FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof;

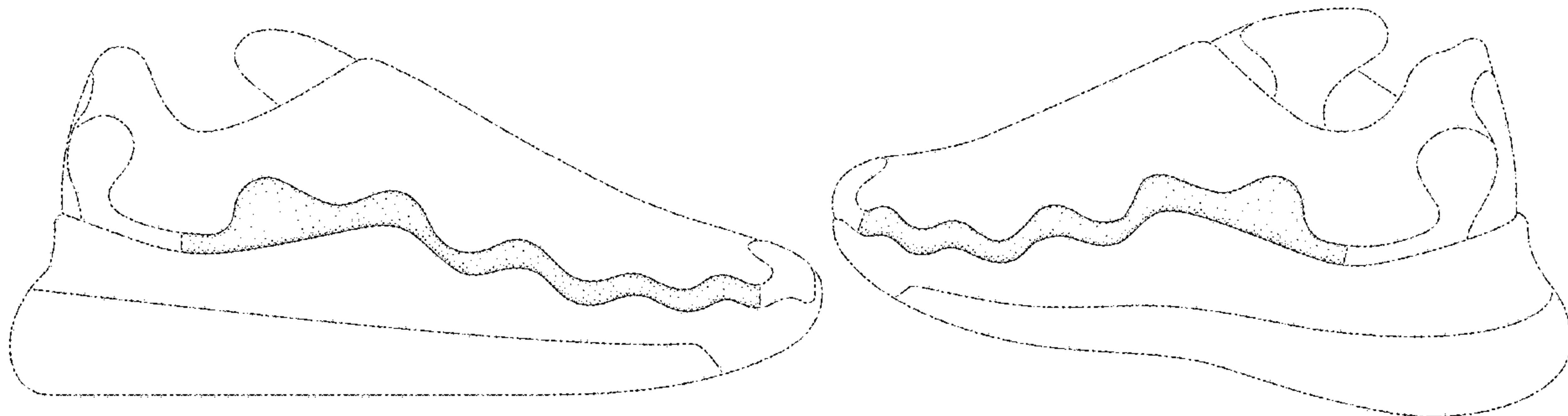
FIG. 4 is an opposite side rear perspective view thereof;

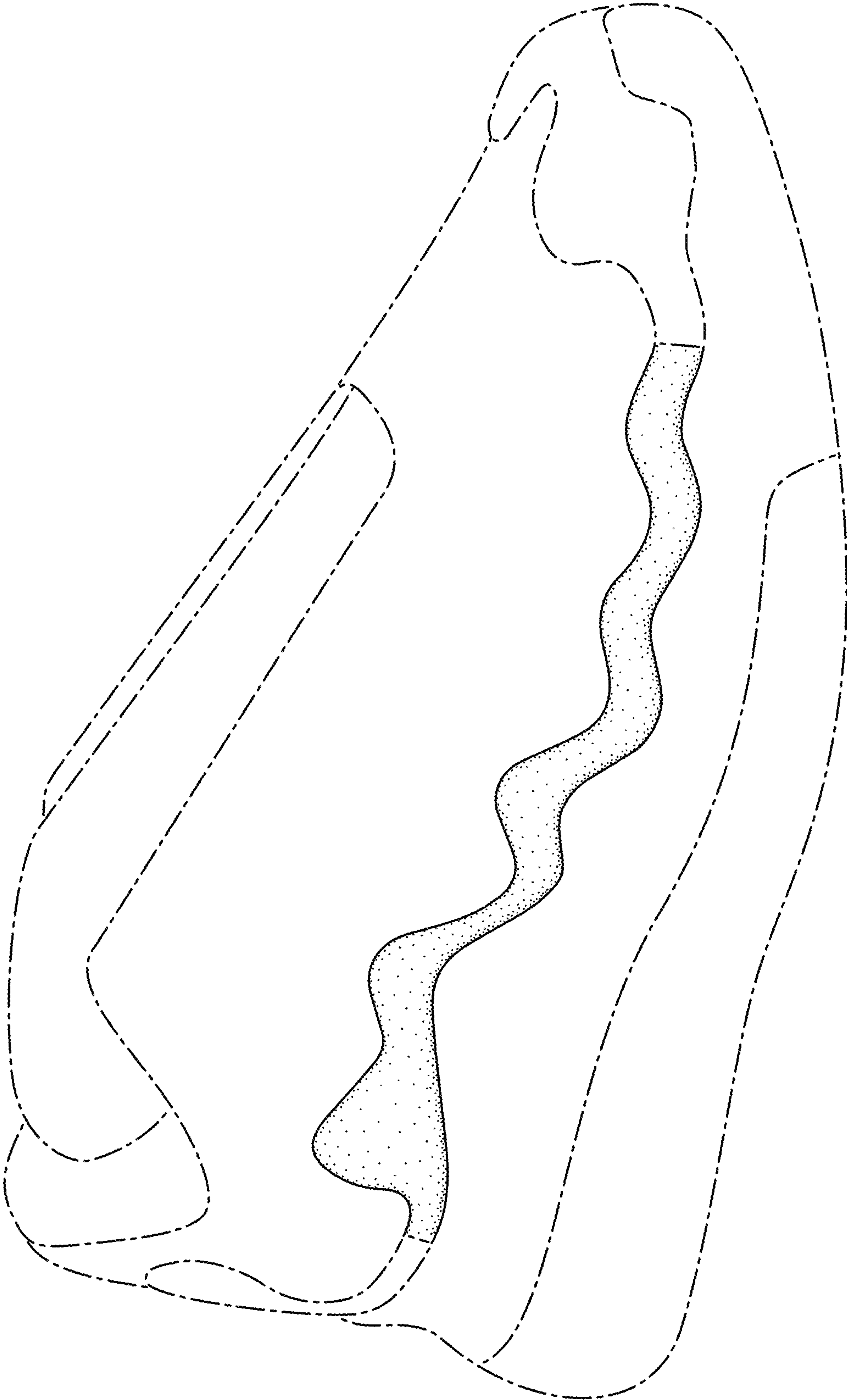

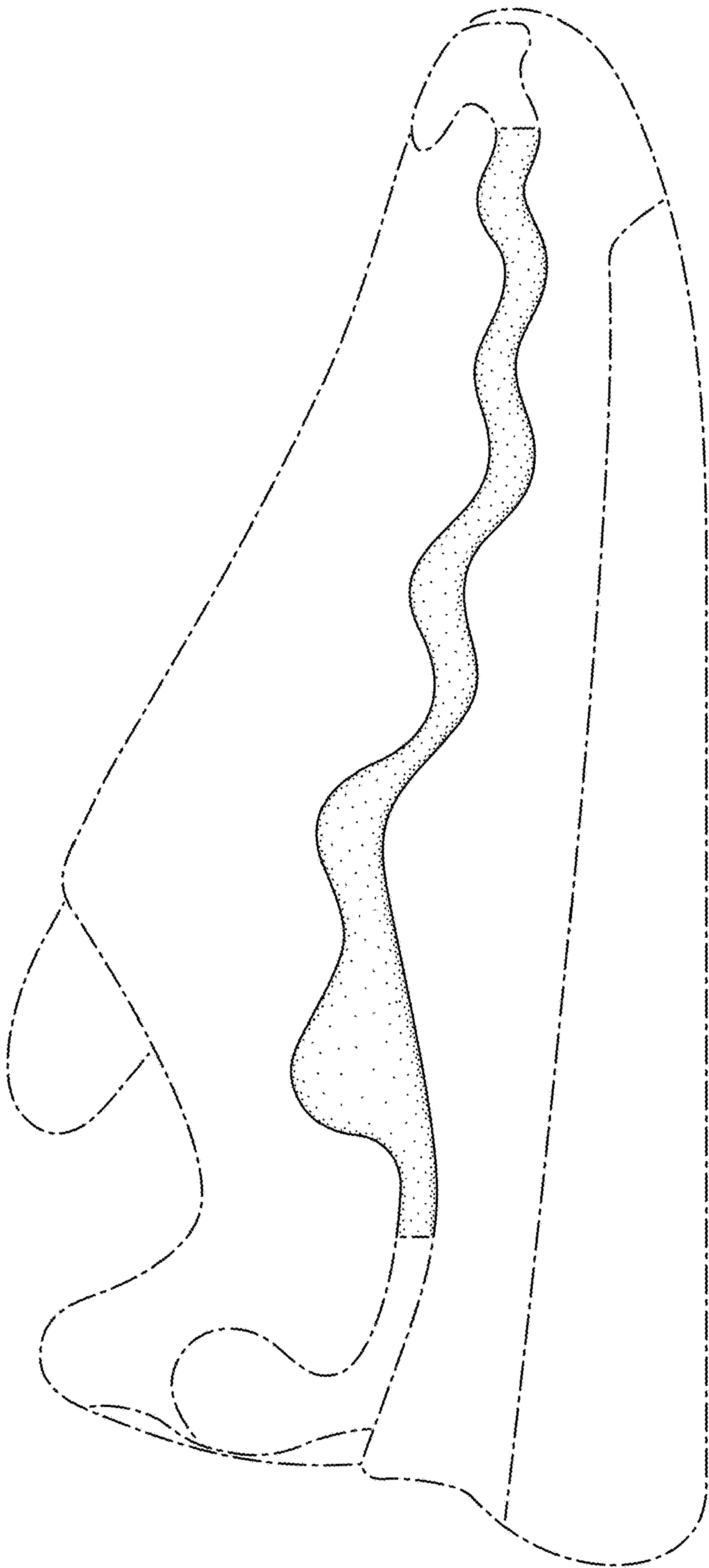

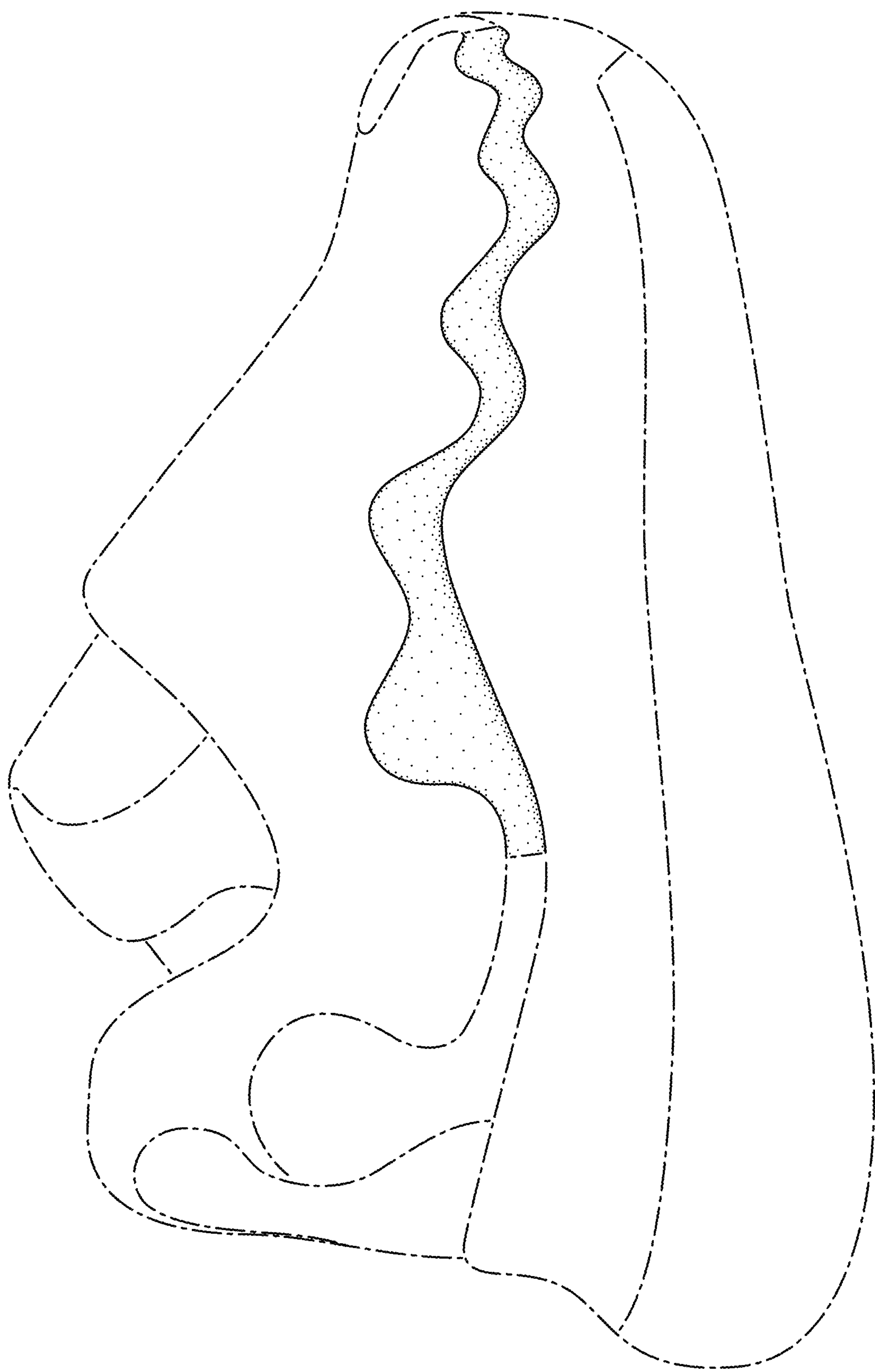

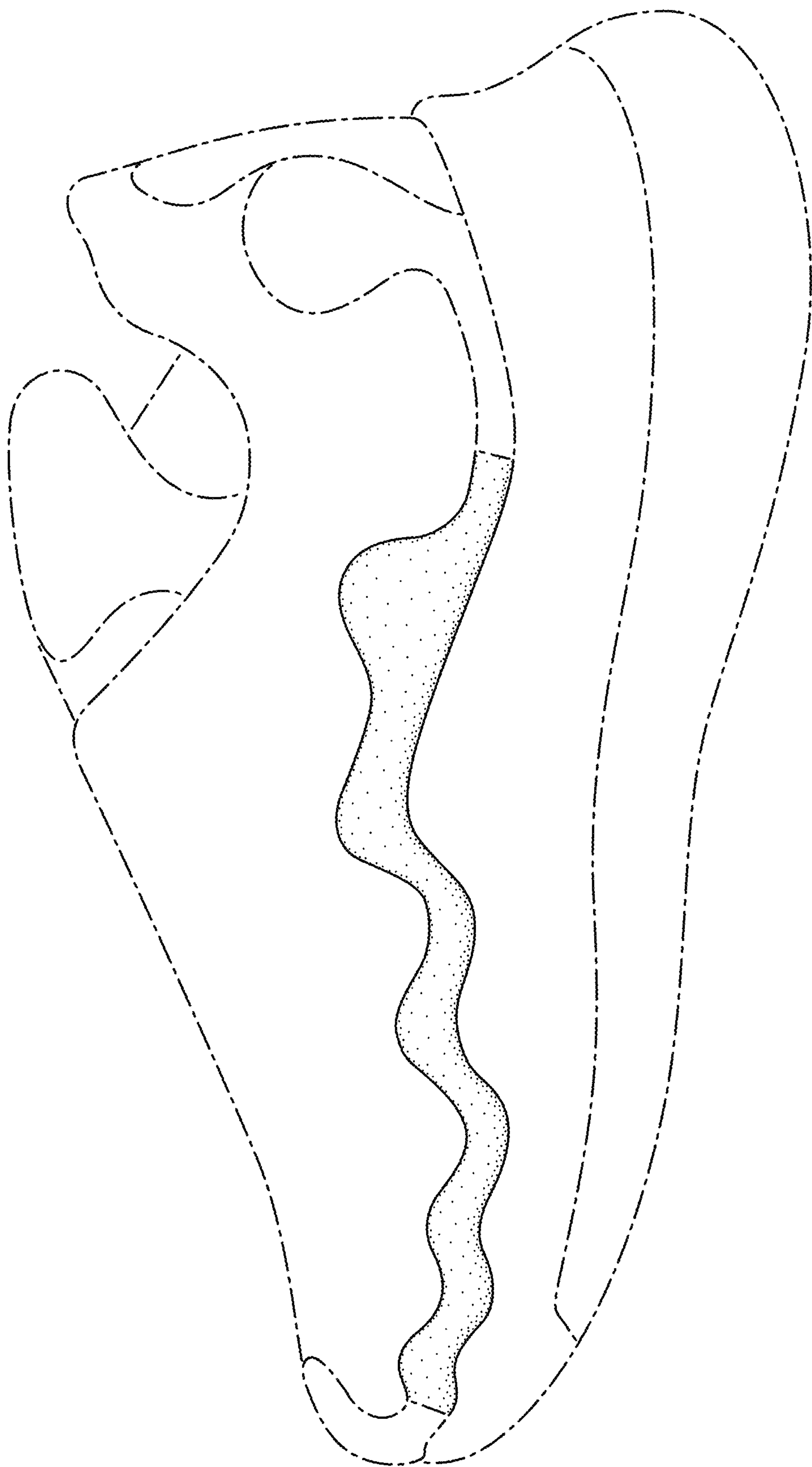

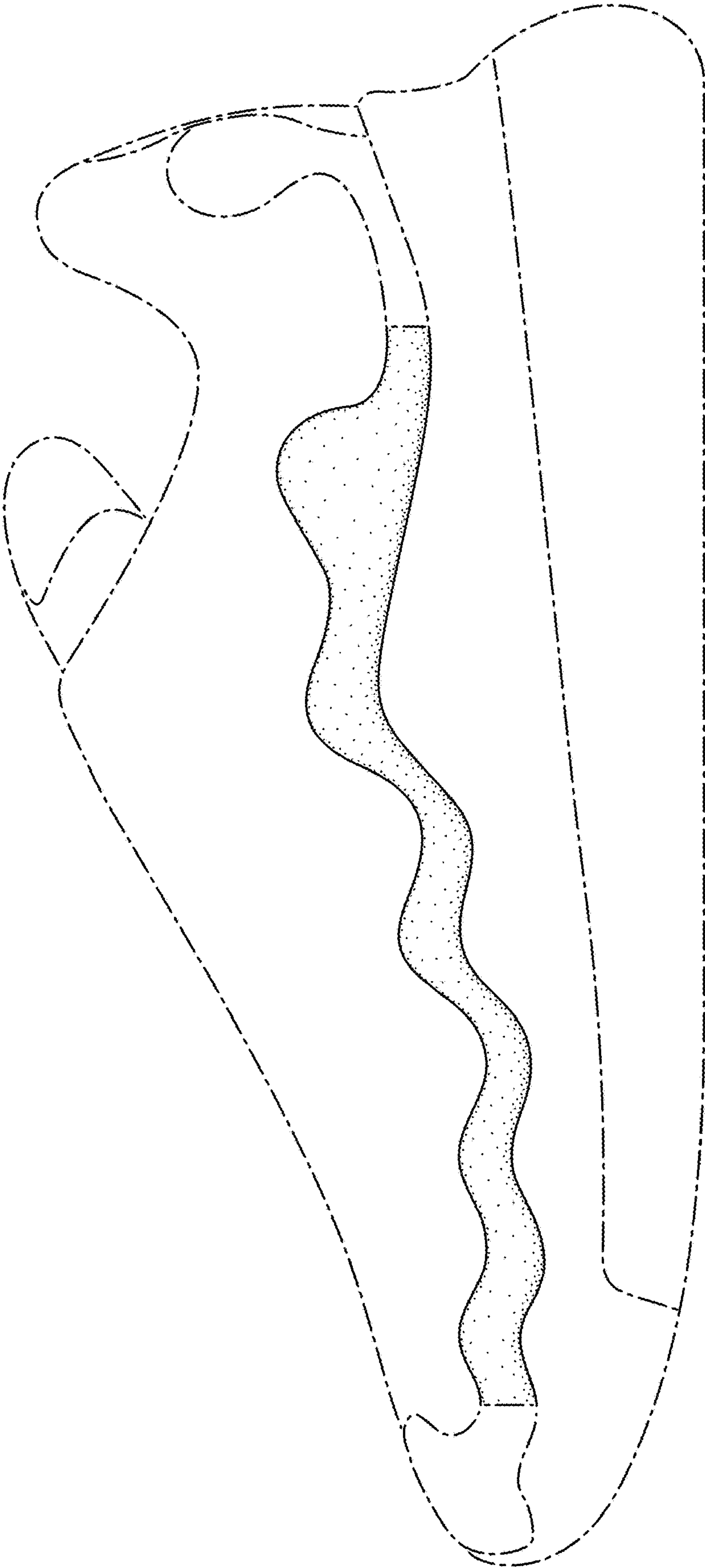

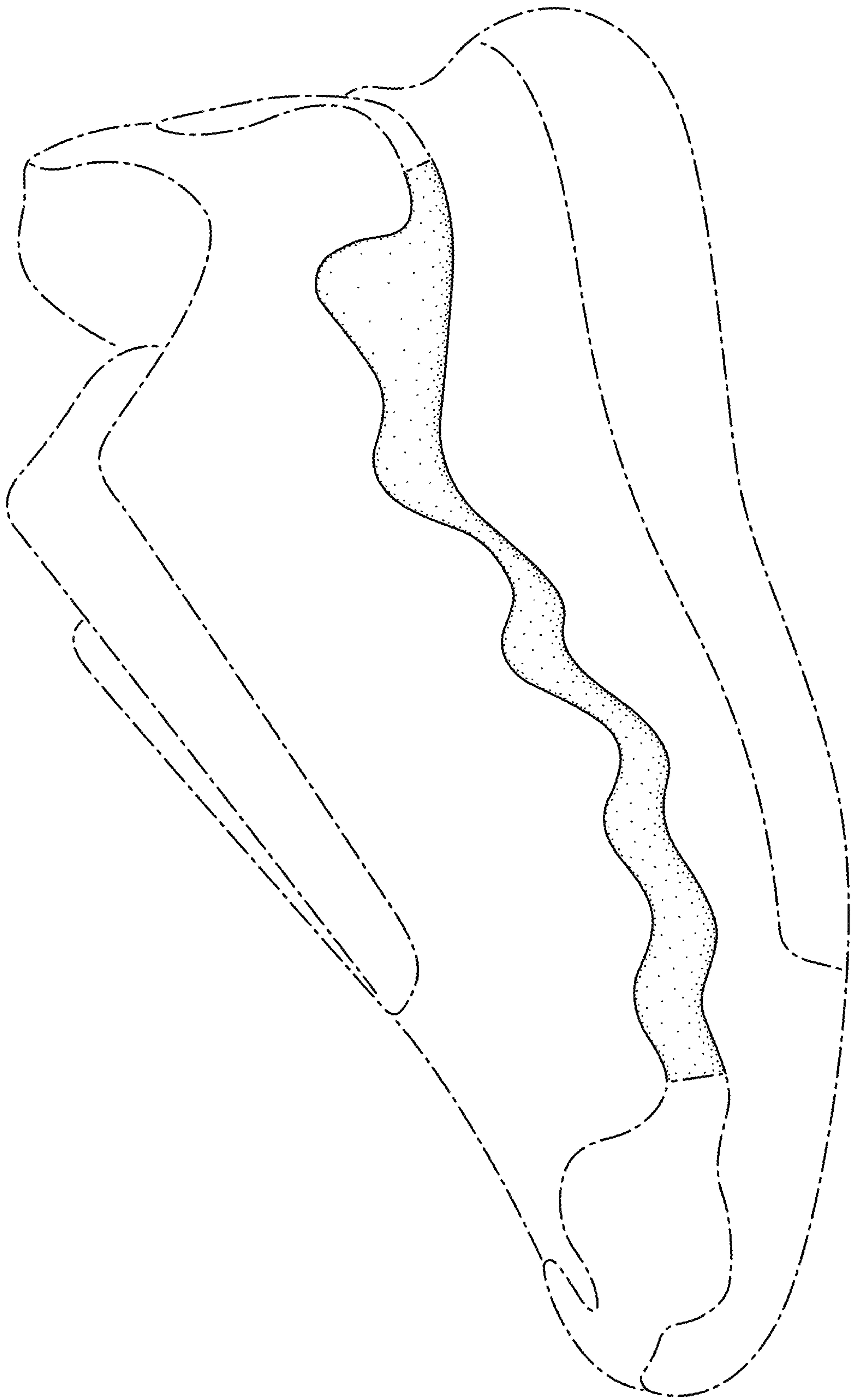
