DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a athletic ring, showing my new design in a slightly bent configuration;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof, illustrated in a straight configuration;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 2, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

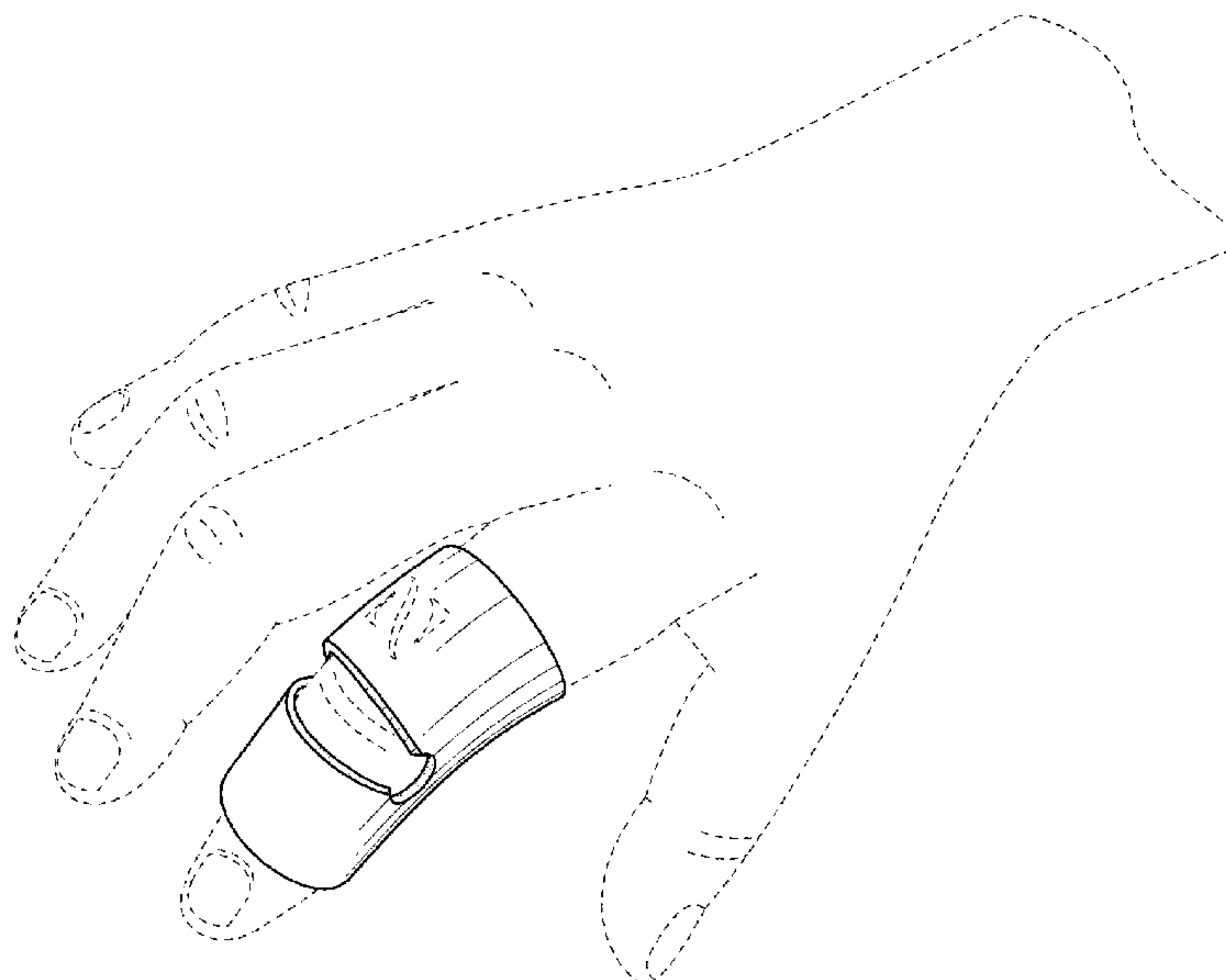
FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 2, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

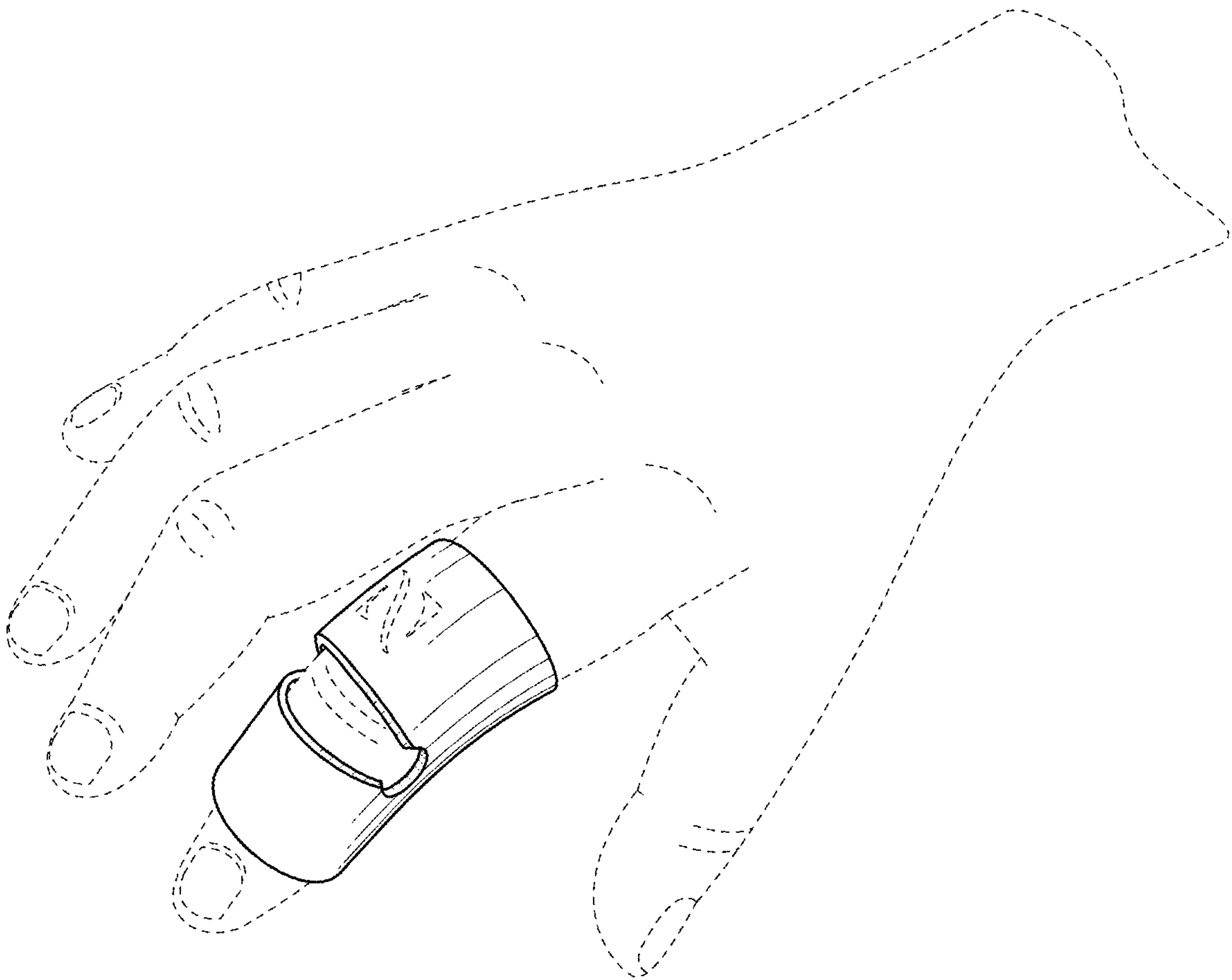

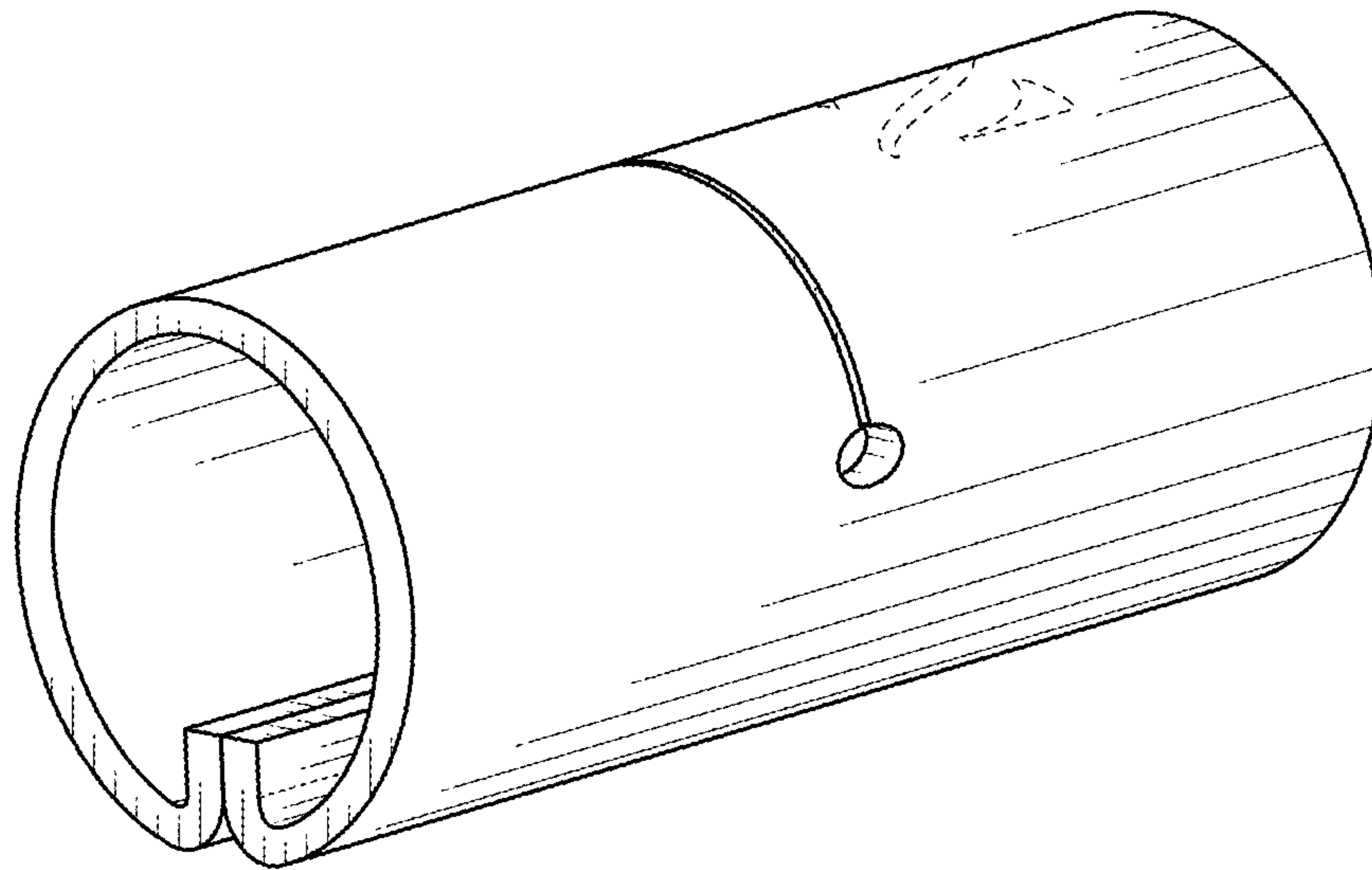

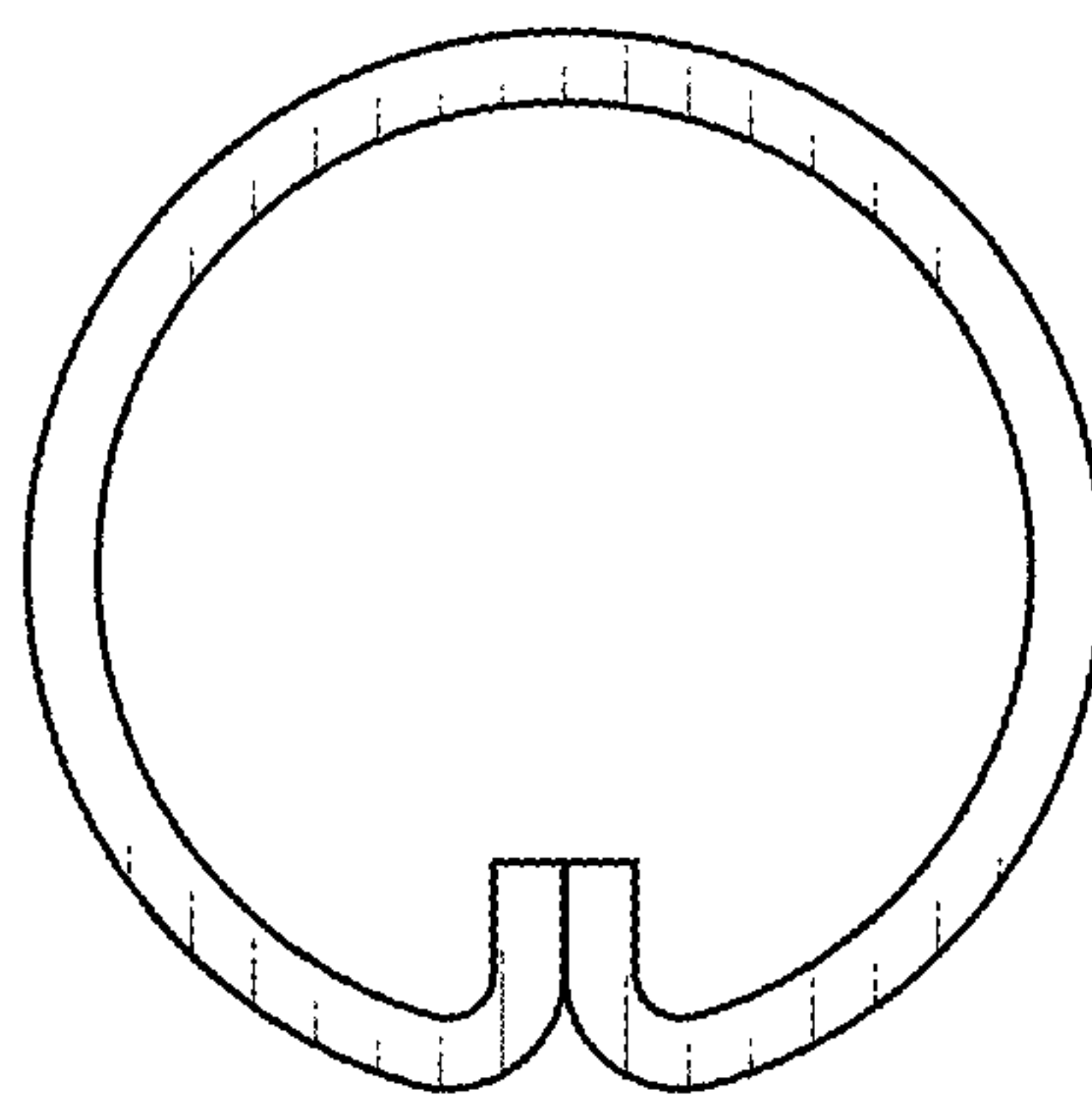

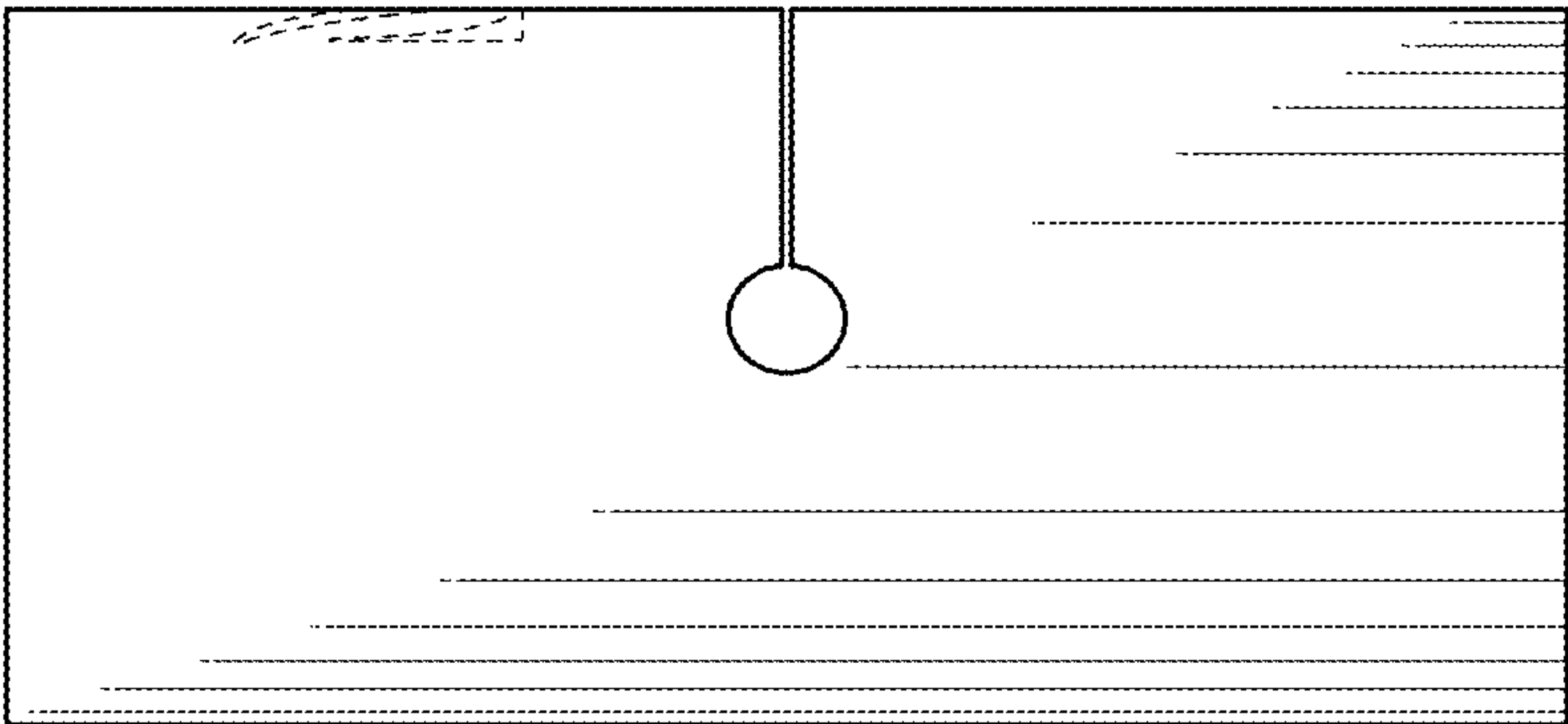

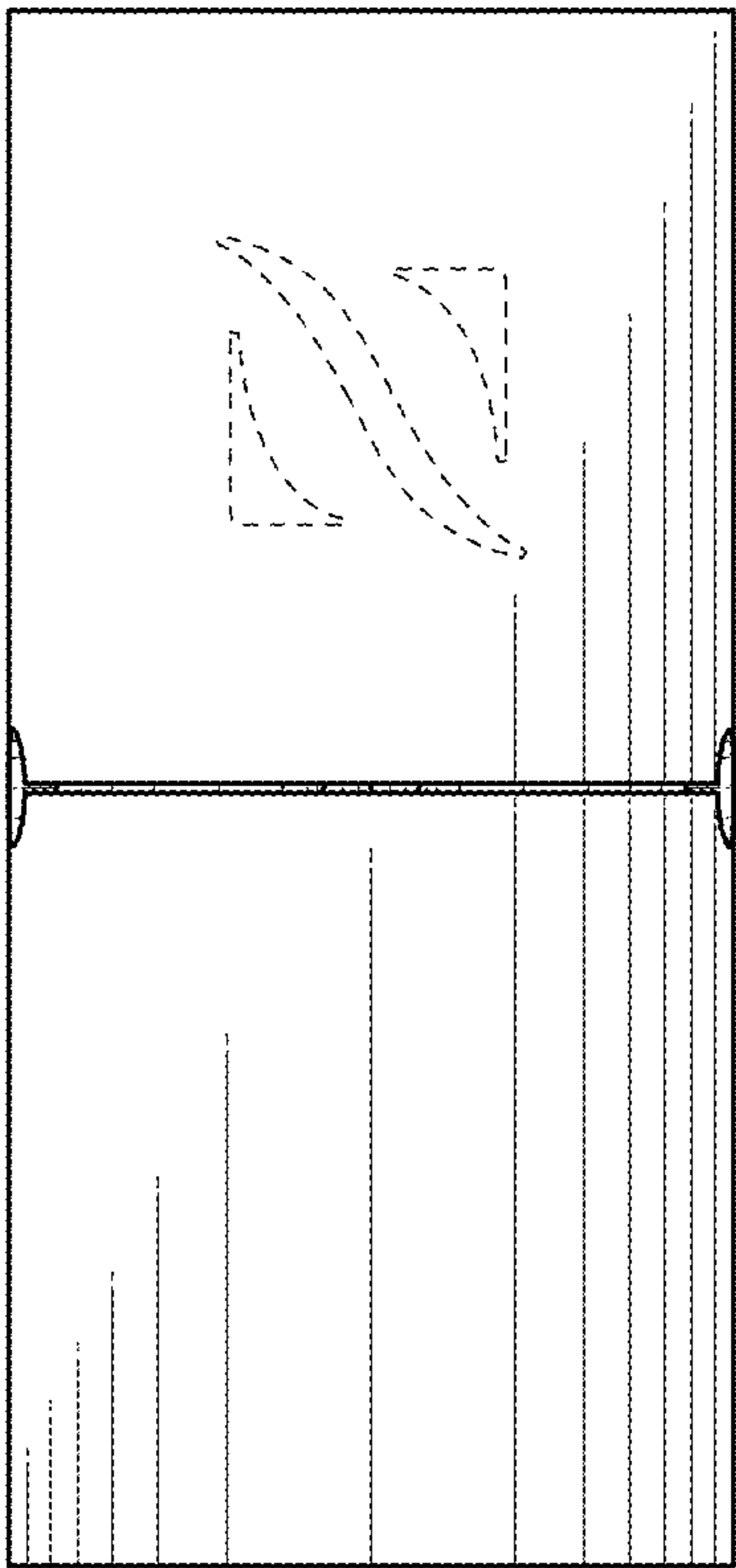

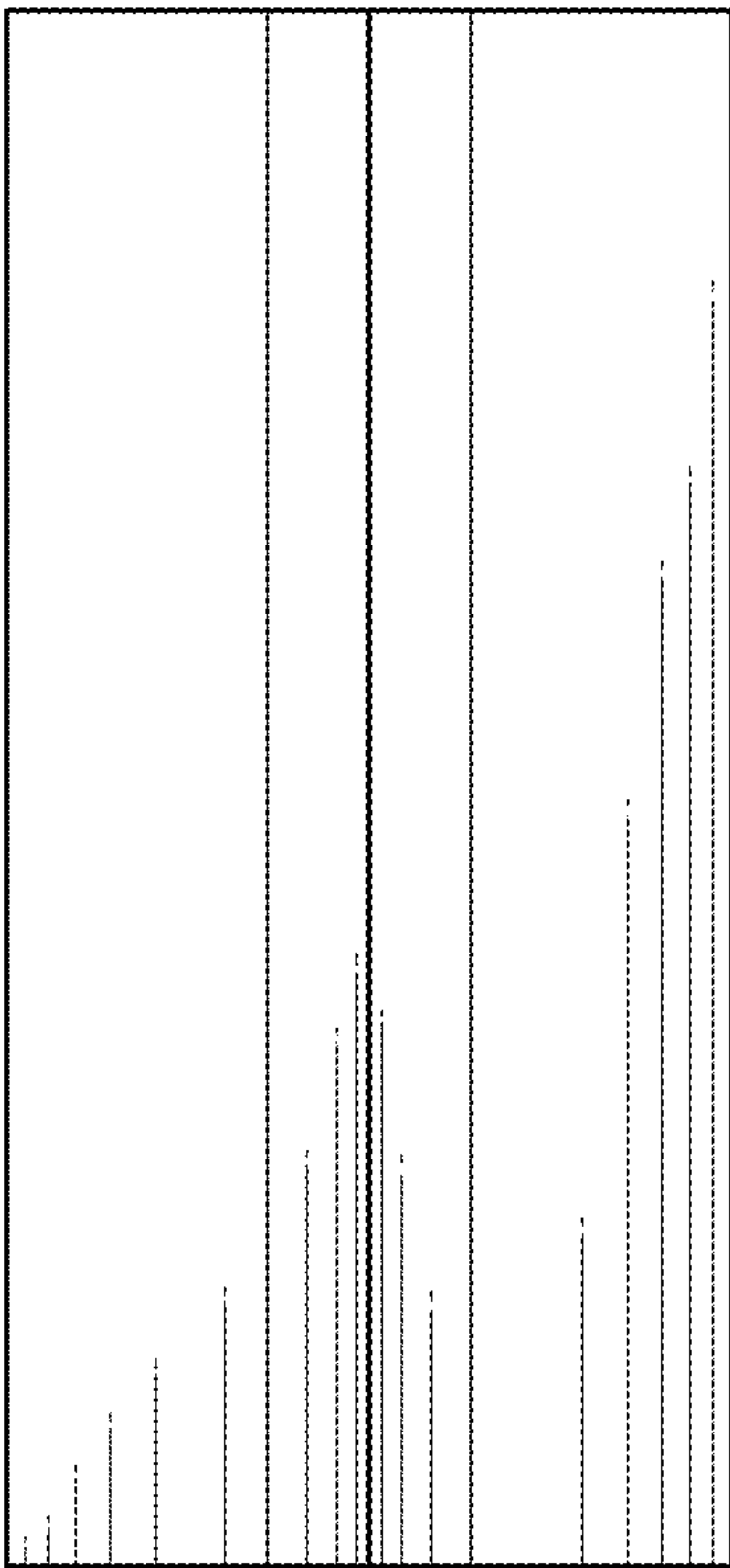
