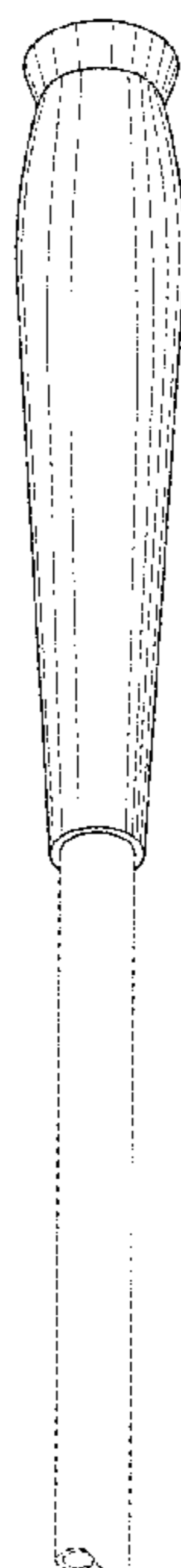
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a grip for golf club, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a grip for golf club showing my design;
 FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

 FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a top view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof;

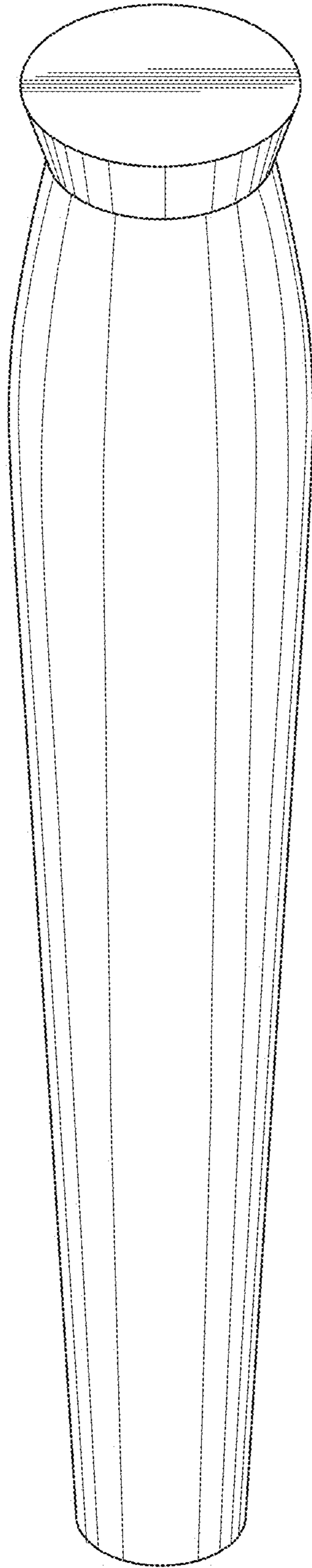

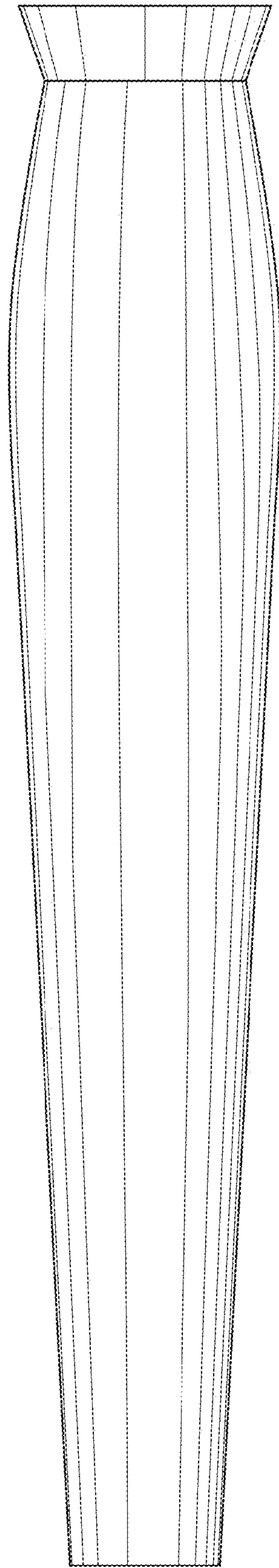

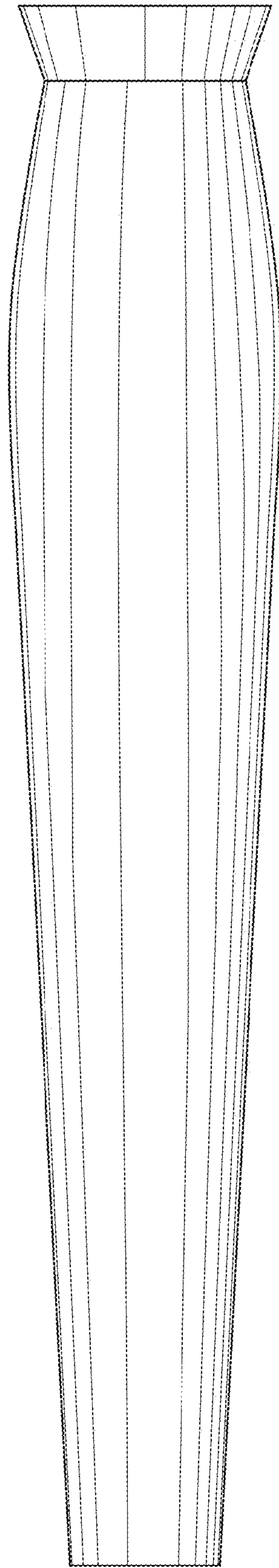

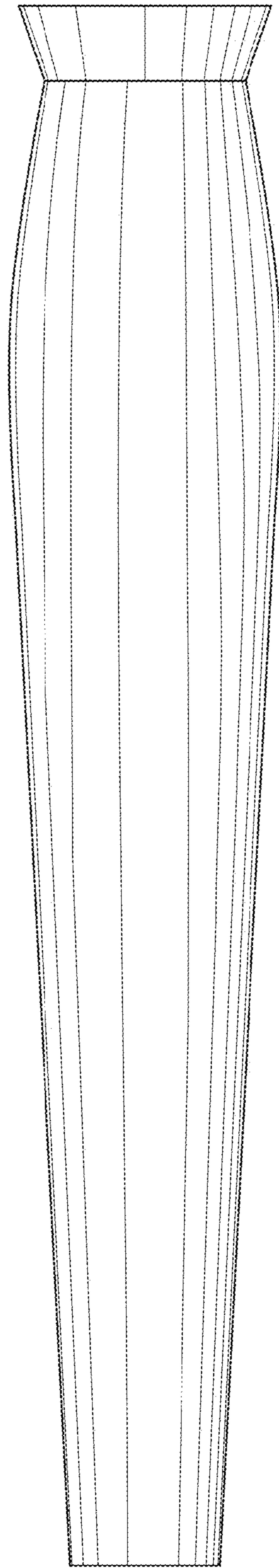

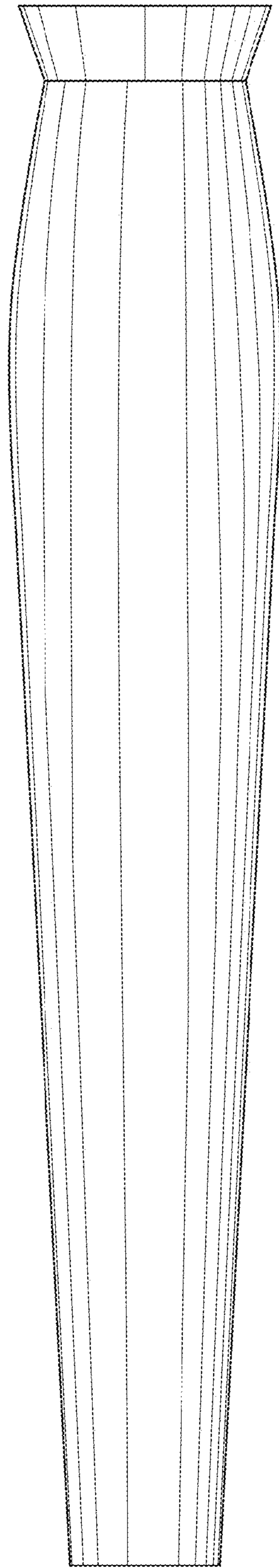

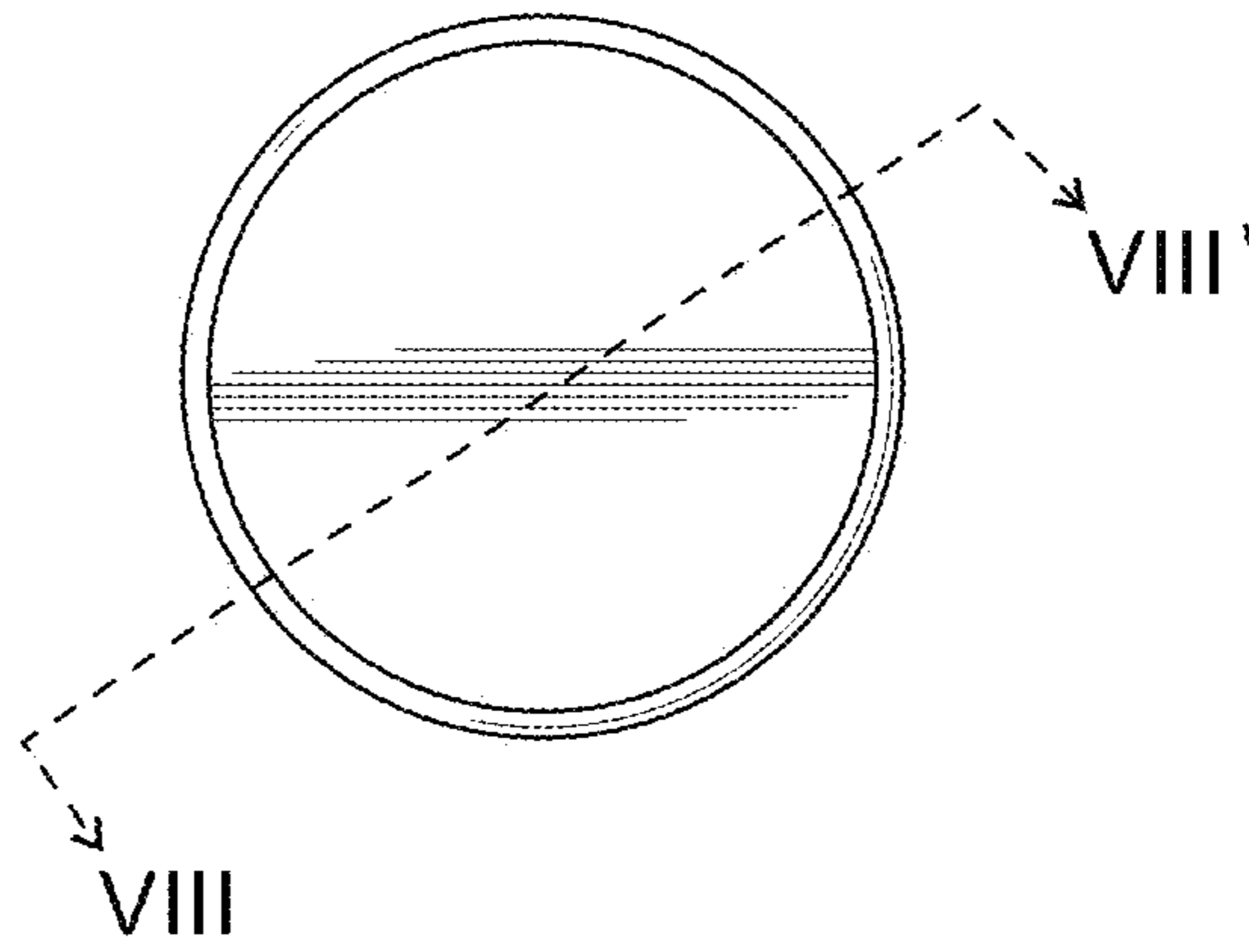

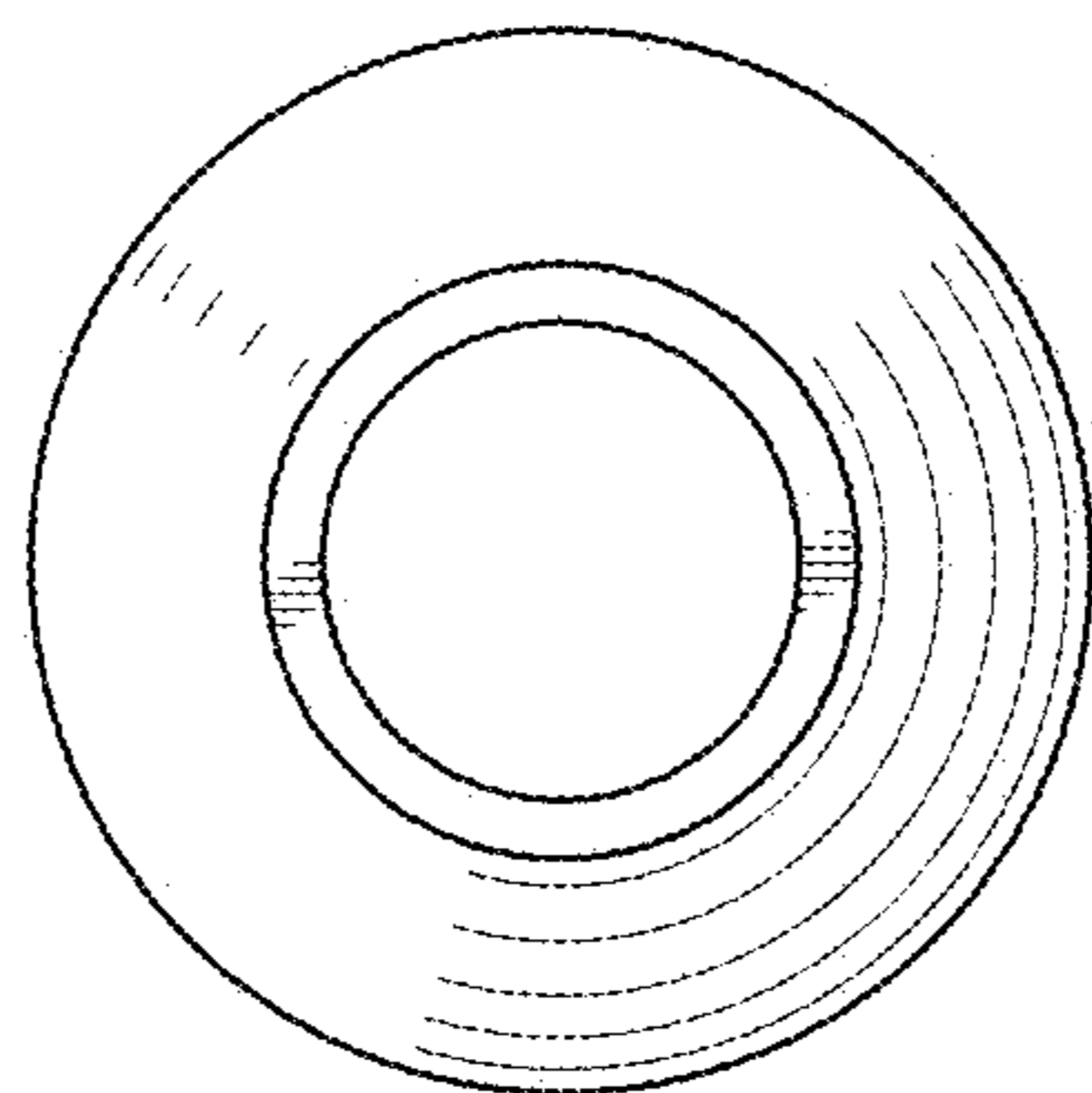

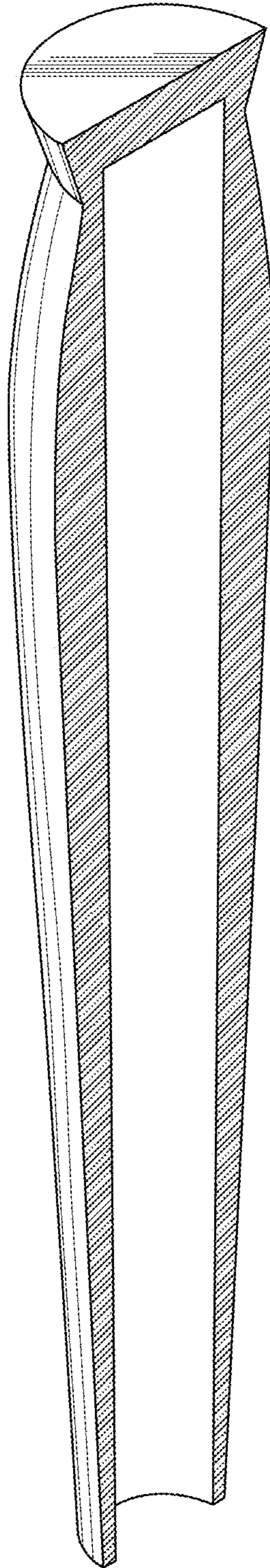

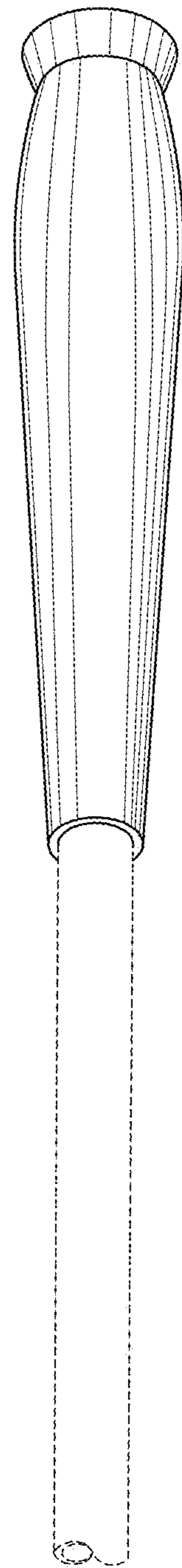
