DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lunch box showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view, the right side elevation view being a mirror image thereof;

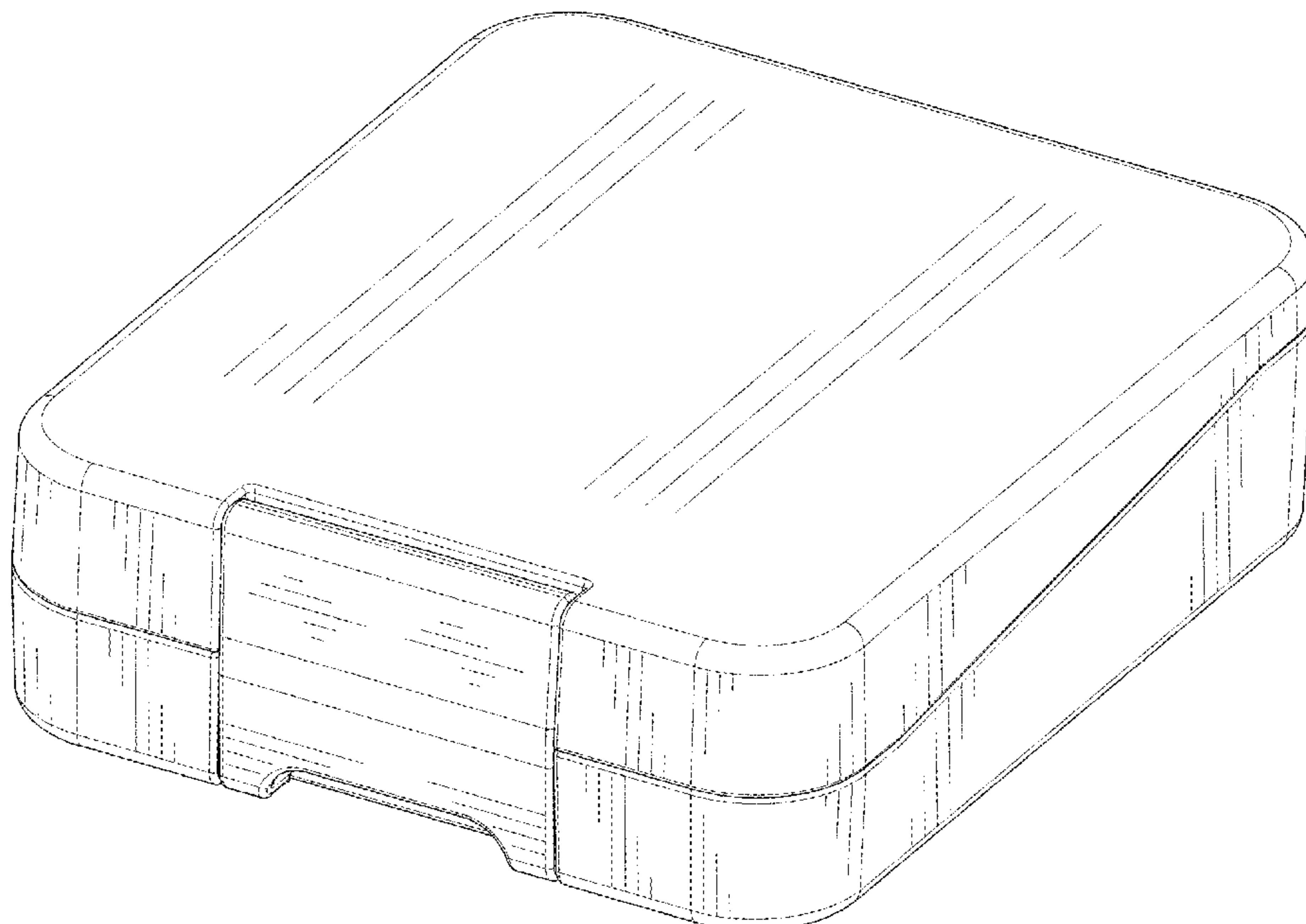
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and

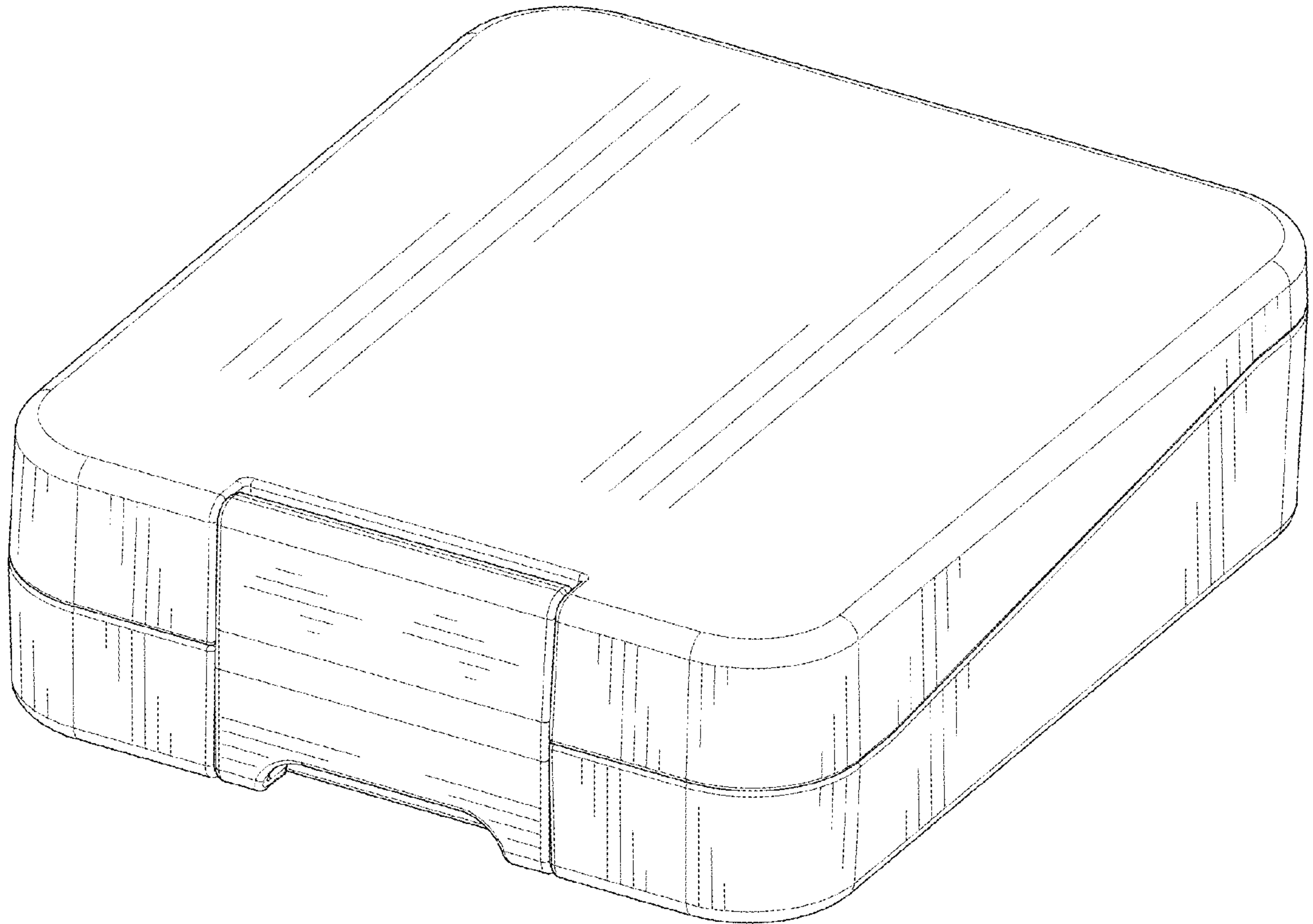

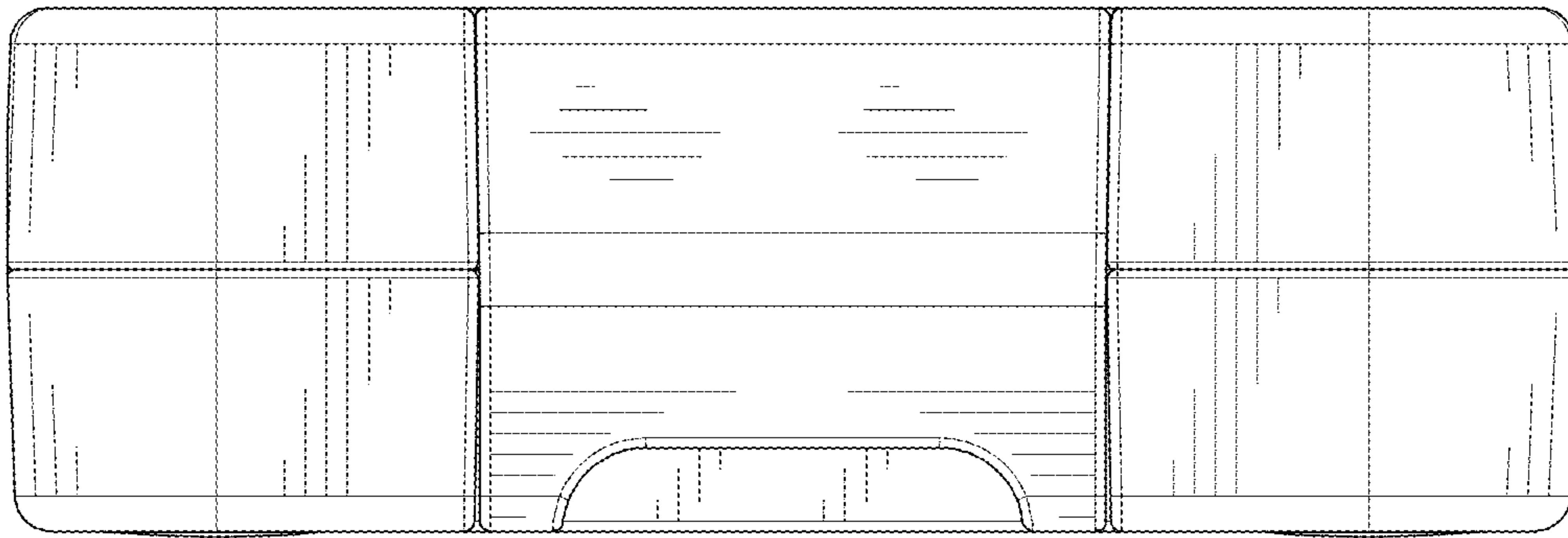

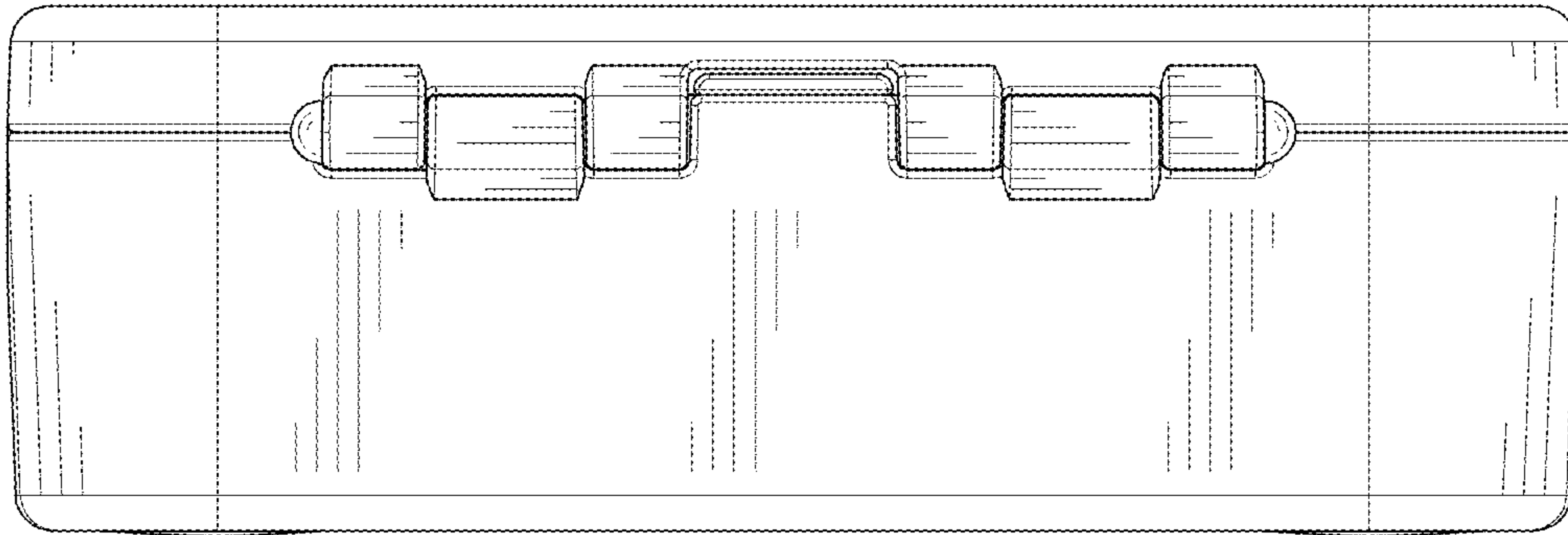

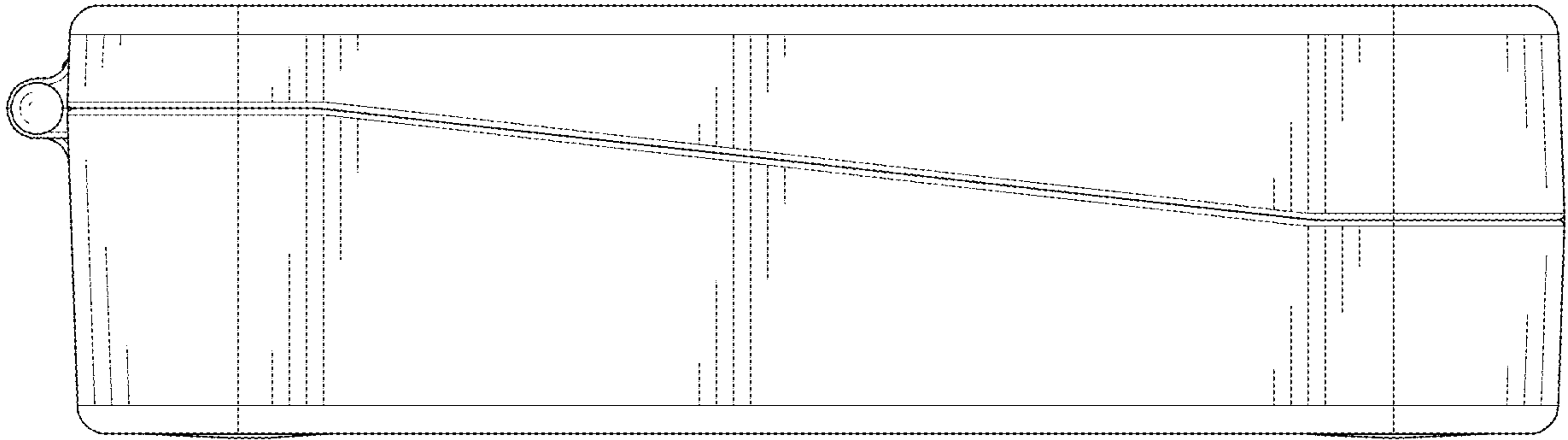

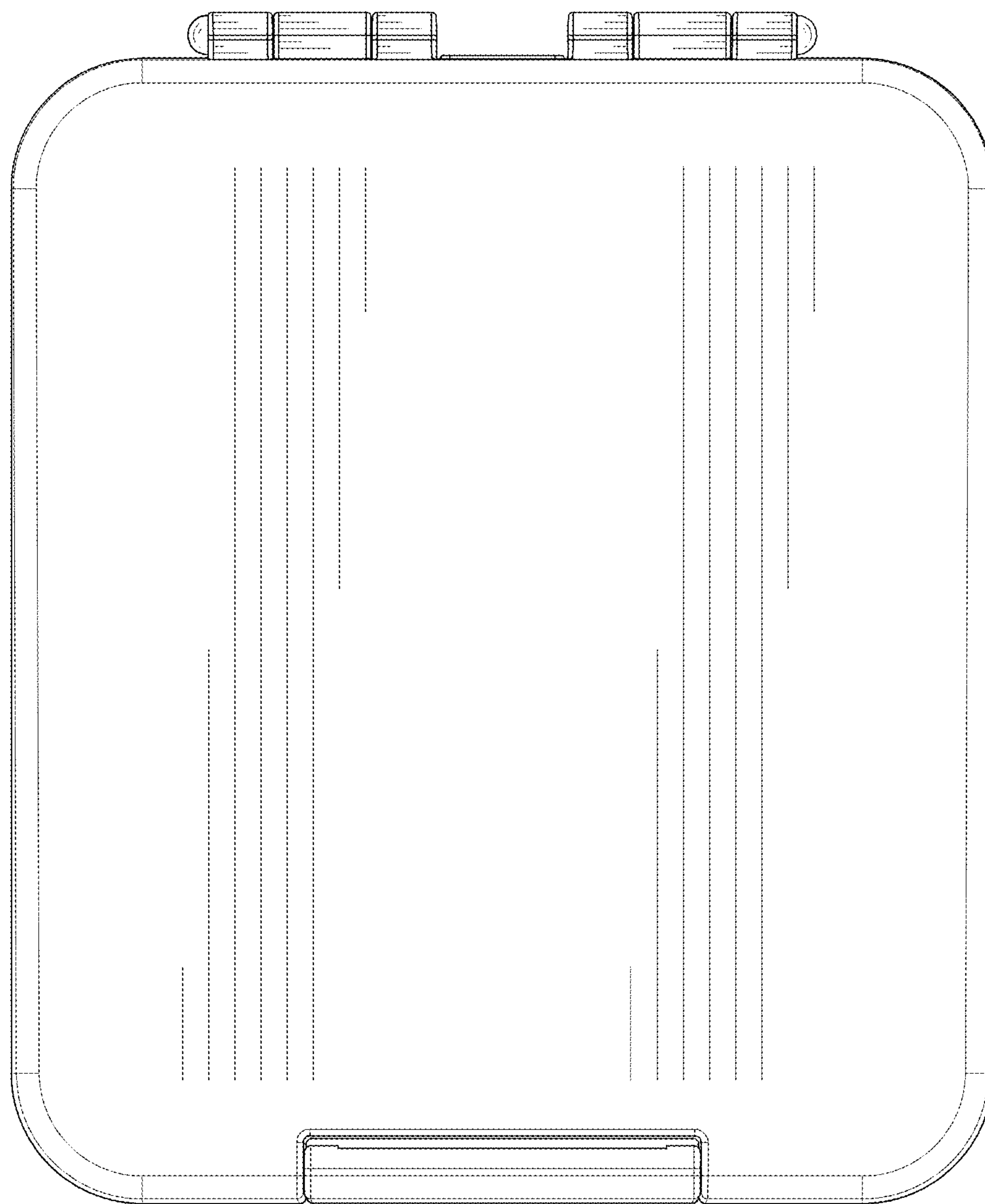

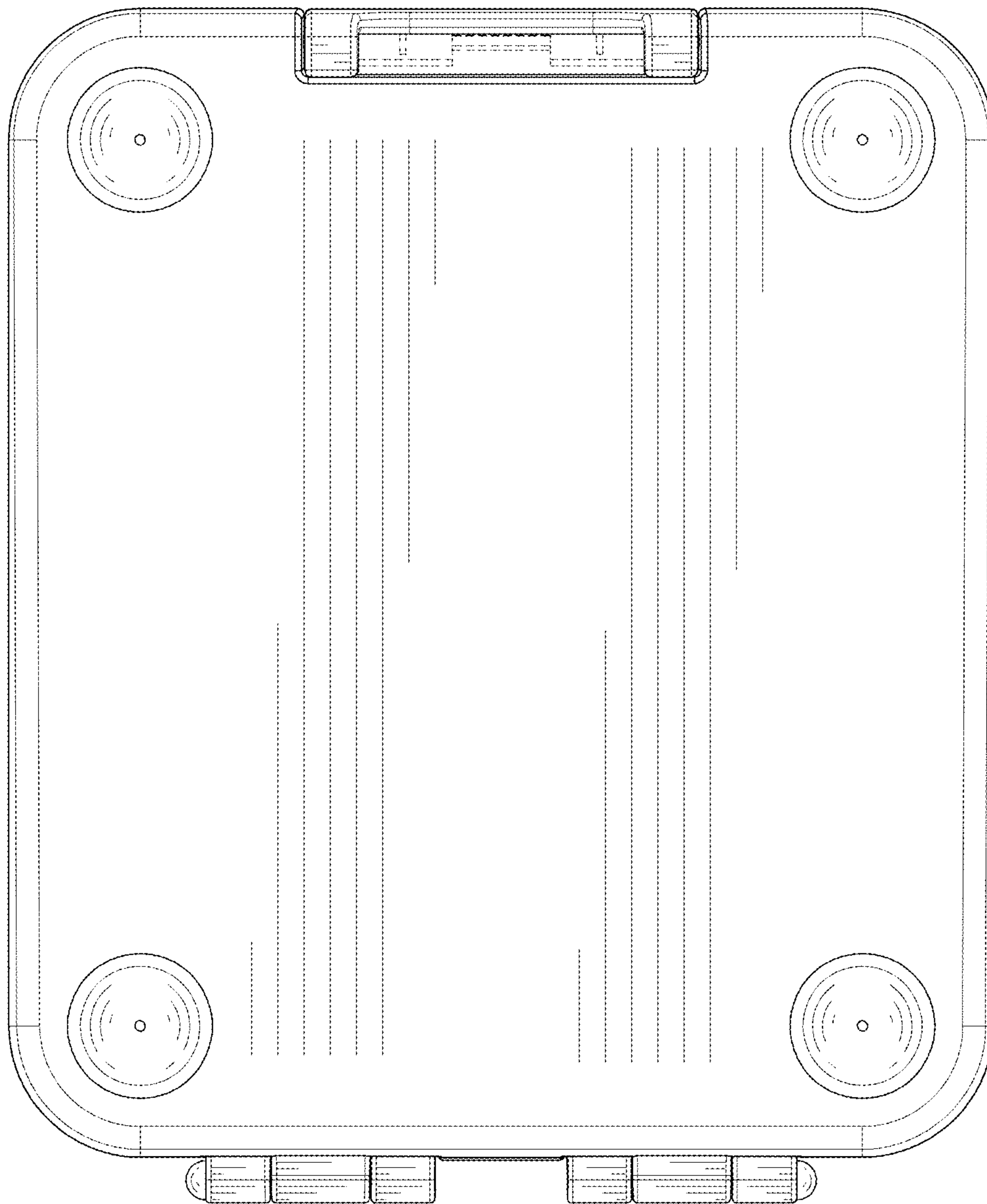

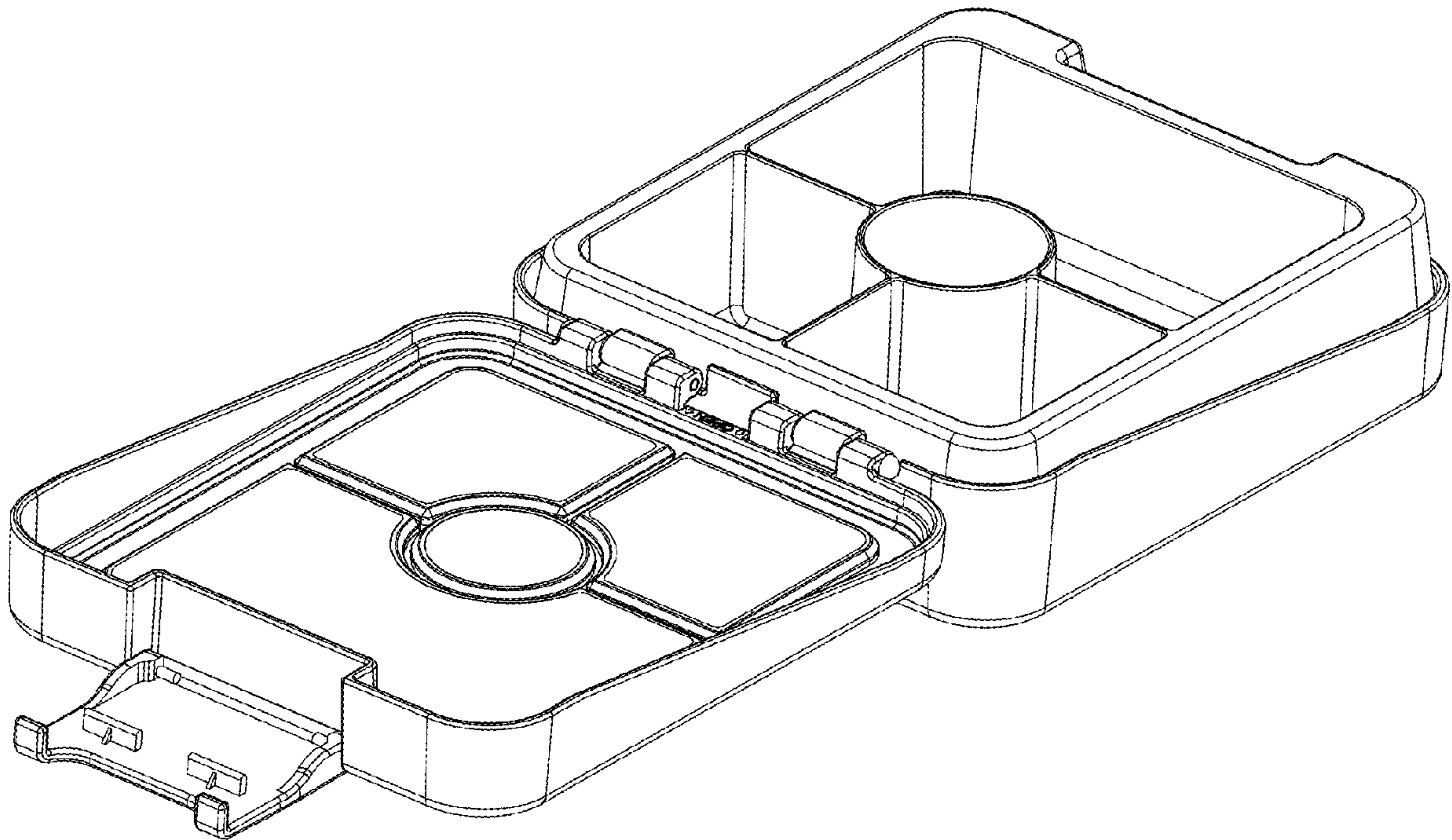
