FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along lines 8-8 of FIG. 6;

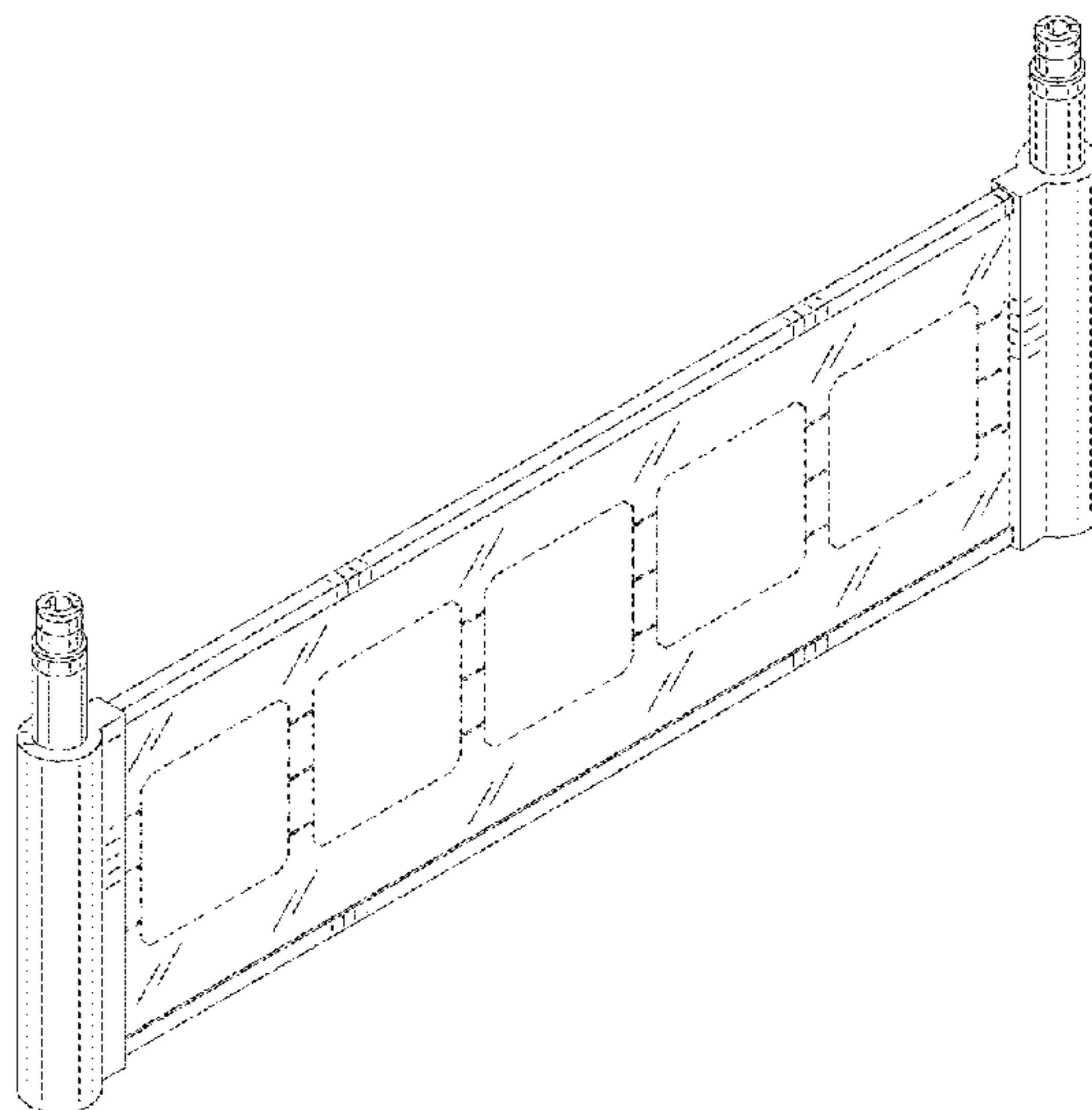
FIG. 9 is a perspective view thereof, shown in a first environment of use;

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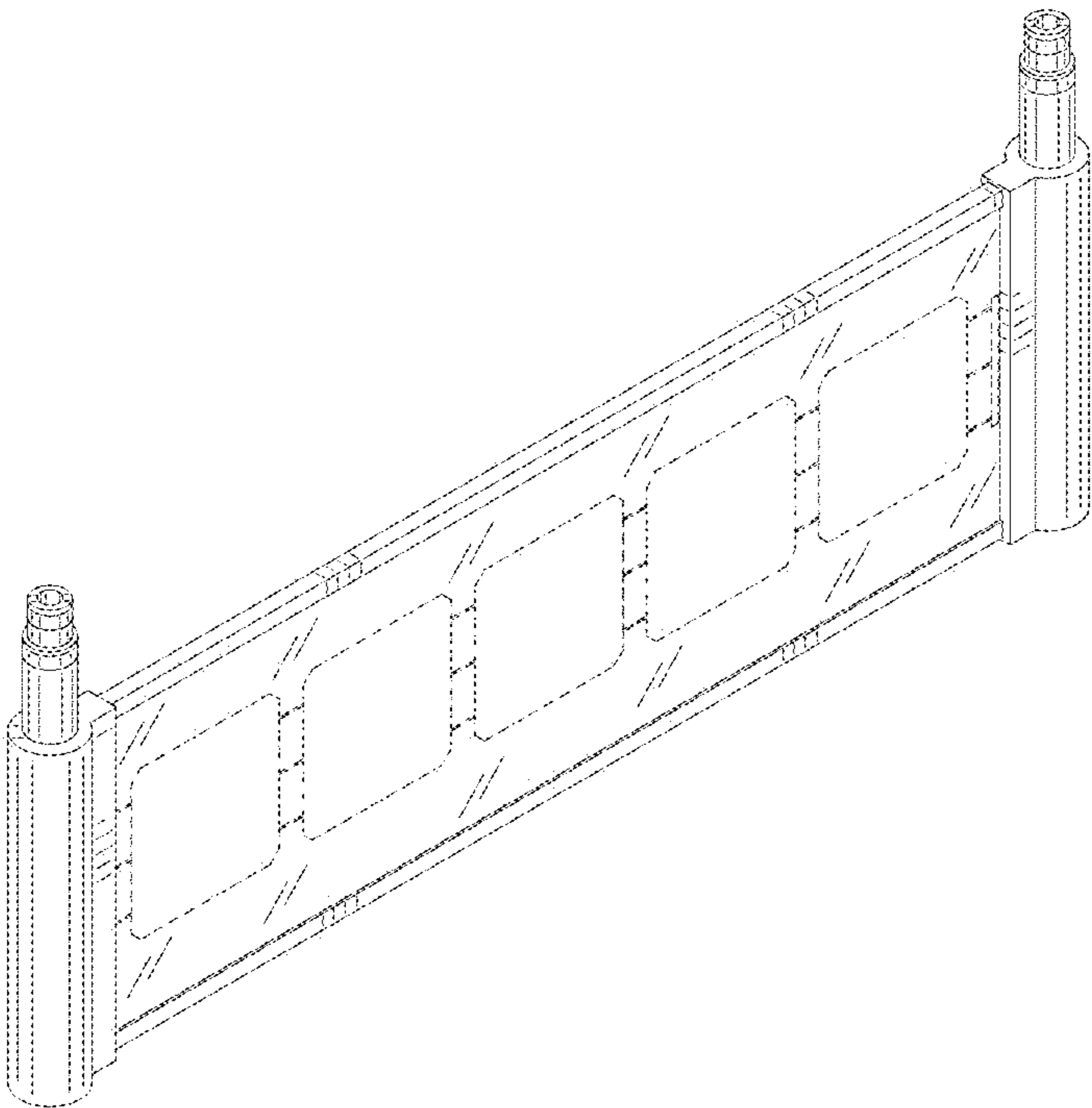

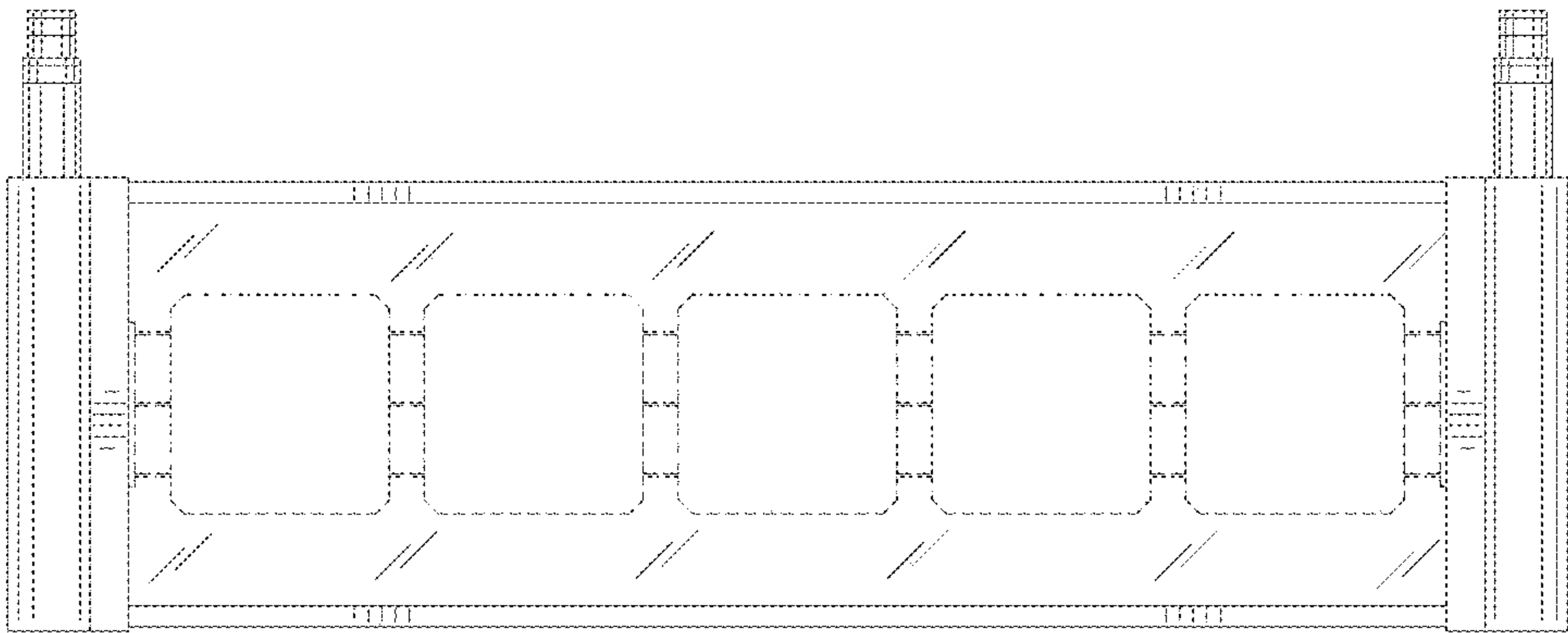

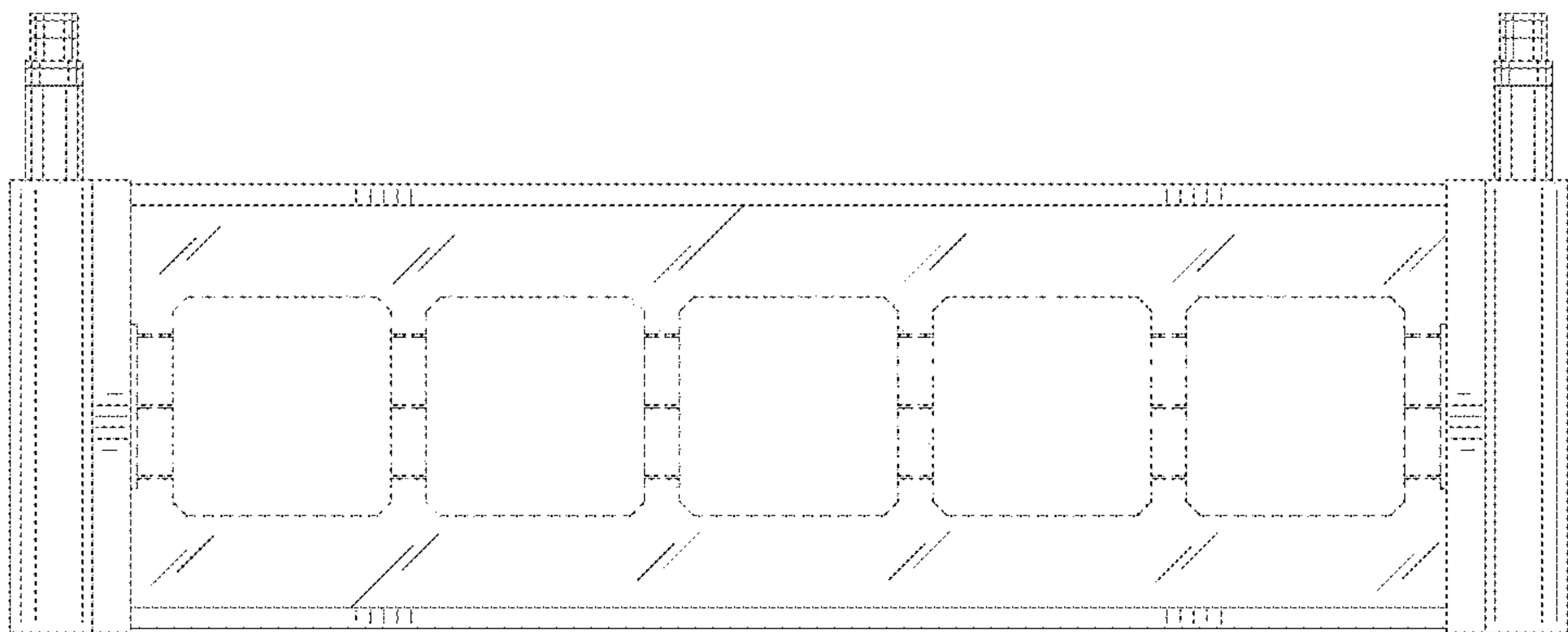

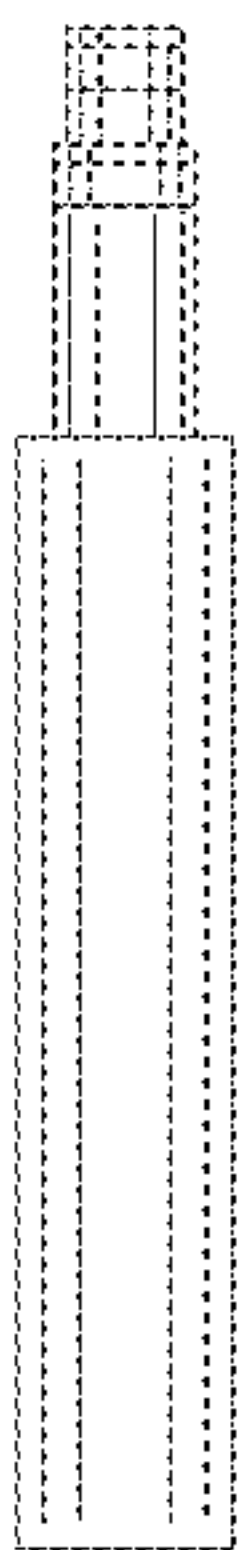

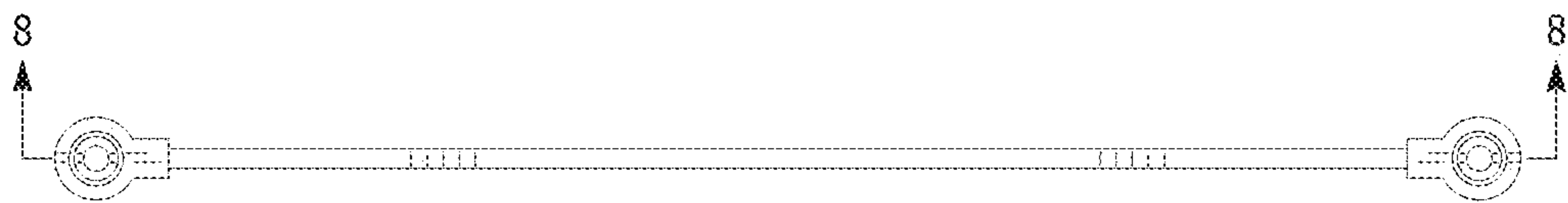

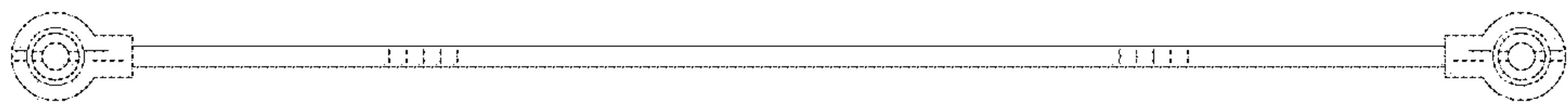

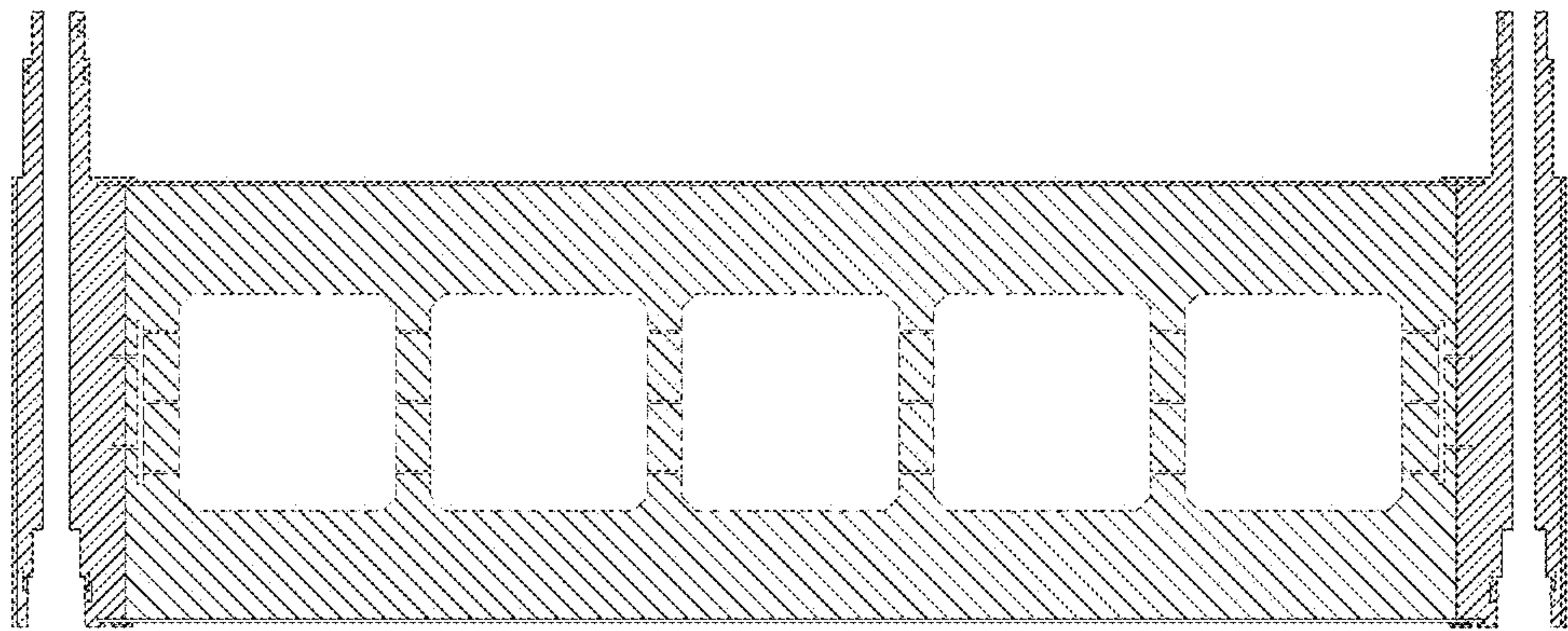

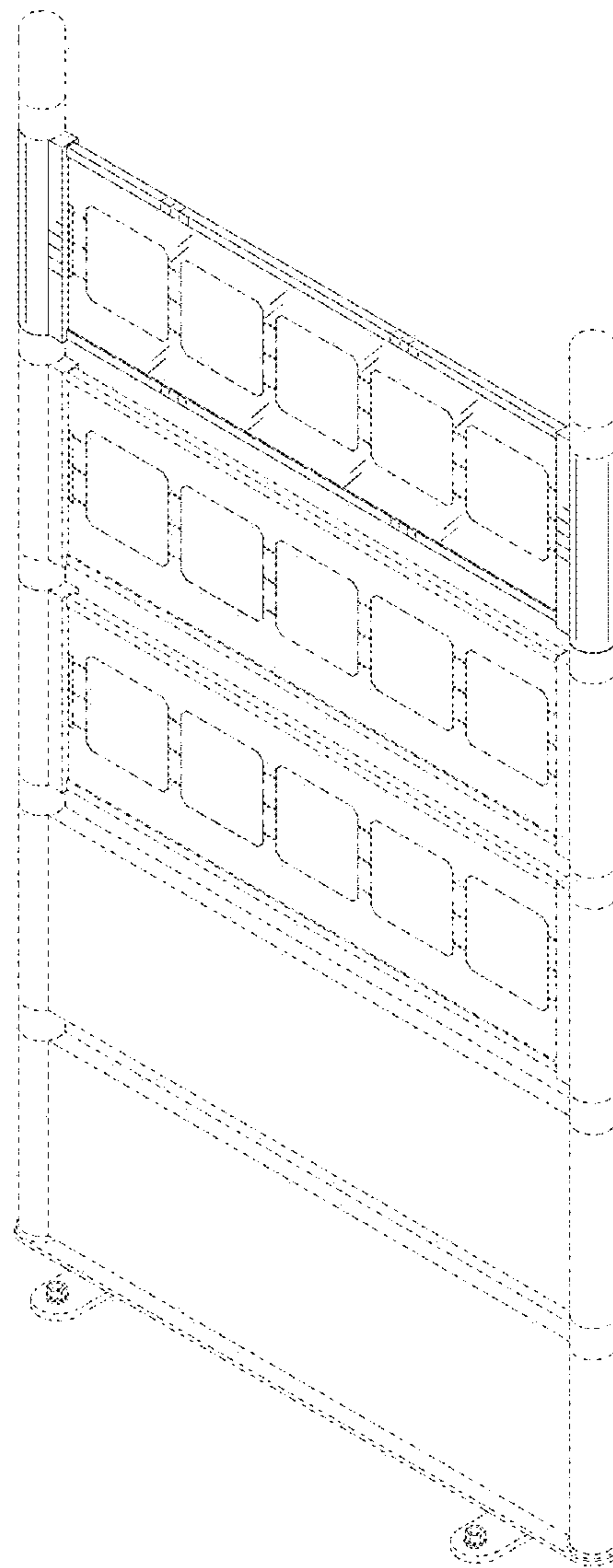

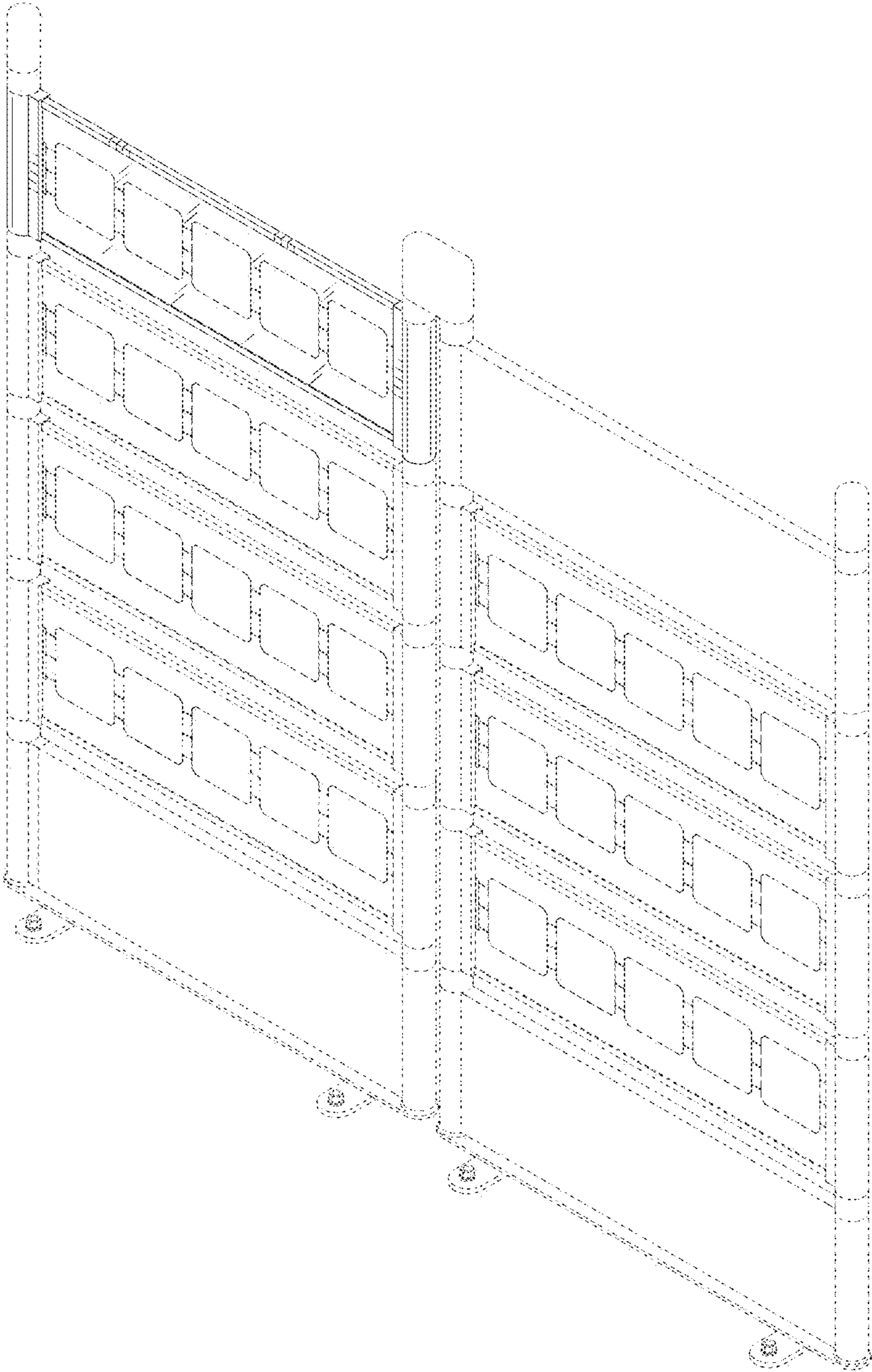

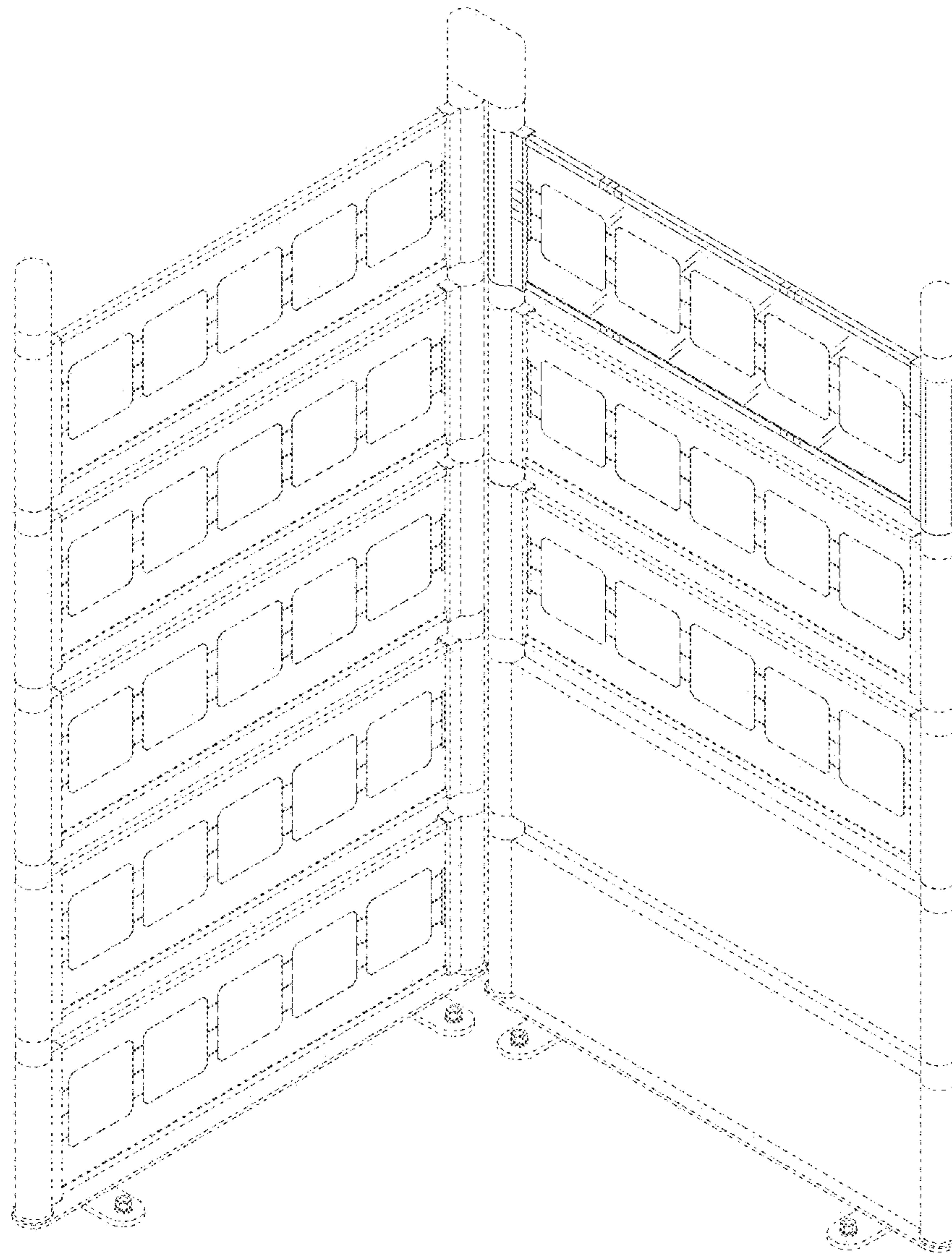
