FIG. 3 is a third perspective view of the oil and aqueous phase separator of FIG. 1.

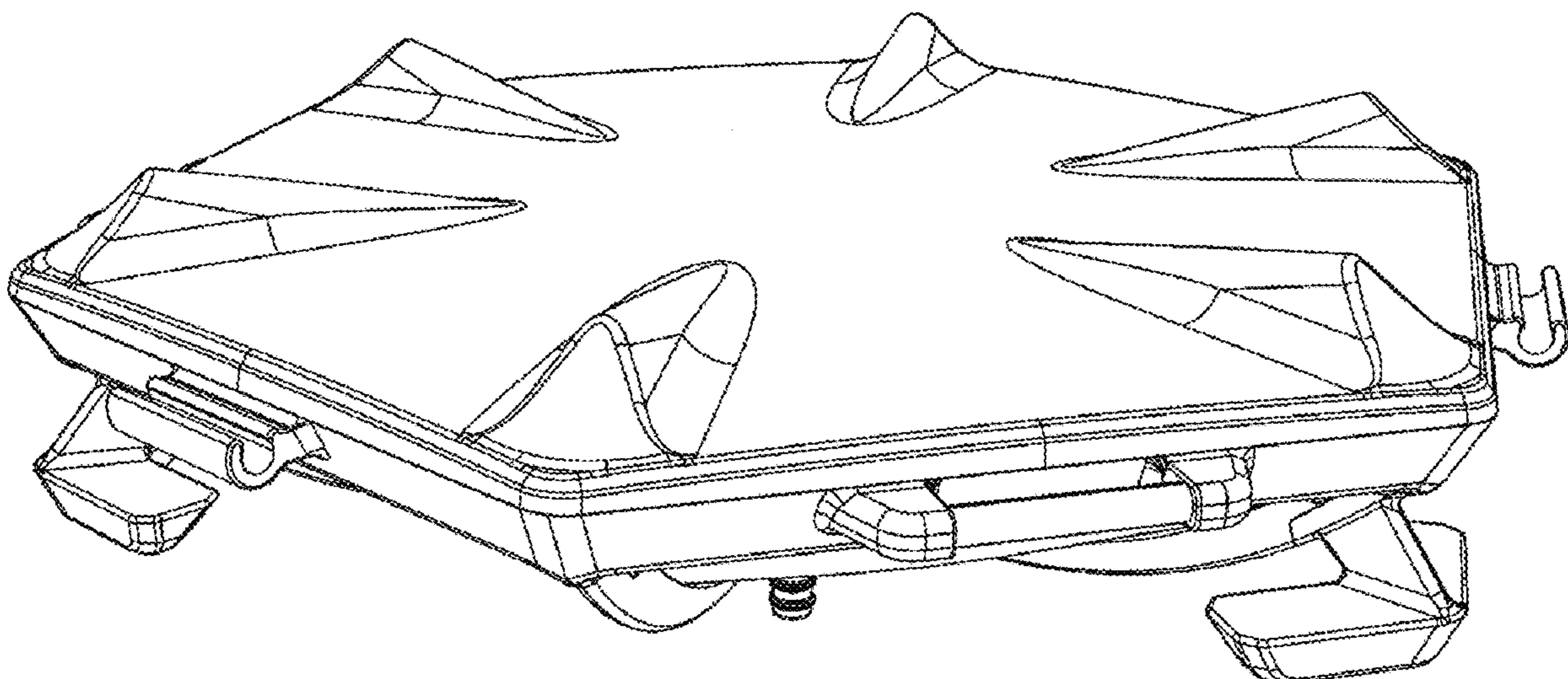
FIG. 4 is a lateral side view of the oil and aqueous phase separator of FIG. 1.

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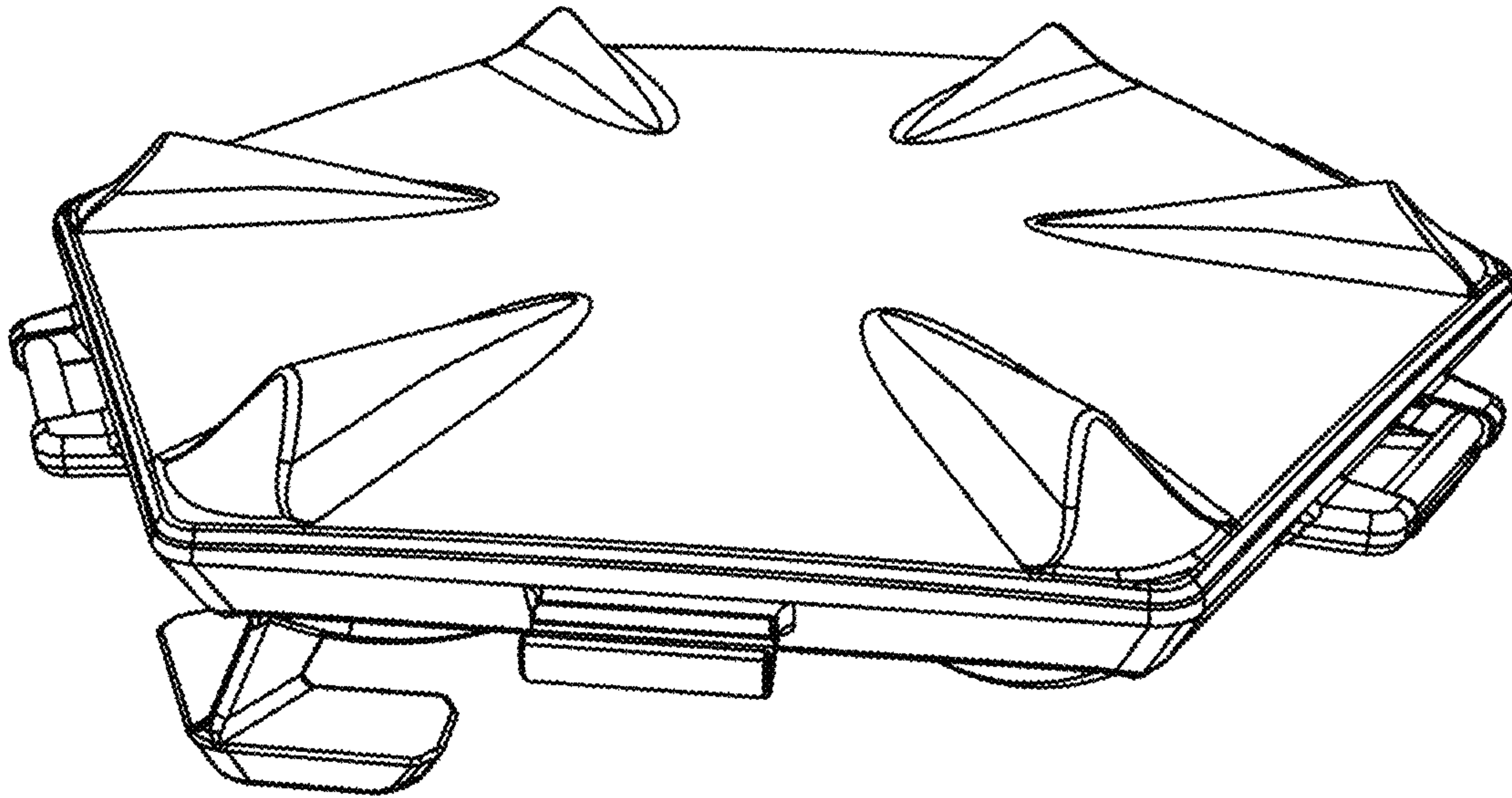

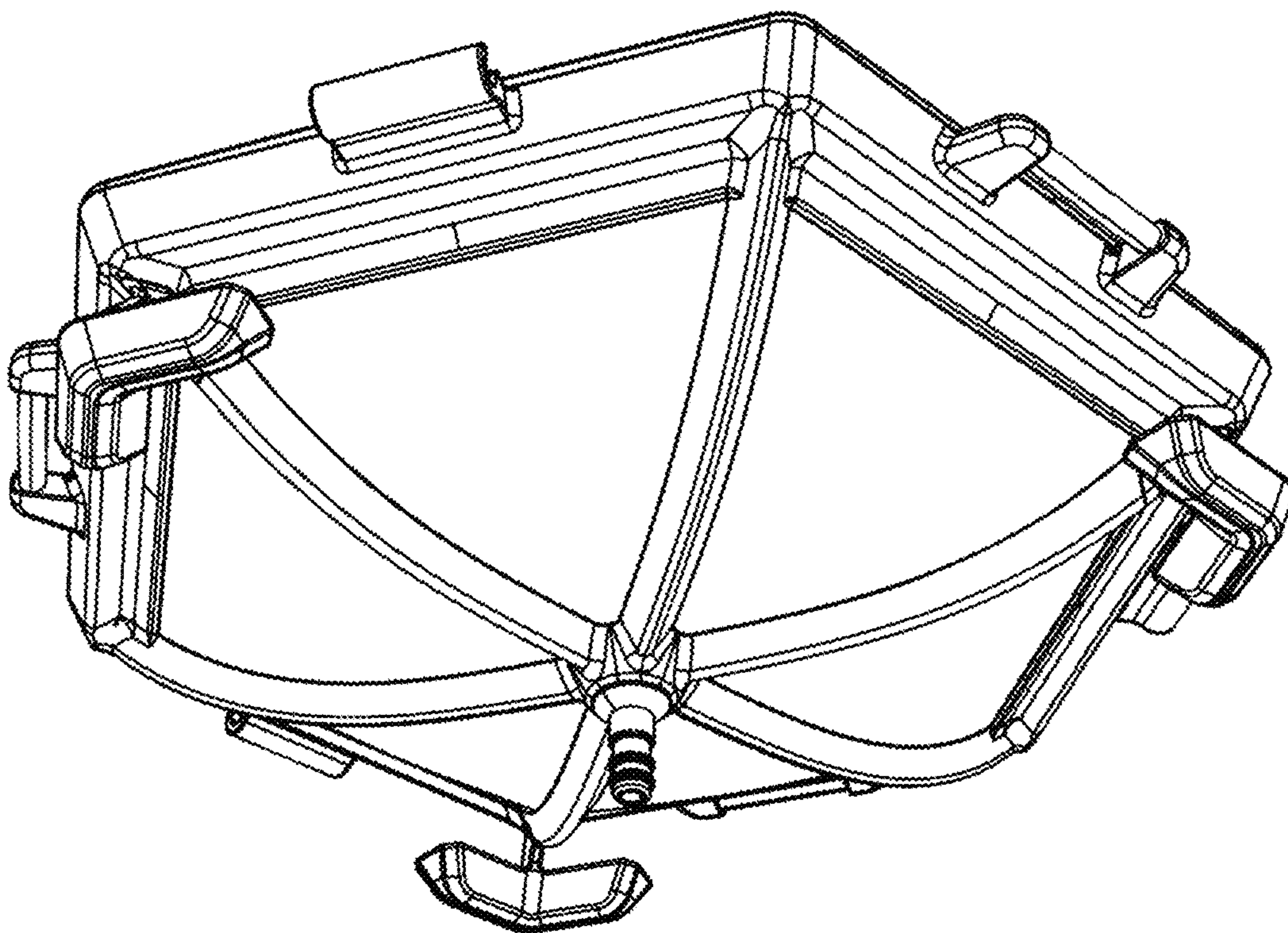

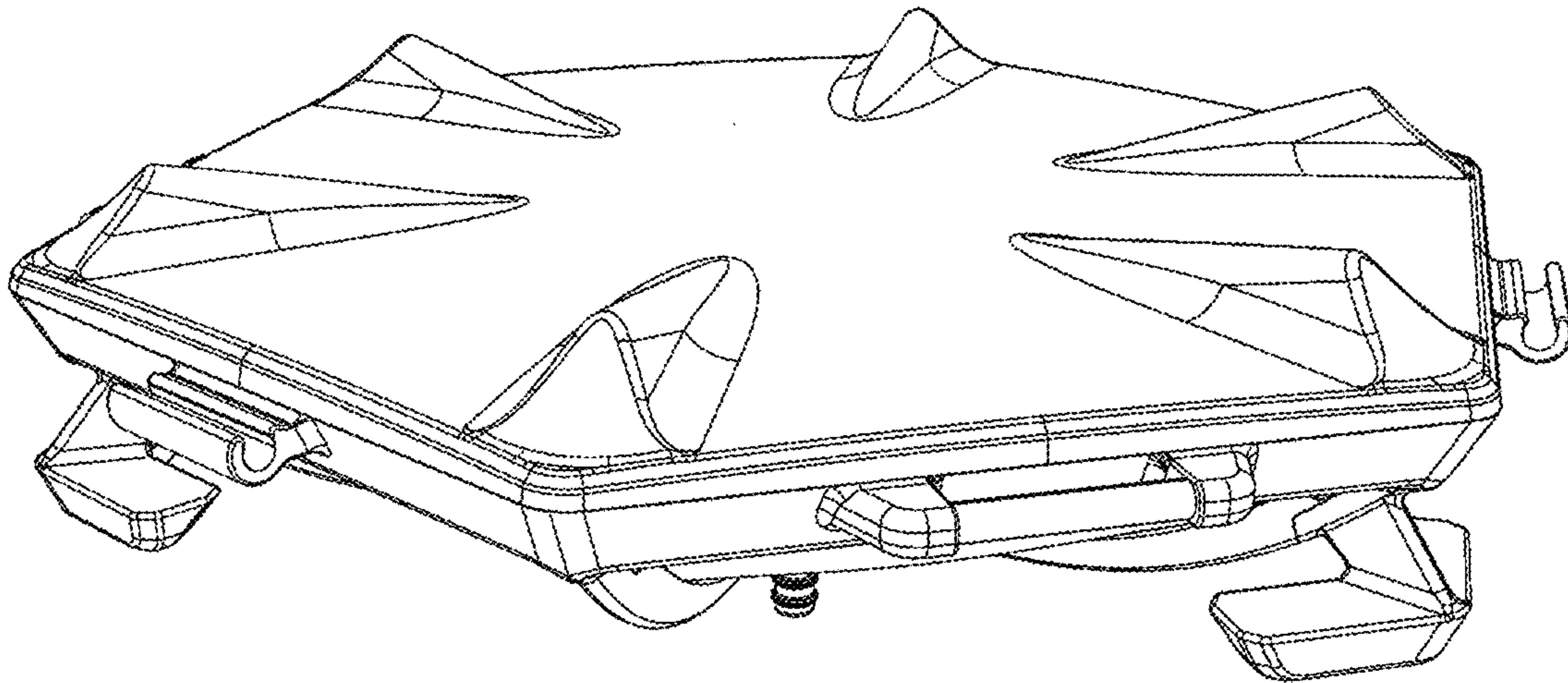

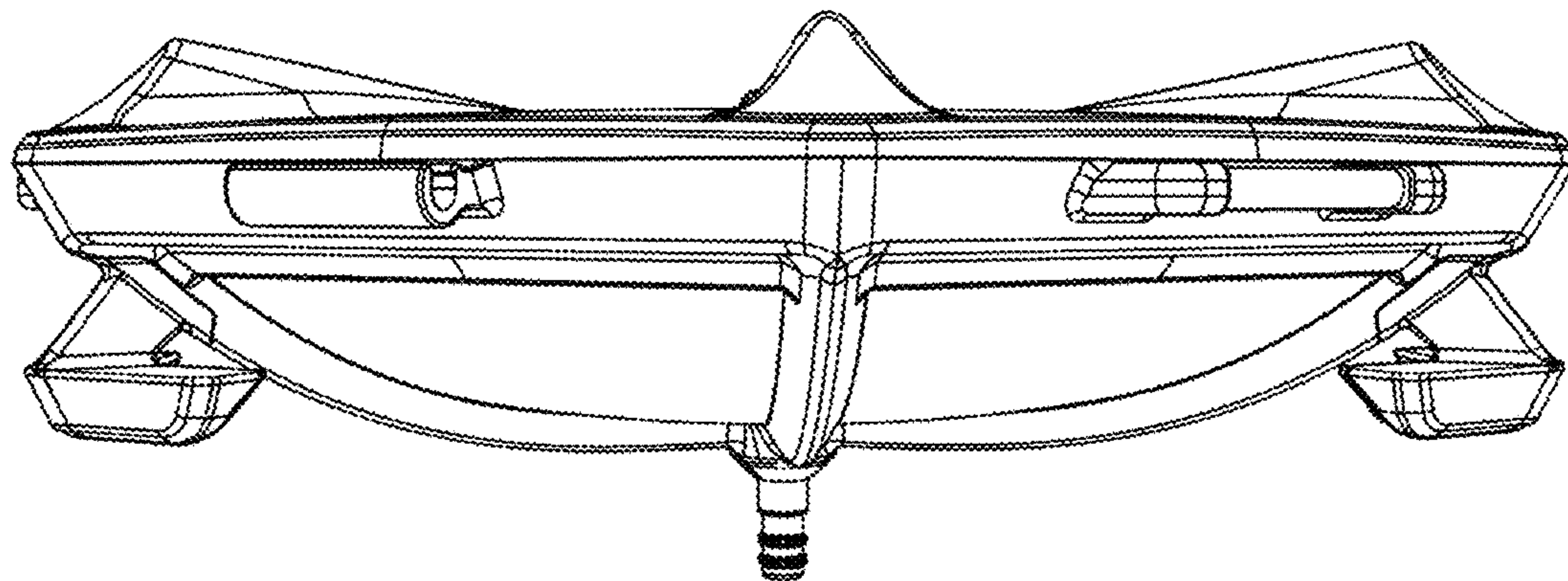

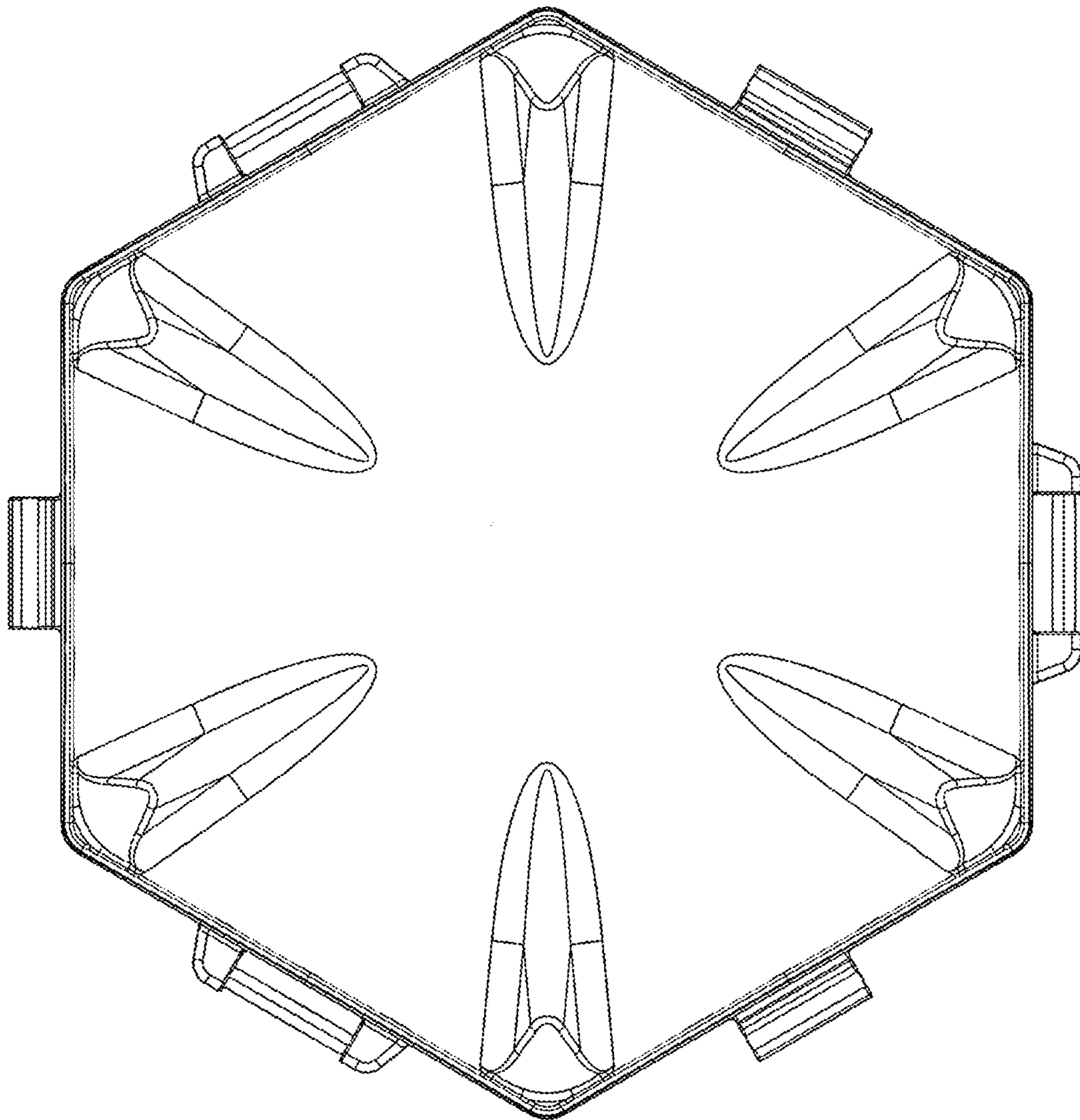

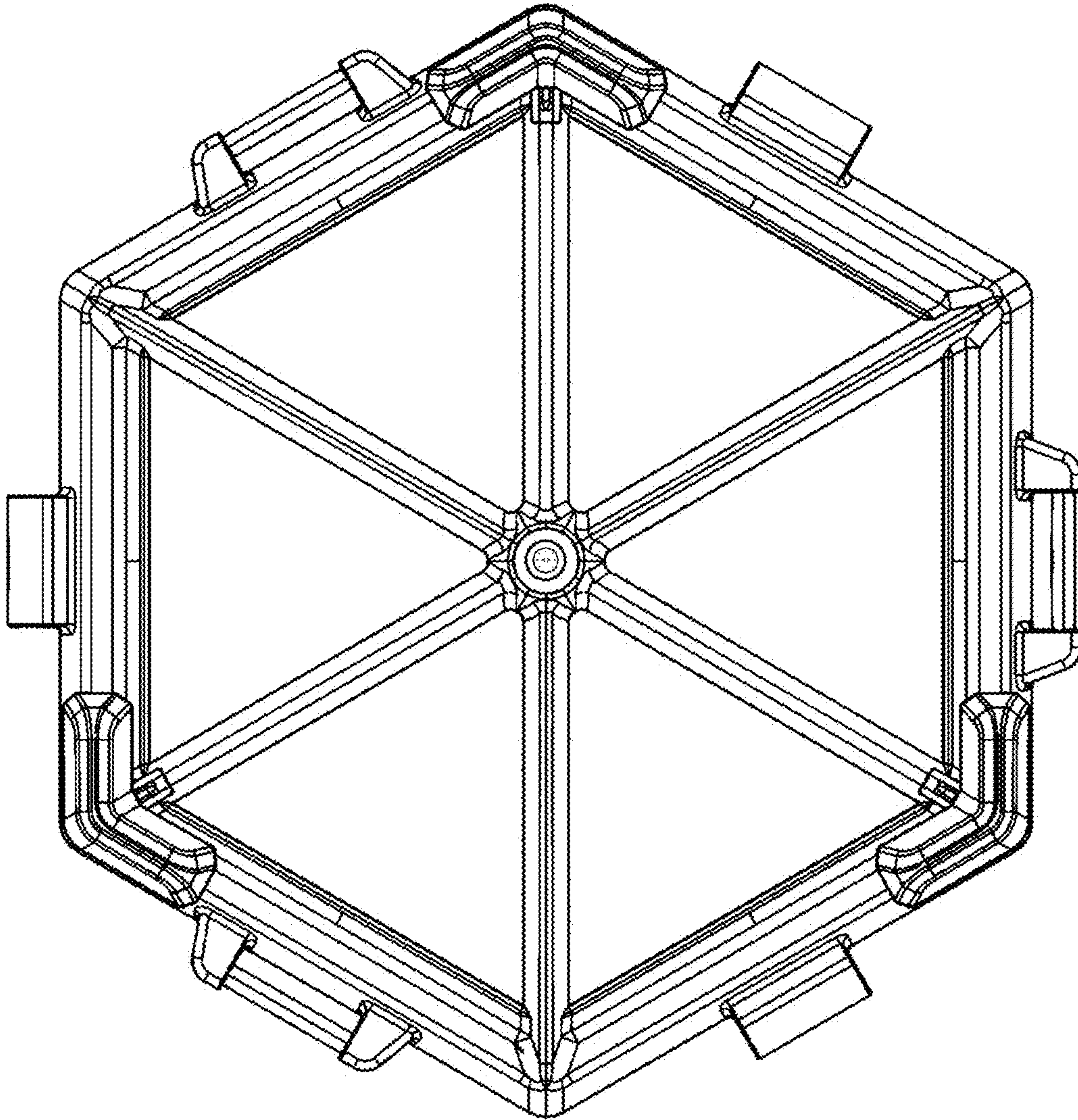
