CLAIM

We claim the ornamental design for a work light, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and right side perspective view of a work light showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof, with the broken lines representing portions of the light which form no part of the claimed design. Dashed lines are included for illustrating interior and/or

environmental structures and form no part of the claimed design.
