(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a modular product, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a modular product showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof—the right-side view is a mirror image of the left side view;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof—the bottom plan view is identical to the top plan view;

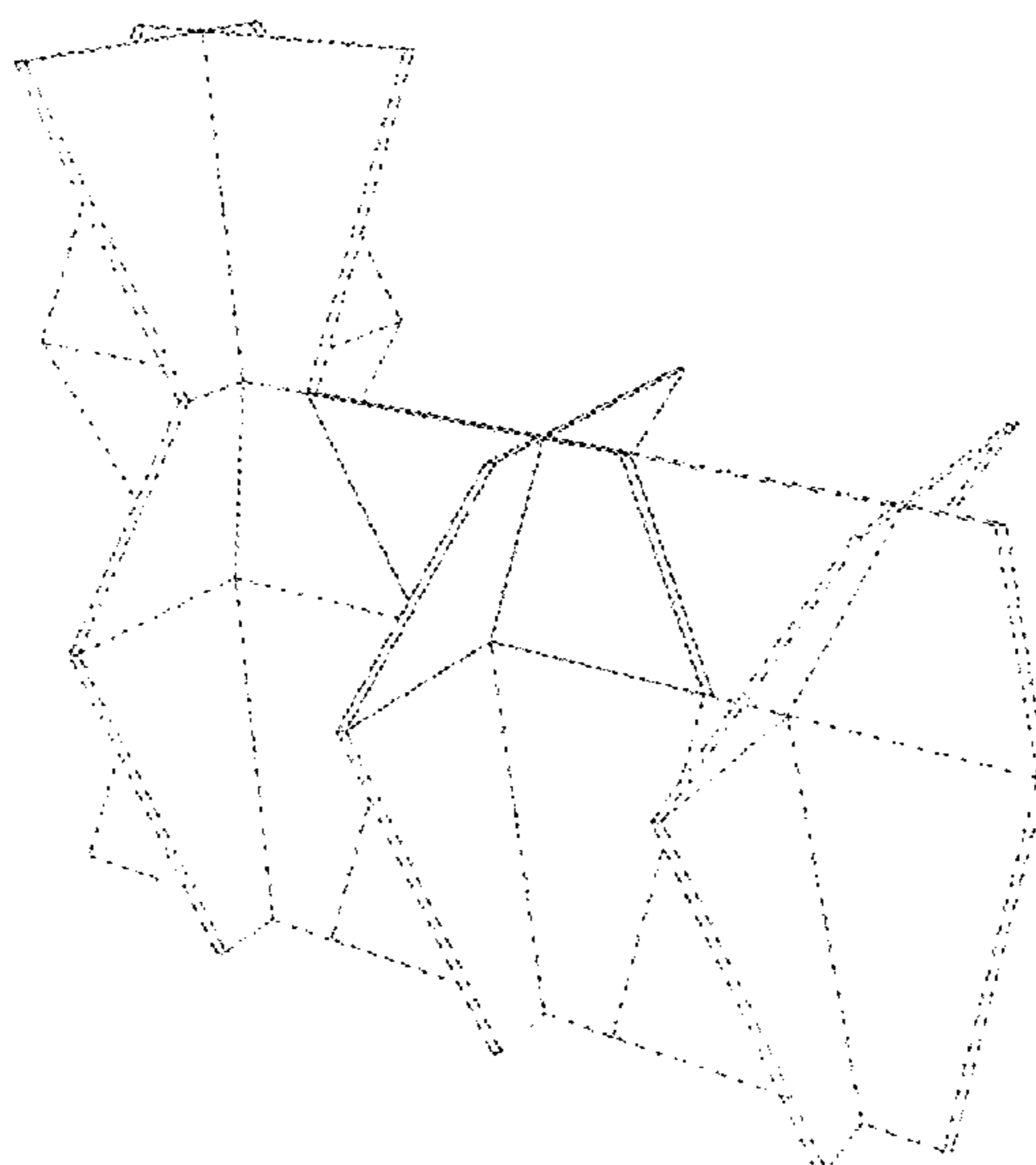

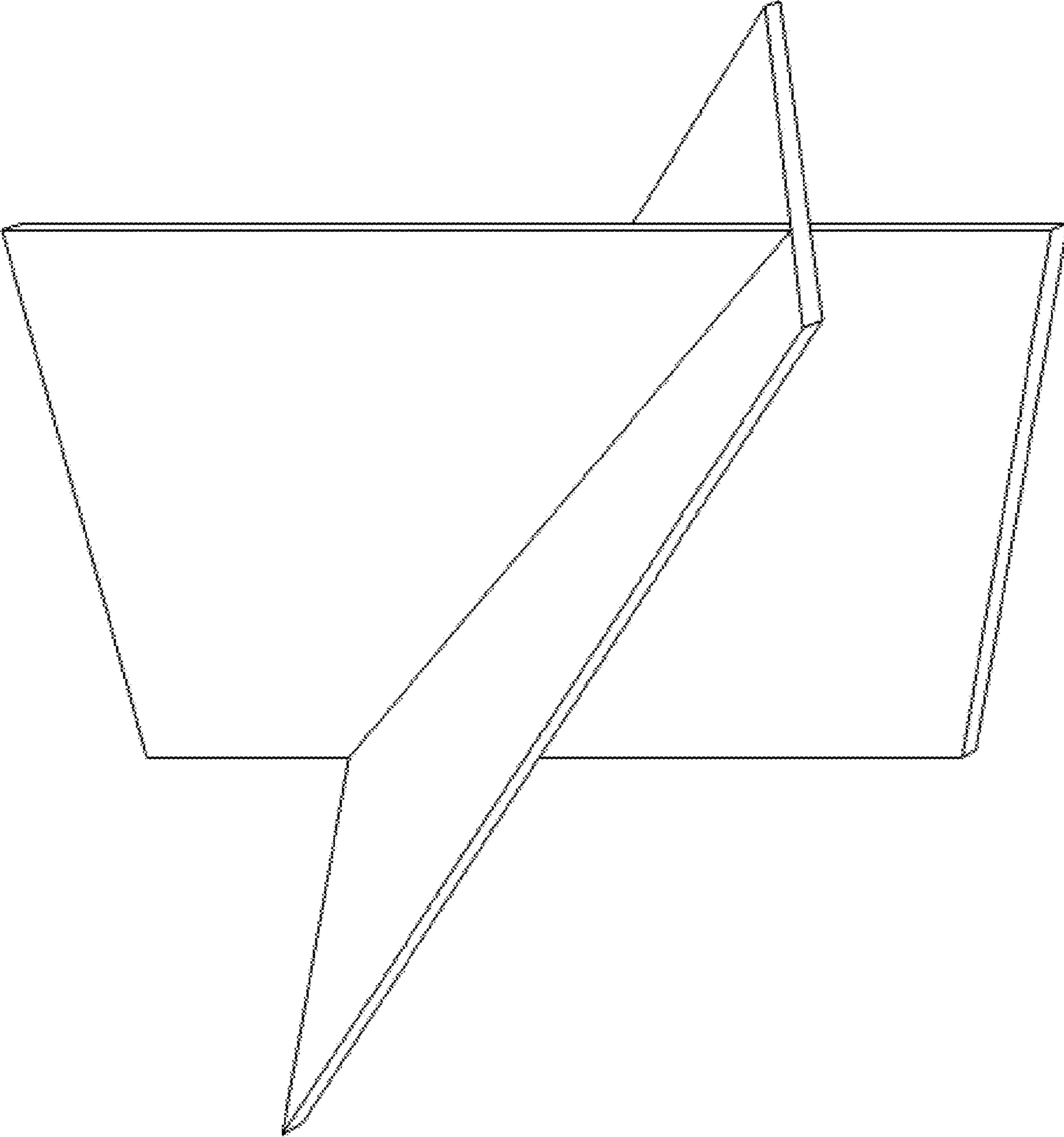

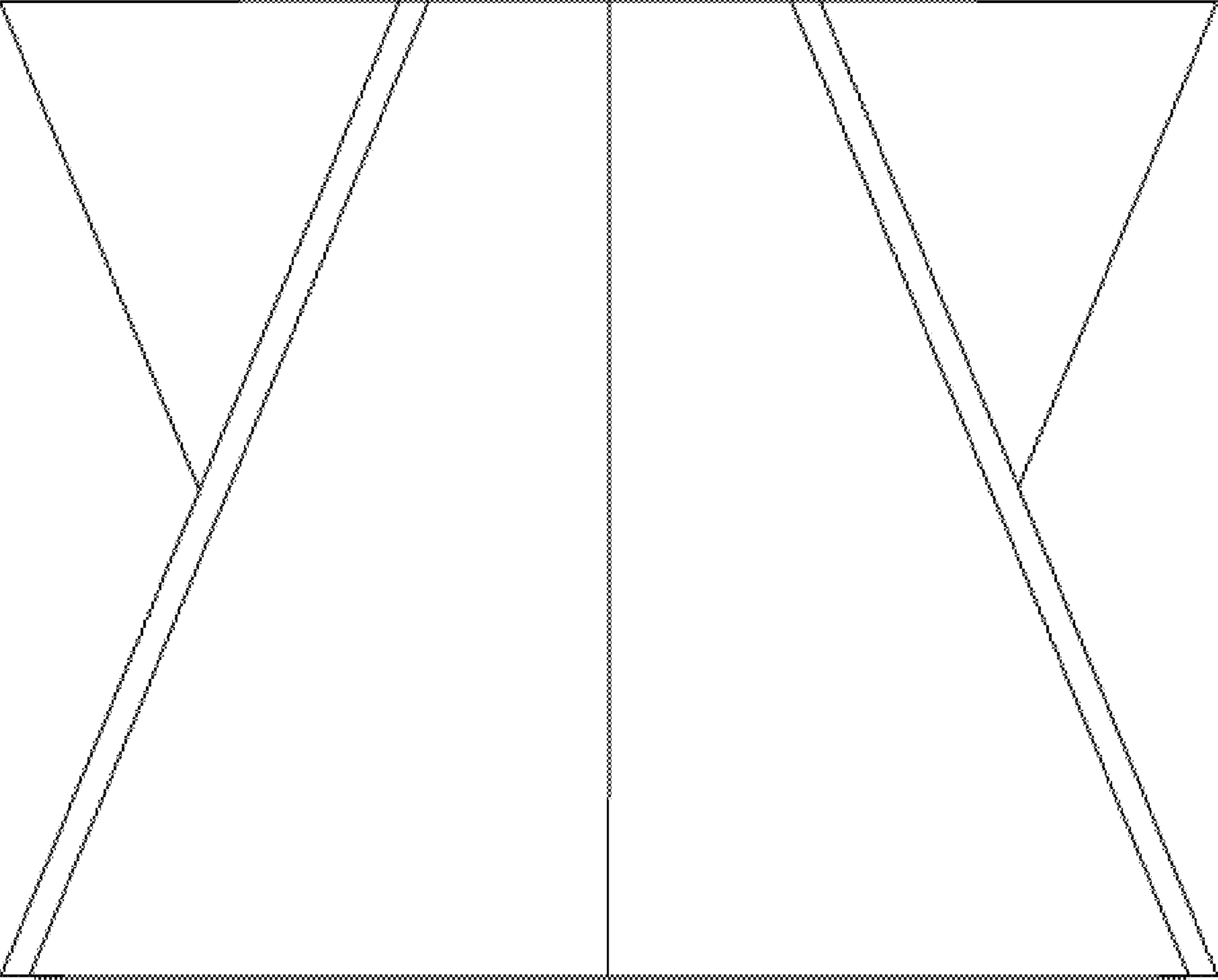

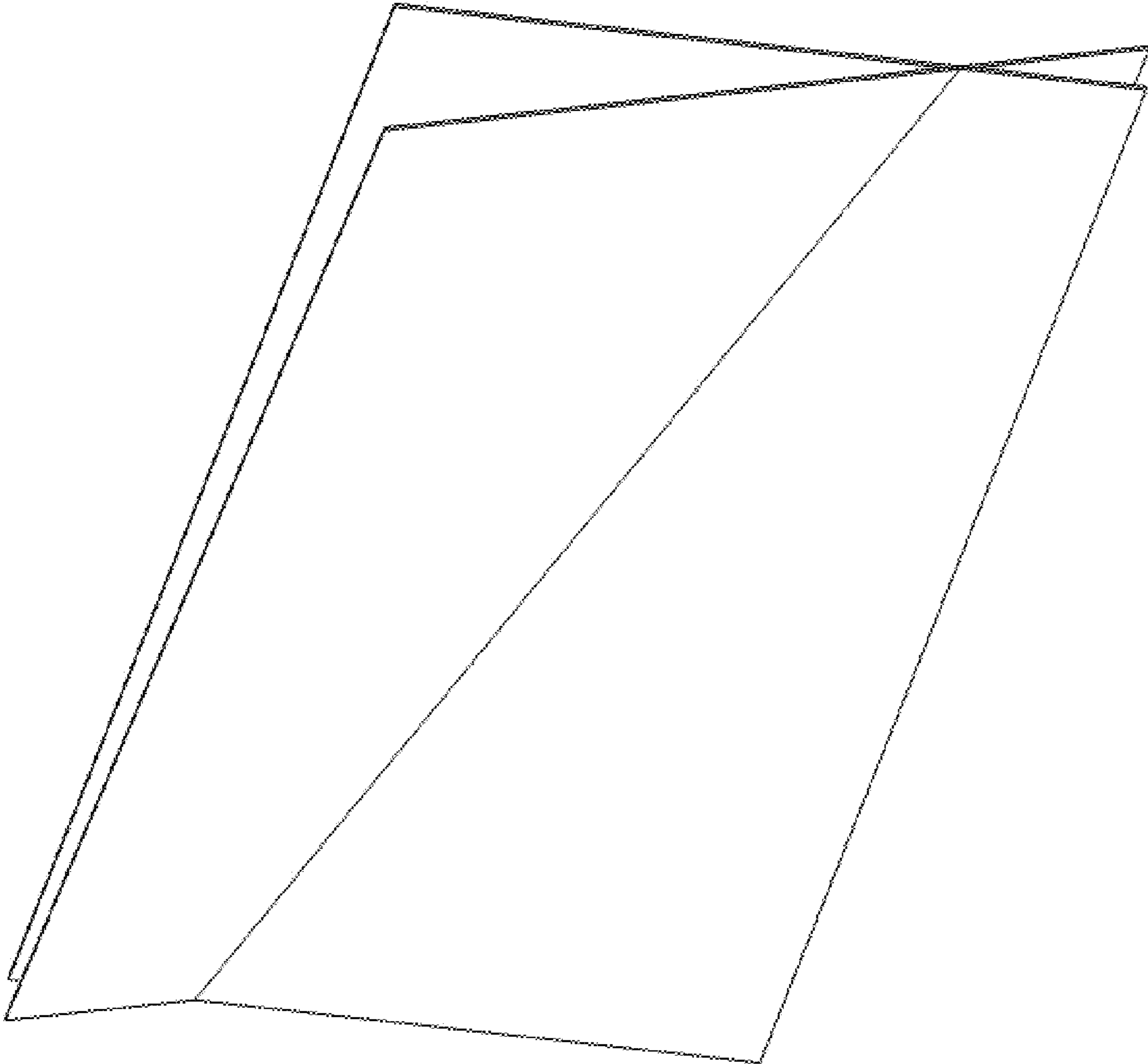

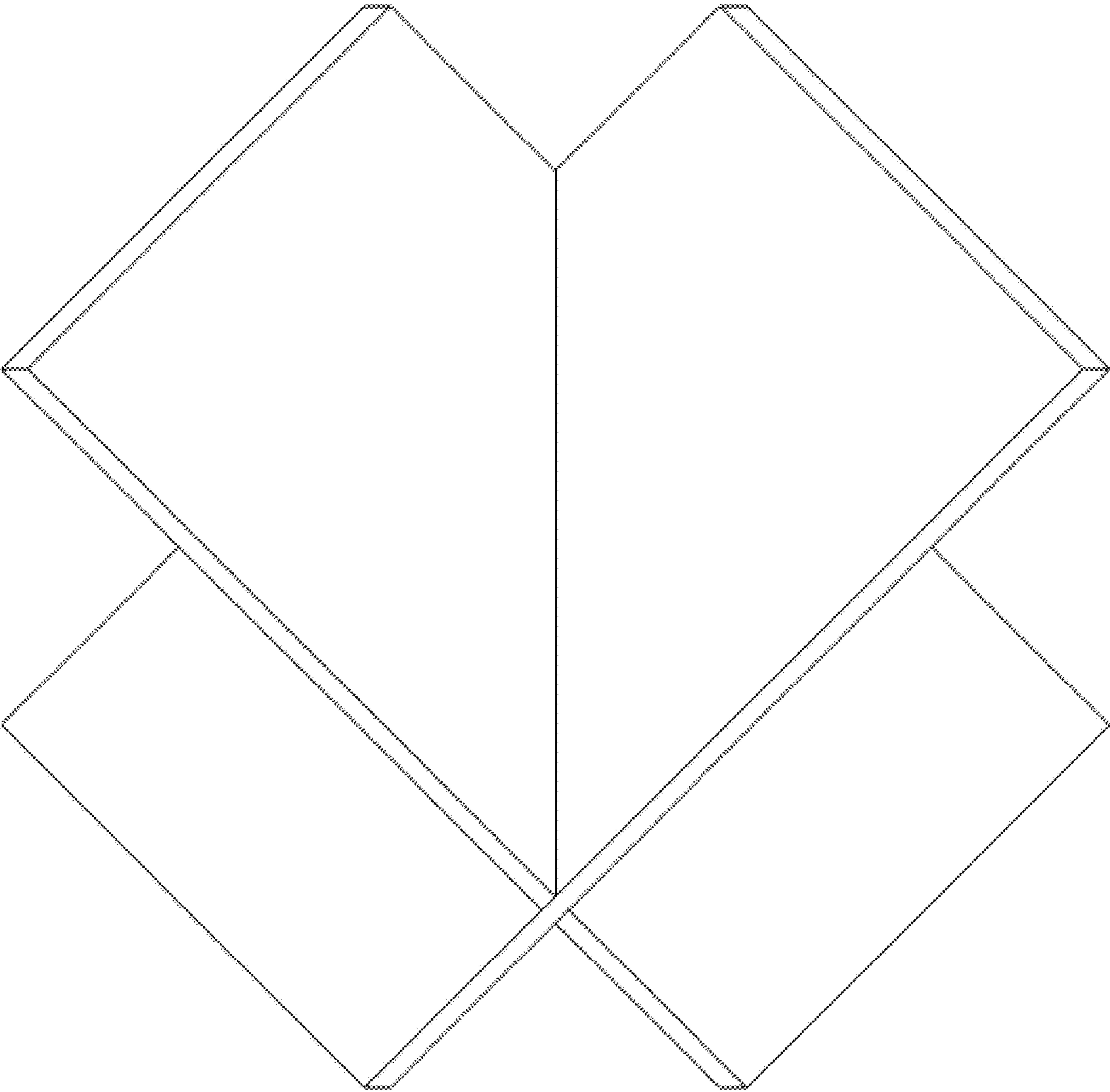

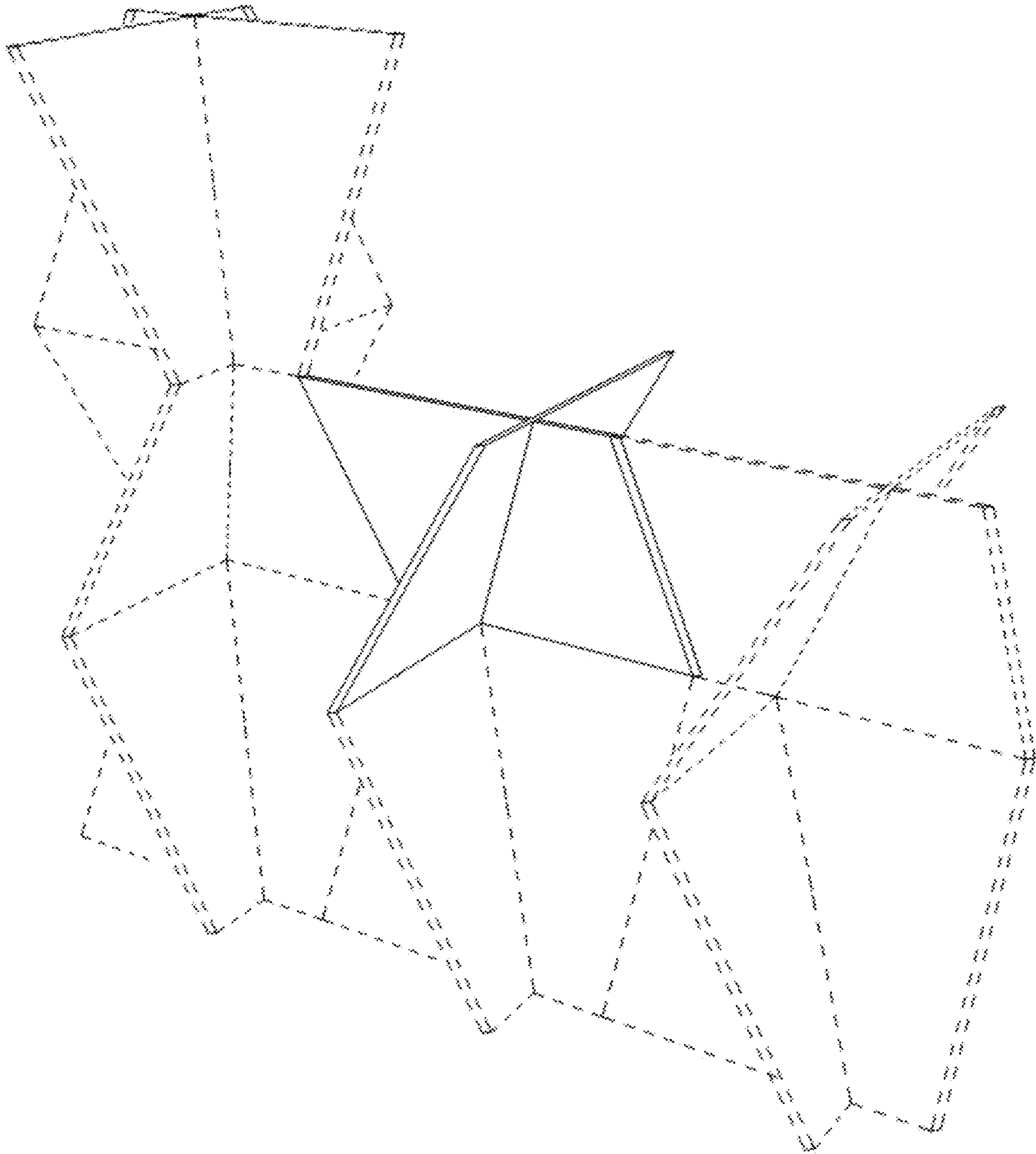

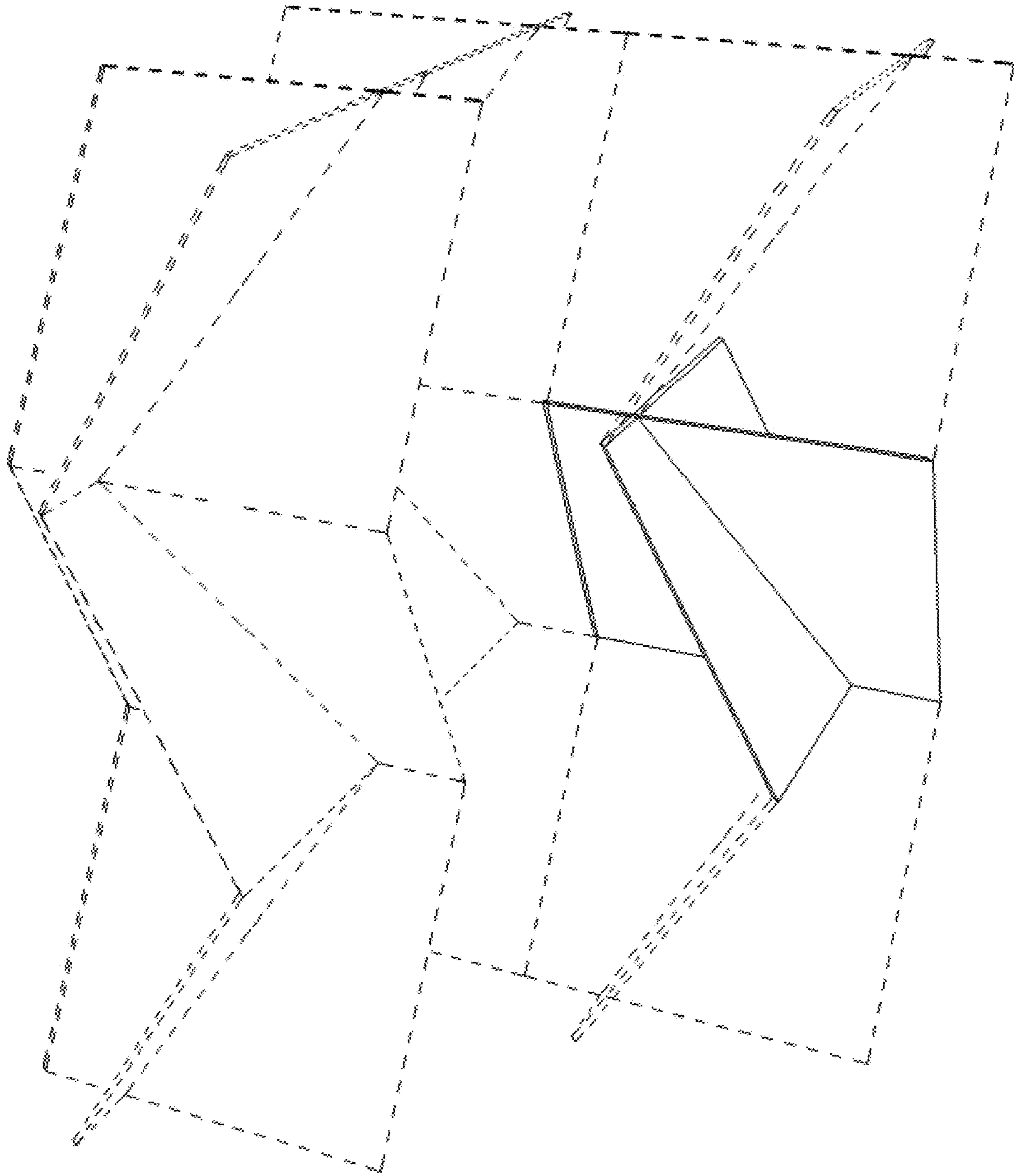

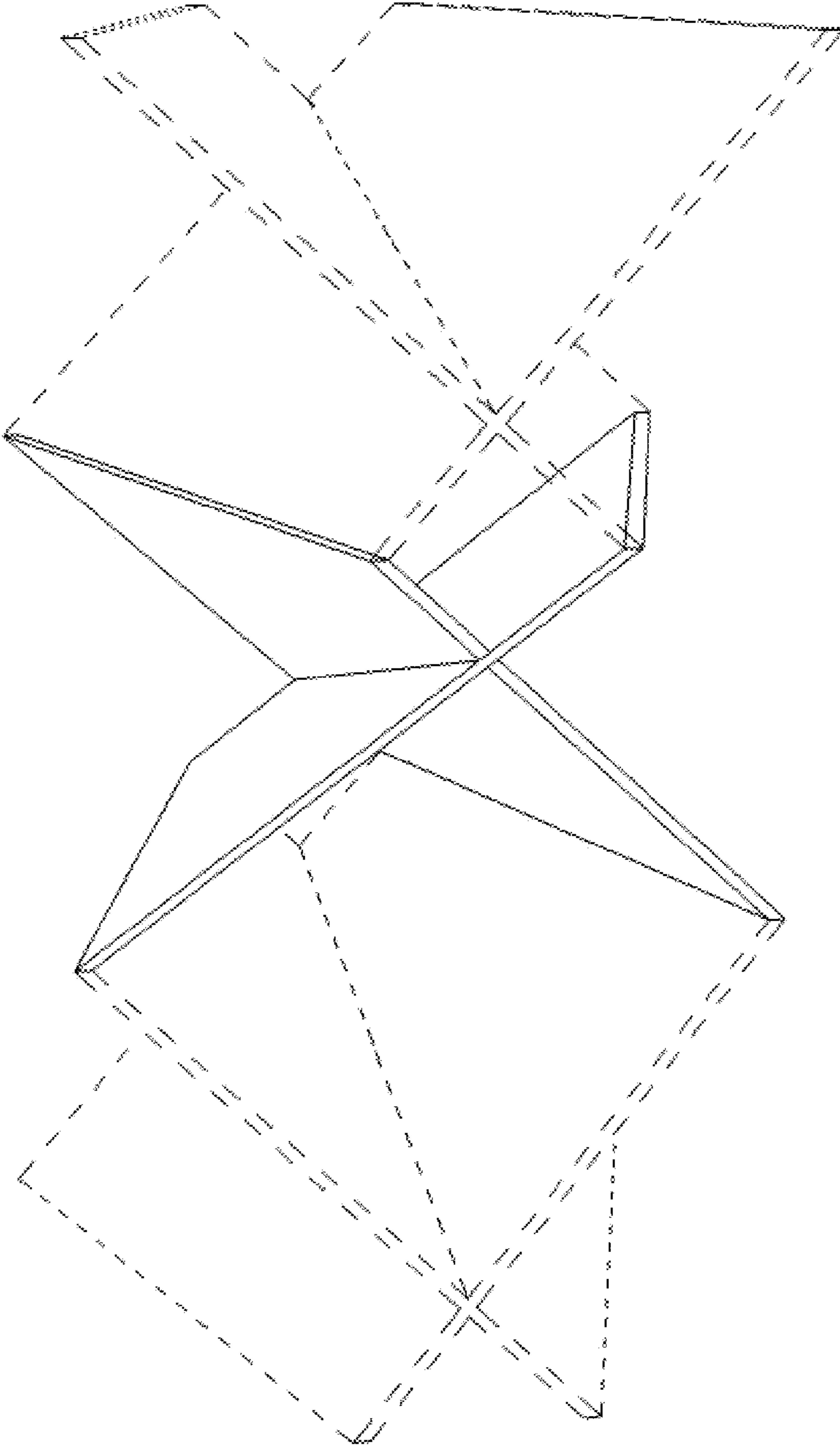
