DESCRIPTION

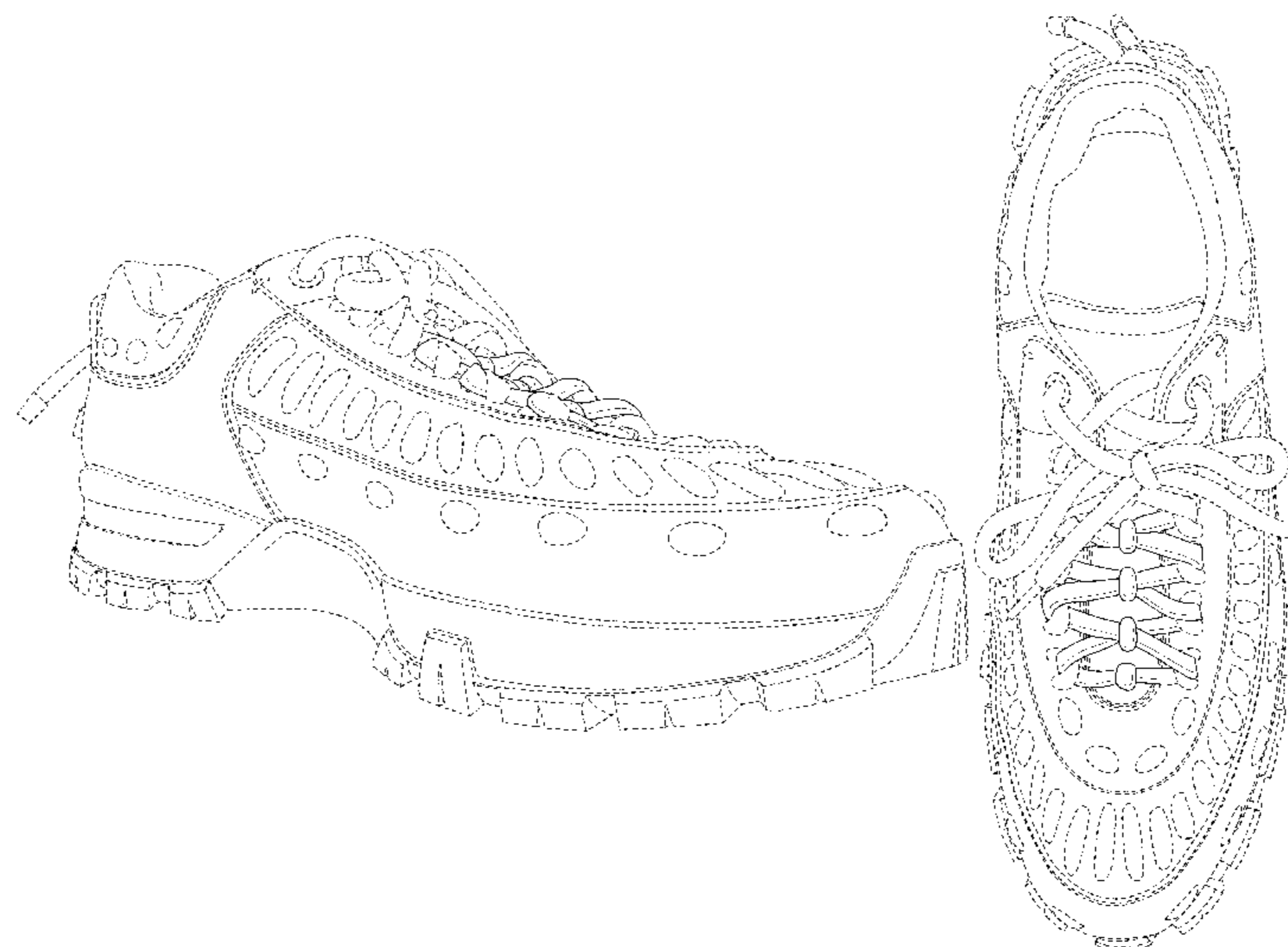
FIG. 1 is a front, left-side perspective view of a shoe in accordance with my new design;

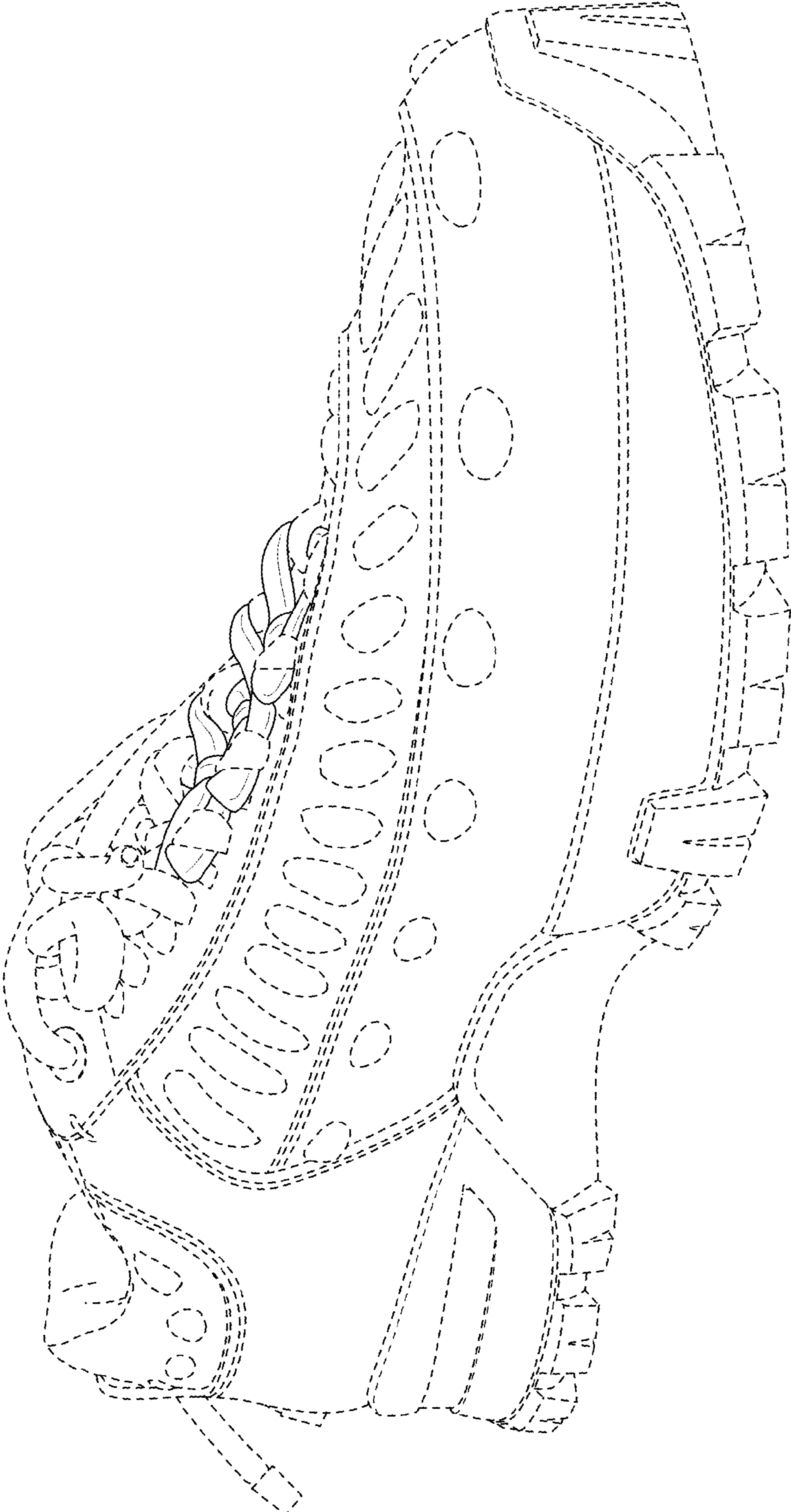

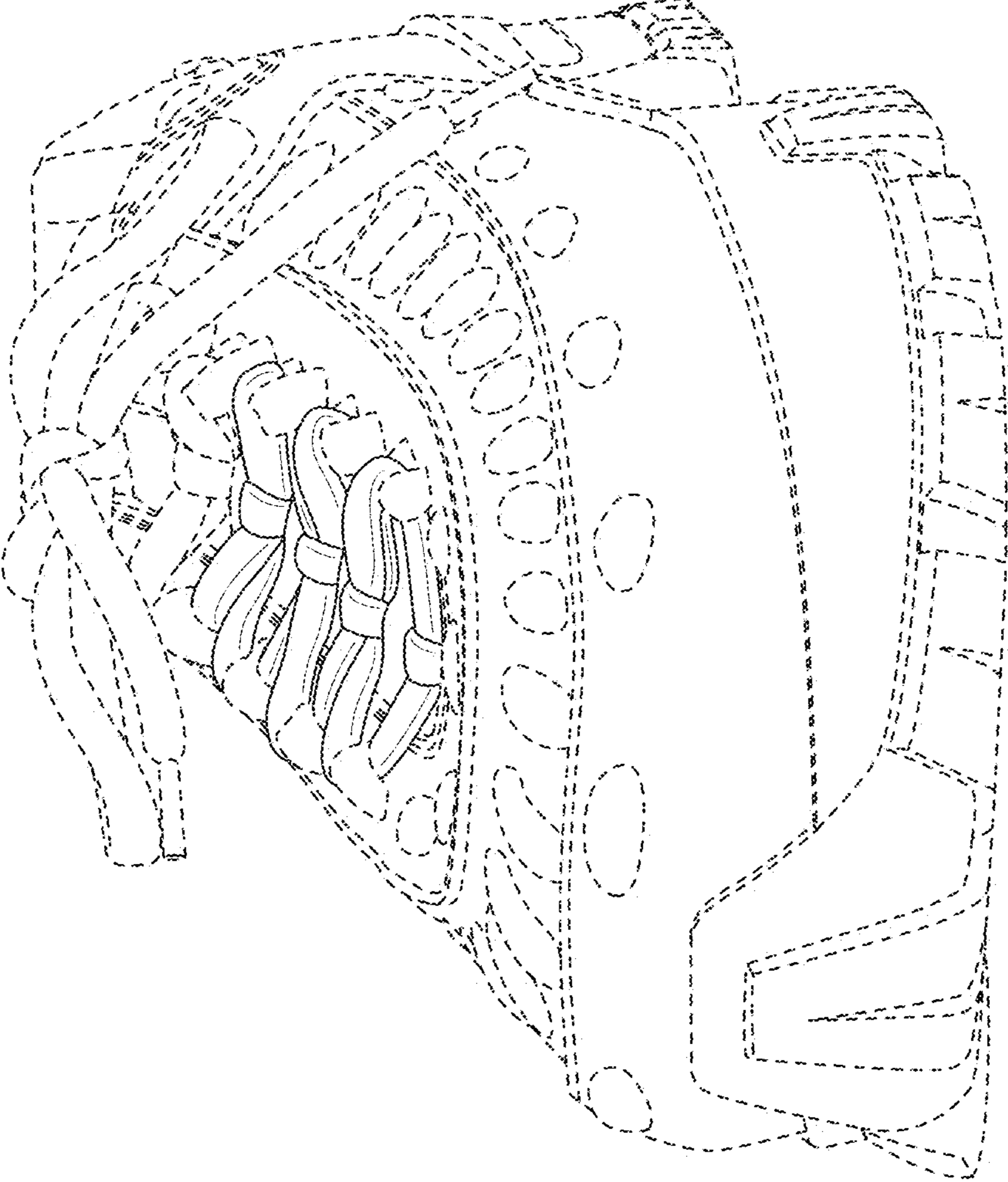

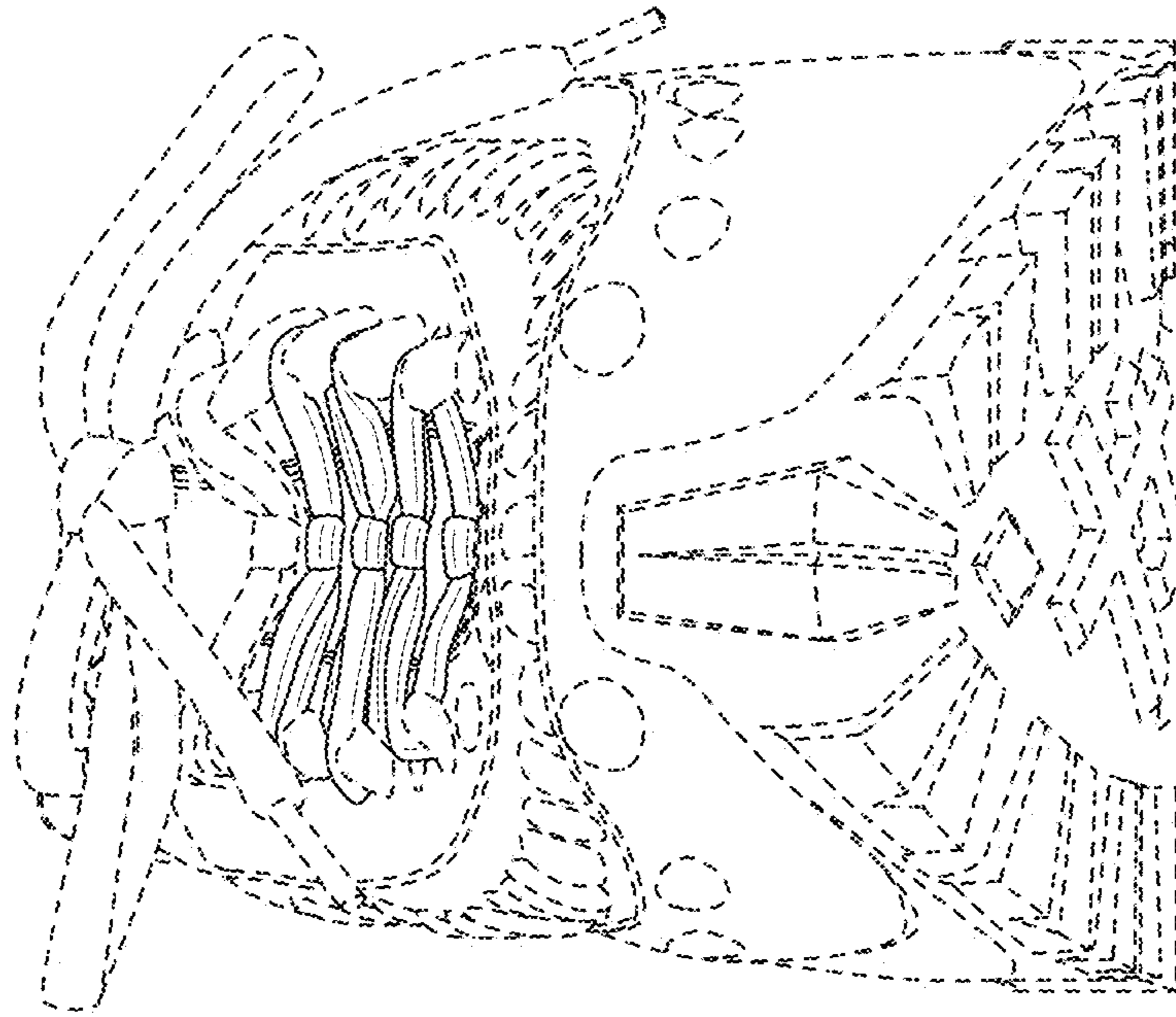

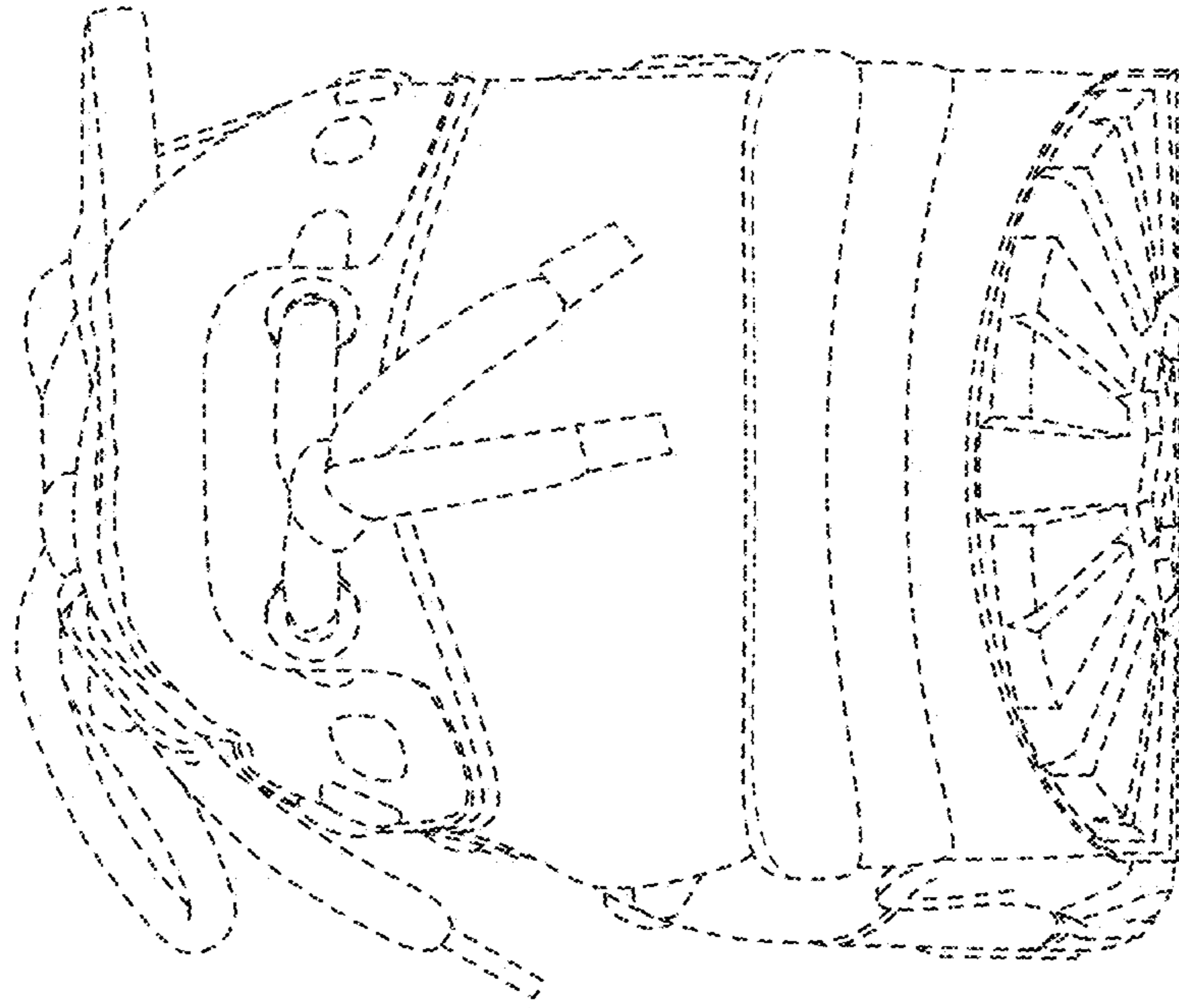

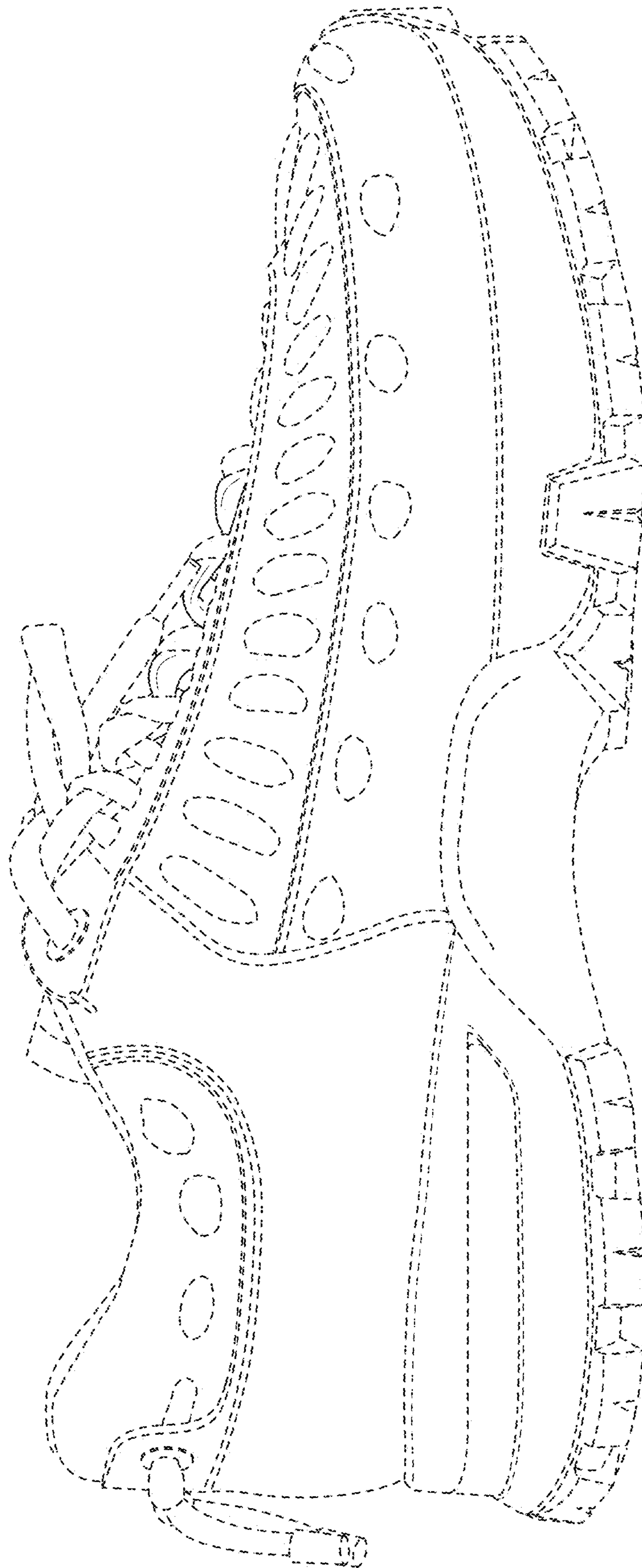

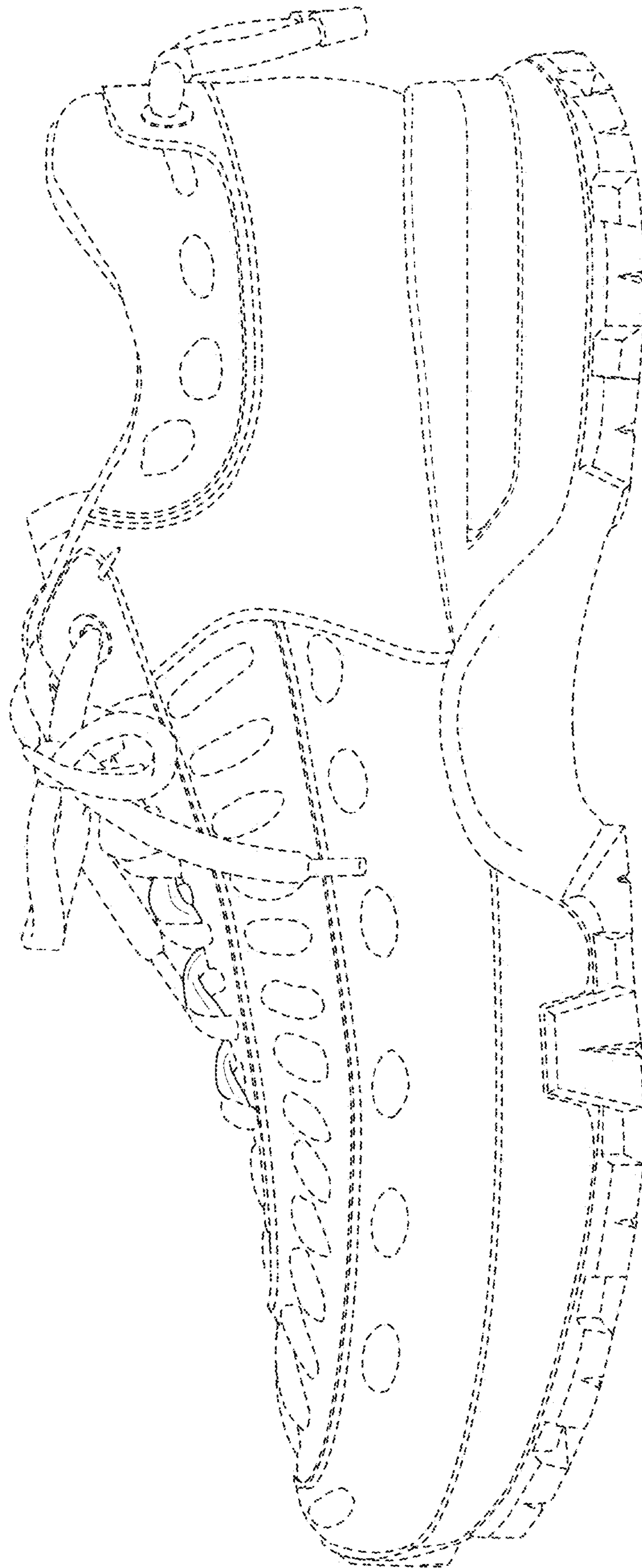

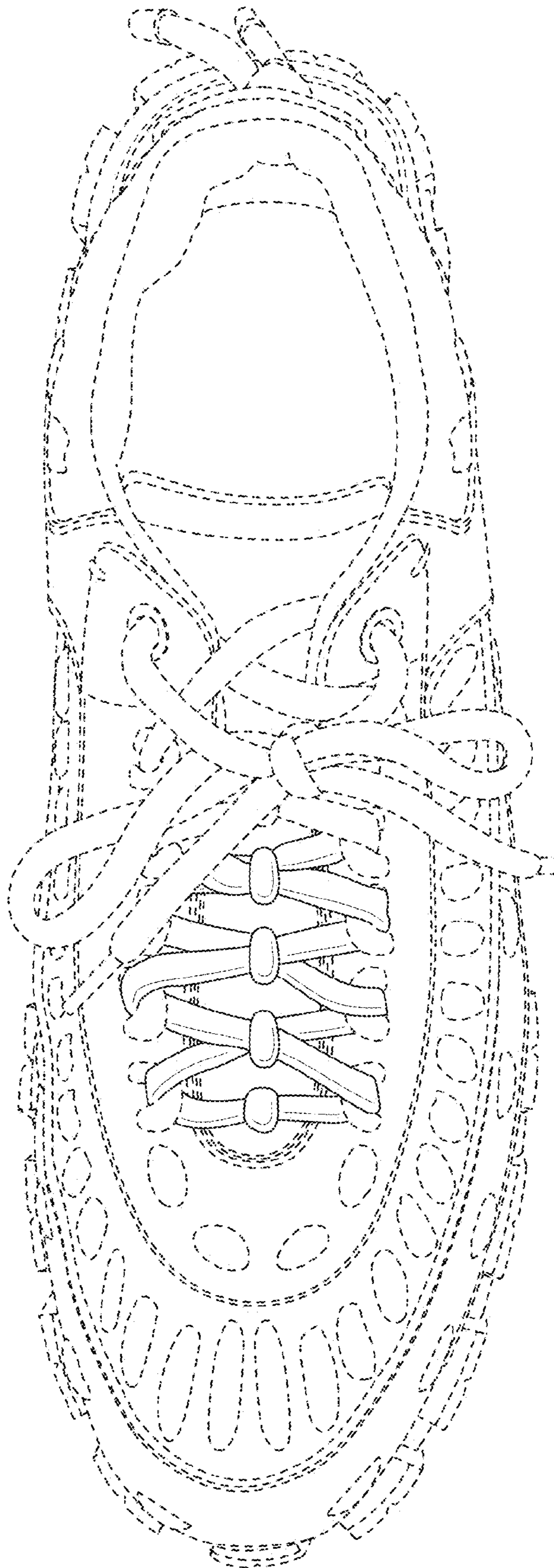

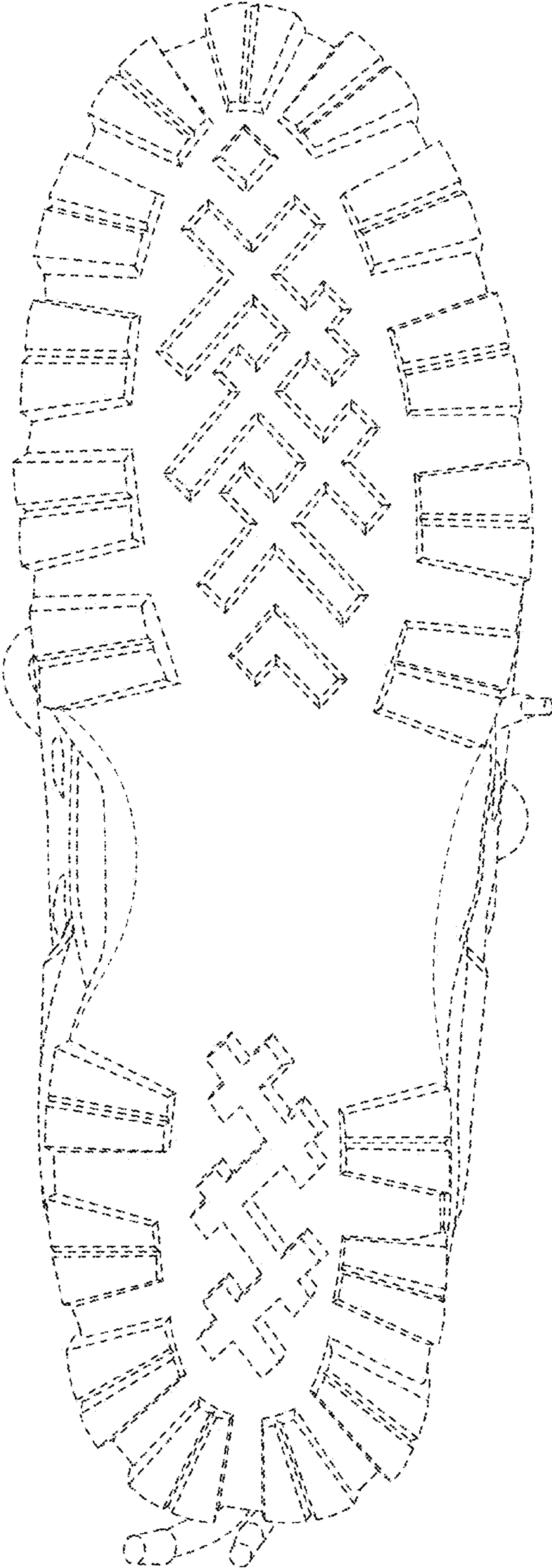
