DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, elevated, right-quartering perspective view
of a particular embodiment of the new design for decorative
horns for a lap desk;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the embodiment shown in FIG.
1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment shown in

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the right half (as viewed
in FIG. 2) of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1, the rear

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the embodiment
shown in FIG. 1, the left side elevational view being the
mirror image of FIG. 5.

of another particular embodiment of the new design for
decorative horns for a lap desk;

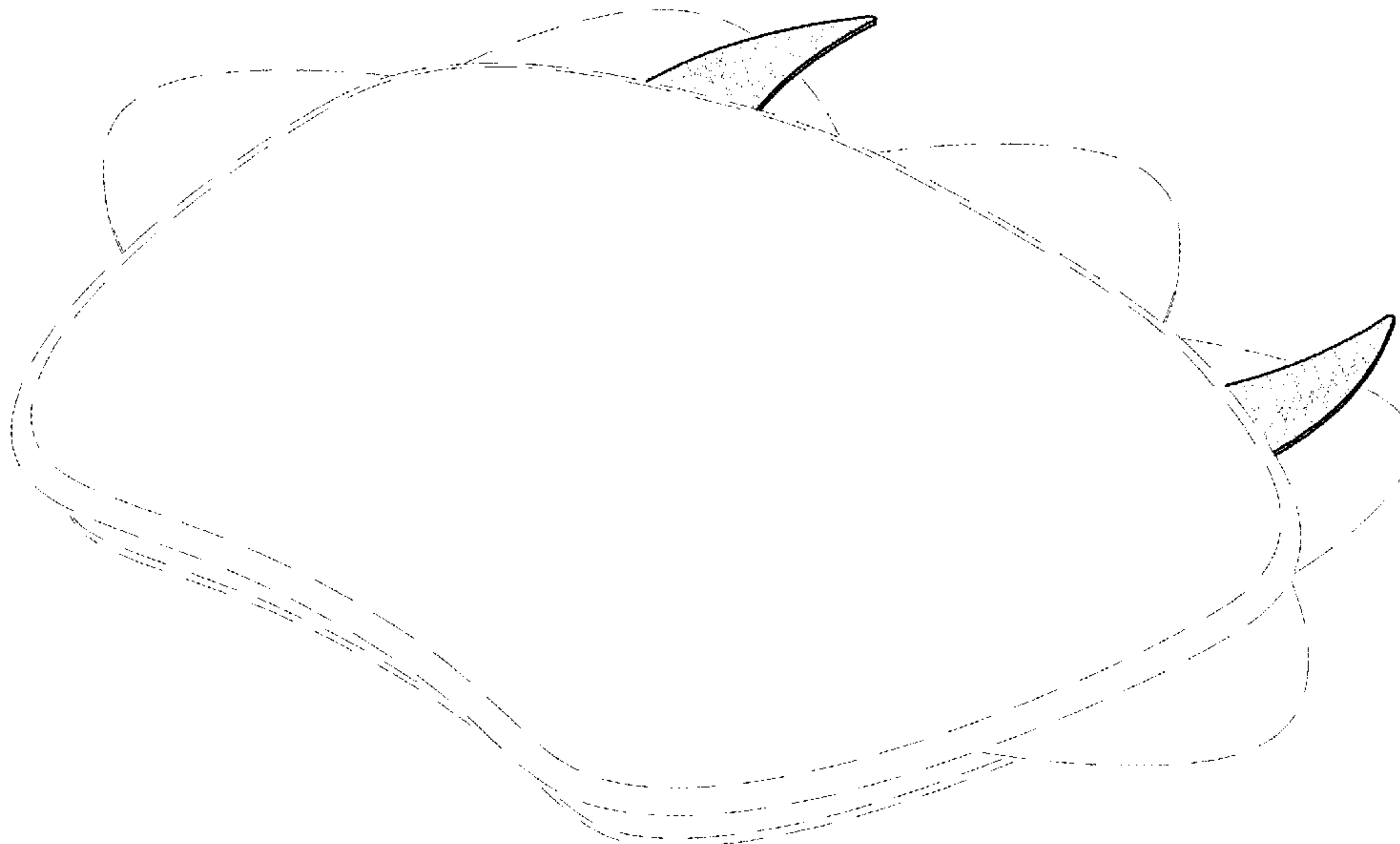
FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the embodiment shown in FIG.

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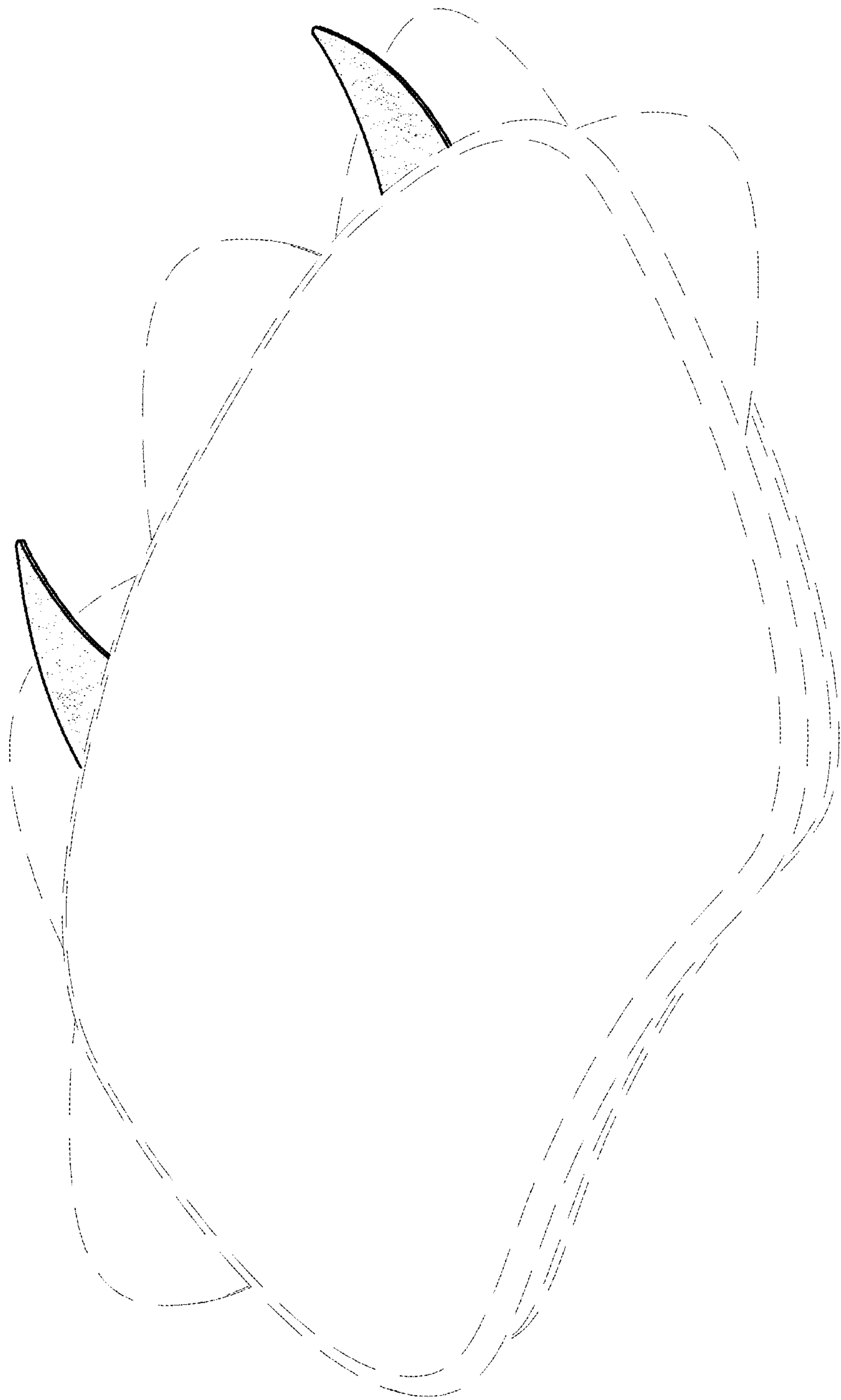

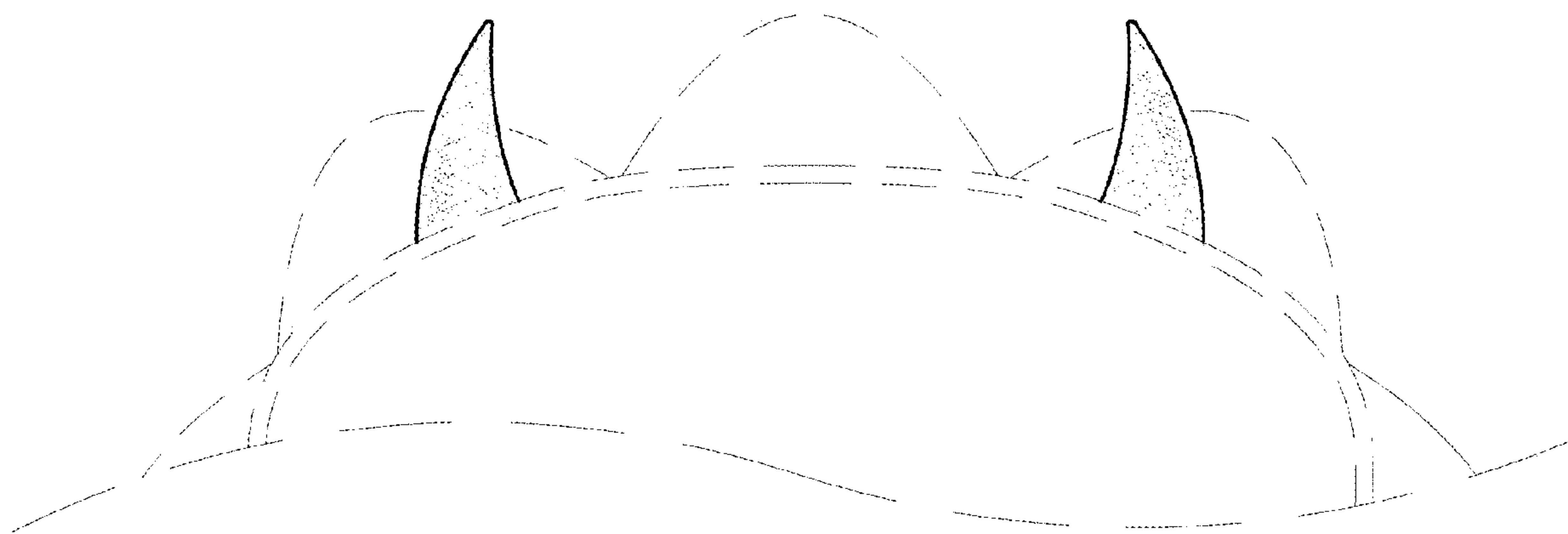

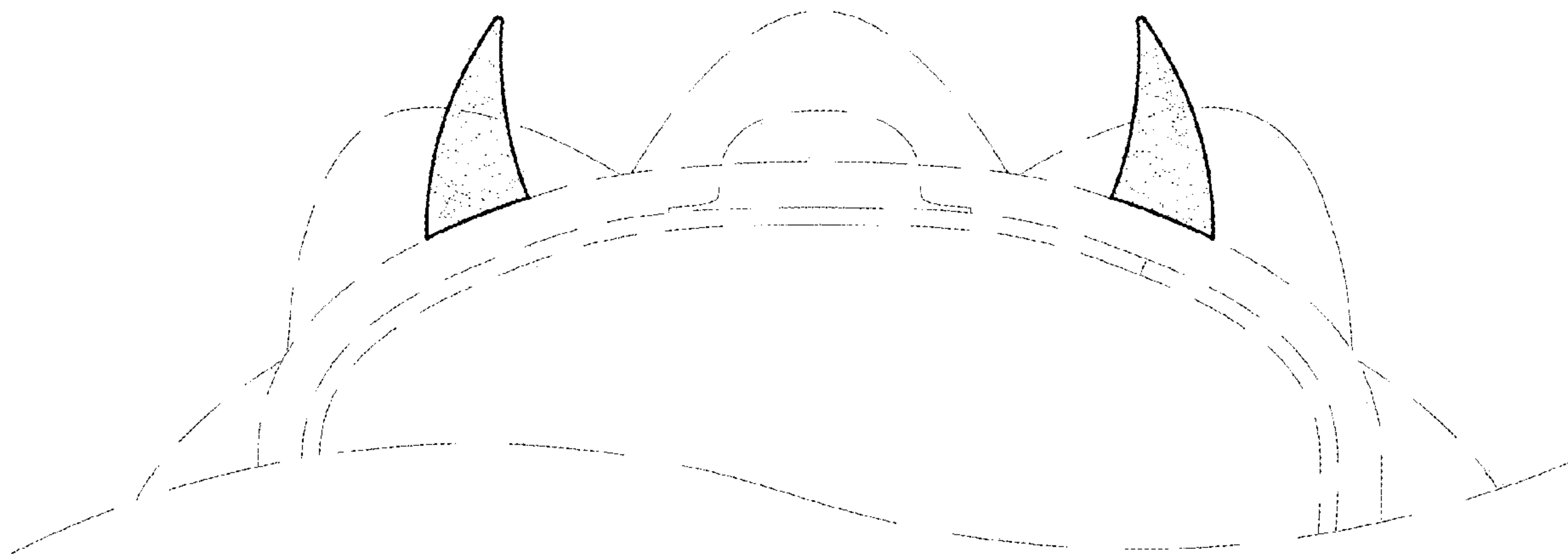

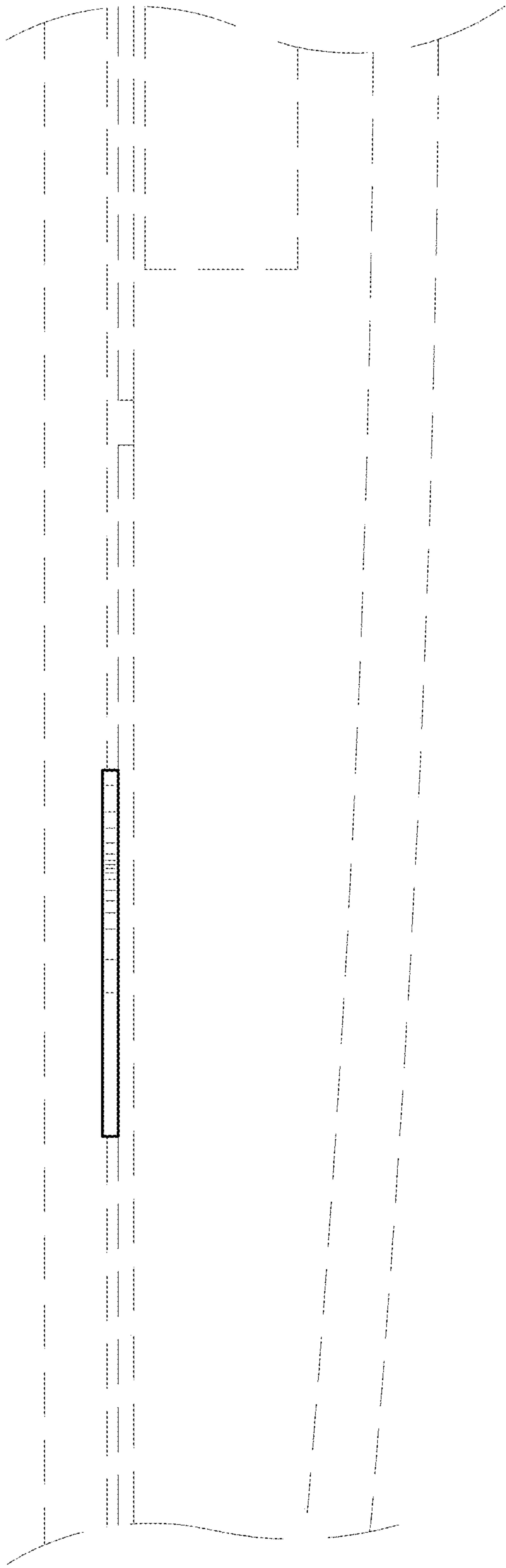

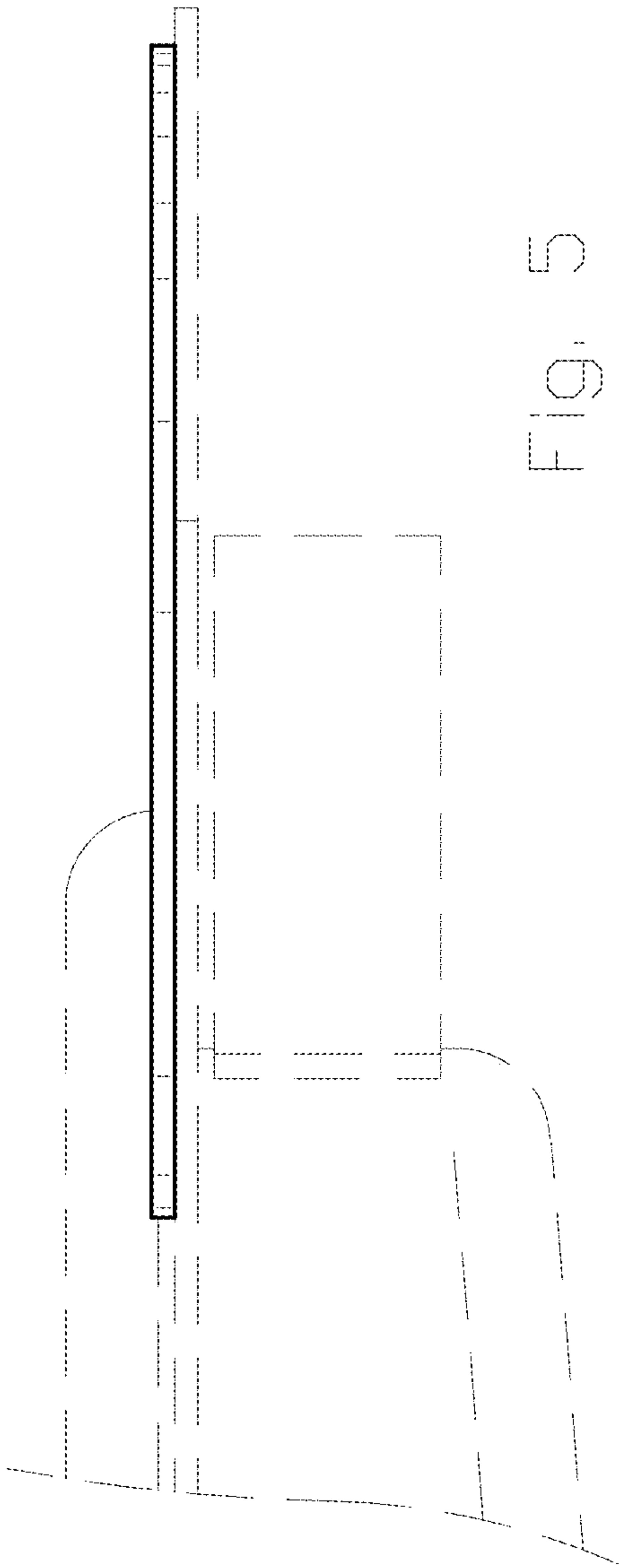

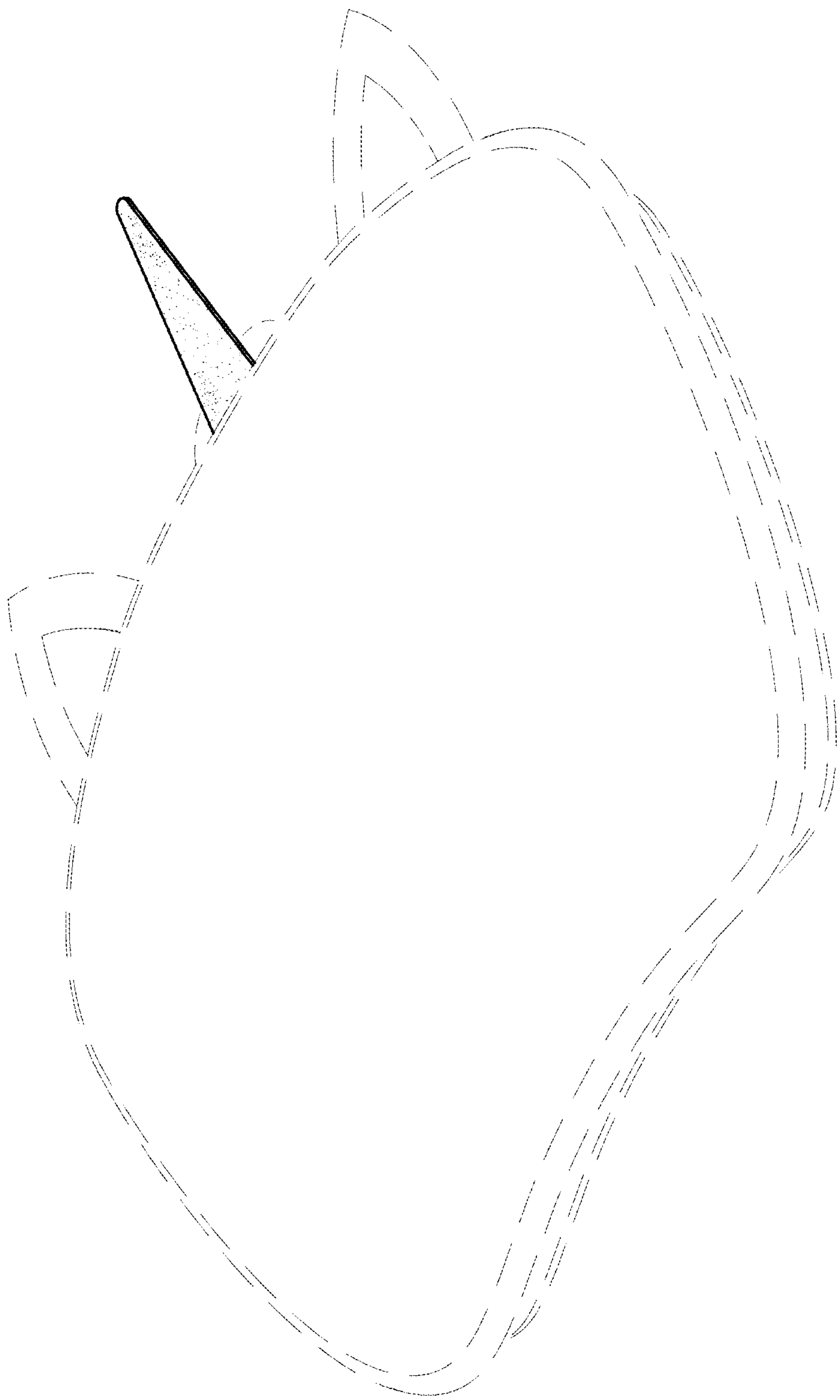

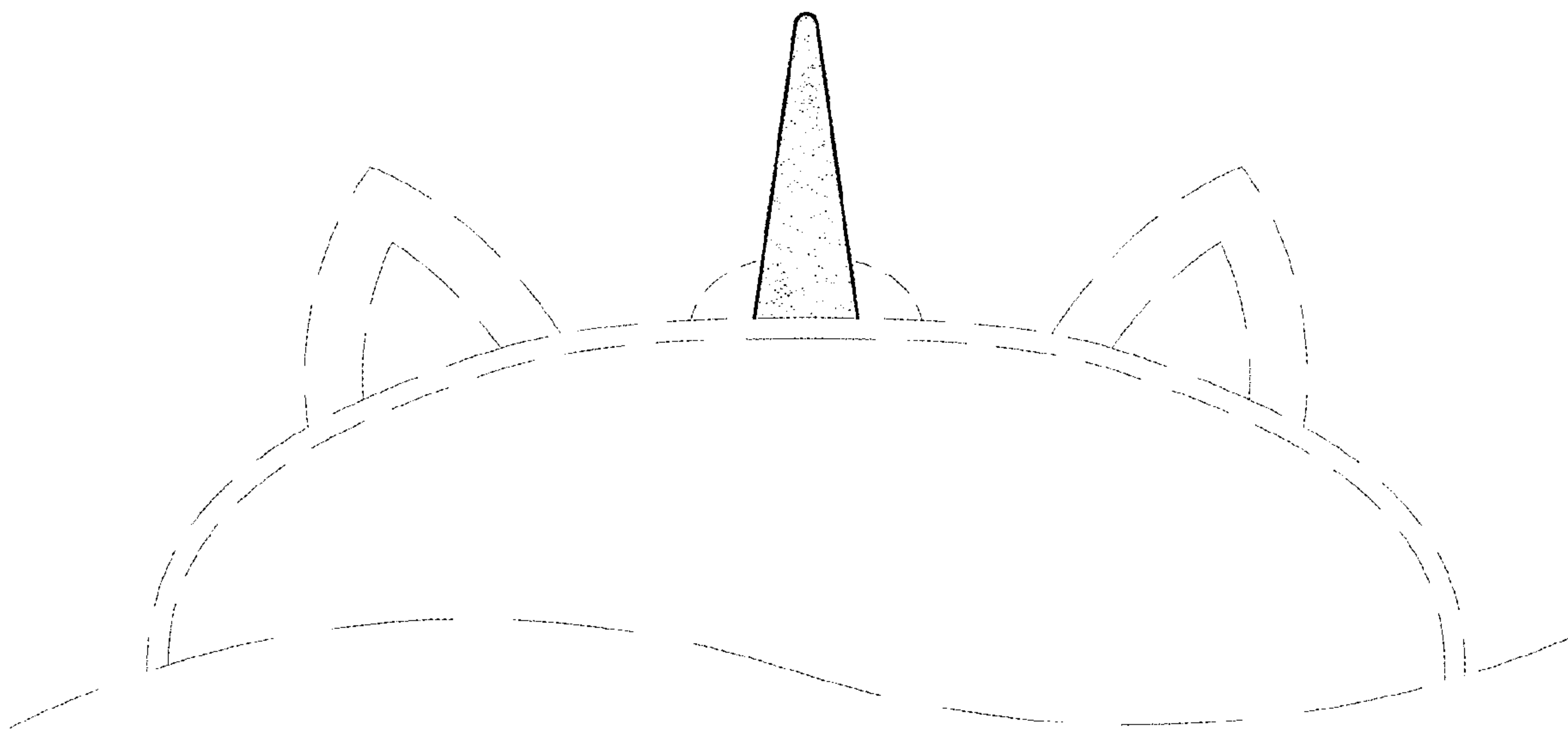

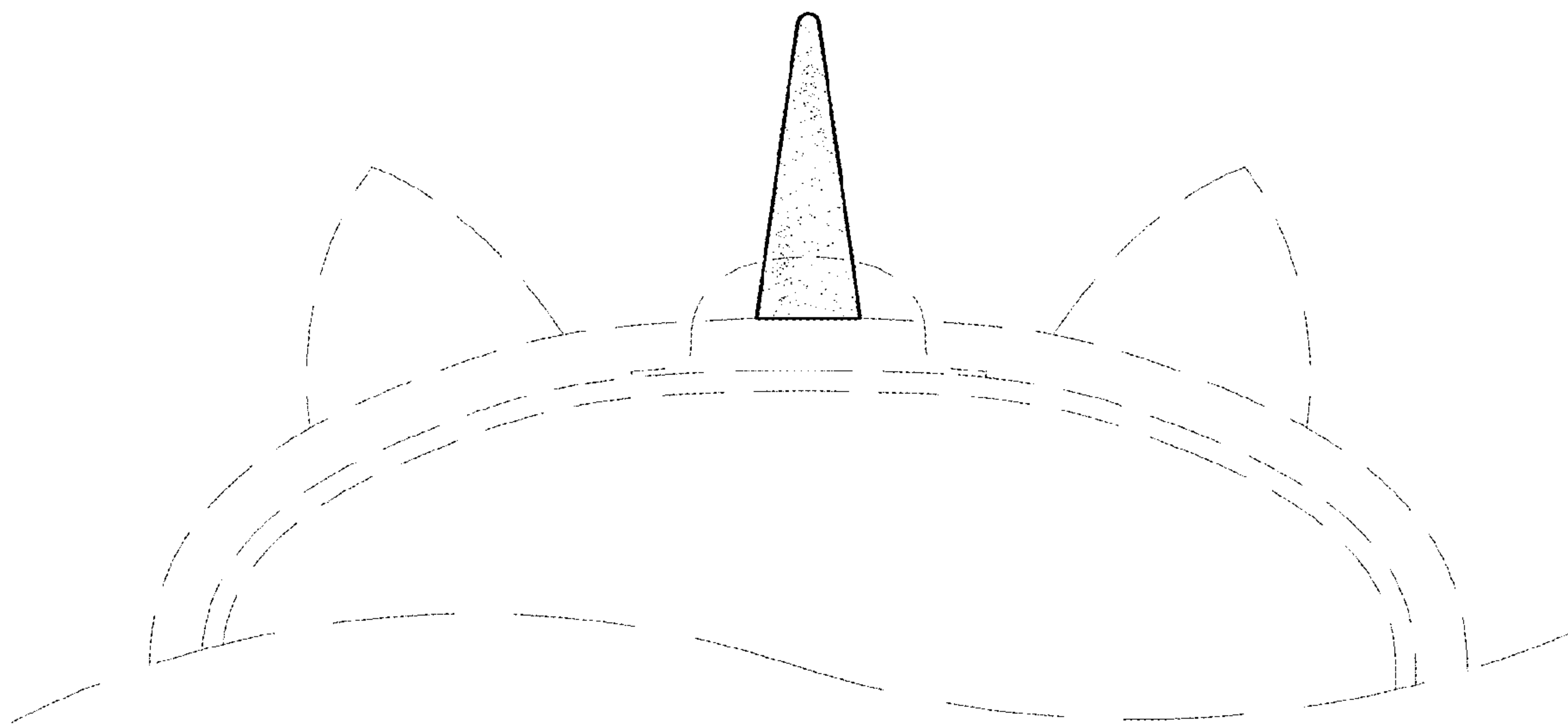

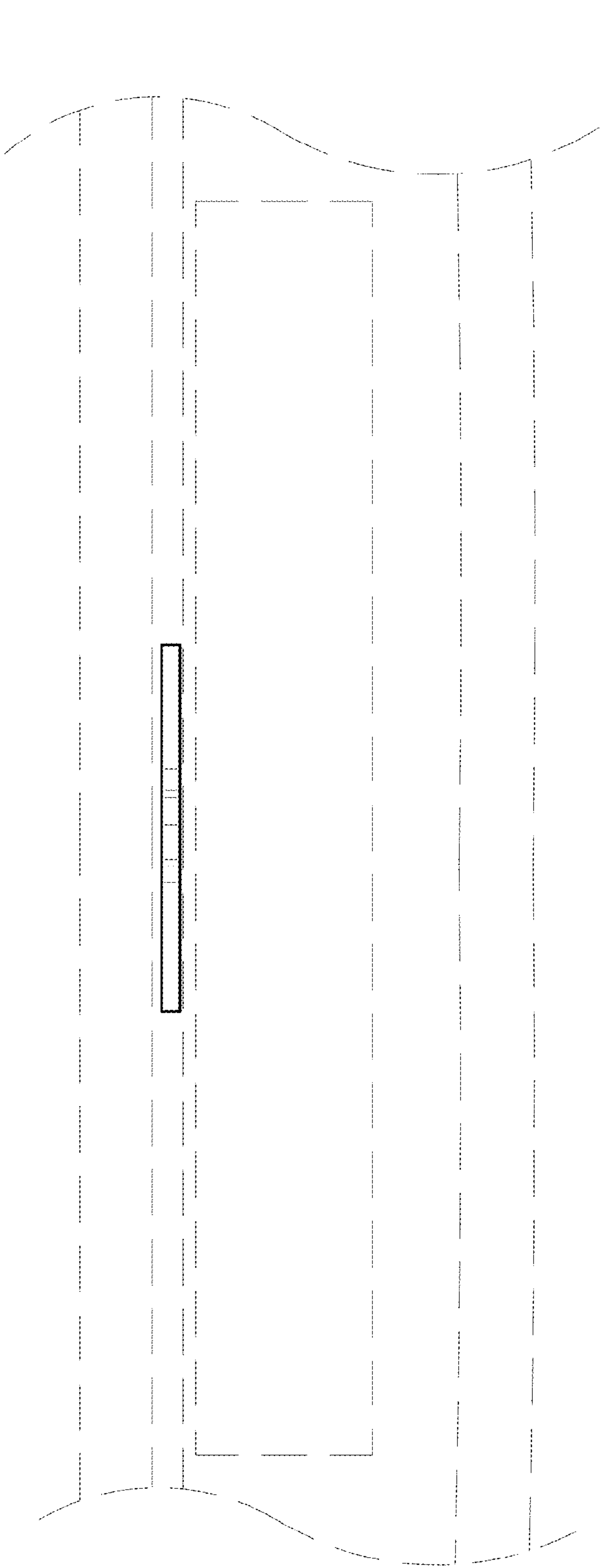

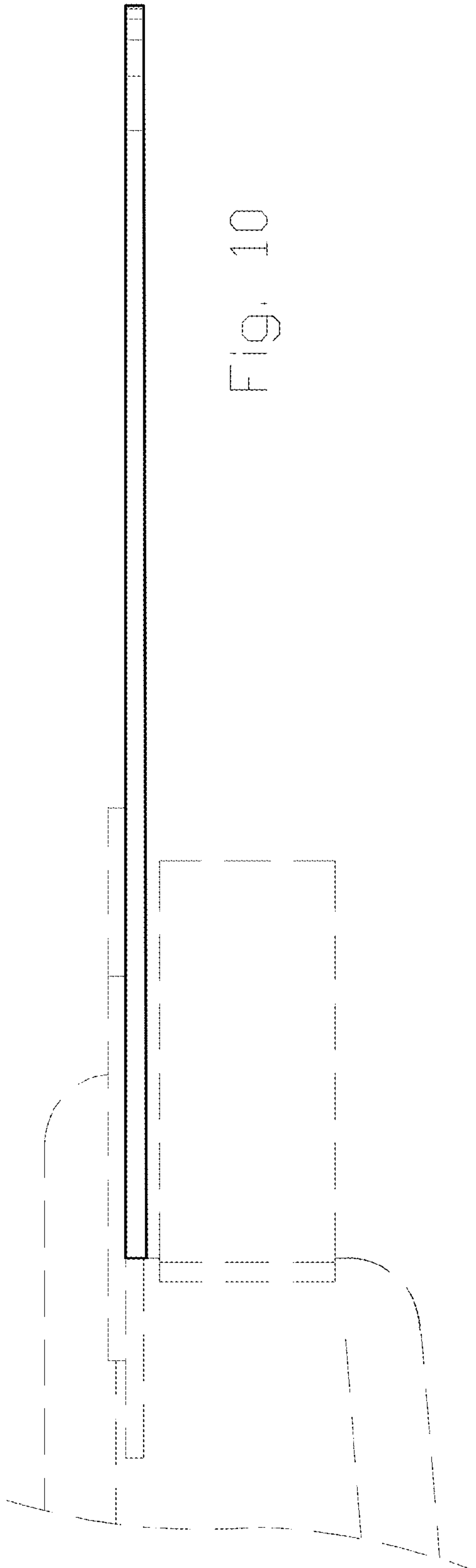
