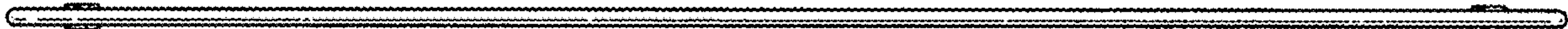
(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a cat scratching pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cat scratching pad showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front elevation view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a rear elevation view thereof.

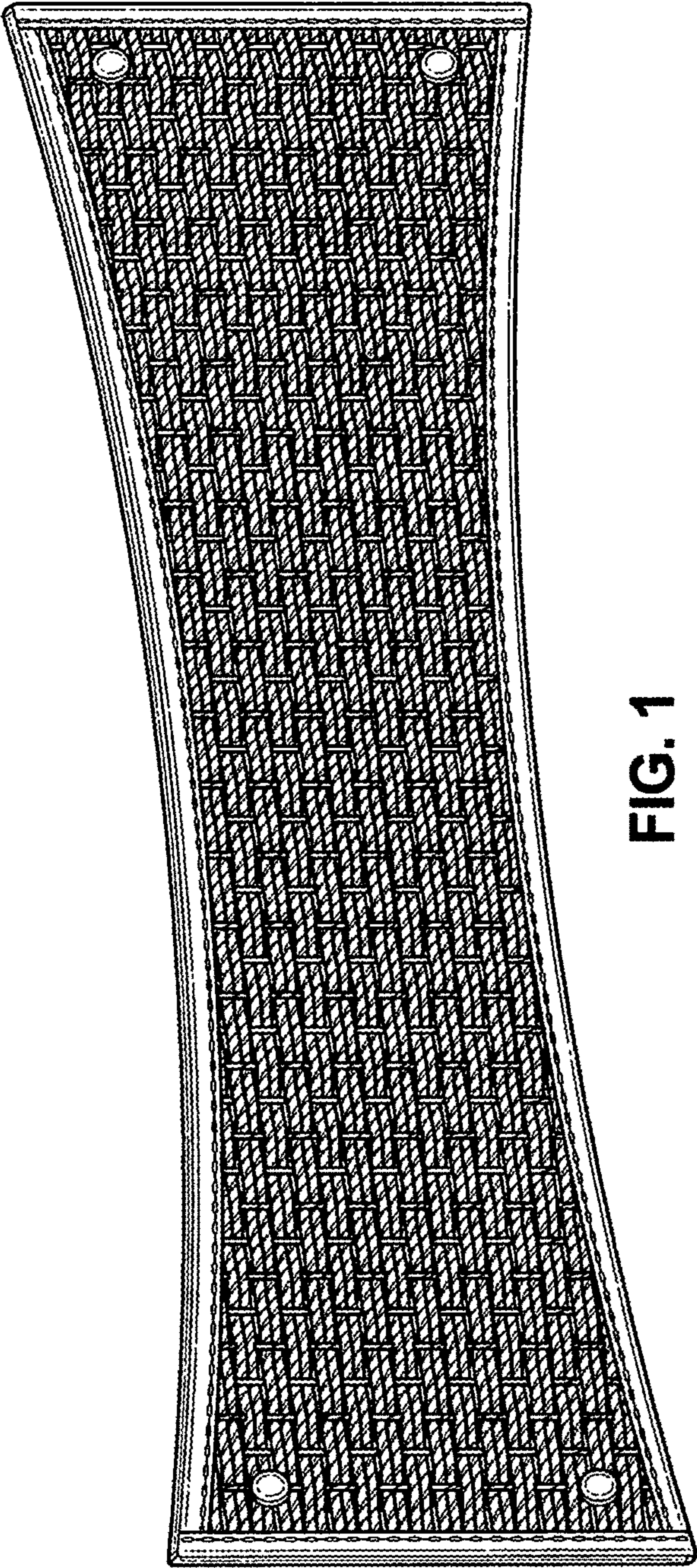

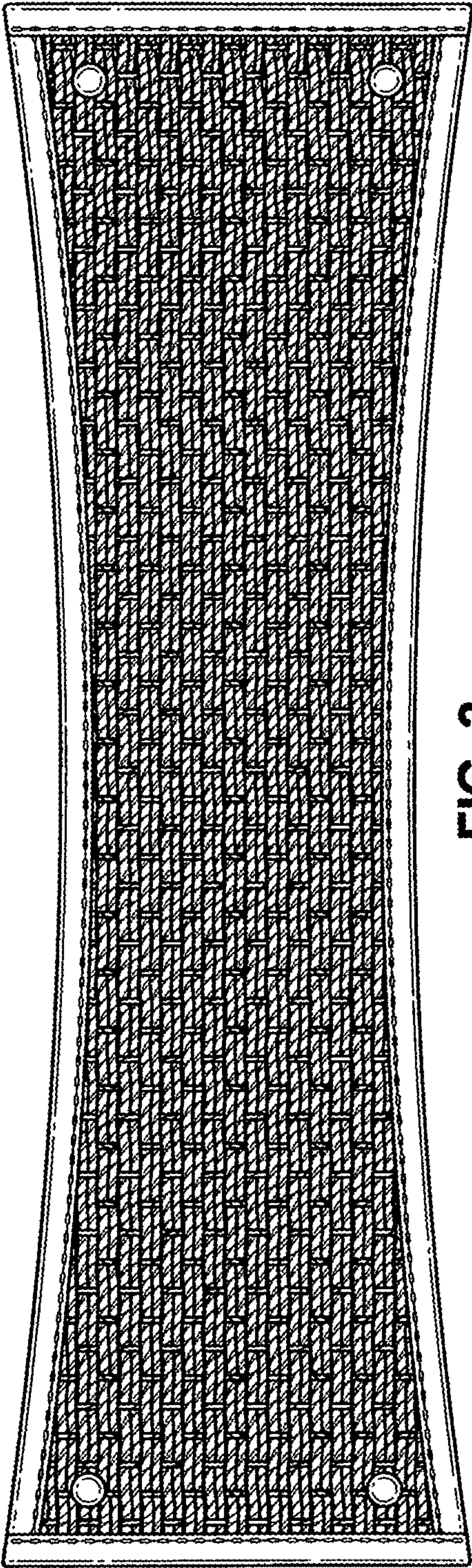

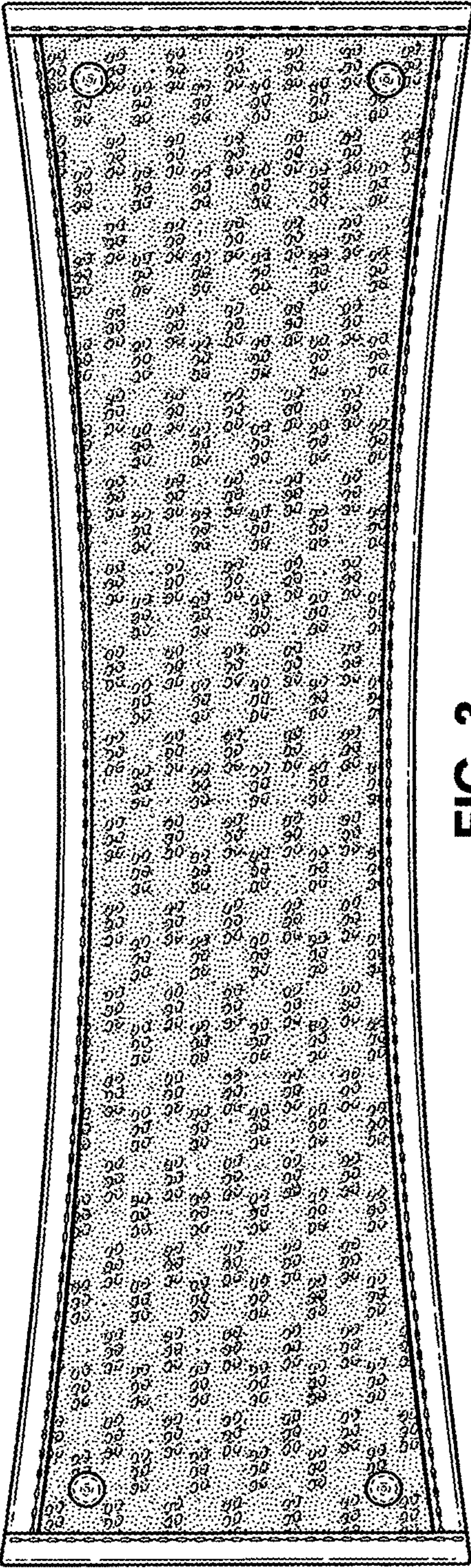
