FIG. 6 is a top view of the safety vest.

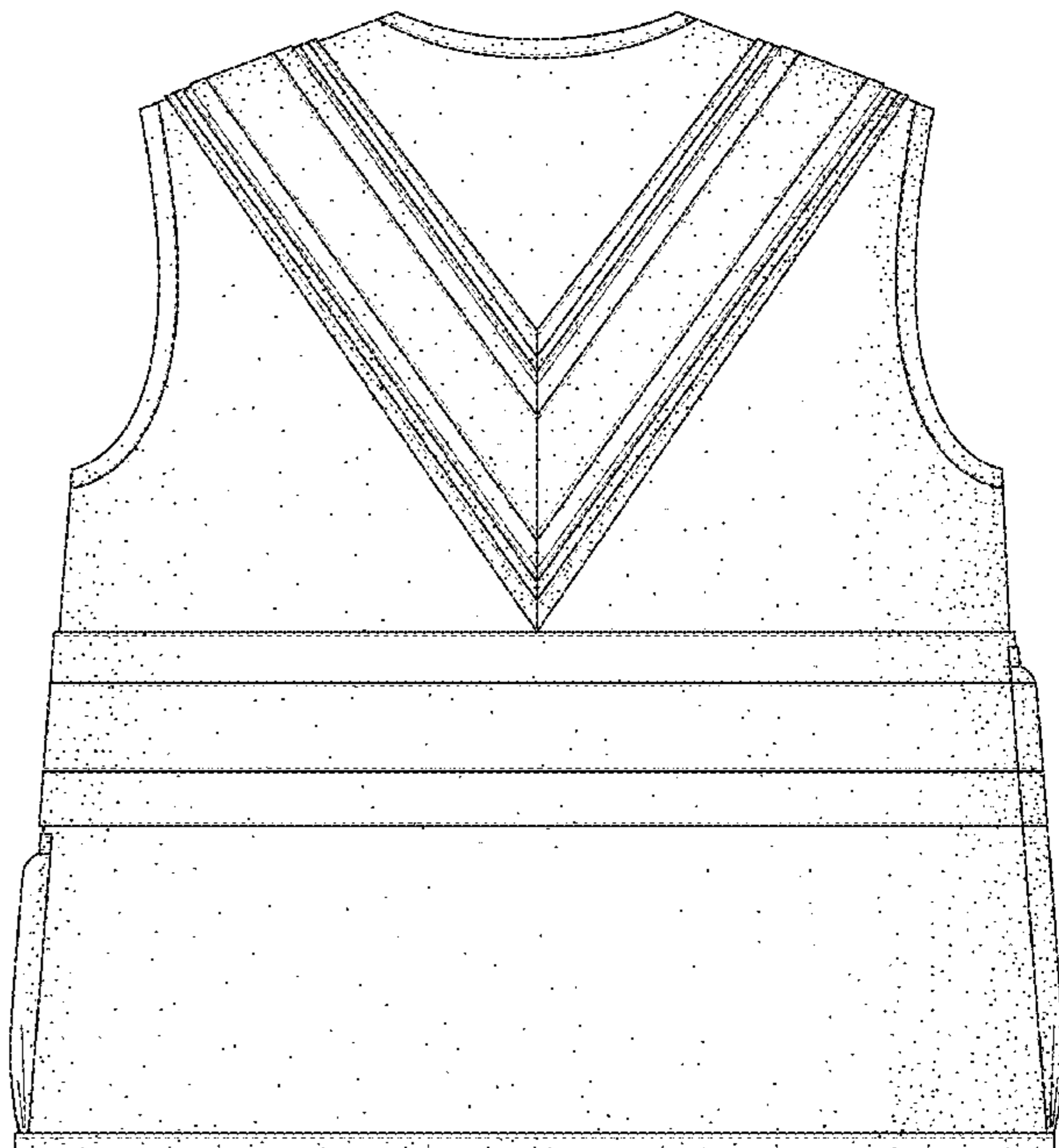
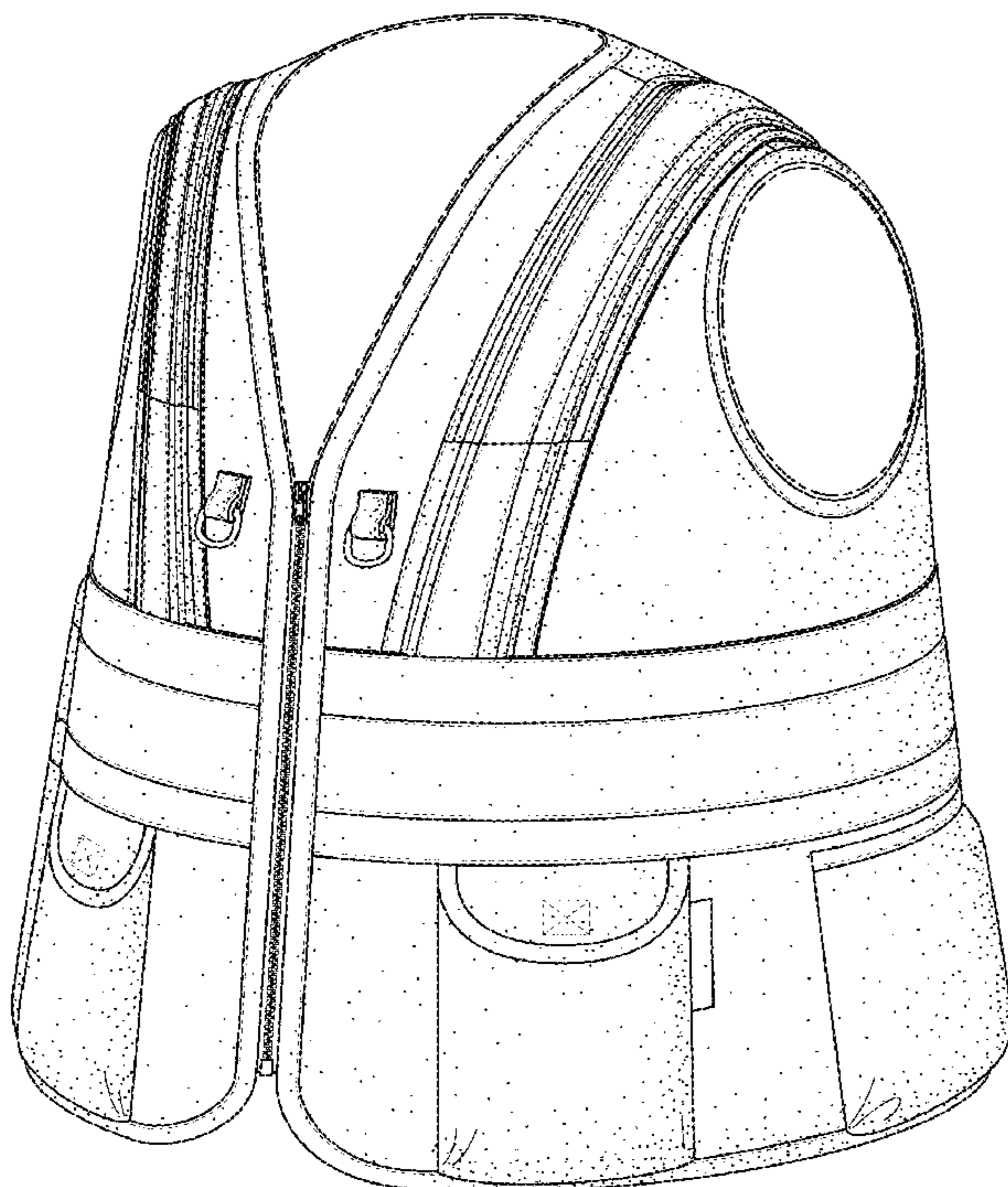
FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the safety vest.

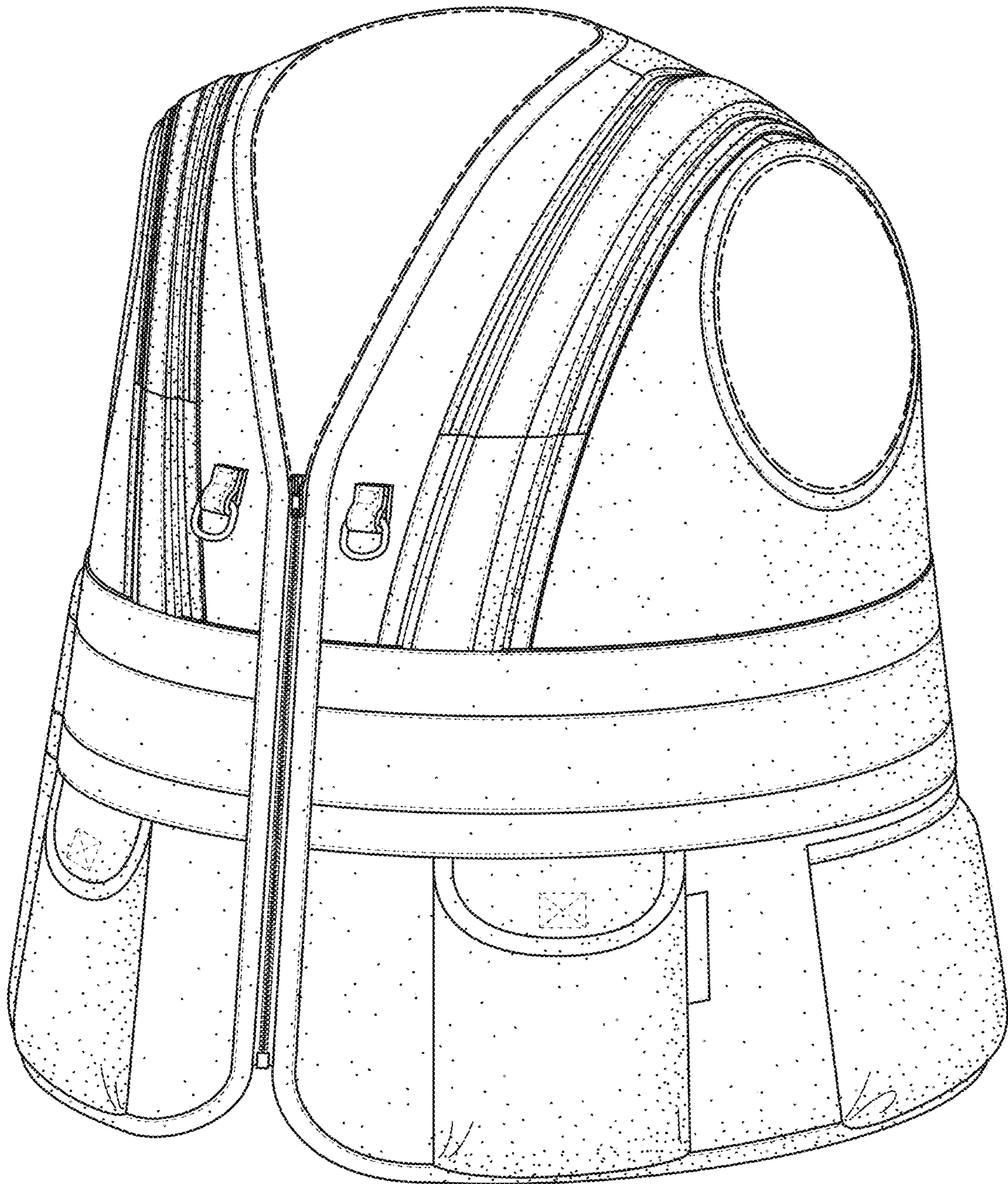

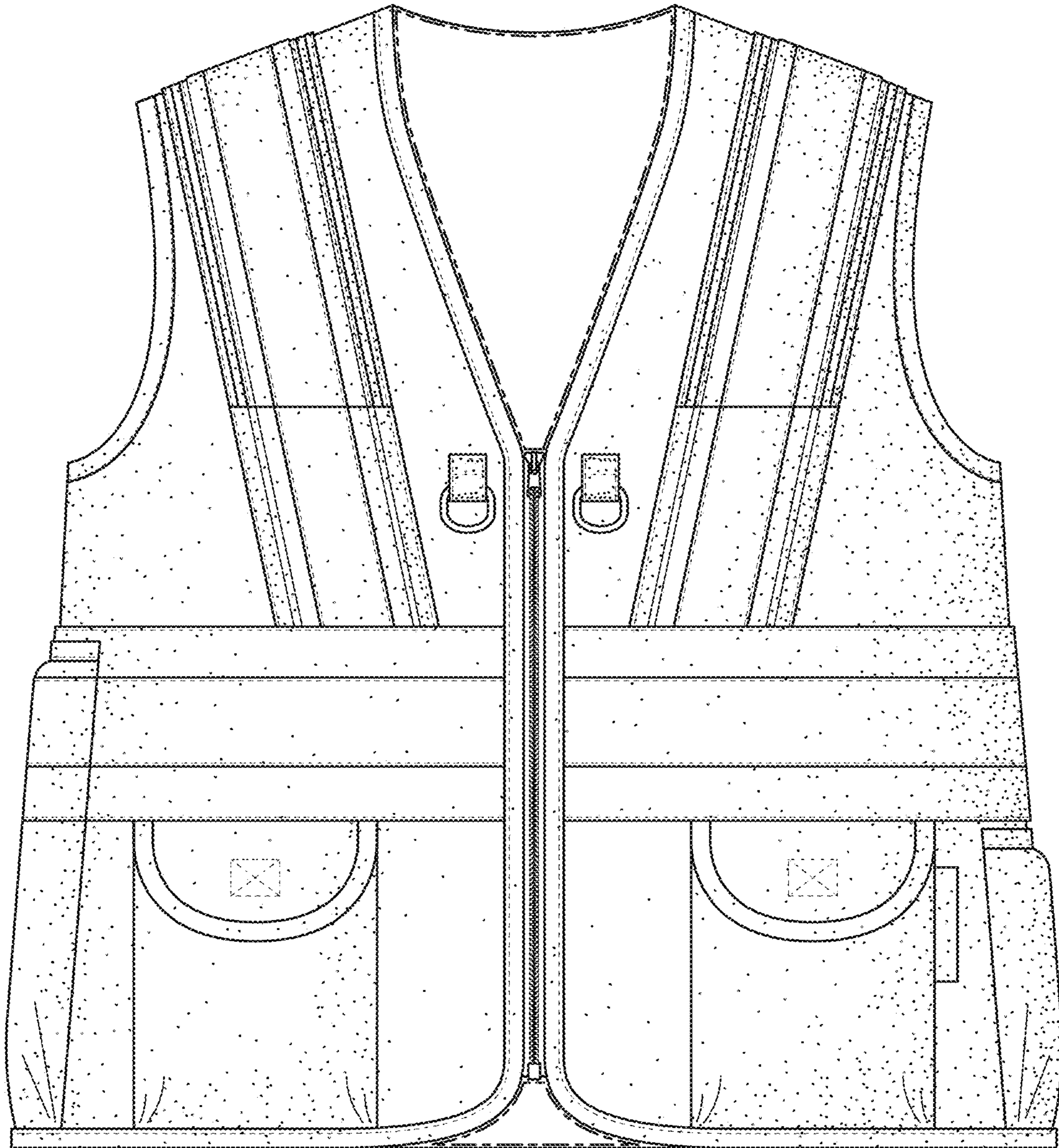

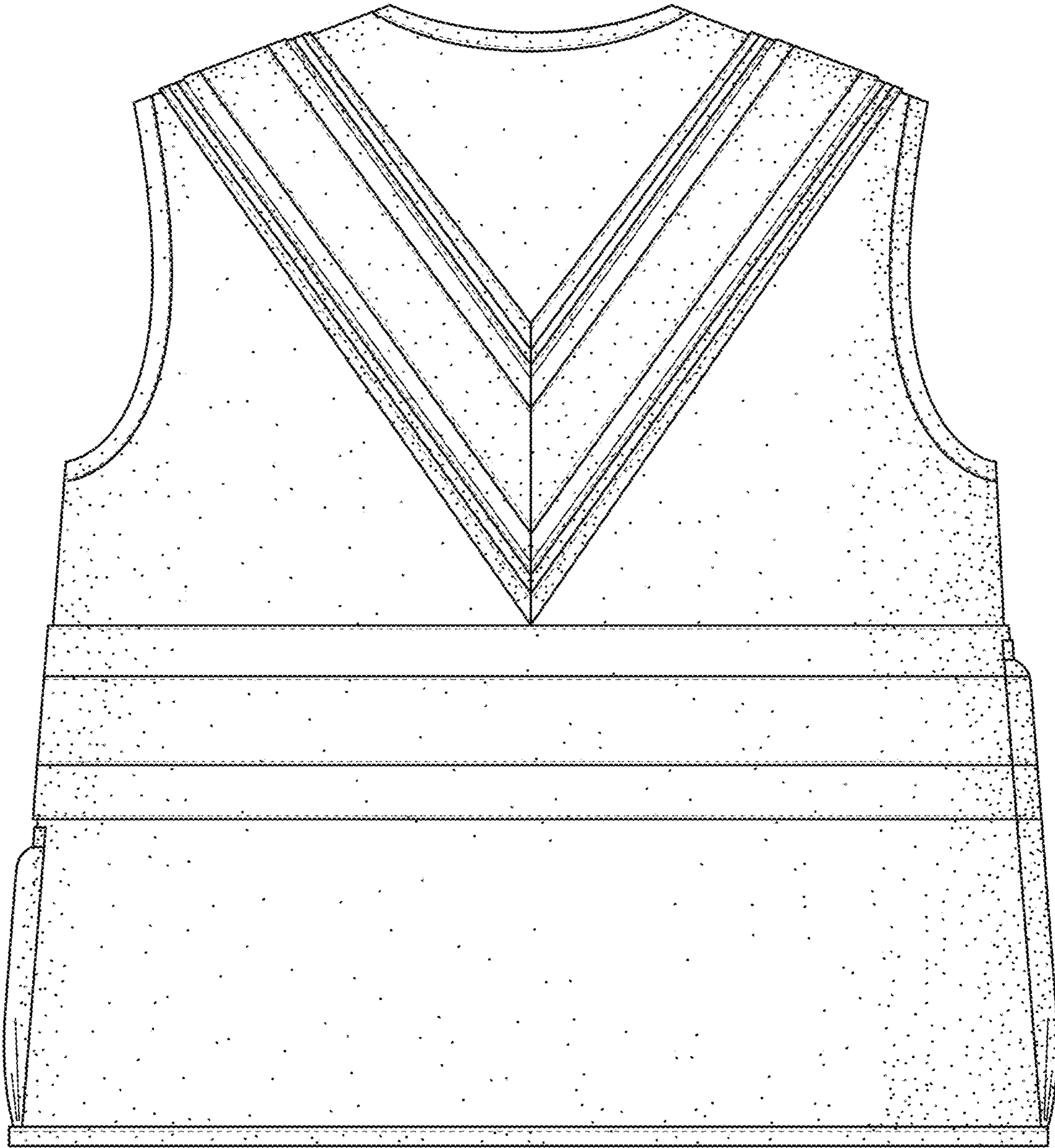

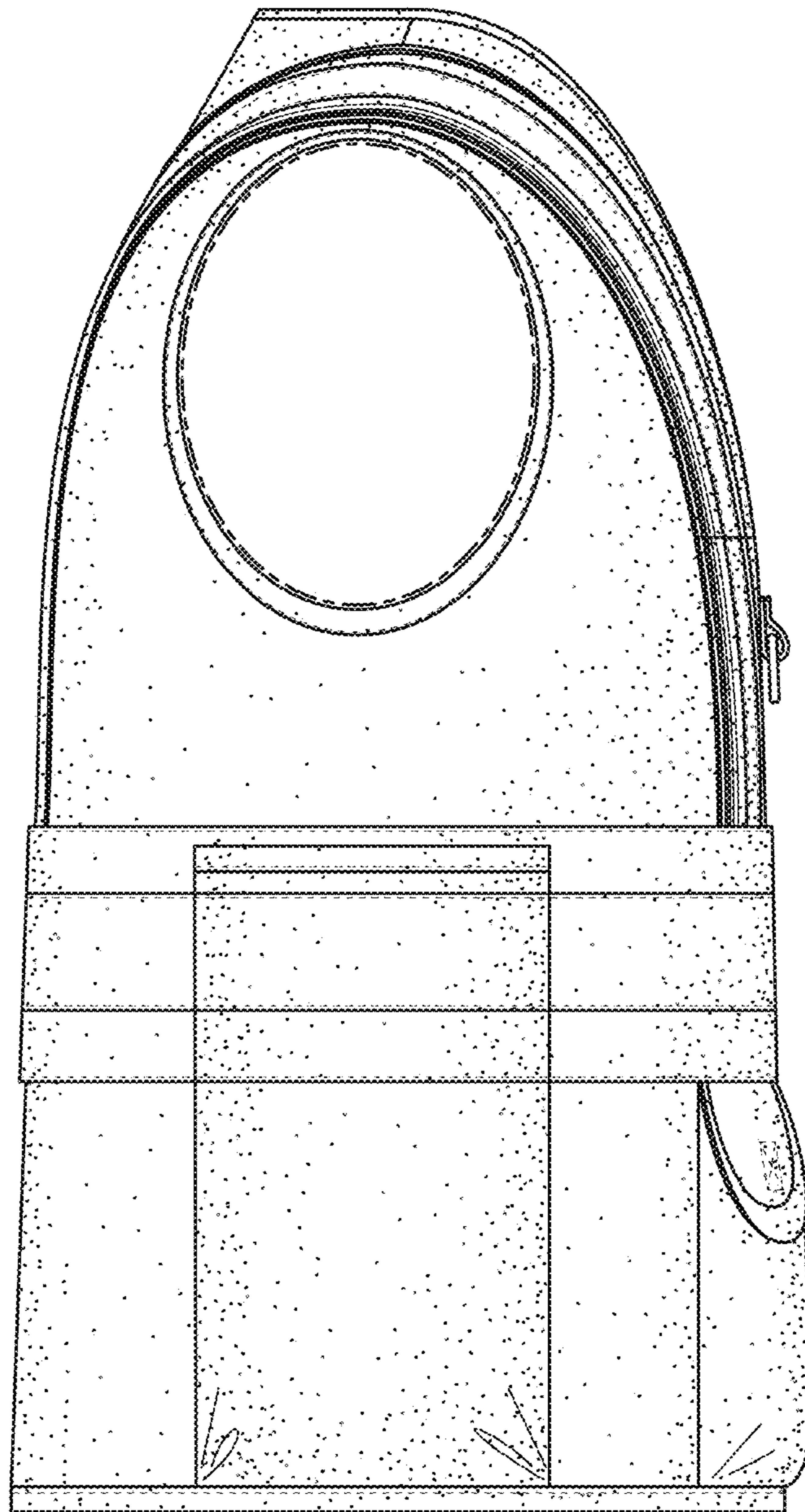

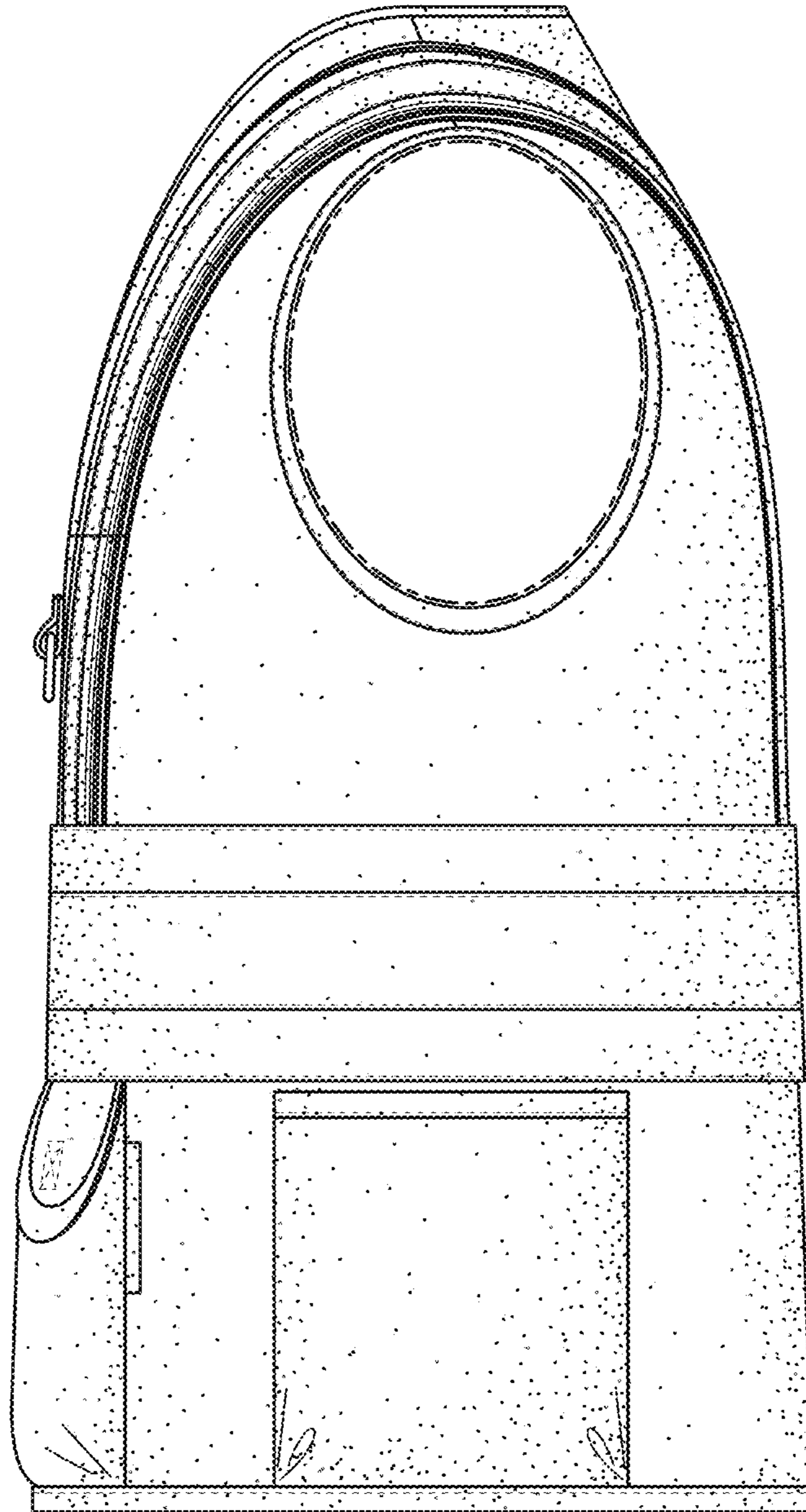

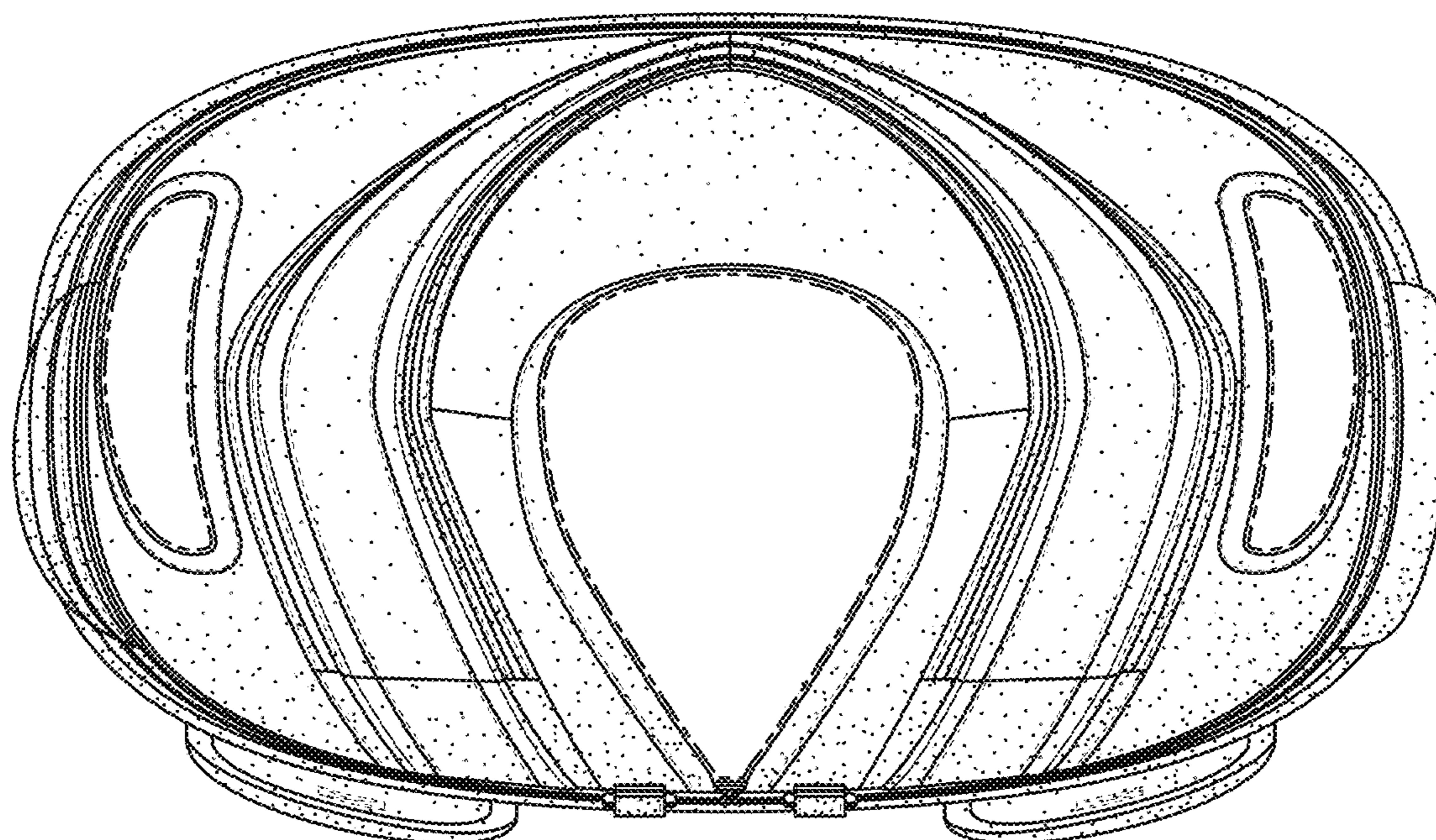

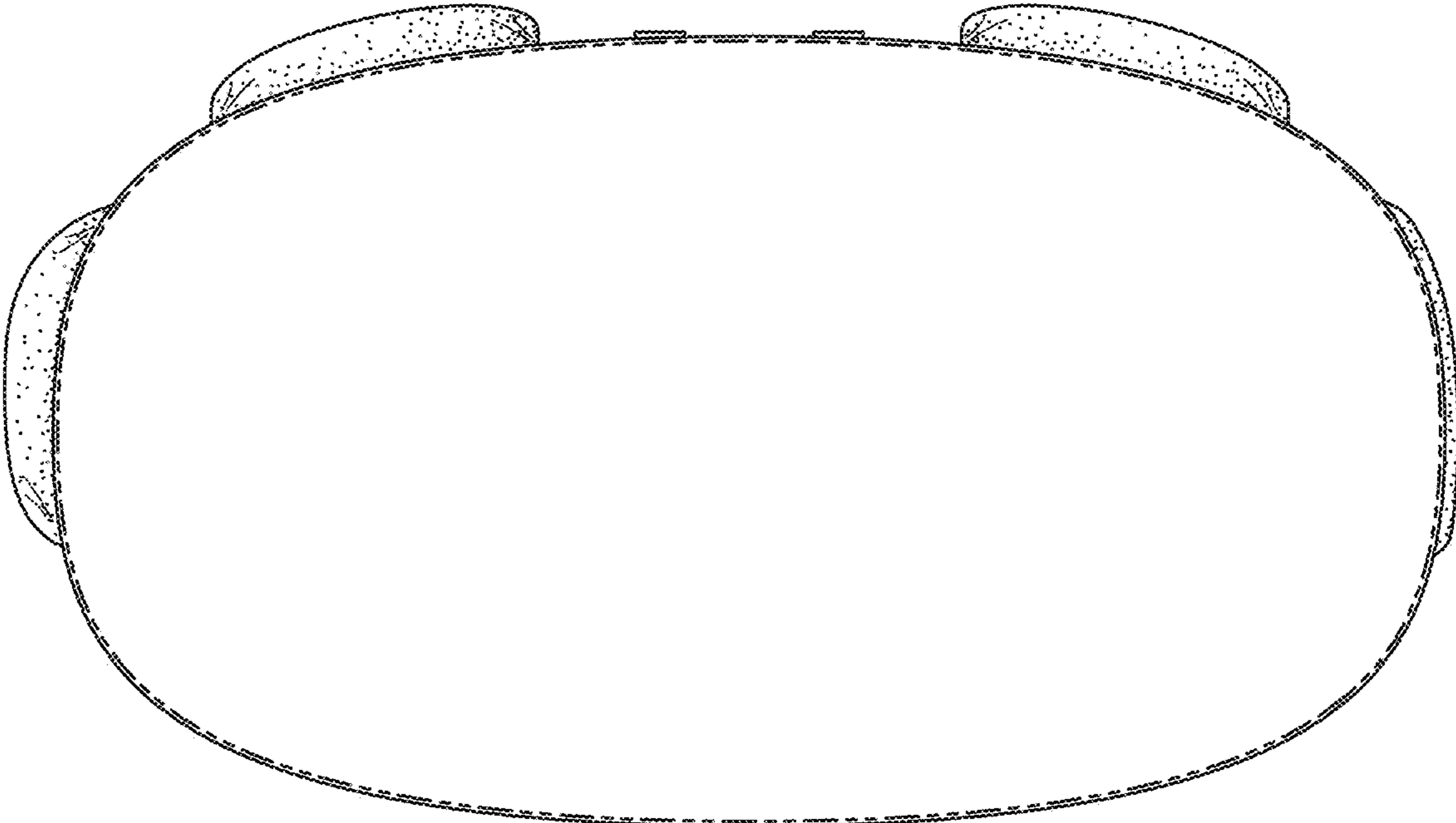

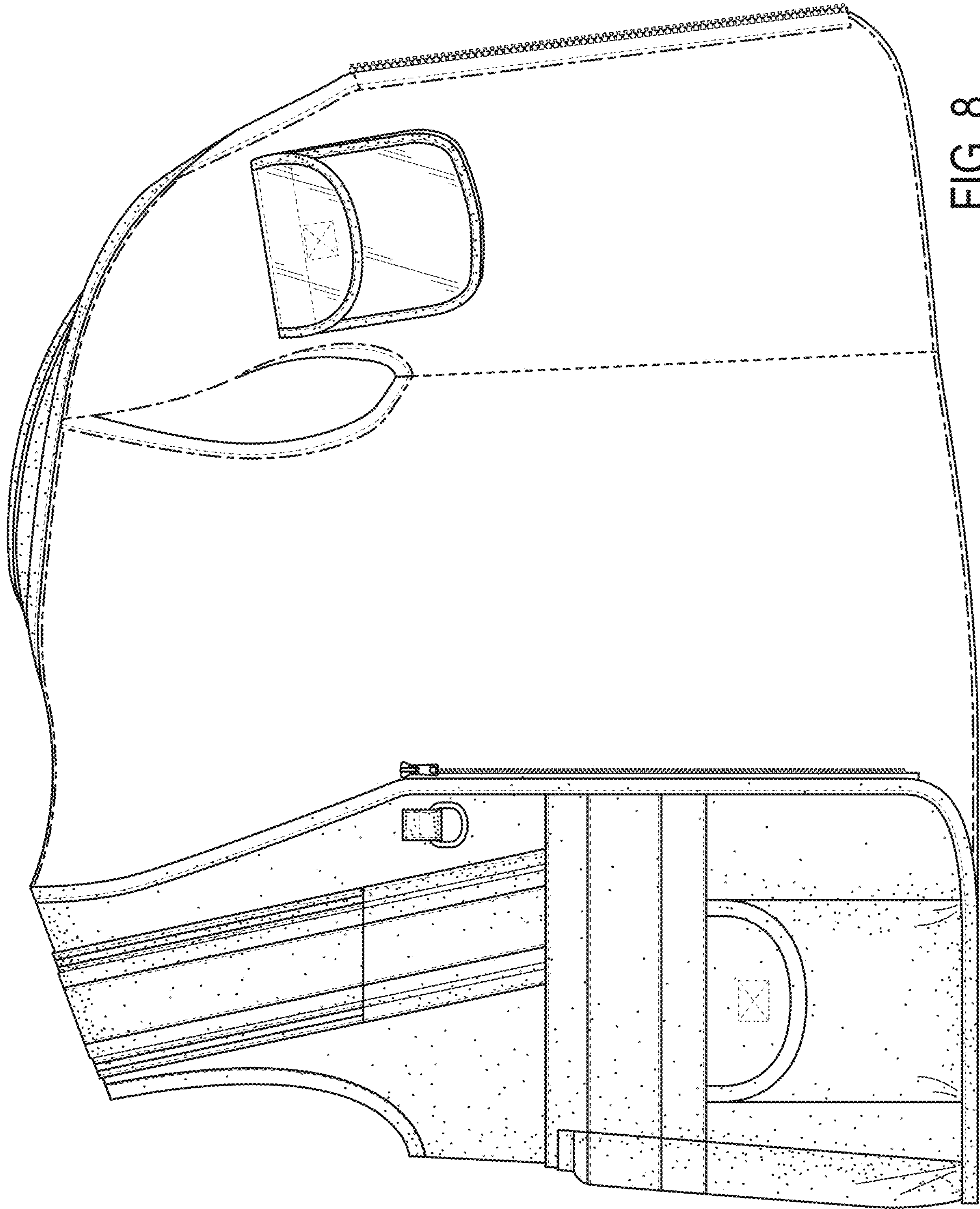
