FIG. 4 is a first side view of the watermelon float in accordance with the invention.

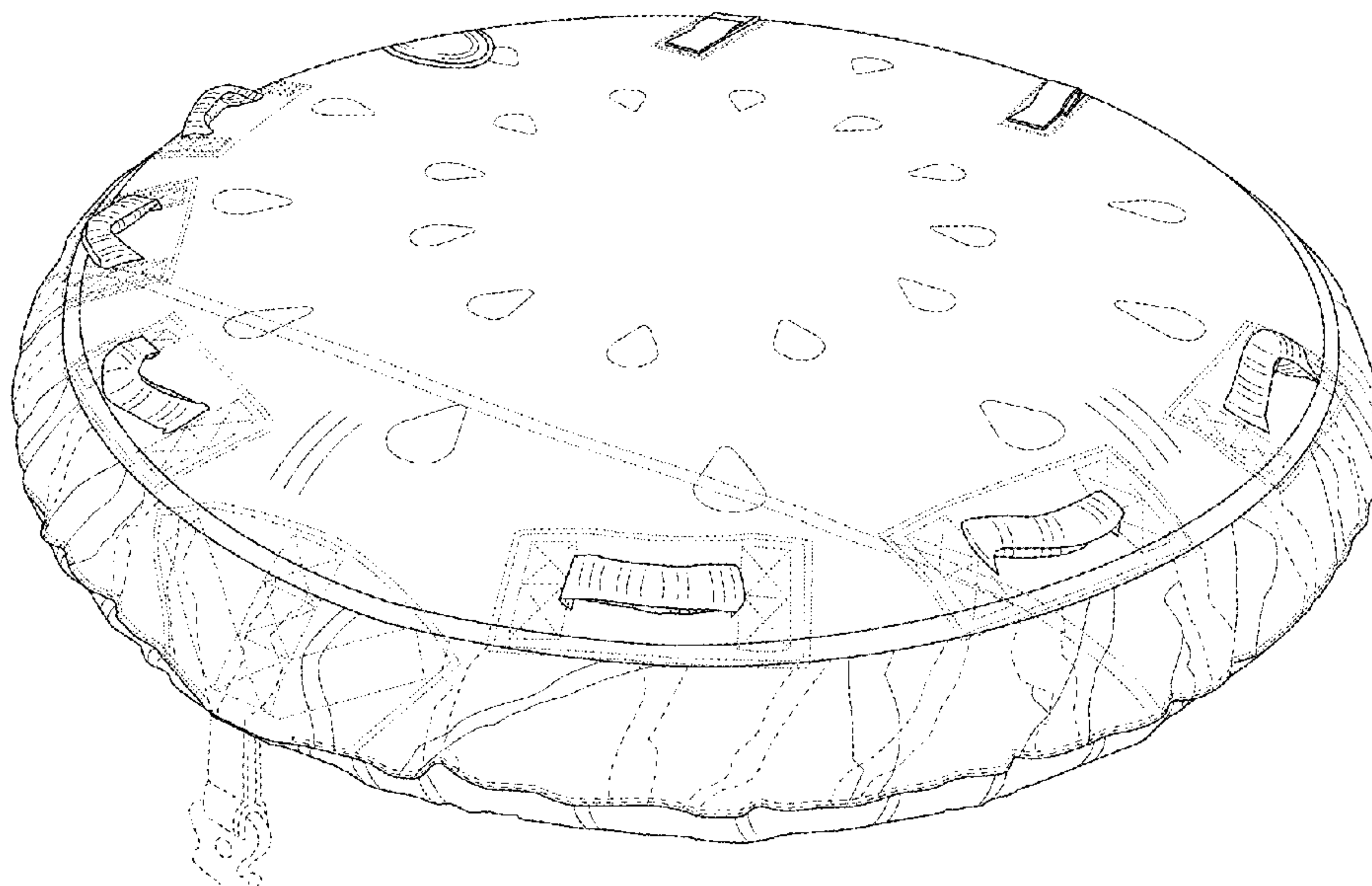
FIG. 5 is a second side view of the watermelon float in accordance with the invention, wherein the second side is opposite the first side.

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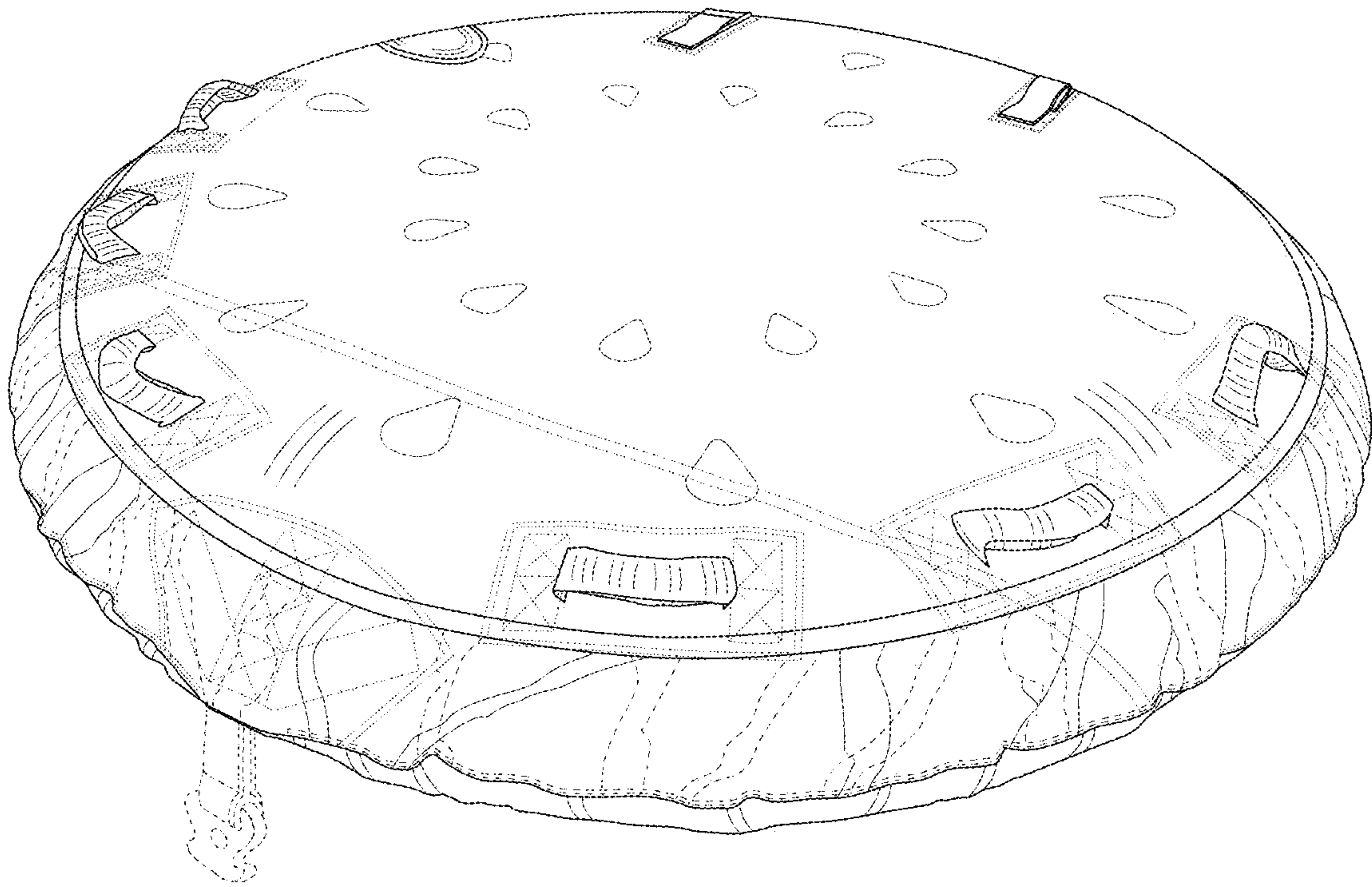

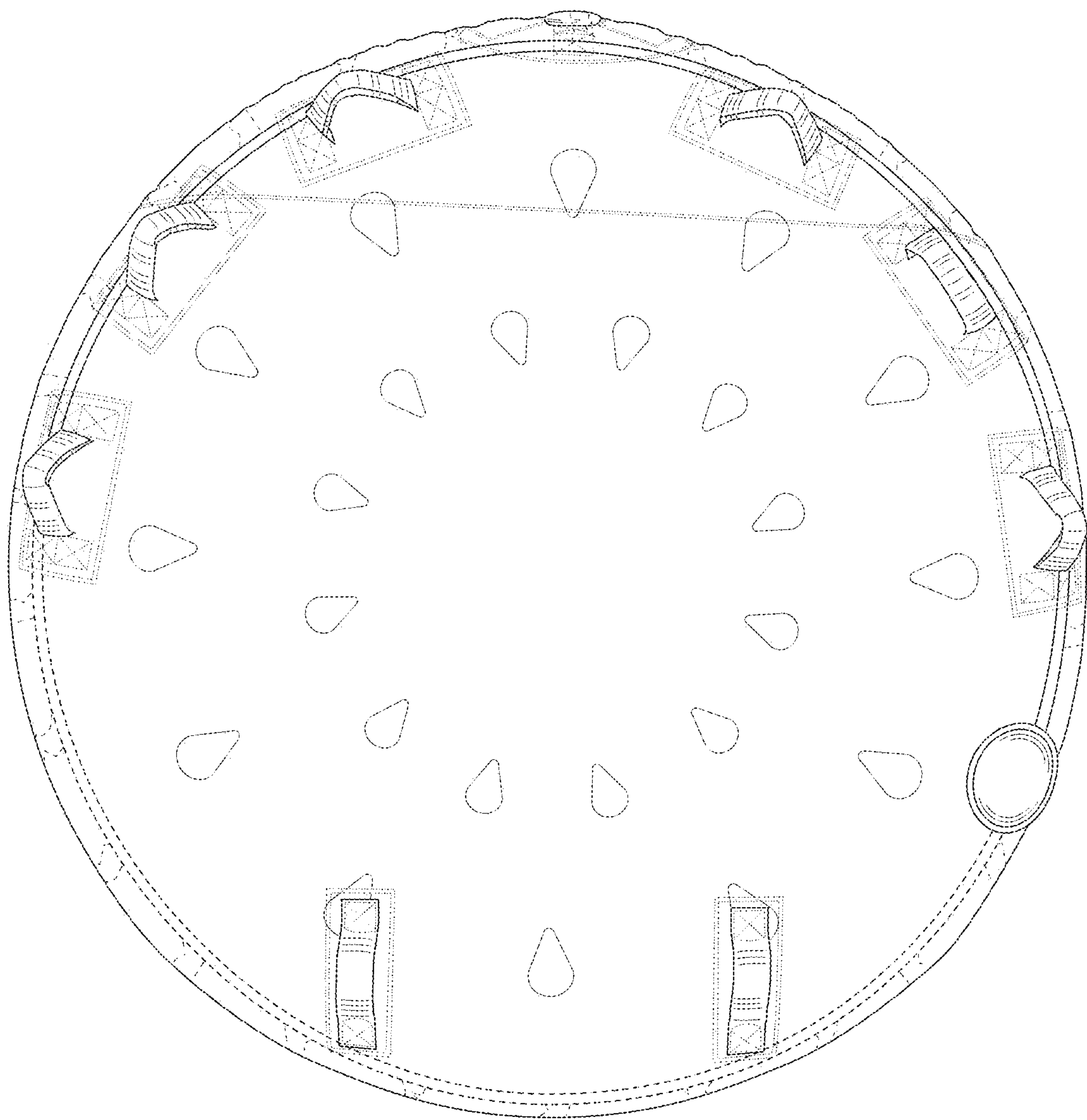

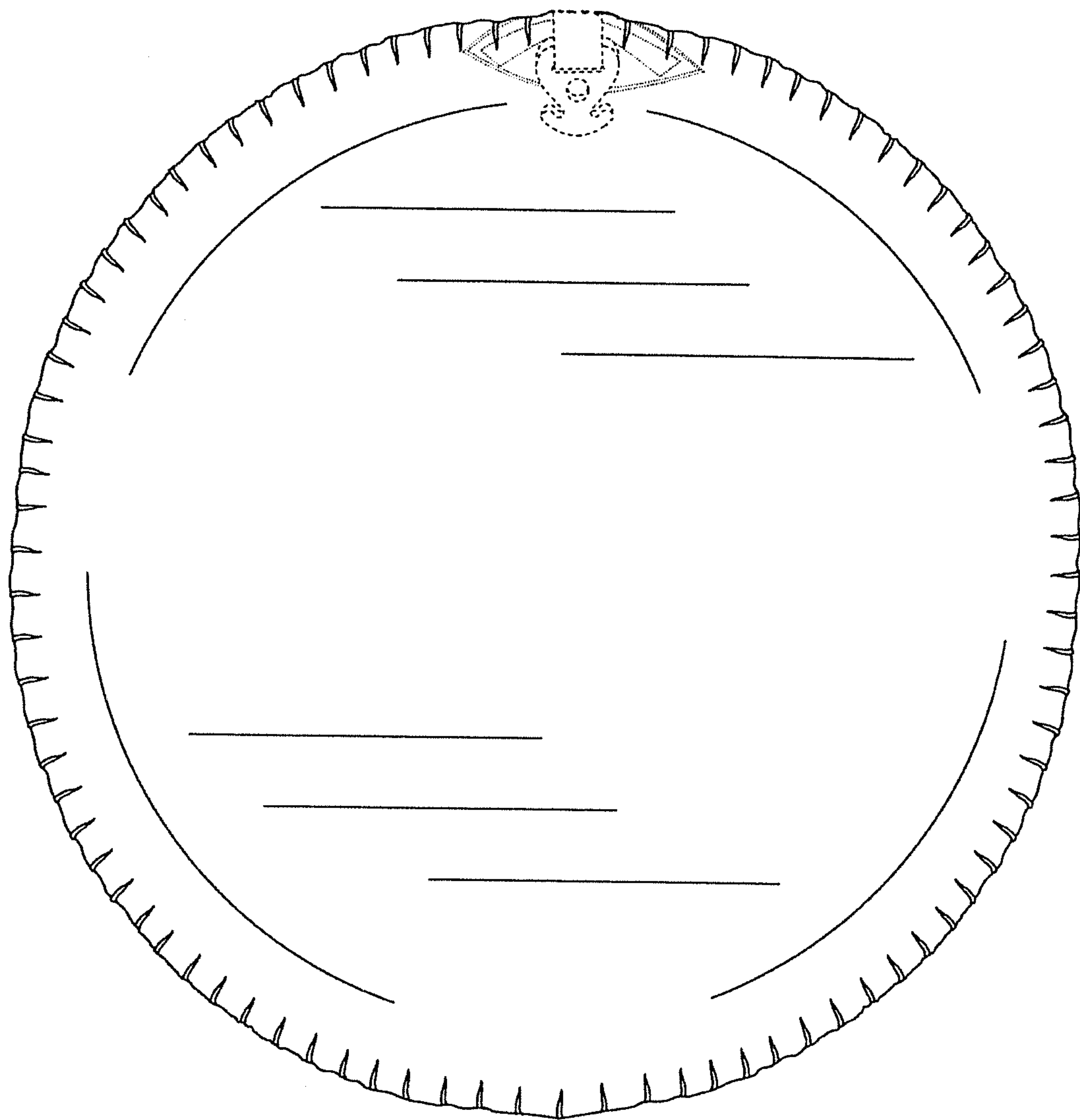

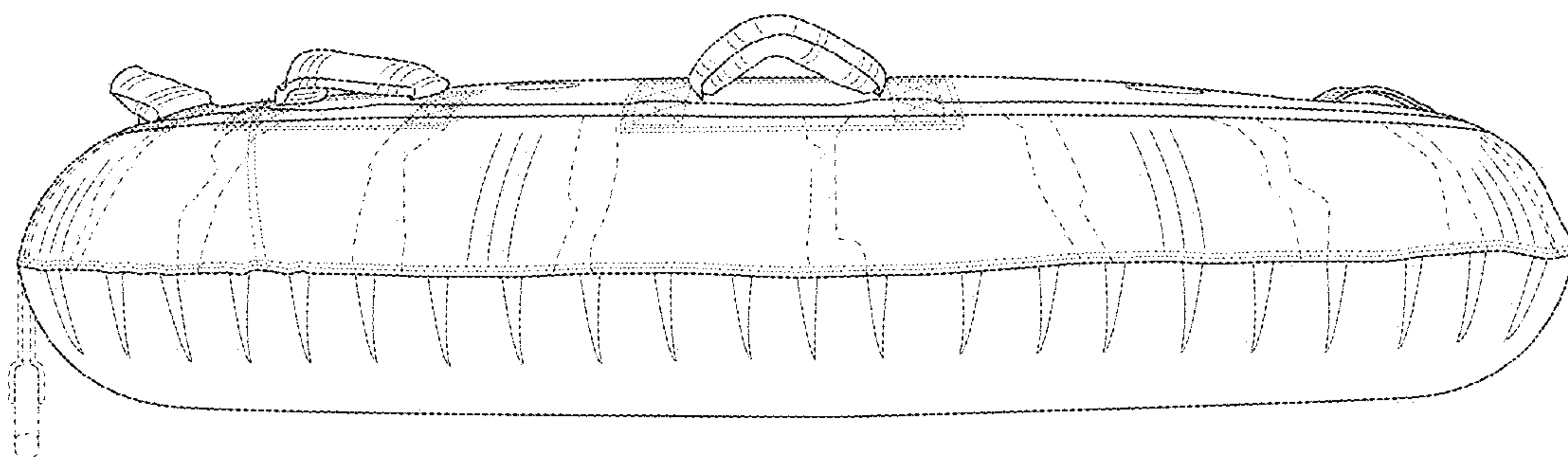

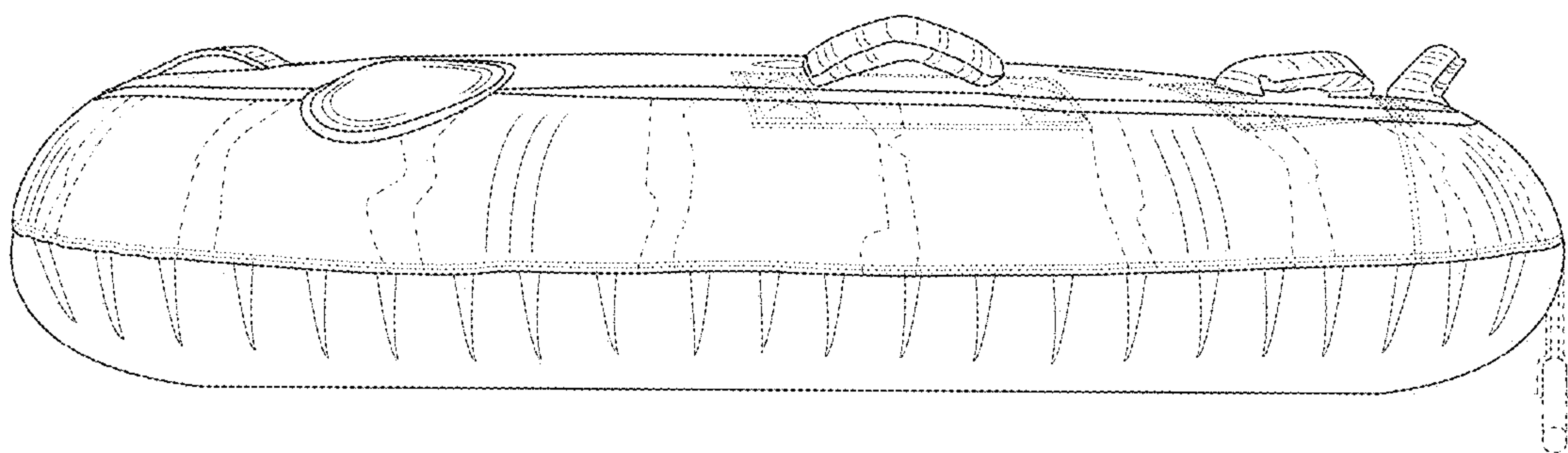

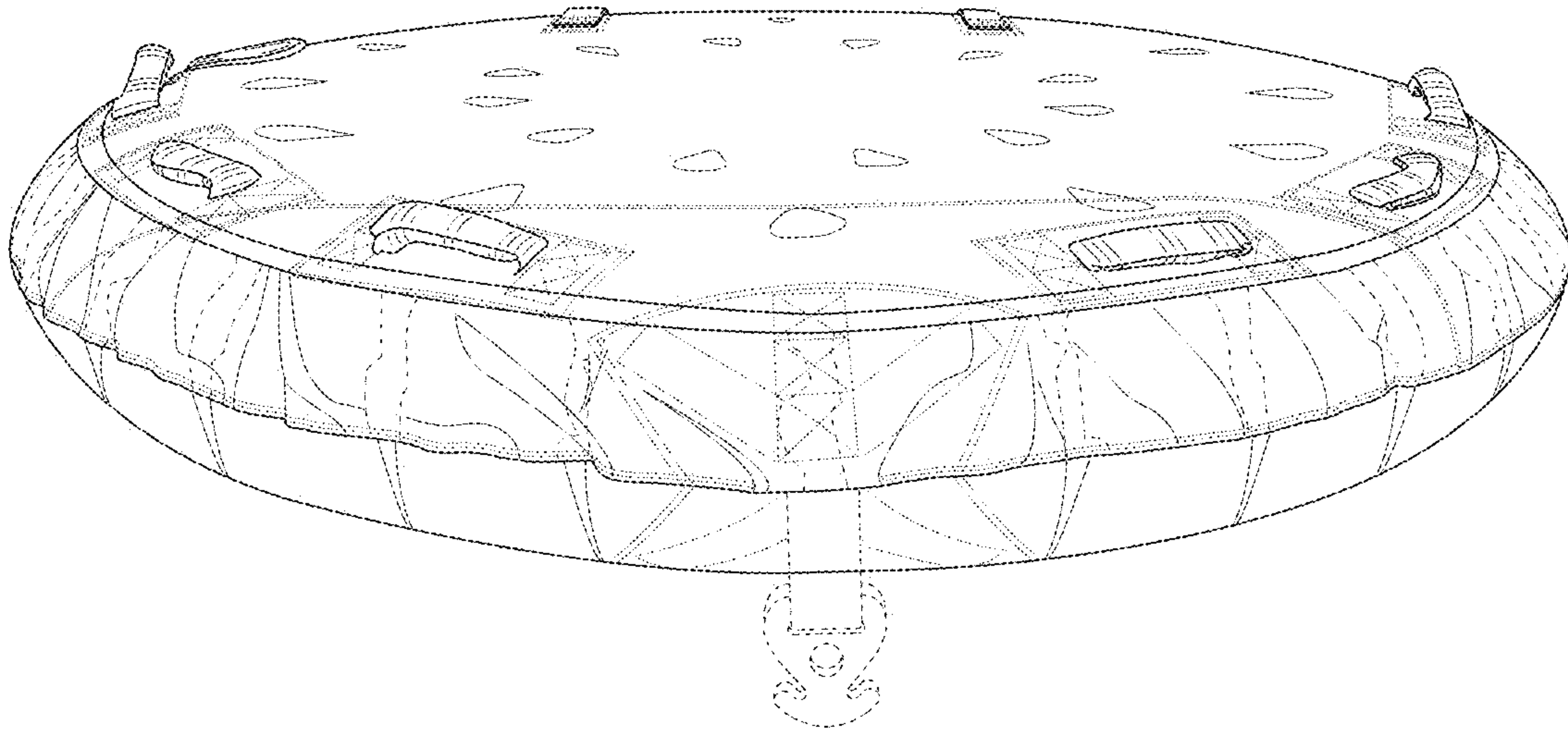

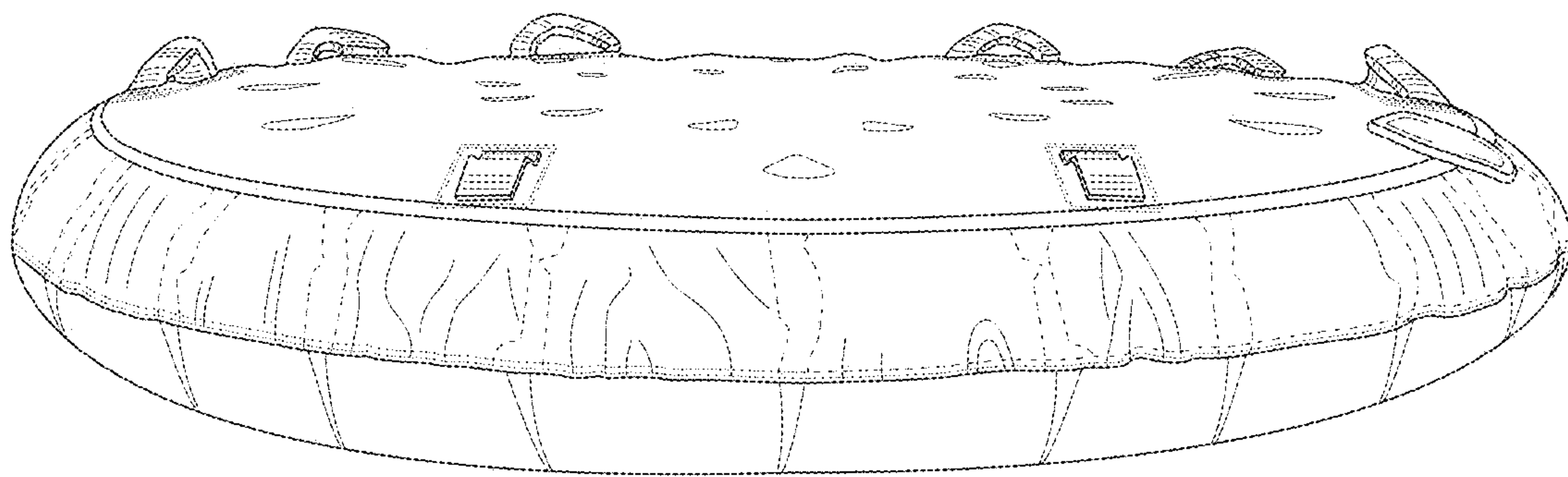
