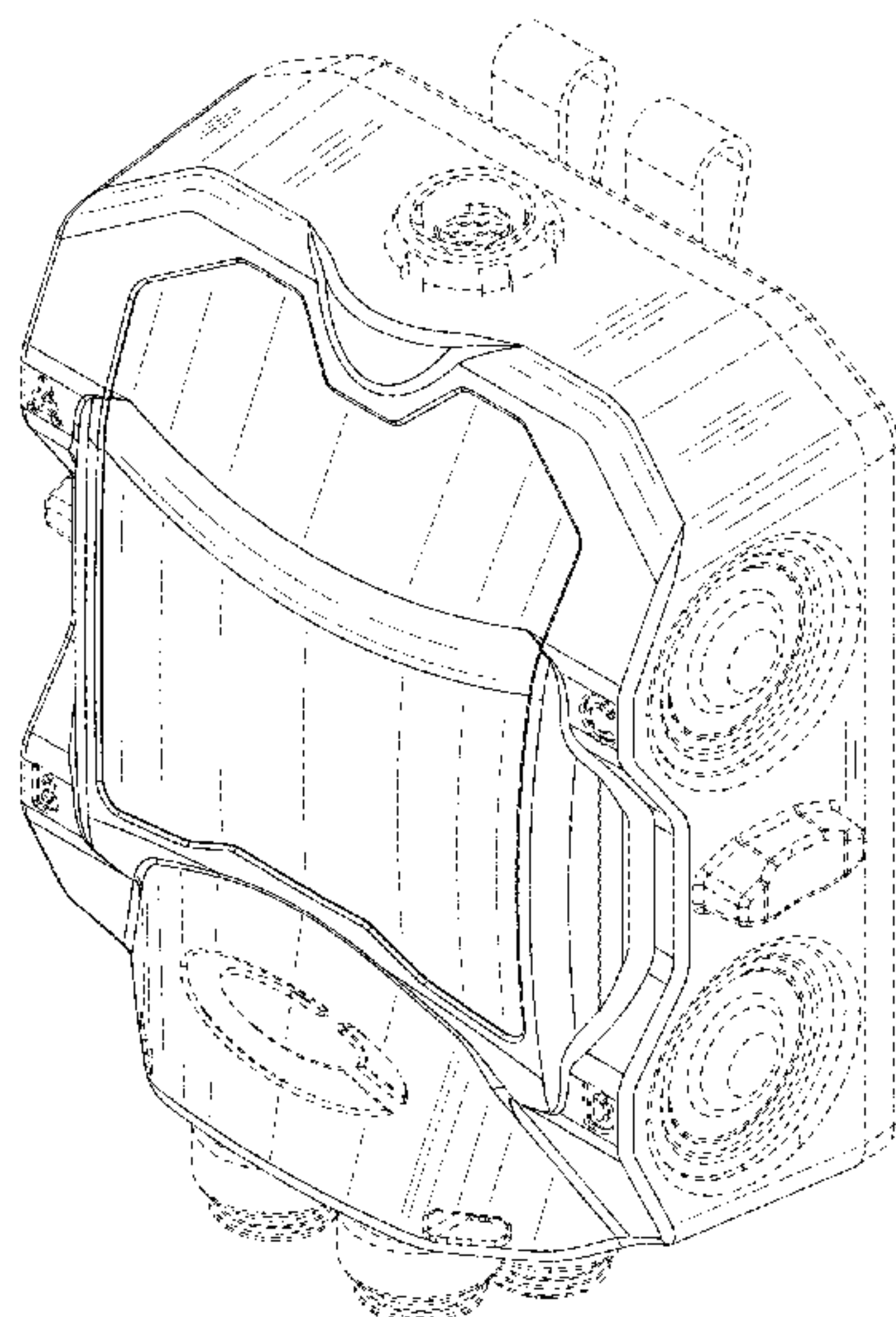
The ornamental design for a communication module, as

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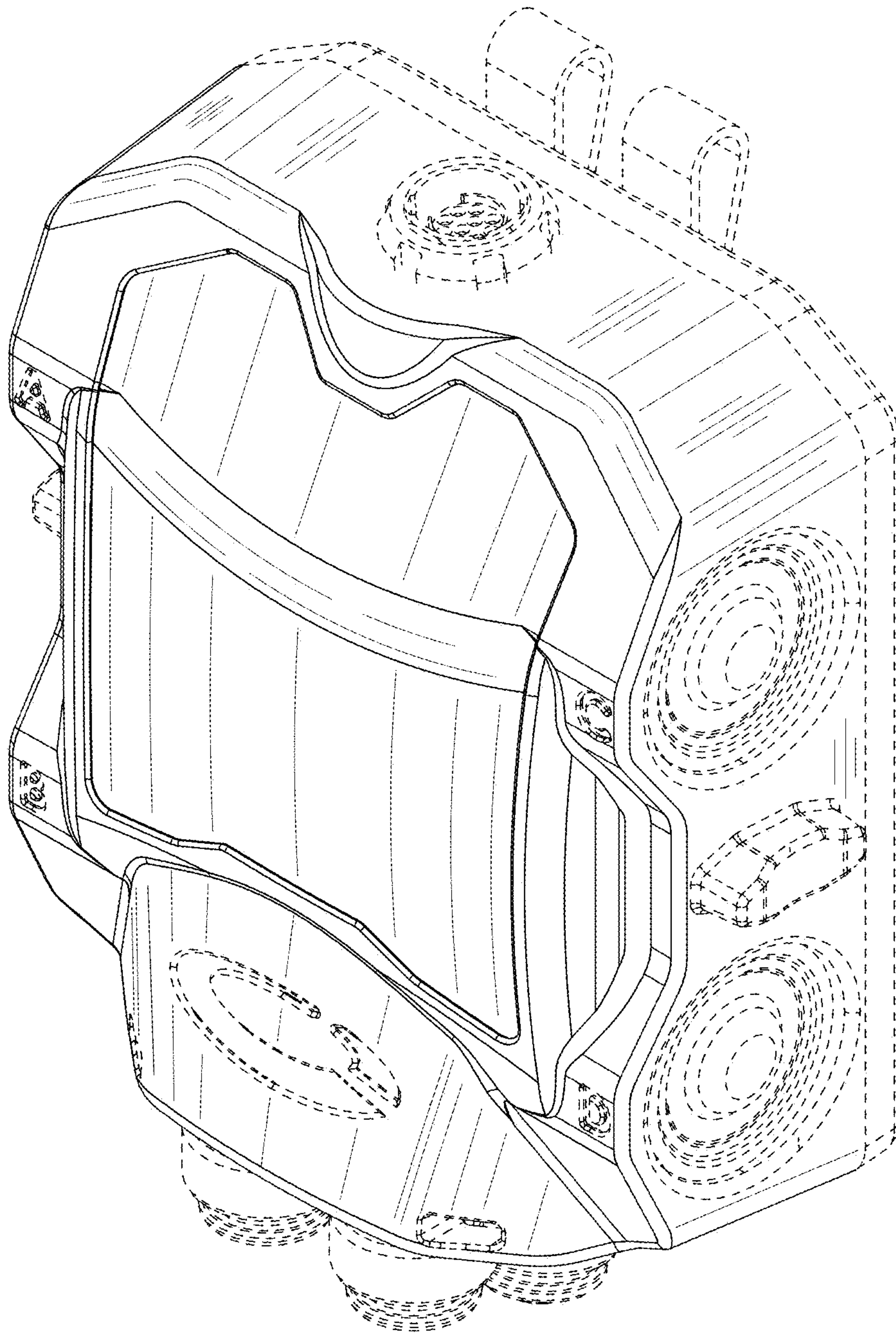

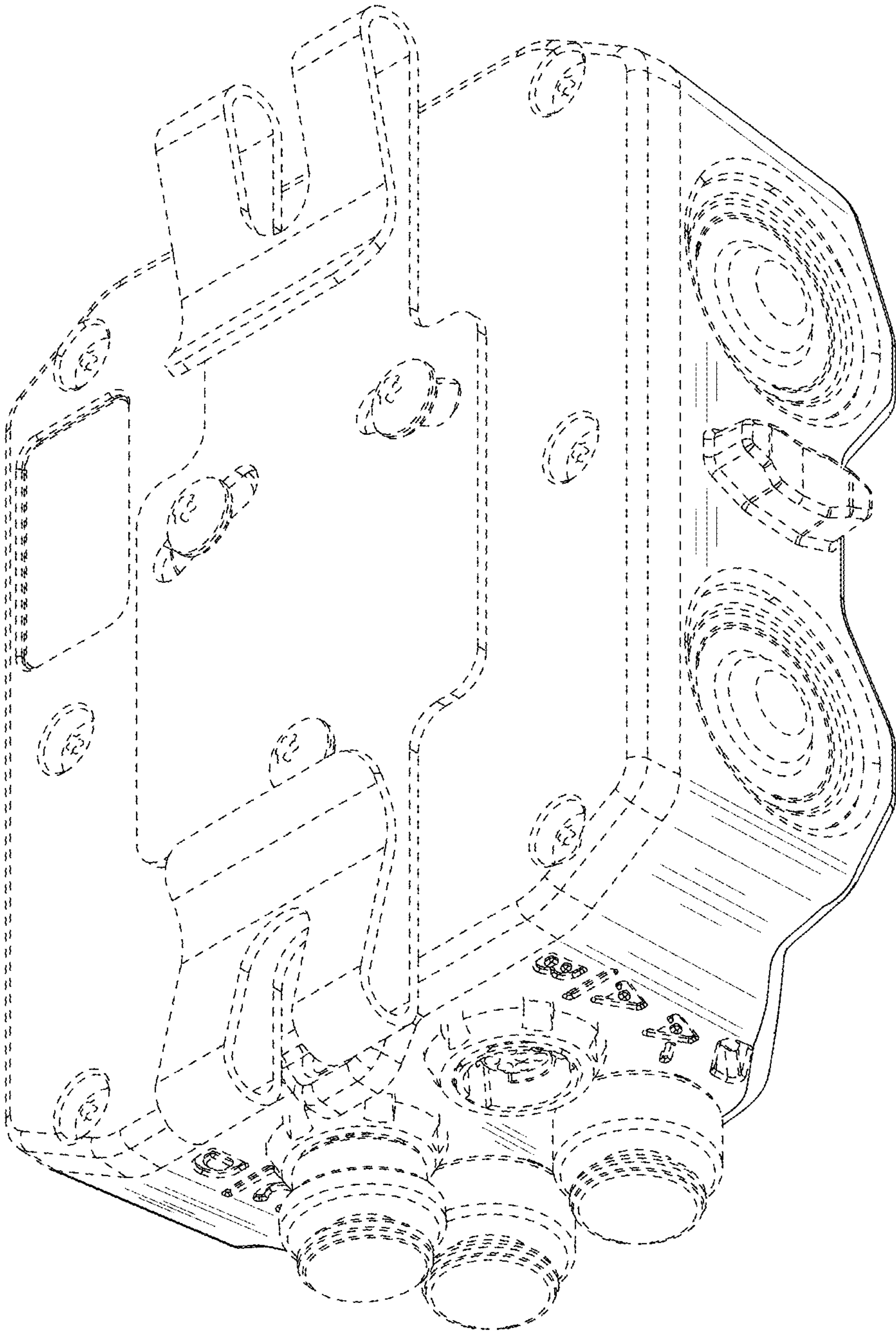

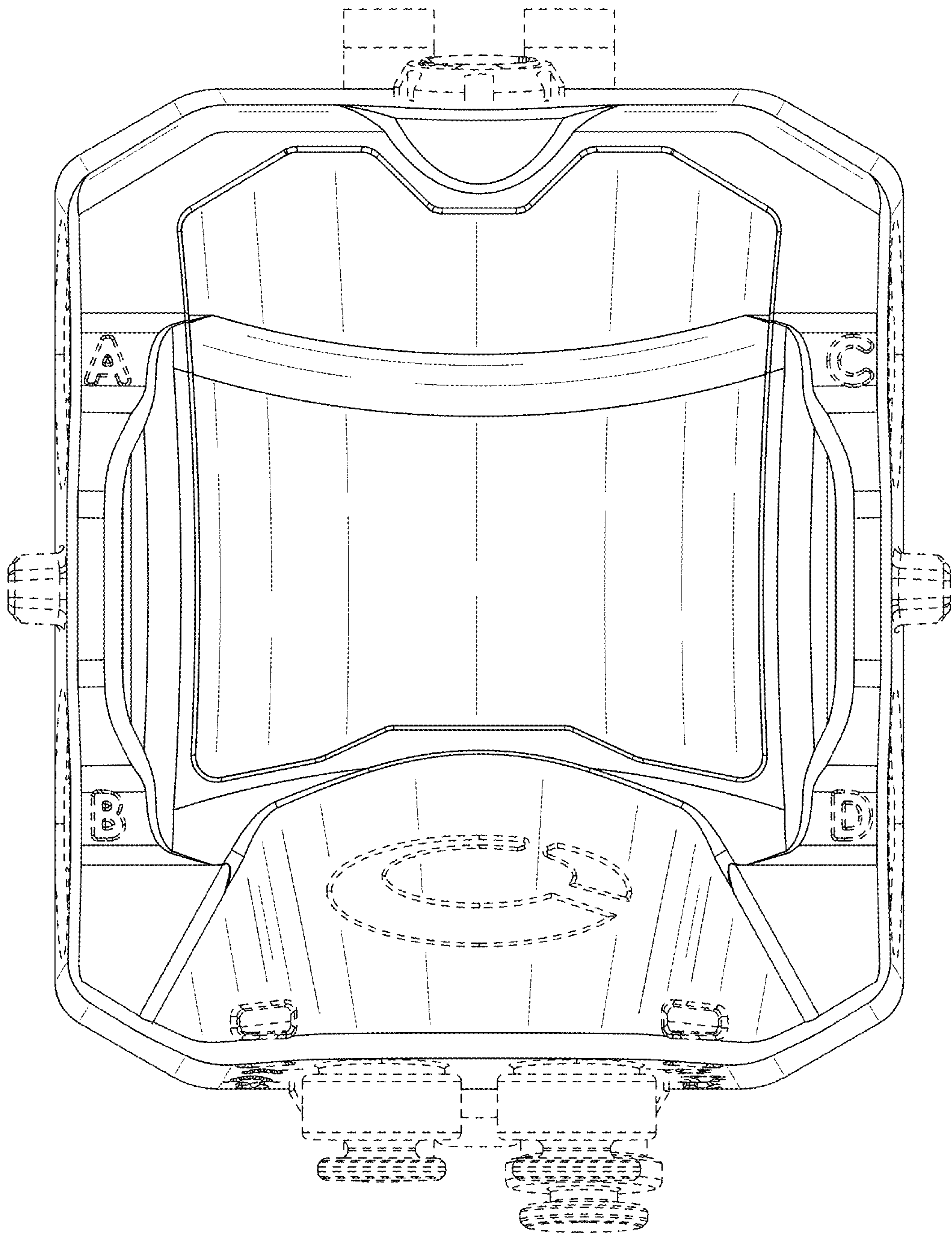

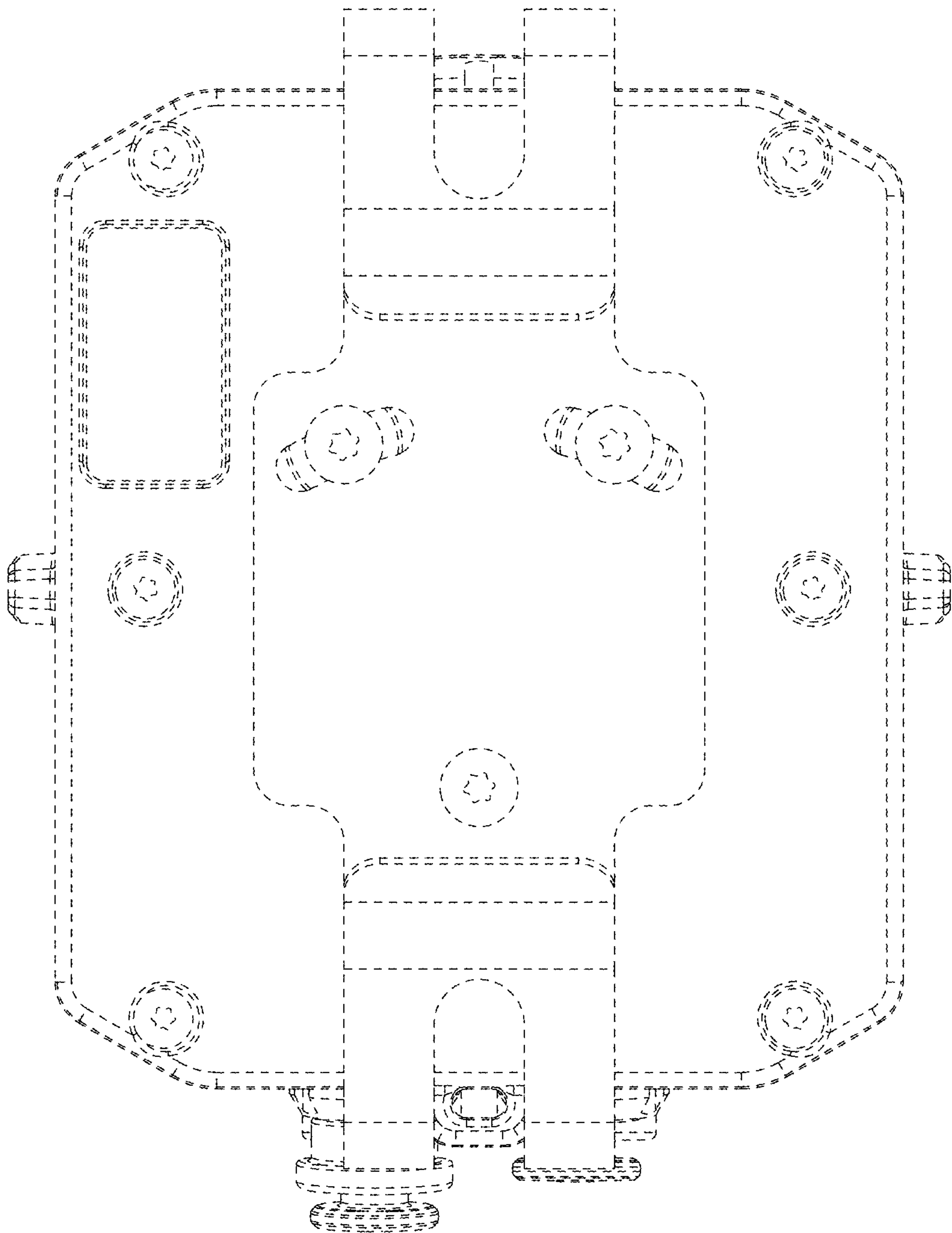

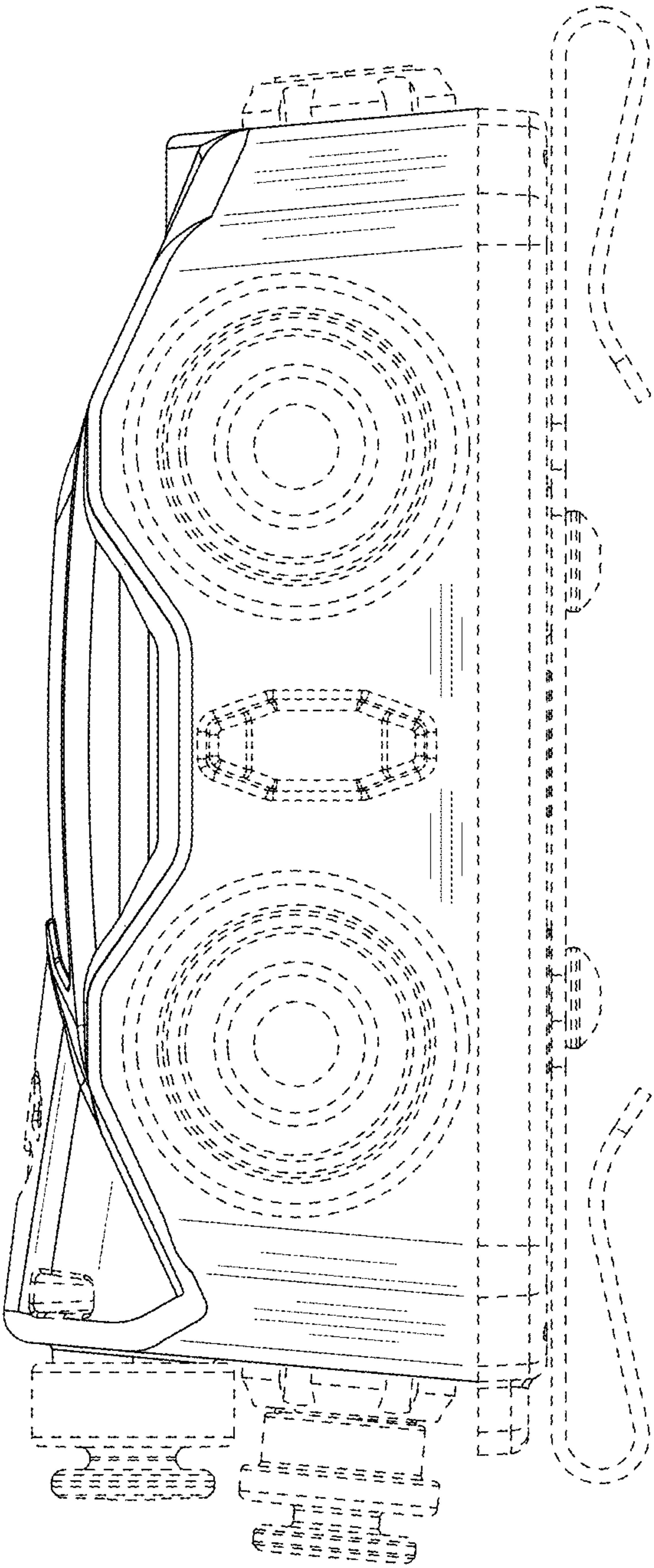

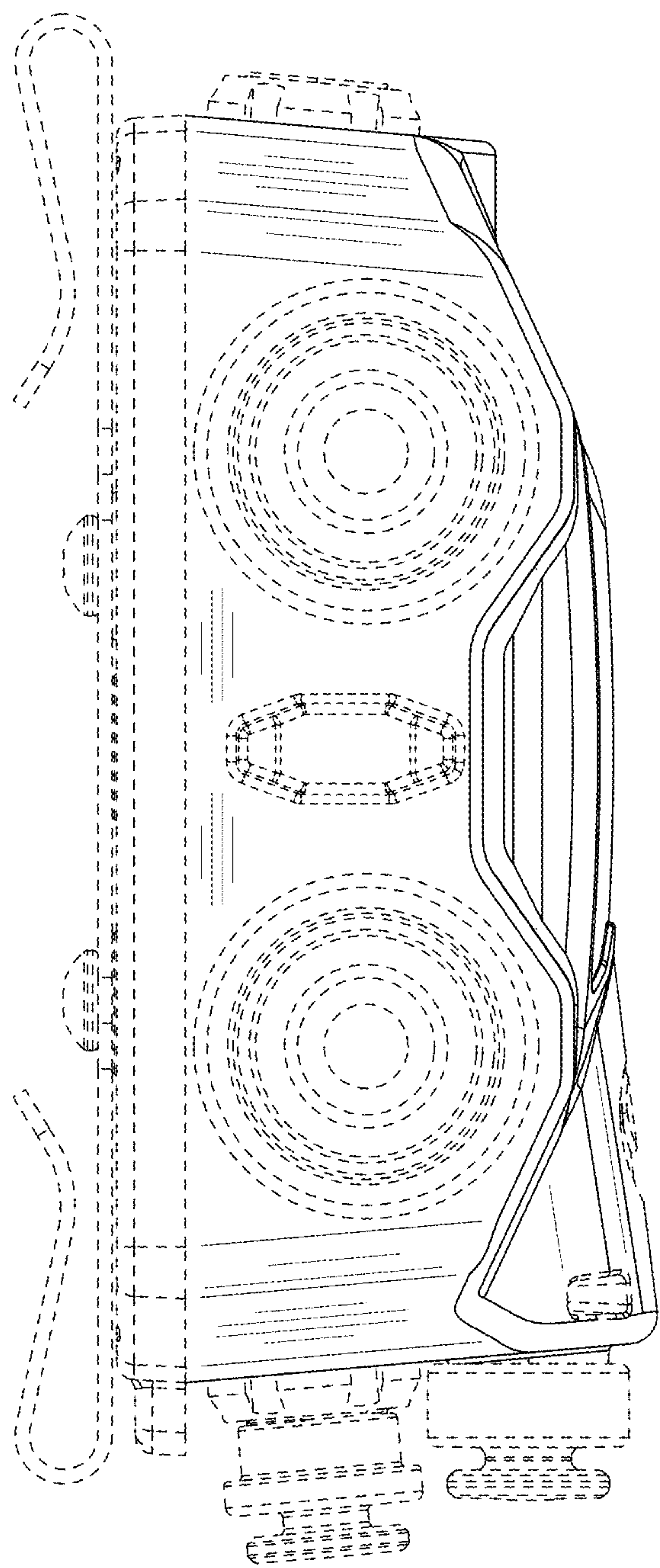

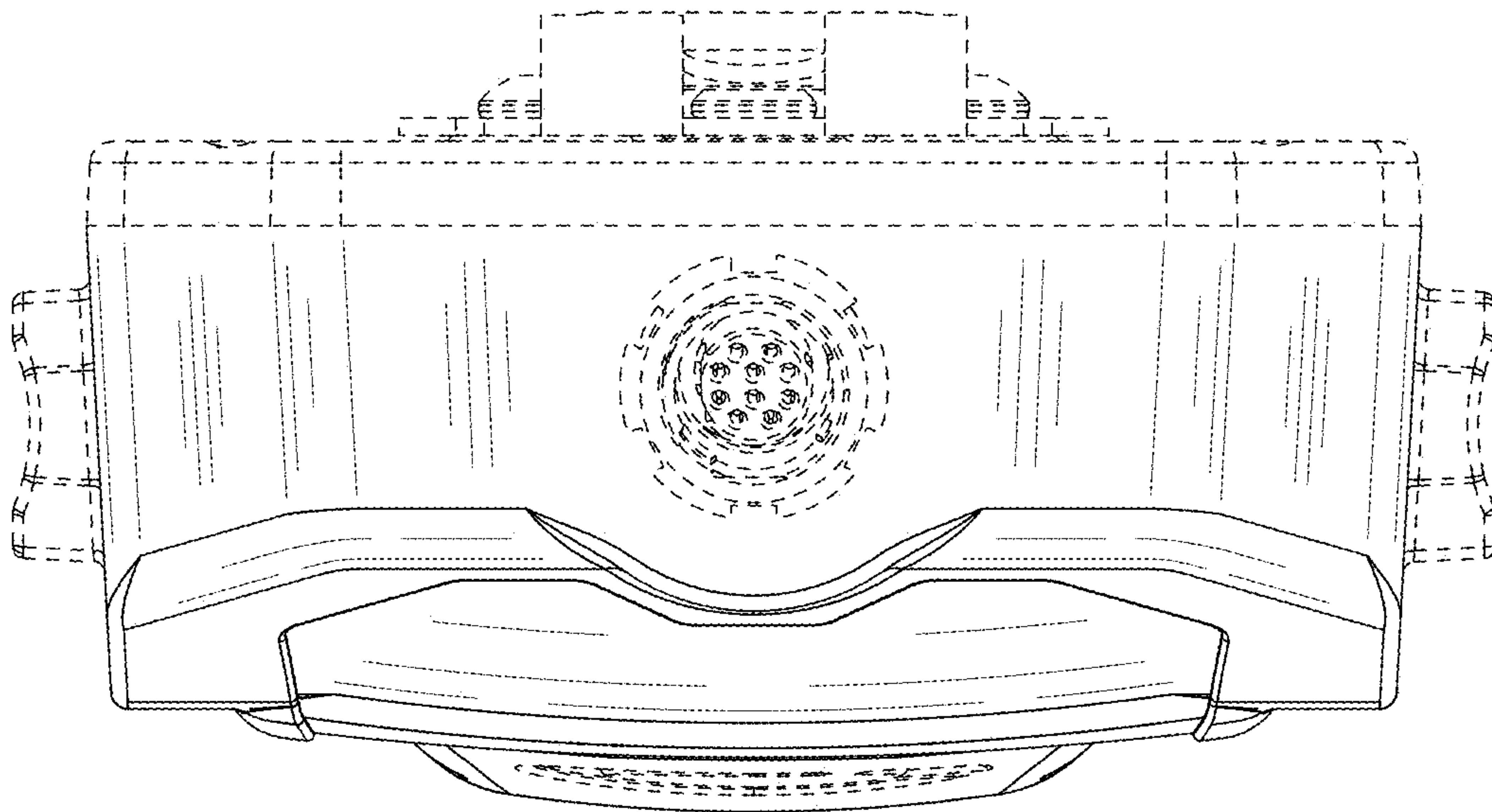

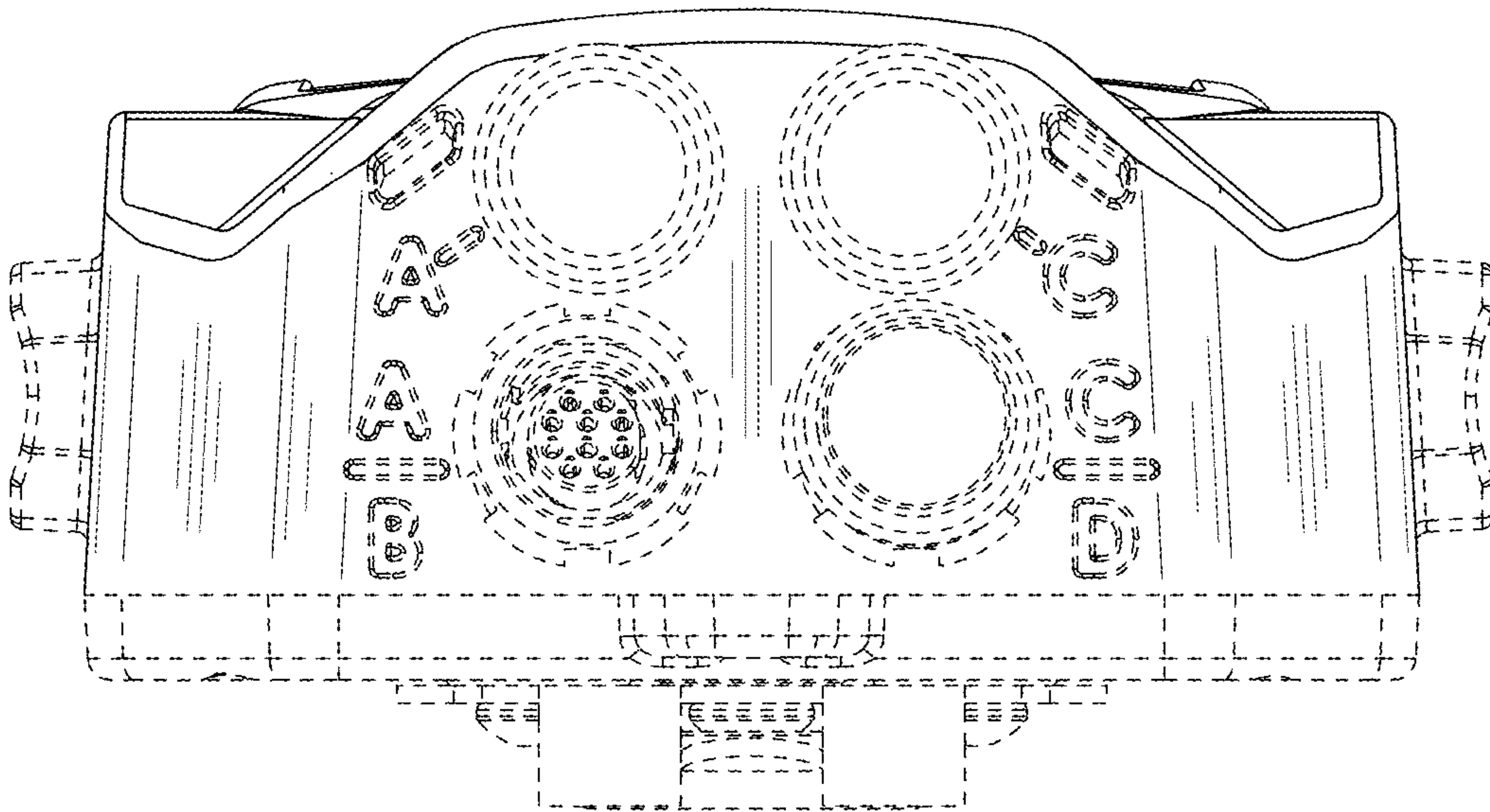
