(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a food jar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a food jar, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is lower perspective view of the first embodiment of the food jar;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the first embodiment of the food jar; FIG. 4 is a right side view of the first embodiment of the food jar;

FIG. 5 is a rear view of the first embodiment of the food jar;

FIG. 6 is a left side view of the first embodiment of the food jar;

FIG. 7 is a top view of the first embodiment of the food jar;

FIG. 8 is a bottom view of the first embodiment of the food jar;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a food jar, showing our new design;

FIG. 10 is lower perspective view of the second embodiment of the food jar;

FIG. 11 is a front view of the second embodiment of the food jar;

FIG. 12 is a right side view of the second embodiment of the food jar;

FIG. 13 is a rear view of the second embodiment of the food jar;

FIG. 14 is a left side view of the second embodiment of the food jar;


FIG. 15 is a top view of the second embodiment of the food jar; and,

FIG. 16 is a bottom view of the second embodiment of the food jar.

The broken lines showing in the figures are included for the purpose of illustrating portions of the food jar that form no part of the claimed design. The dash-dot lines showing in the figures are included for defining the bounds of the claimed design that form no part therof.

The food jar is shown with a symbolic break in its length. The appearance of any portion of the article between the breakaway lines forms no part of the claimed design.

























