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(57) **CLAIM**

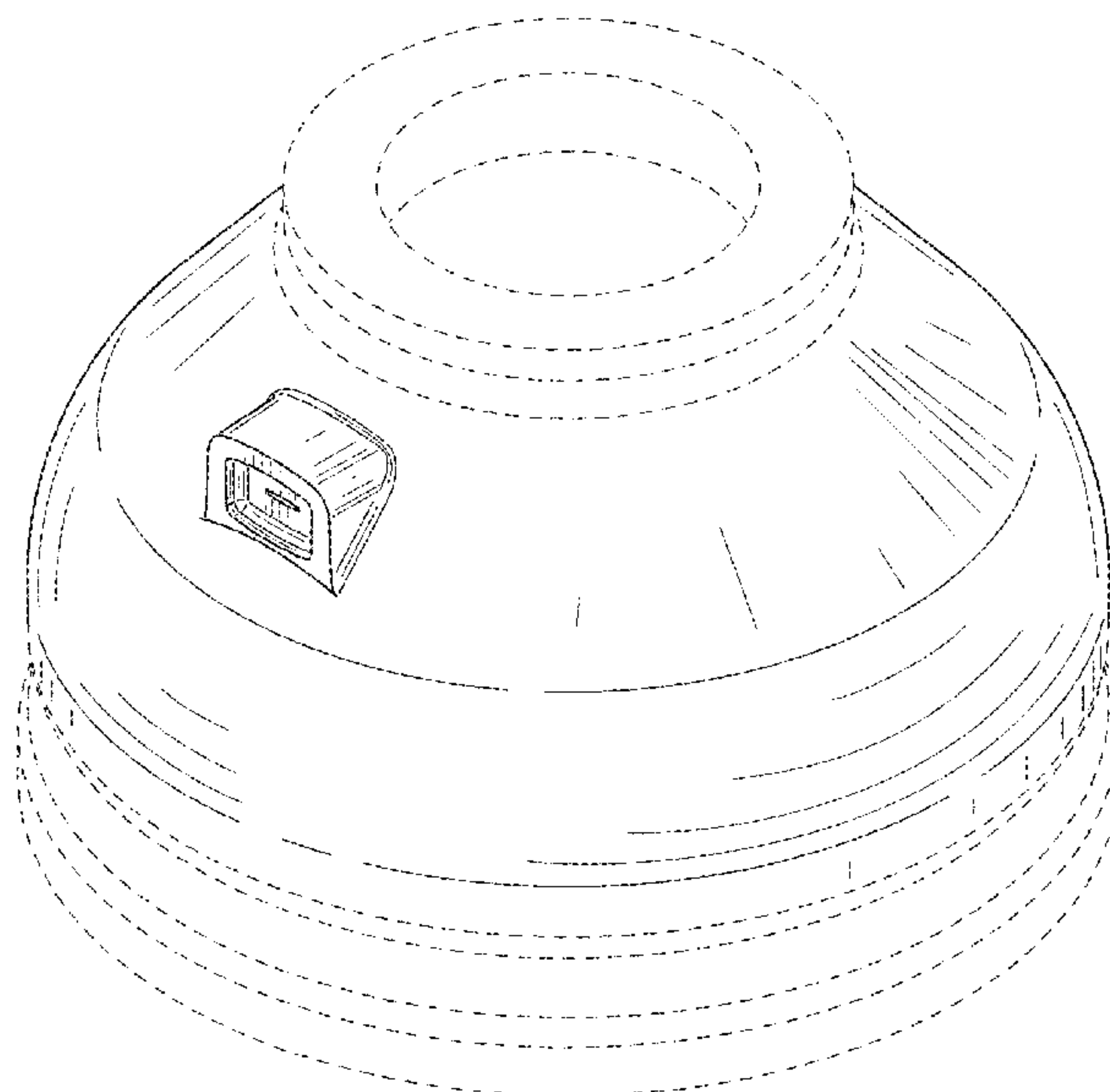
The ornamental design for a dust boot, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a dust boot, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front side view of the dust boot in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a back side view of the dust boot in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left side view of the dust boot in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the dust boot in FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the dust boot in FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the dust boot in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 8 is an isometric view of the dust boot in FIG. 1, in a state of use.

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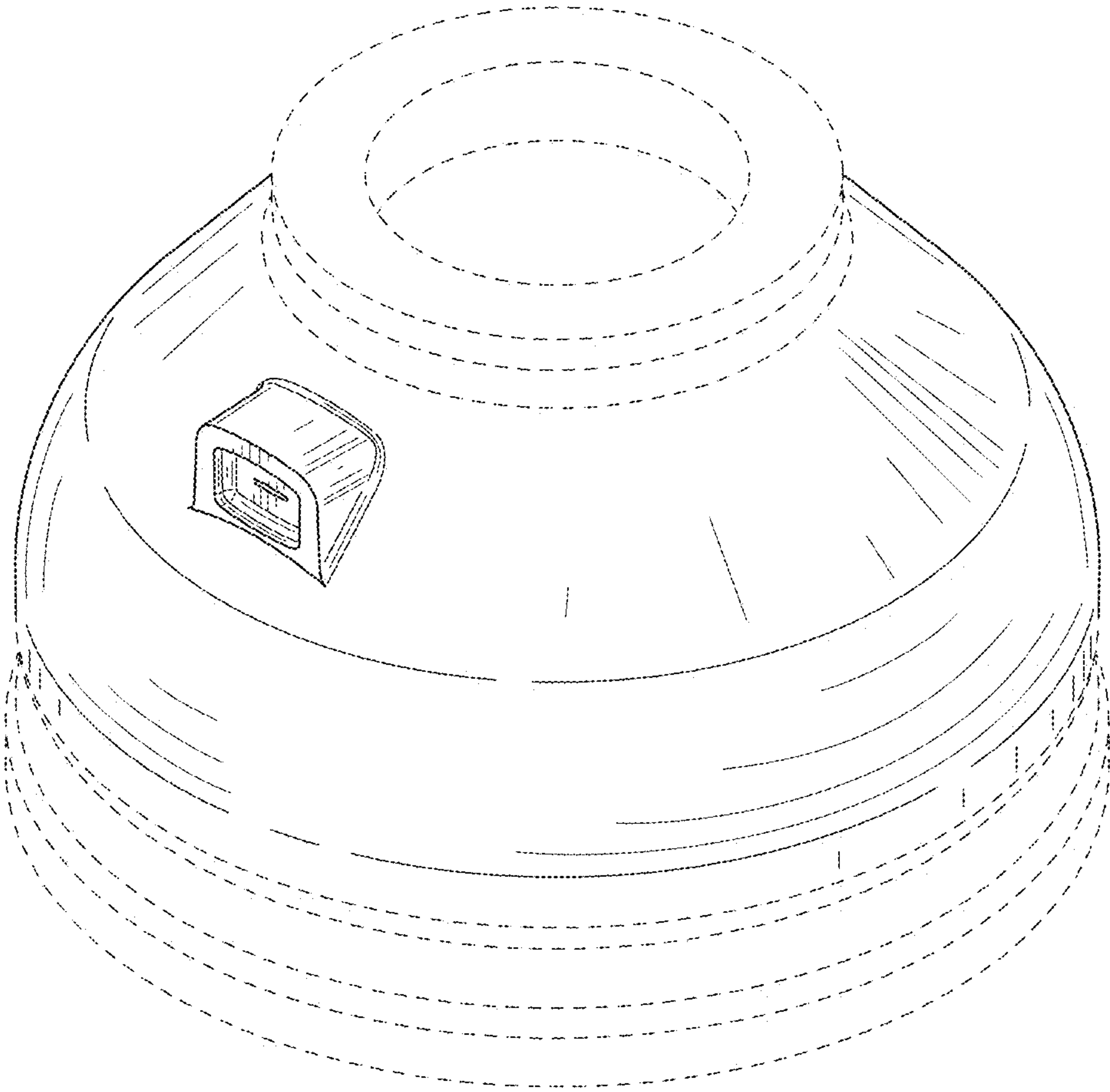

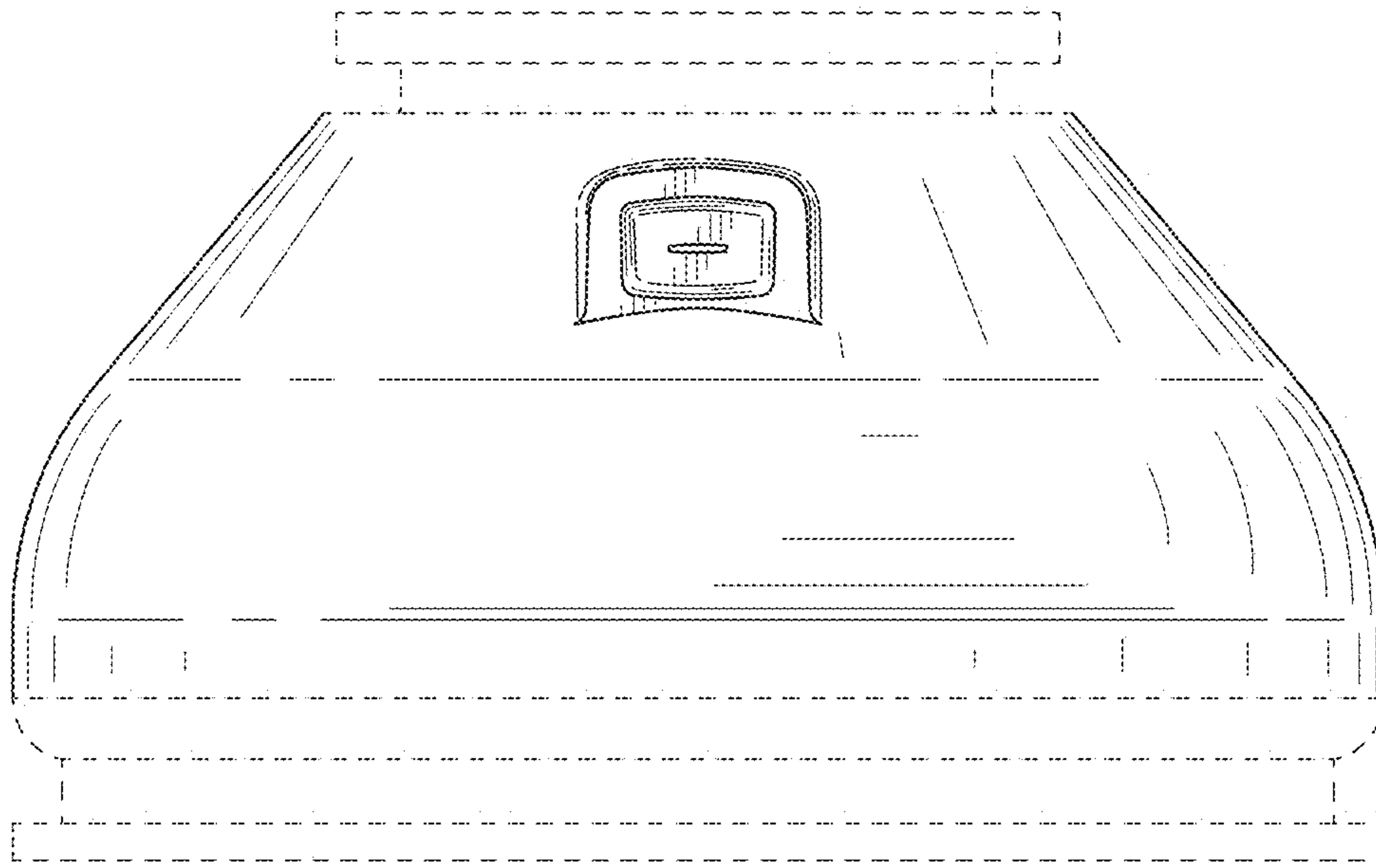

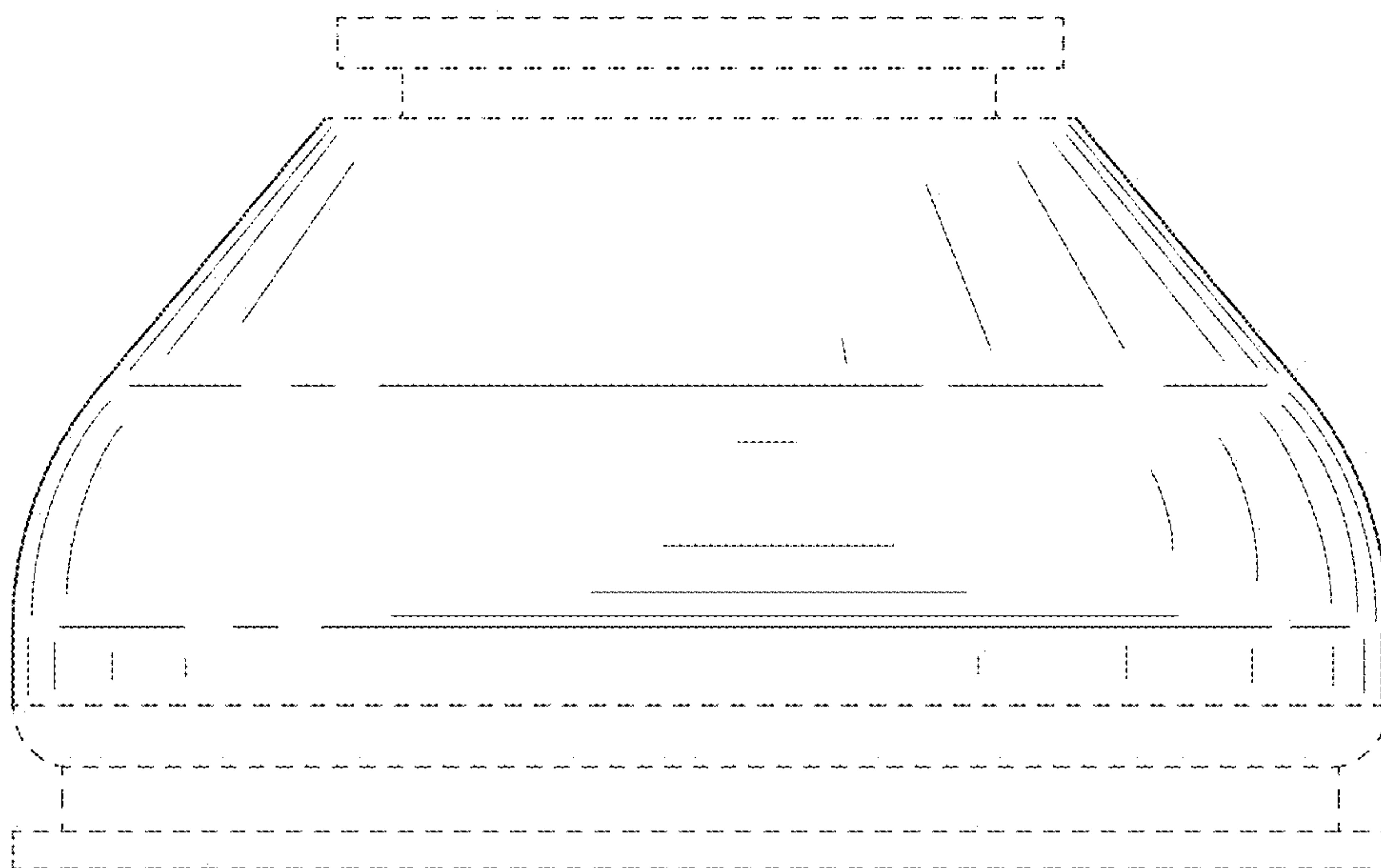

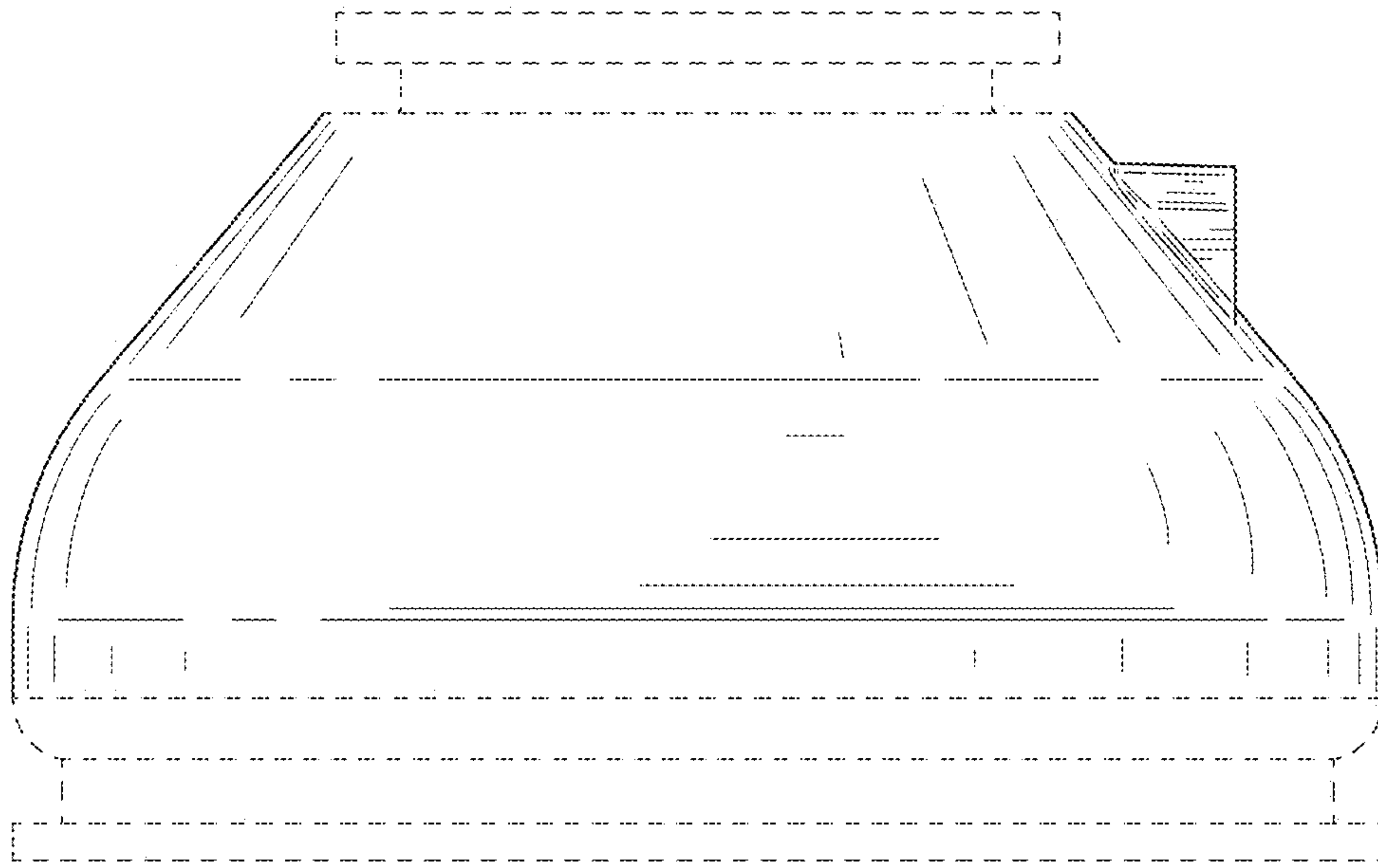

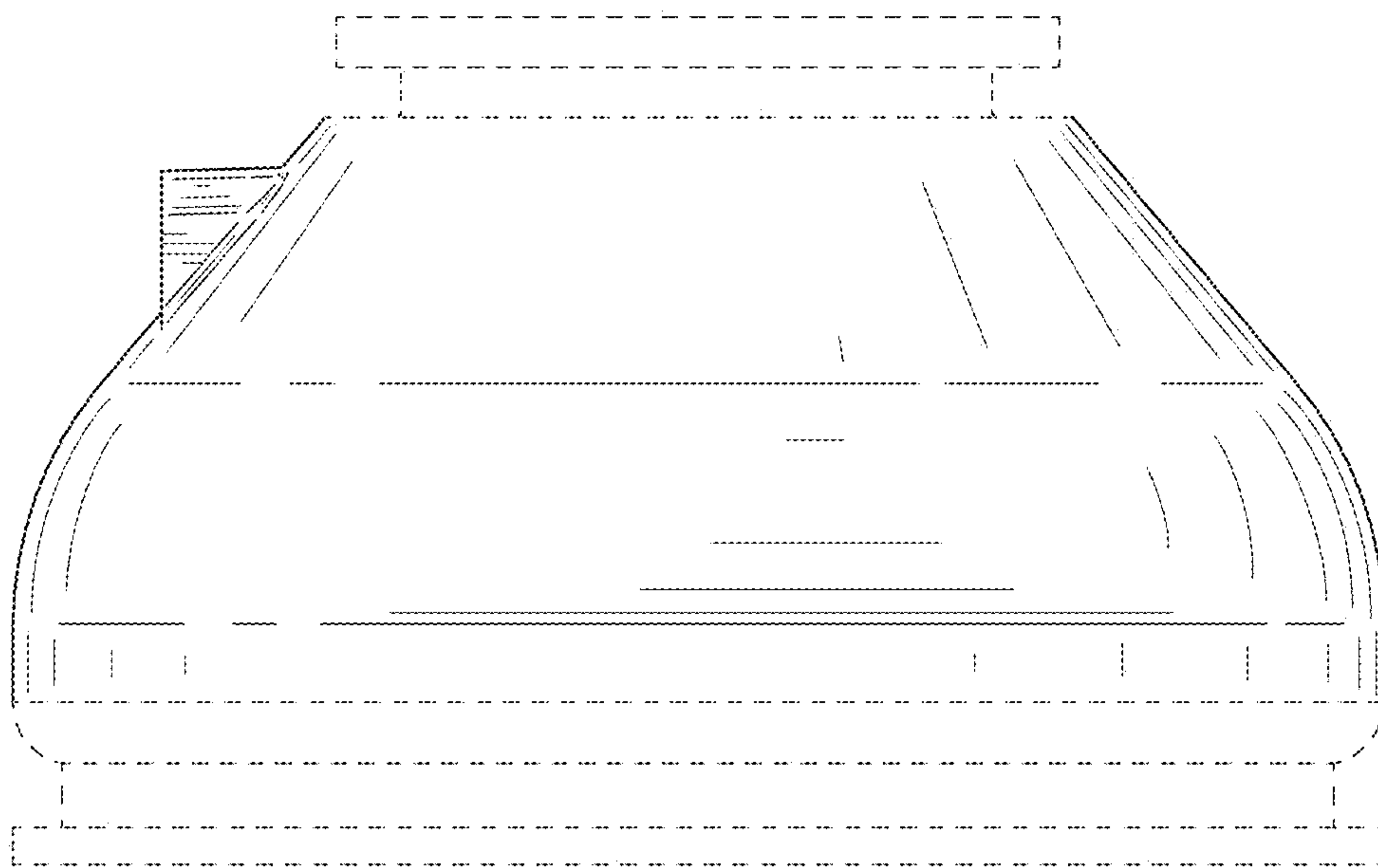

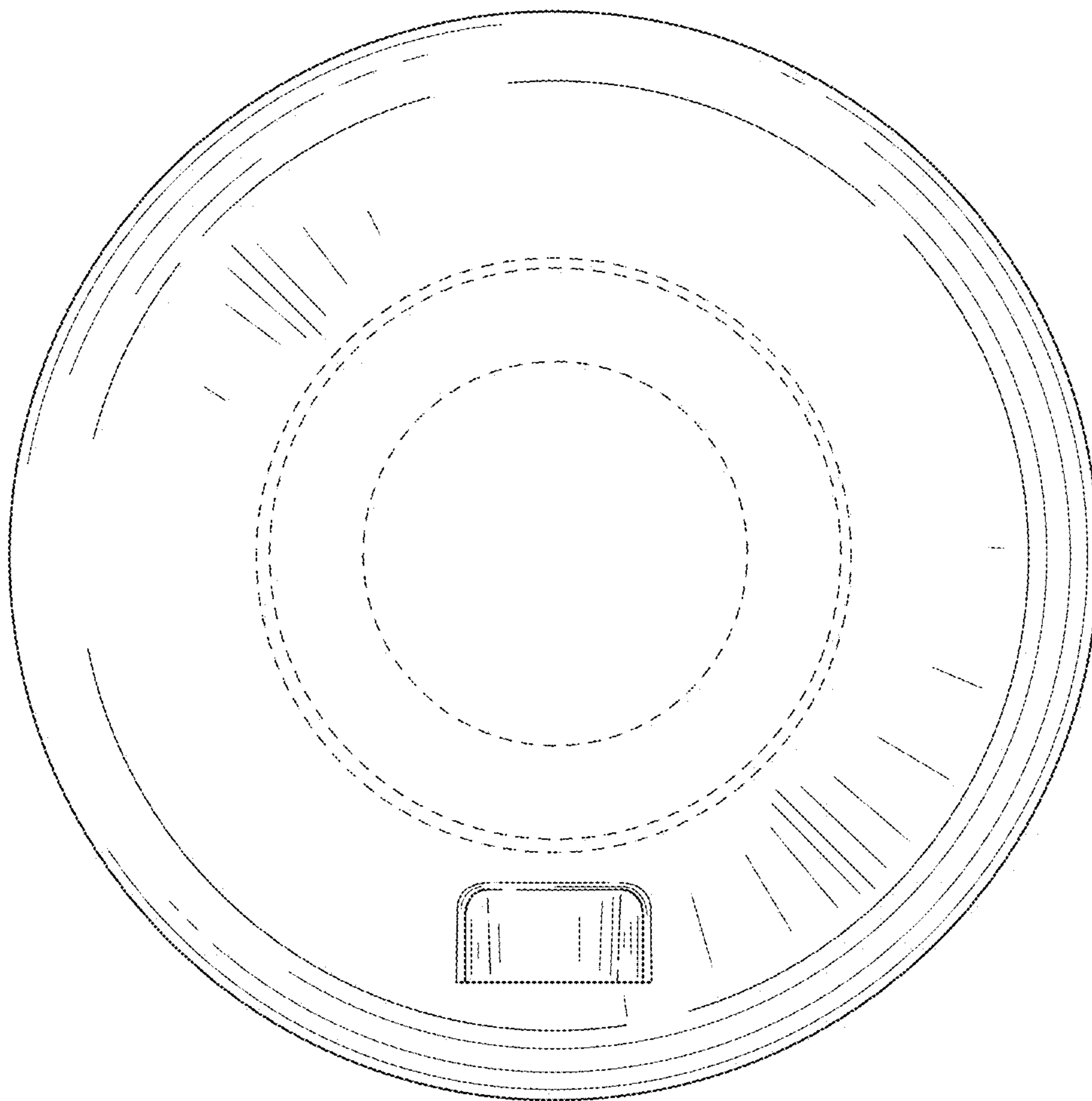

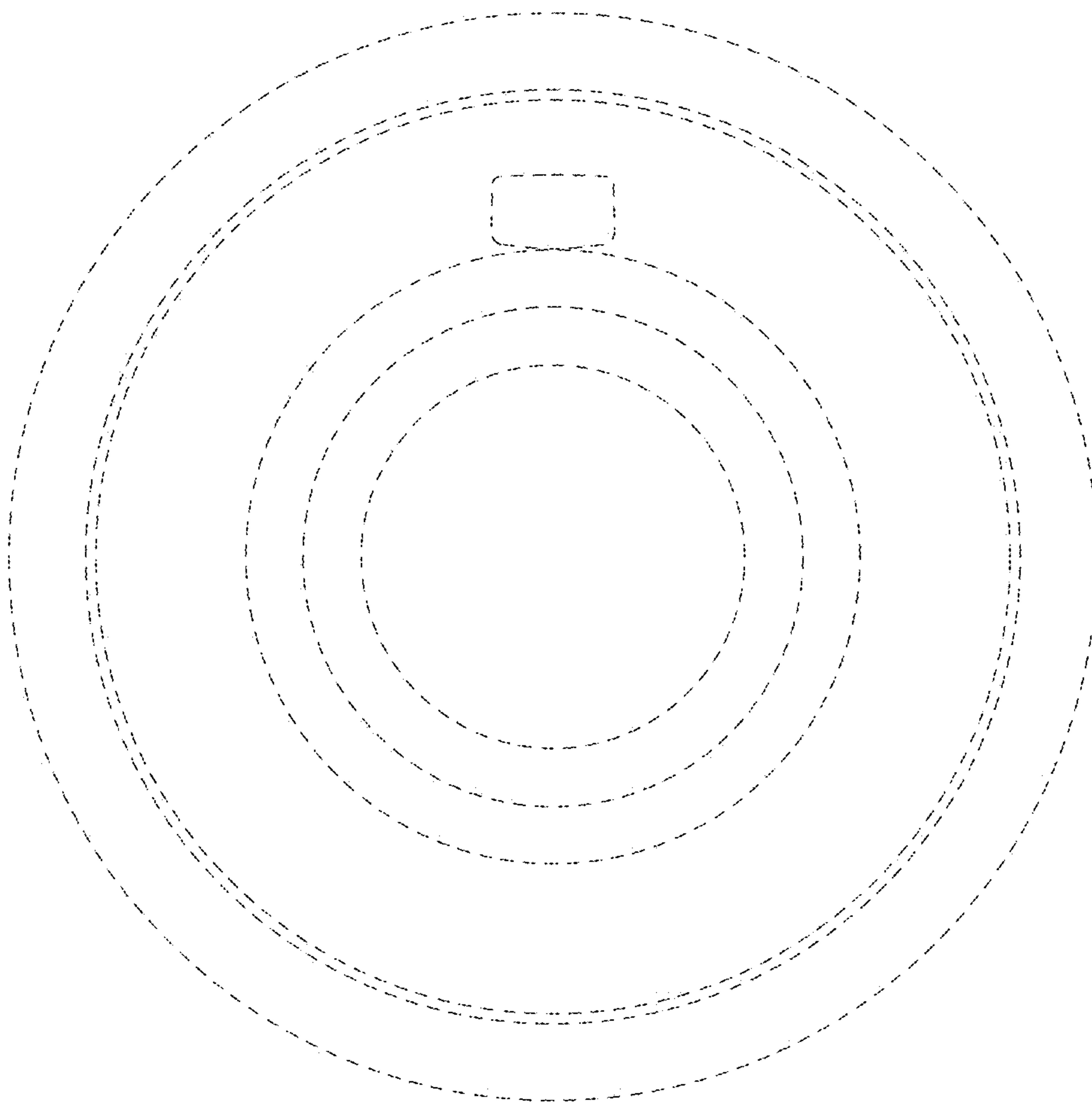

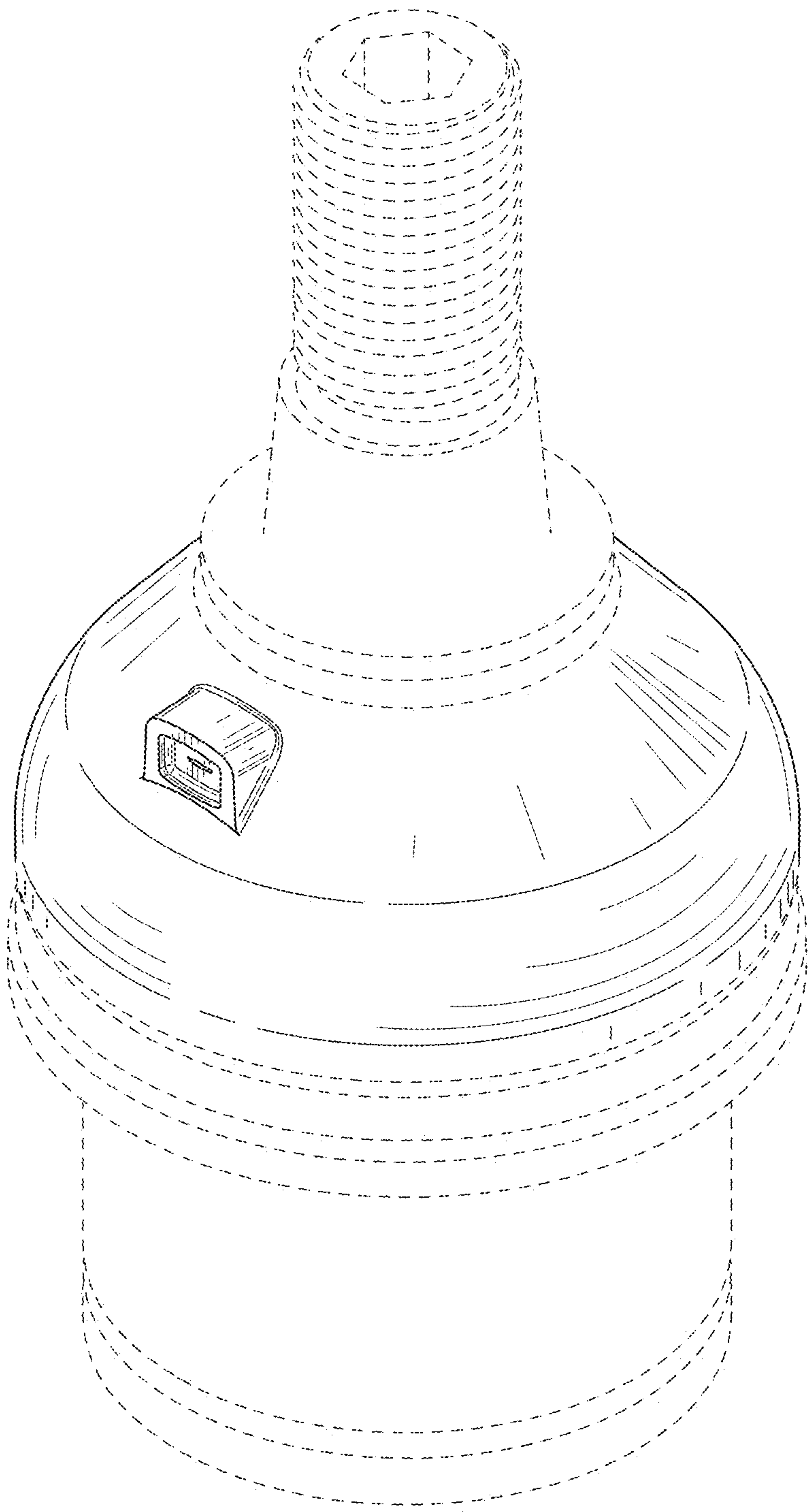
