FIG. 10 is a front view of the walking aid attachment shown in a second alternate state; and,

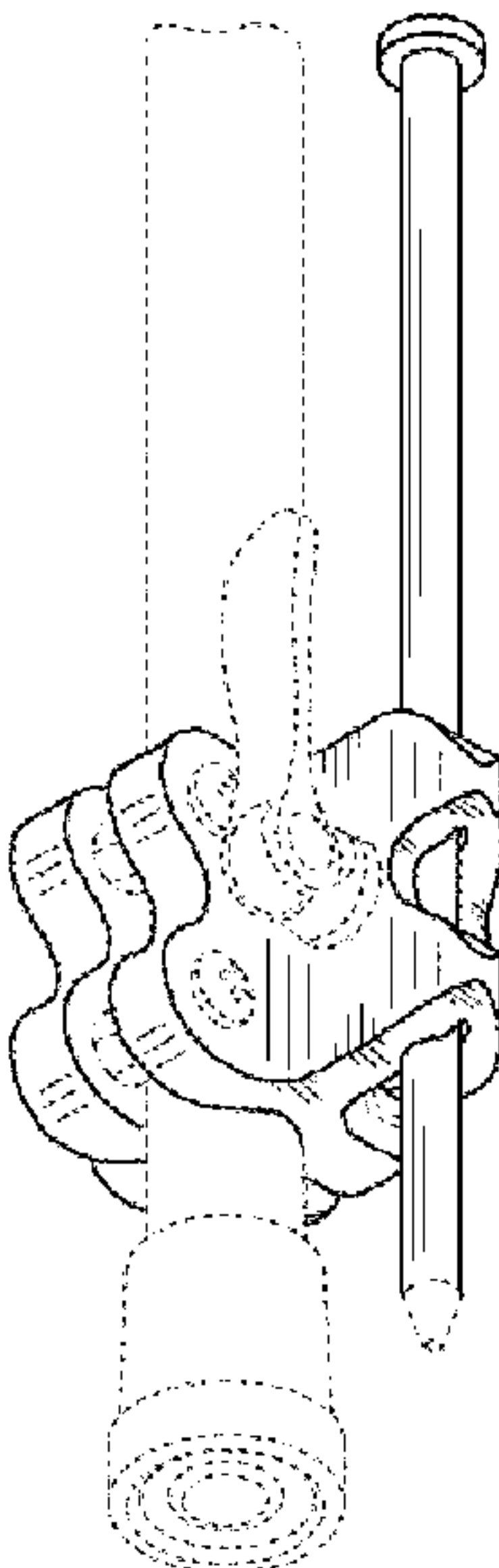
FIG. 11 is a front view of the walking aid attachment shown in a third alternate state.

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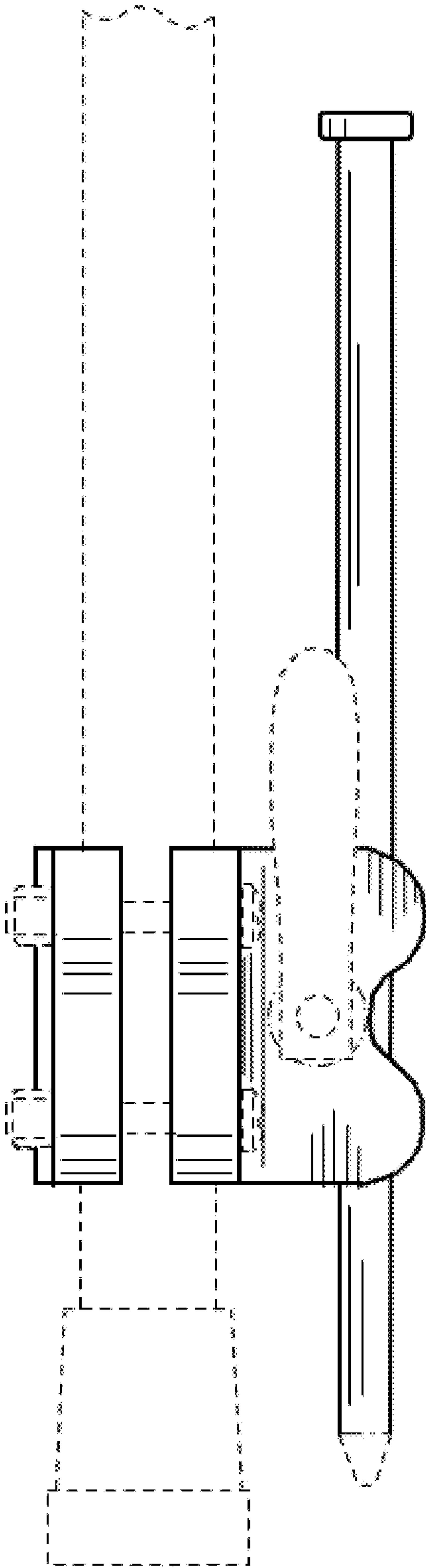
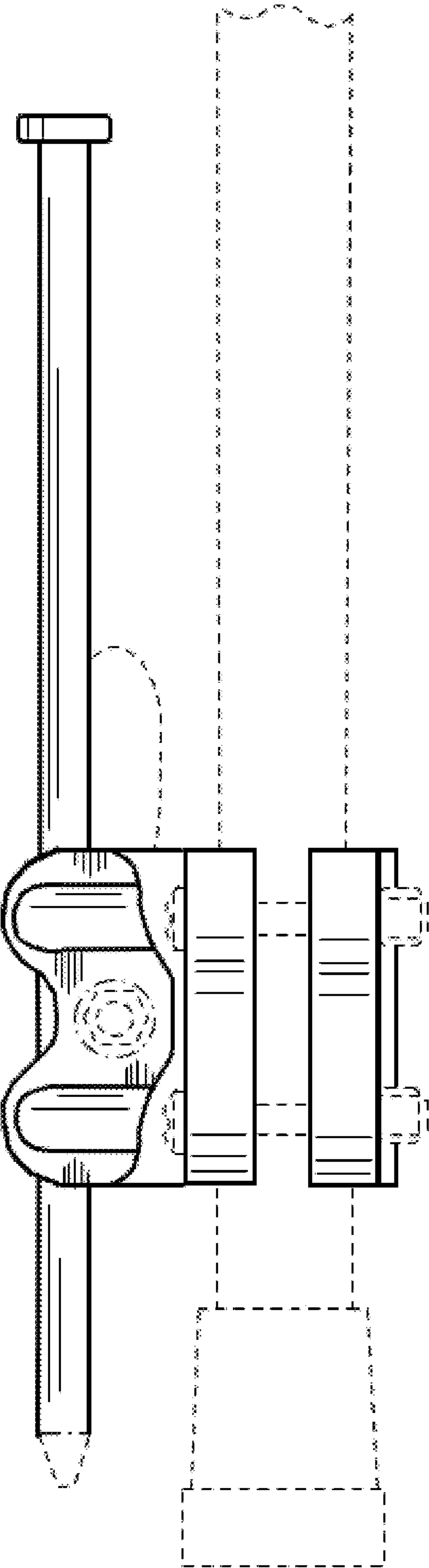

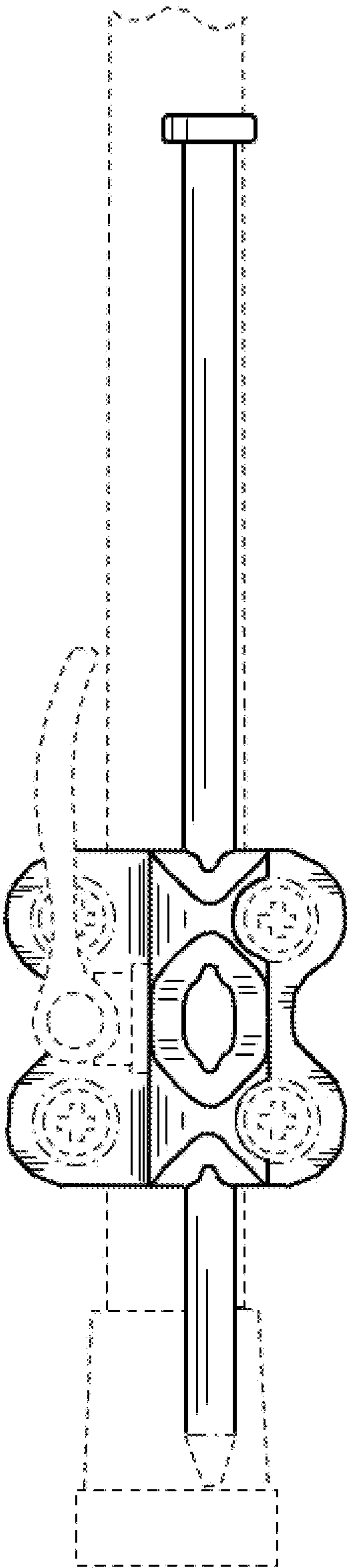

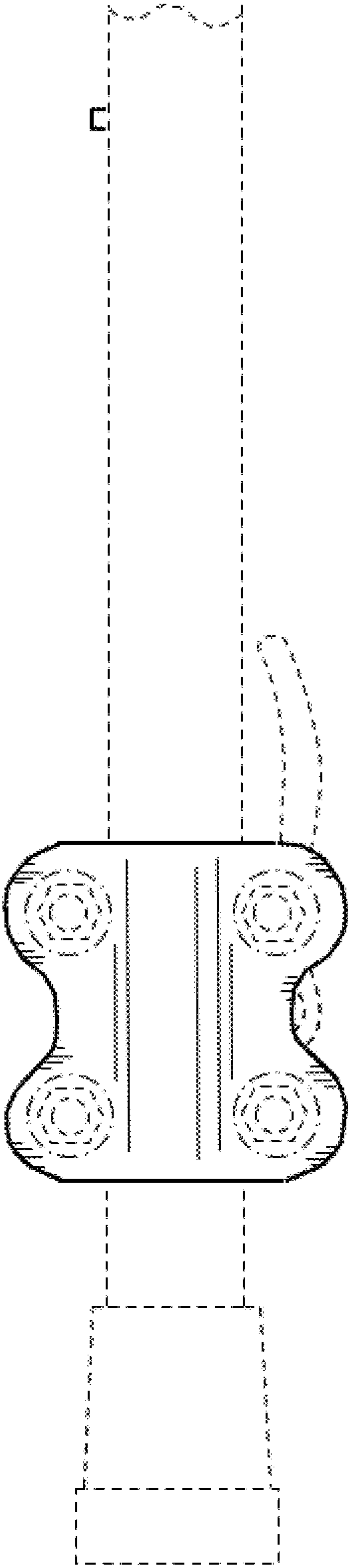

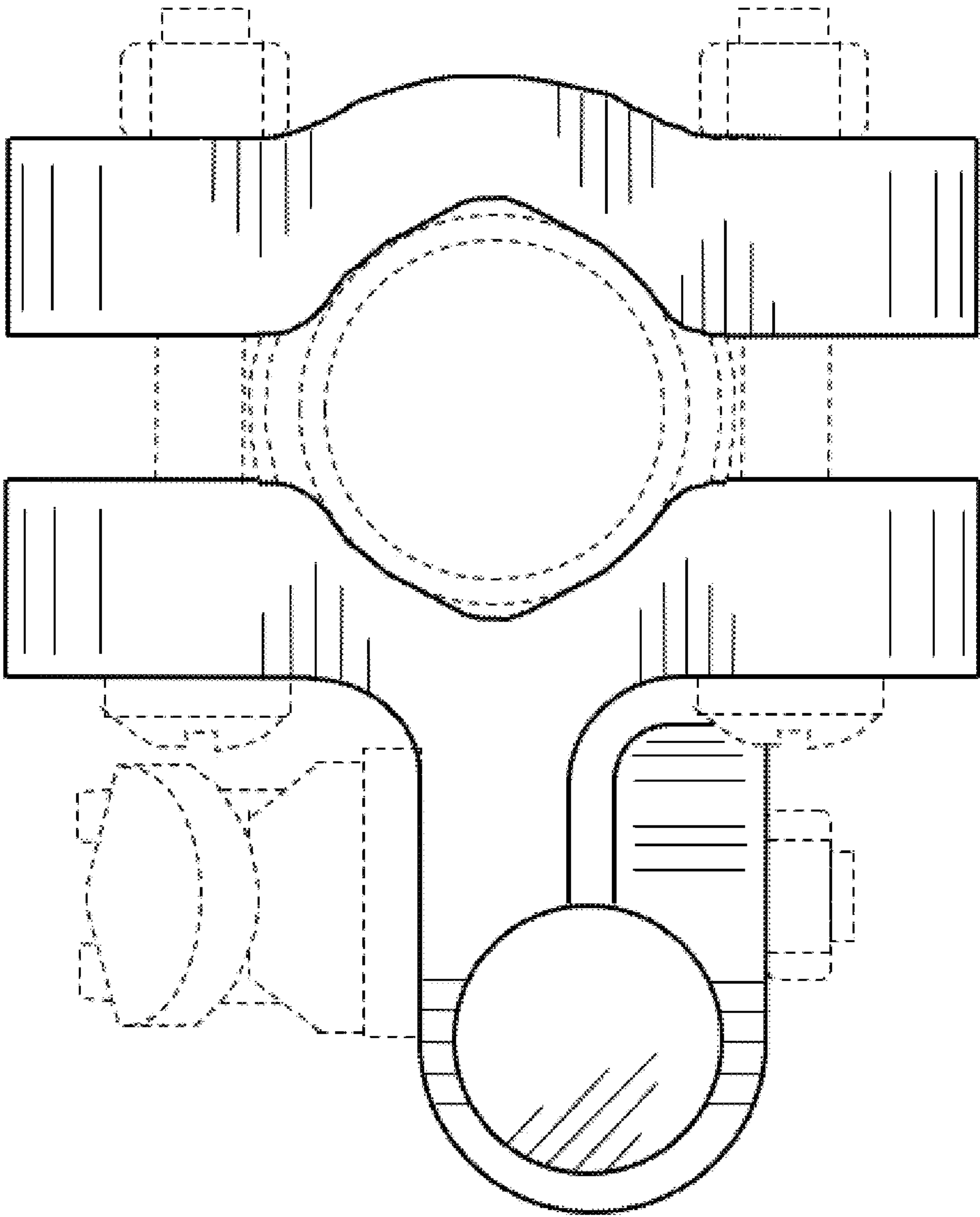

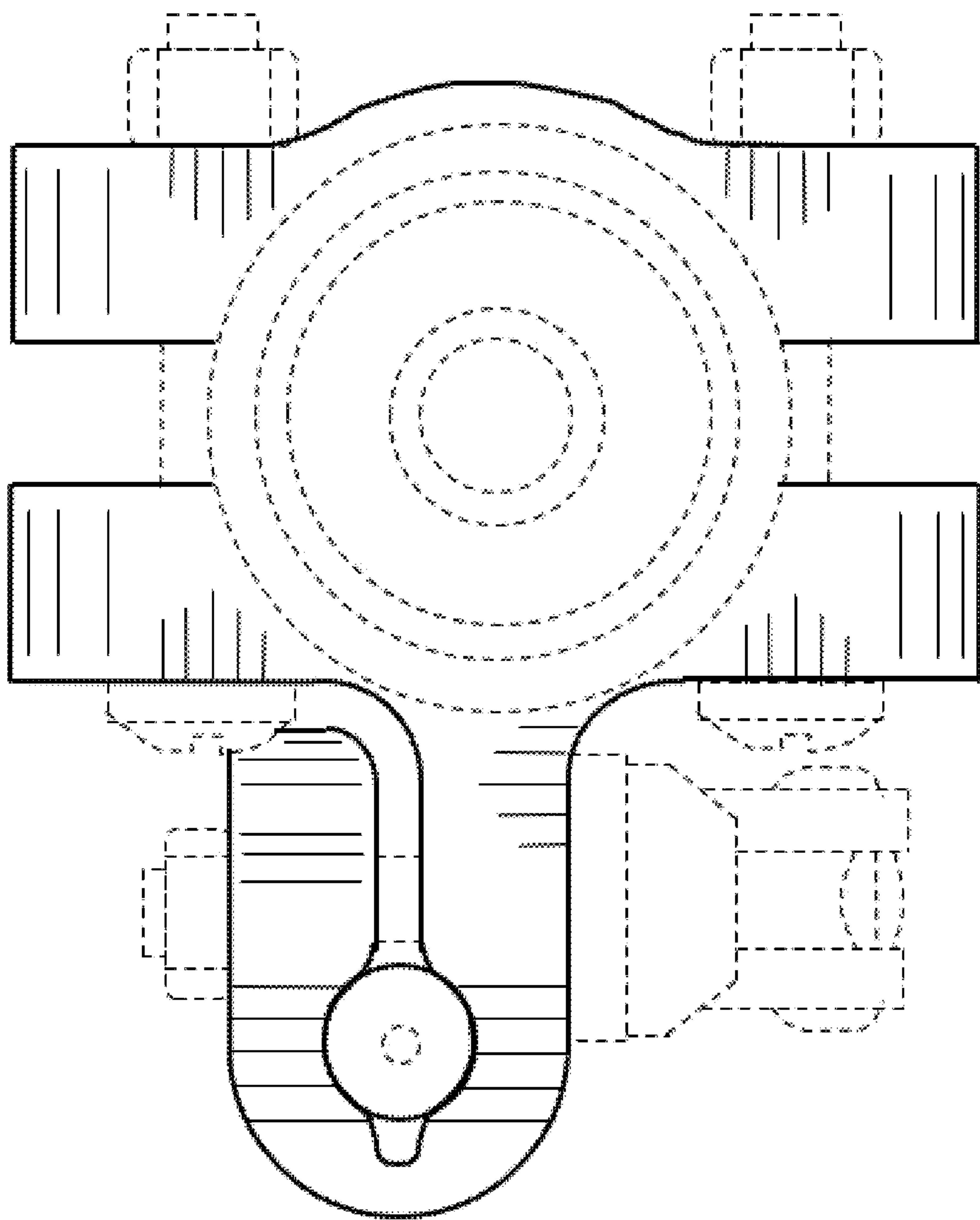

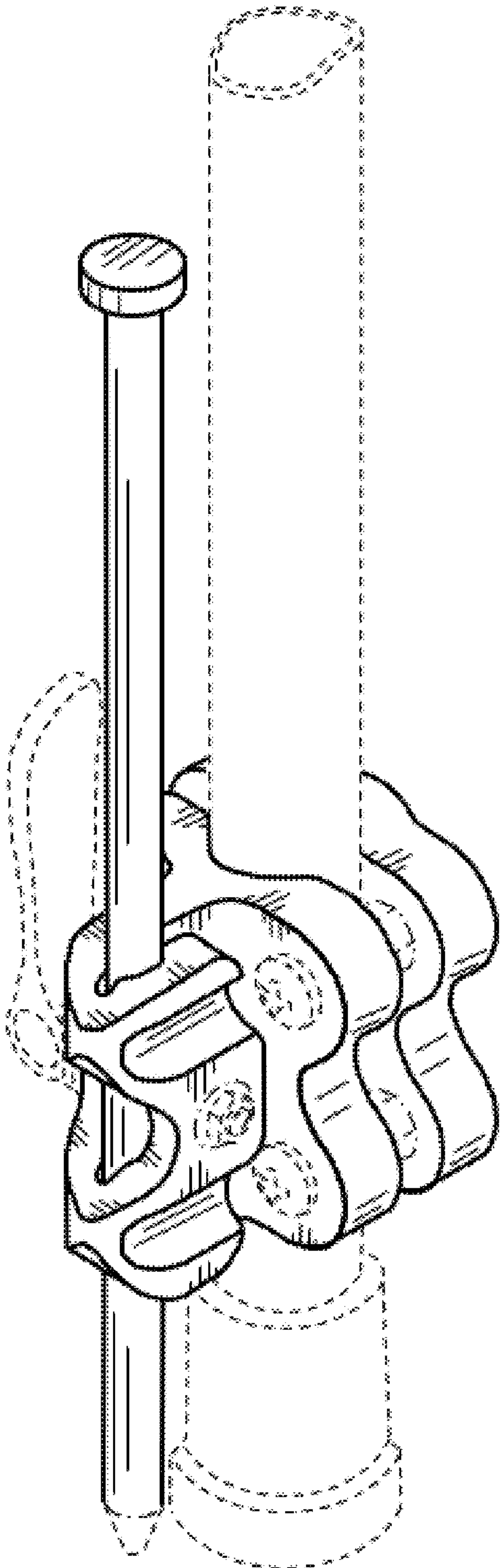

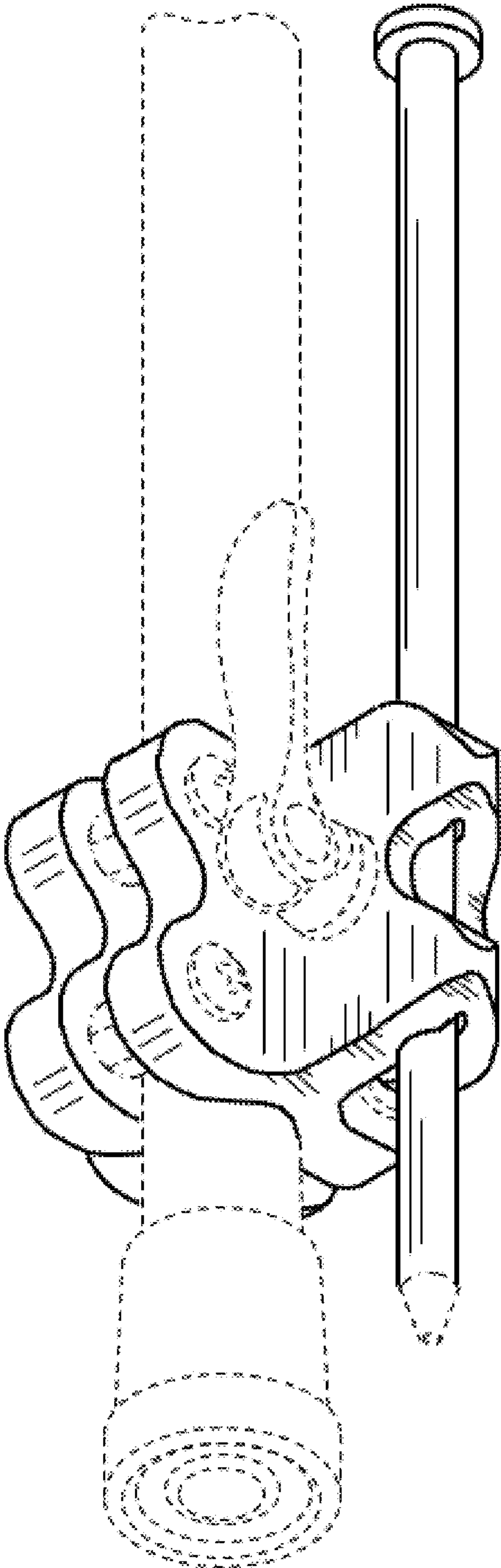

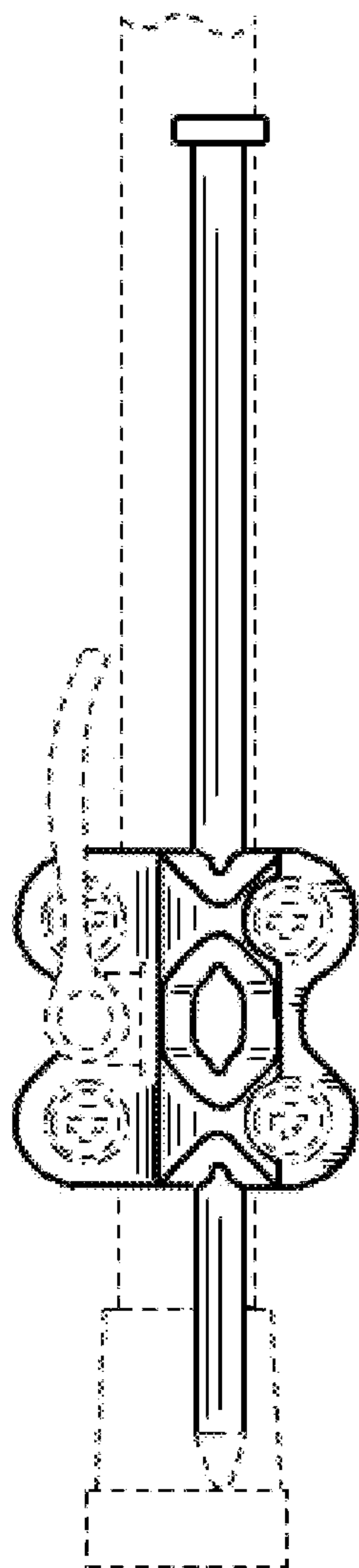

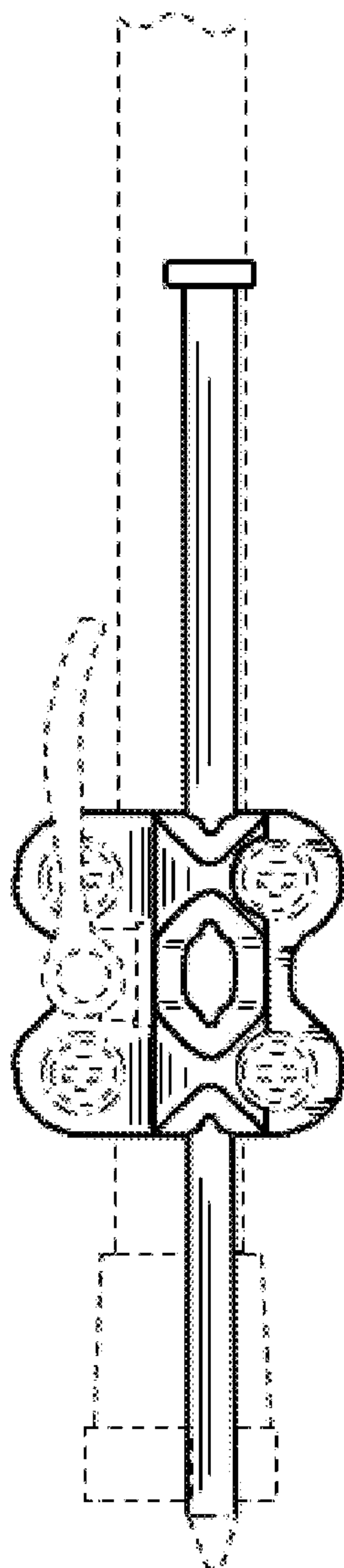

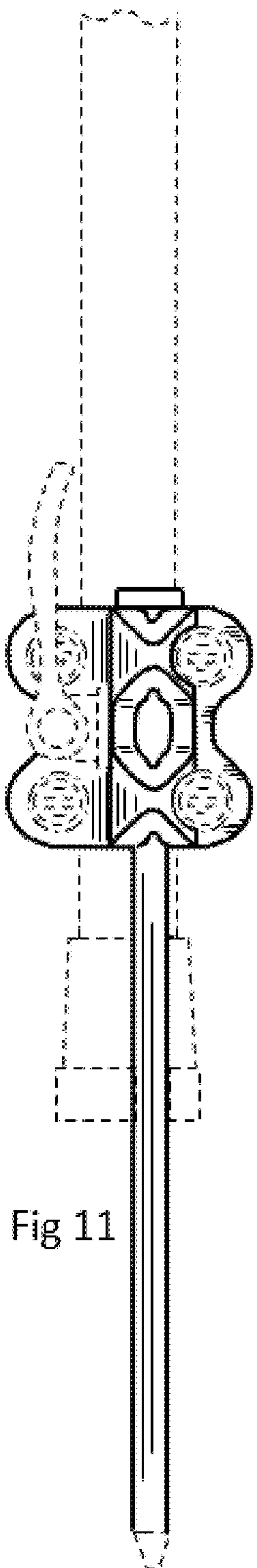
