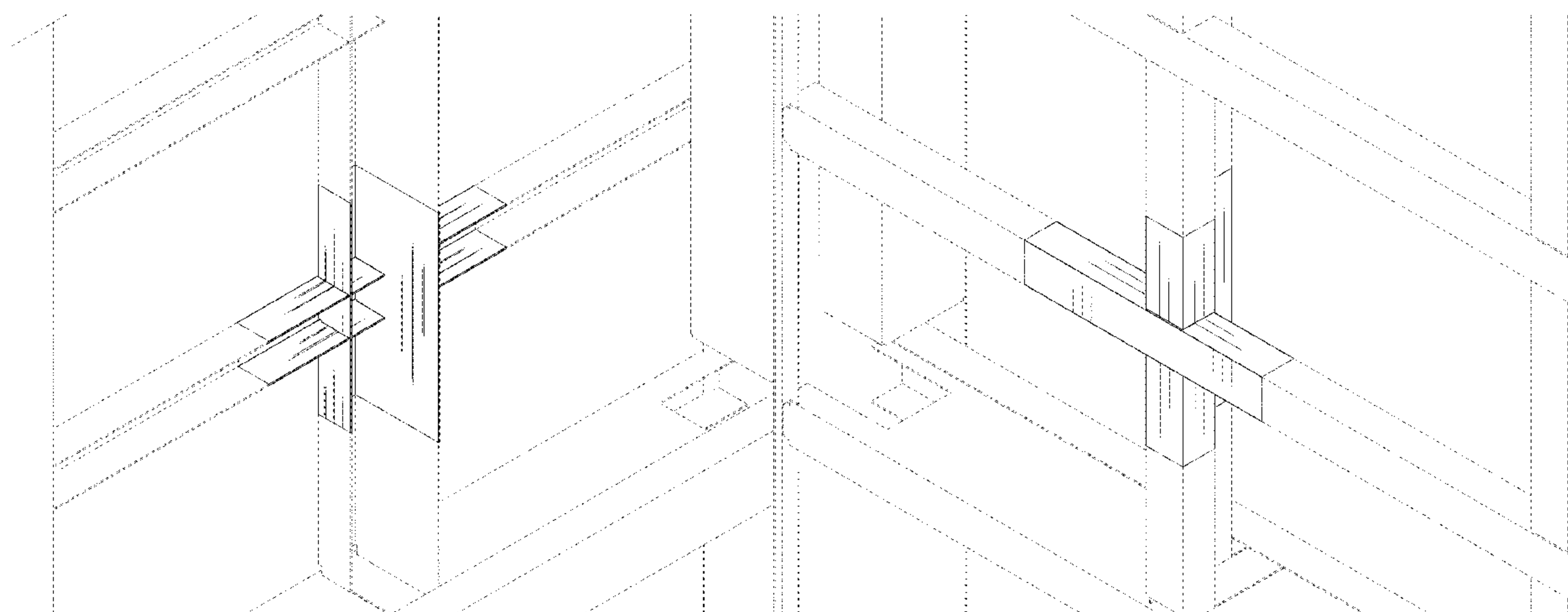
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a mounting frame for light source module, showing an initial embodiment of our new design;

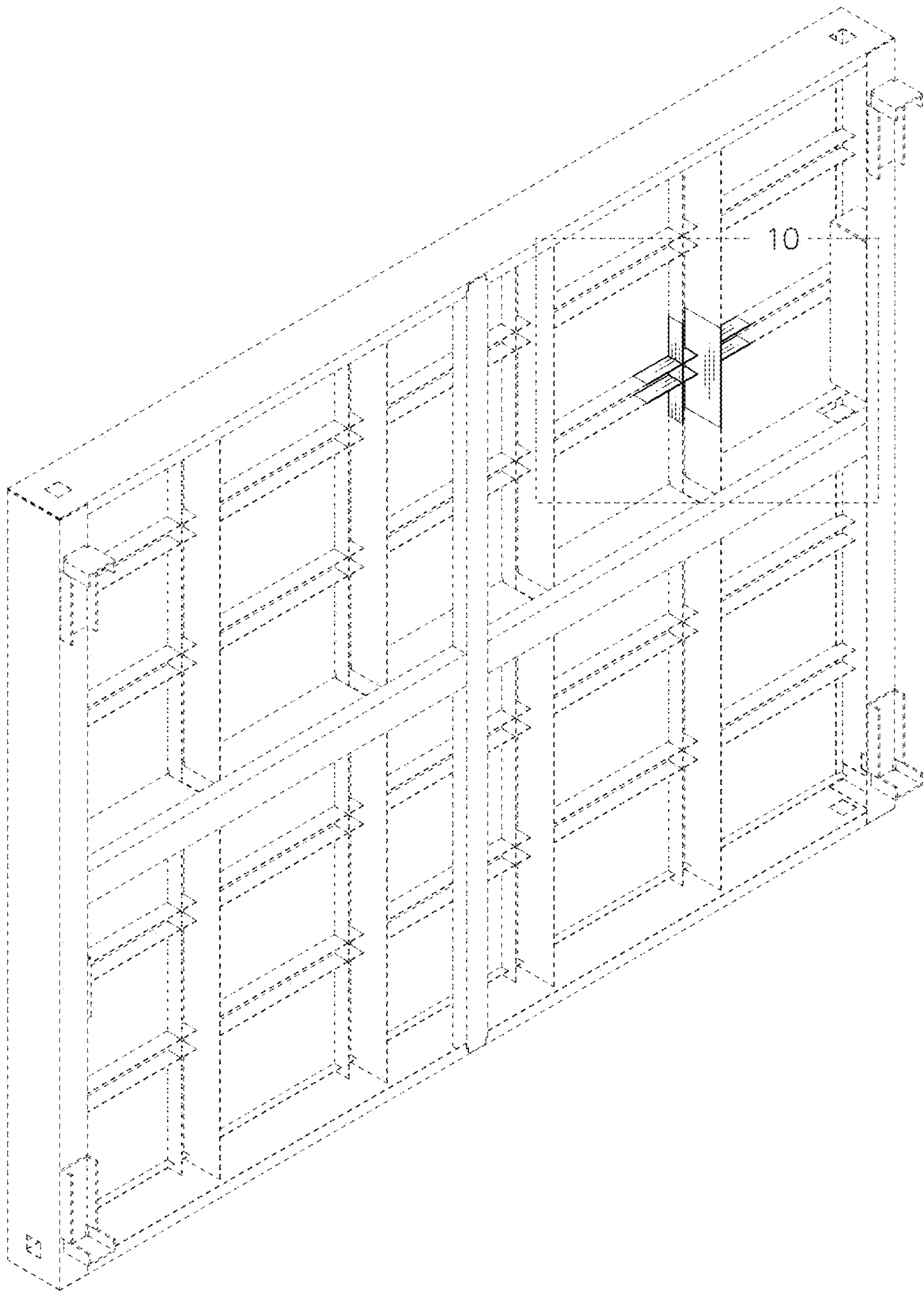

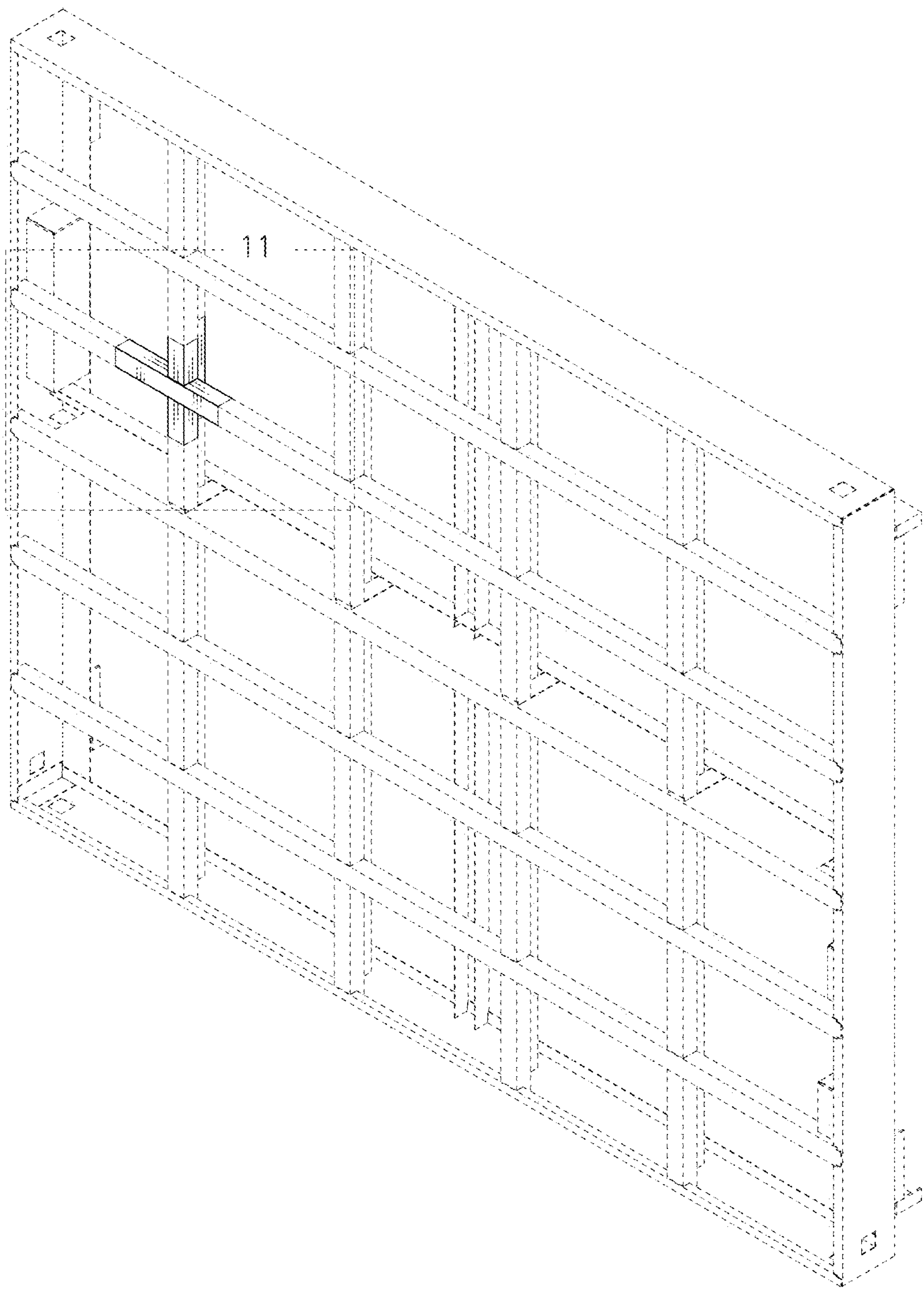

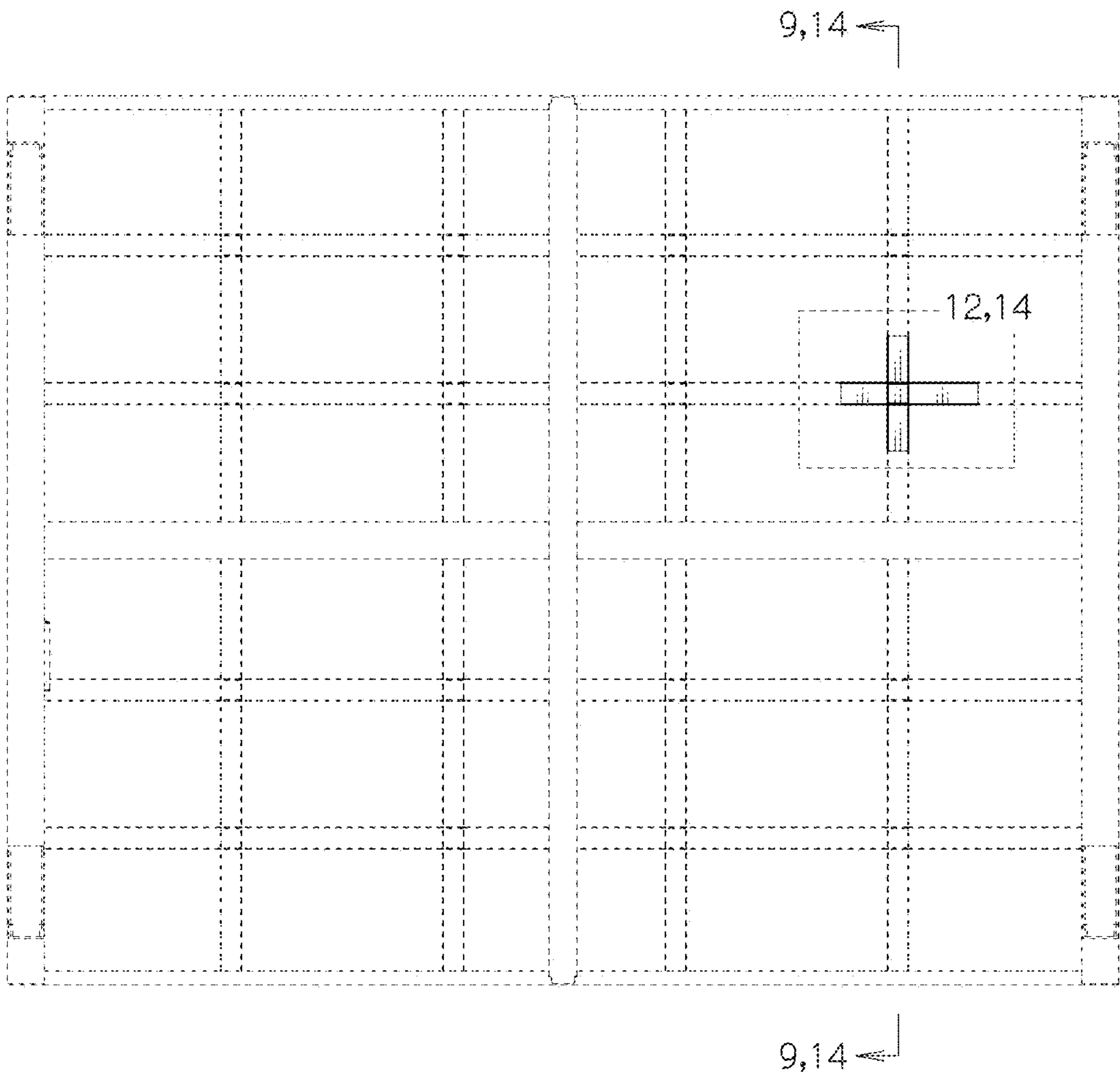

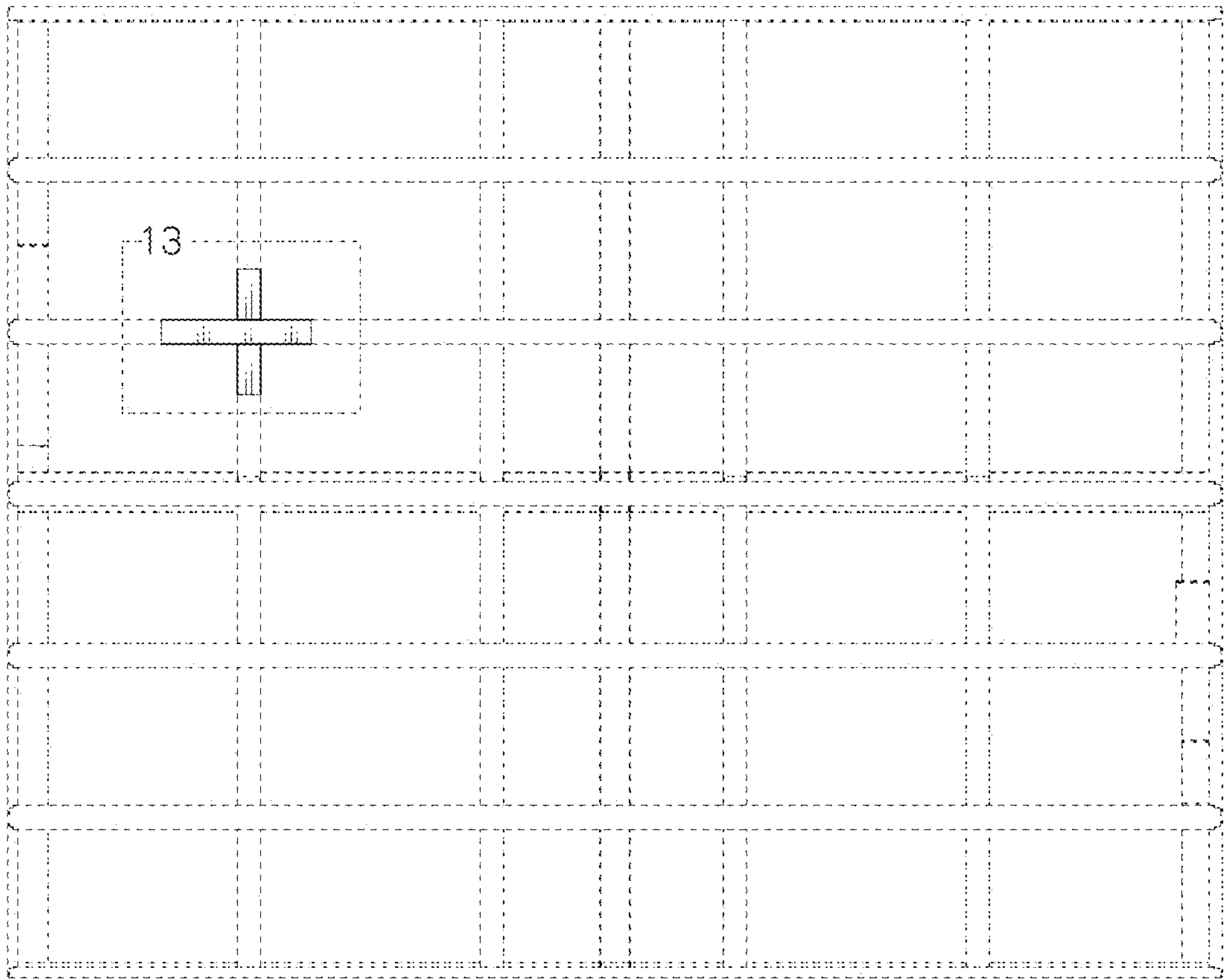

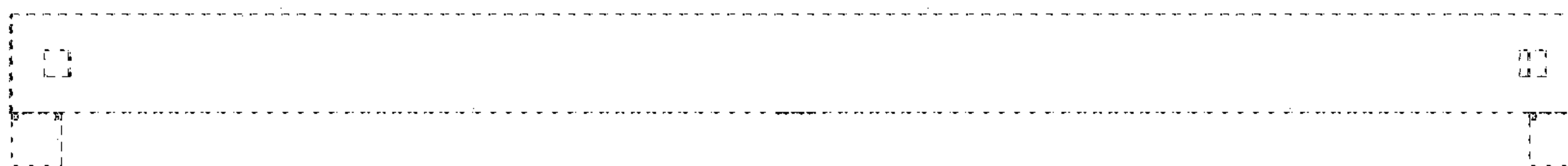

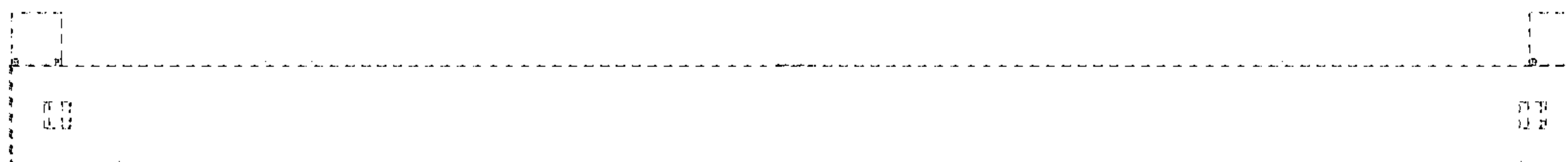

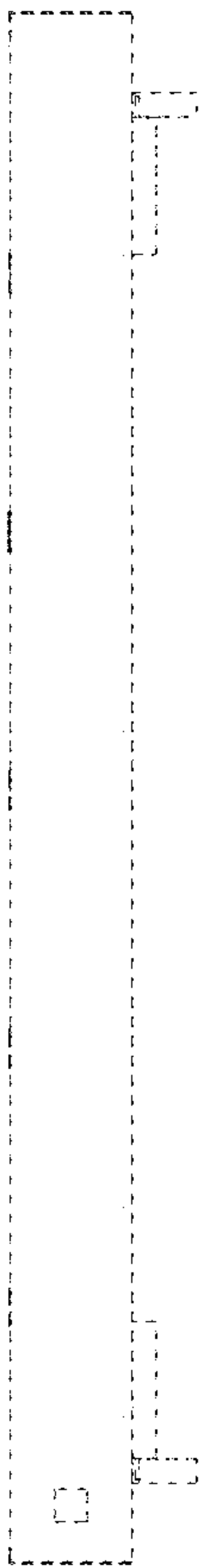

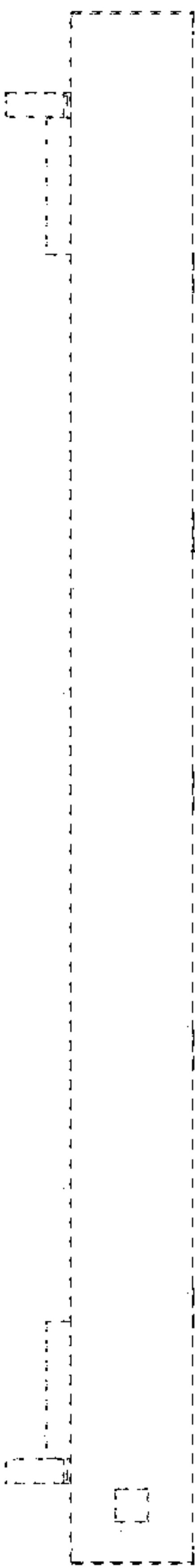

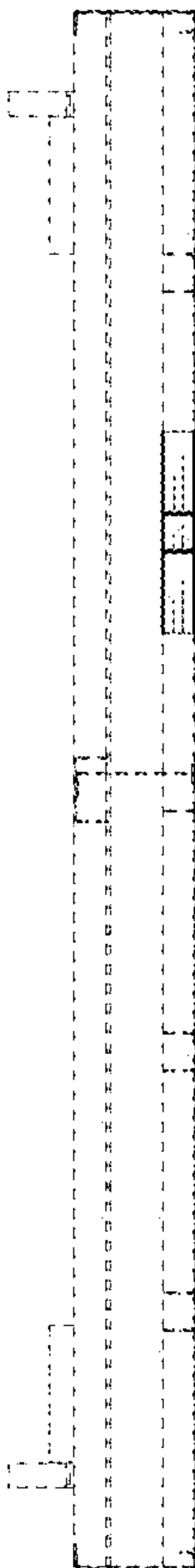

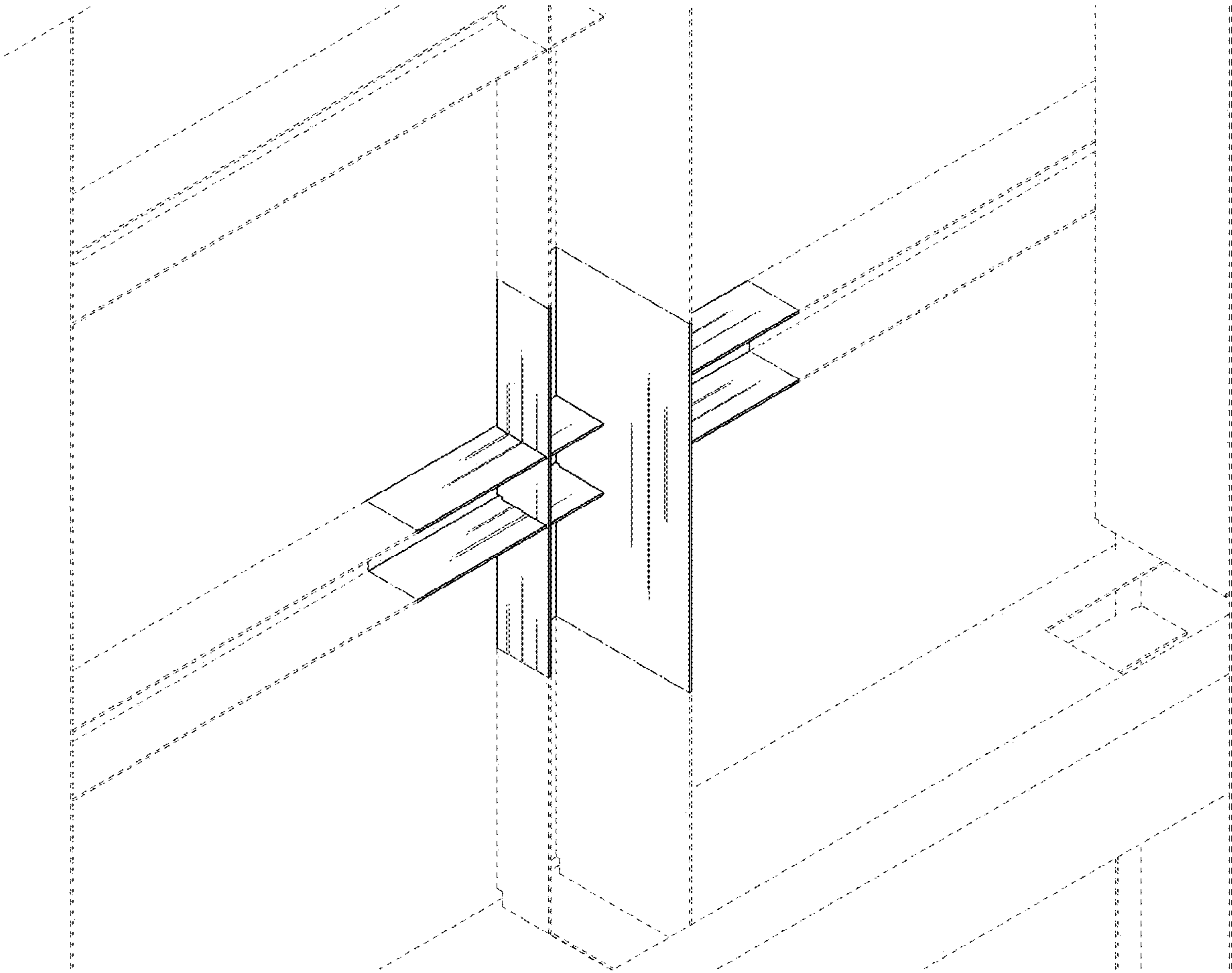

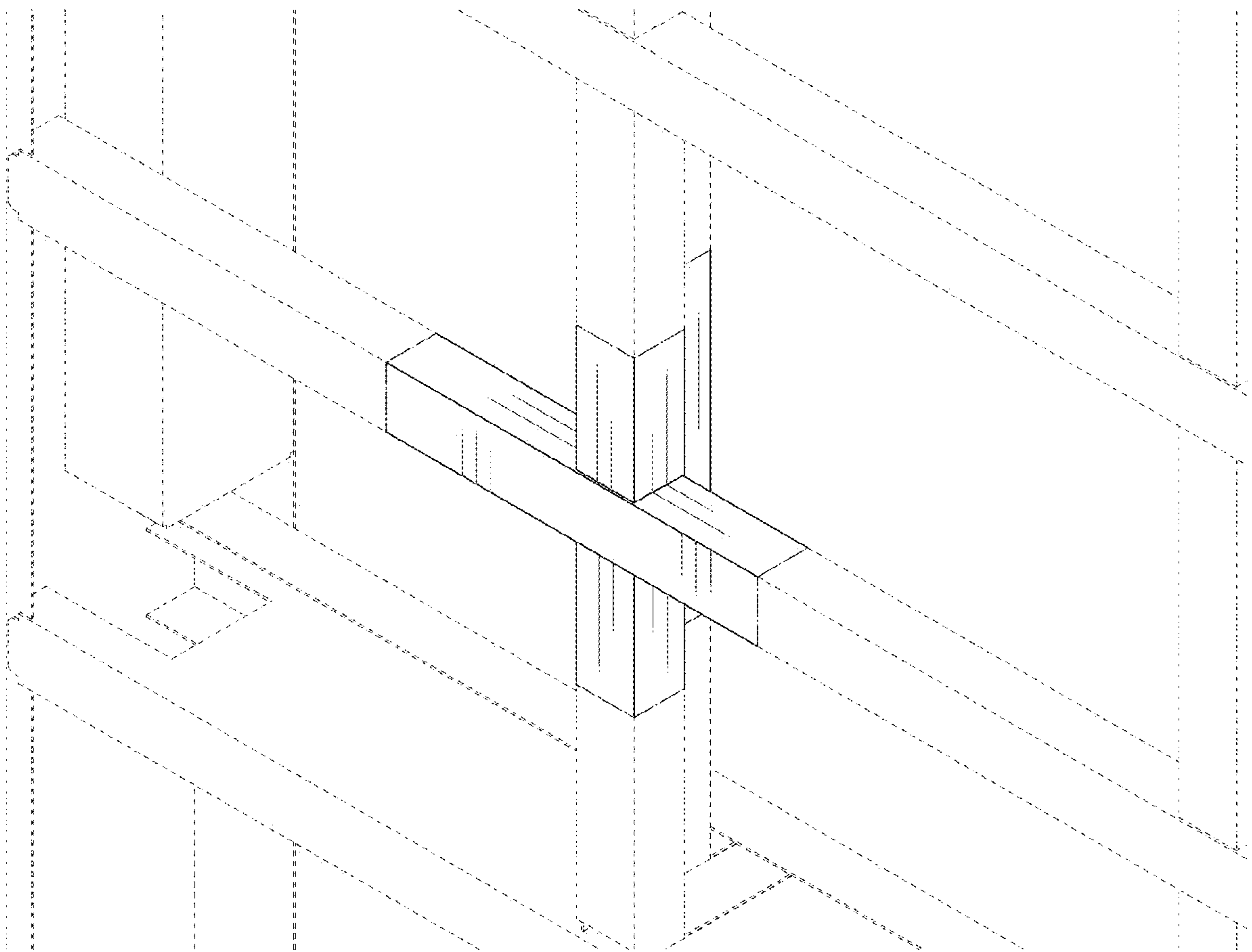

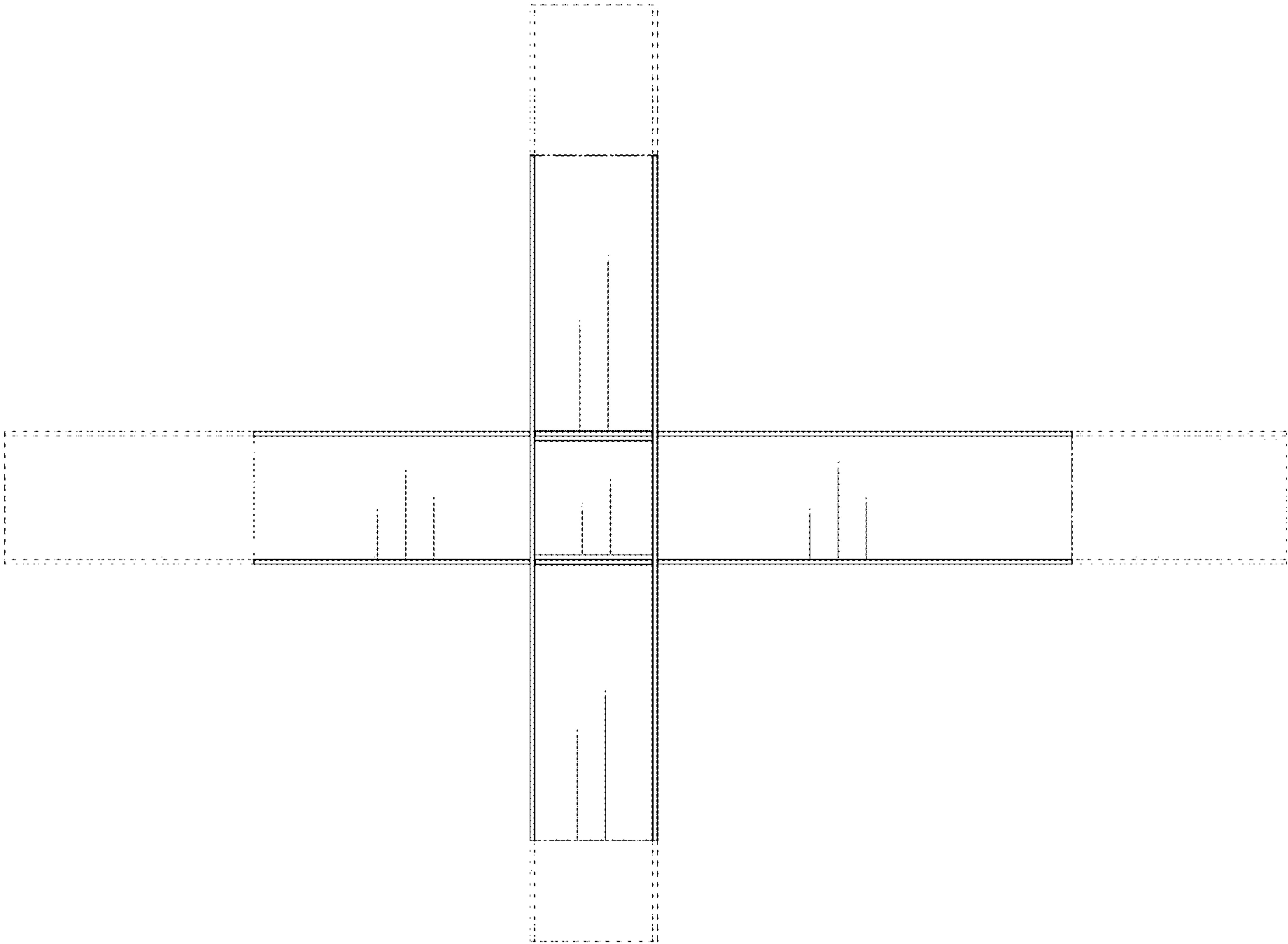

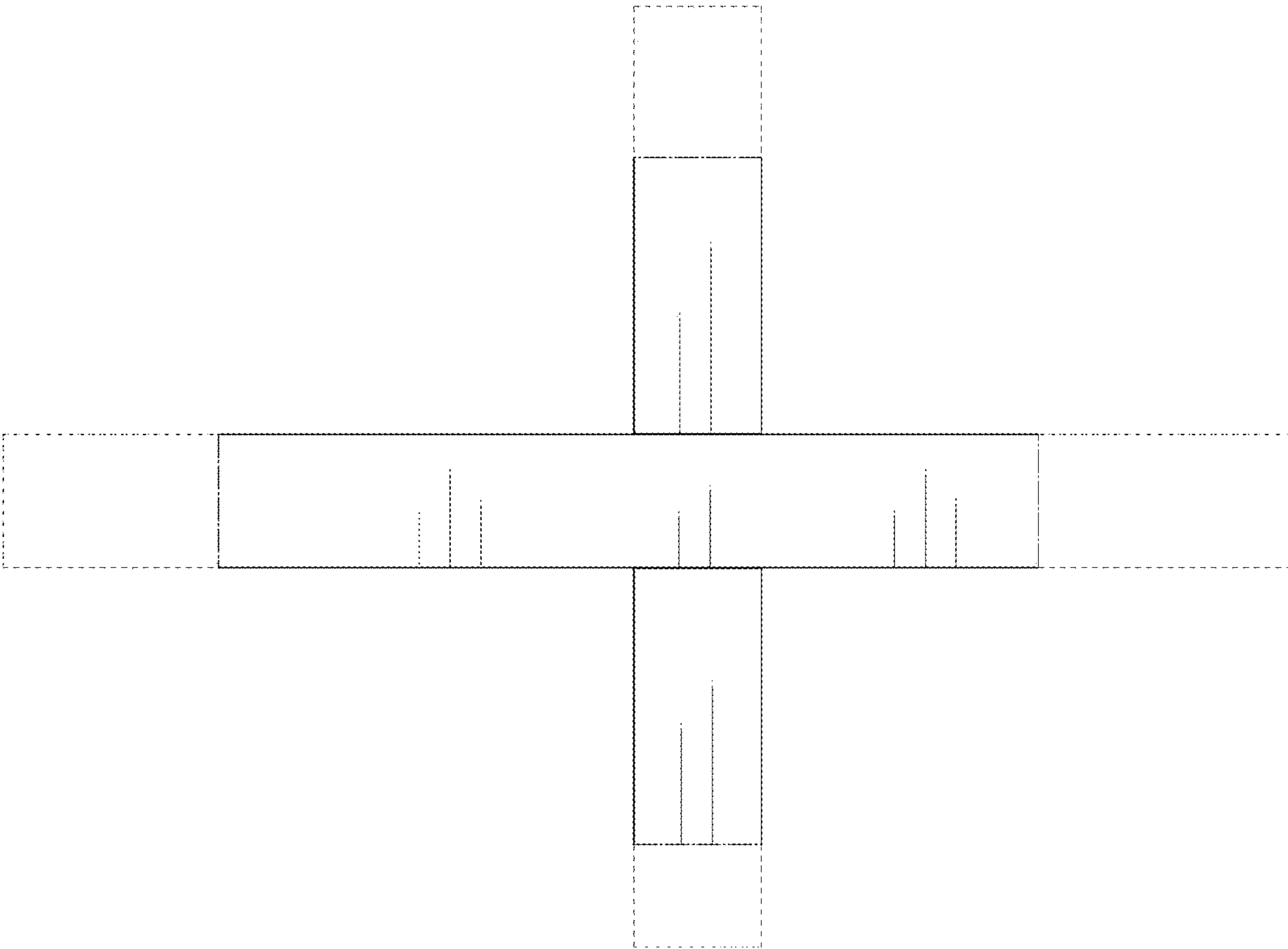

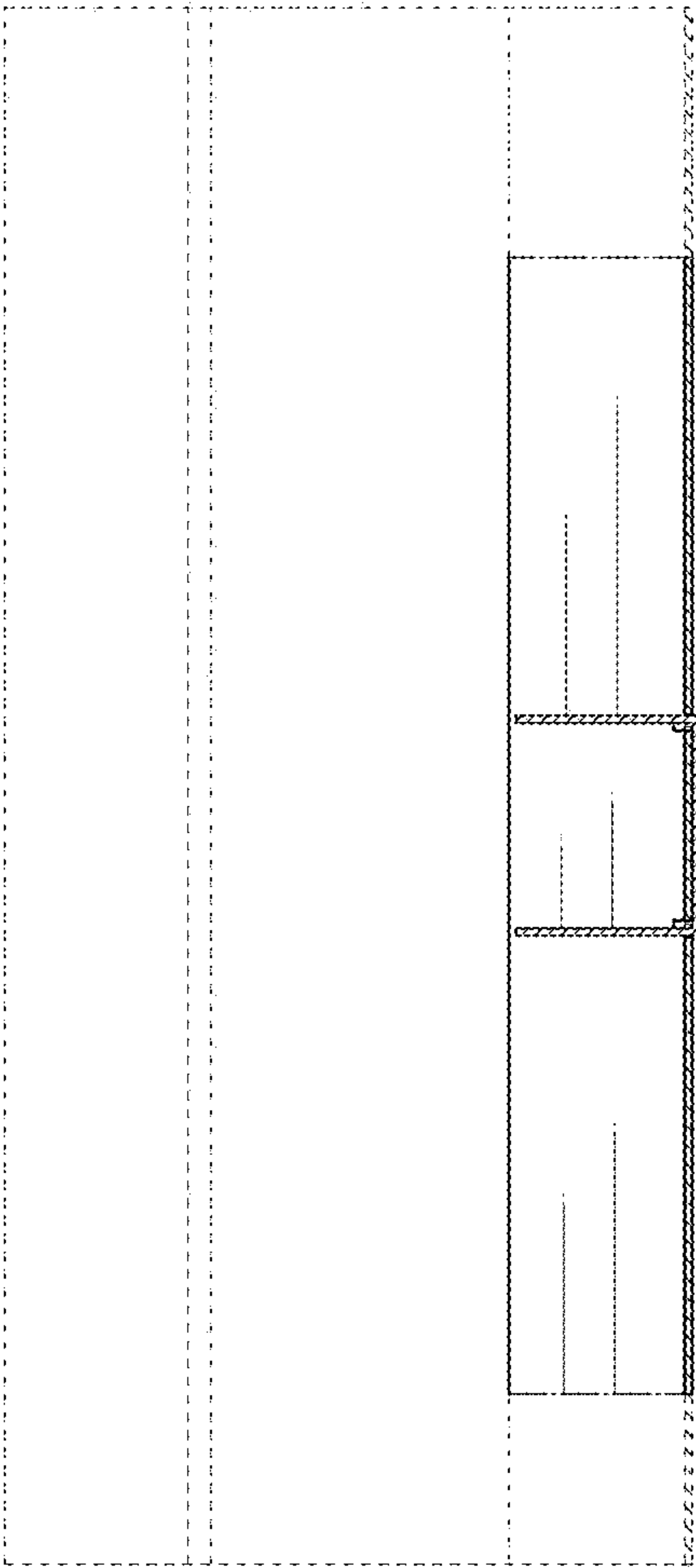

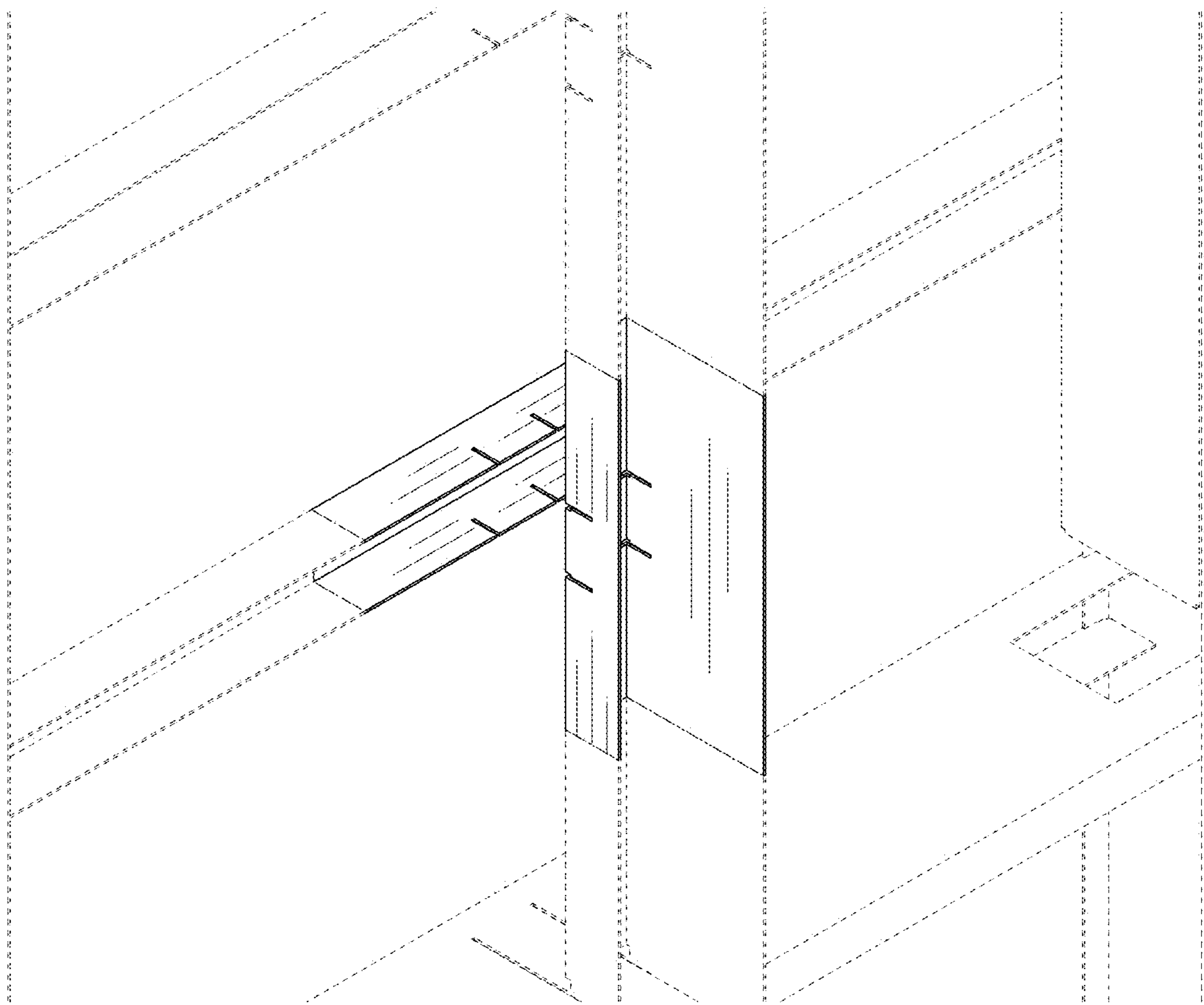

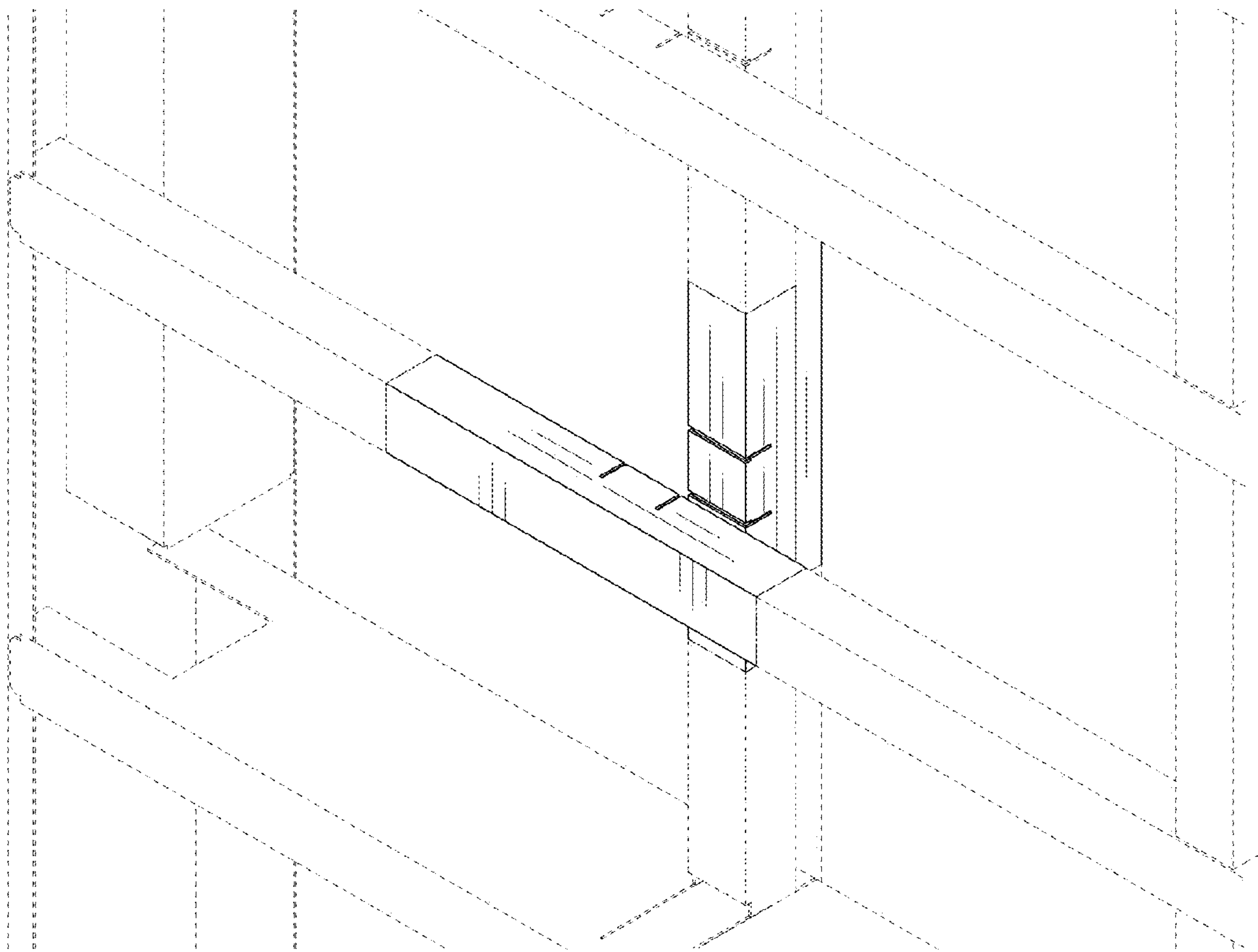
