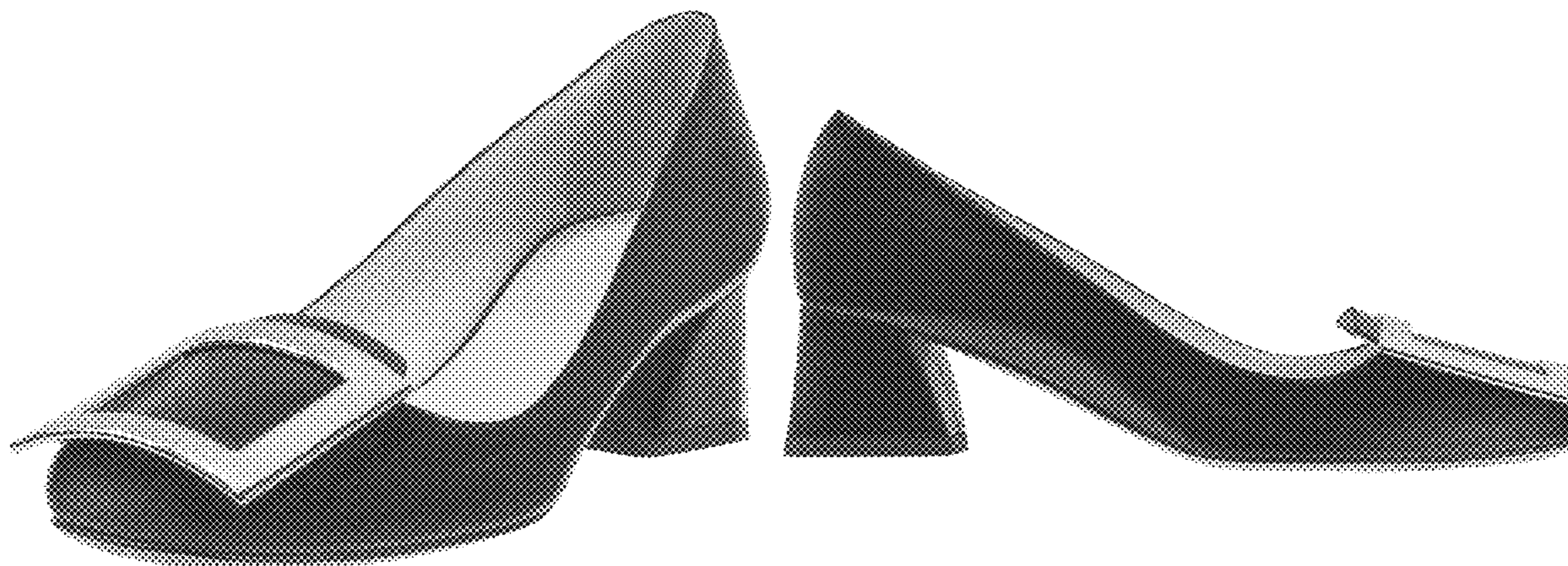

DESCRIPTION

1. Shoe
 1.1 is a perspective view of a shoe showing our new design;
 1.2 is a front view thereof;
 1.3 is a rear view thereof;
 1.4 is a side view thereof;
 1.5 is an opposite side view thereof;
 1.6 is a top view thereof; and
 1.7 is a bottom view thereof.
 The various views of the design show only the right shoe; the right shoe is not shown as it is symmetrical to the left one.

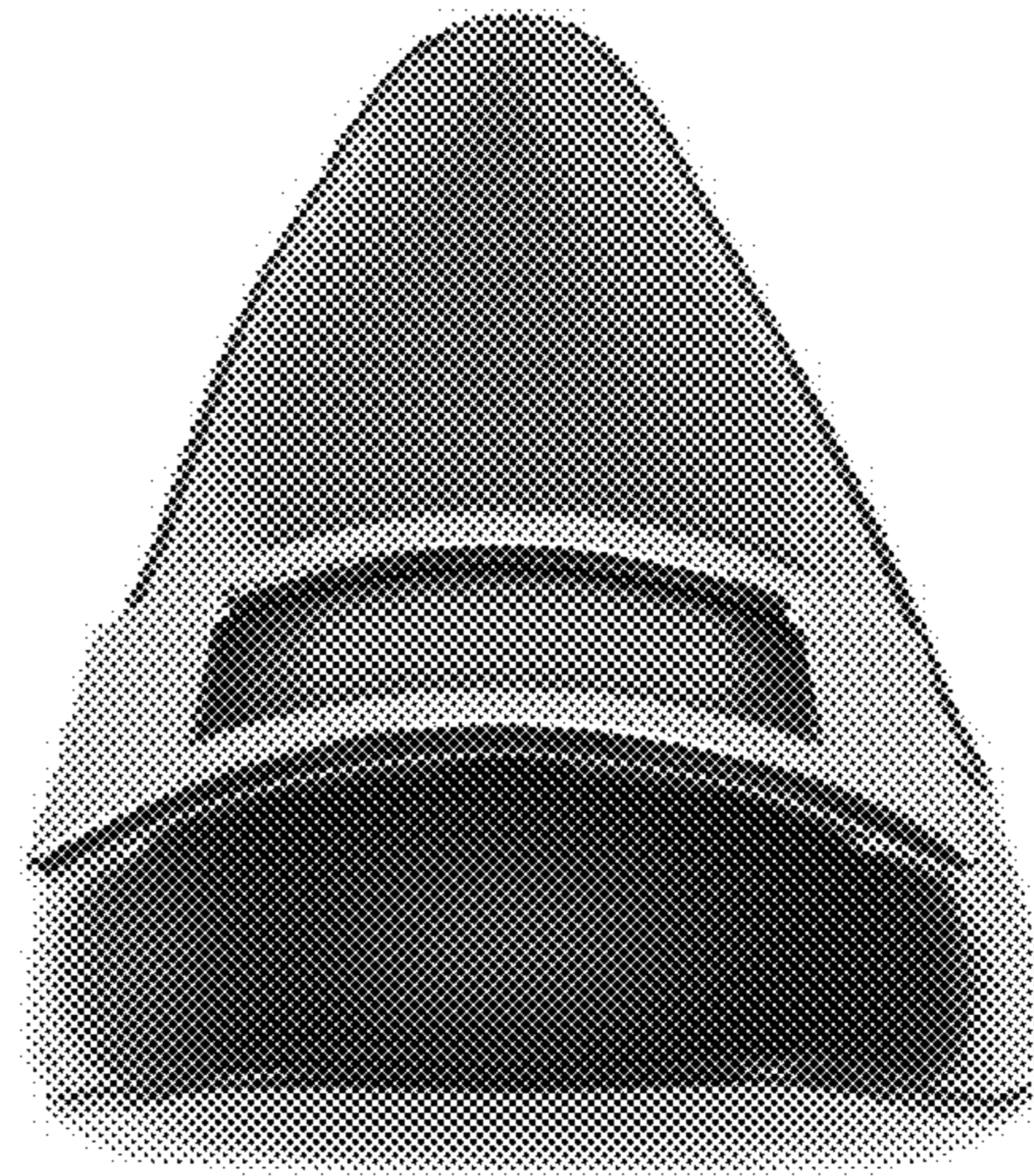

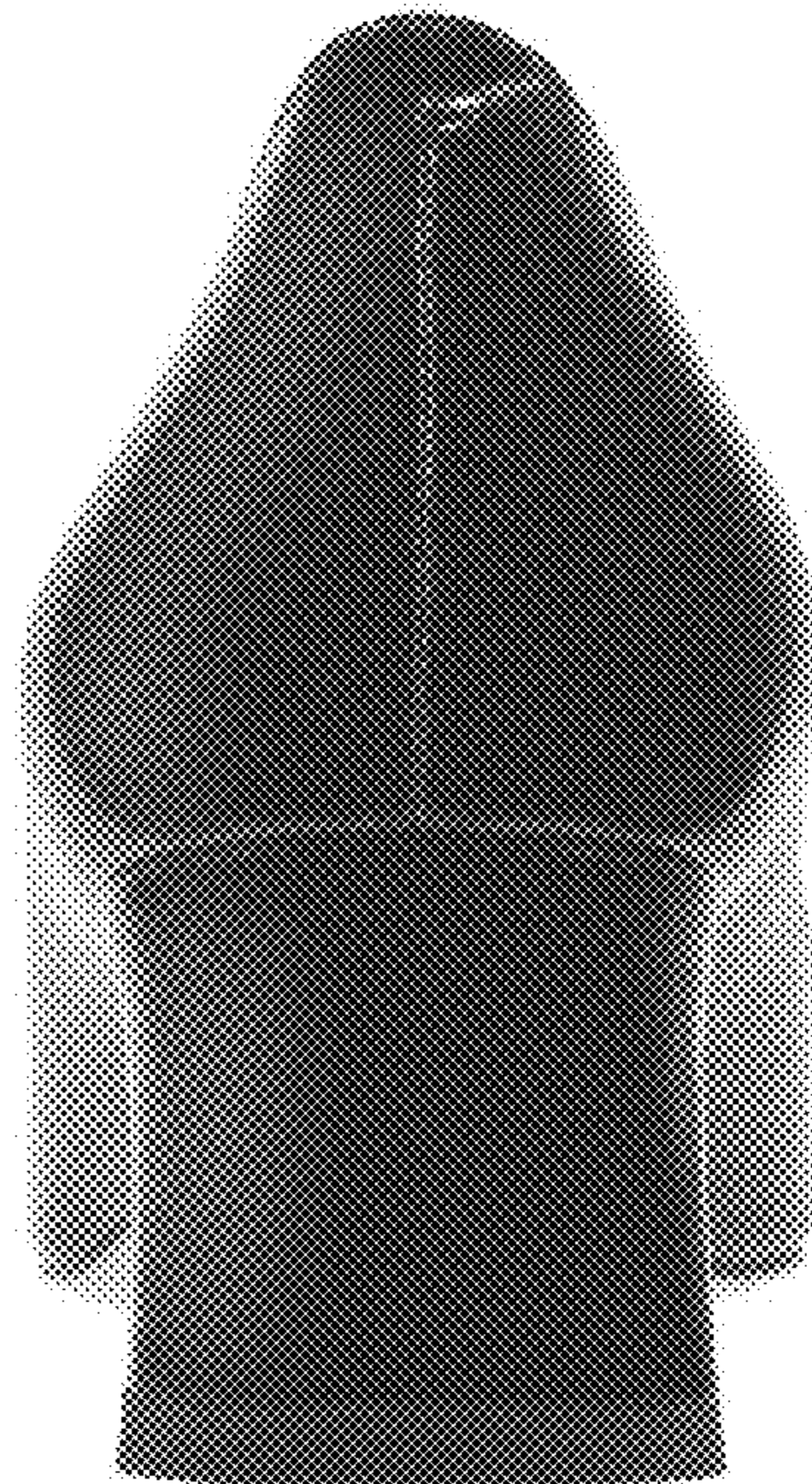

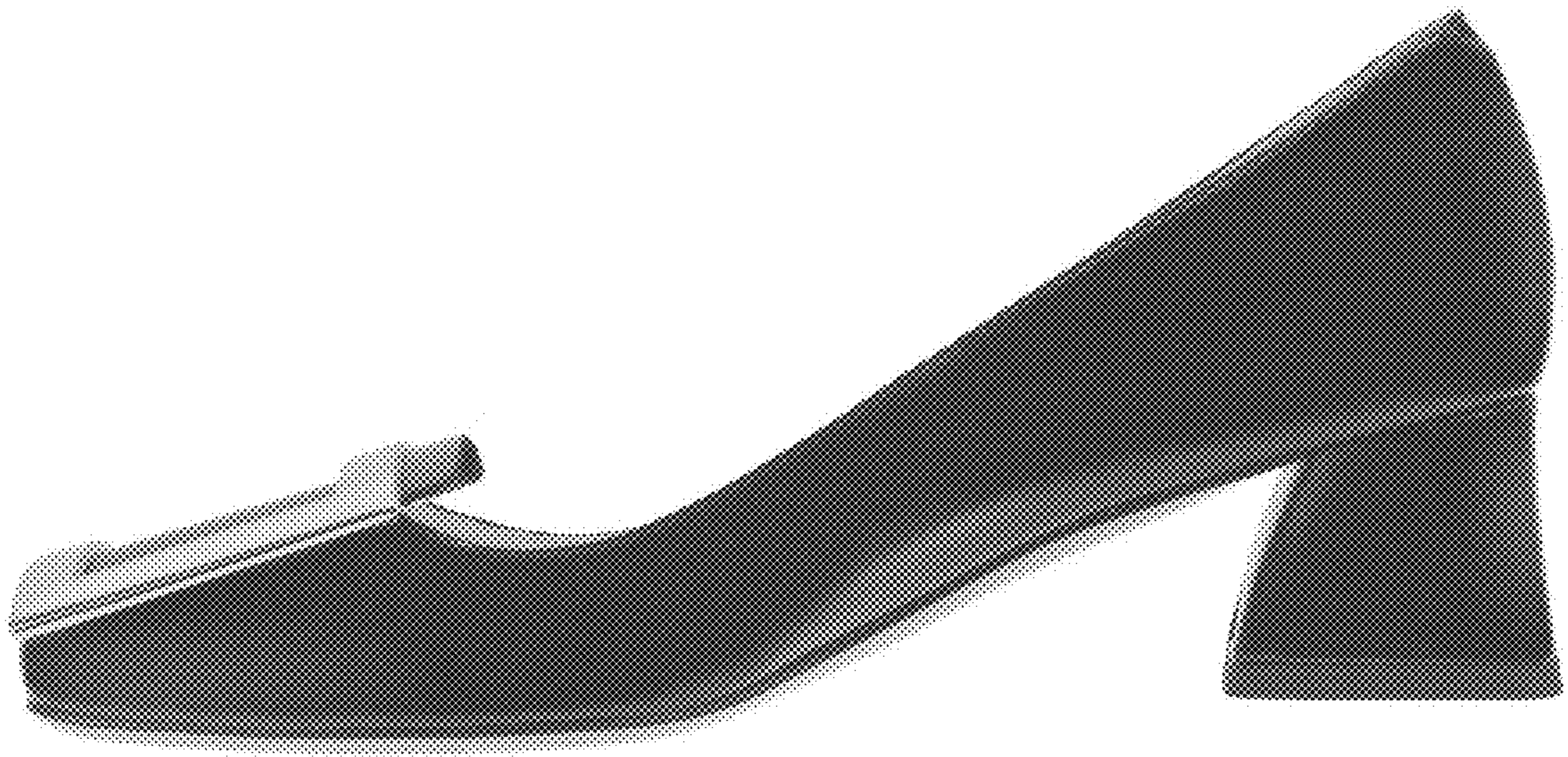

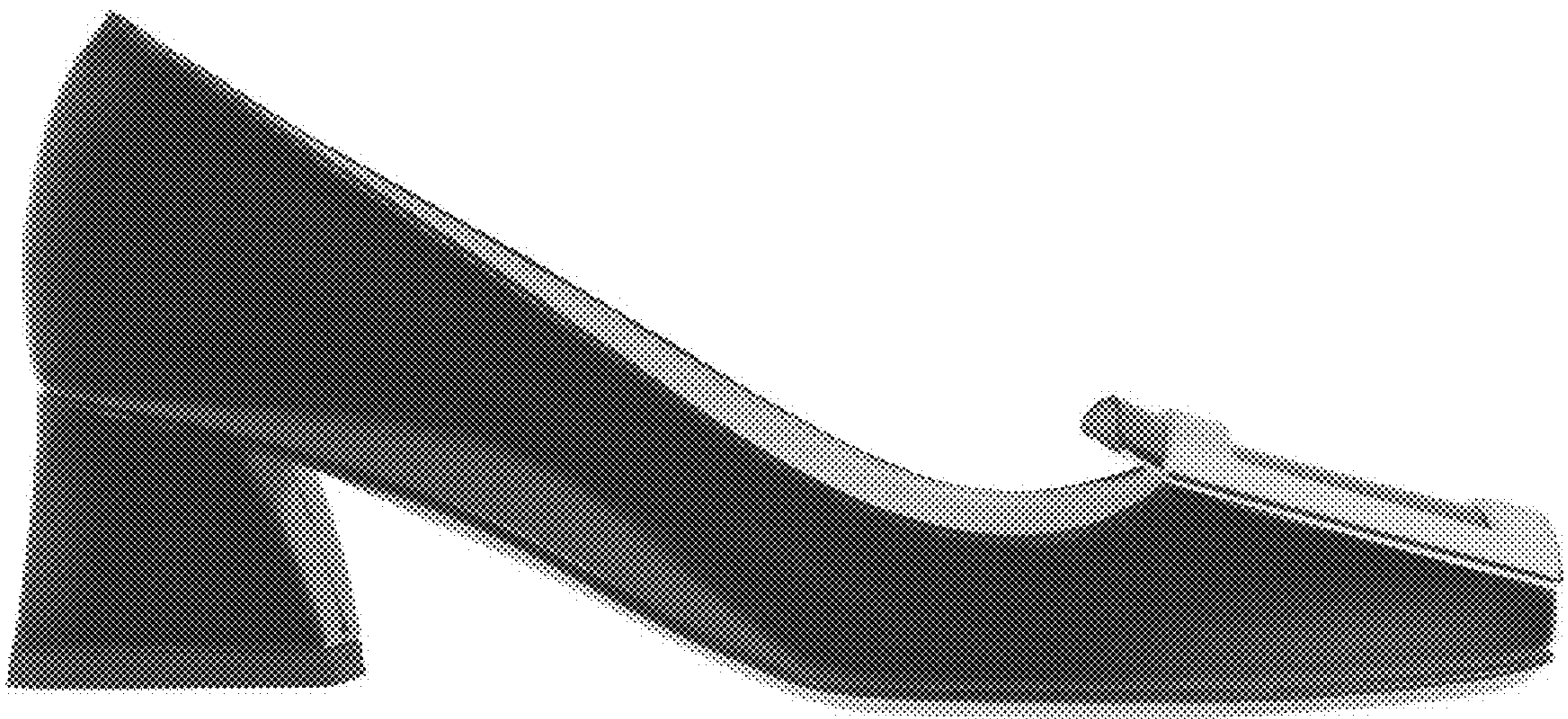

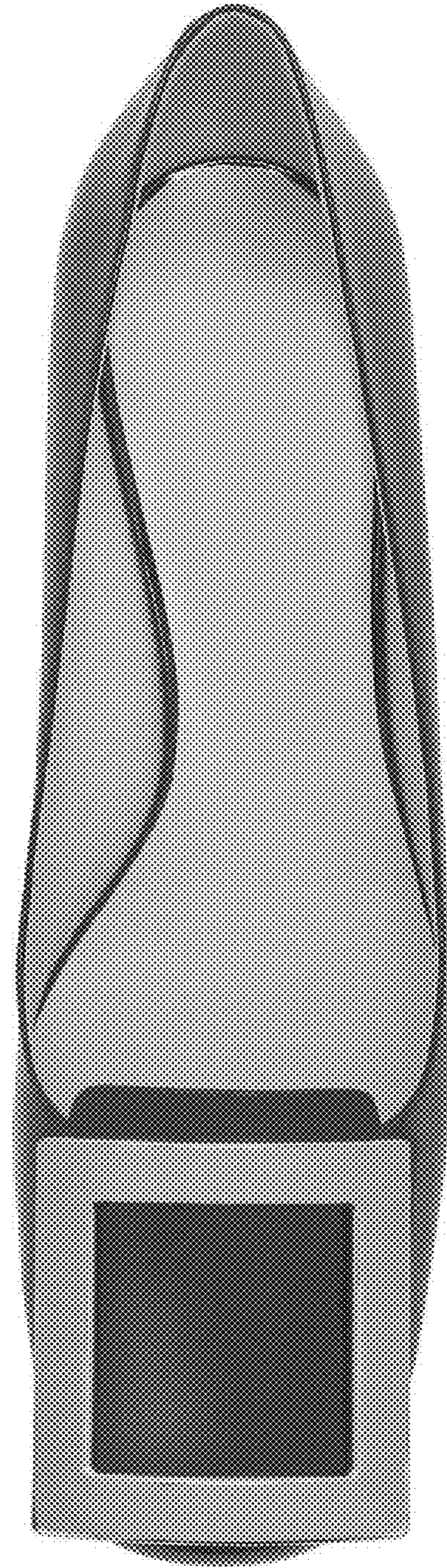
