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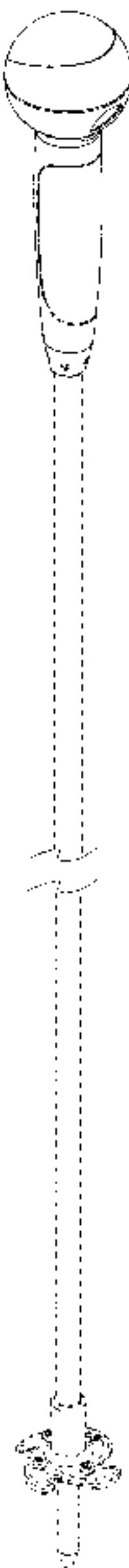
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a lighted hiking pole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lighted hiking pole in accordance with the present design;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is an enlarged view of the lighted hiking pole, taken from the area within the indicated dash-dot-dash lines of FIG. 2.
The lighted hiking pole is shown with a symbolic break in its length. The appearance of any portion of the article between the break lines forms no part of the claimed design. The evenly spaced broken lines depict portions of the article that form no part of the claimed design.

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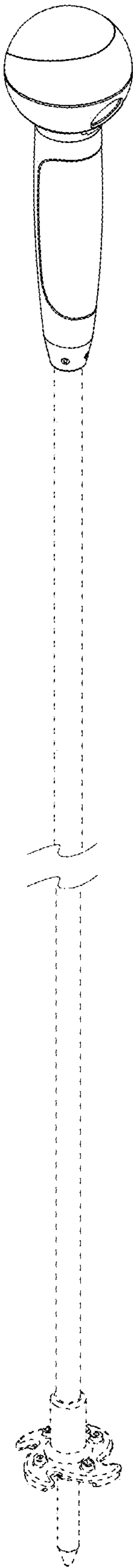

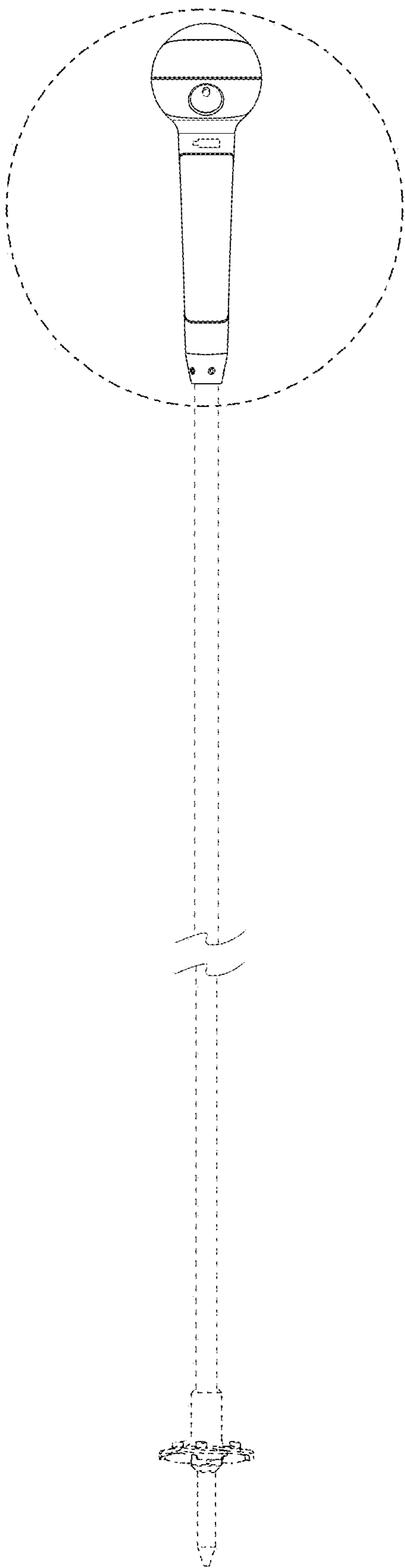

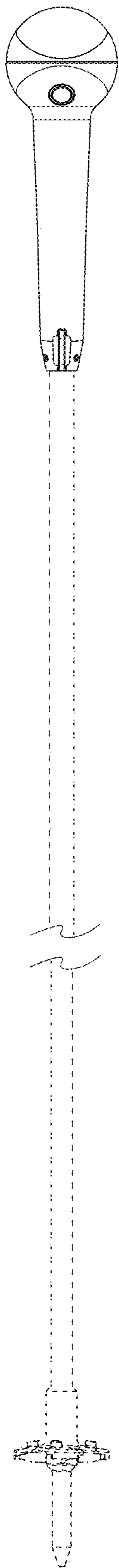

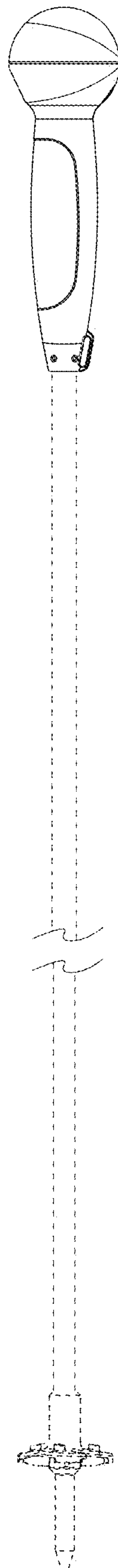

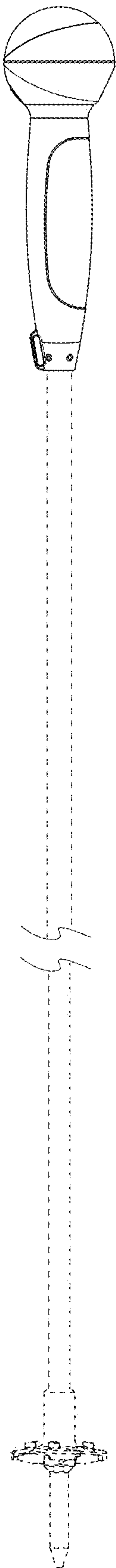

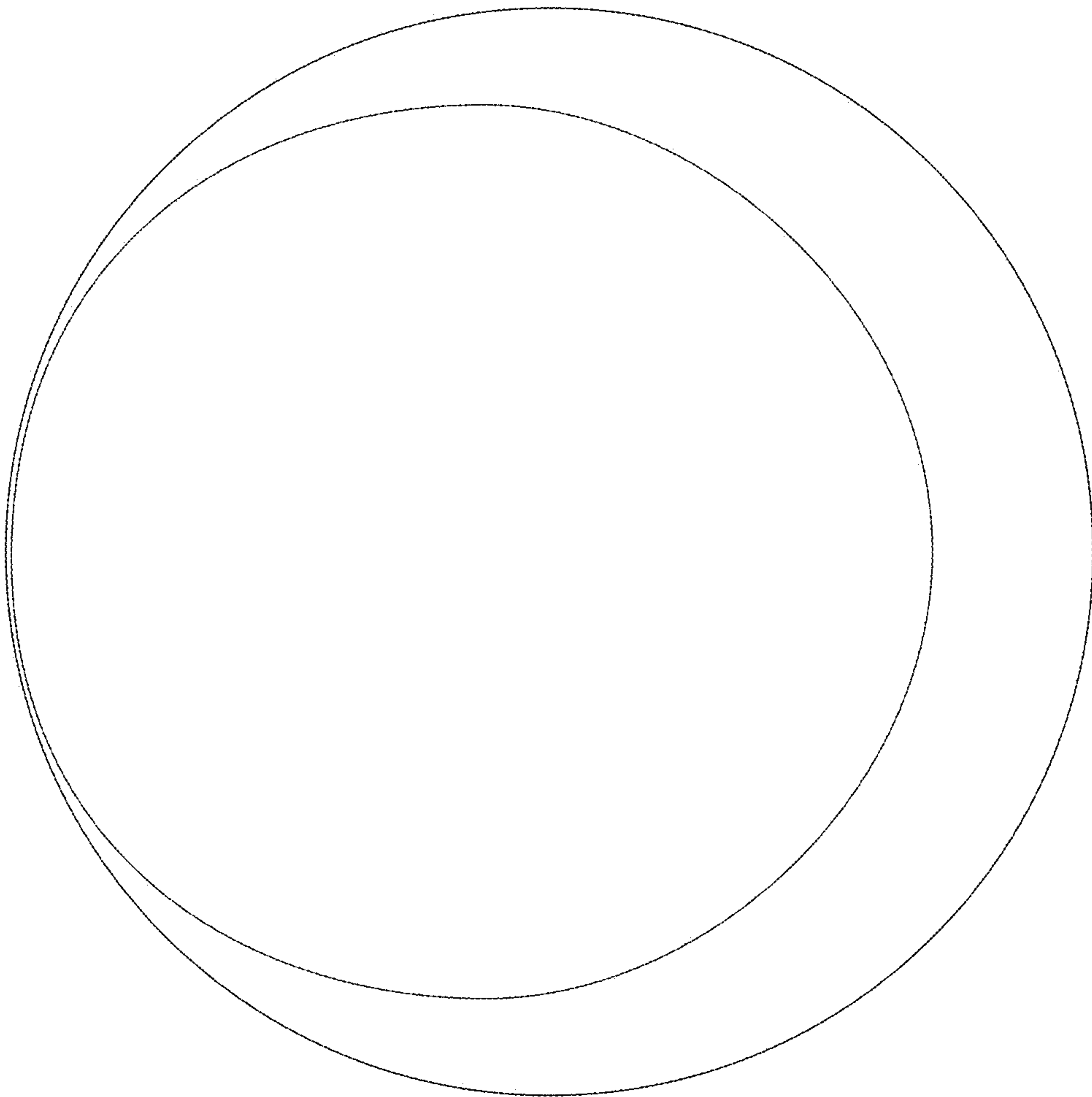

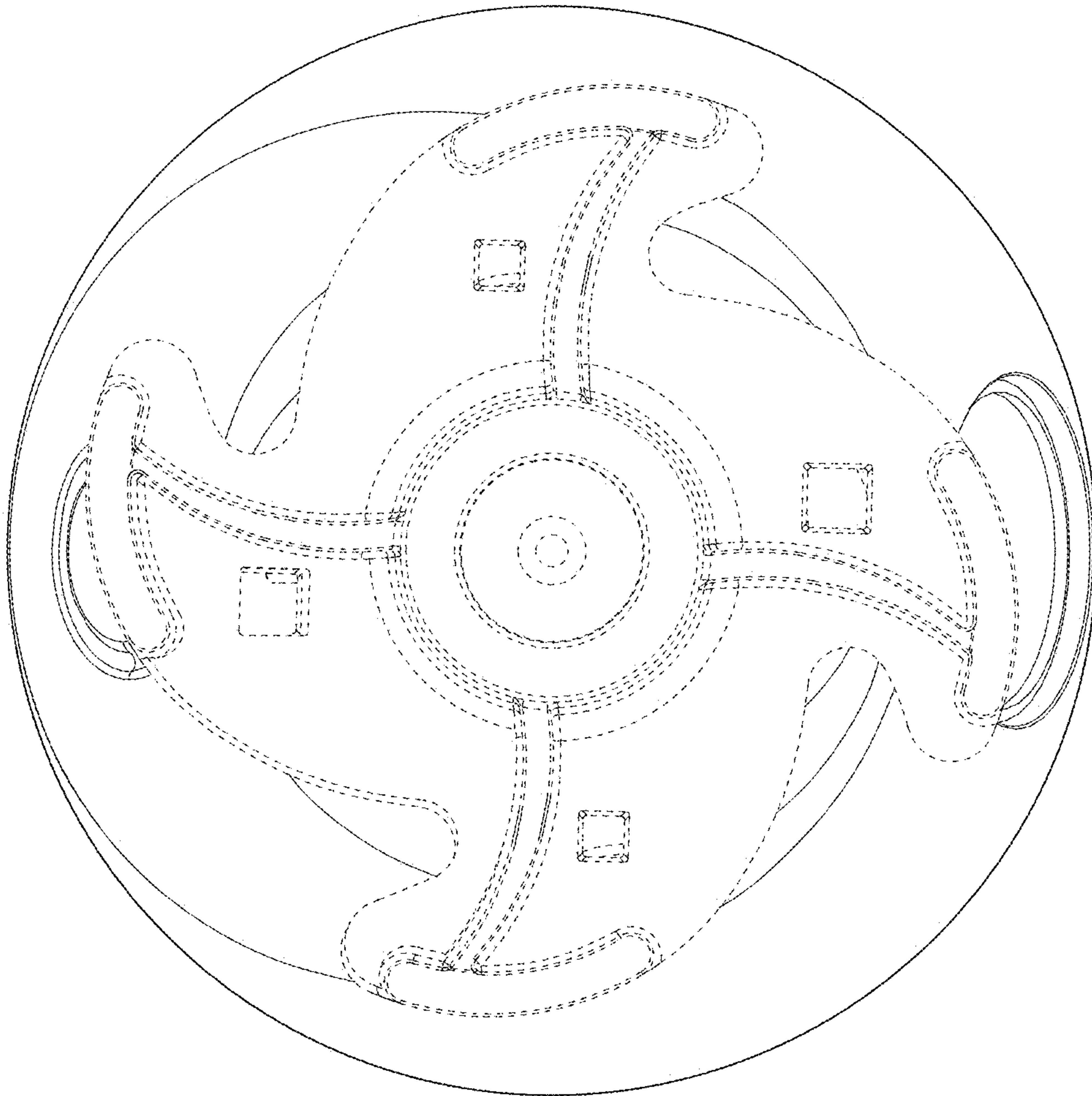

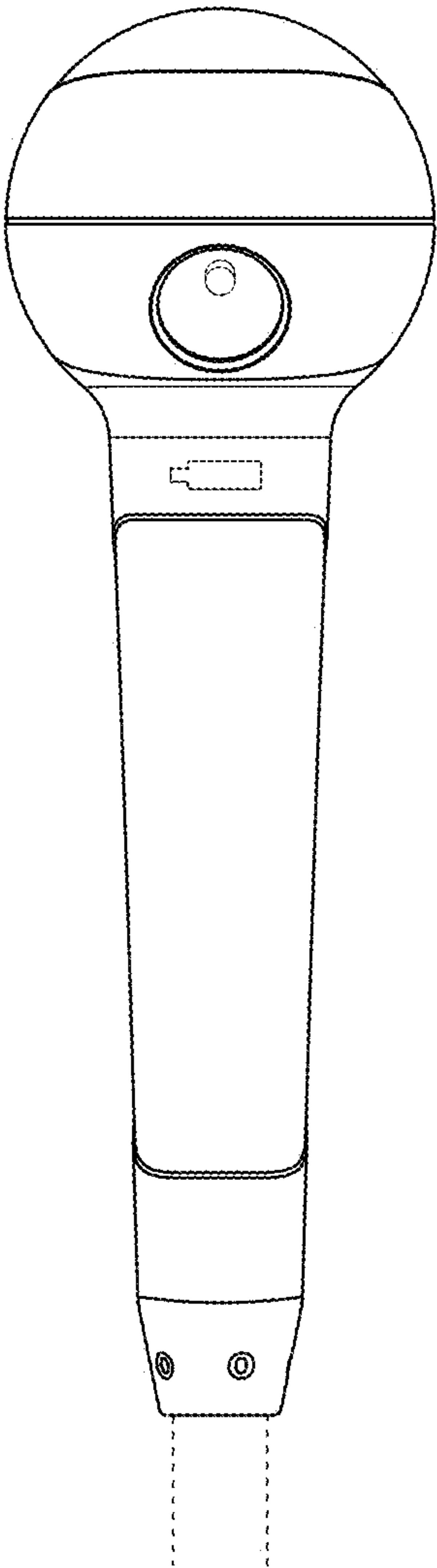
