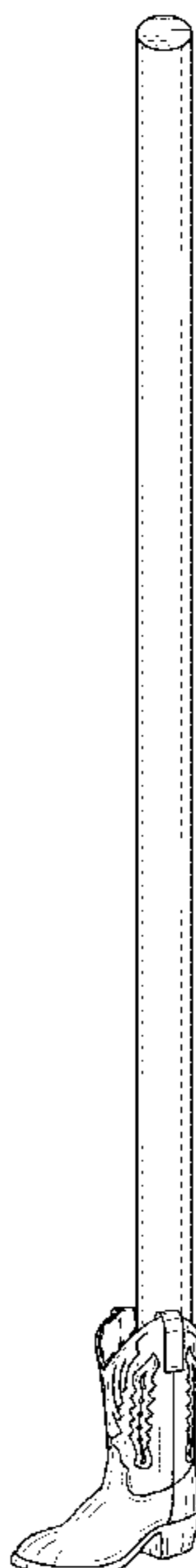
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a walking cane, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a walking cane; and FIG. 2 is a front plan view thereof; and FIG. 3 is rear plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof. The broken lines depict portions of the article that form no part of the claimed design.

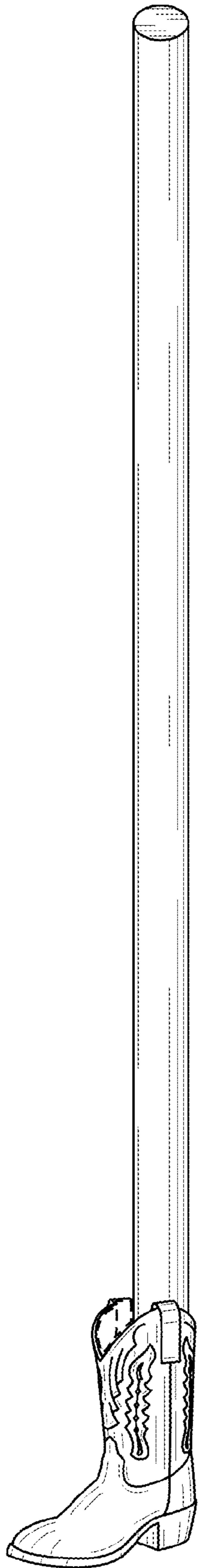

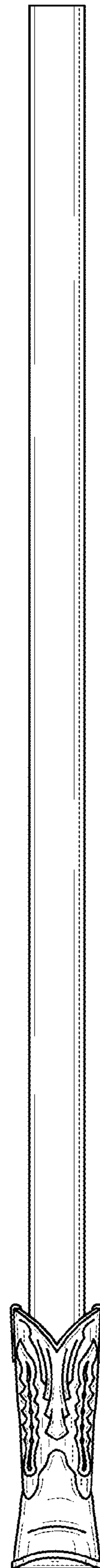

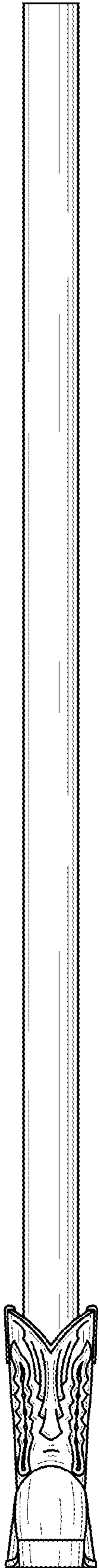

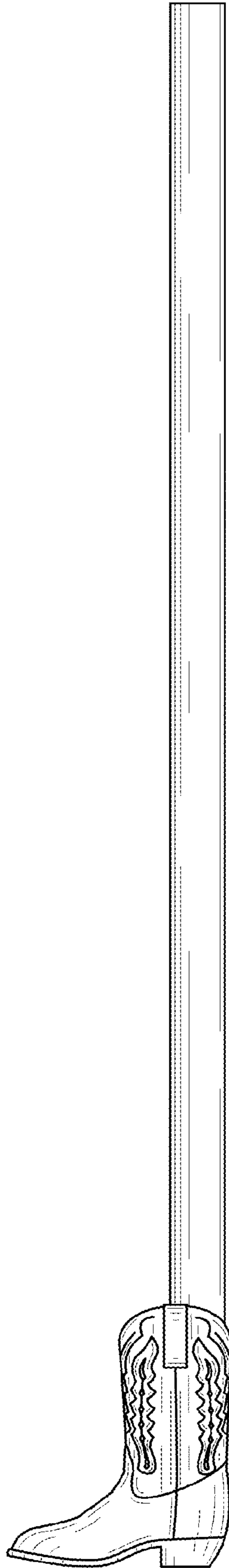

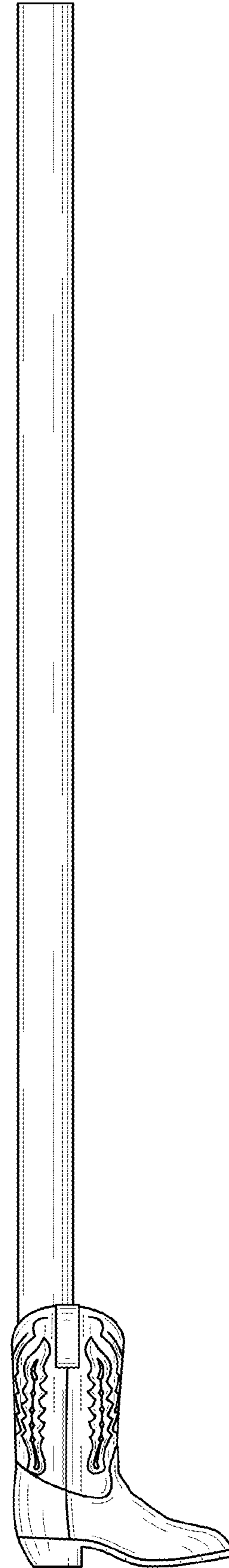
