(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a backpack, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the backpack showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is an alternate perspective view thereof showing the front of the design.

FIG. 3 is an alternate perspective view thereof, showing the top of the design, with the straps shown in an alternate position.

FIG. 4 is an alternate perspective view thereof, showing the left side of the design, with the straps shown in an alternate position.

FIG. 5 is an alternate perspective view thereof, showing the right side of the design, with the straps shown in an alternate position.

FIG. 6 is an alternate perspective view thereof, showing the back of the design, with the straps shown in an alternate position.

FIG. 7 is an alternate perspective view thereof, showing the bottom of the design, with the straps shown in an alternate position, and with the draw strings out of view due to the vantage point; and,

FIG. 8 is a top perspective view thereof, with the backpack in the open configuration, with the straps shown in an alternate position.

The masked area defined by broken lines depicts portions of the backpack which form no part of the claimed design.

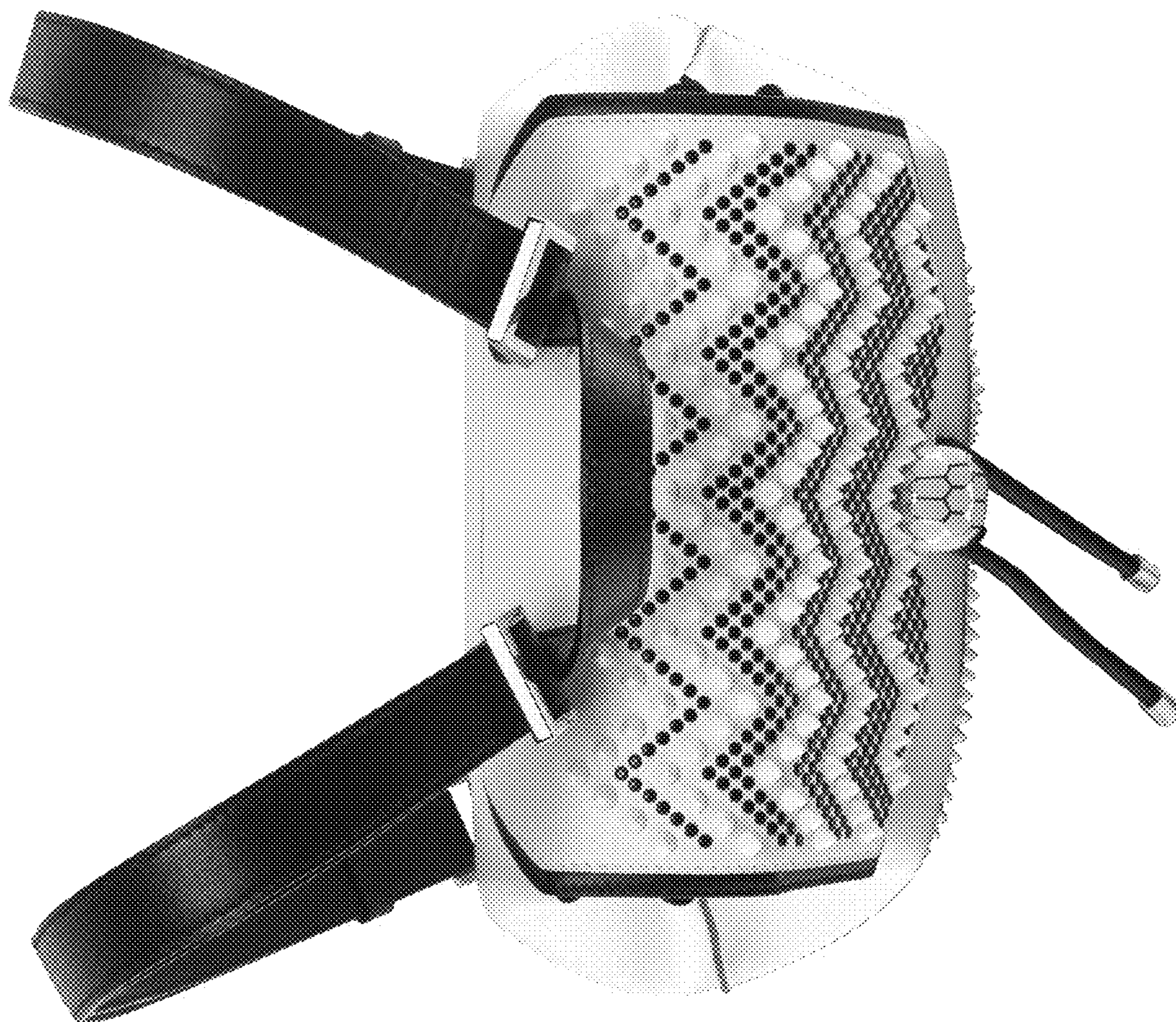
