of a vehicle showing a transition panel according to an exemplary embodiment of our new design for use on a first side of the vehicle; FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the transition panel shown in FIG. 1 without the environmental elements; FIG. 3 is a top view of the transition panel shown in FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the transition panel shown in FIG. 2; FIG. 5 is a front view of the transition panel shown in FIG. 2; FIG. 6 is a left side view of the transition panel shown in FIG. 2; FIG. 7 is an environmental view of a vehicle showing a transition panel according to an exemplary embodiment of our new design for use on a second side of the vehicle; FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of the transition panel shown in FIG. 7 without the environmental elements; FIG. 9 is a top view of the transition panel shown in FIG. 8; FIG. 10 is a bottom view of the transition panel shown in FIG. 8; FIG. 11 is a front side view of the transition panel shown in FIG. 8; and, FIG. 12 is a right side view of the transition panel shown in FIG. 8.

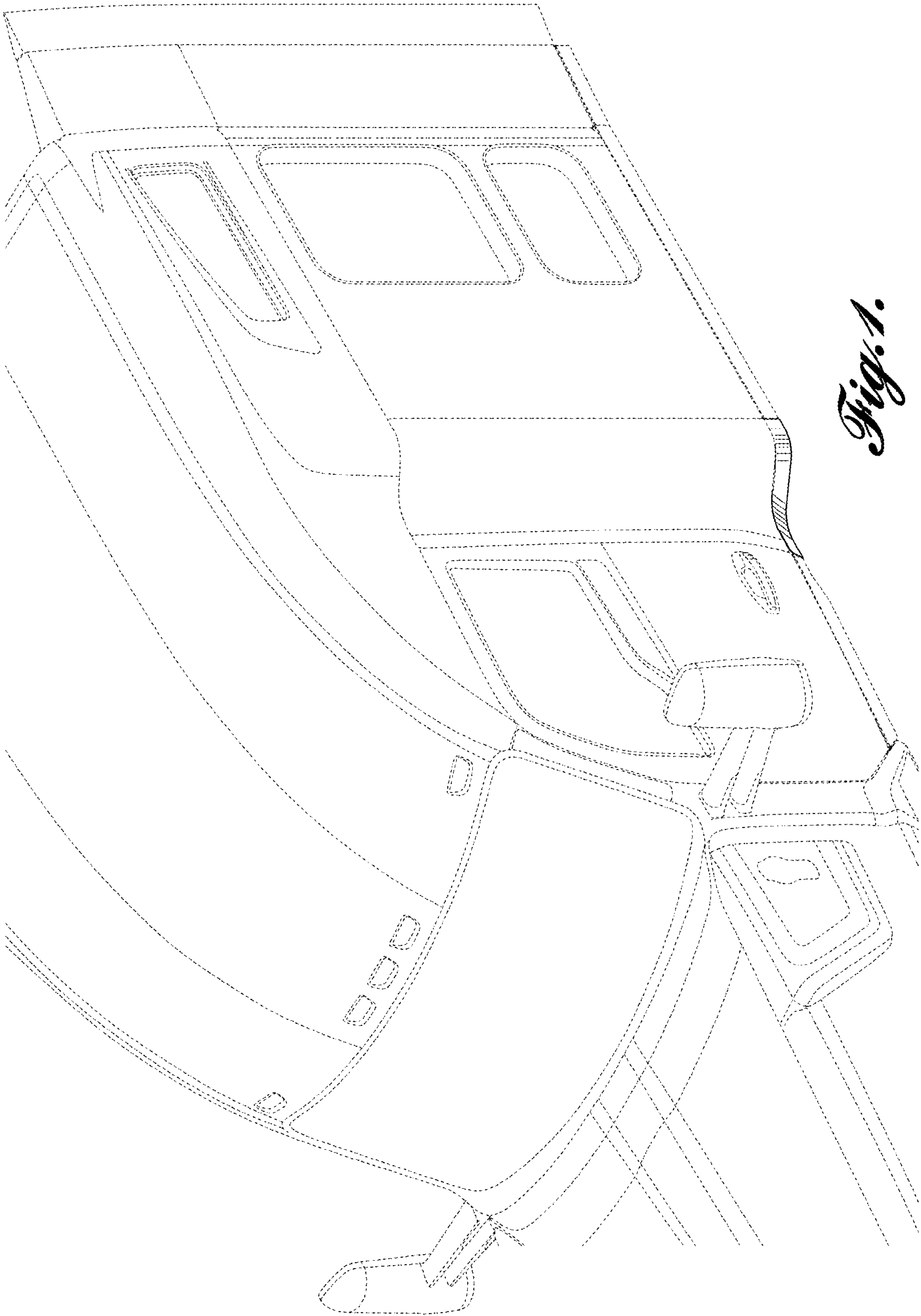
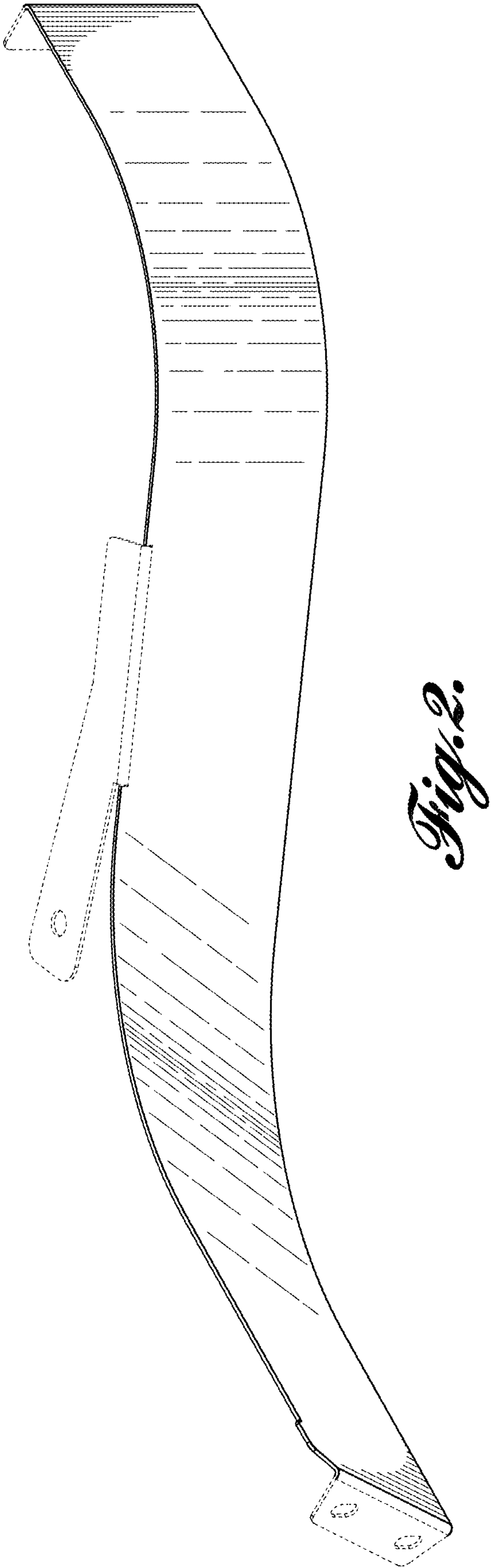

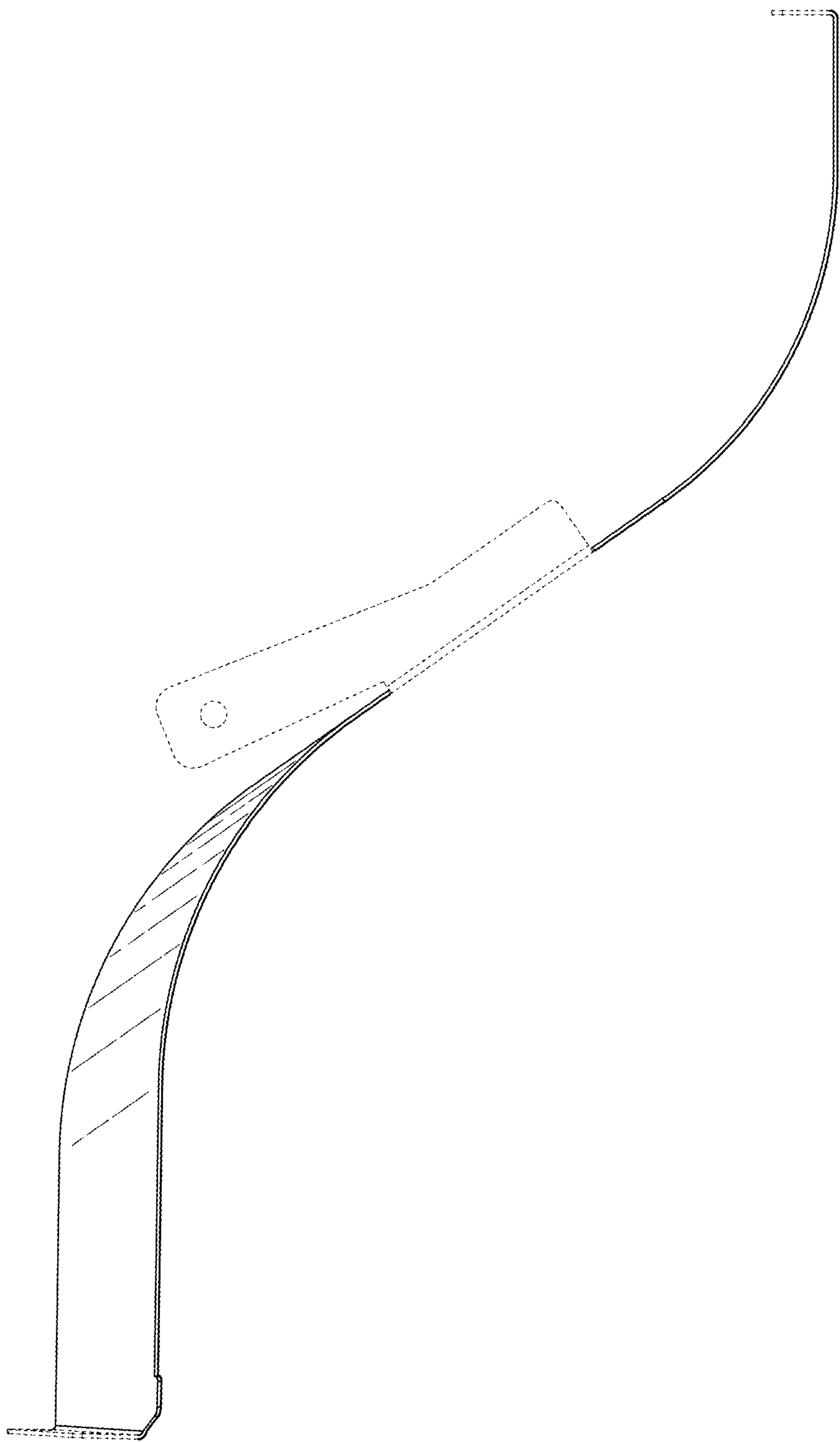

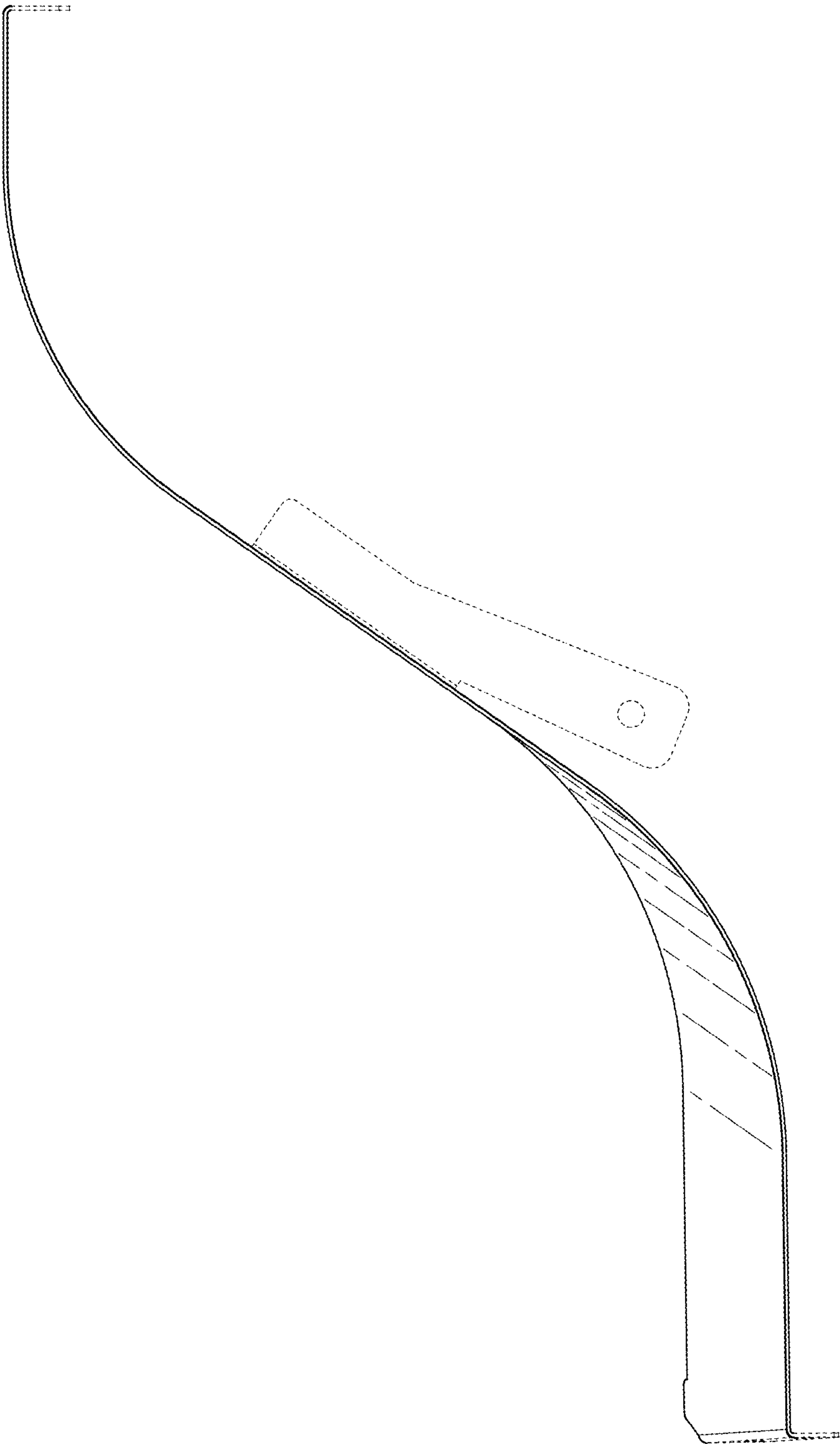

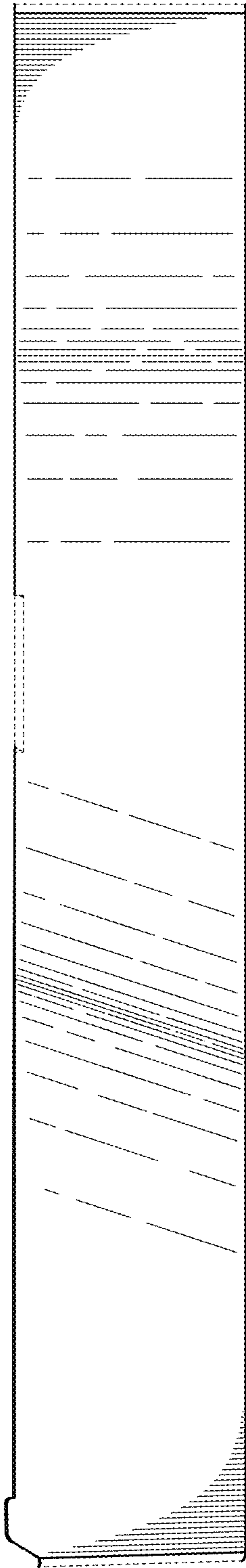

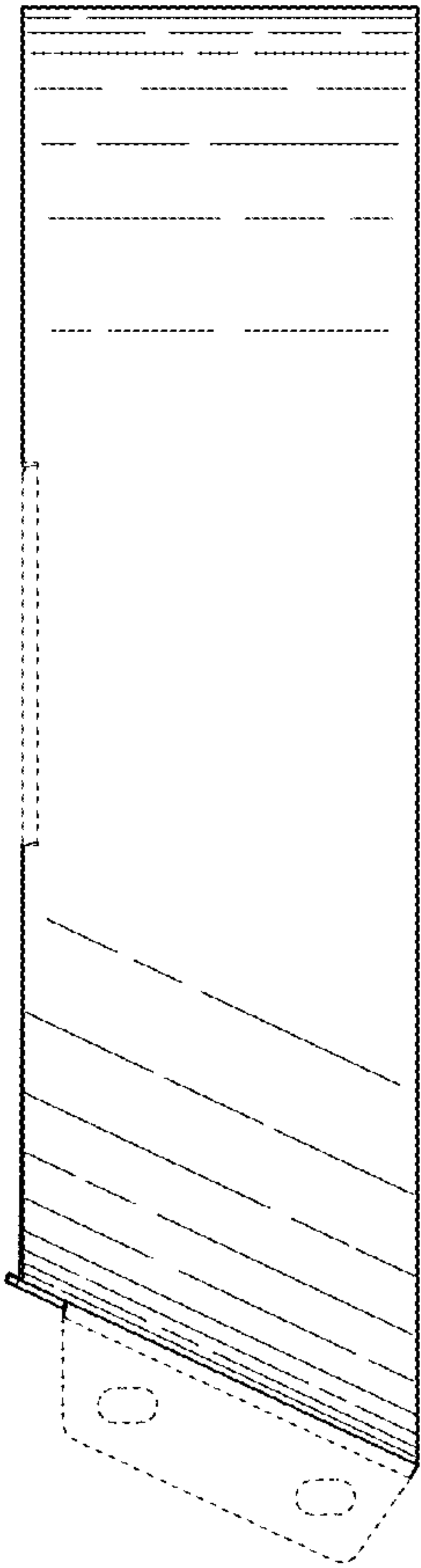

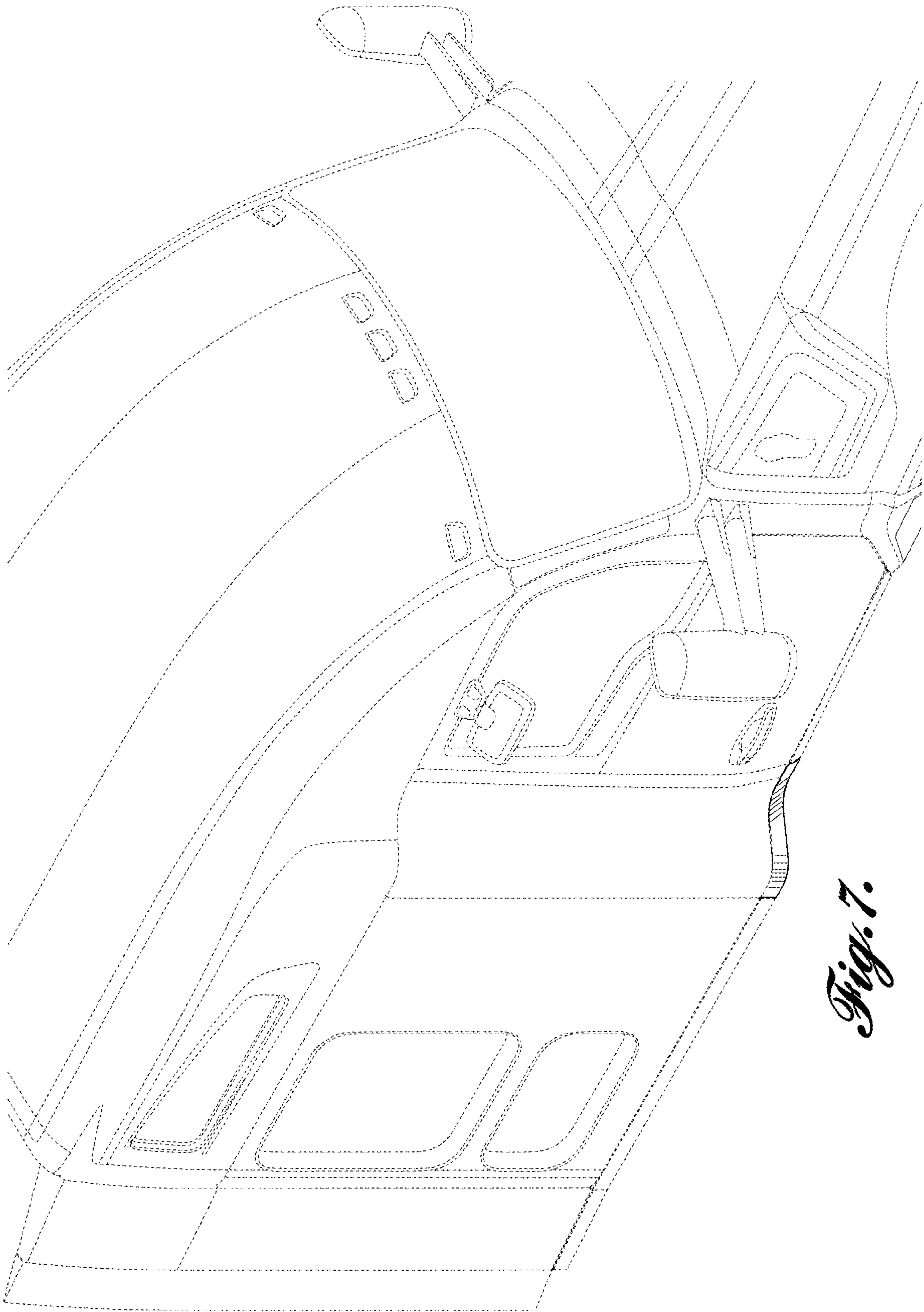

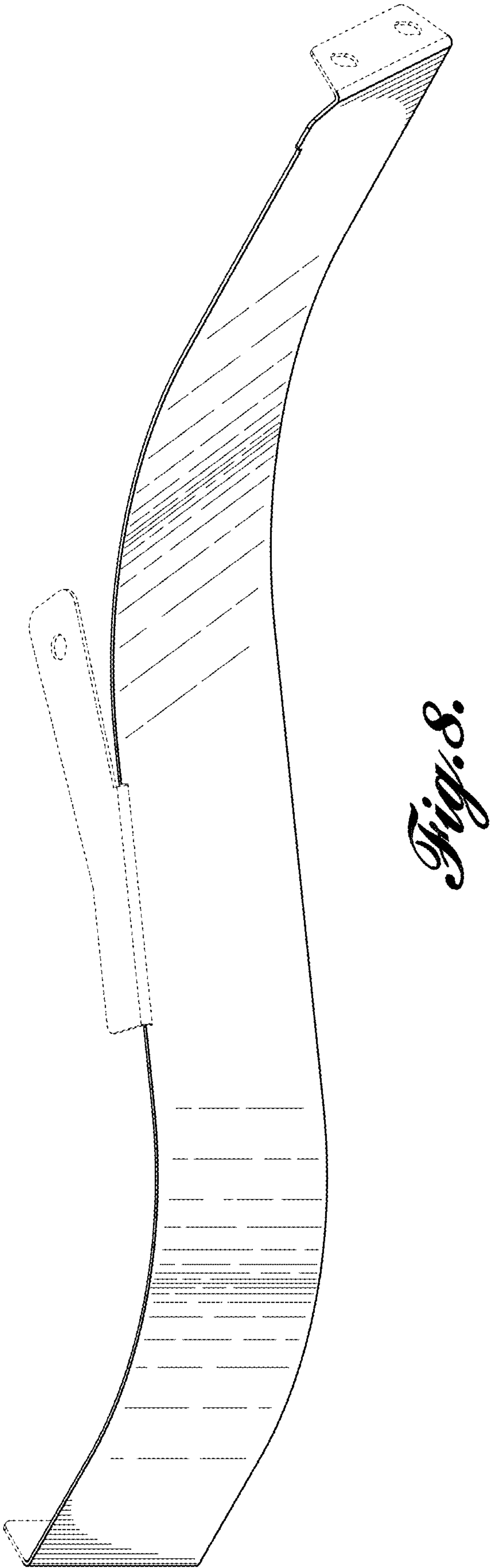

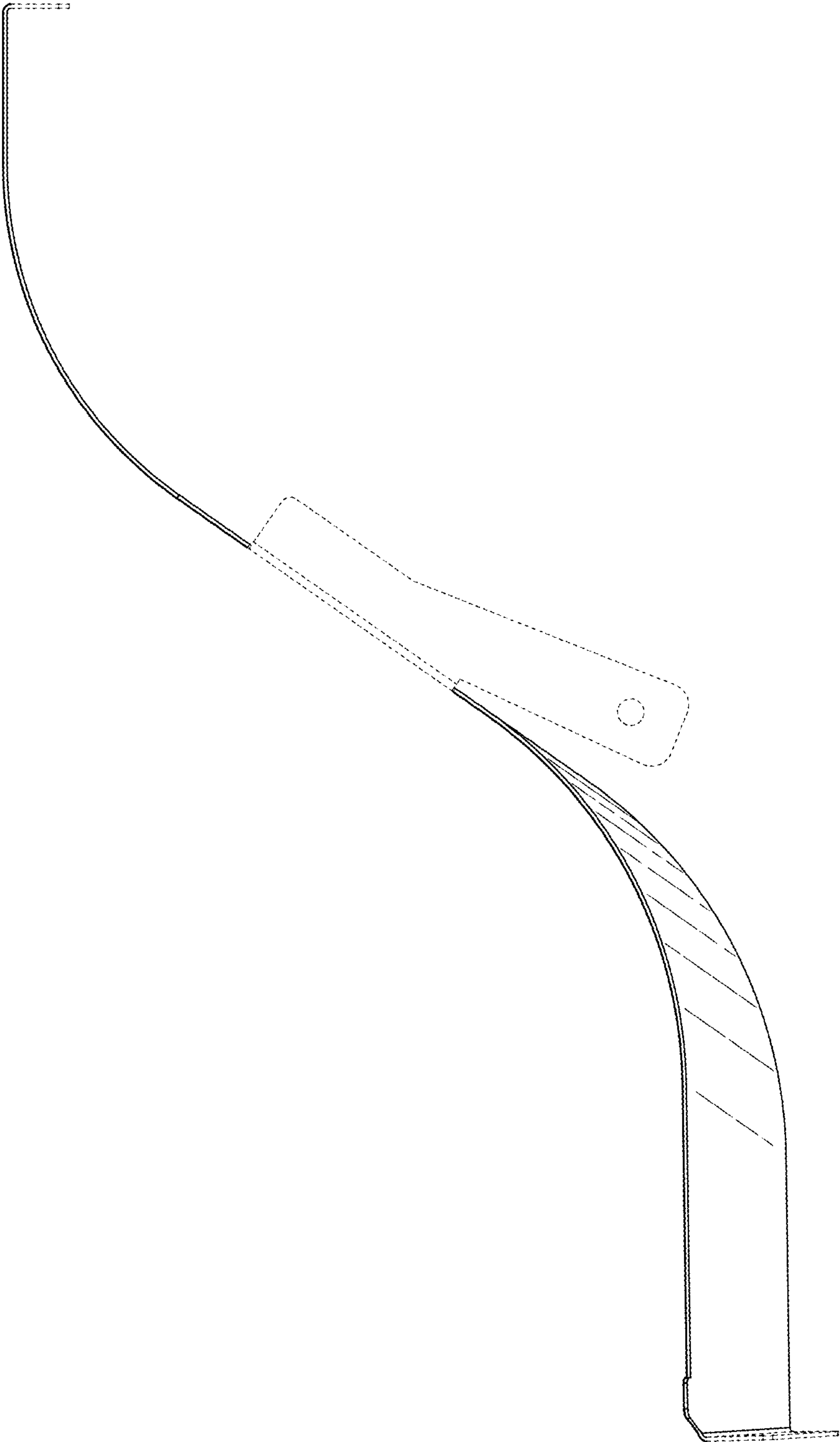

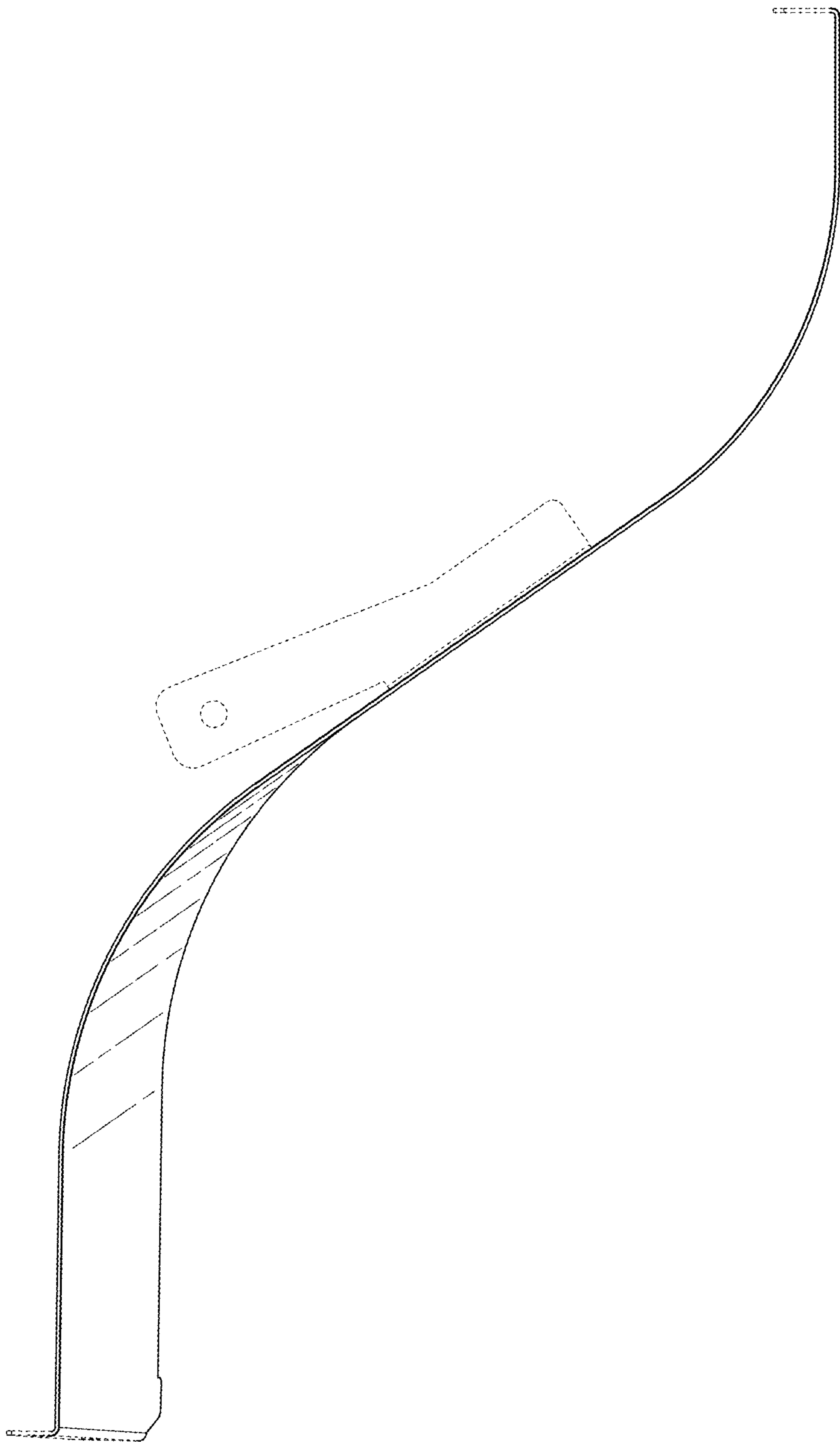

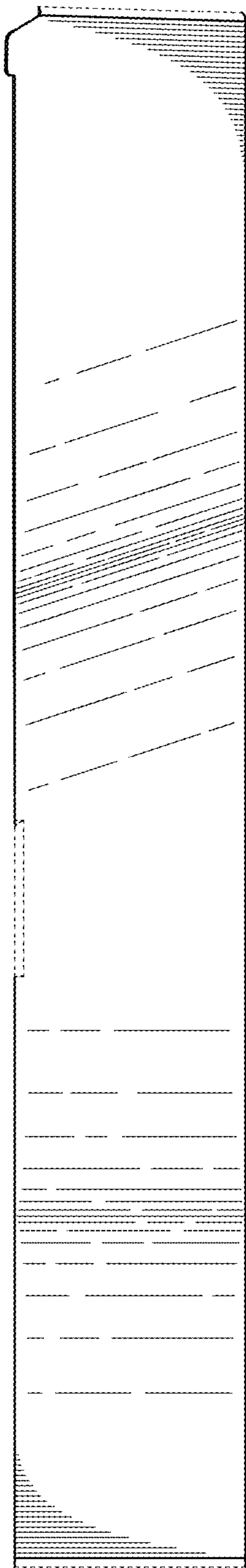

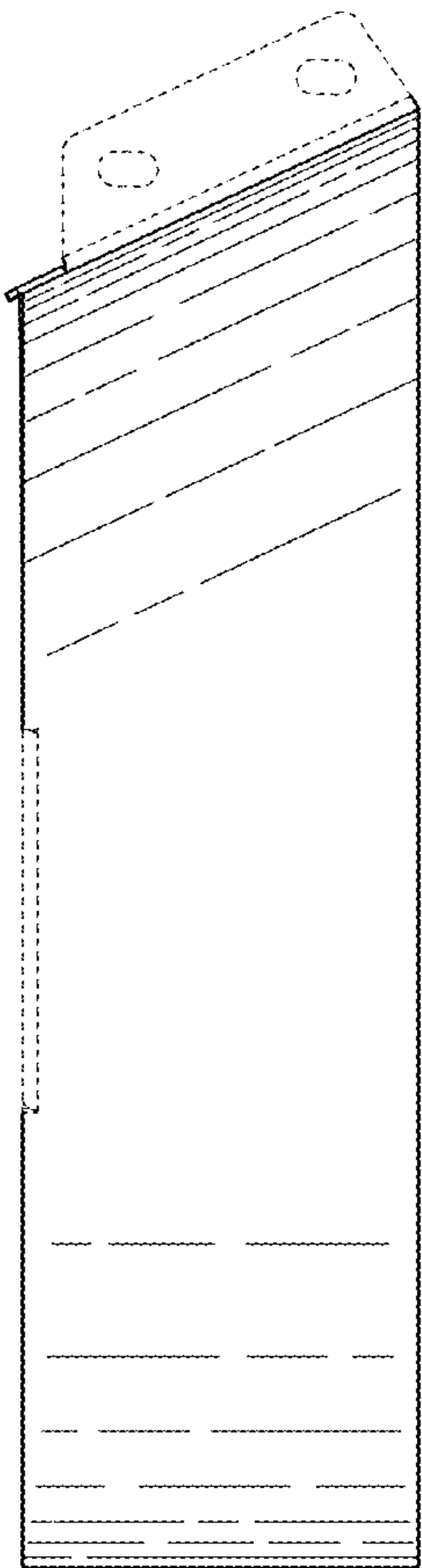
