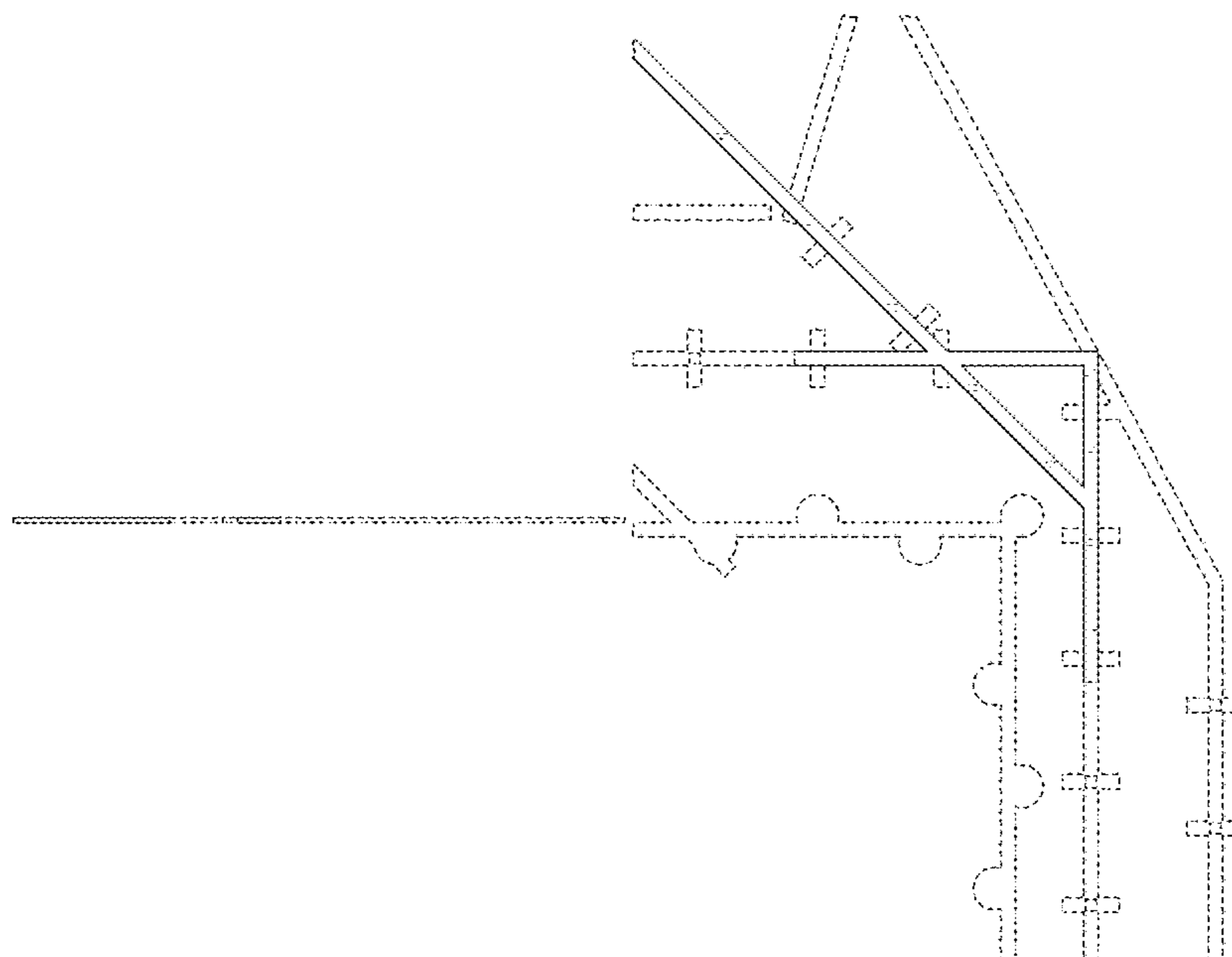
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an exercise guide for floor surfaces, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of the exercise guide for floor surfaces.  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view of the exercise guide for floor surfaces.  
FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view of the exercise guide for floor surfaces.  
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view of the exercise guide for floor surfaces.  
FIG. 5 is a top view of the exercise guide for floor surfaces.  
FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the exercise guide for floor surfaces.  
FIG. 7 is a front left isometric view of the exercise guide for floor surfaces; and,

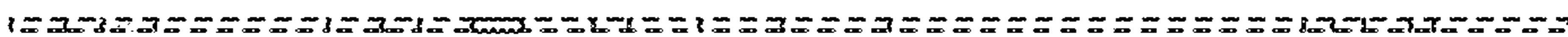

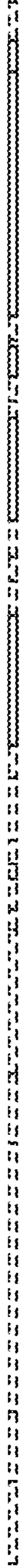

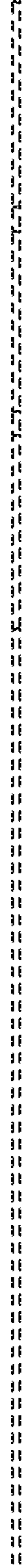

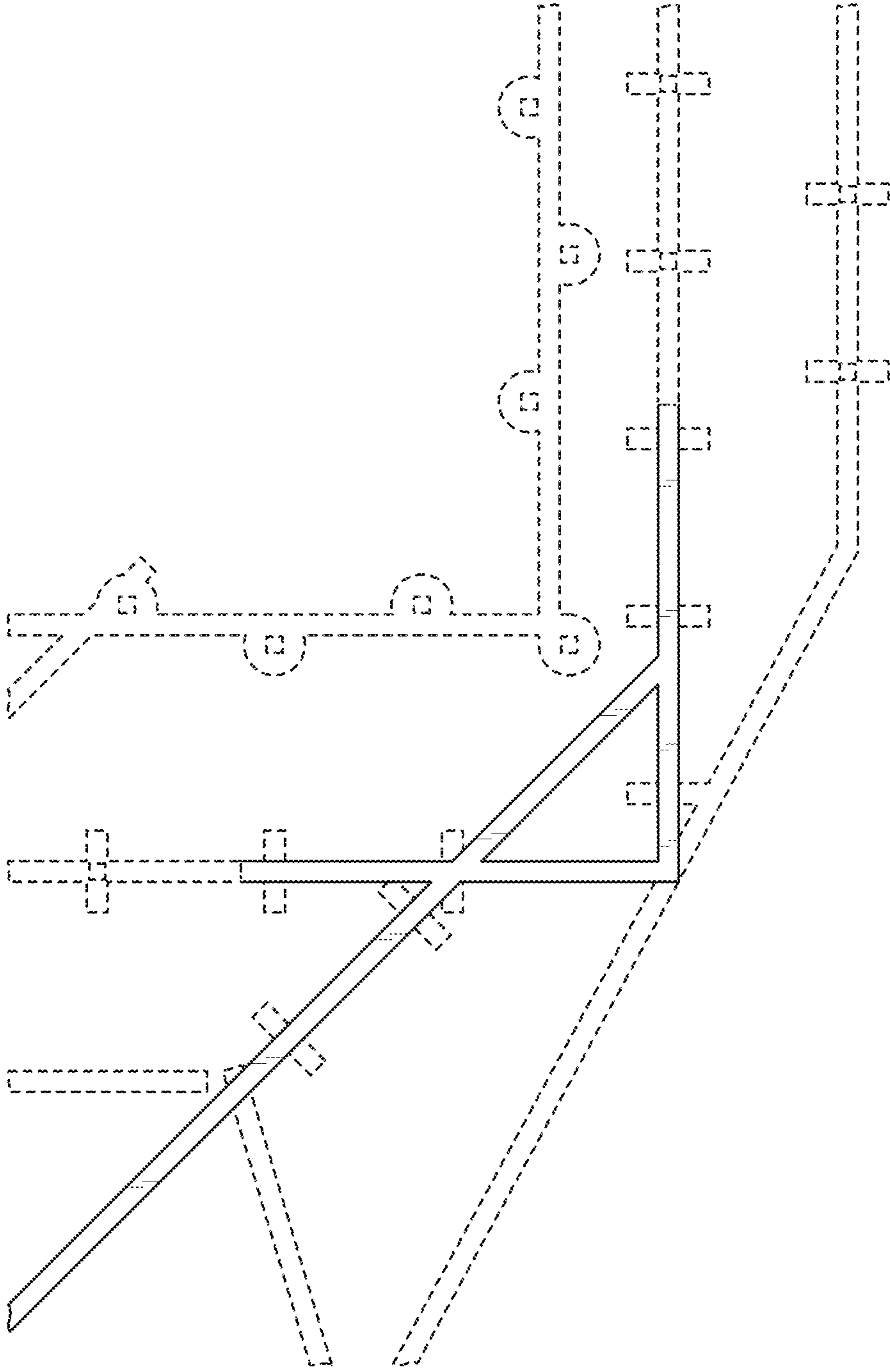

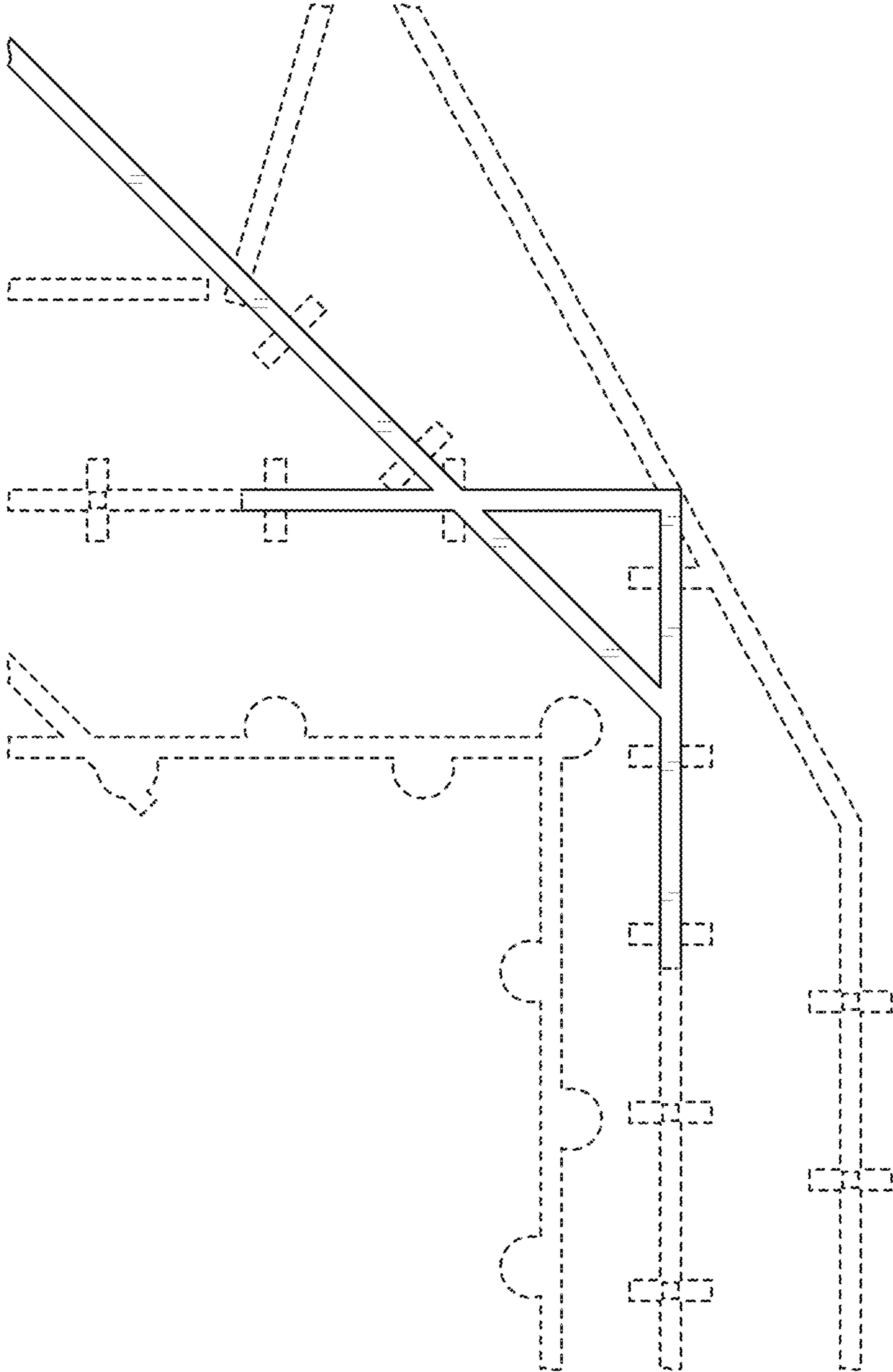

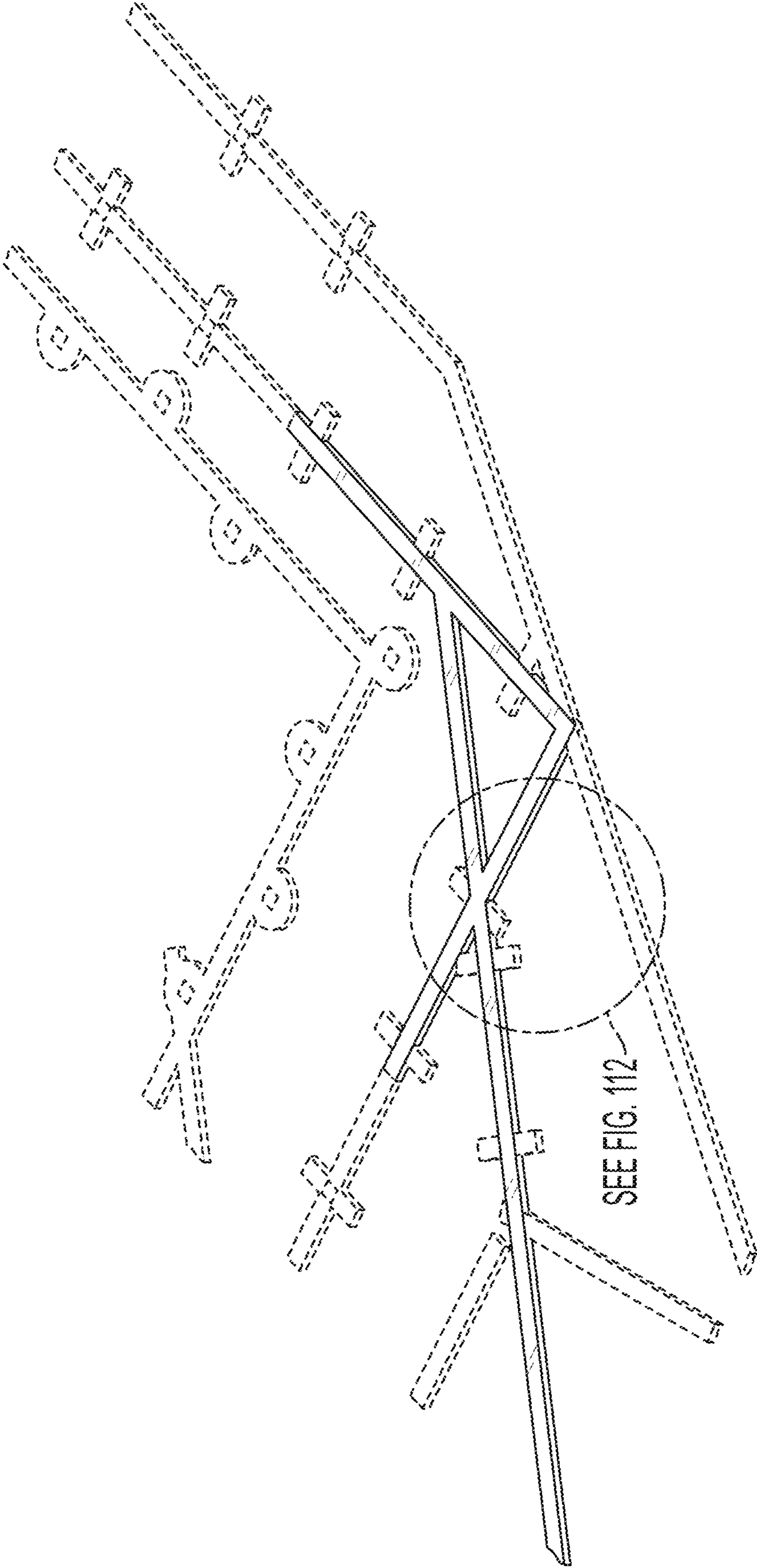

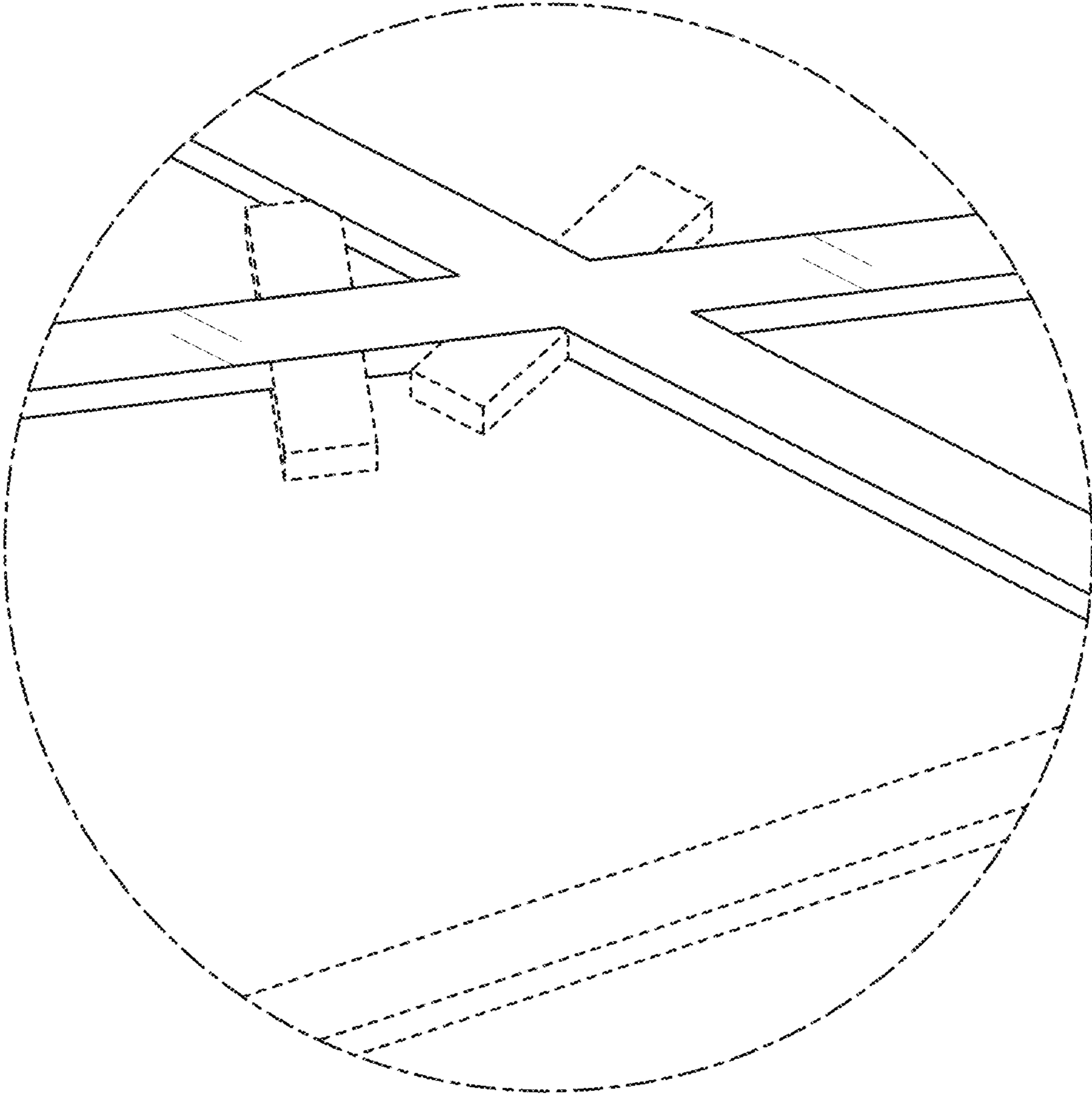
