(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a washer for use on a vehicle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, left, front perspective view, to include the mirror image, of a washer for use on a vehicle, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof;

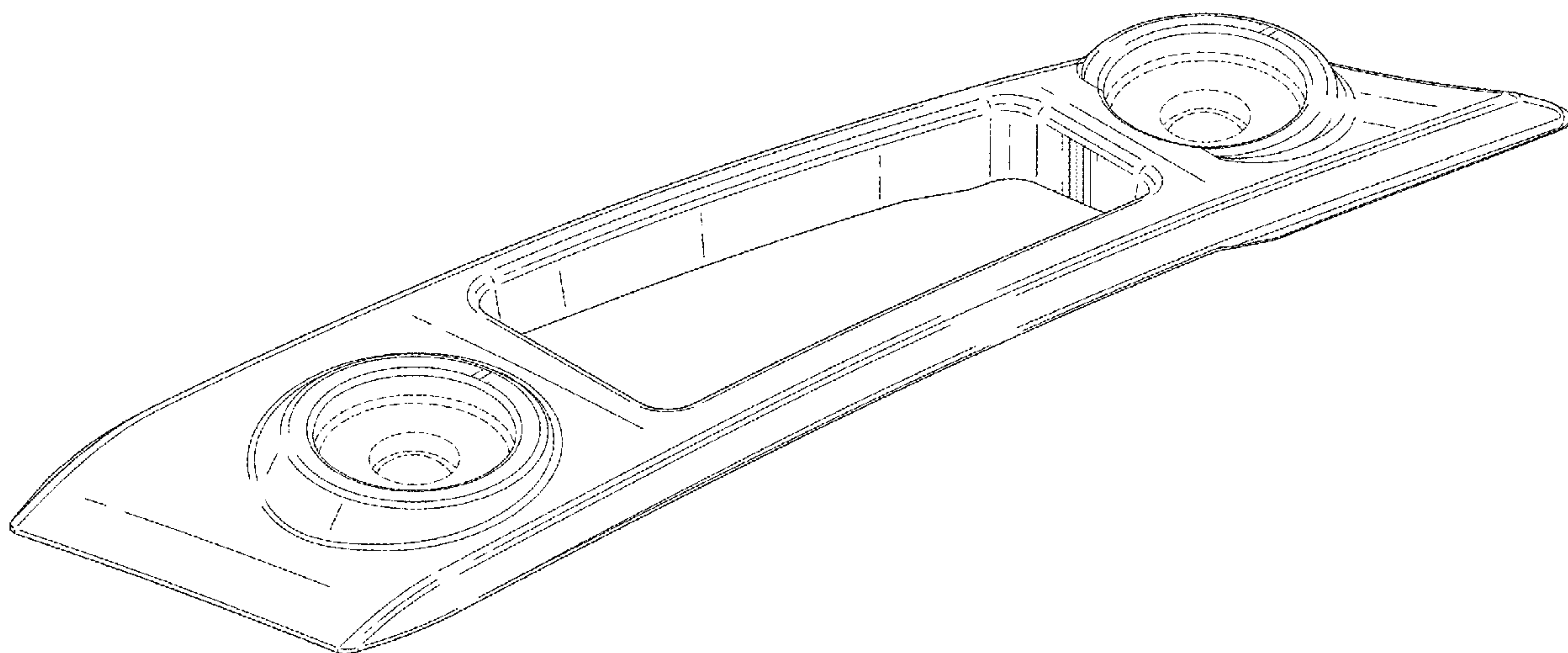
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is a top, left, rear perspective view thereof, shown in a state of use.

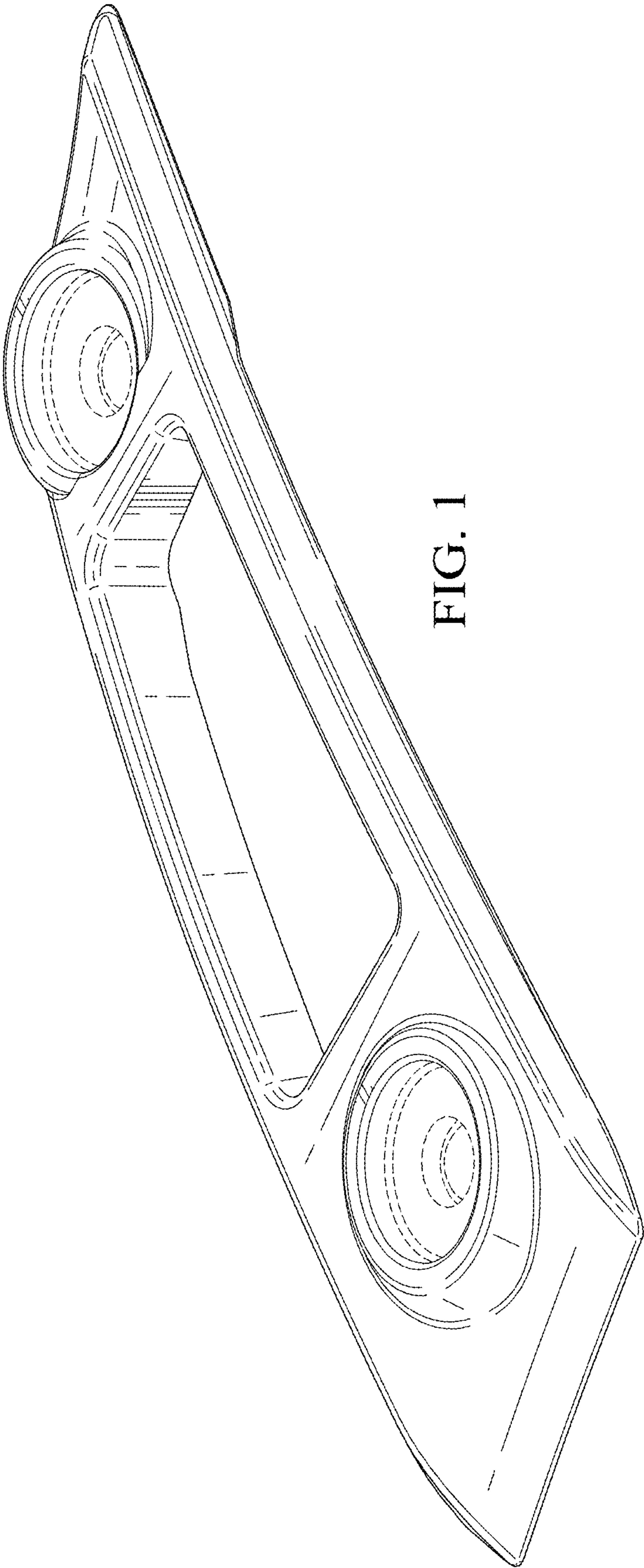

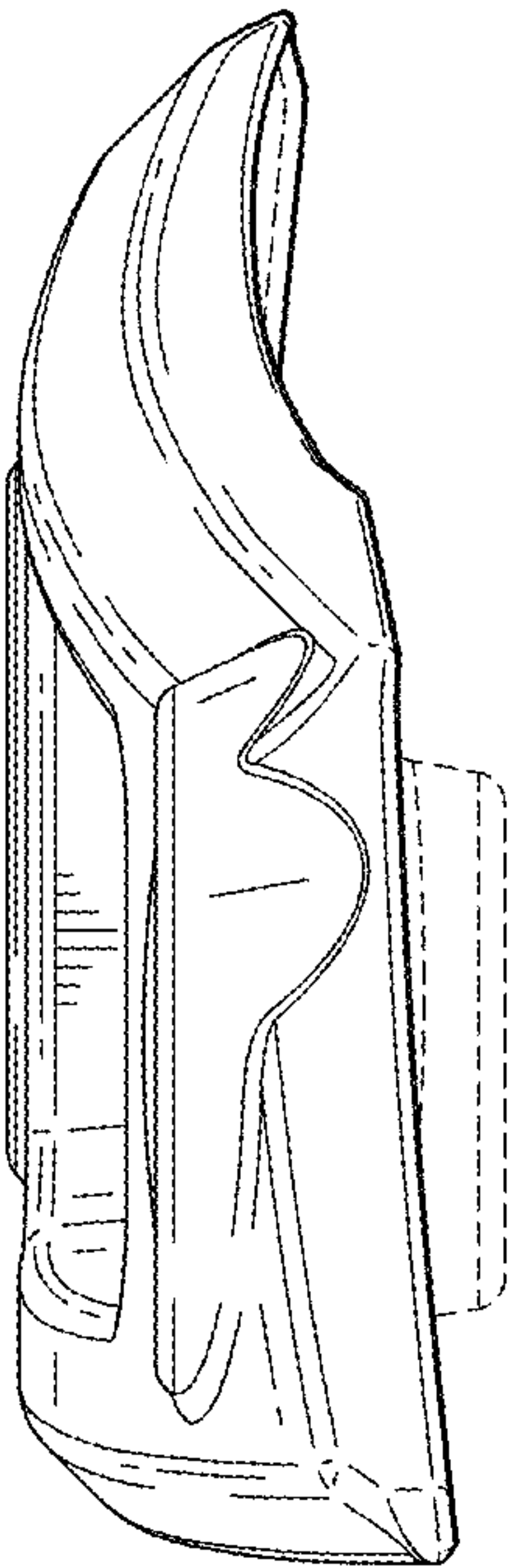

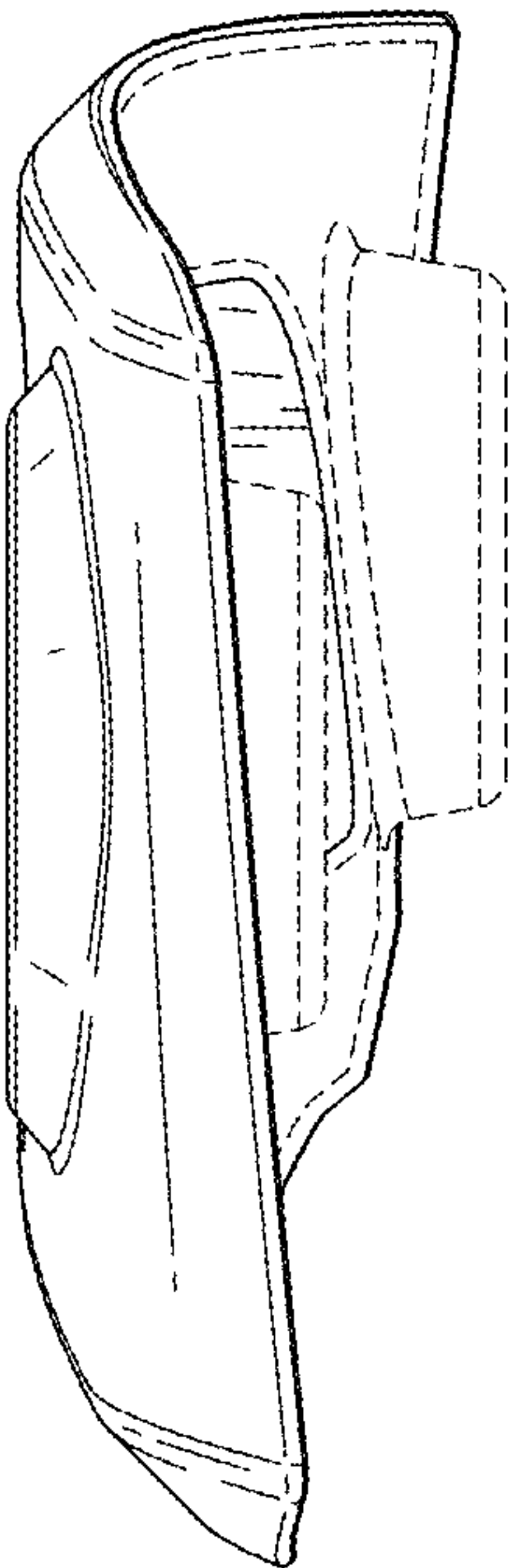

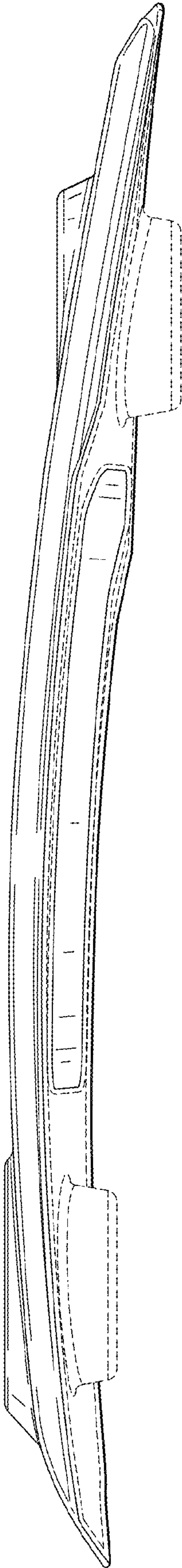

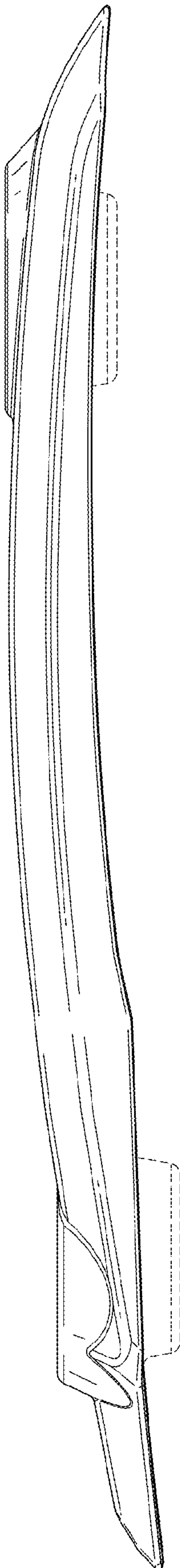

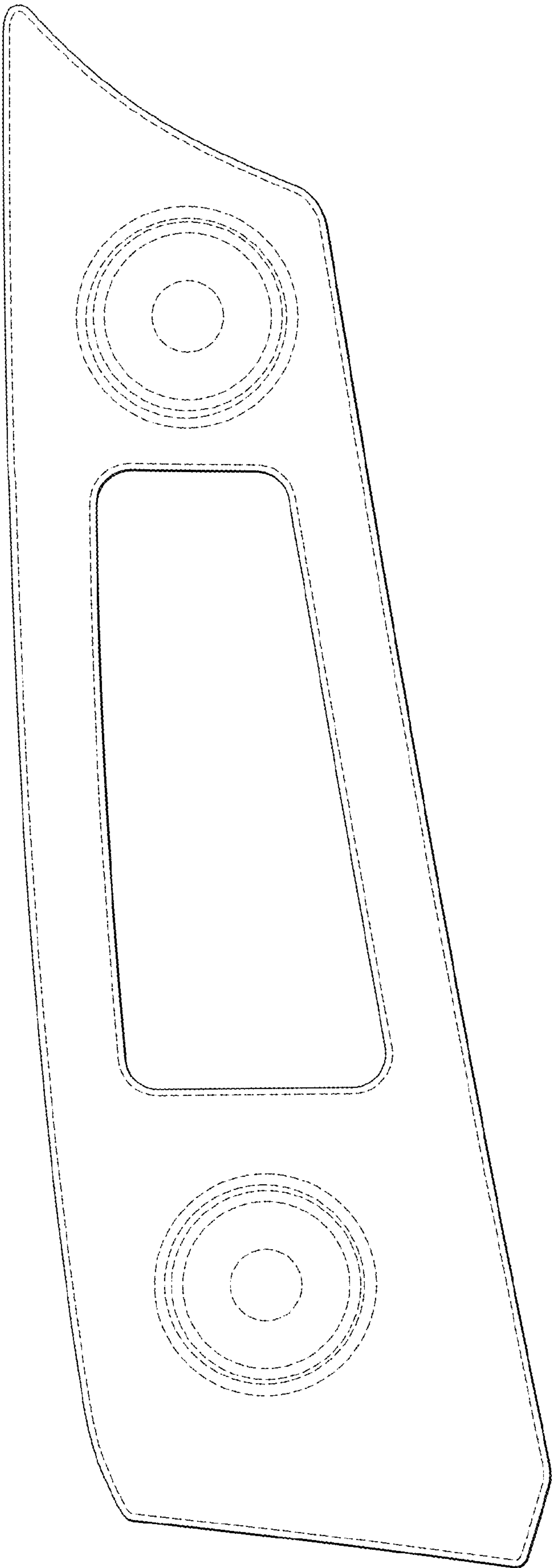

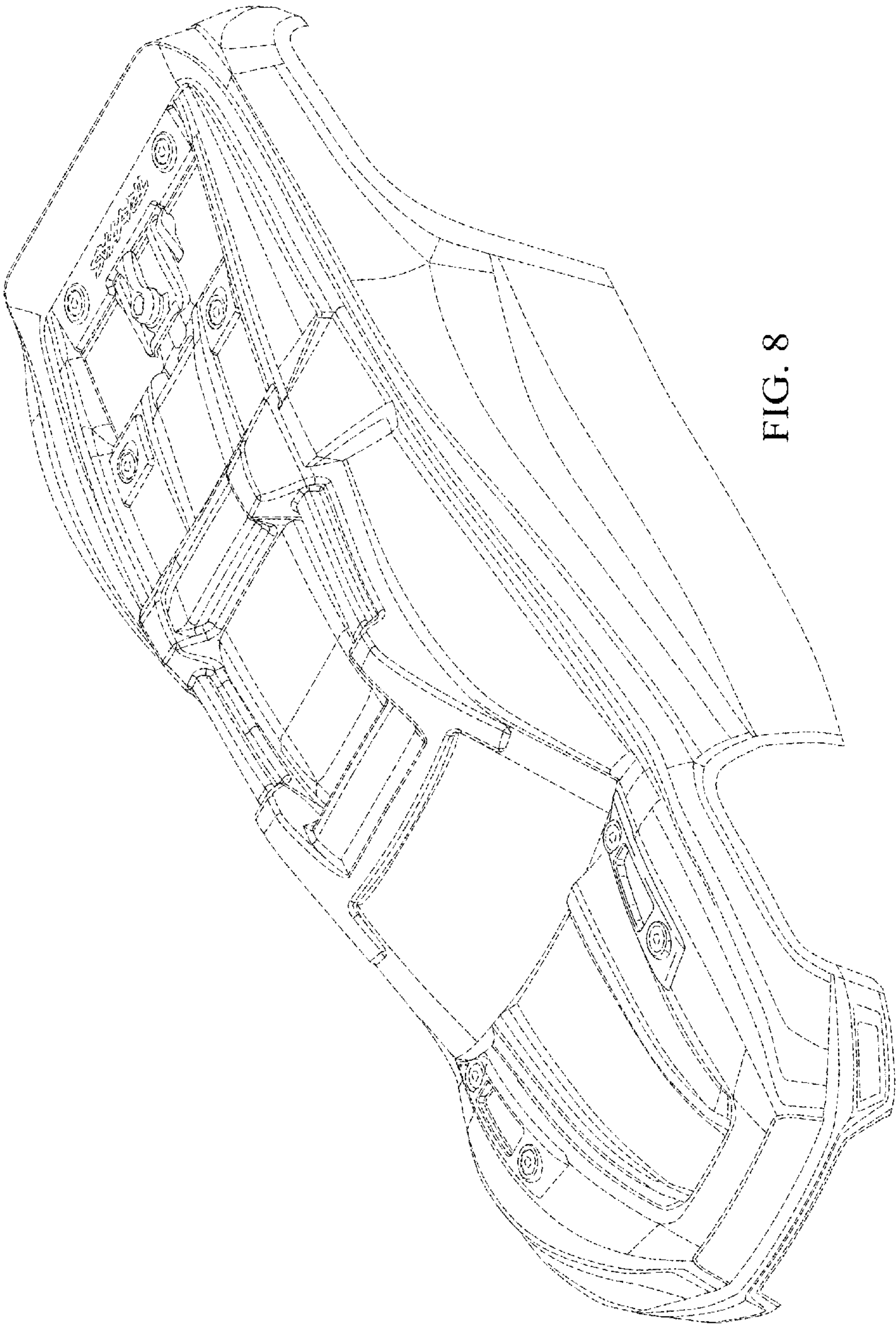
