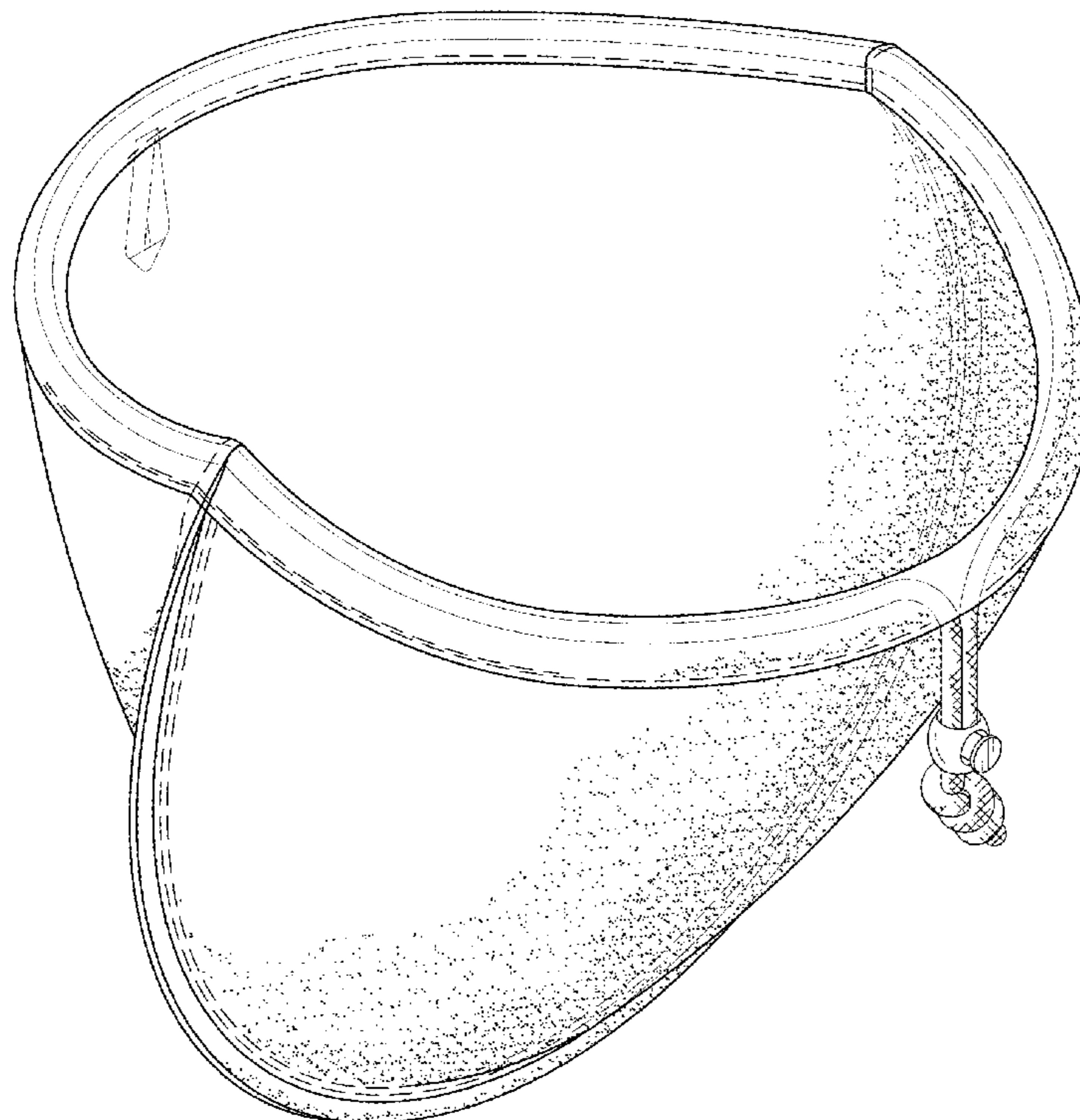
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a strainer pouch, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a strainer pouch showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevation thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevation thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a left side elevation thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a top side elevation thereof;

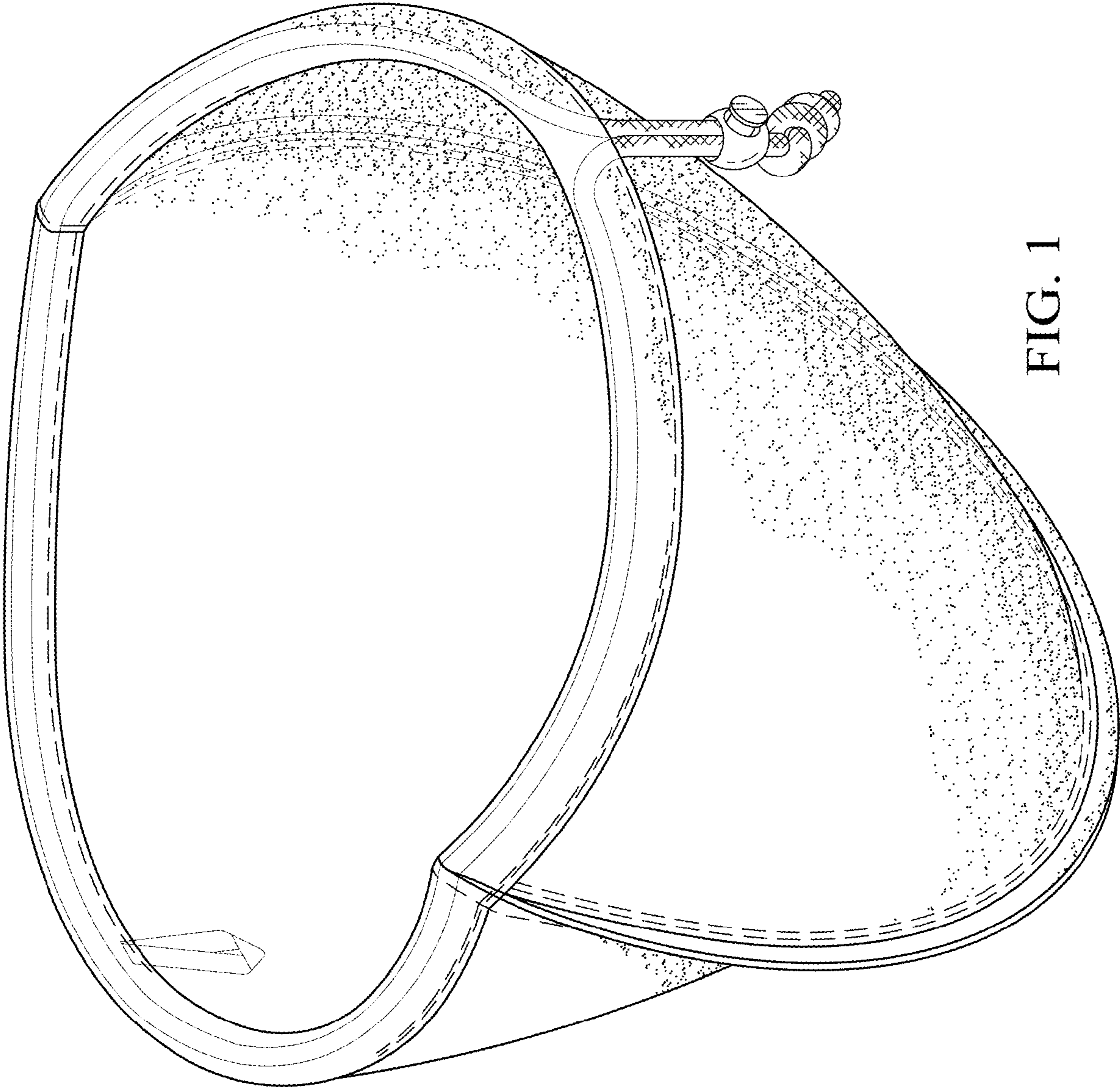

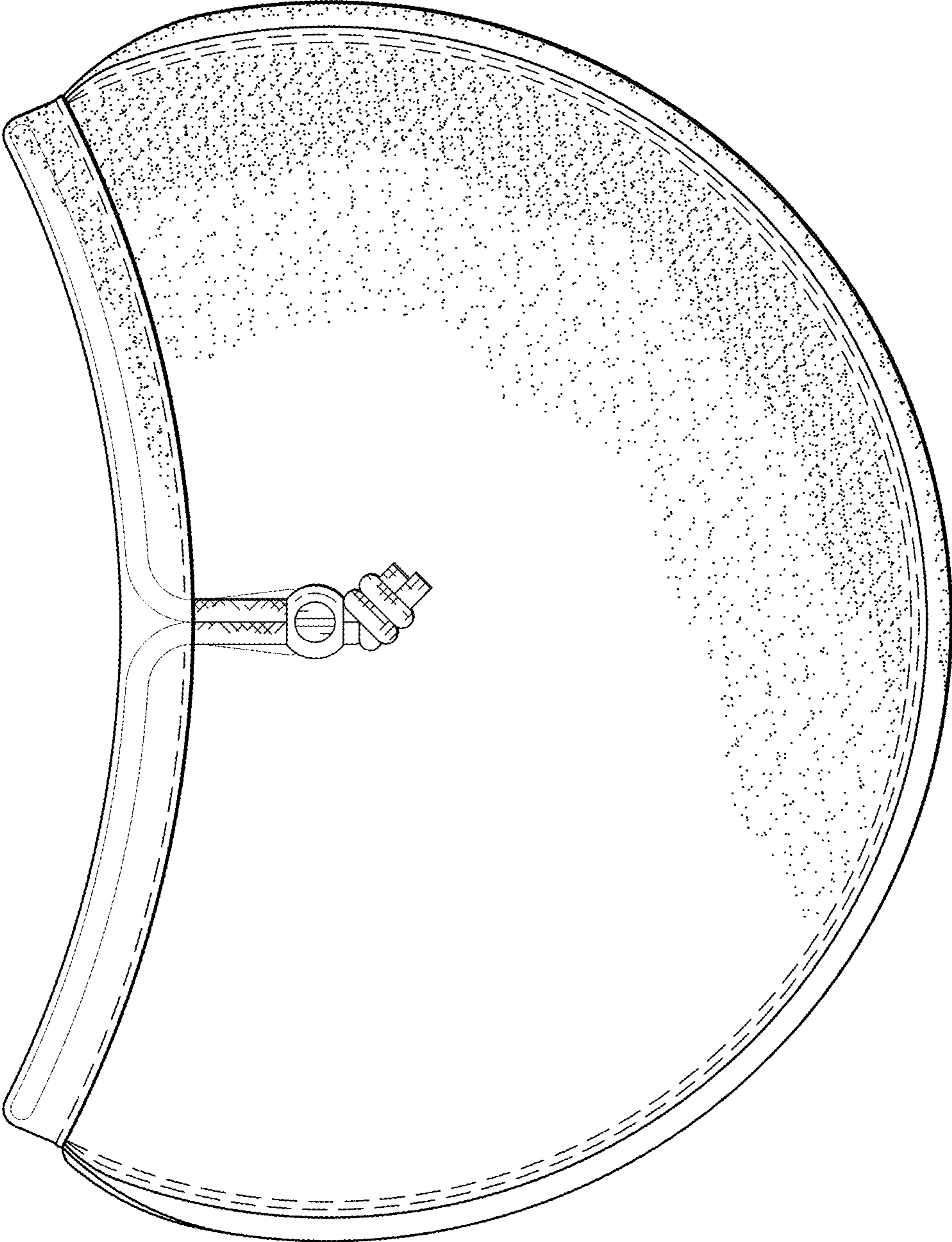

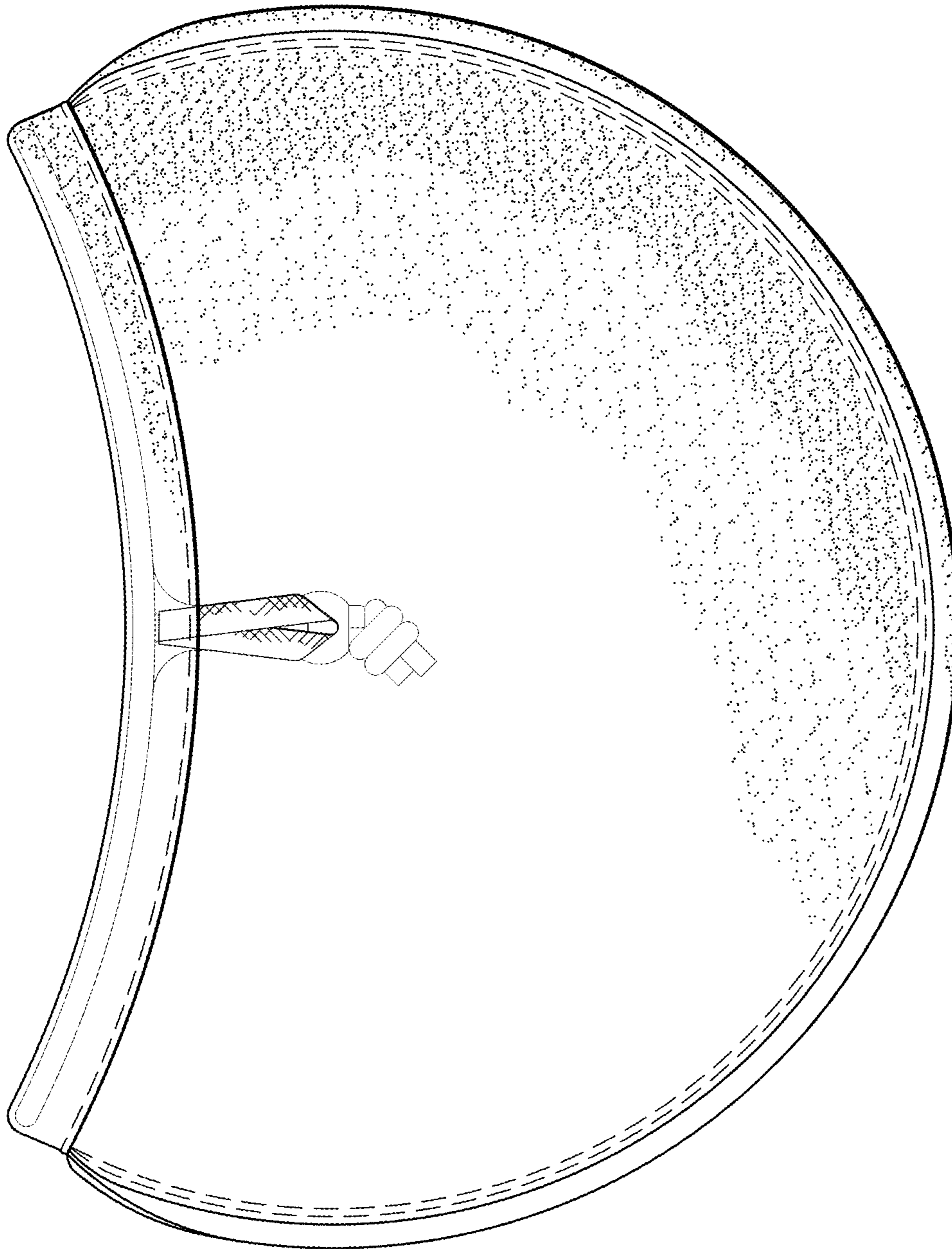

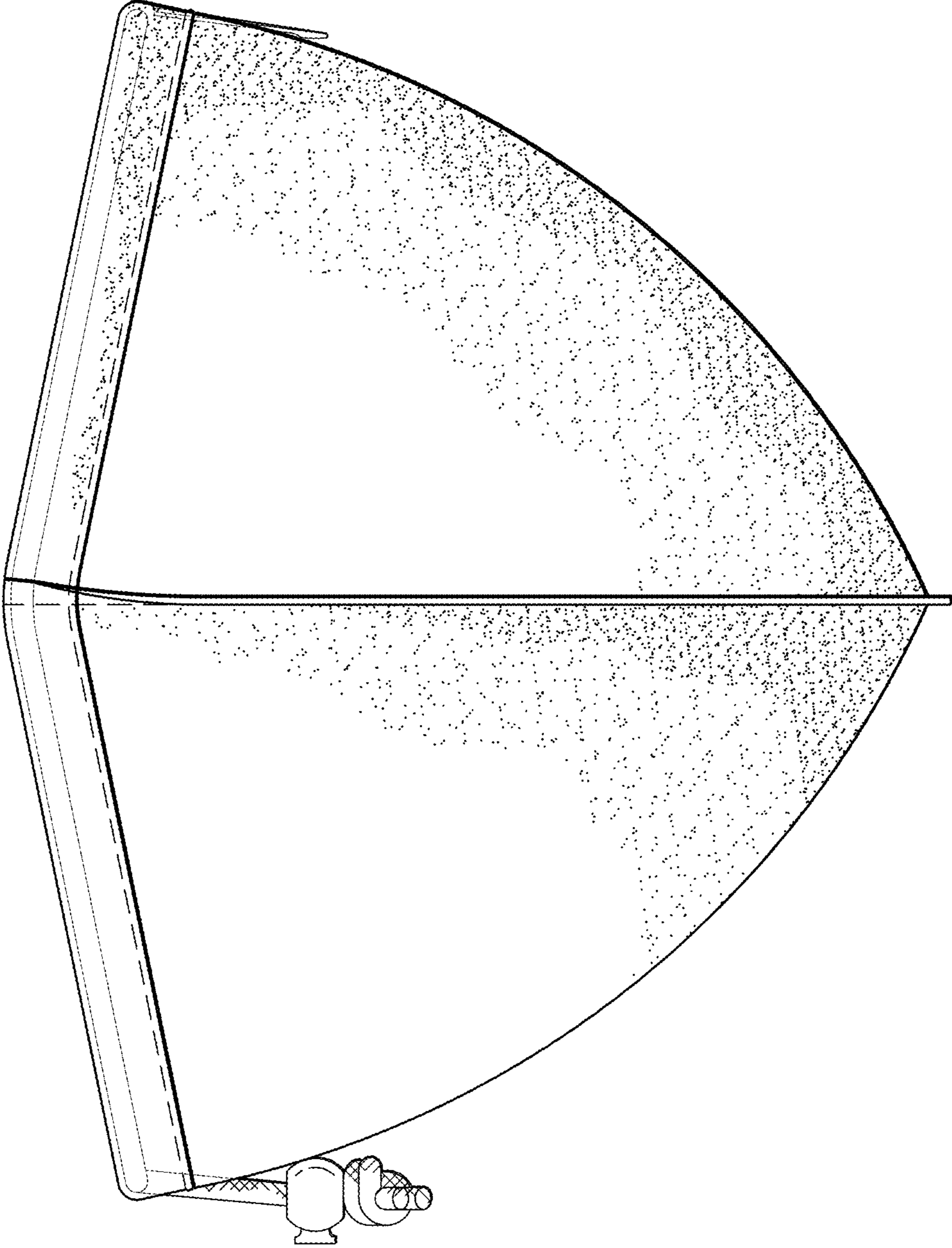

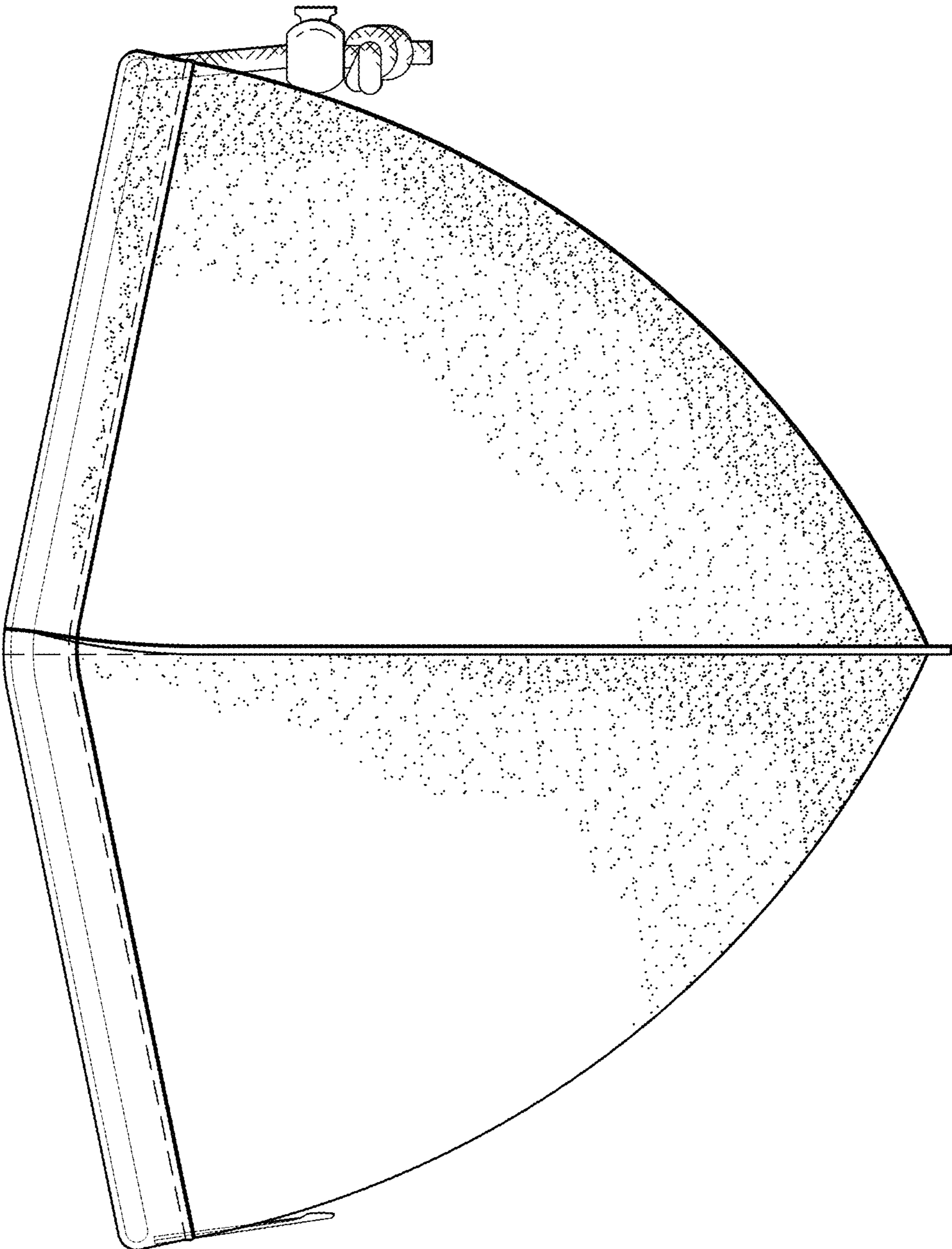

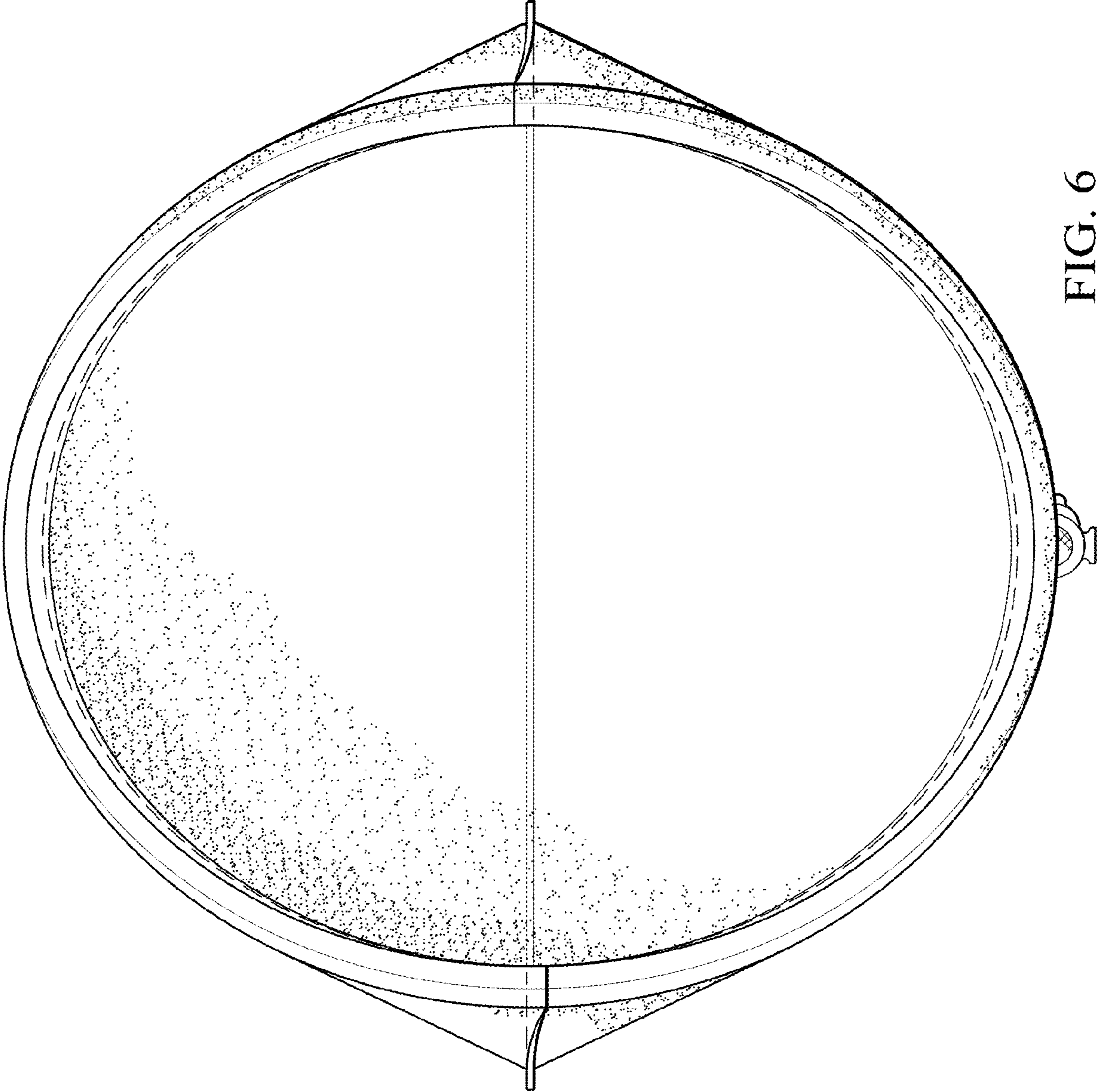

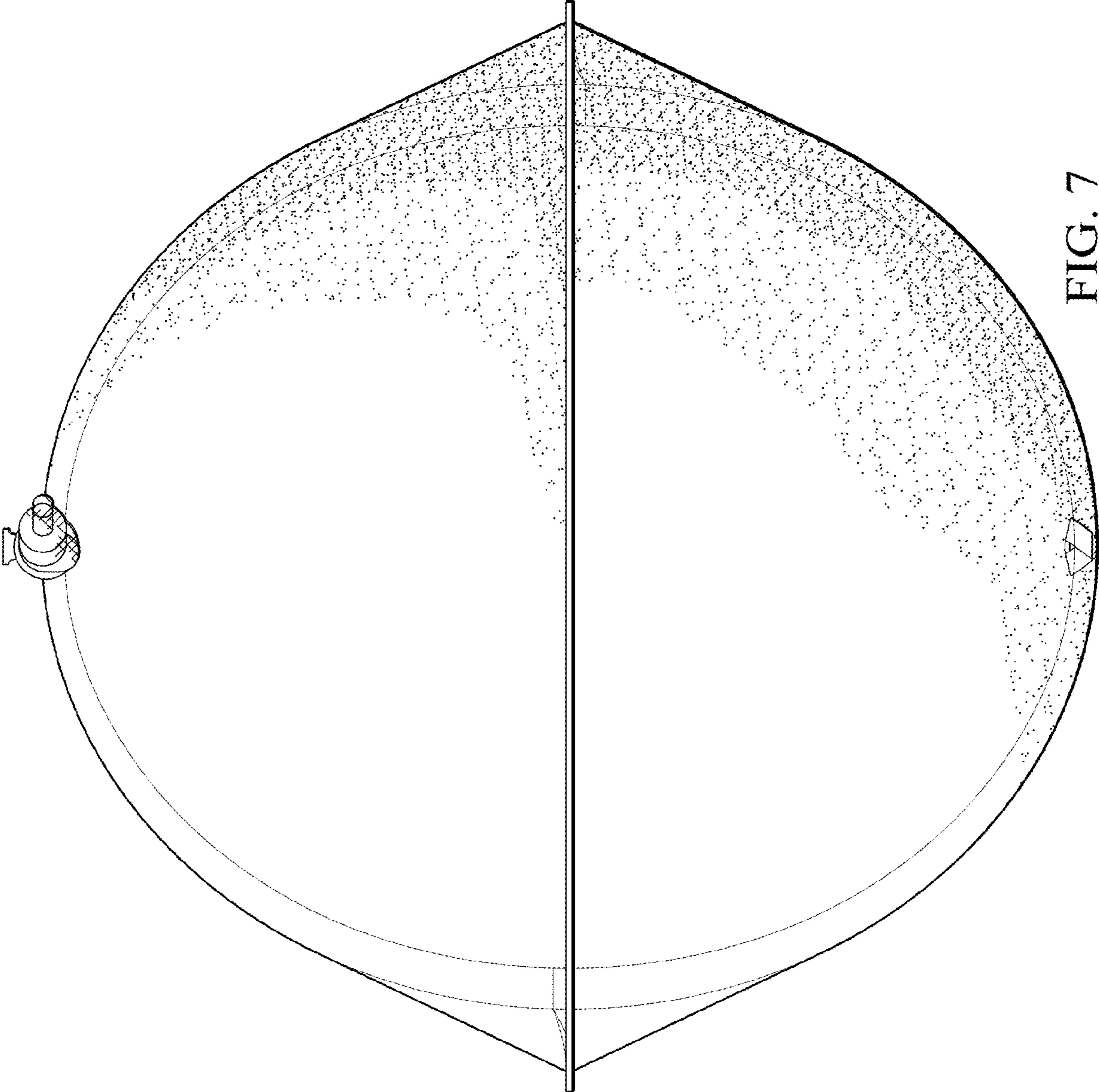

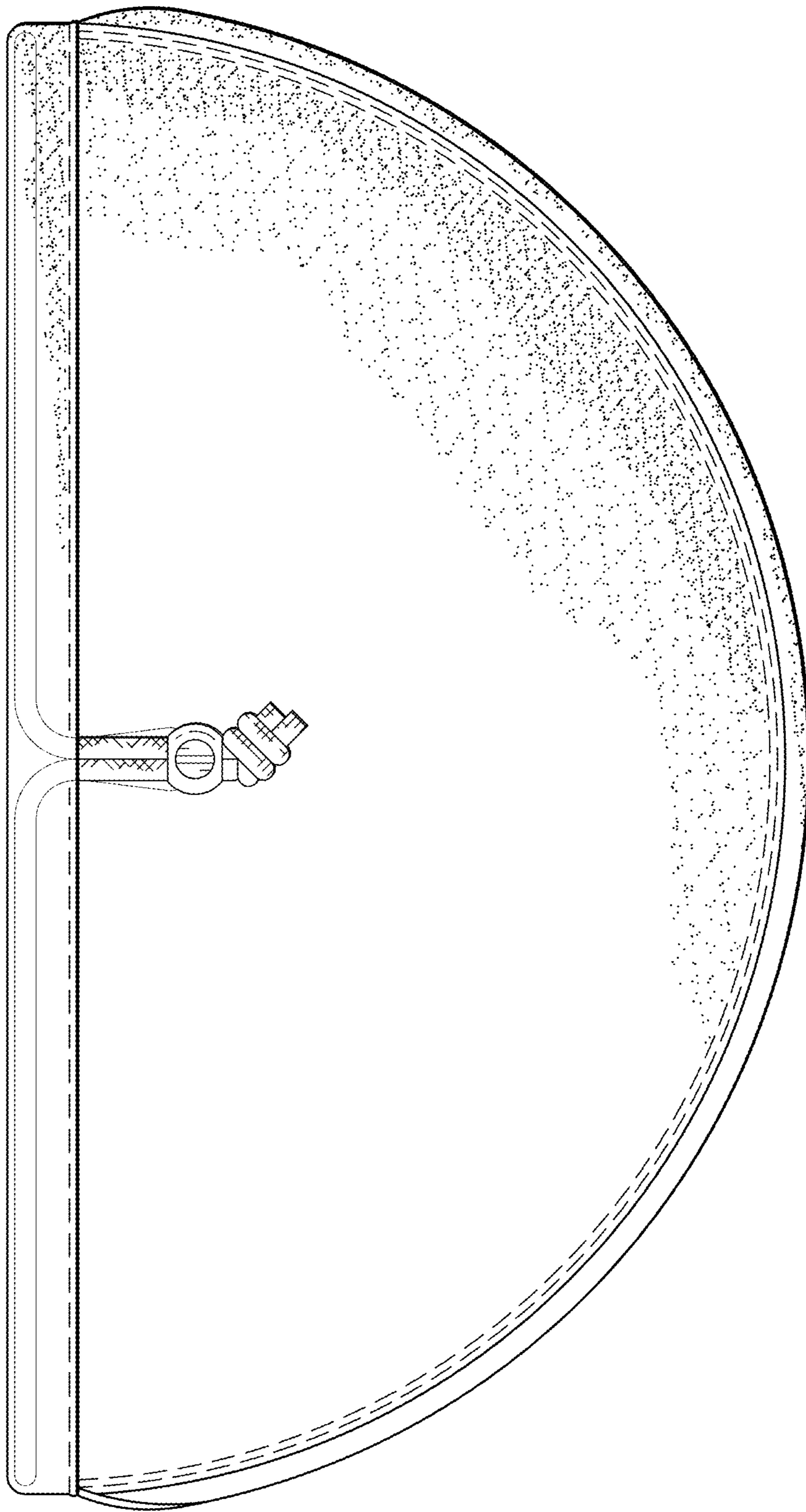

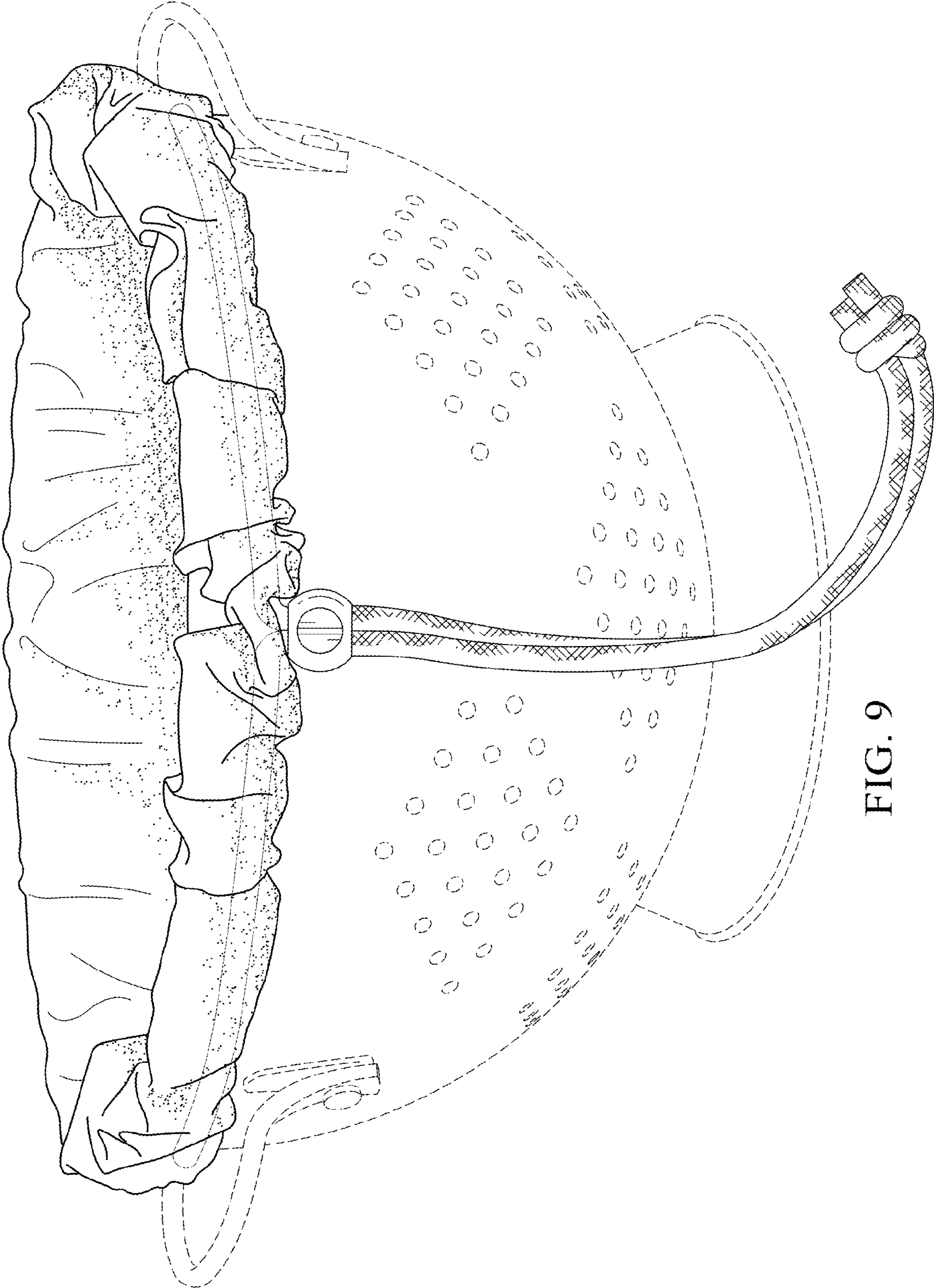
