DESCRIPTION

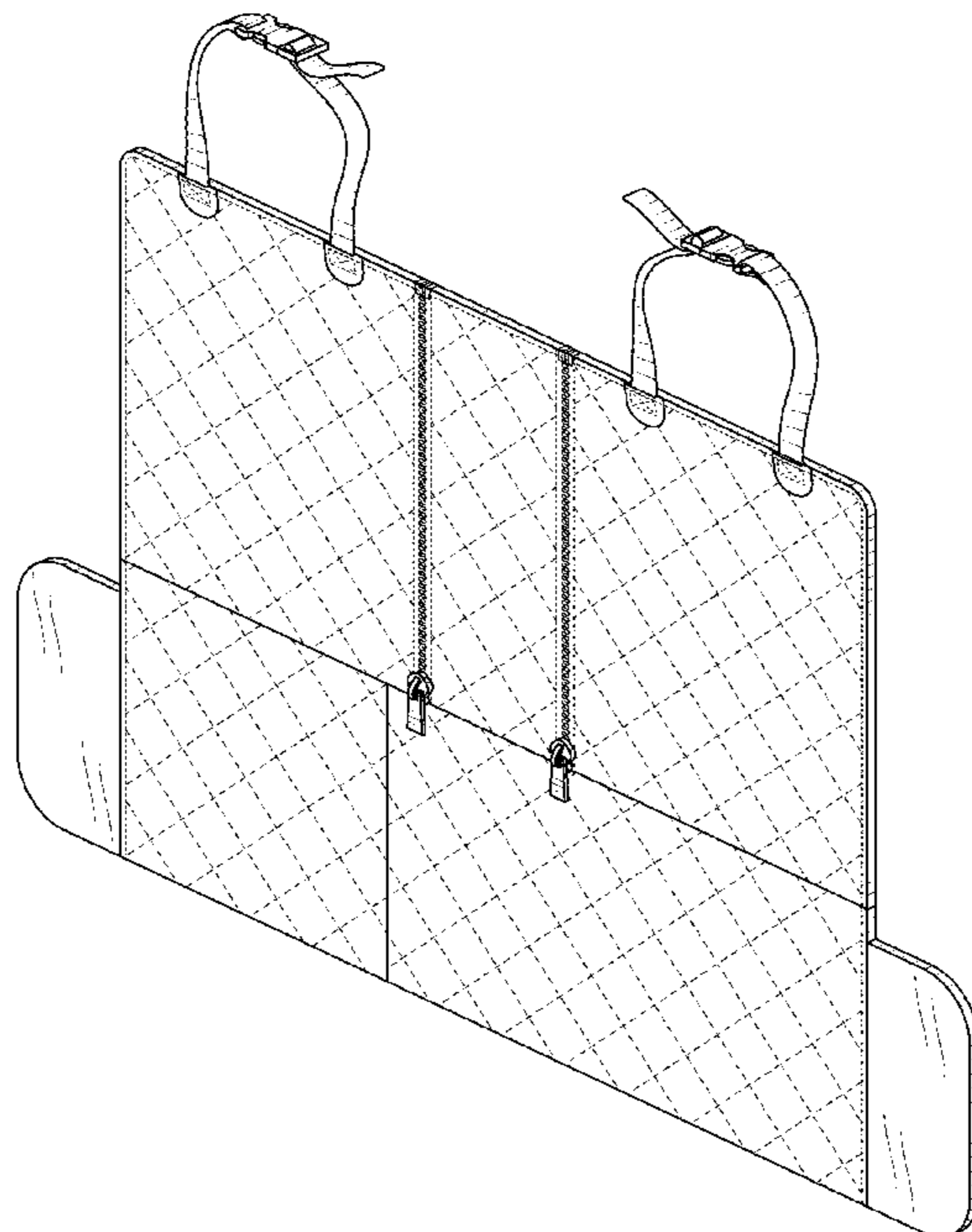
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a split bench seat cover in accordance with the present design;

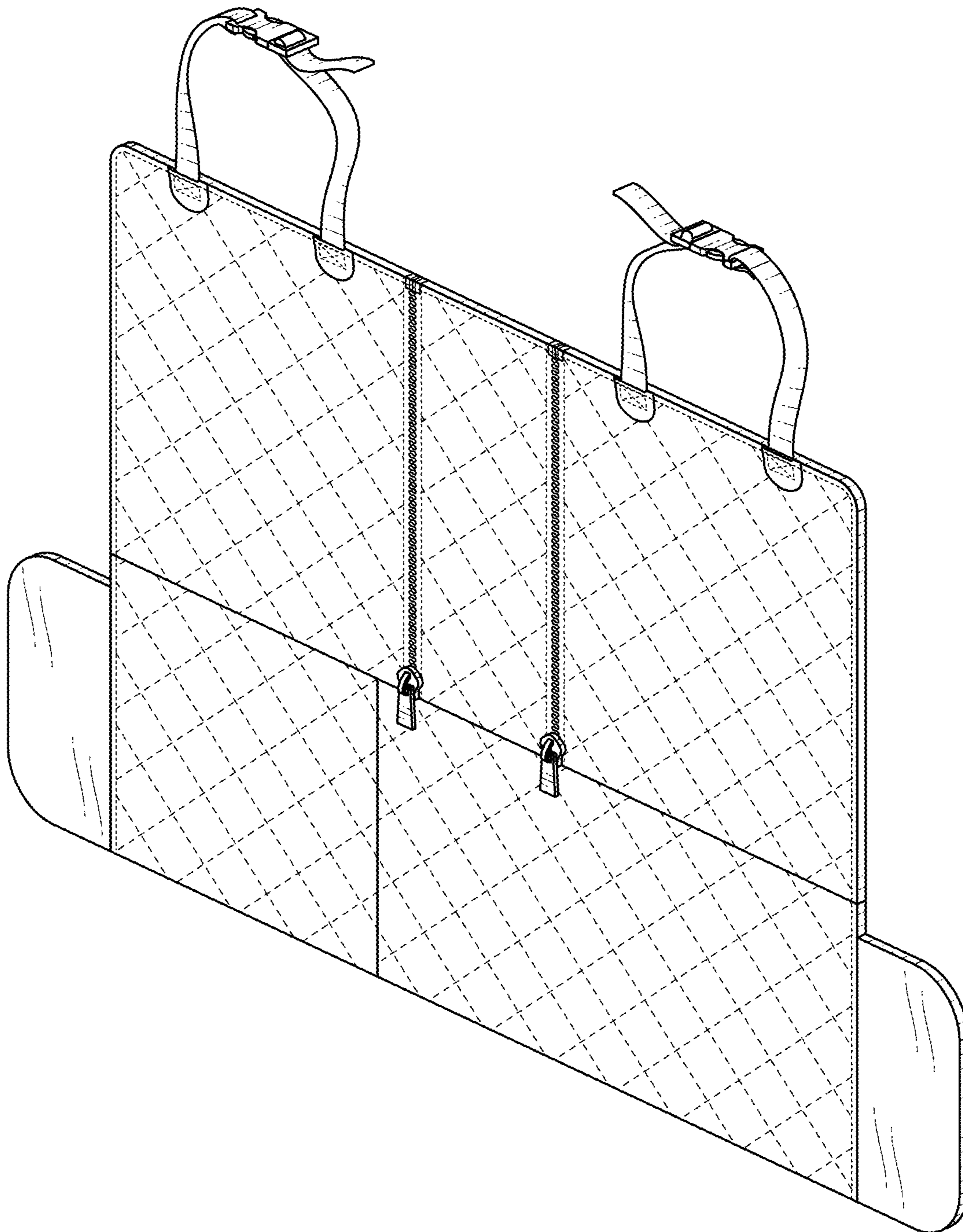

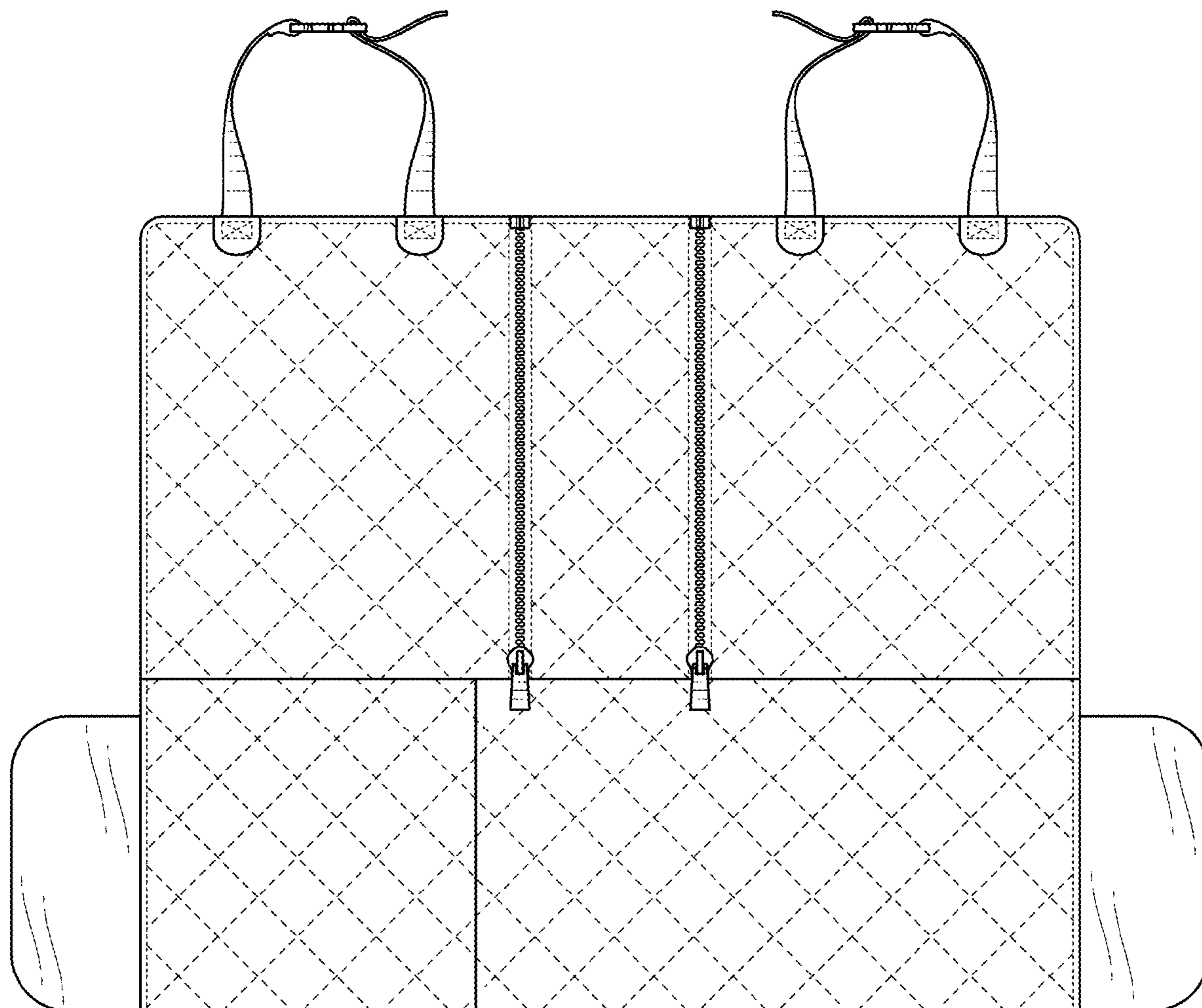

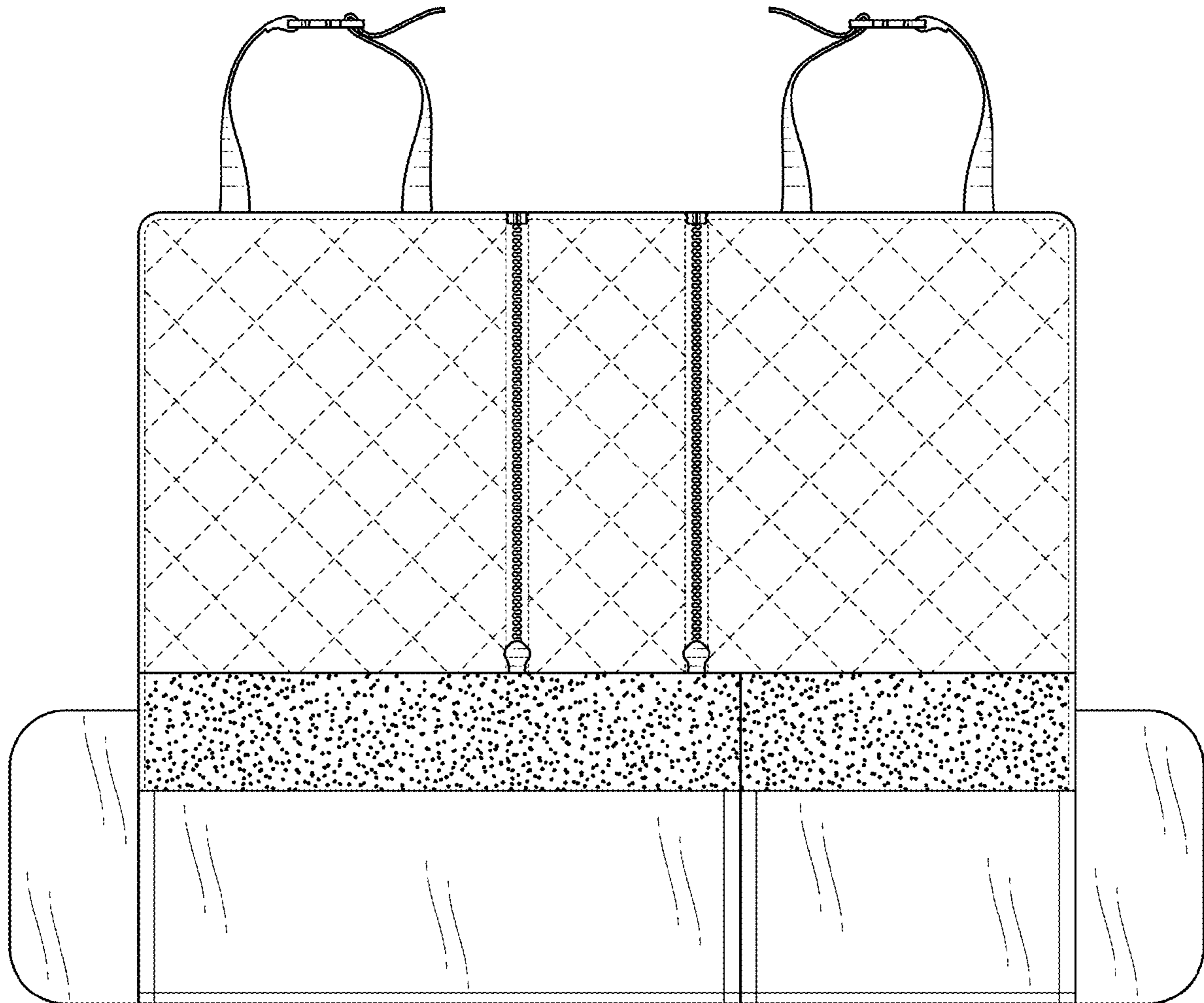

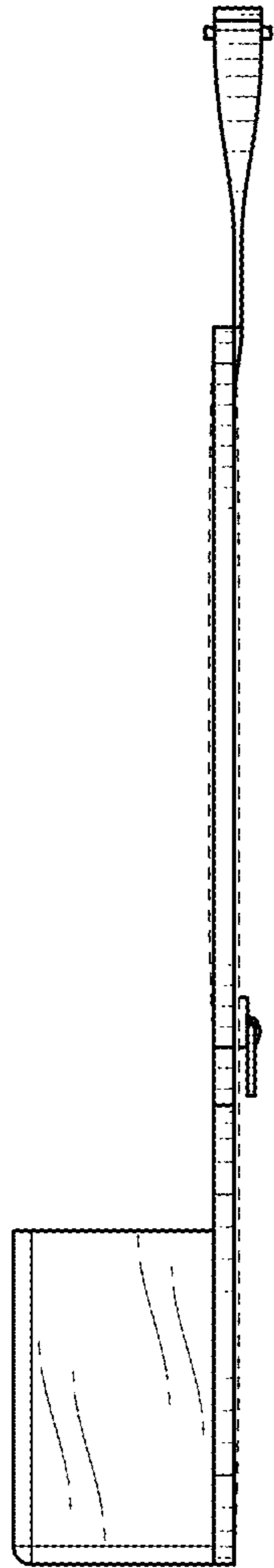

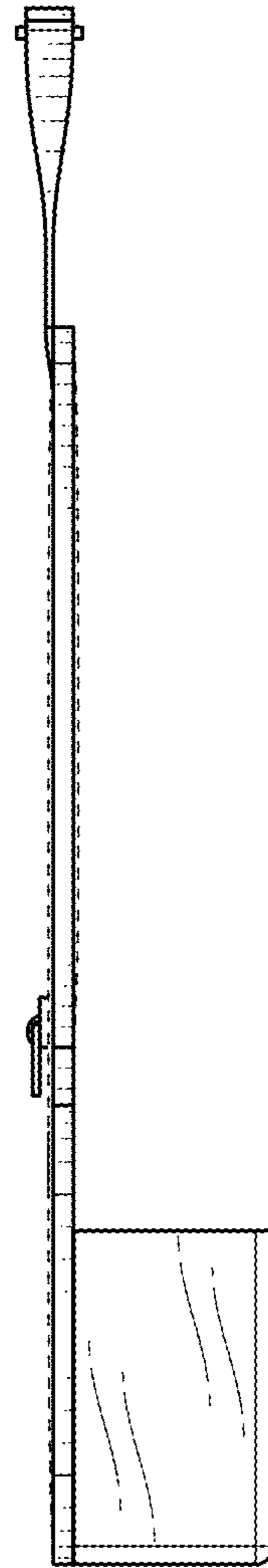

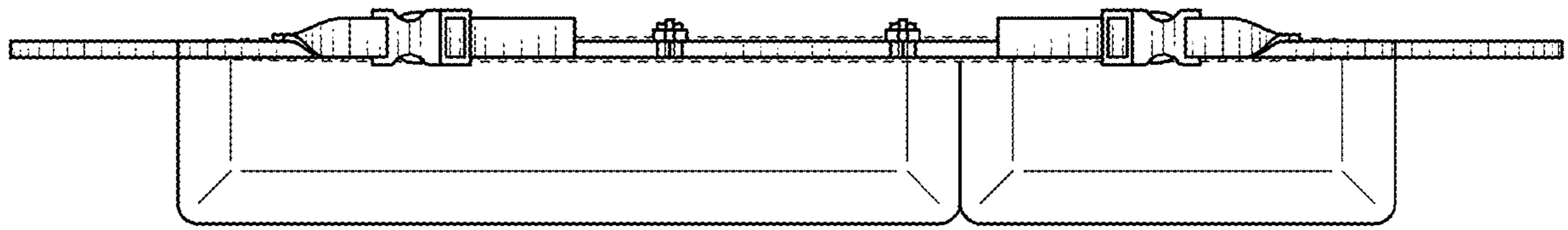

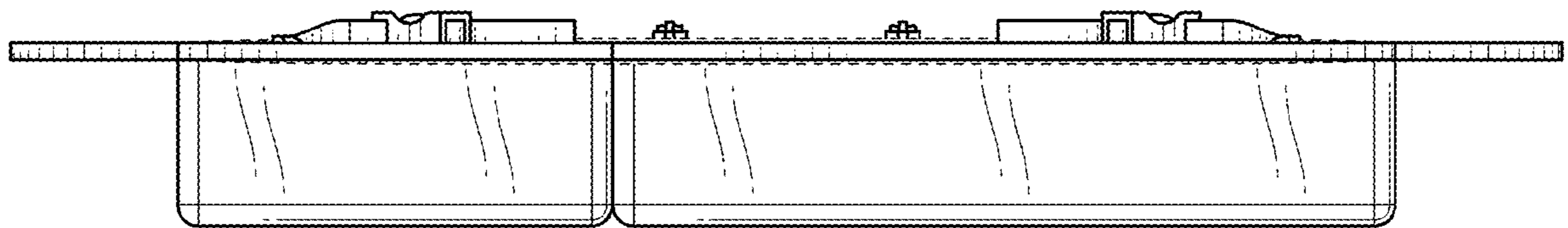
