DESCRIPTION

FIG. 11 is a top end view of the massage roller of FIG. 8;

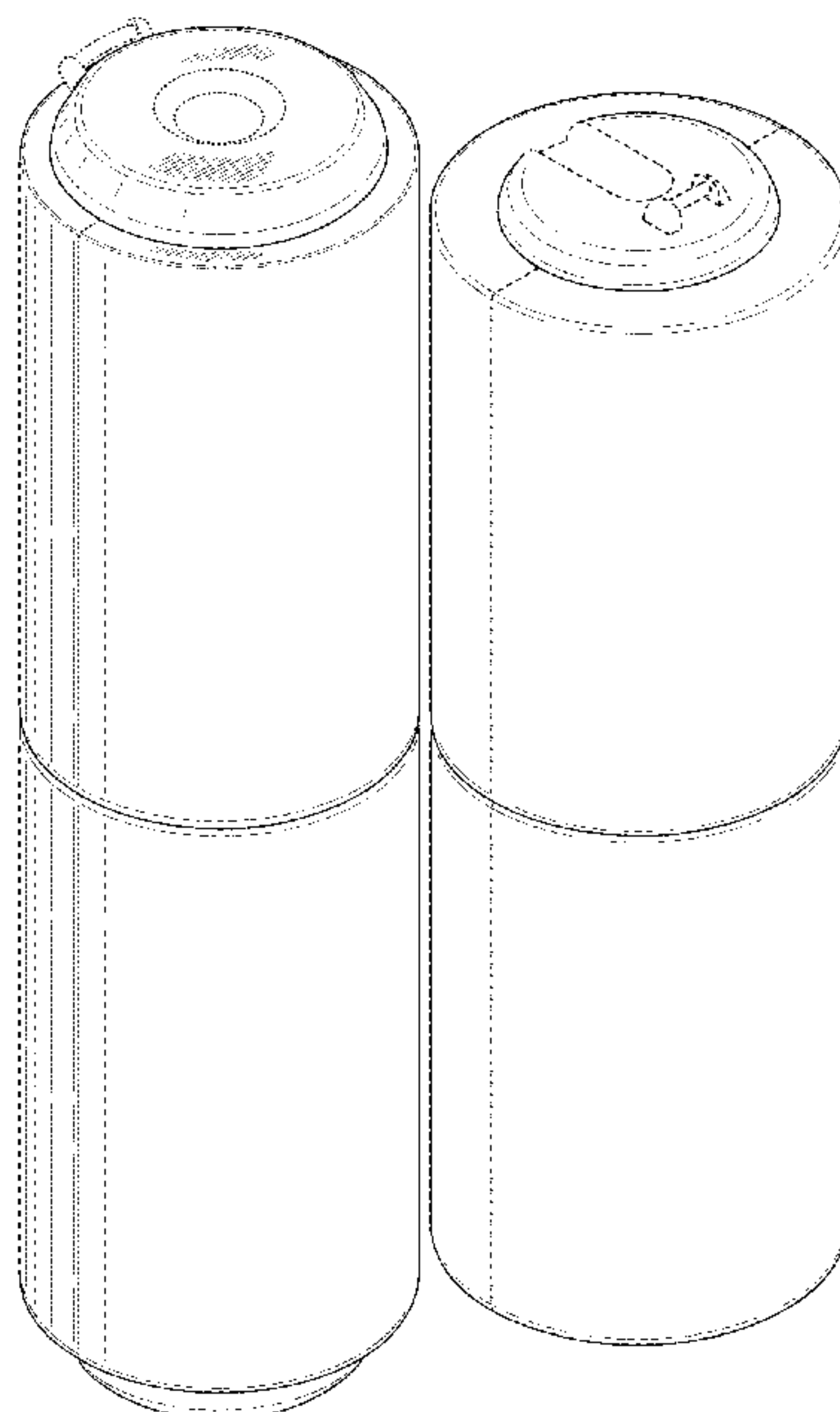
FIG. 12 is a bottom end view of the massage roller of FIG. 8;

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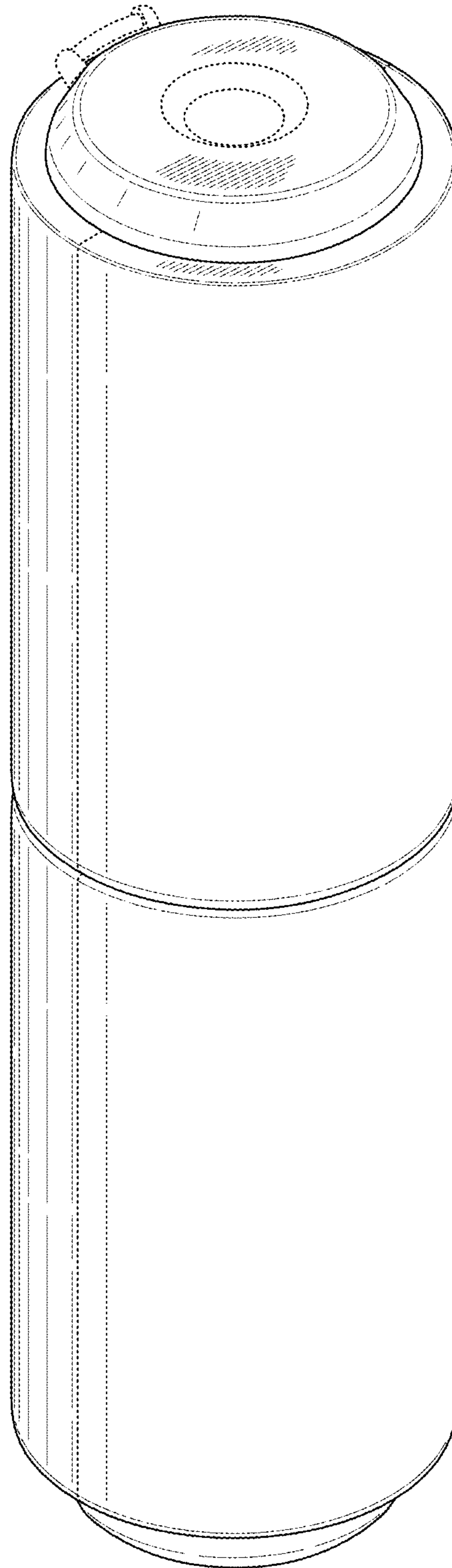

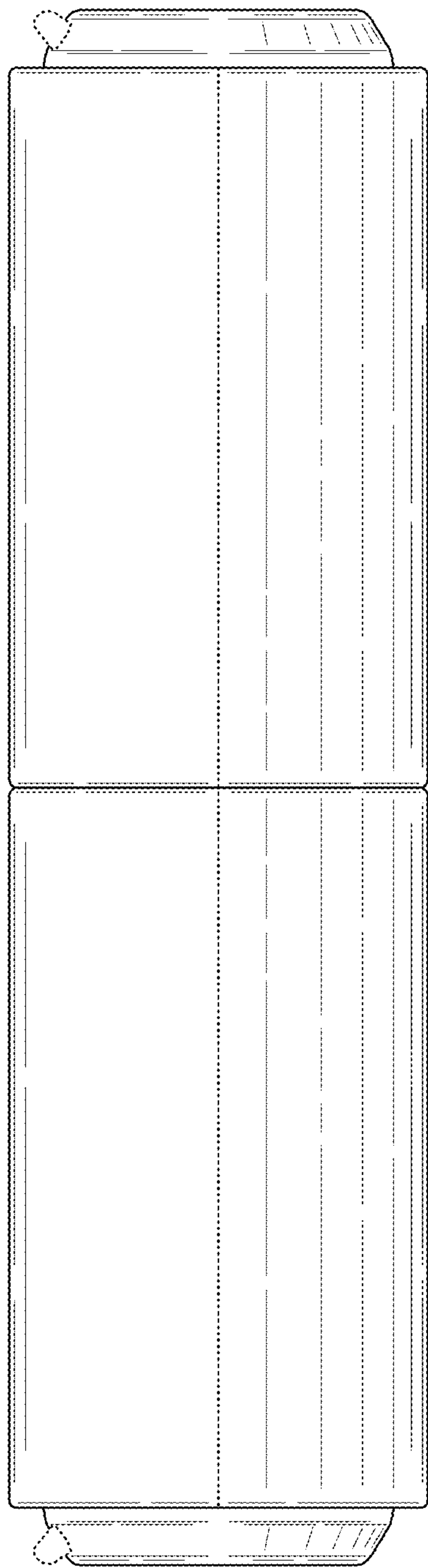

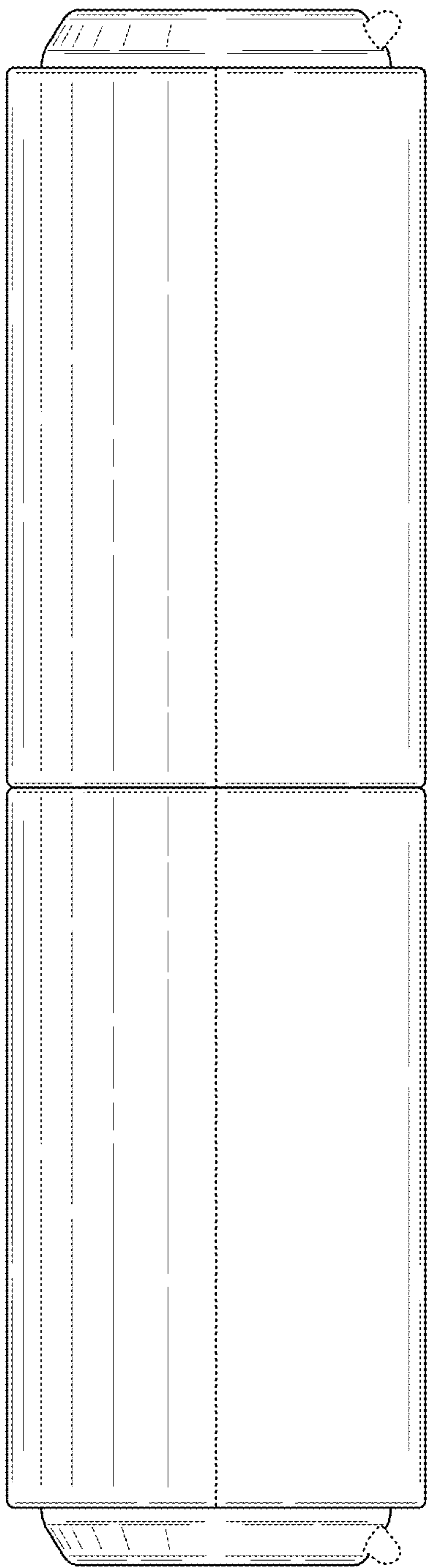

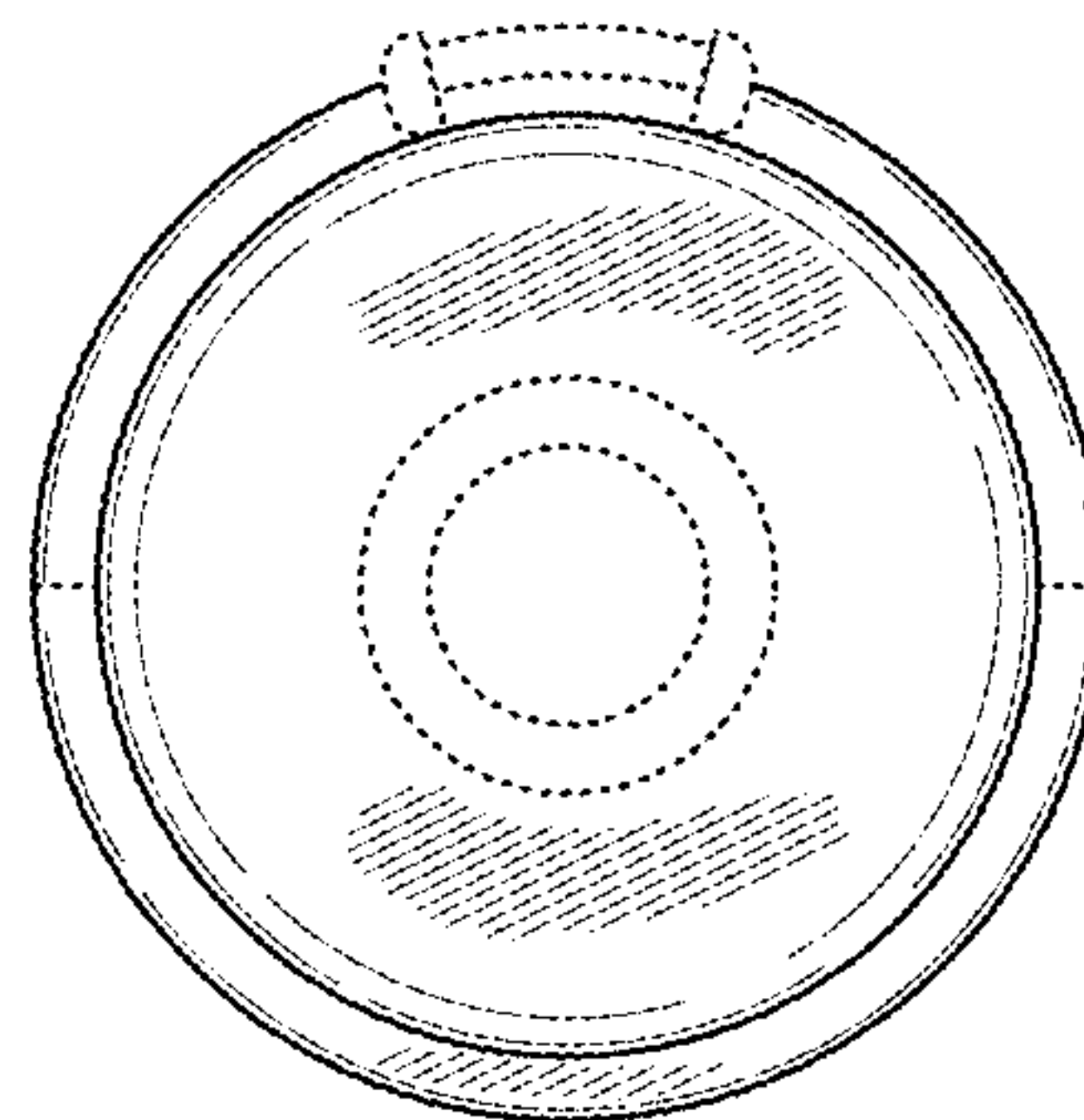

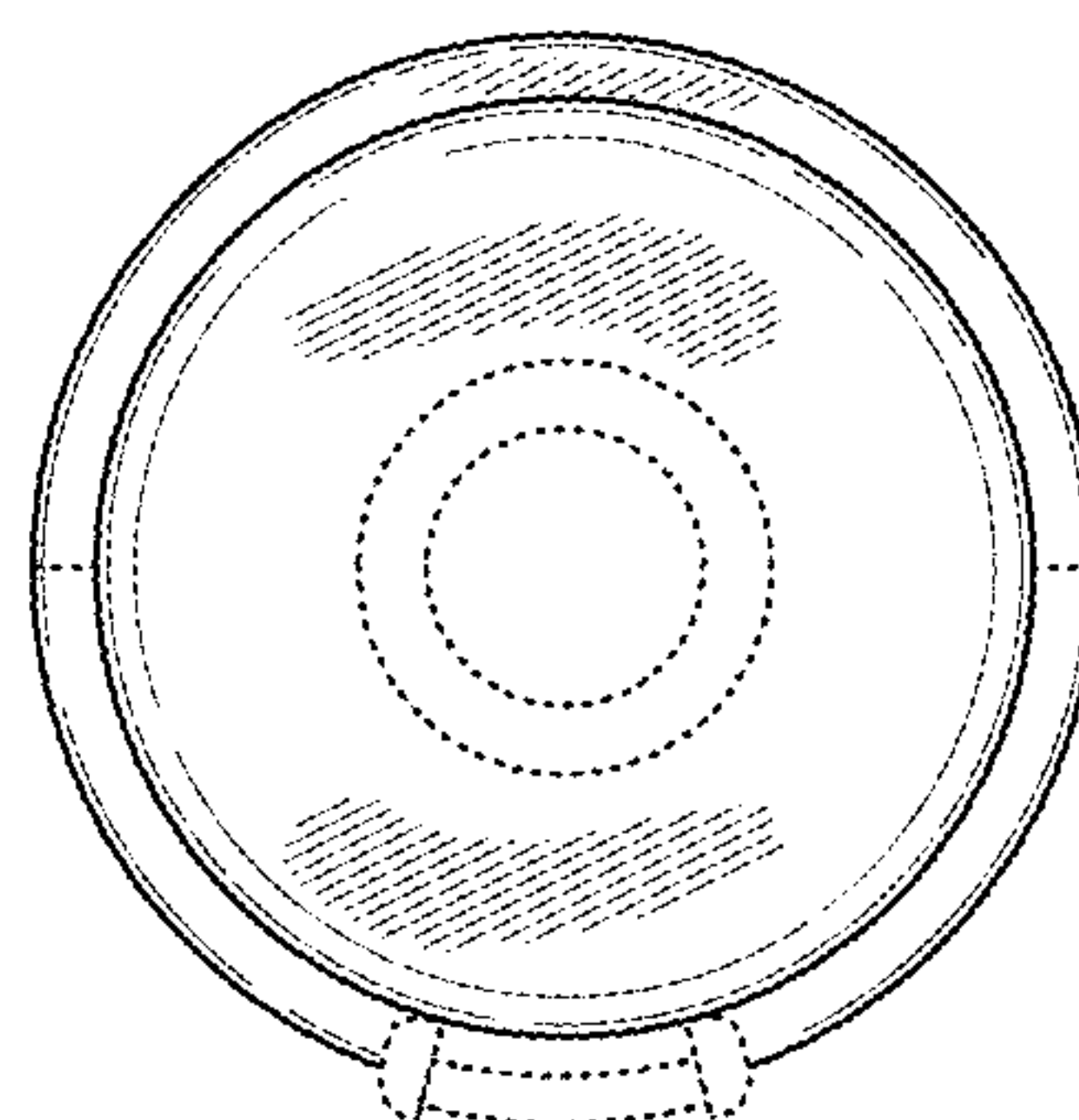

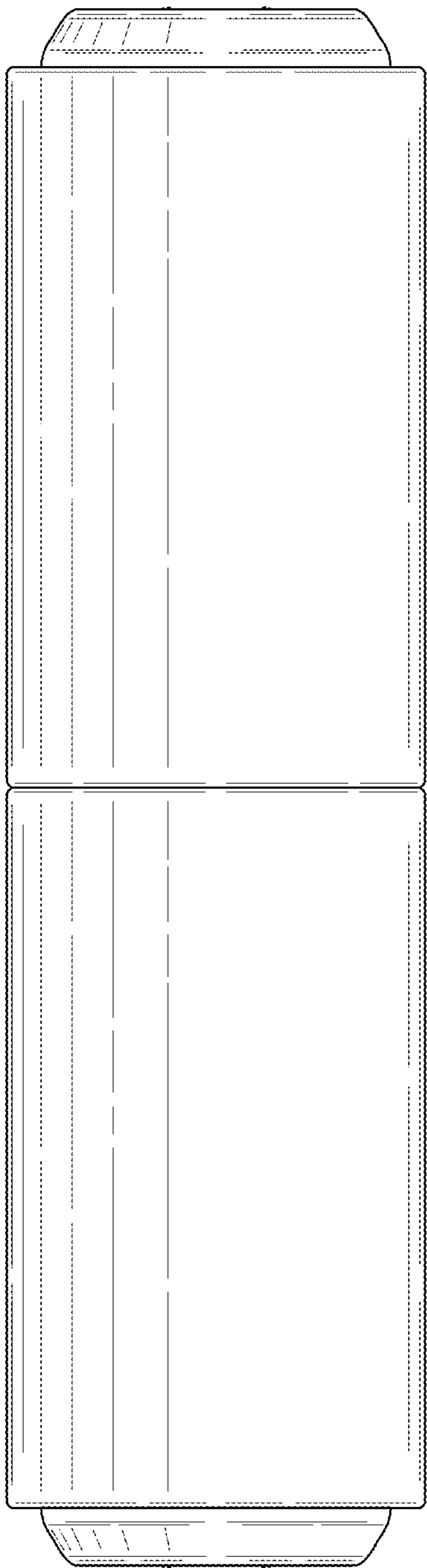

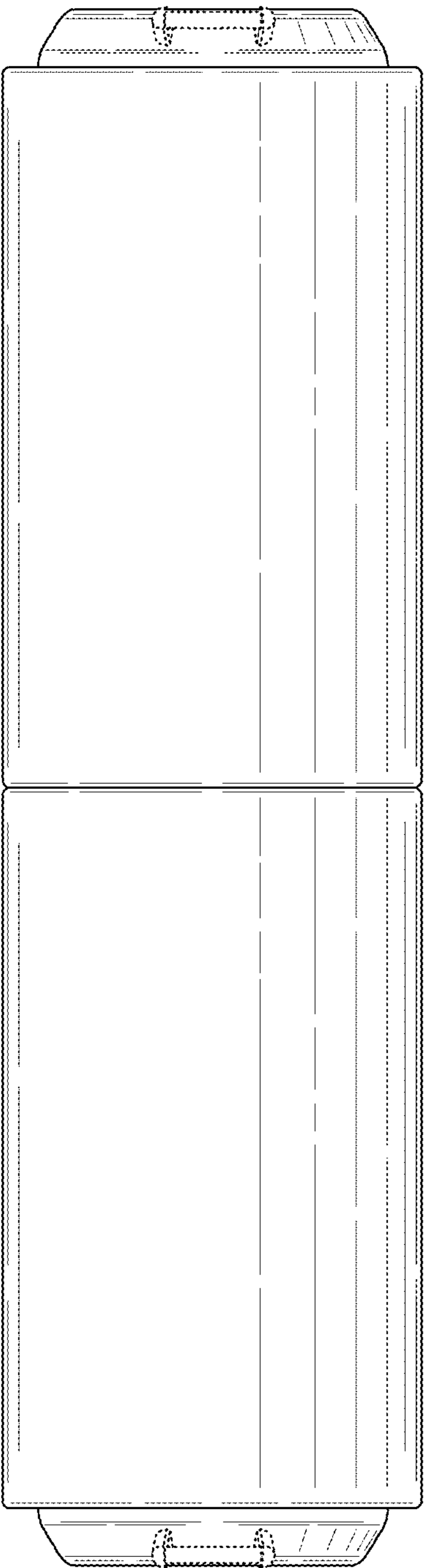

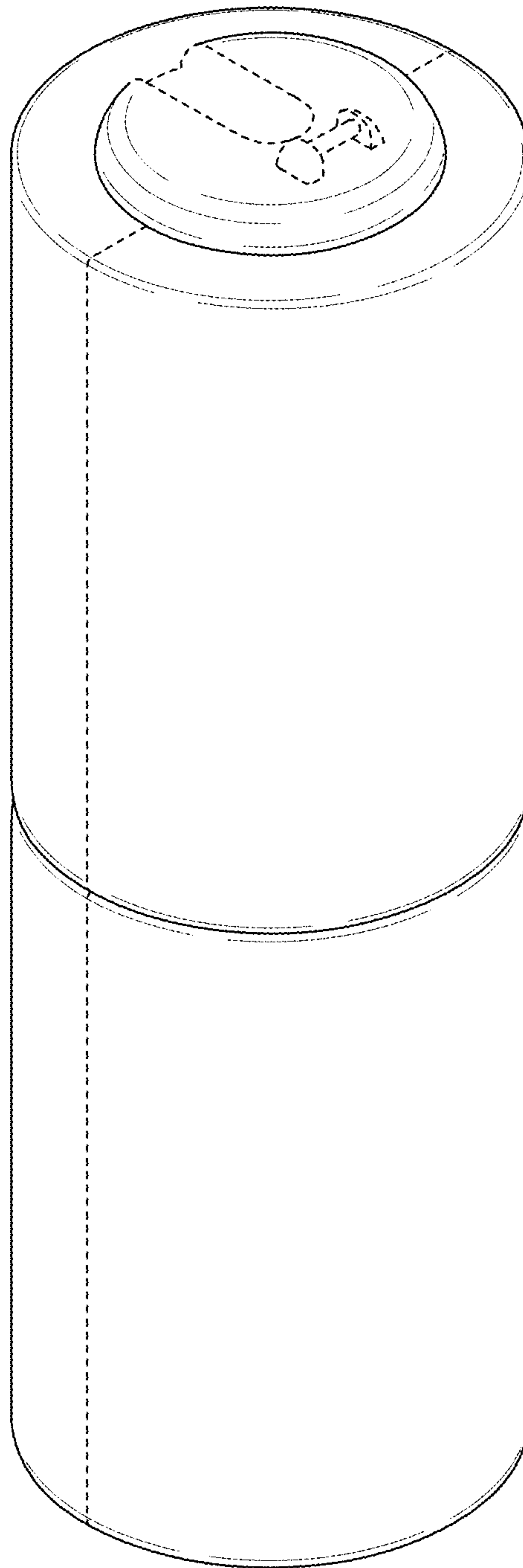

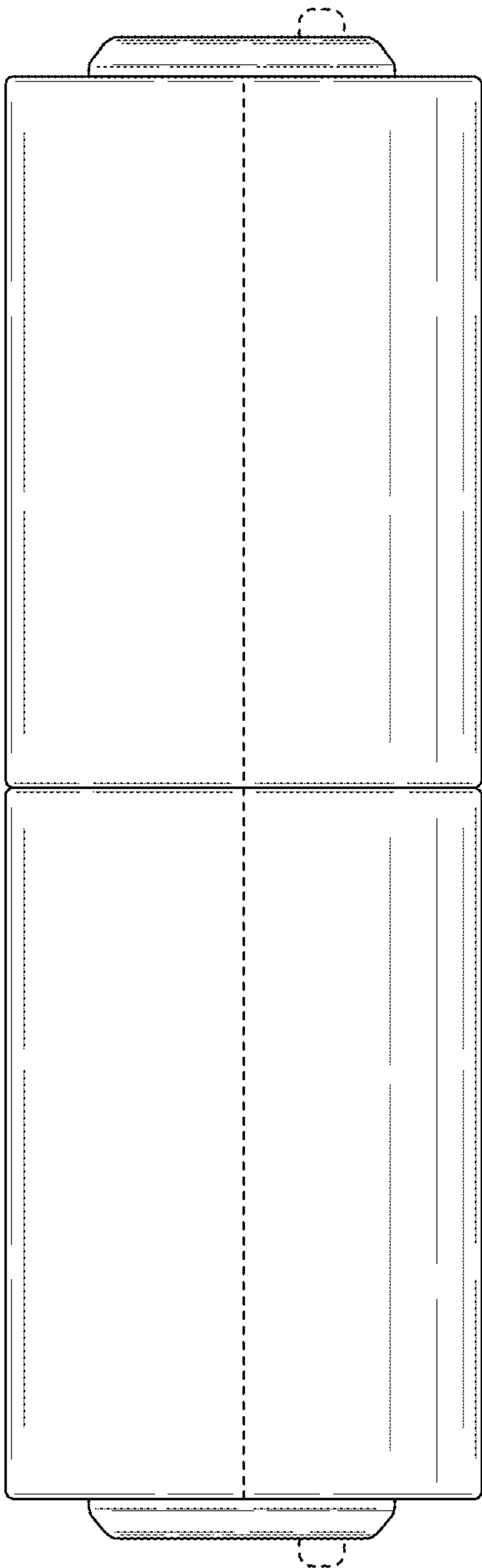

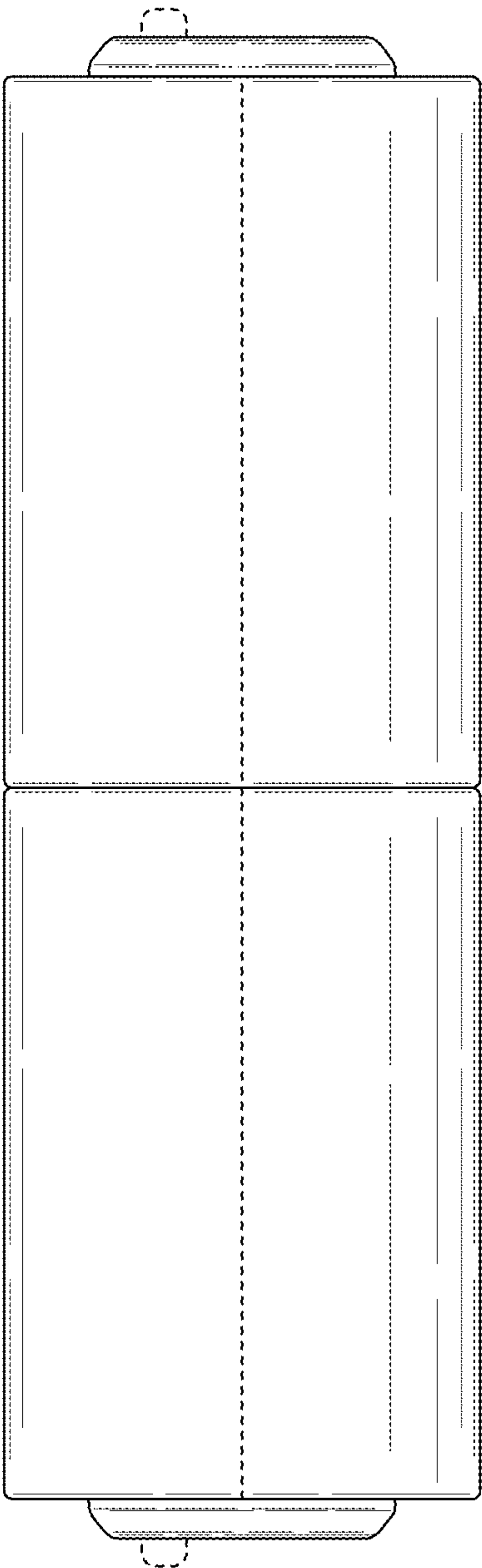

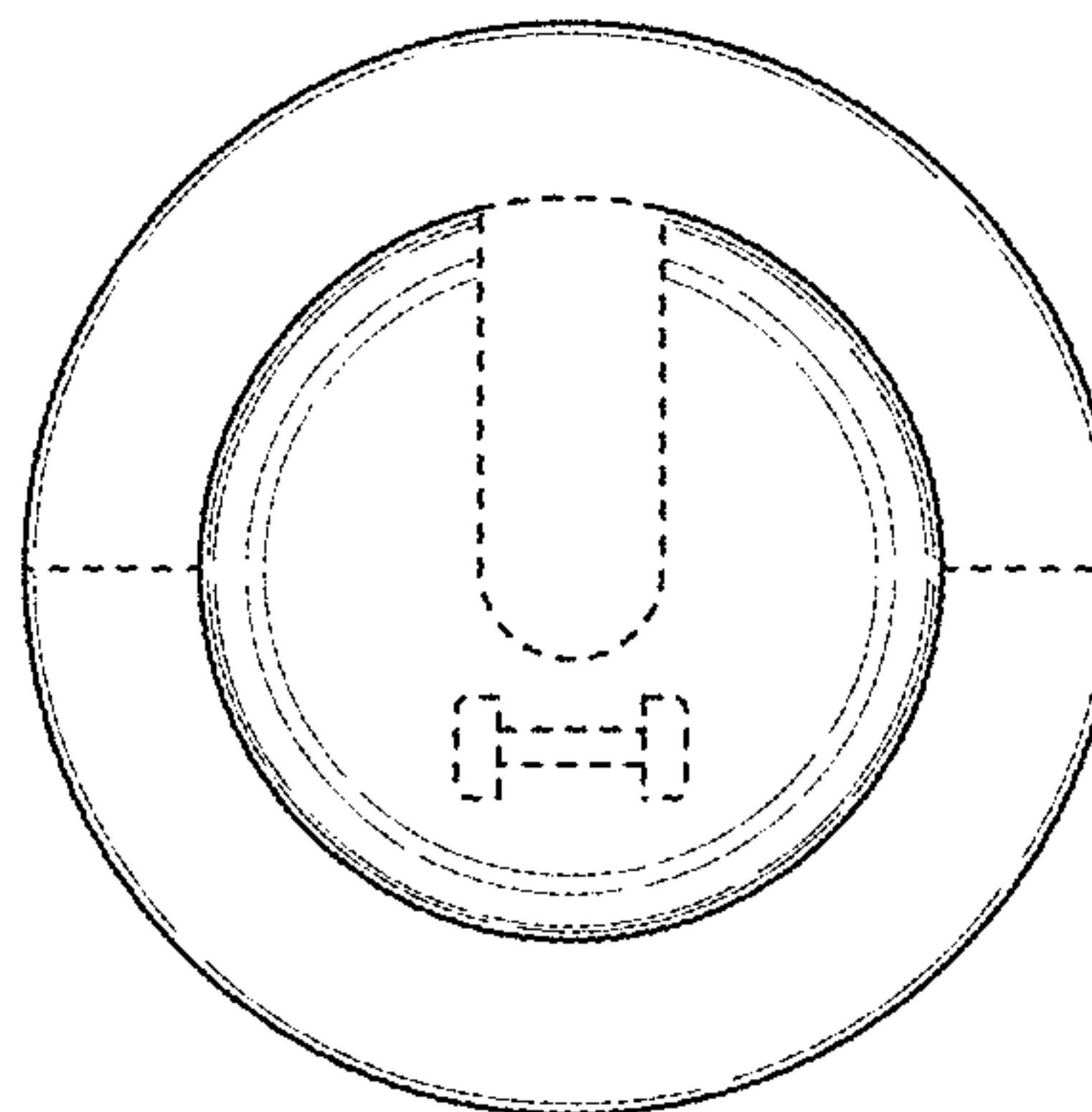

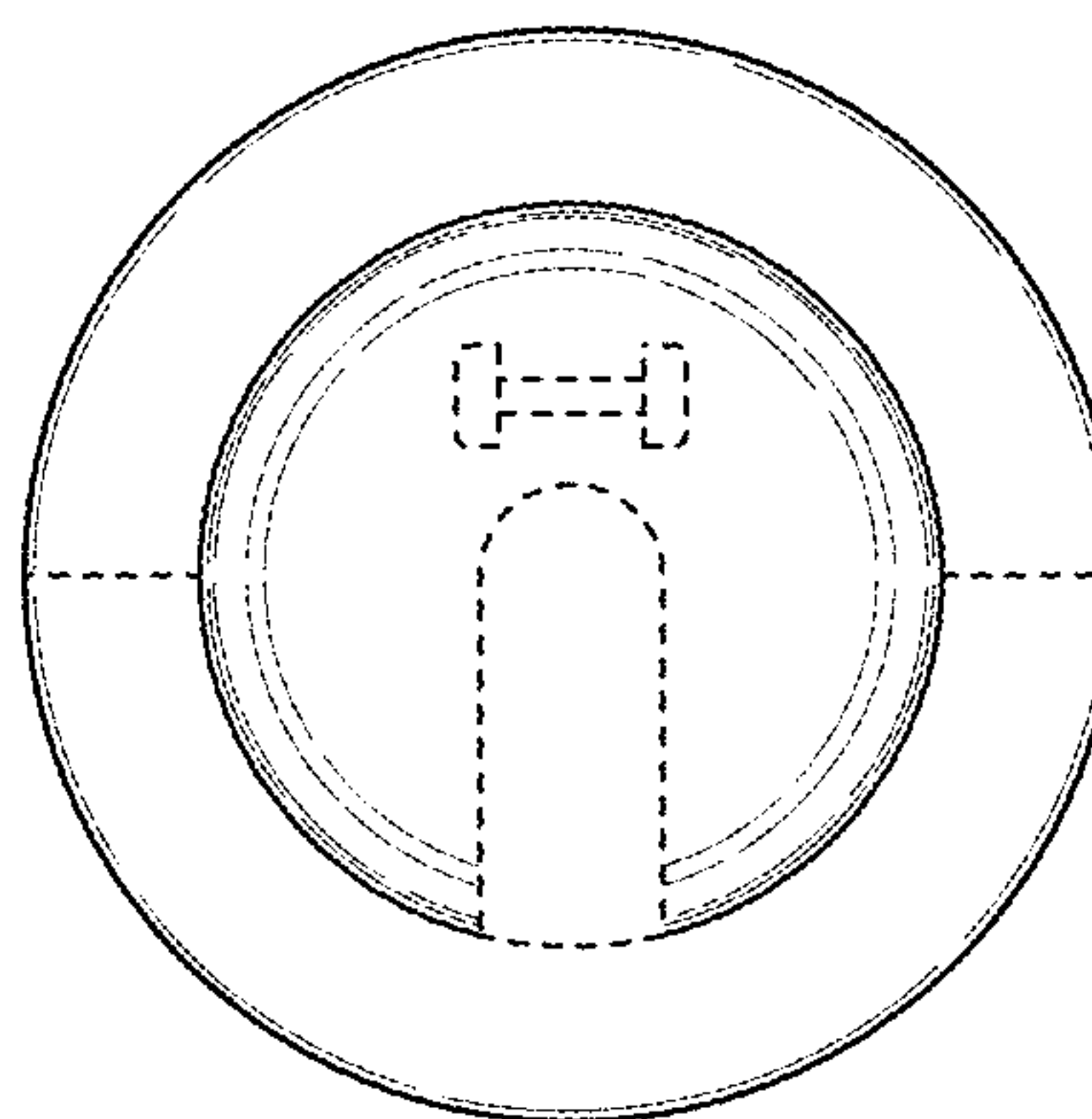

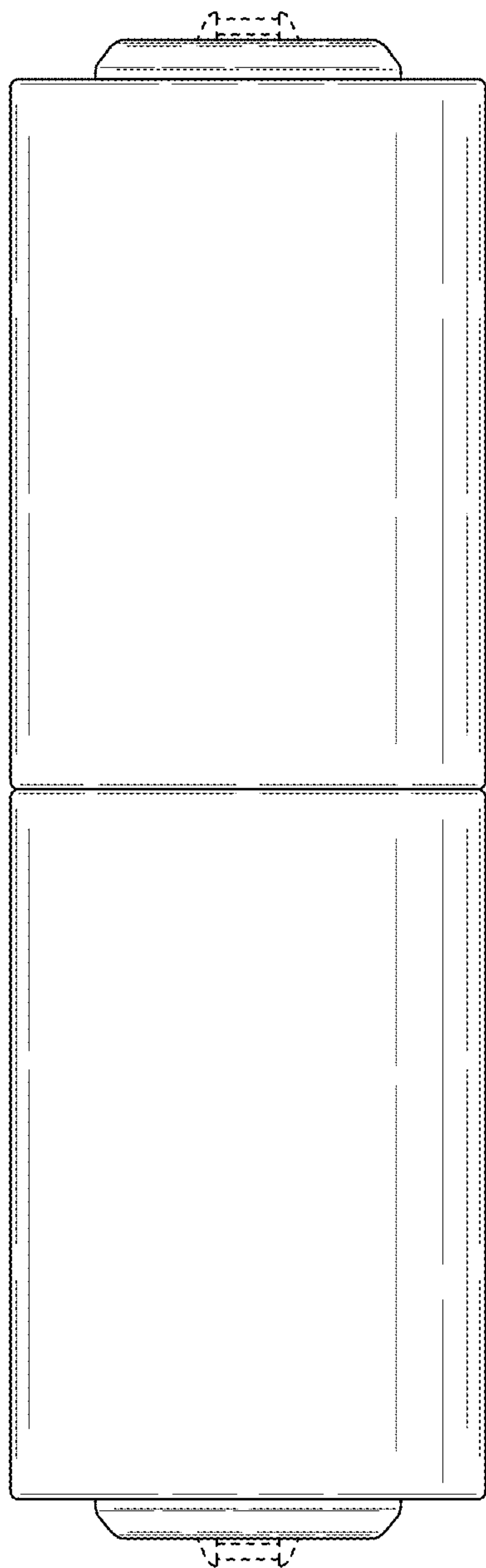

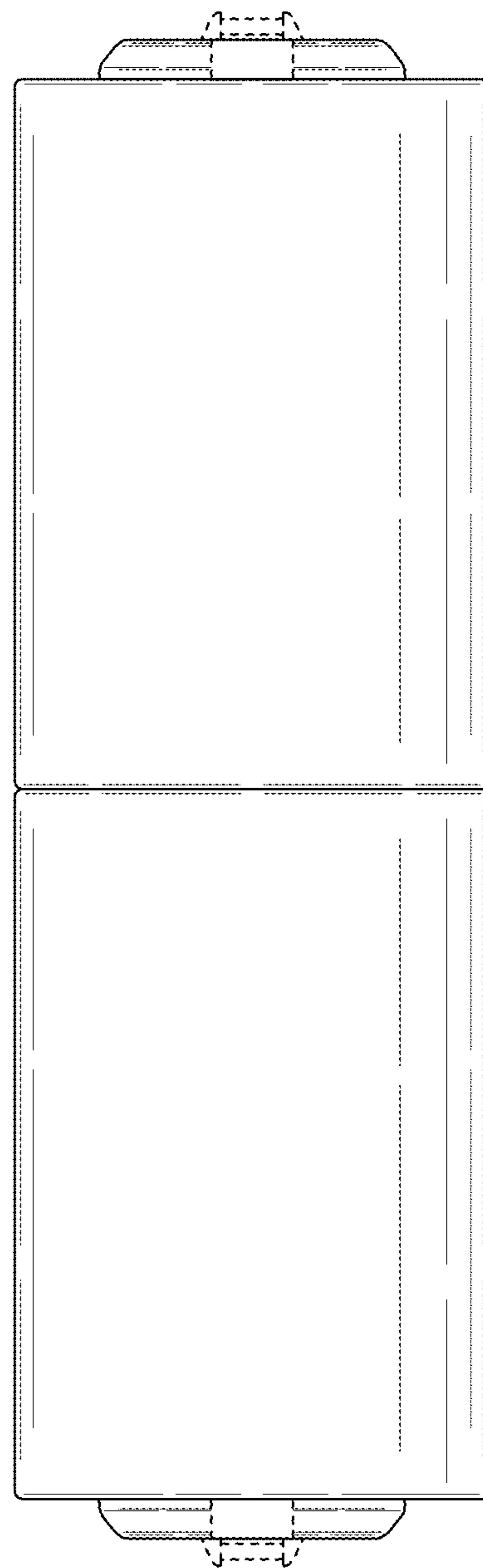
