FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an inhaler jar for use with aromatic herbs, spices, and essential oils, showing our new design;

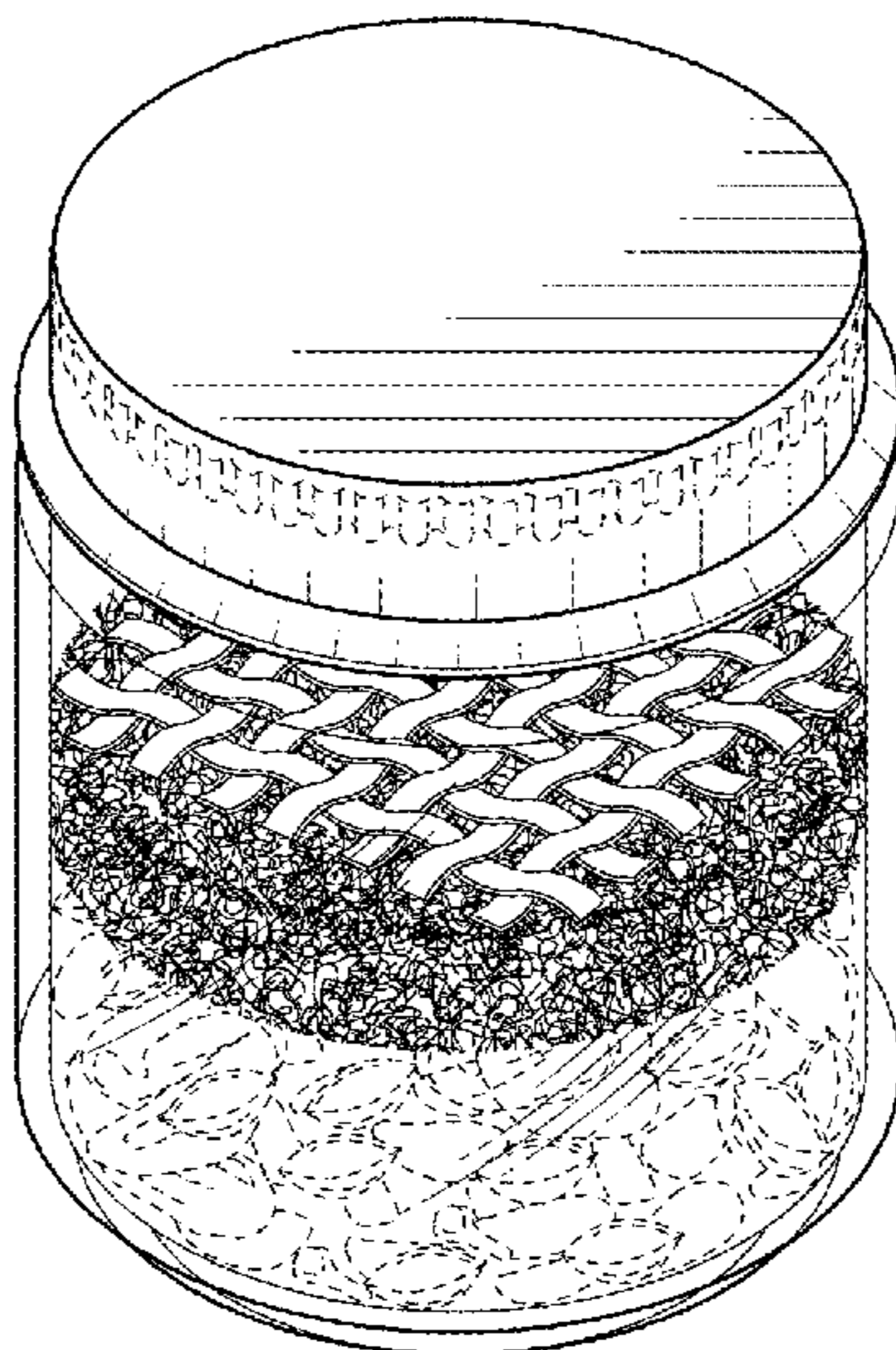

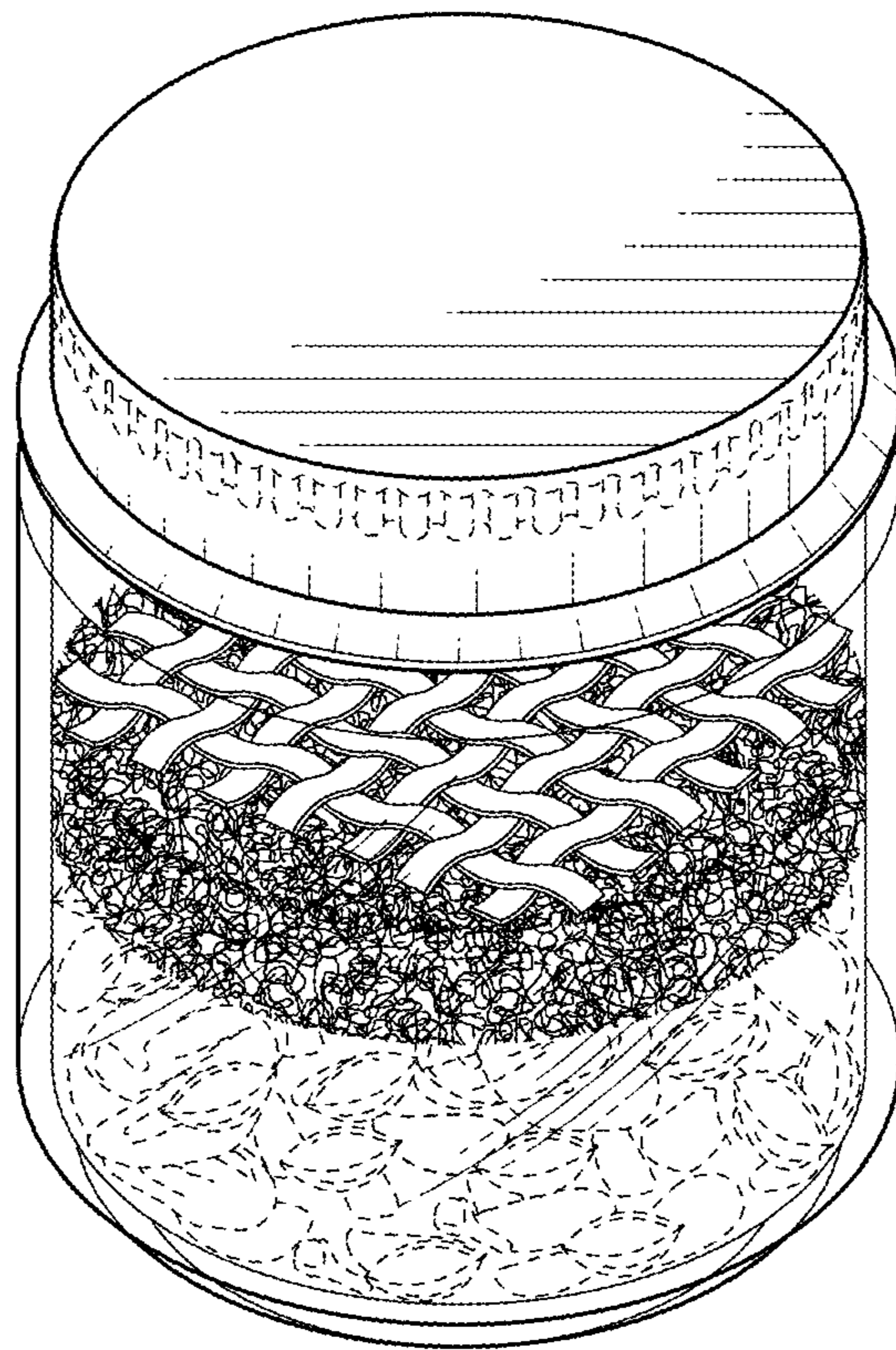

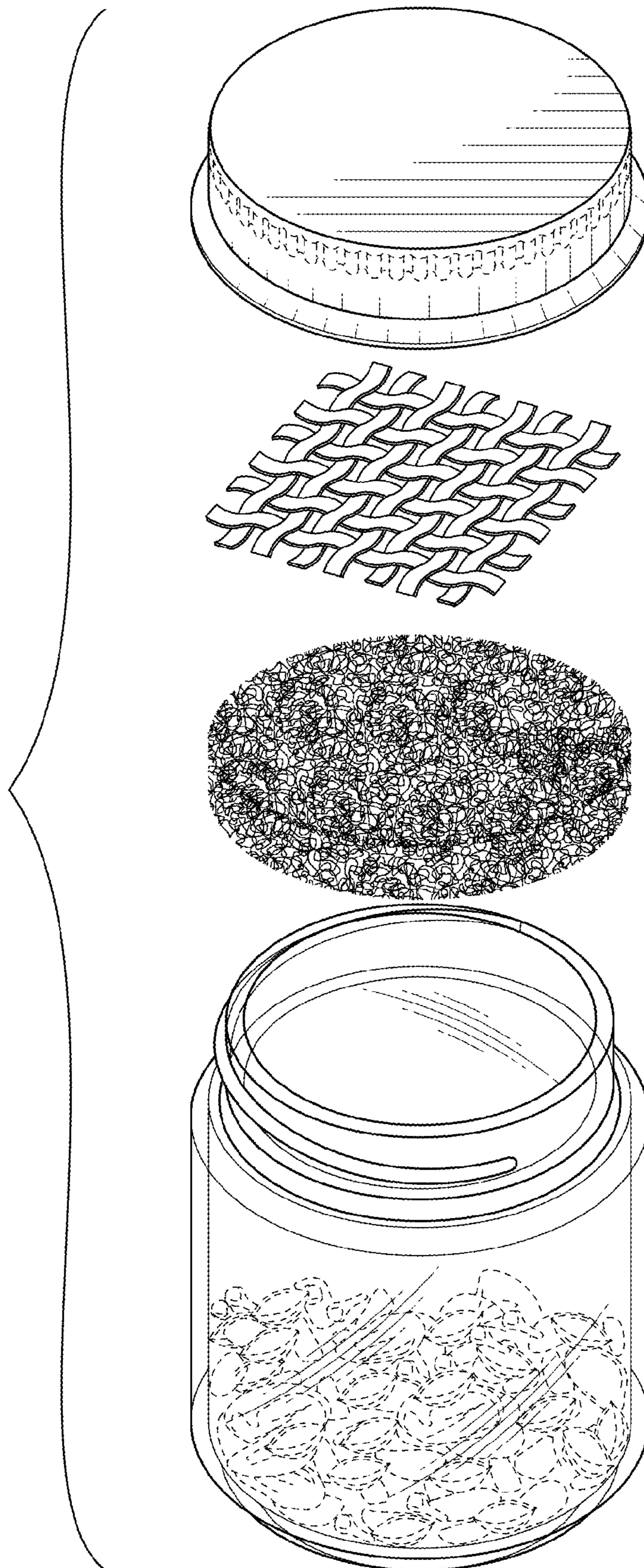

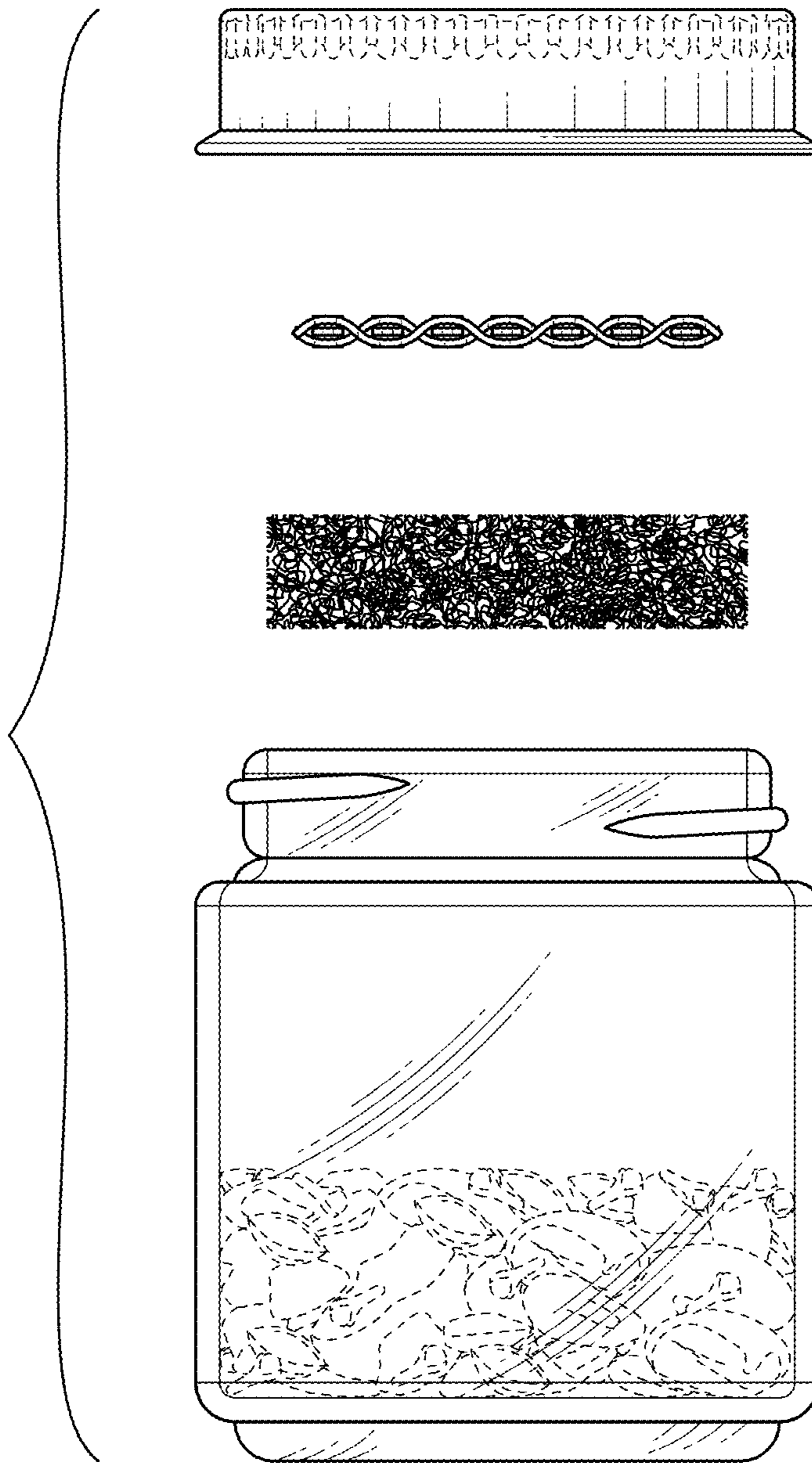

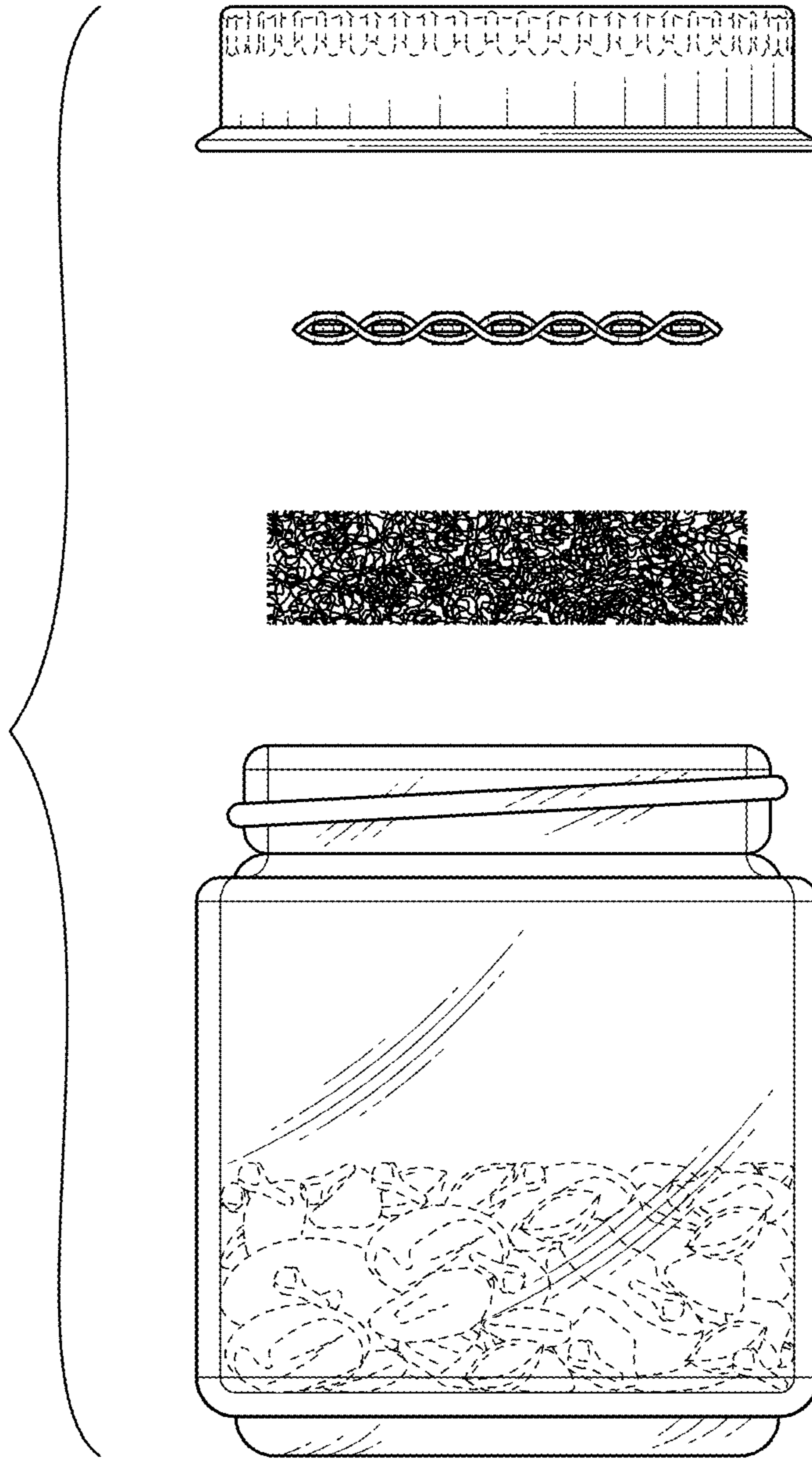

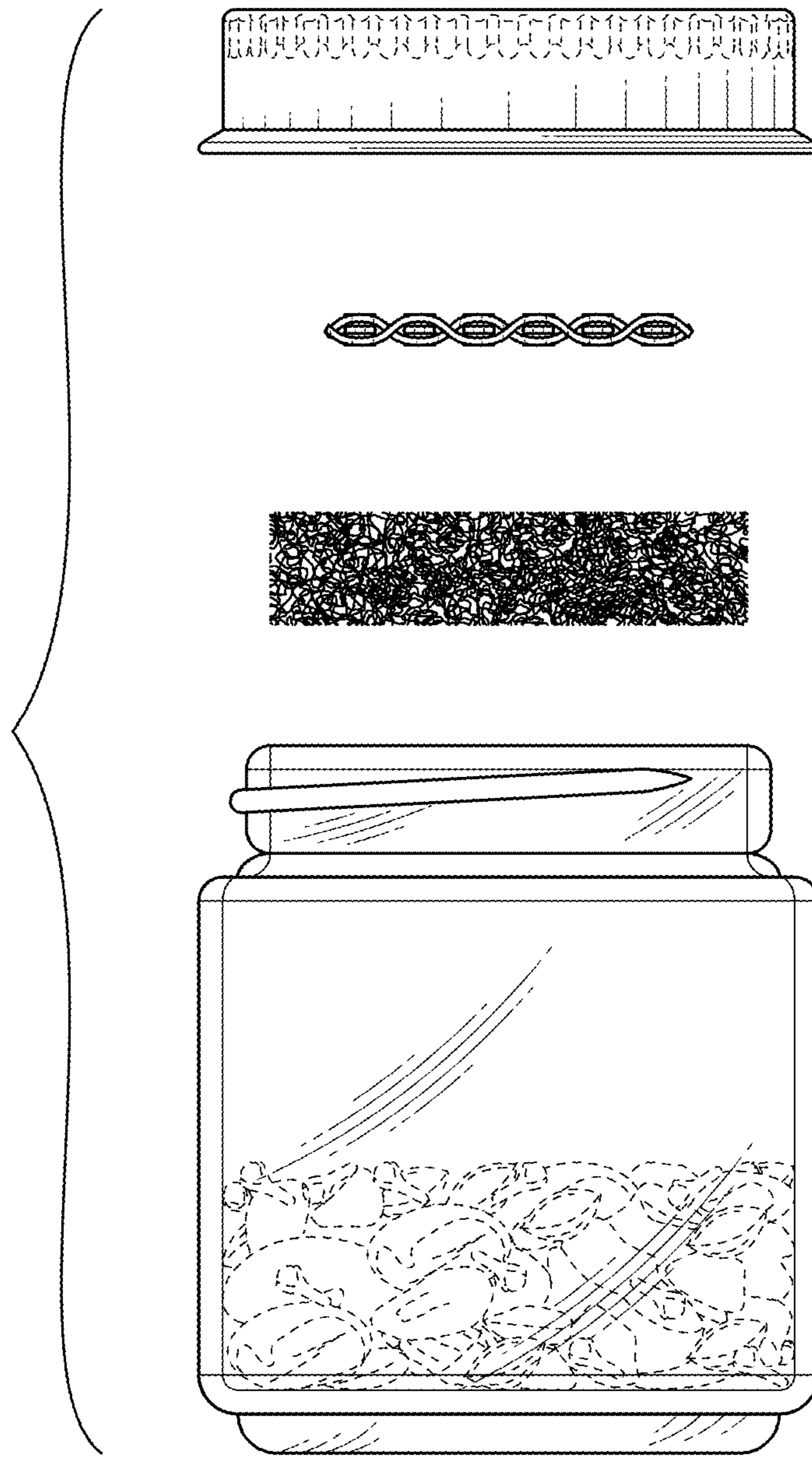

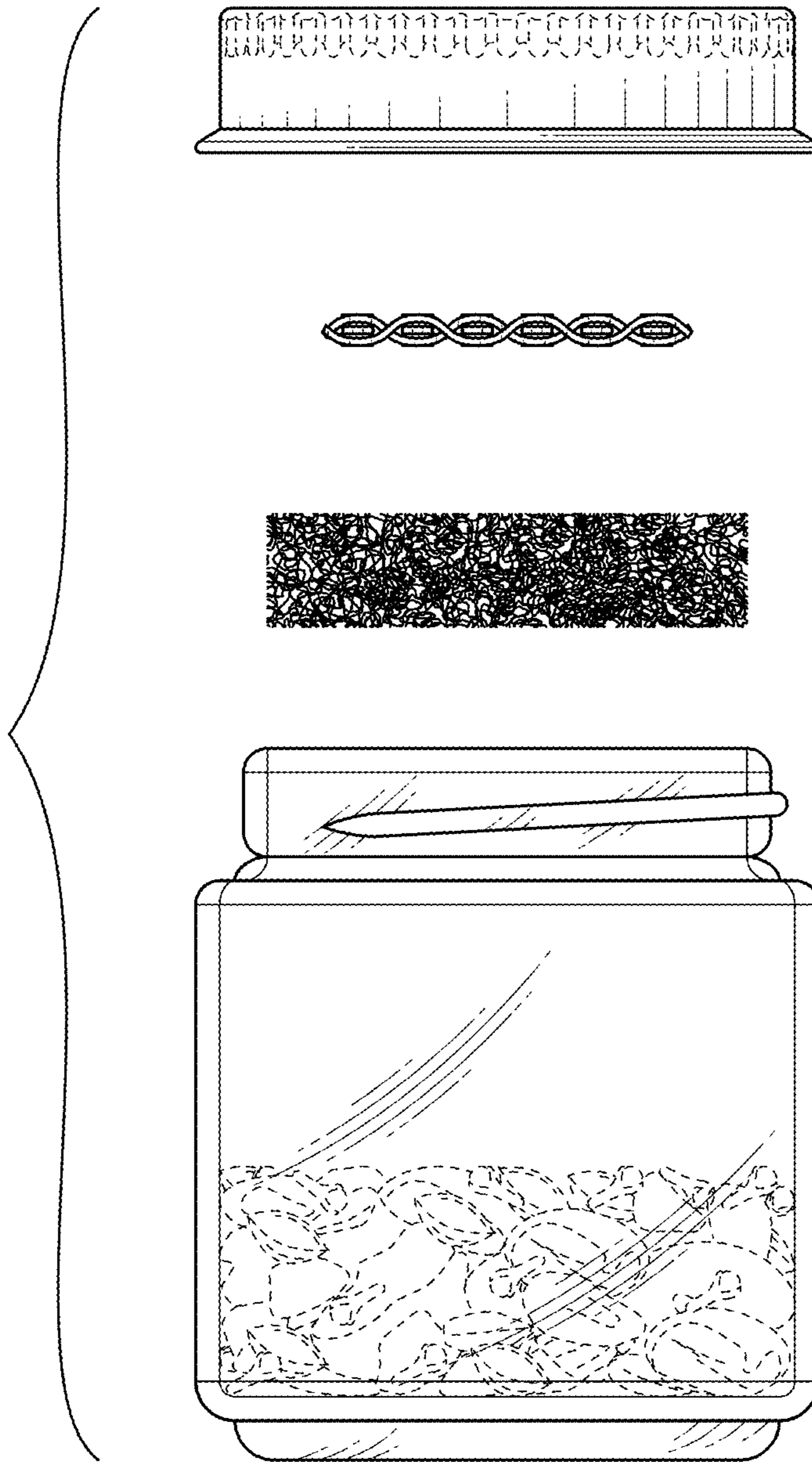

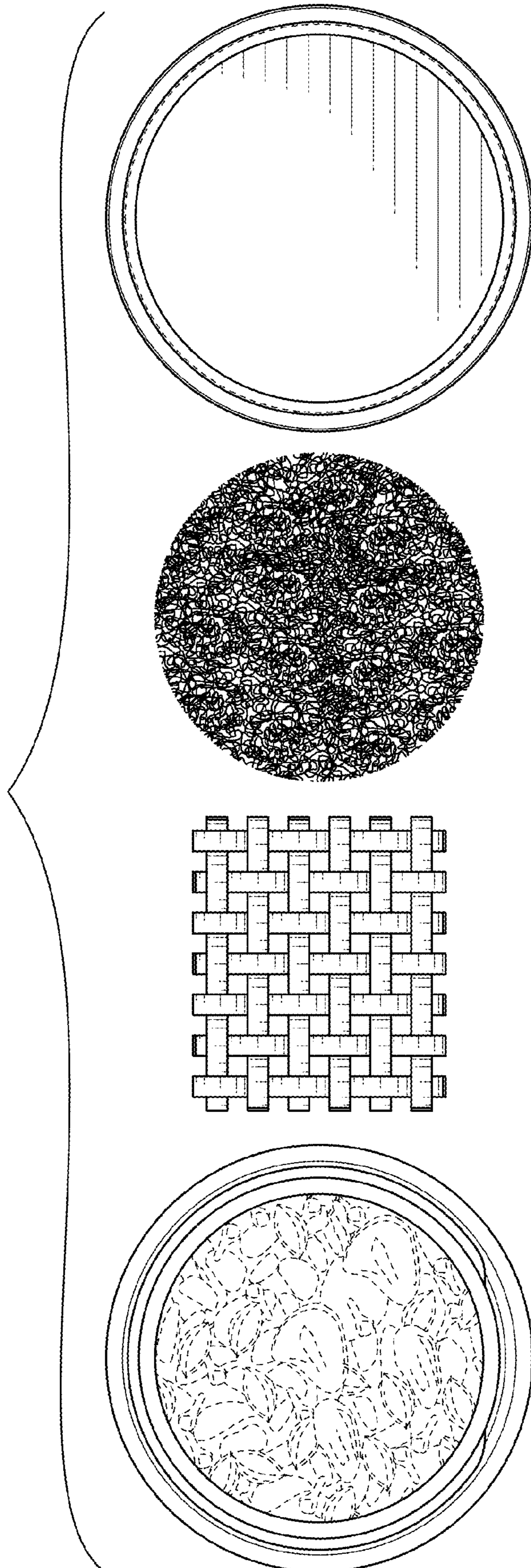

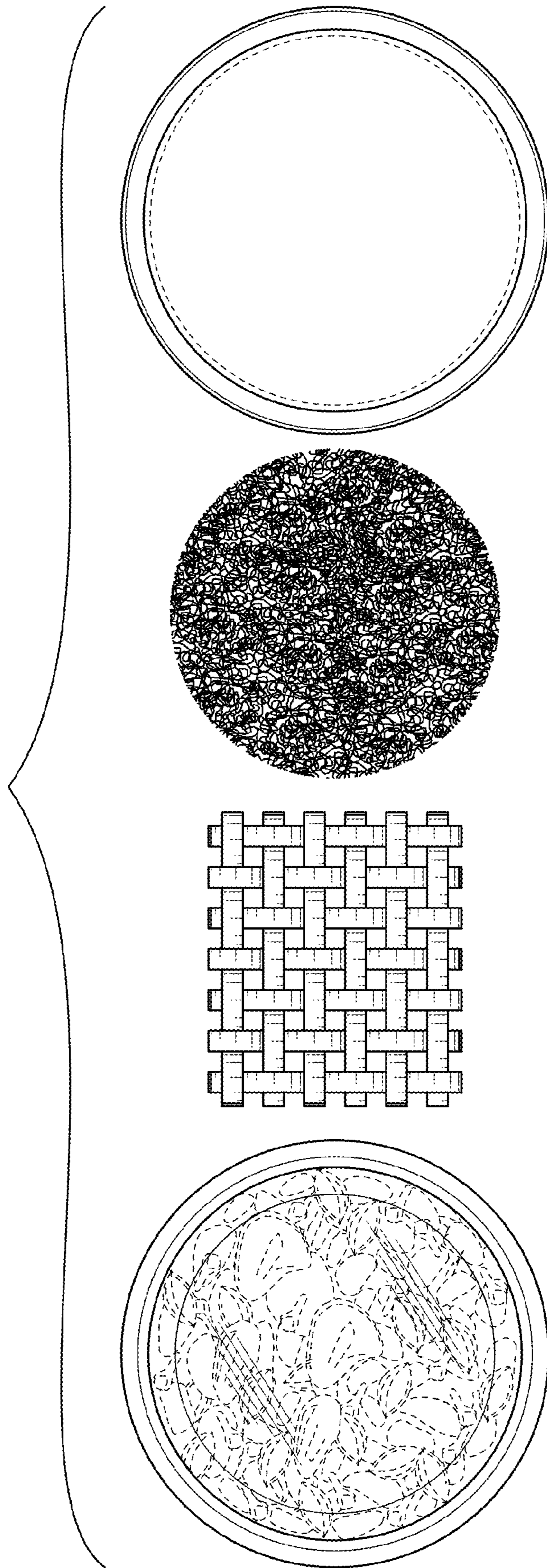
