What is claimed is the ornamental design for a paddle blade notch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view showing a paddle blade notch of Applicant's invention.

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the paddle blade notch of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the paddle blade notch of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the paddle blade notch of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the paddle blade notch of FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the paddle blade notch of FIG. 1.

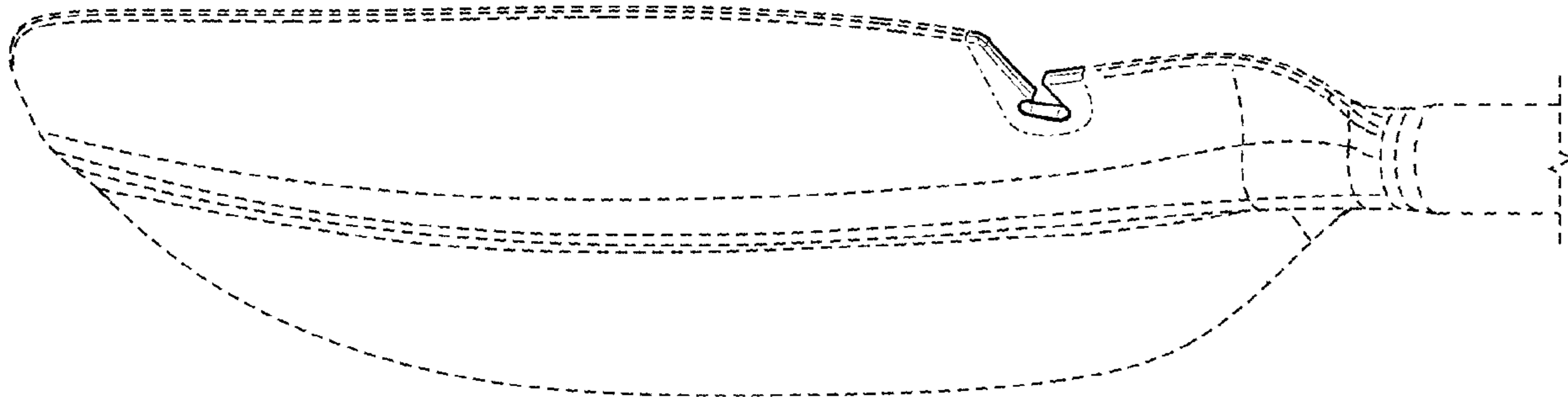
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the paddle blade notch of FIG. 1; and,

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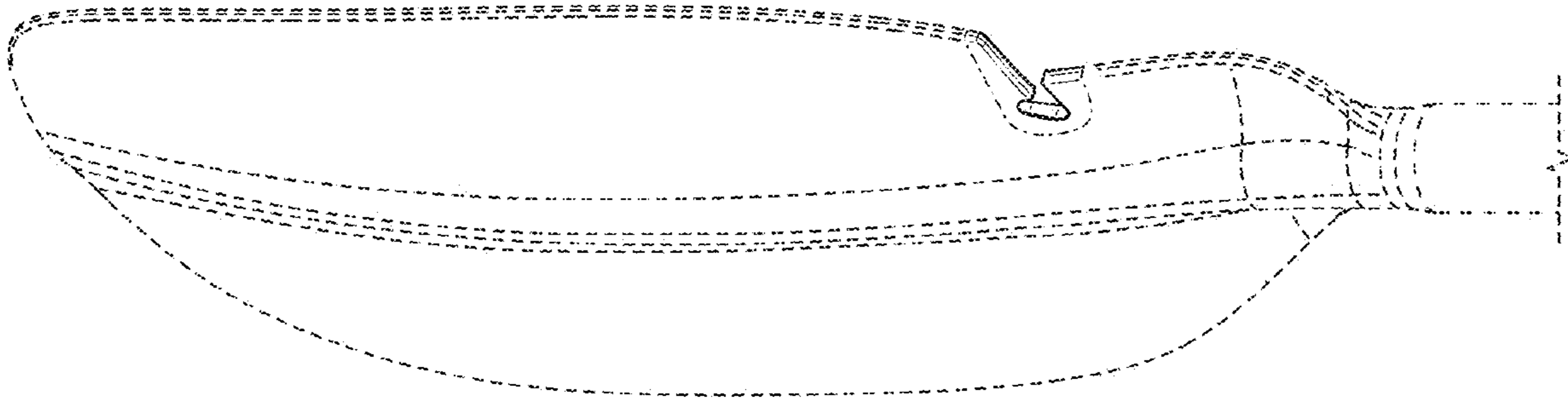

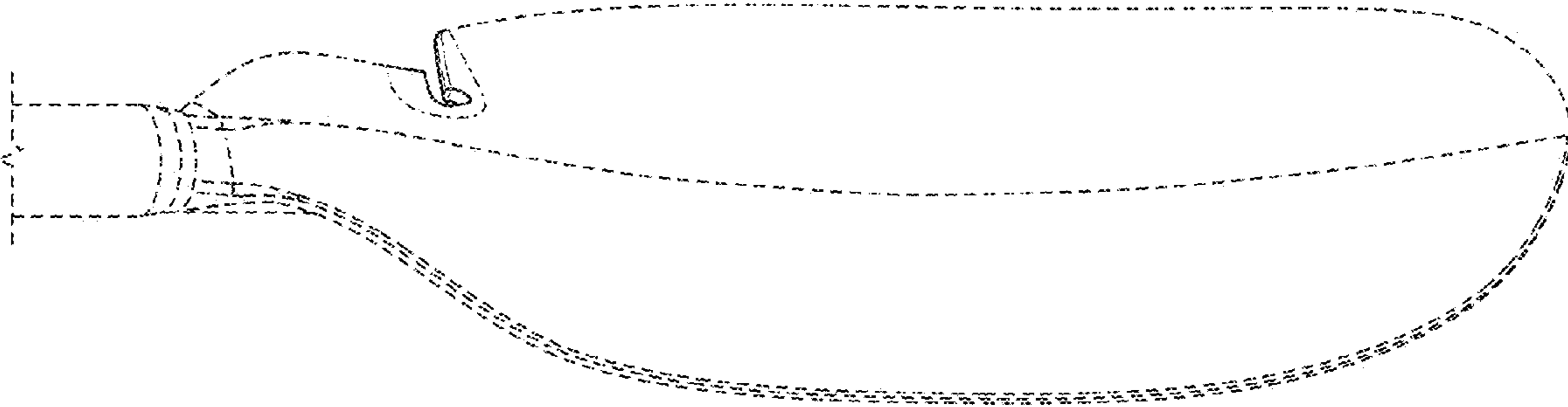

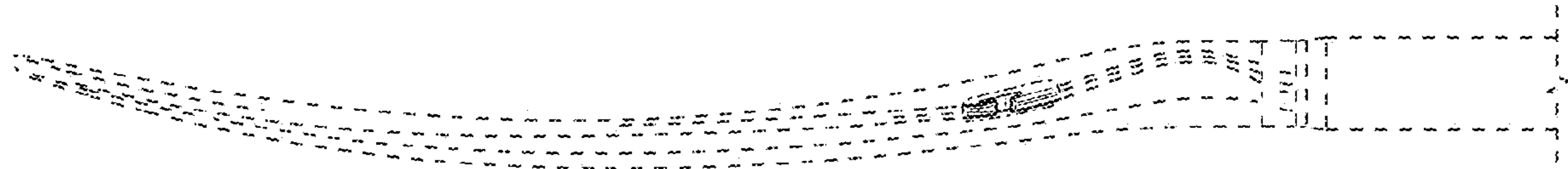

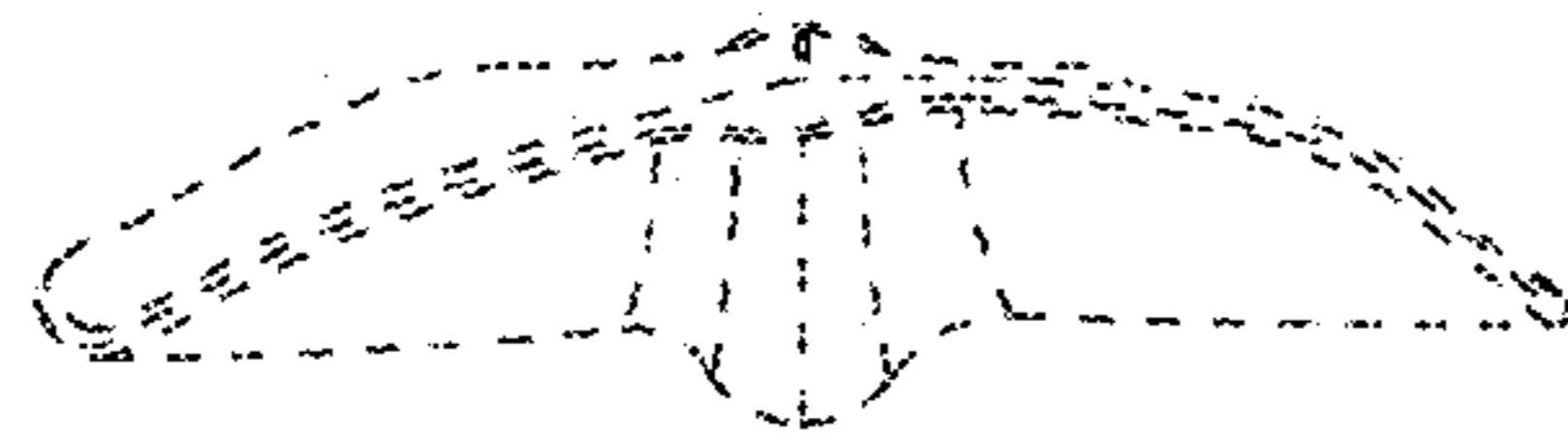

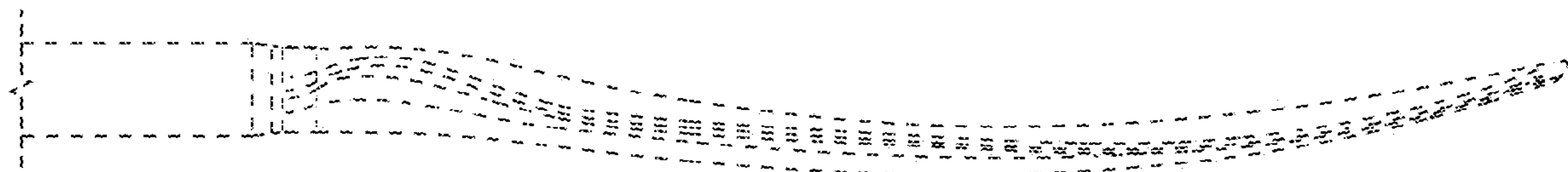

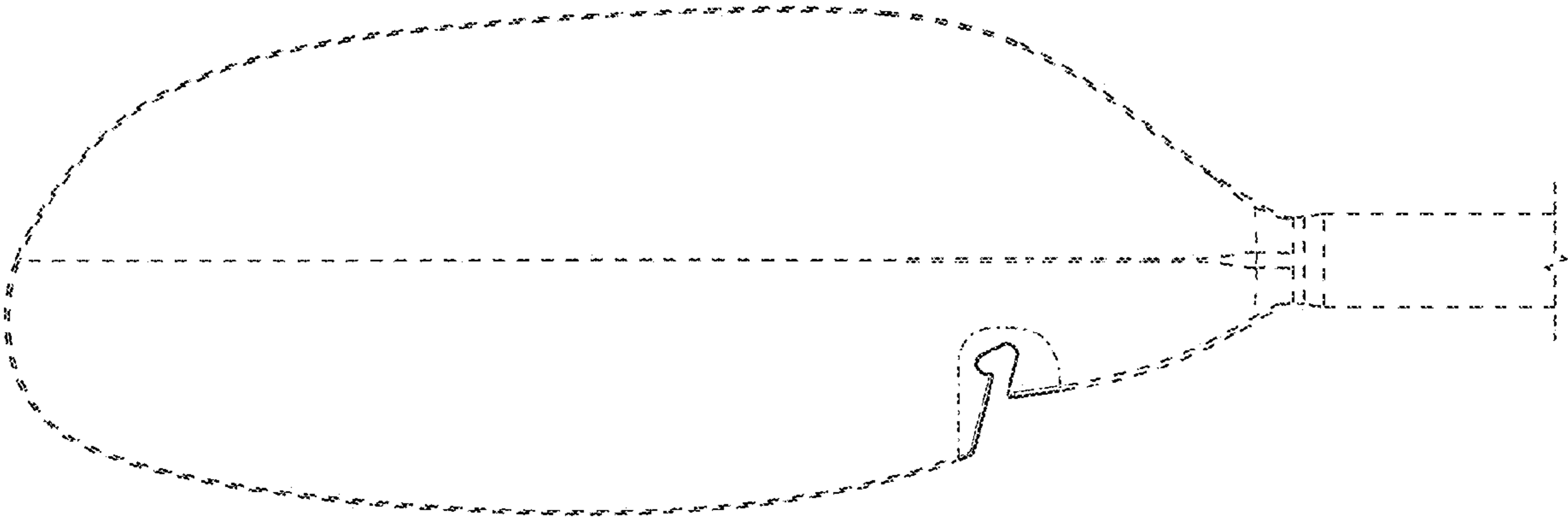

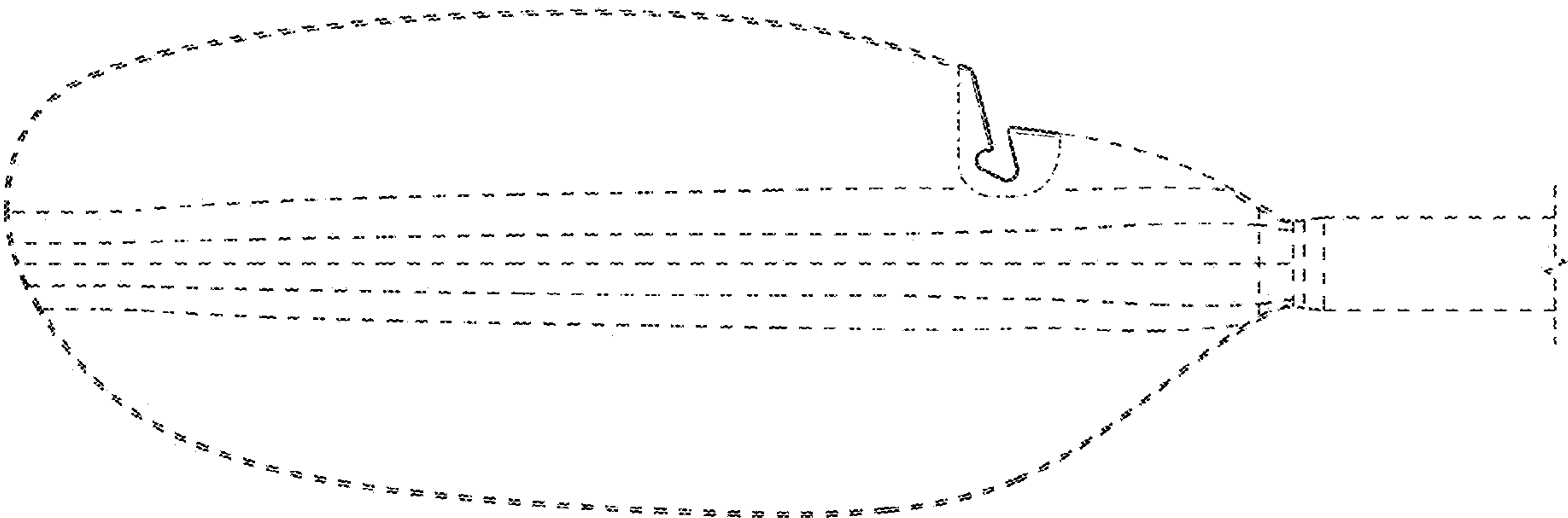
