**DESCRIPTION**

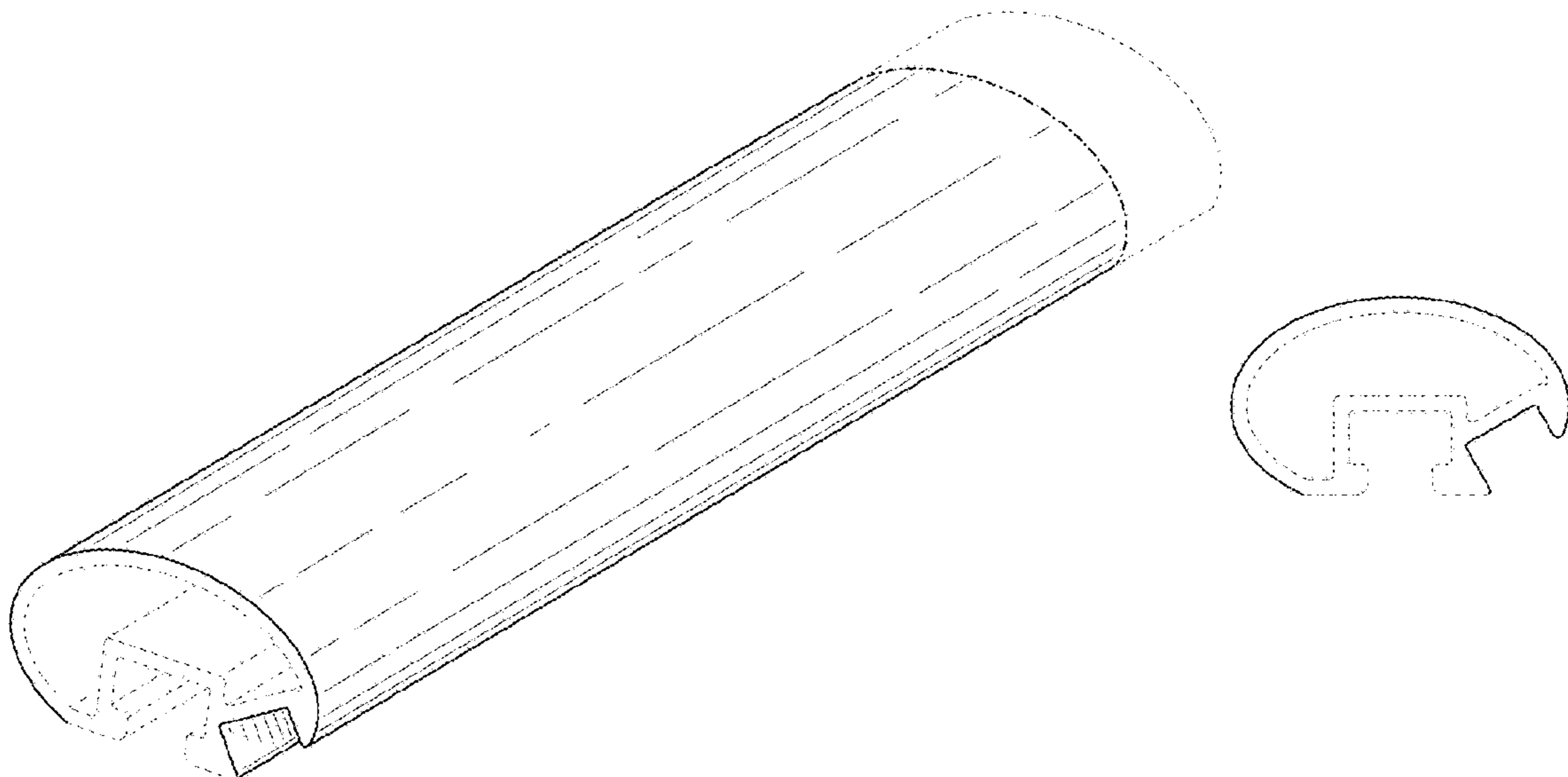
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a safety rail installed on an exemplary marine vessel.

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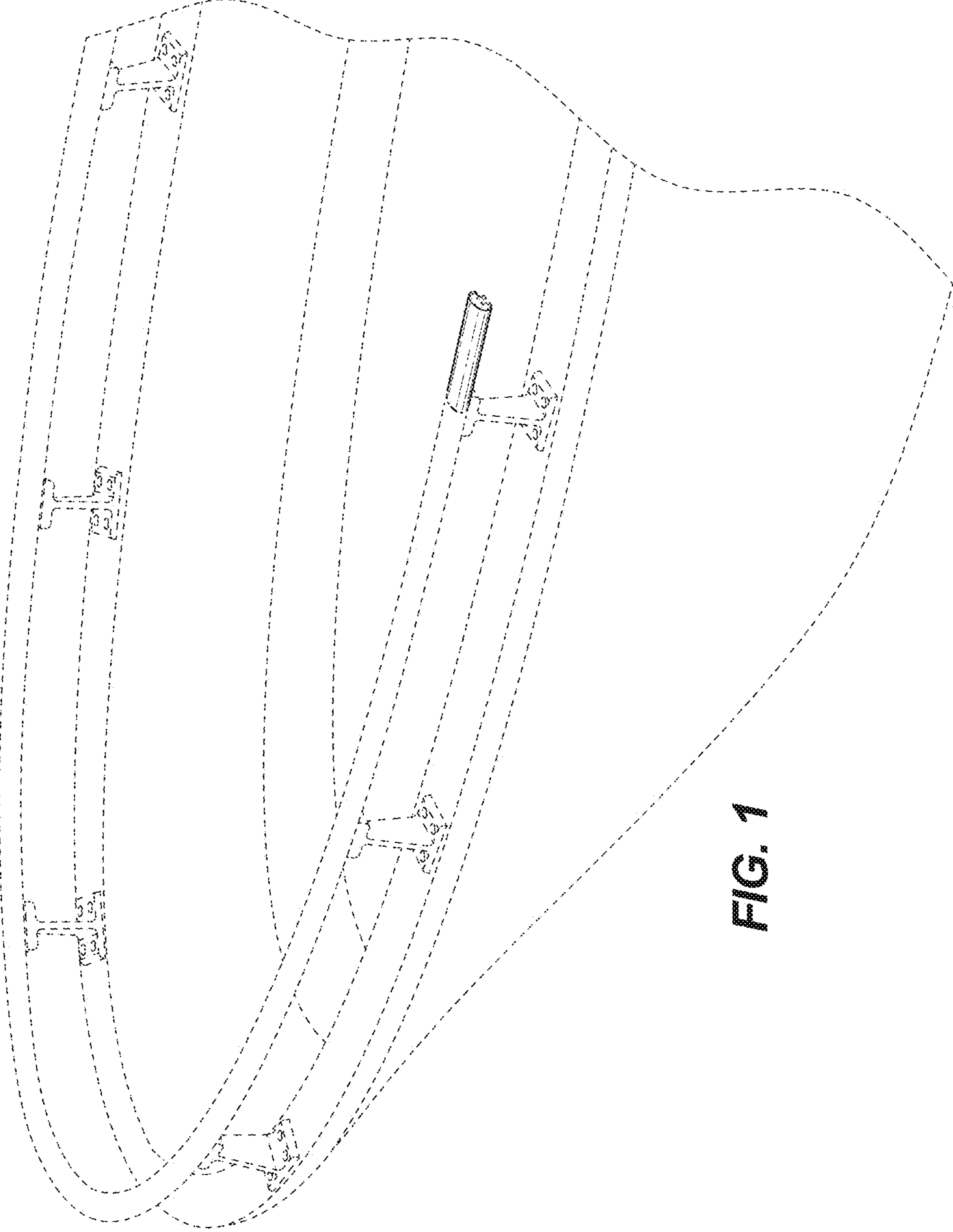

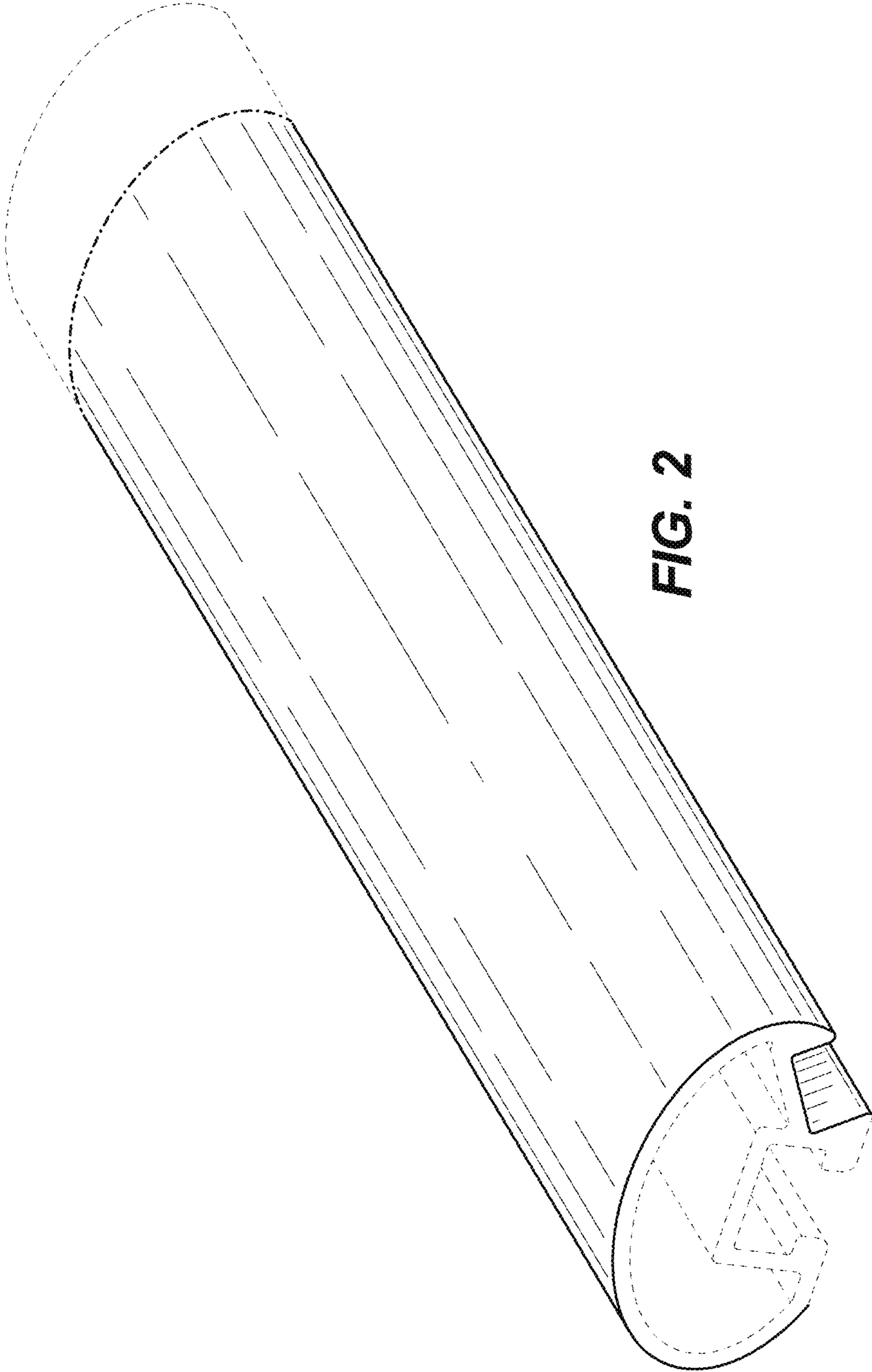
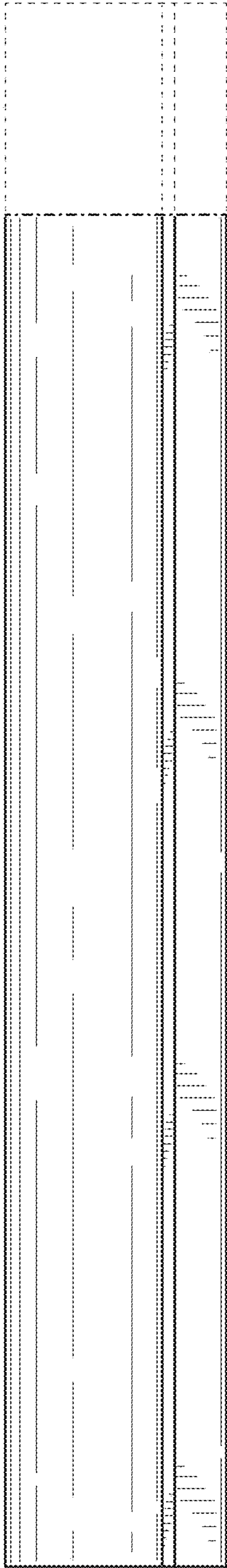
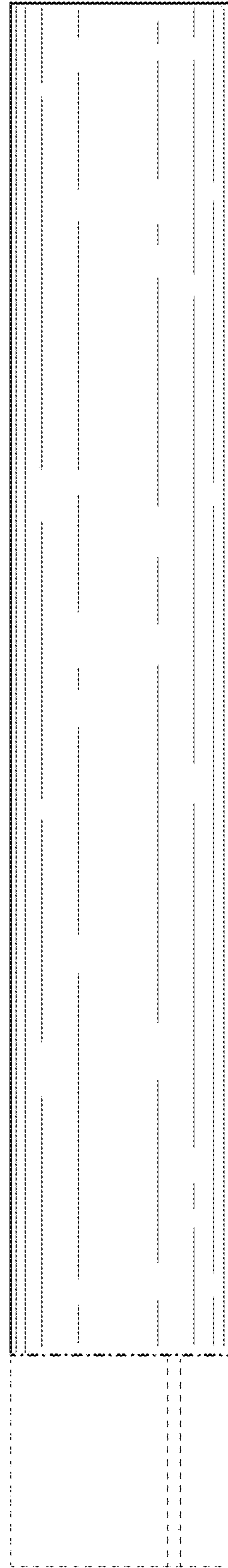


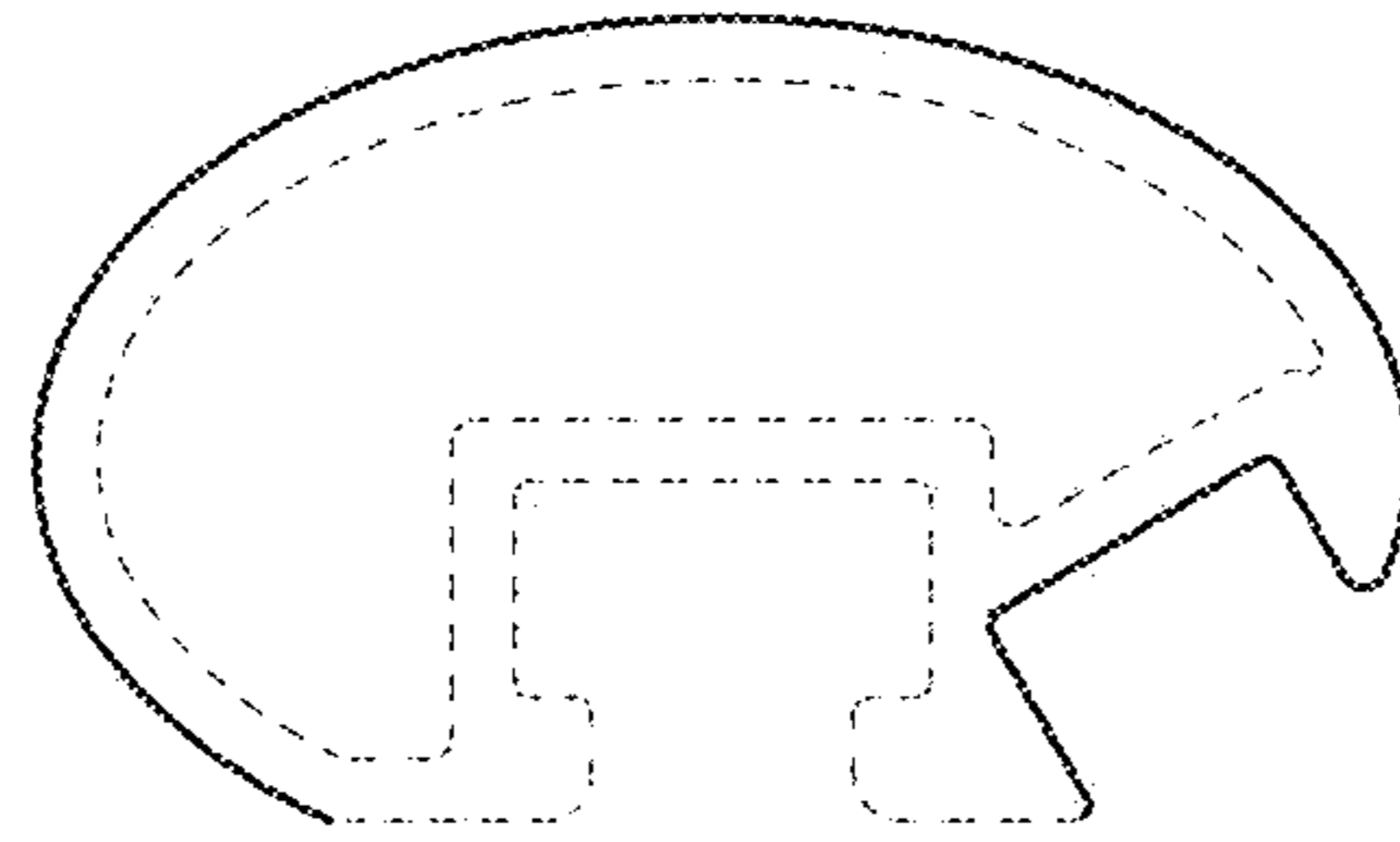

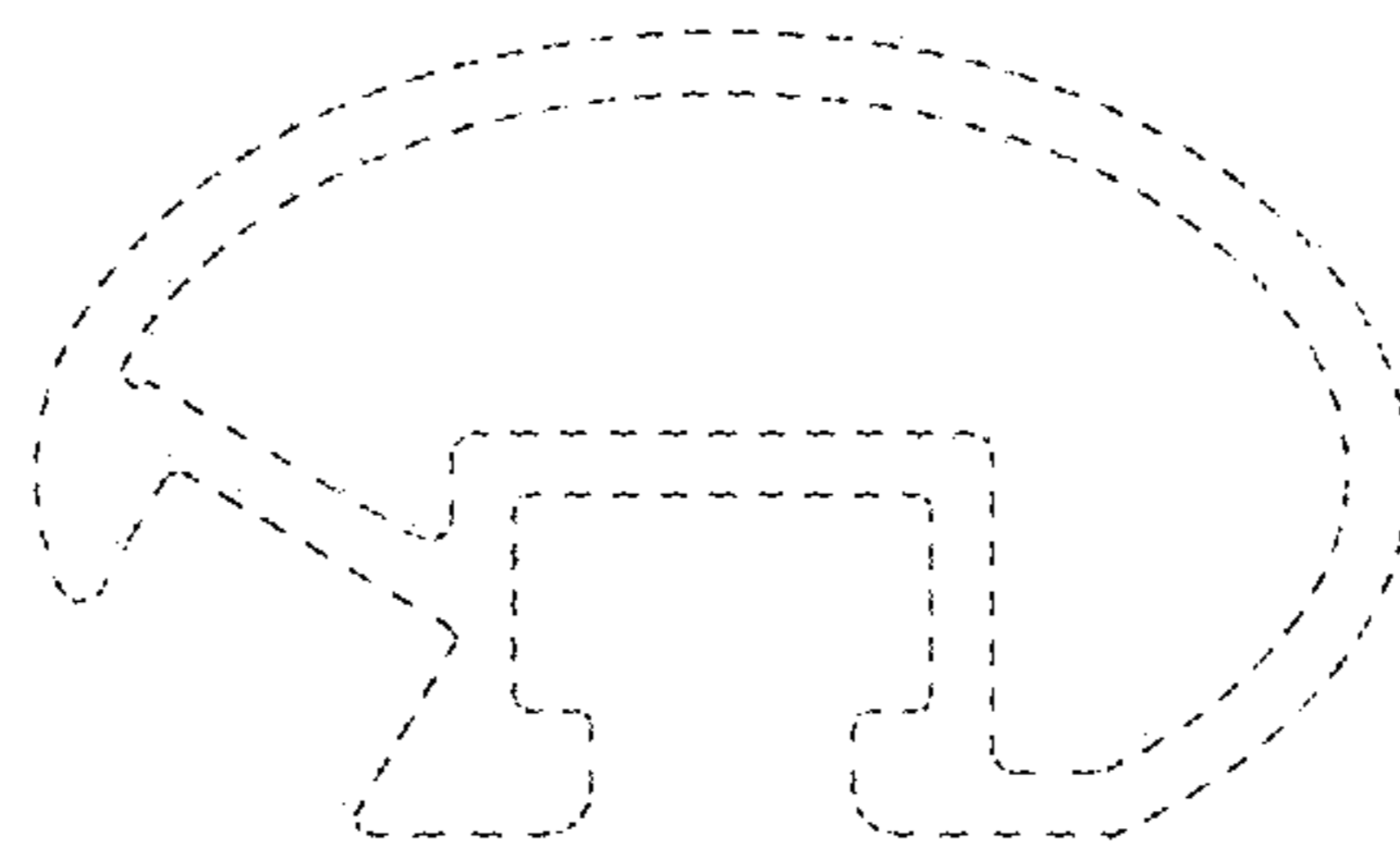

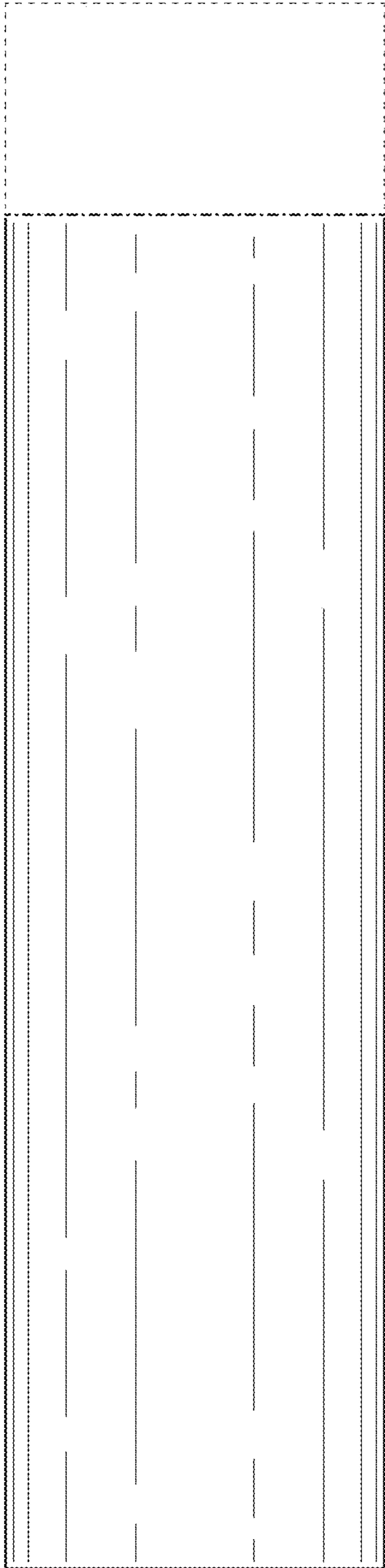

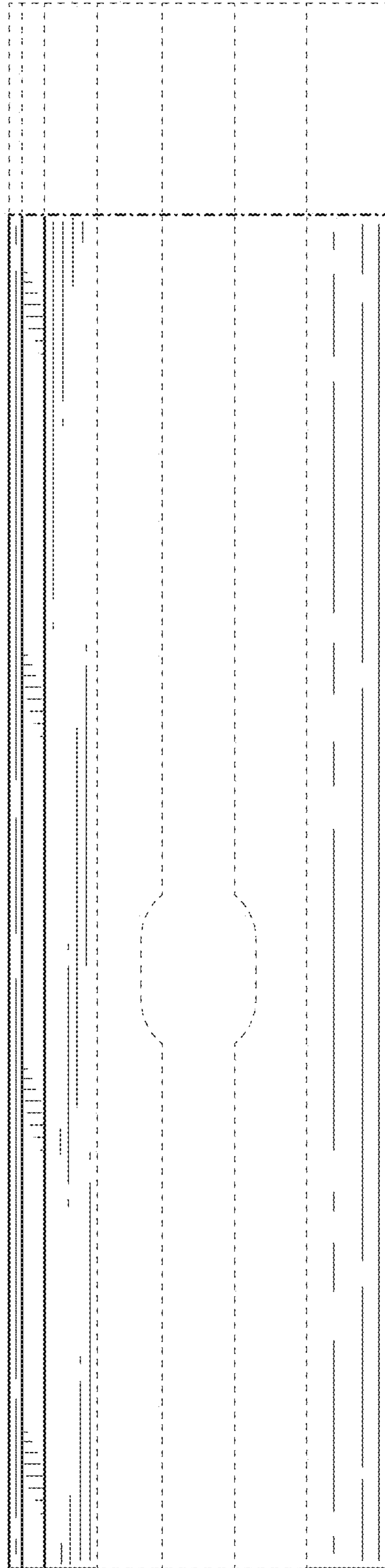
