The ornamental design for a collapsible glass microwave cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a collapsible glass microwave food cover, showing my new design in an expanded configuration;

FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 1, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a top perspective view thereof, illustrated in a collapsed configuration;

FIG. 8 is a bottom perspective view of FIG. 7;

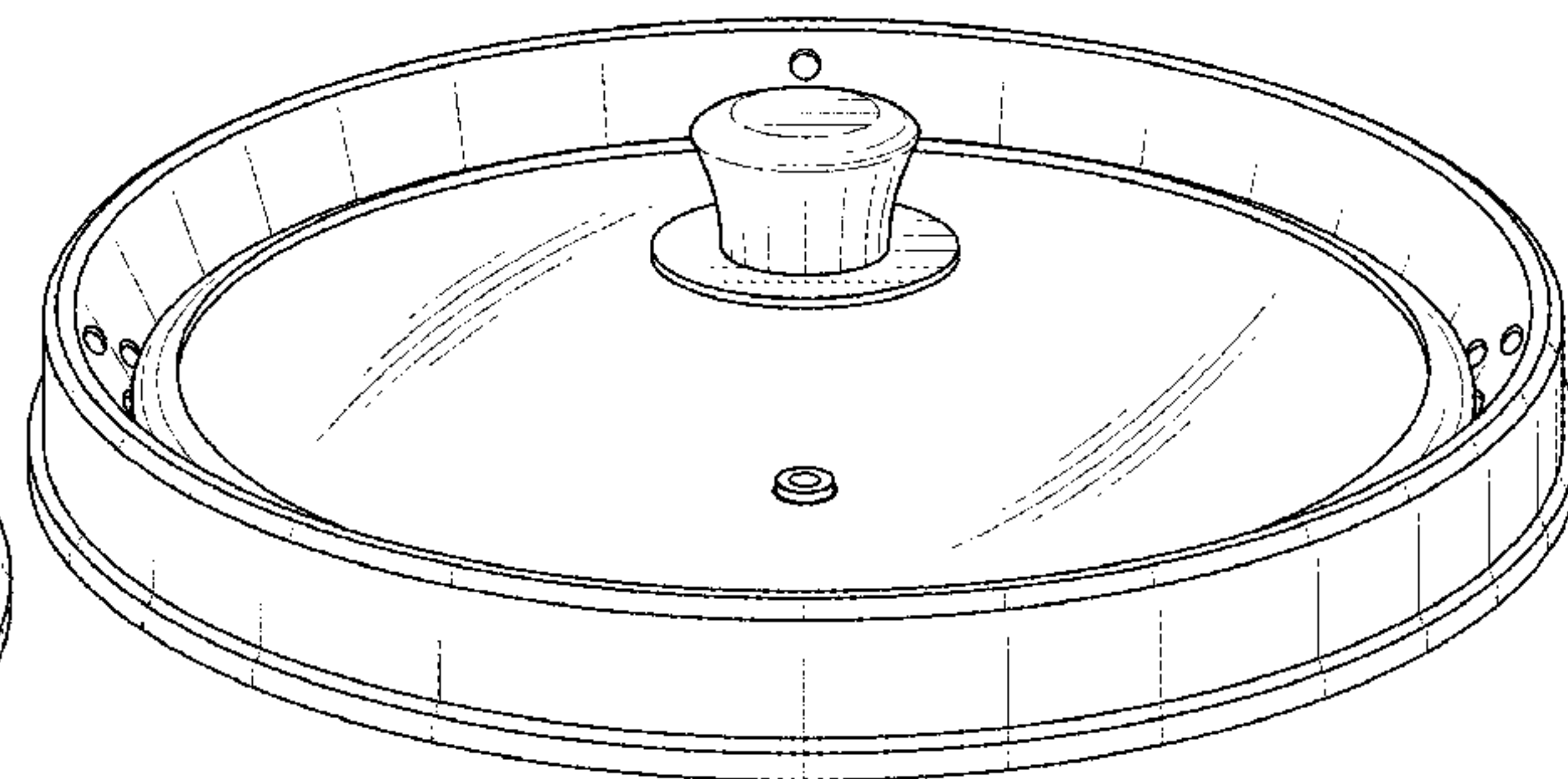
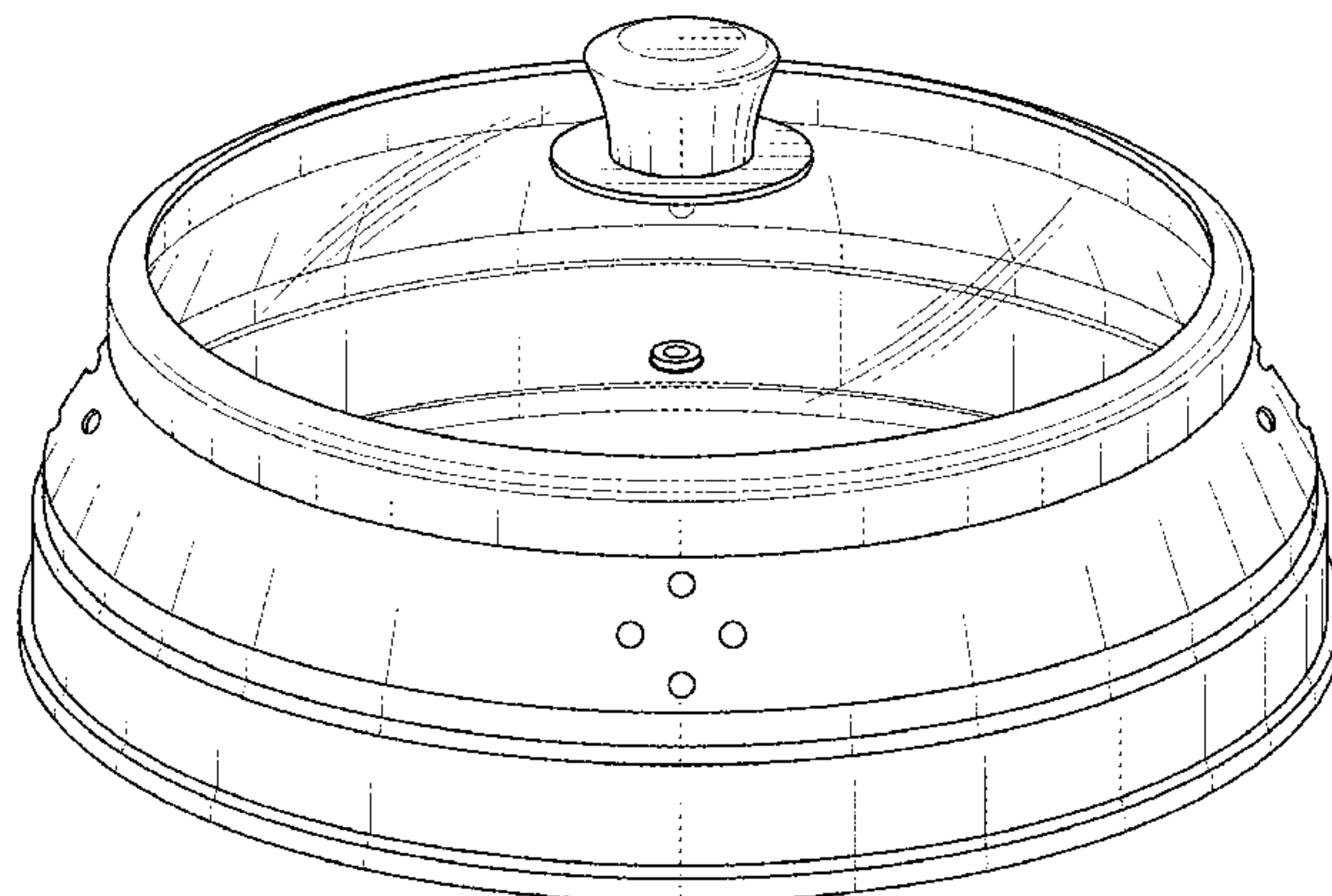
FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

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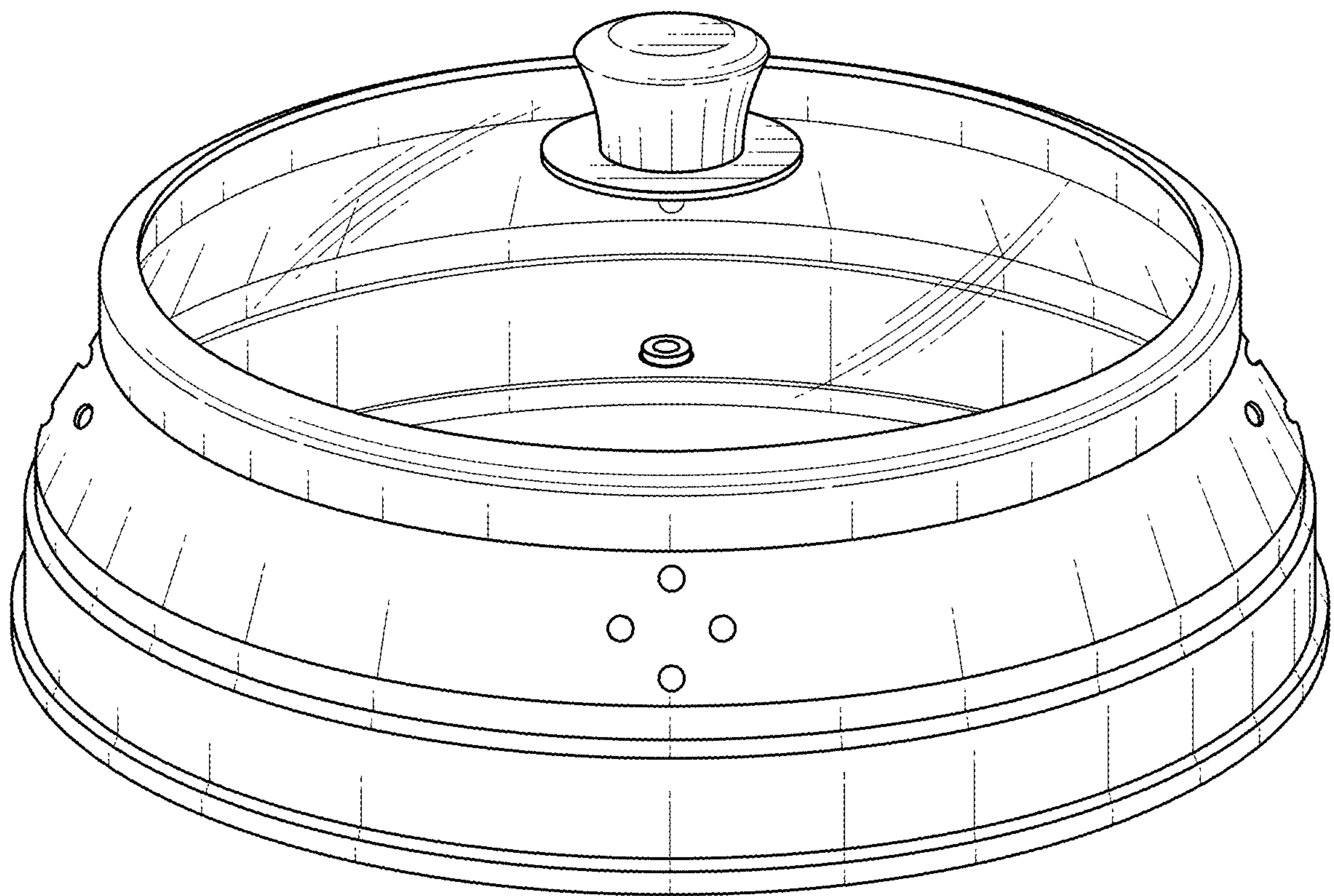

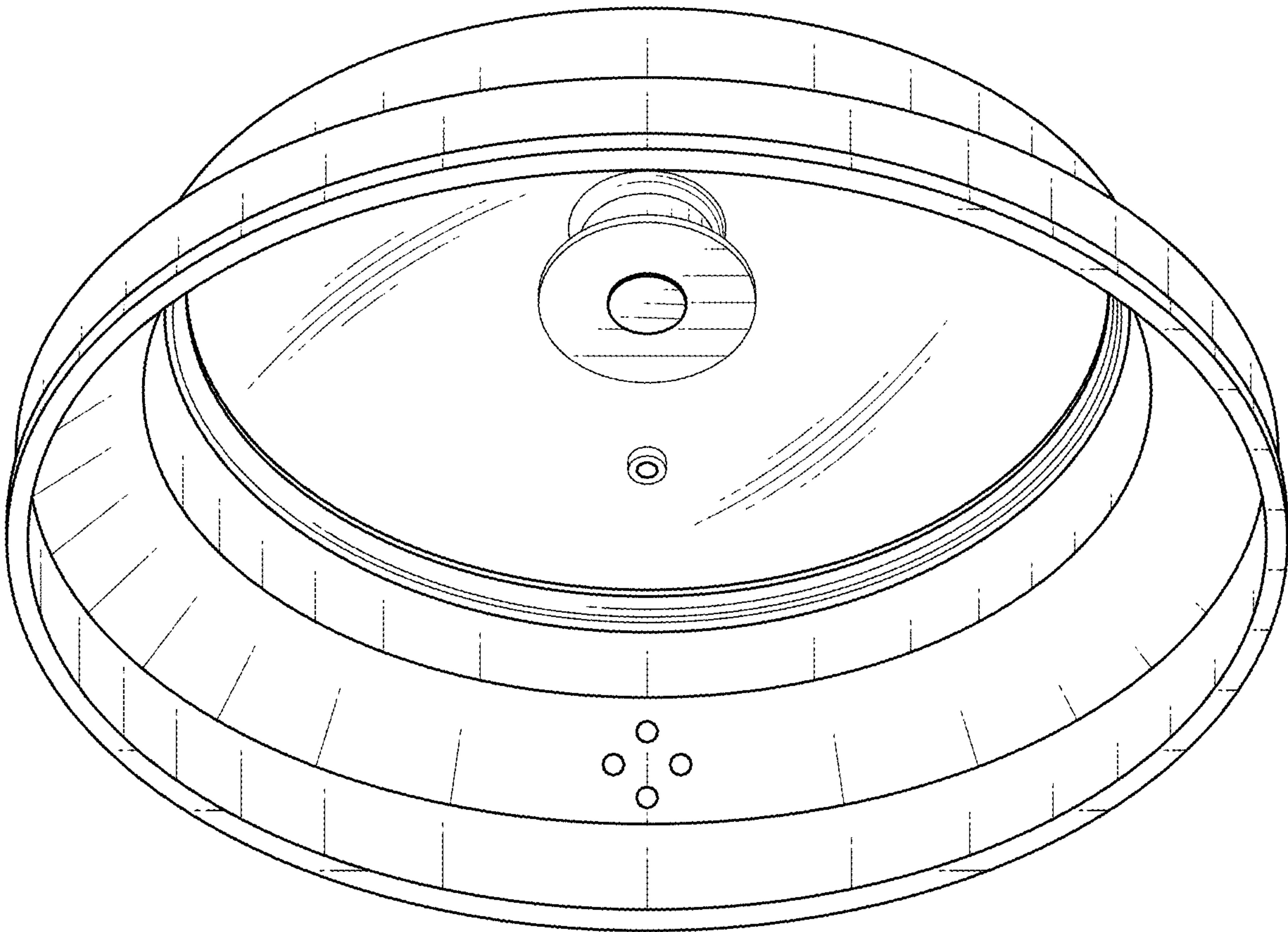

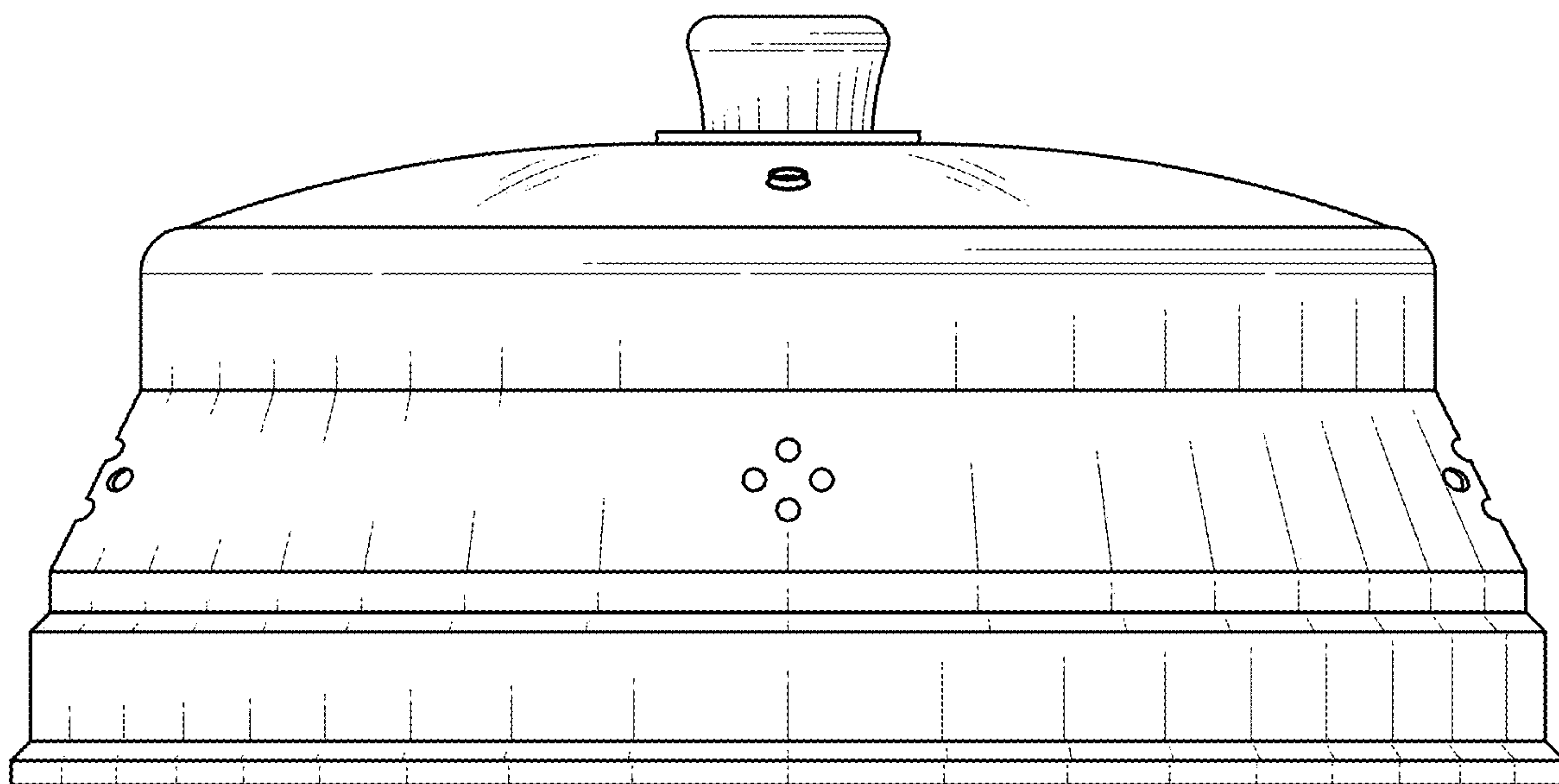

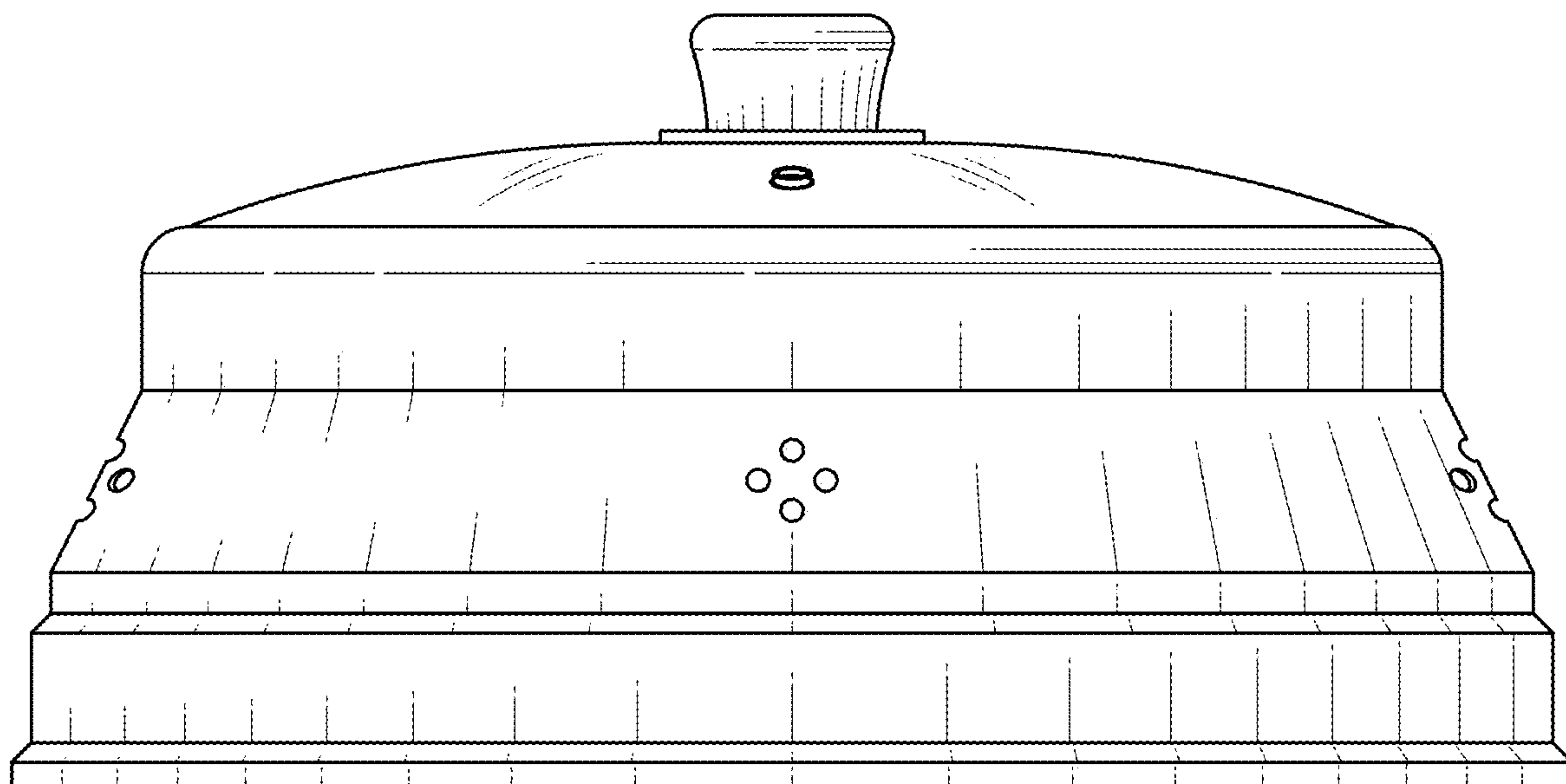

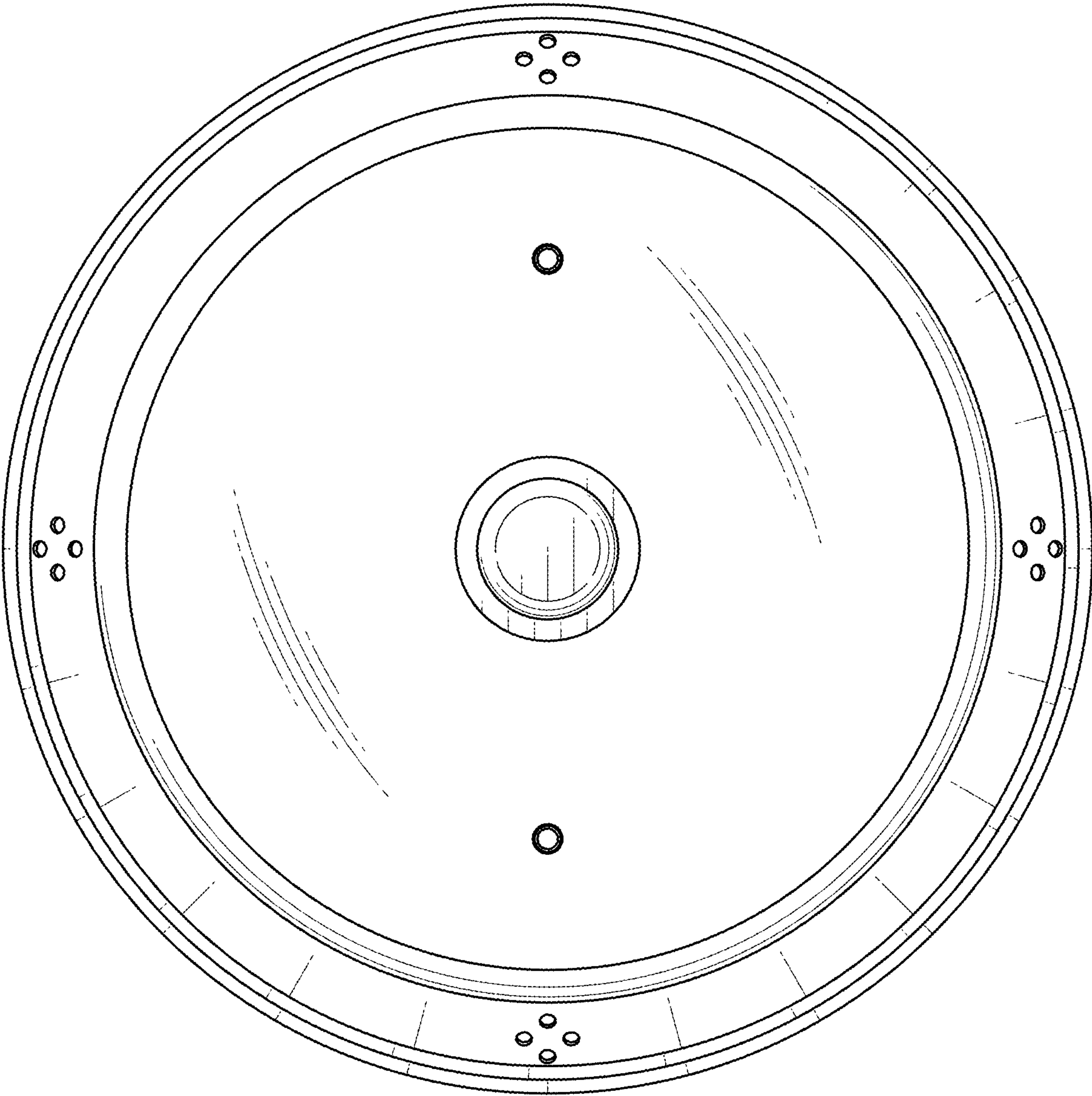

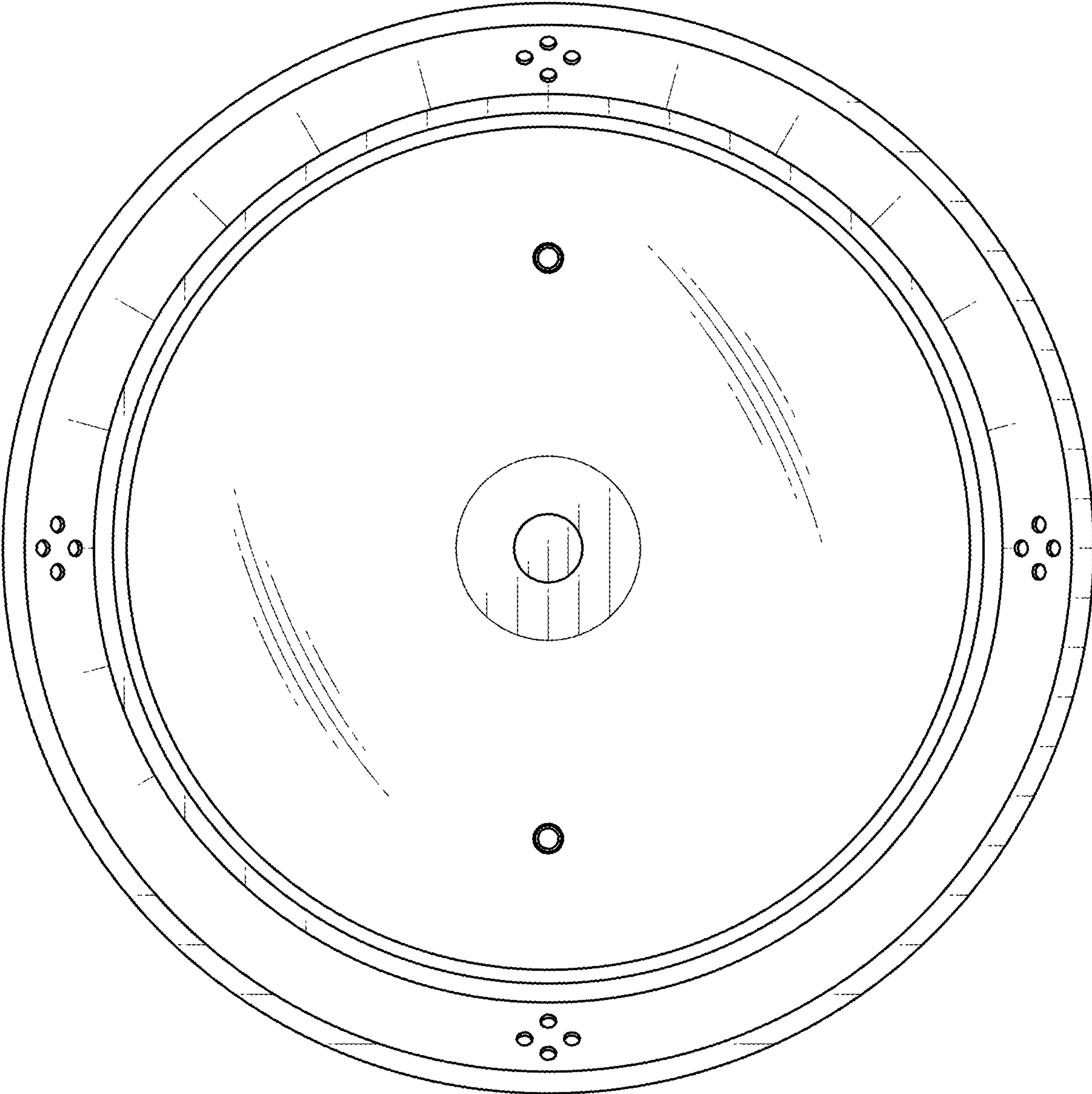

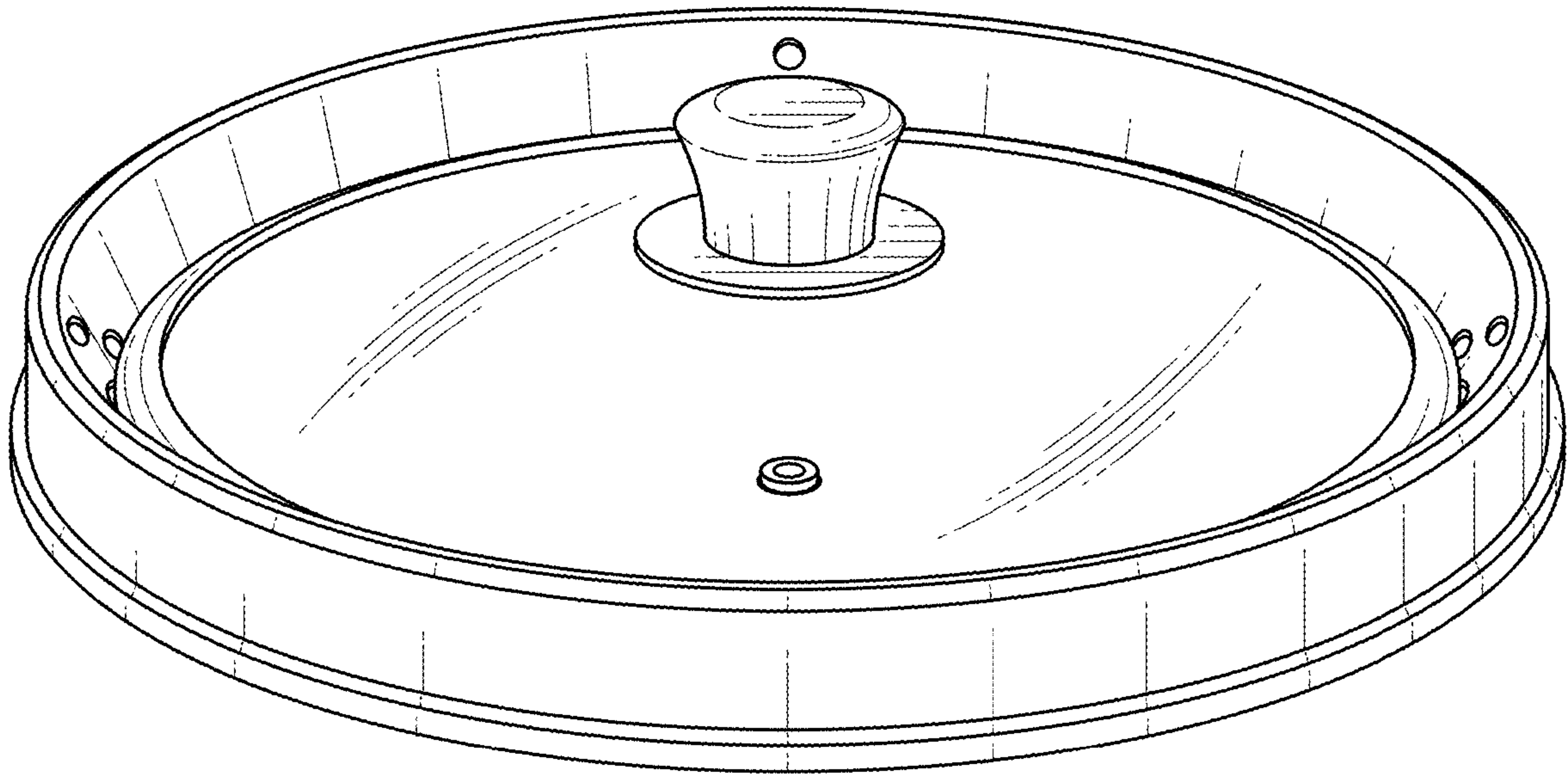

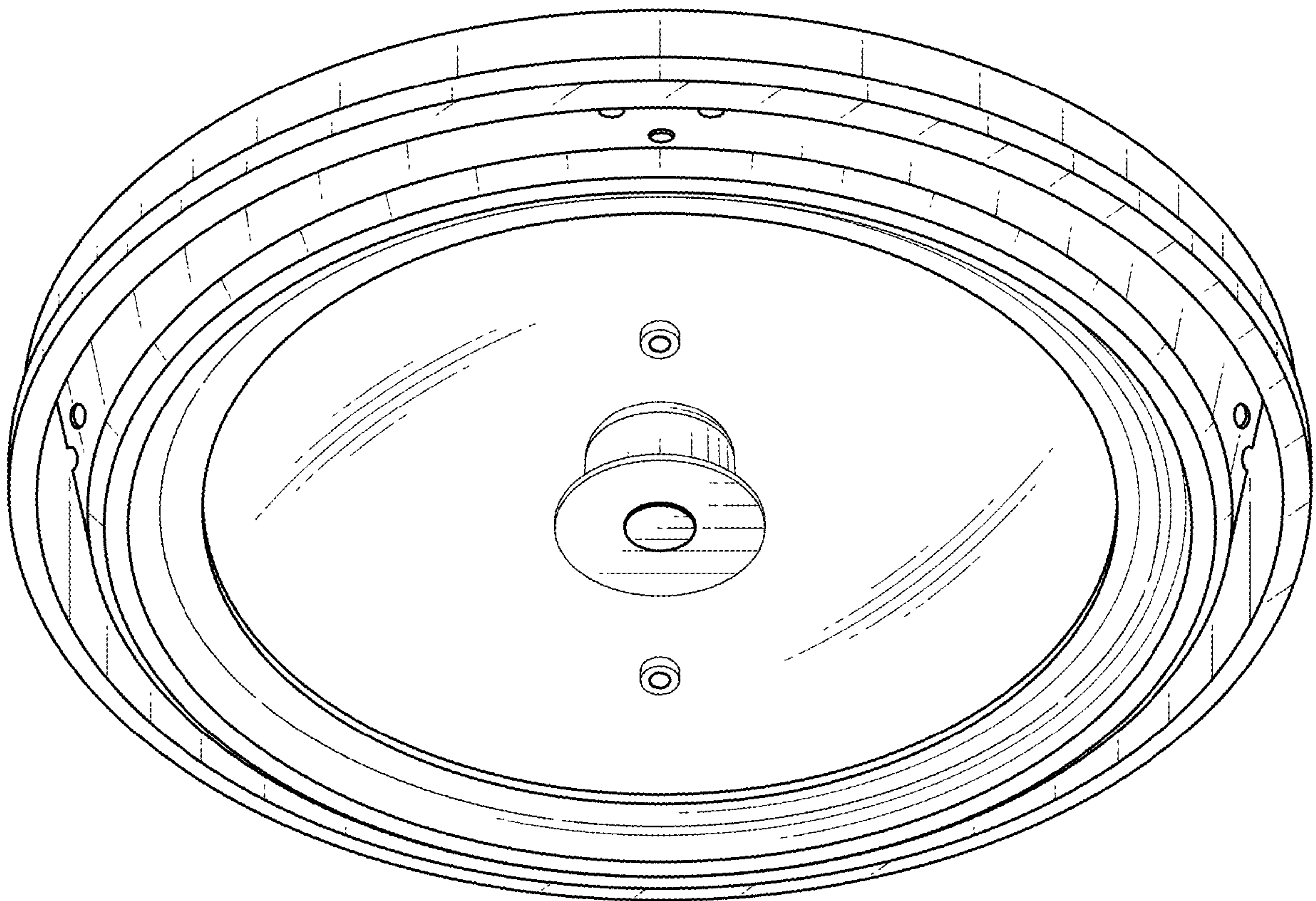

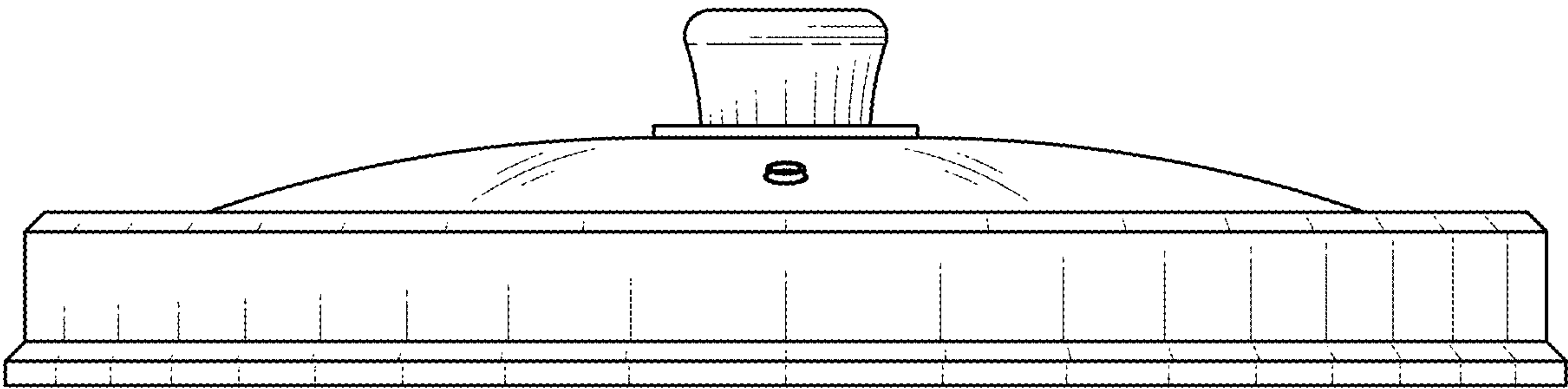

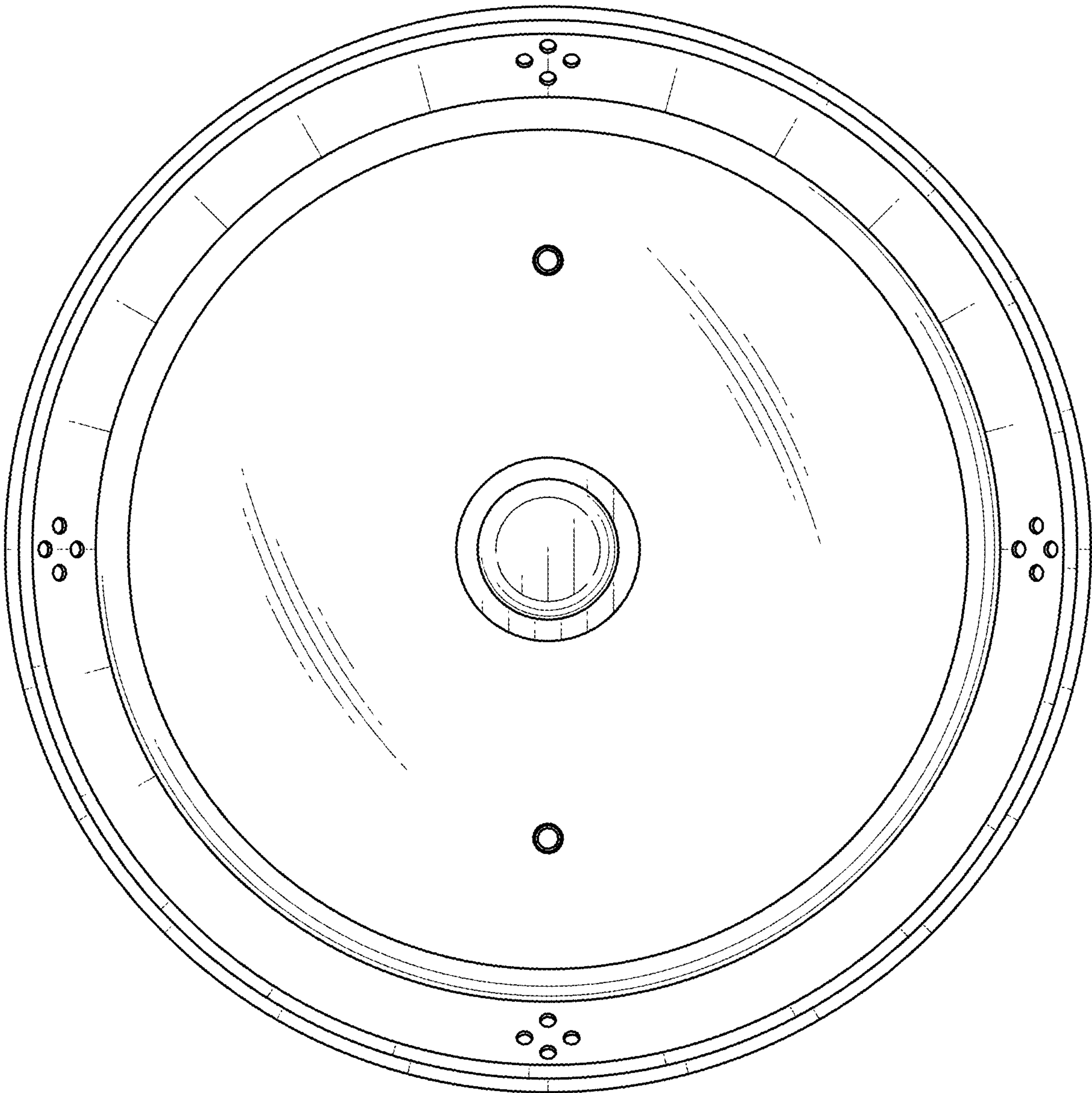

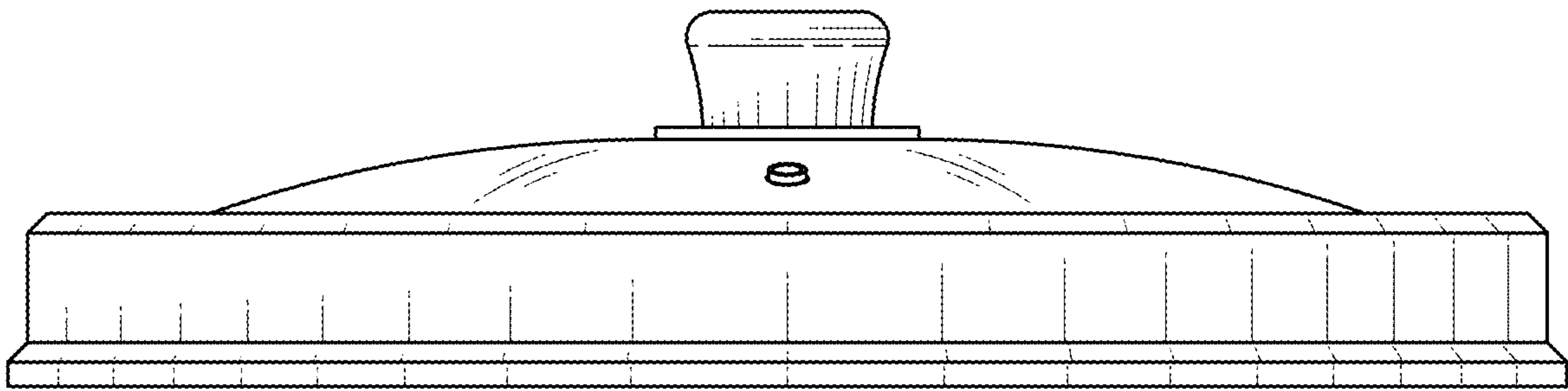

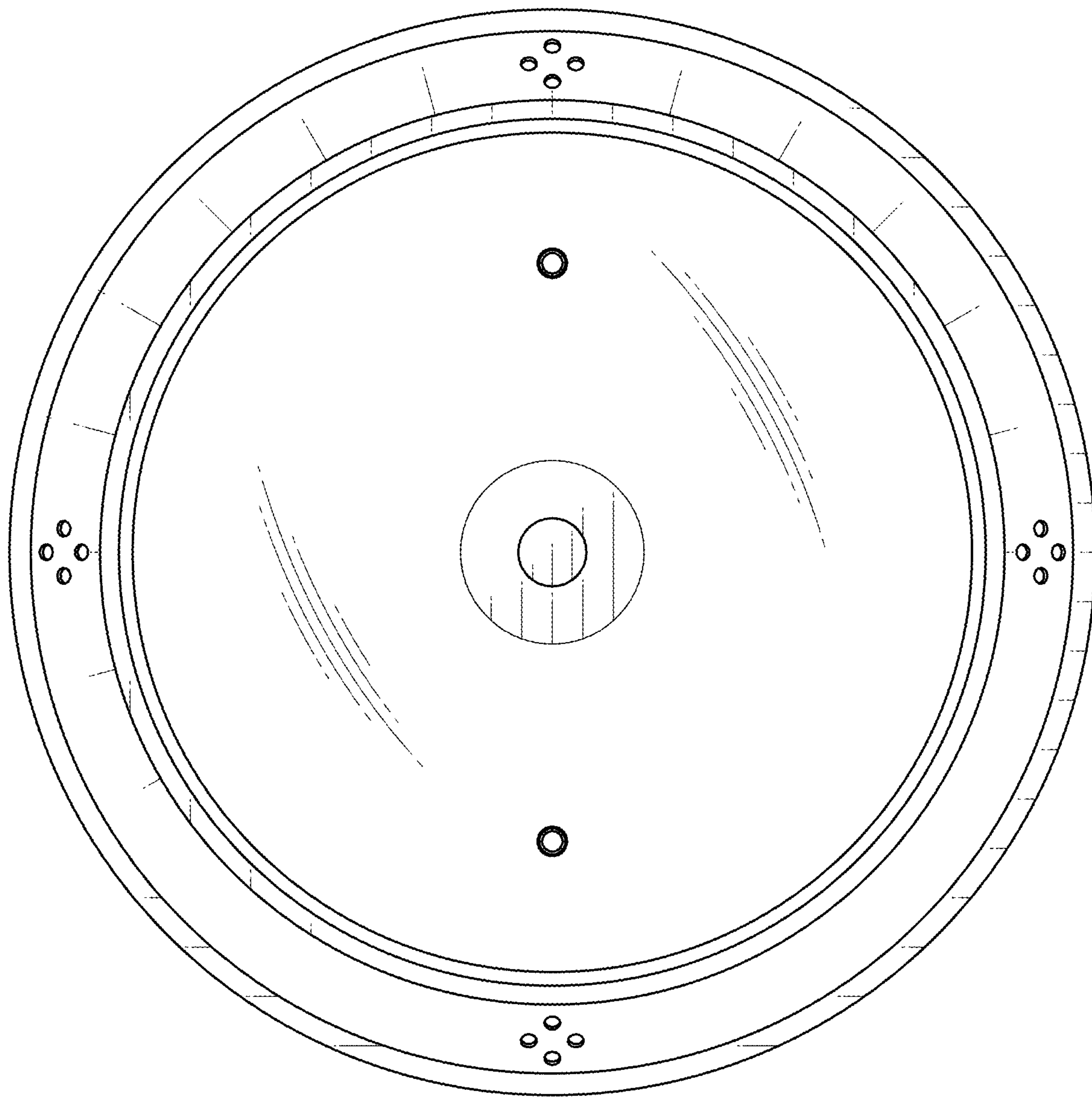
