We claim the ornamental design for a snake bottle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a first top perspective view of the snake bottle of the present invention;

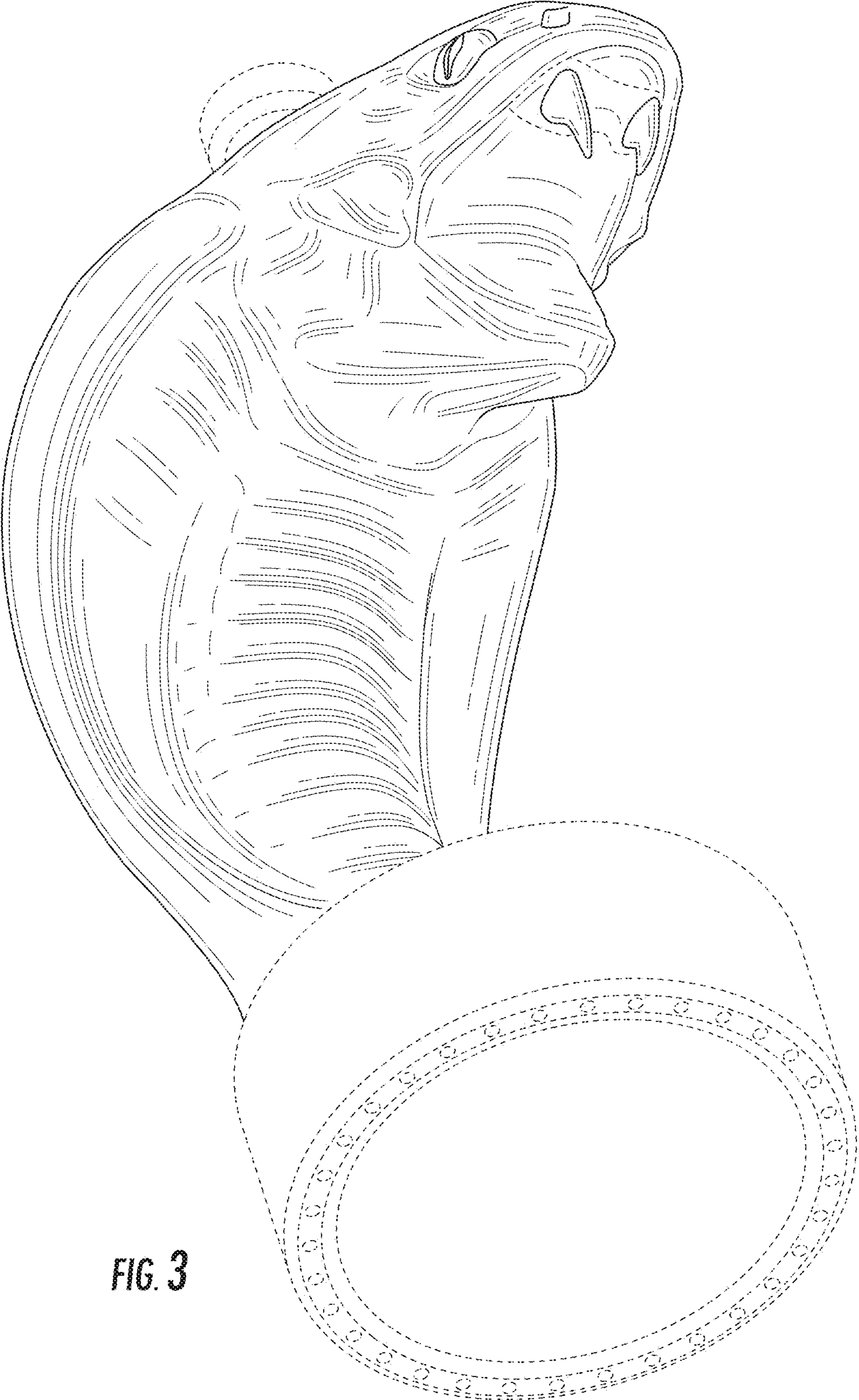

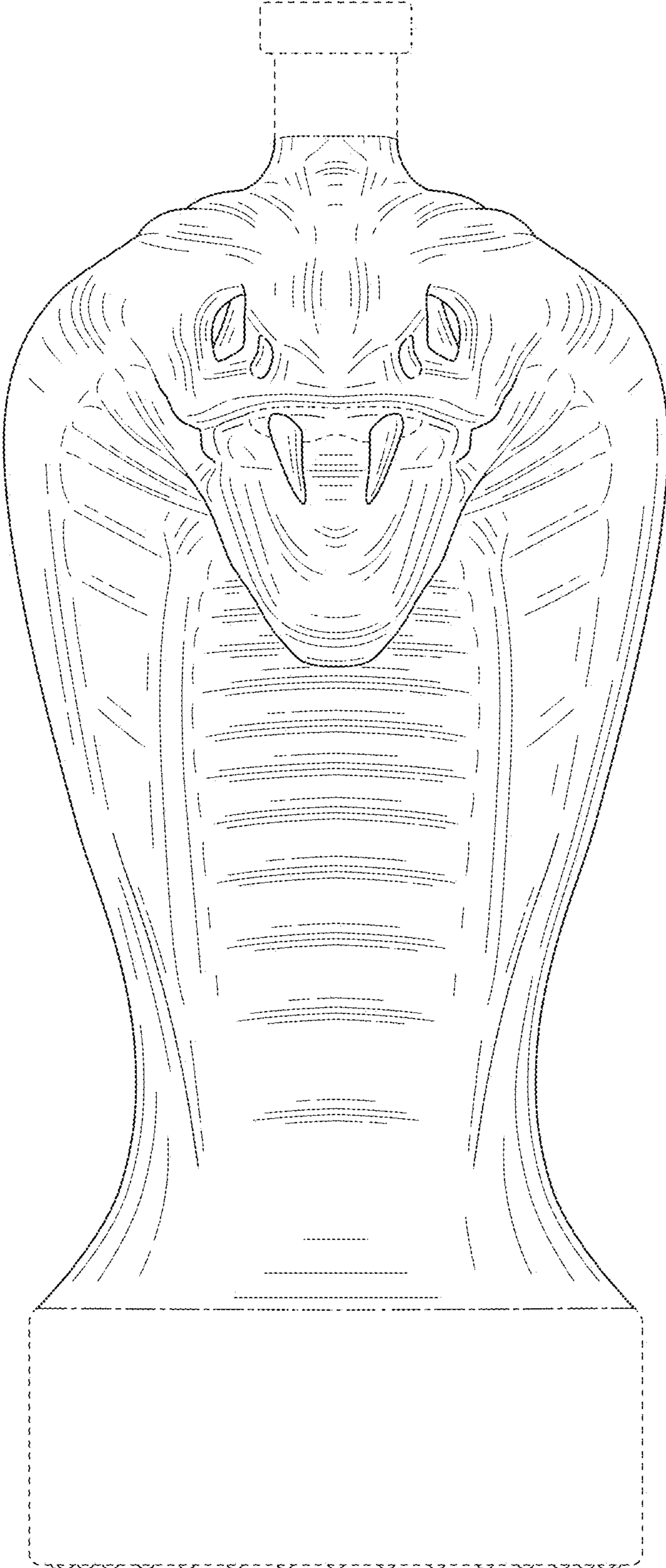

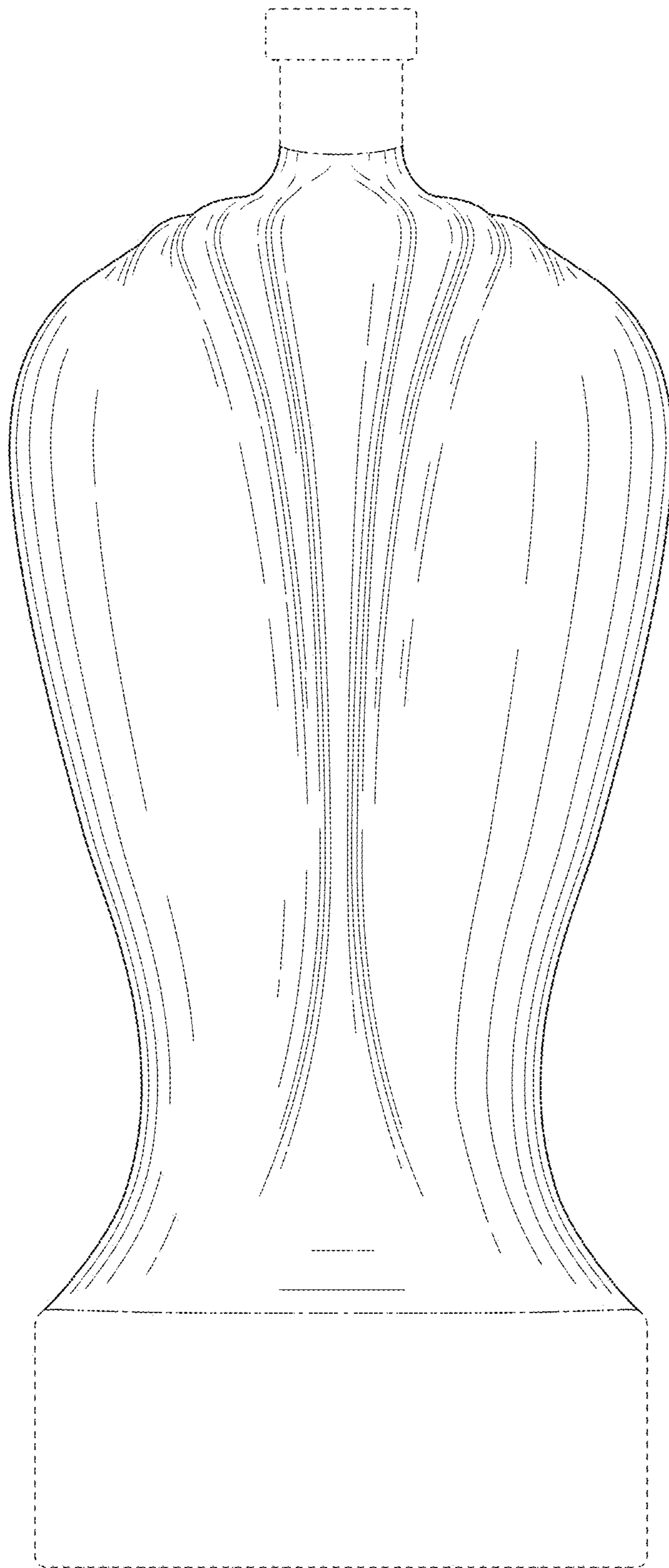

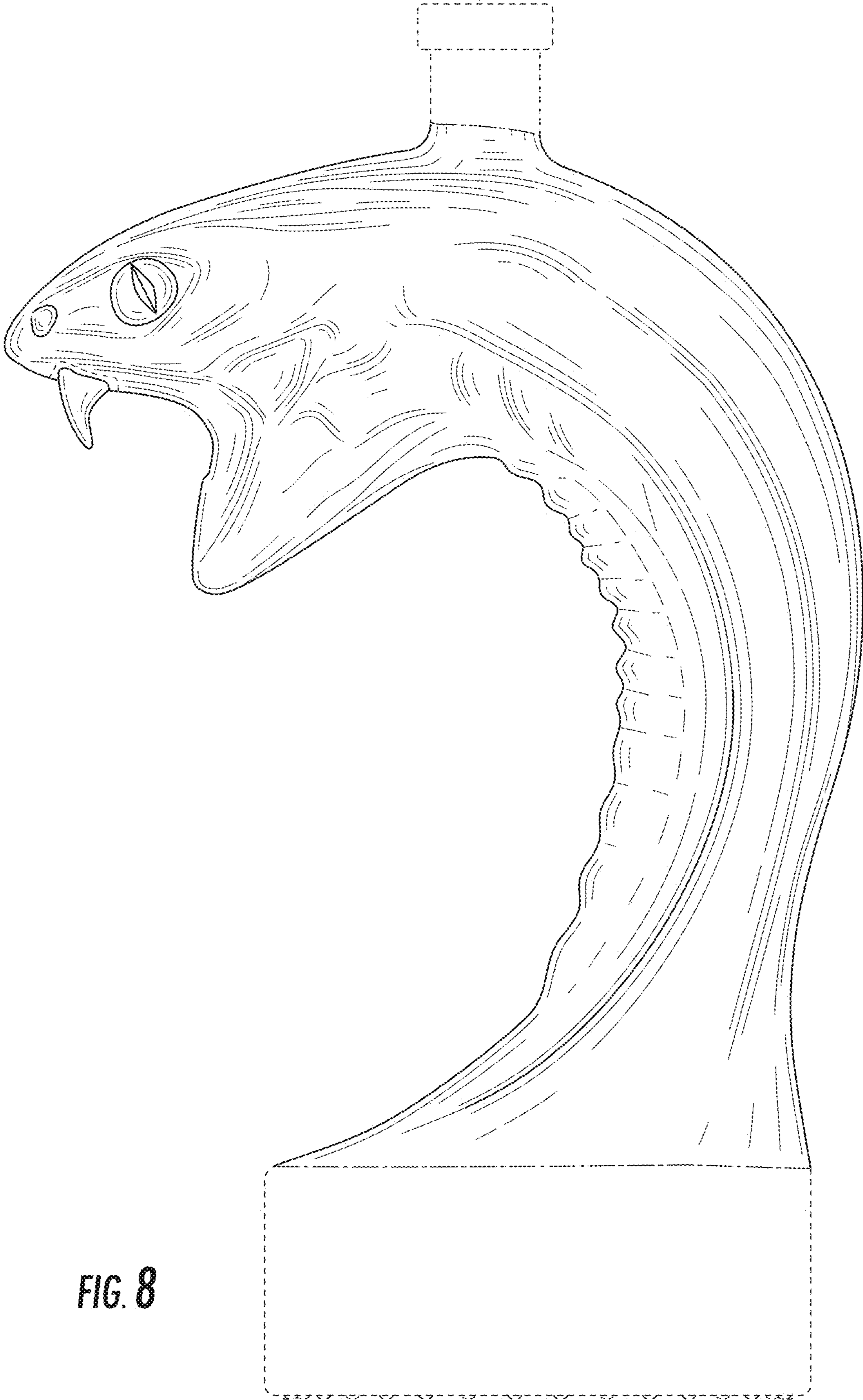

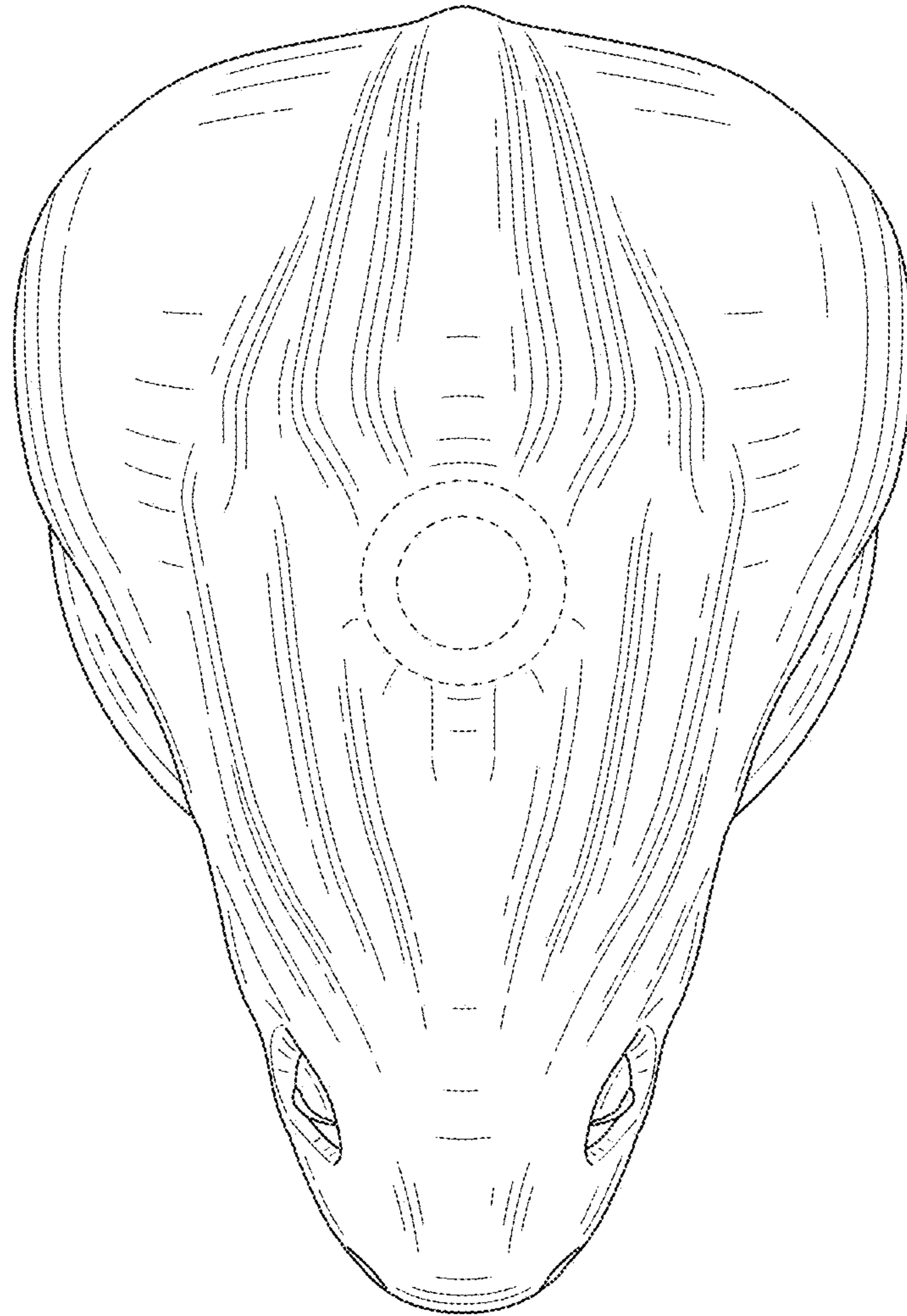

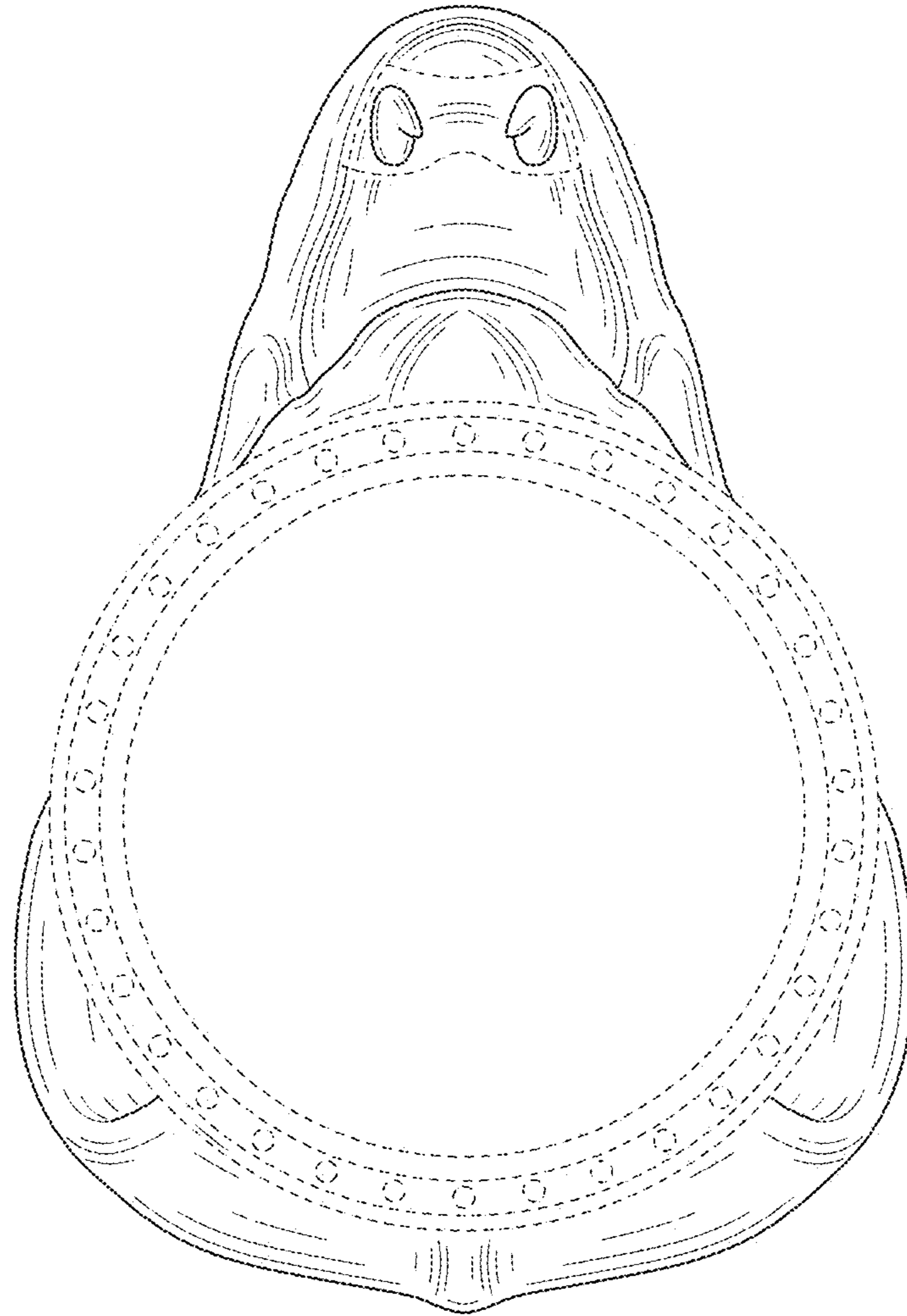
